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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a handle for decorating tools, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the top, front and left side of my new design for a handle for decorating tools;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation of the handle of FIG. 1;

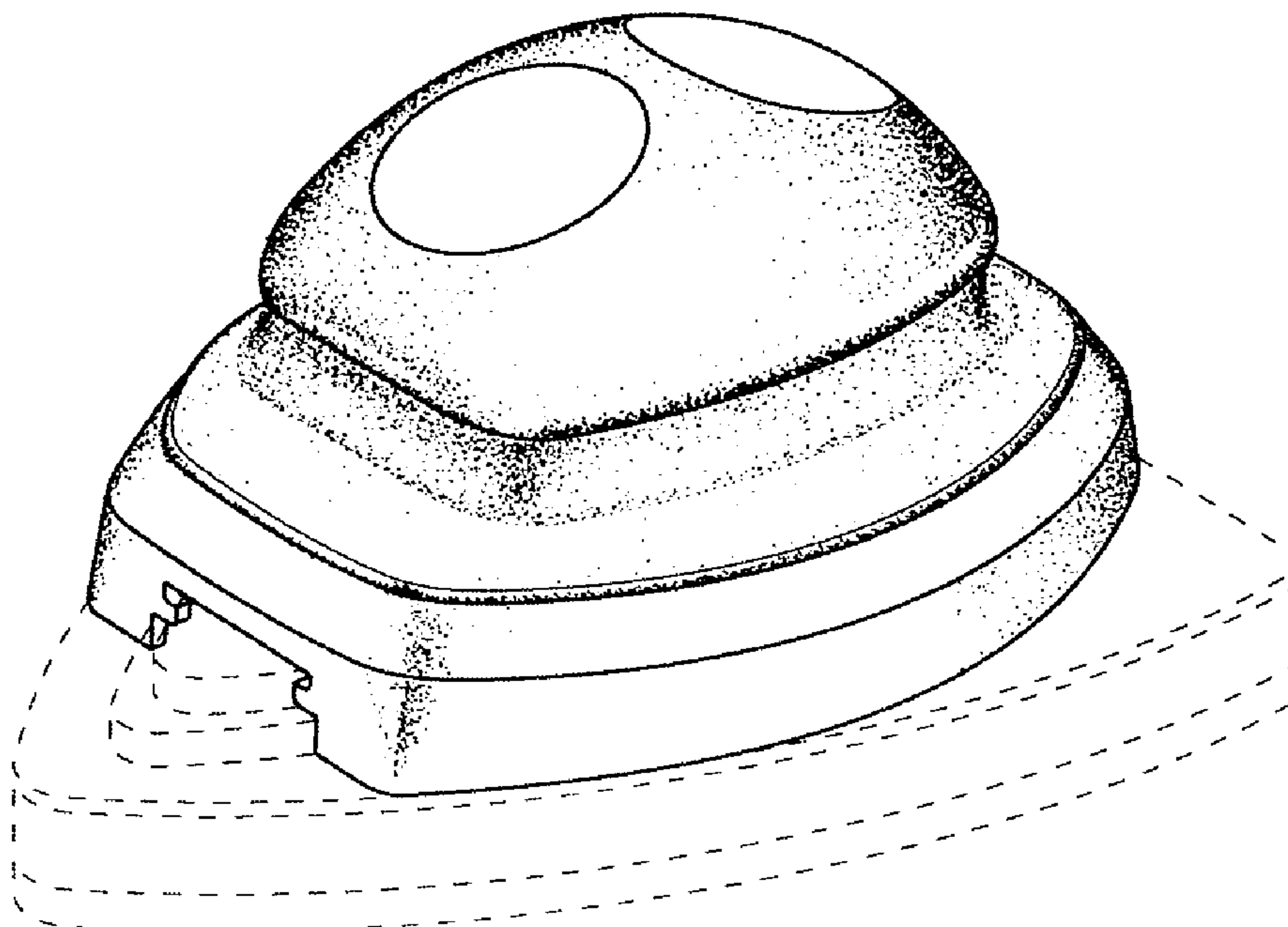
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation of the handle of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a side elevation of the handle of FIG. 1, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and,

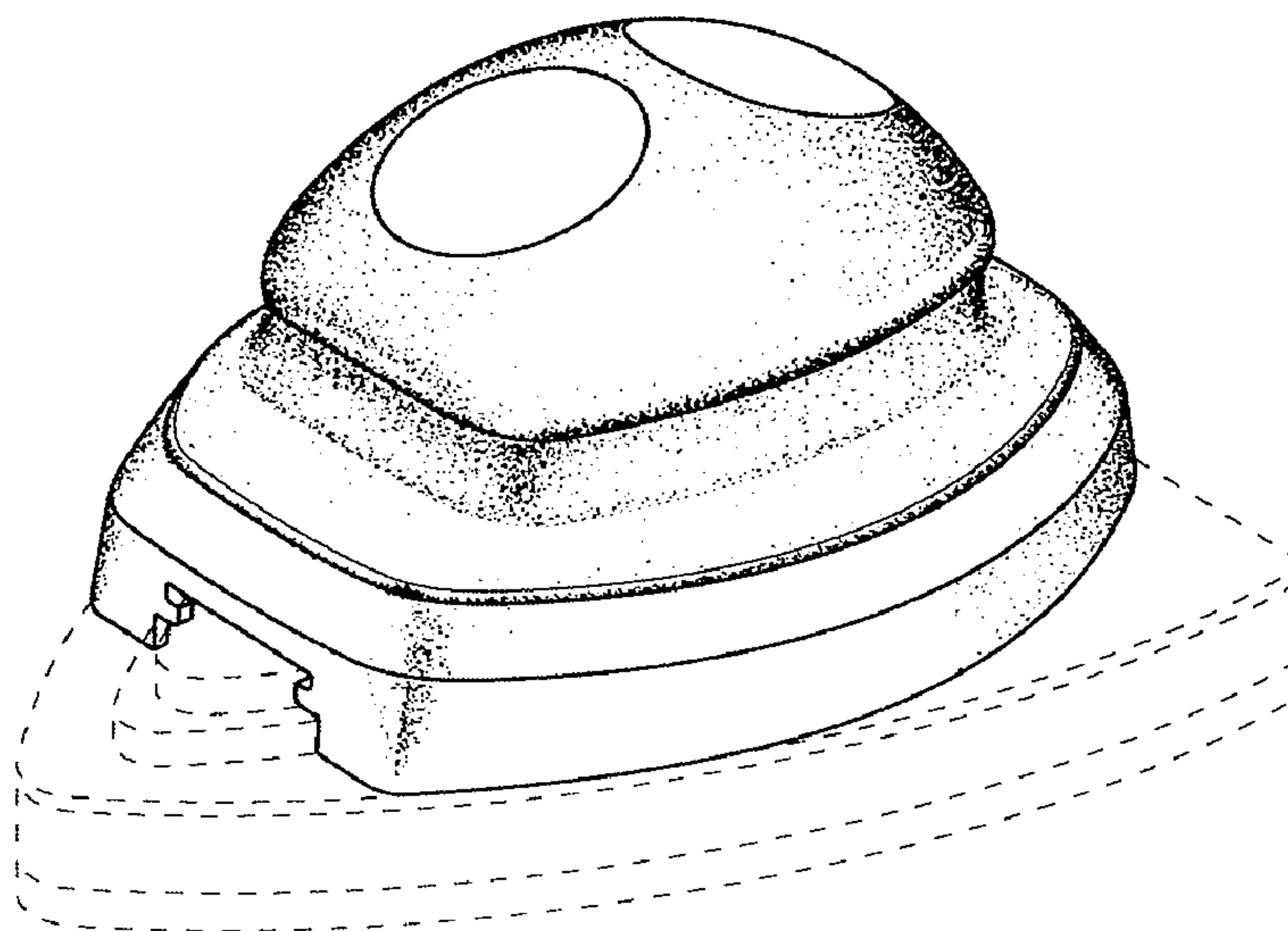

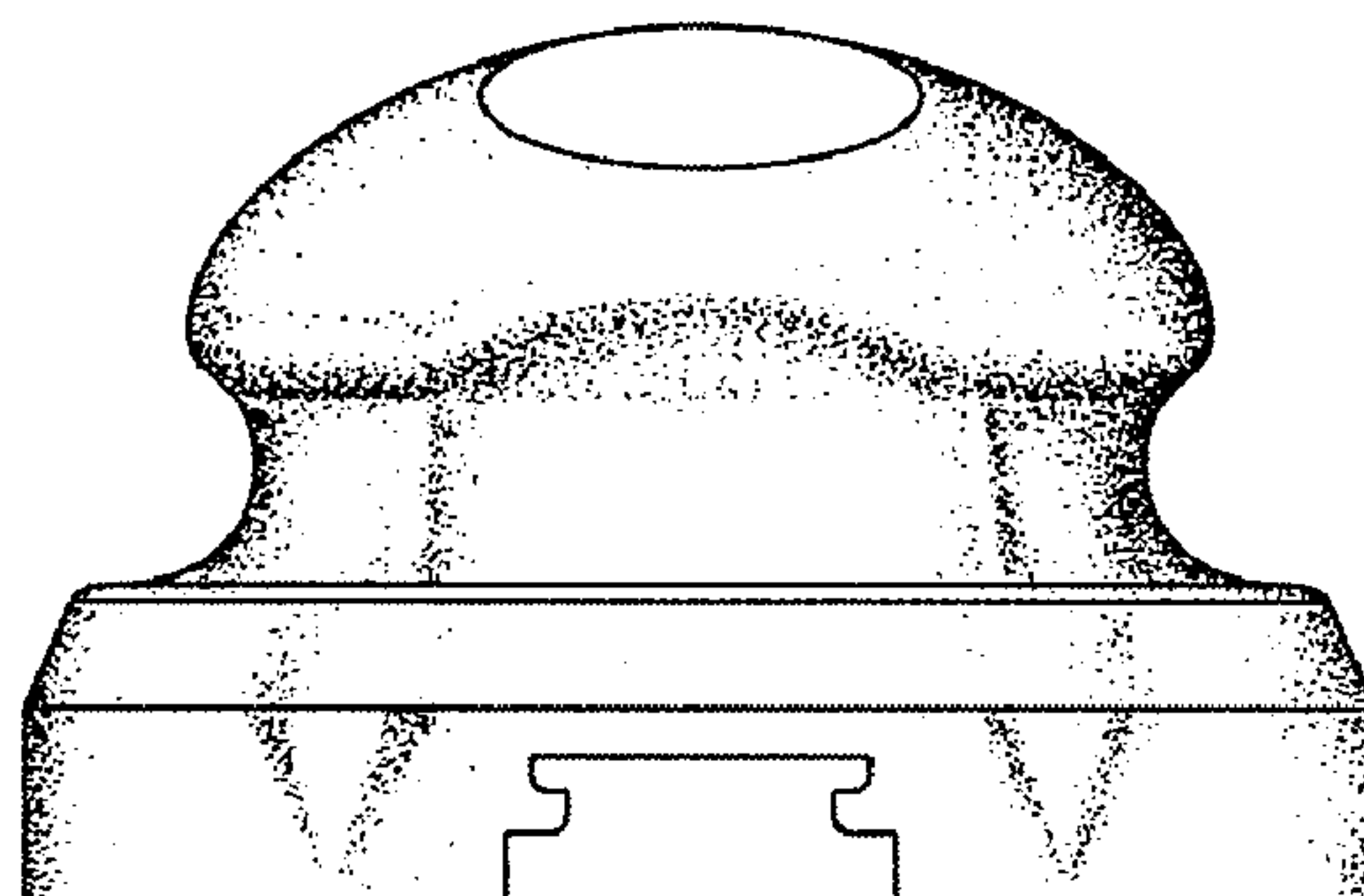

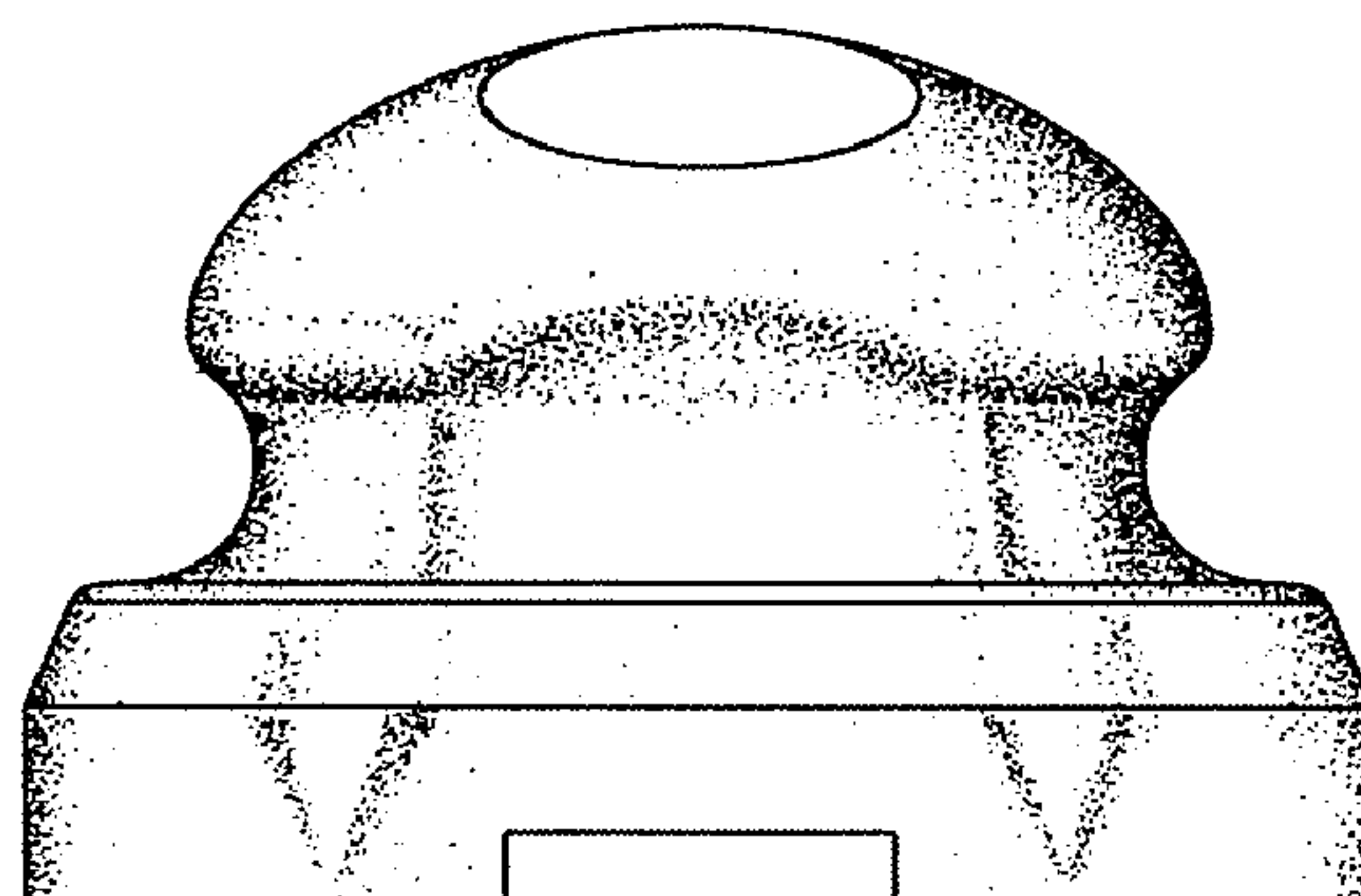

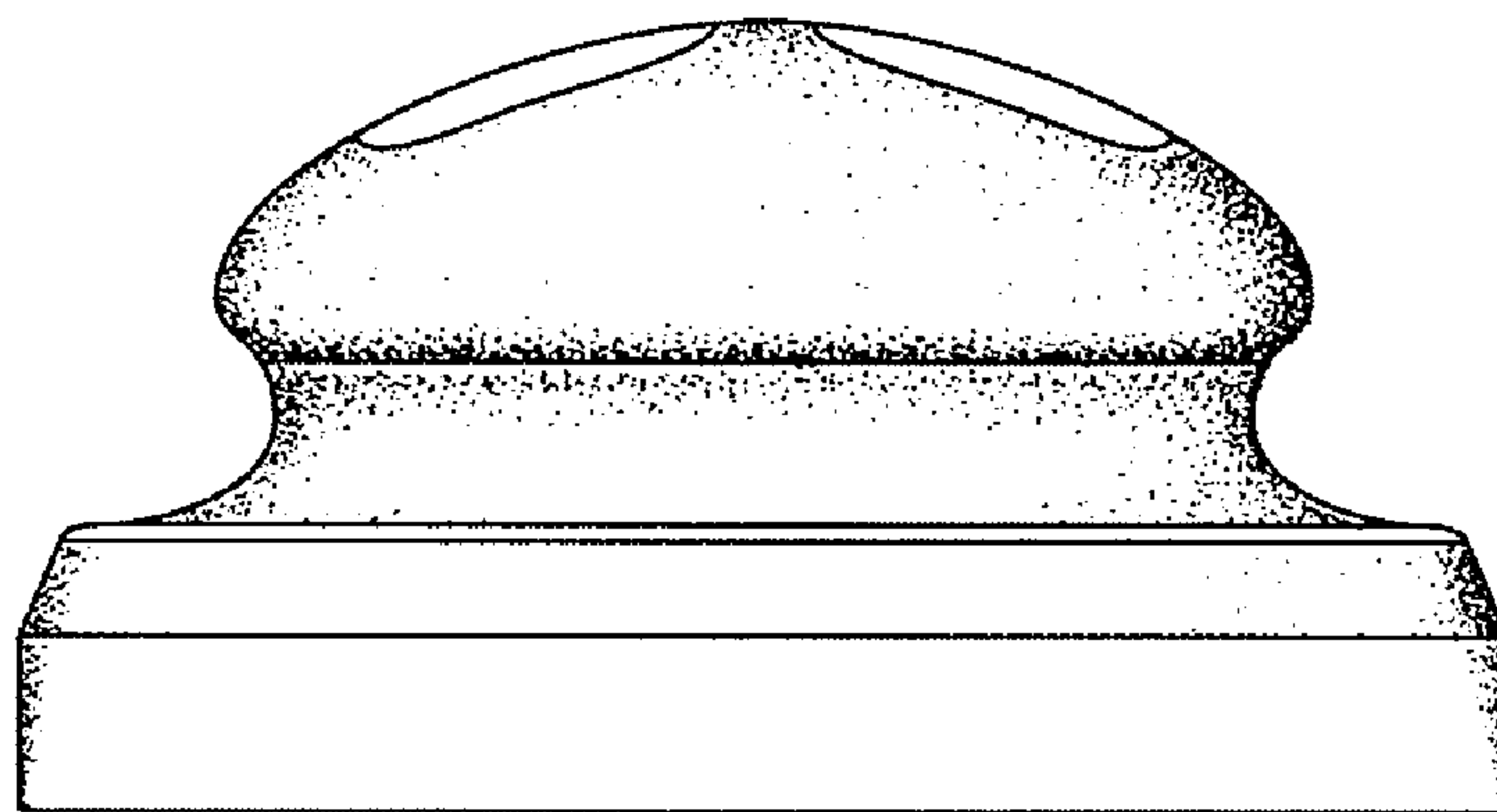

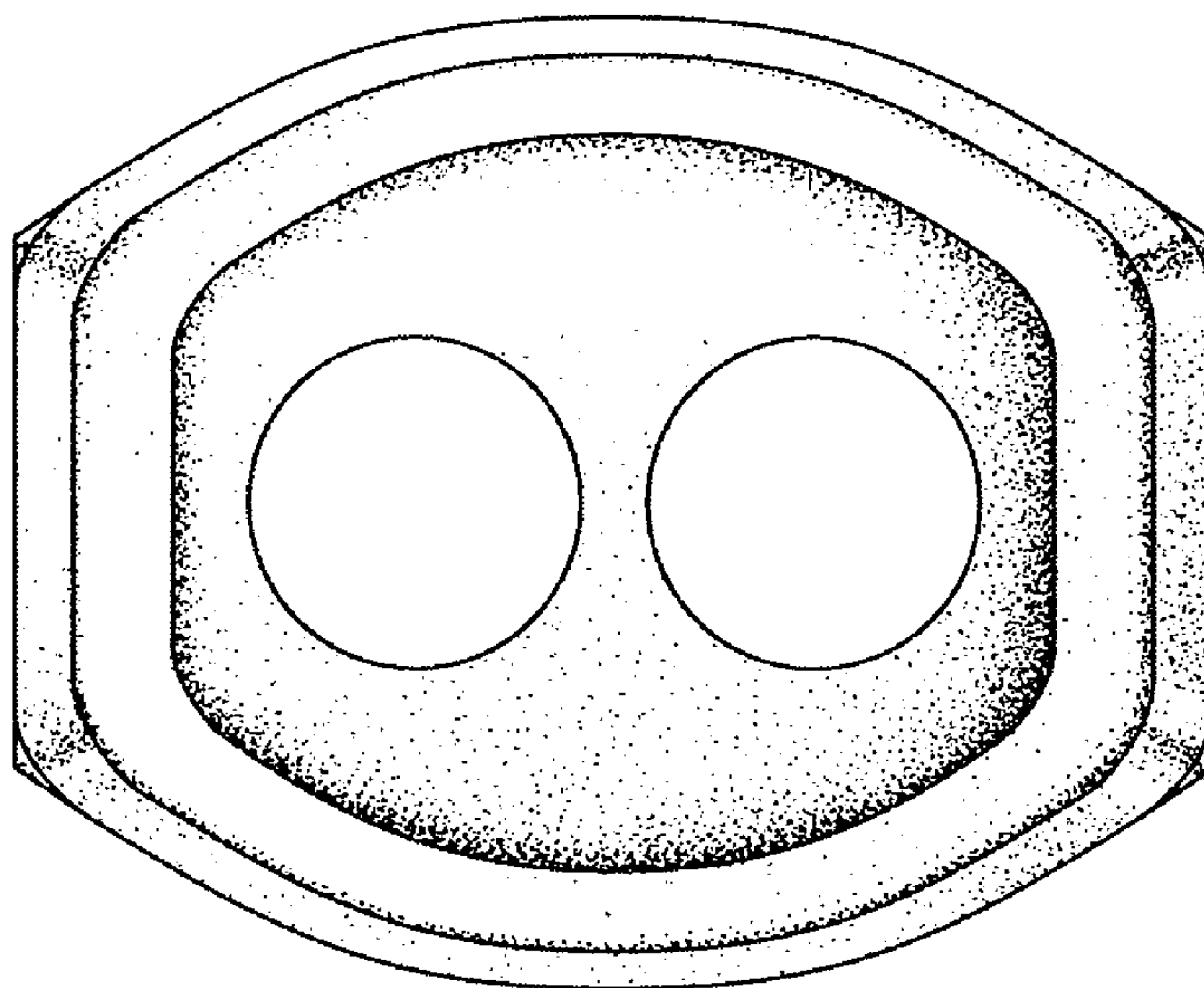
