as shown.

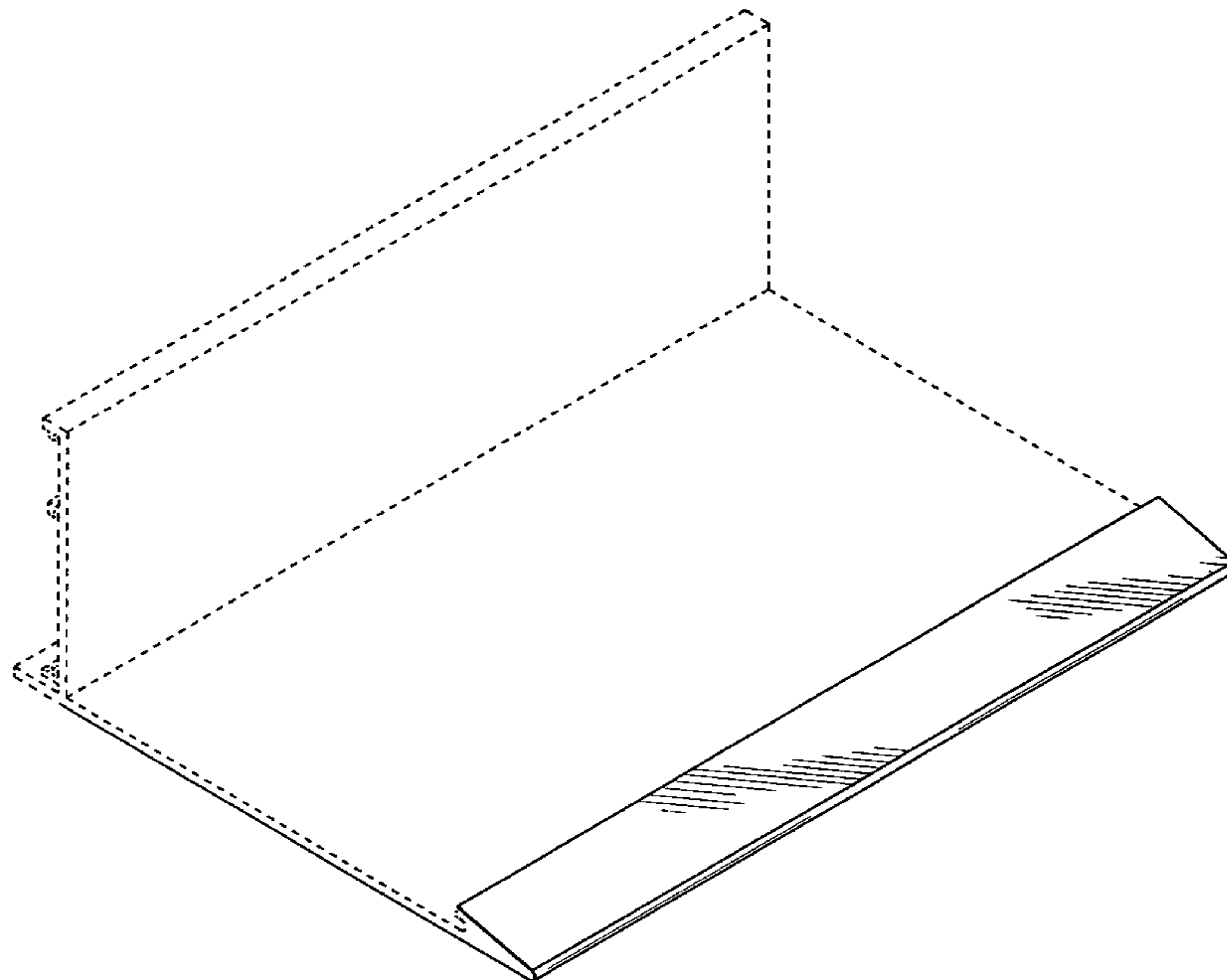
DESCRIPTION

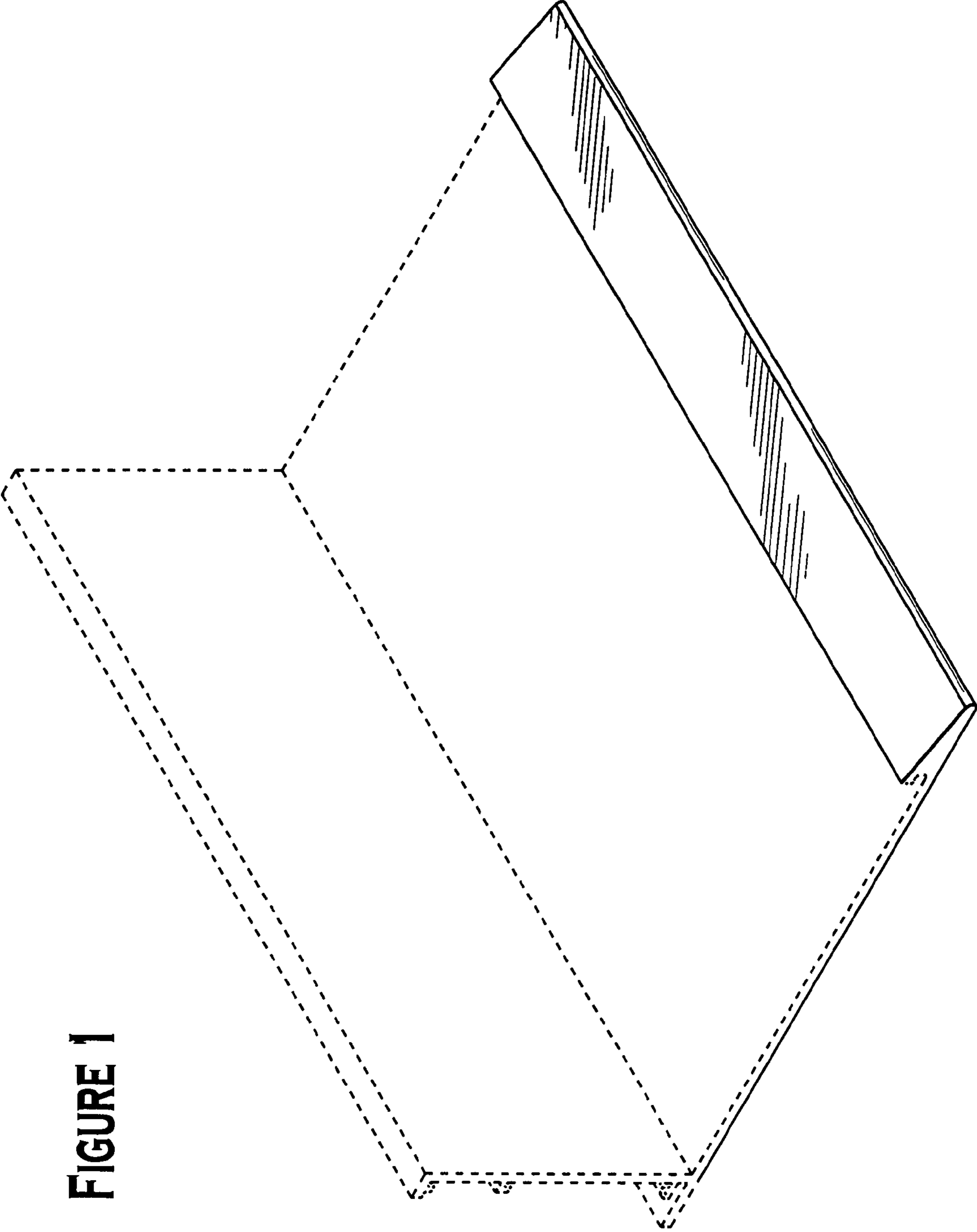

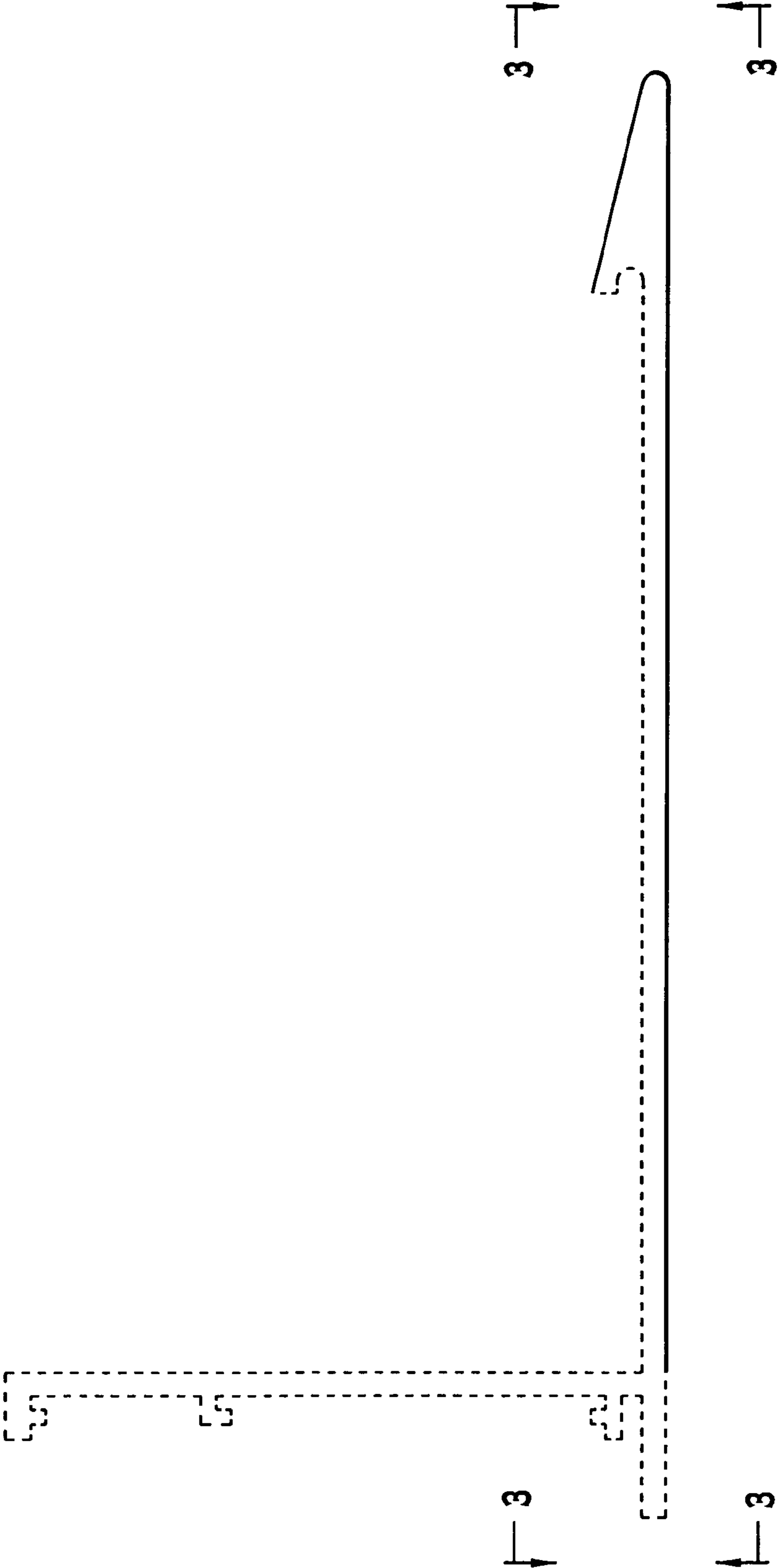
