(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an ankle brace cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a lateral view of an ankle brace cover.

FIG. 2 is a contra-lateral view of an ankle brace cover.

FIG. 3 is an enlarged top view of an ankle brace cover.

FIG. 4 is a front view of an ankle brace cover in use.

FIG. 5 is an enlarged lateral perspective view of an ankle brace cover in use.

FIG. 6 is an enlarged contra-lateral perspective view of an ankle brace cover in use.

FIG. 7 is a back view of an ankle brace cover.

FIG. 8 is a lateral view of an ankle brace cover.

FIG. 9 is a contra-lateral view of an ankle brace cover.

FIG. 10 is an enlarged top view of an ankle brace cover.

FIG. 11 is a front view of an ankle brace cover in use.

FIG. 12 is an enlarged lateral perspective view of an ankle brace cover in use.

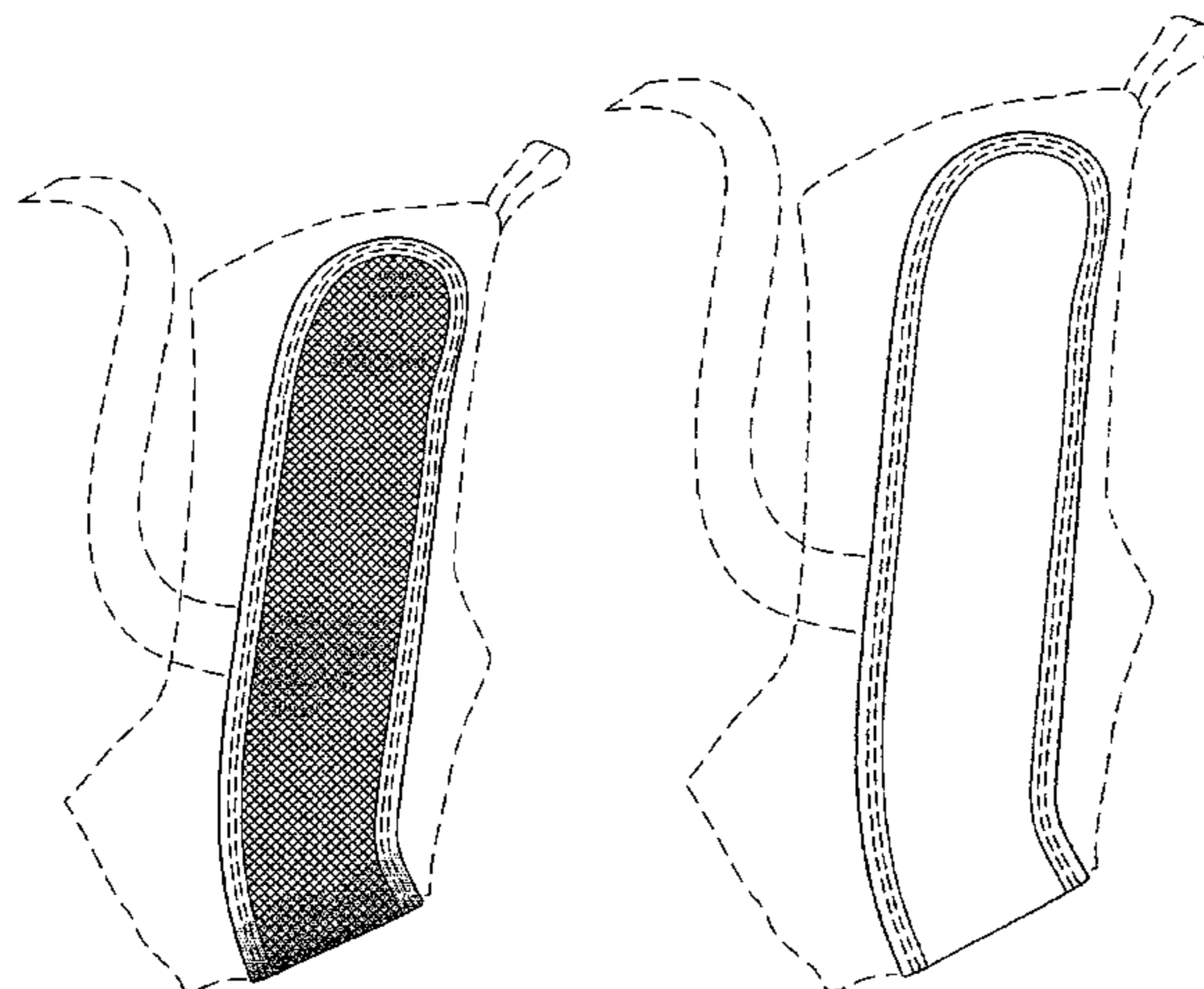
FIG. 13 is an enlarged contra-lateral perspective view of an ankle brace cover in use; and,

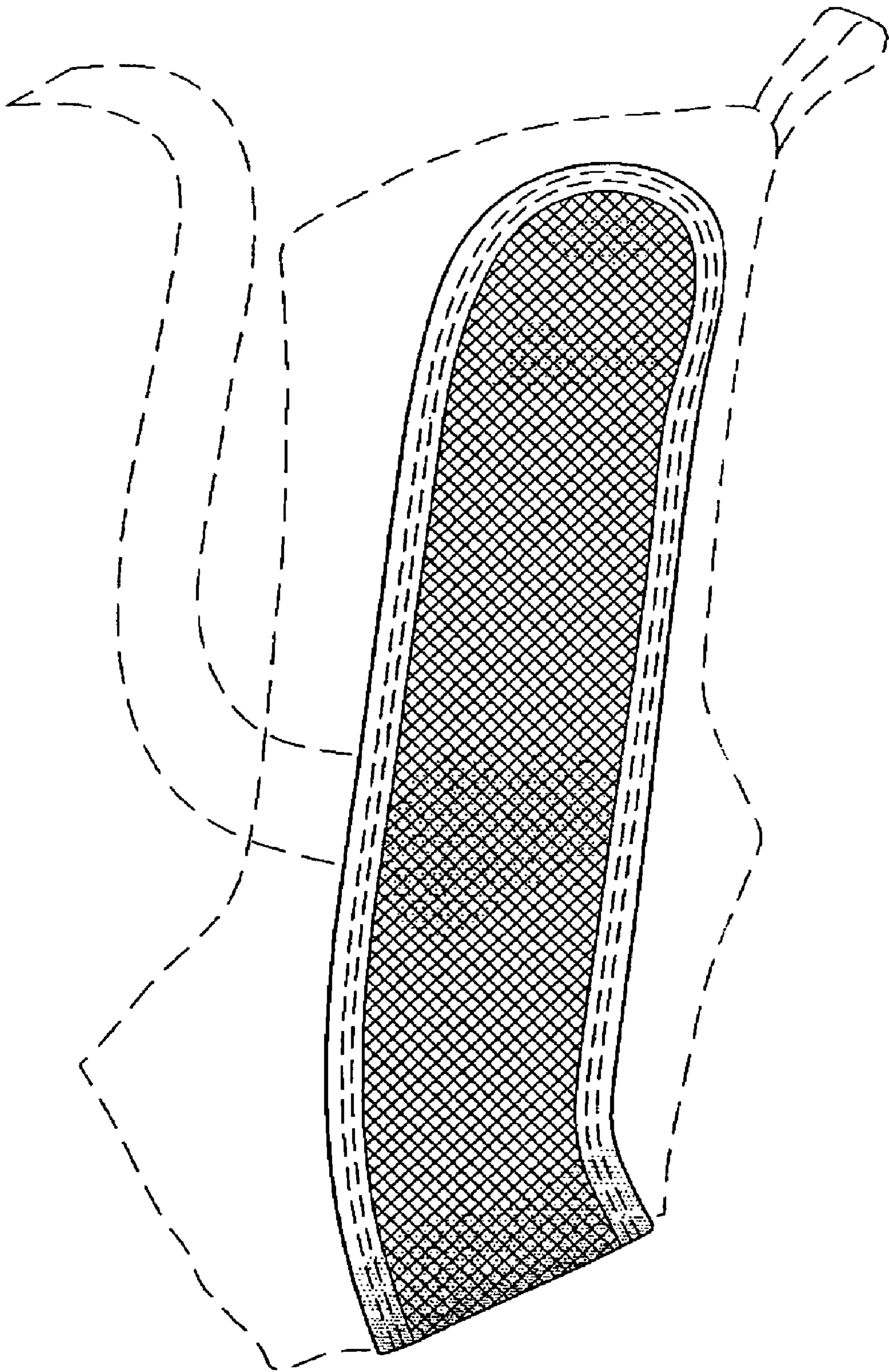

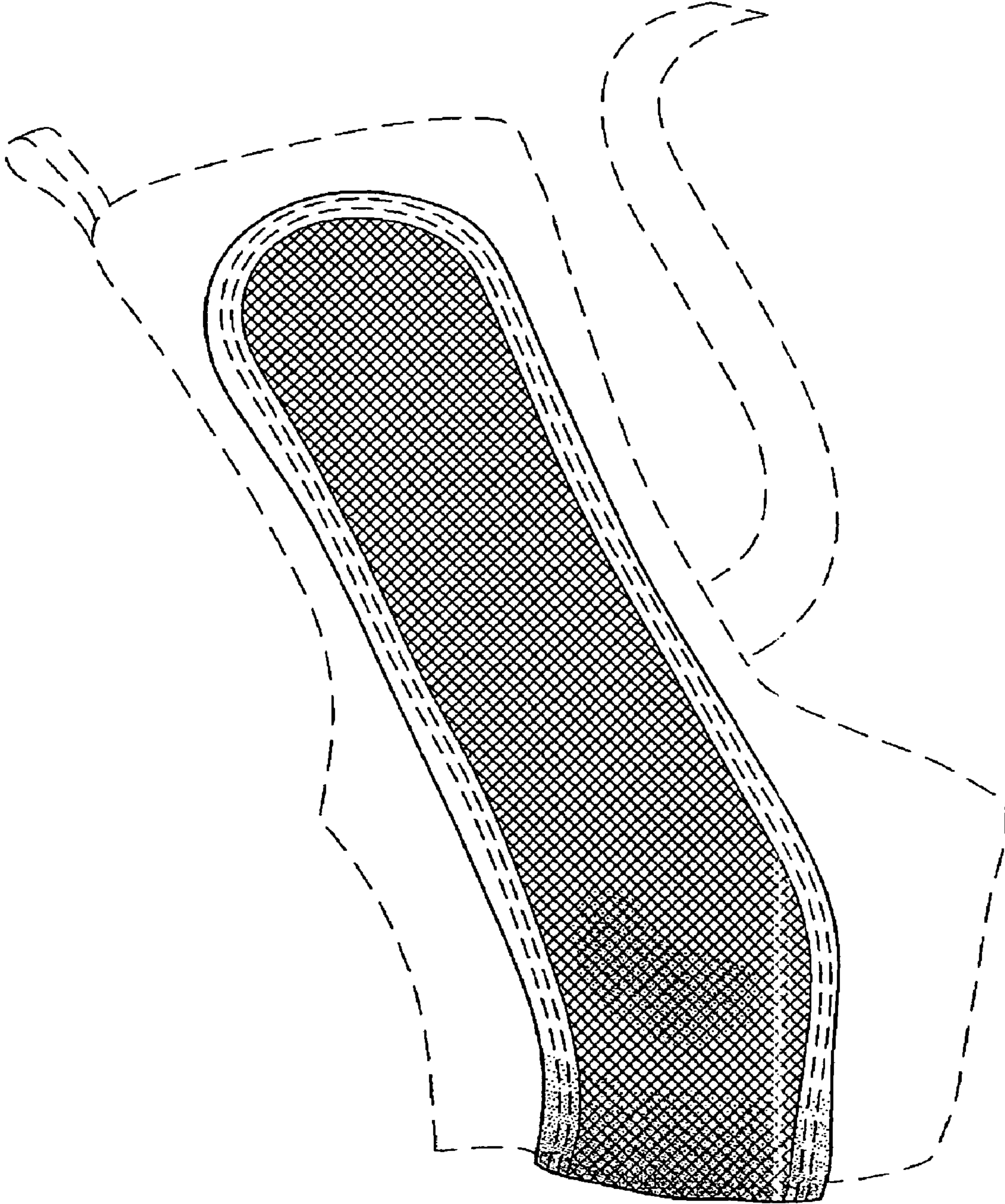

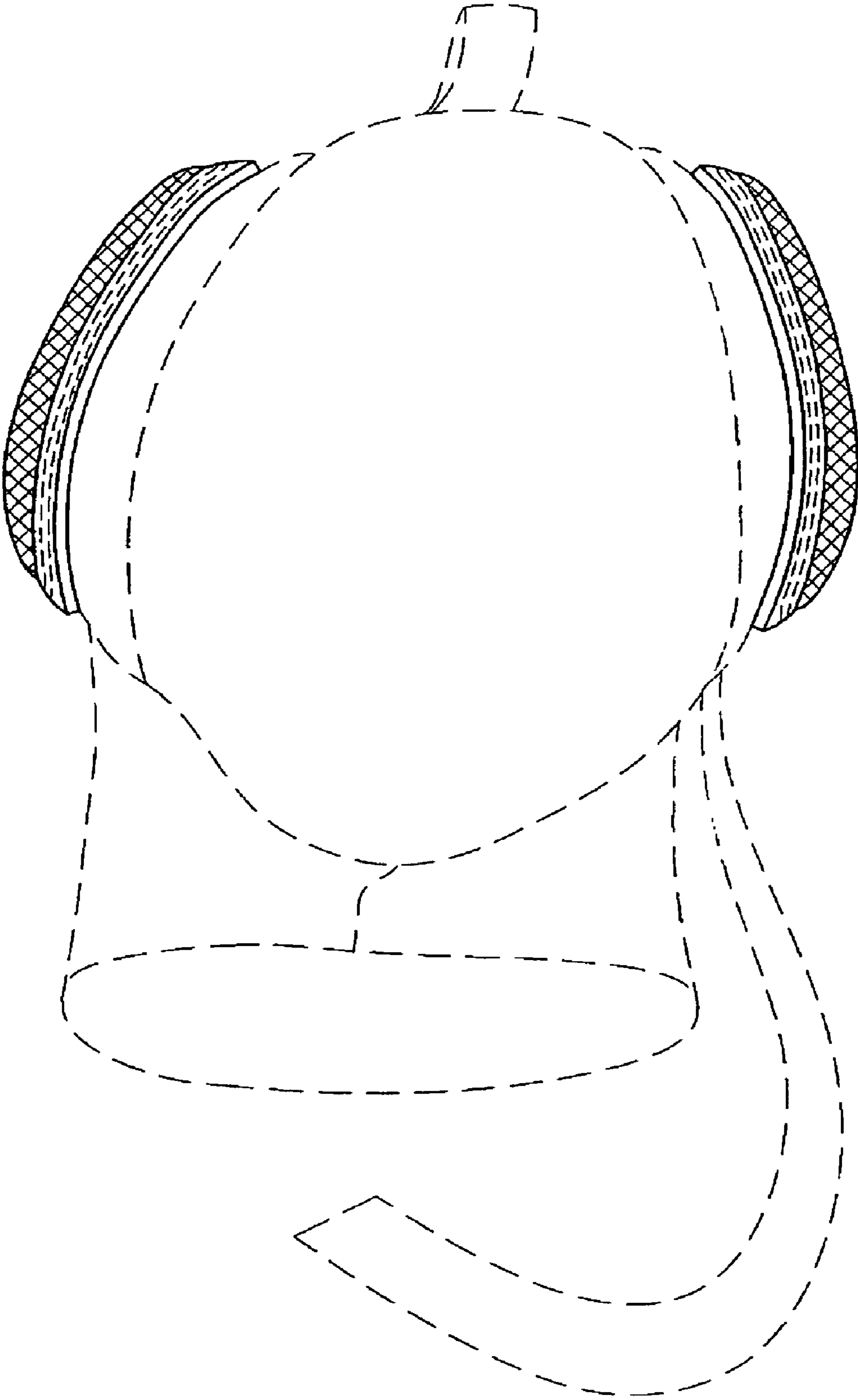

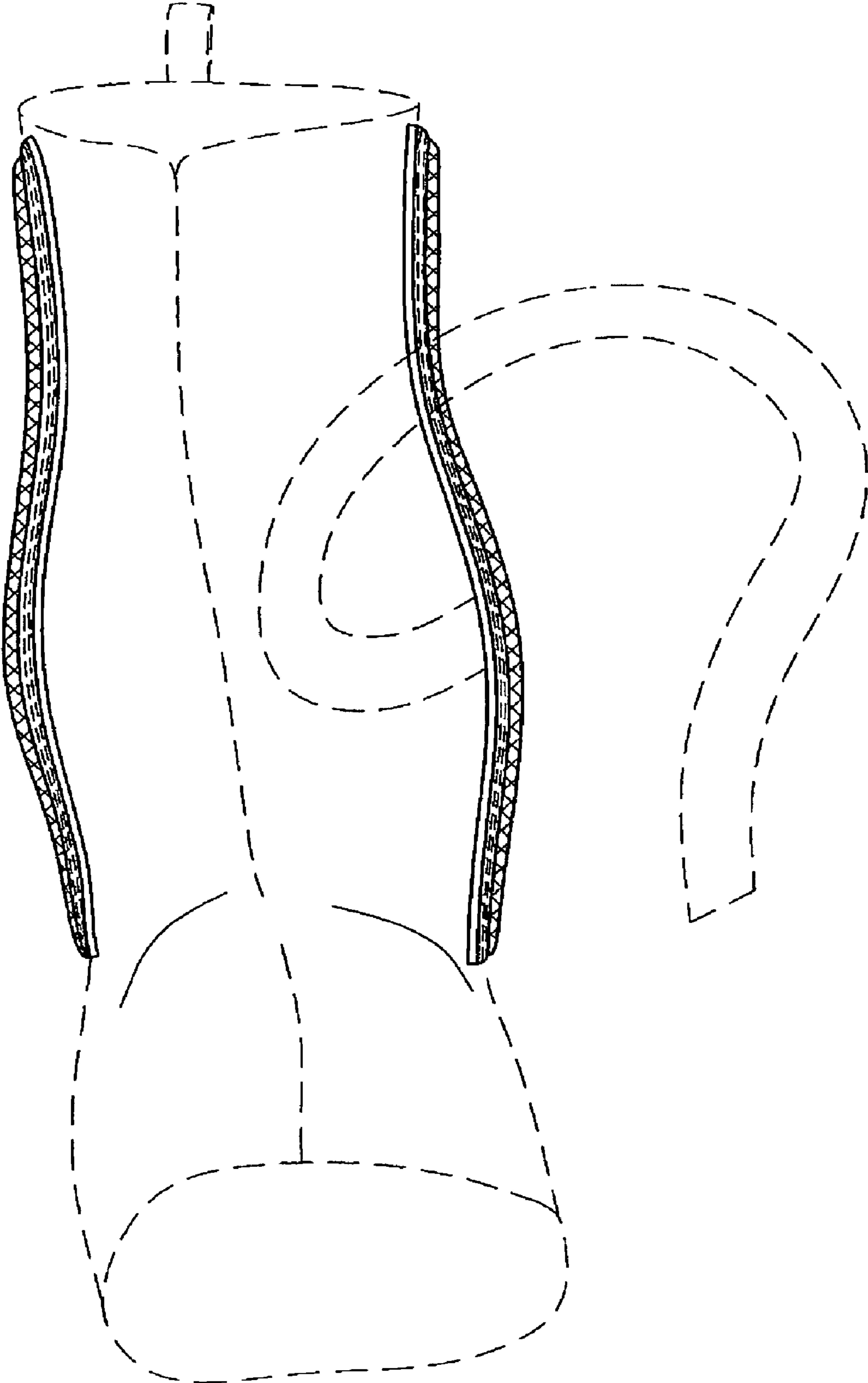

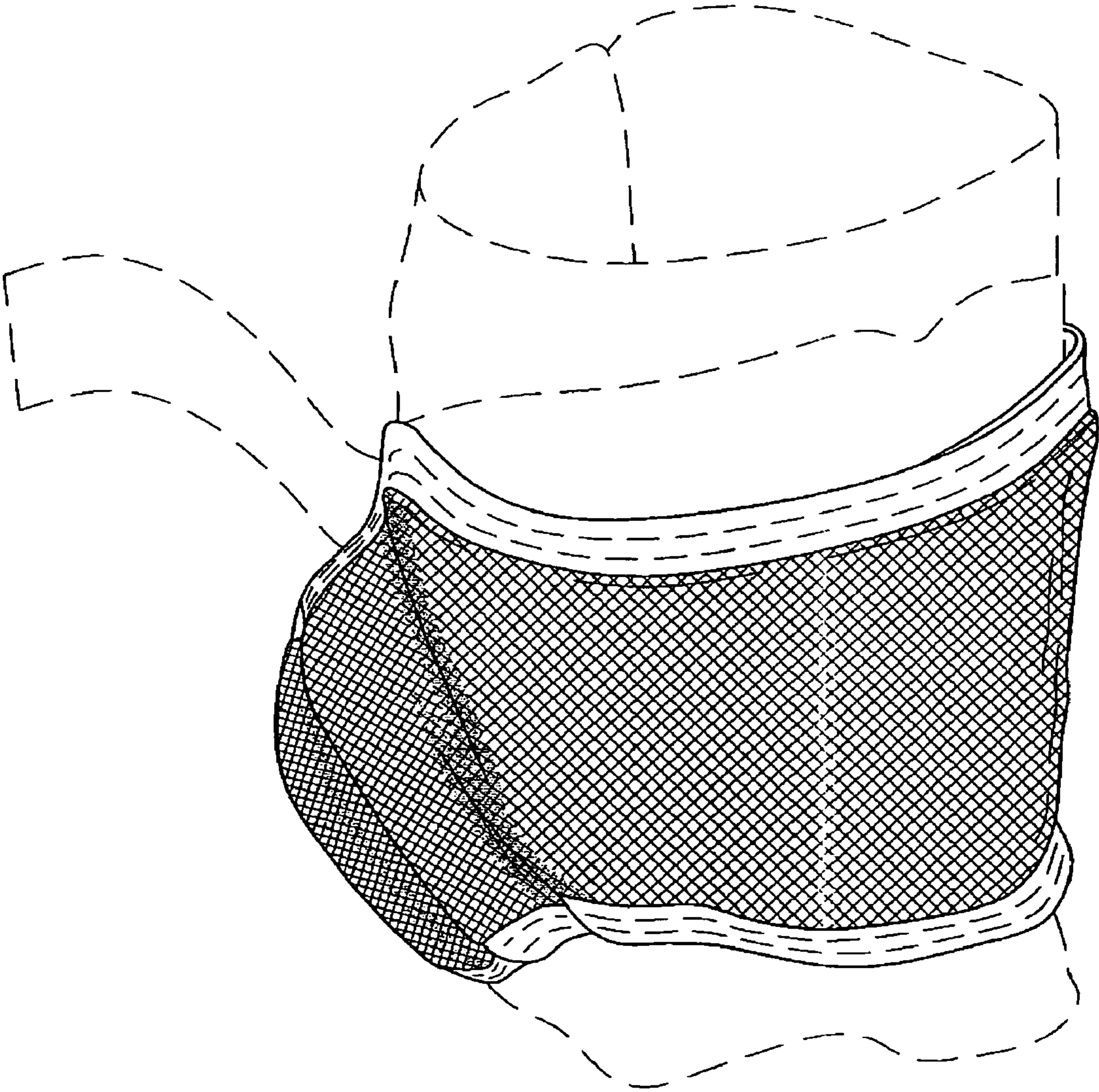

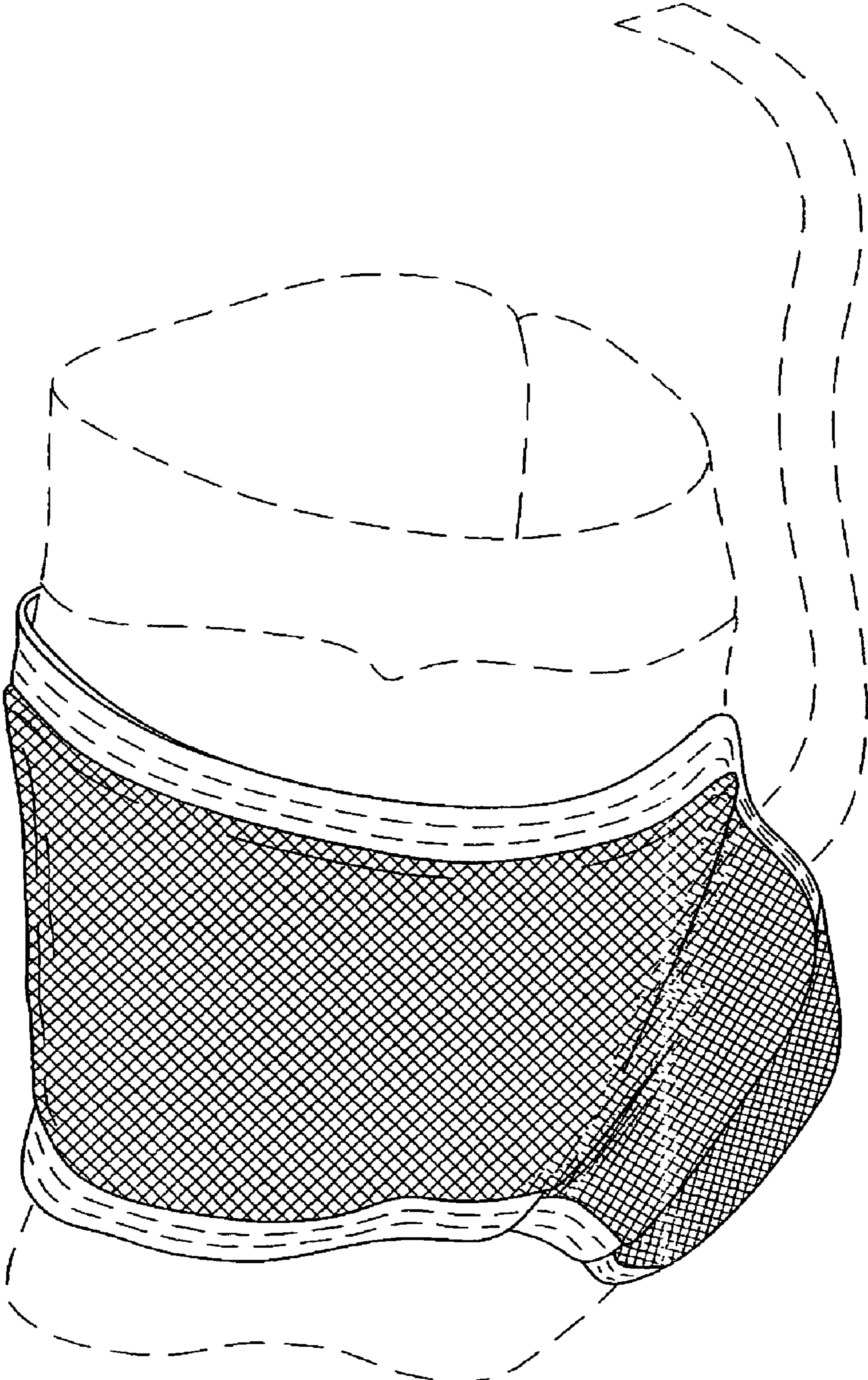

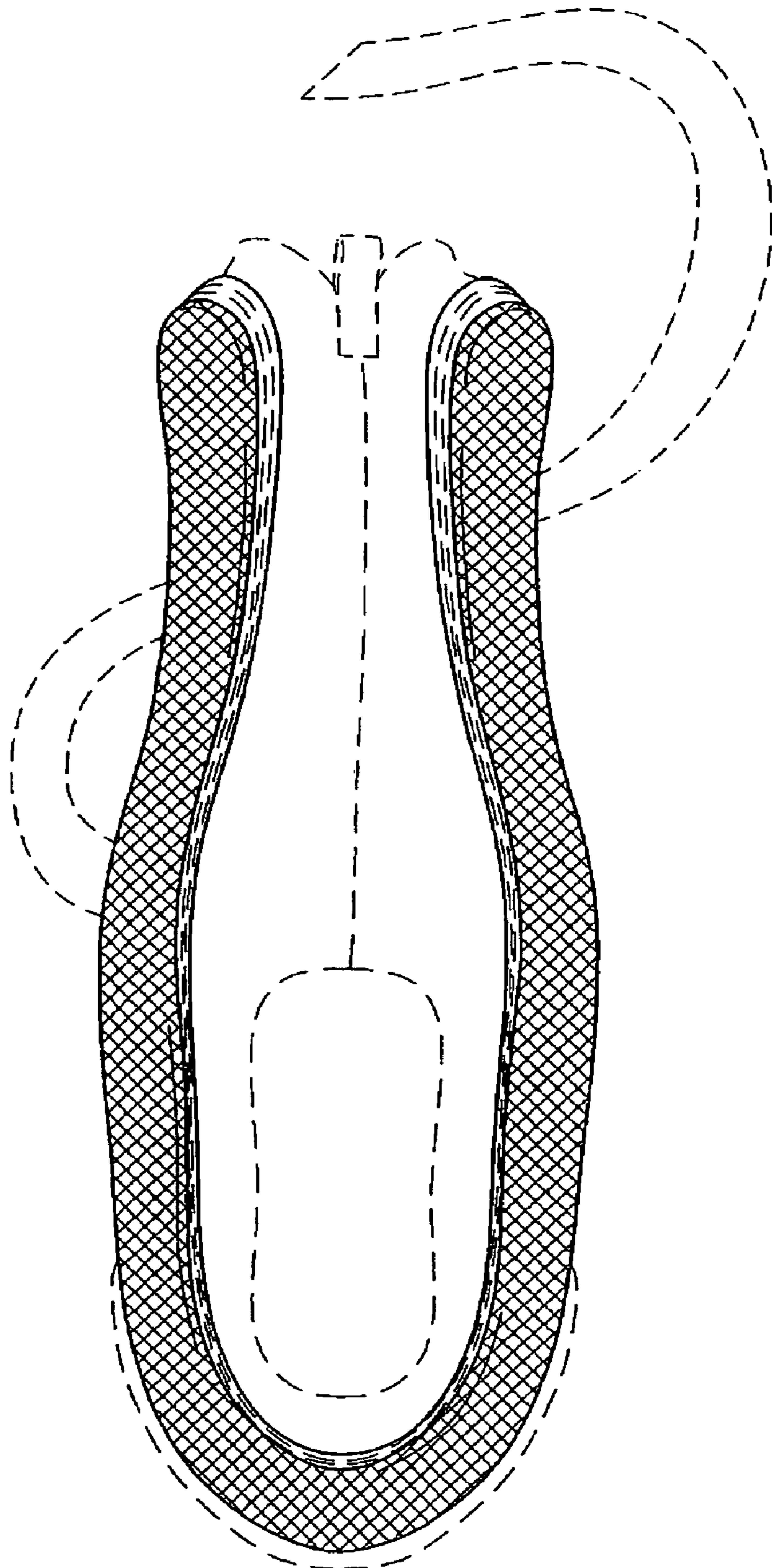

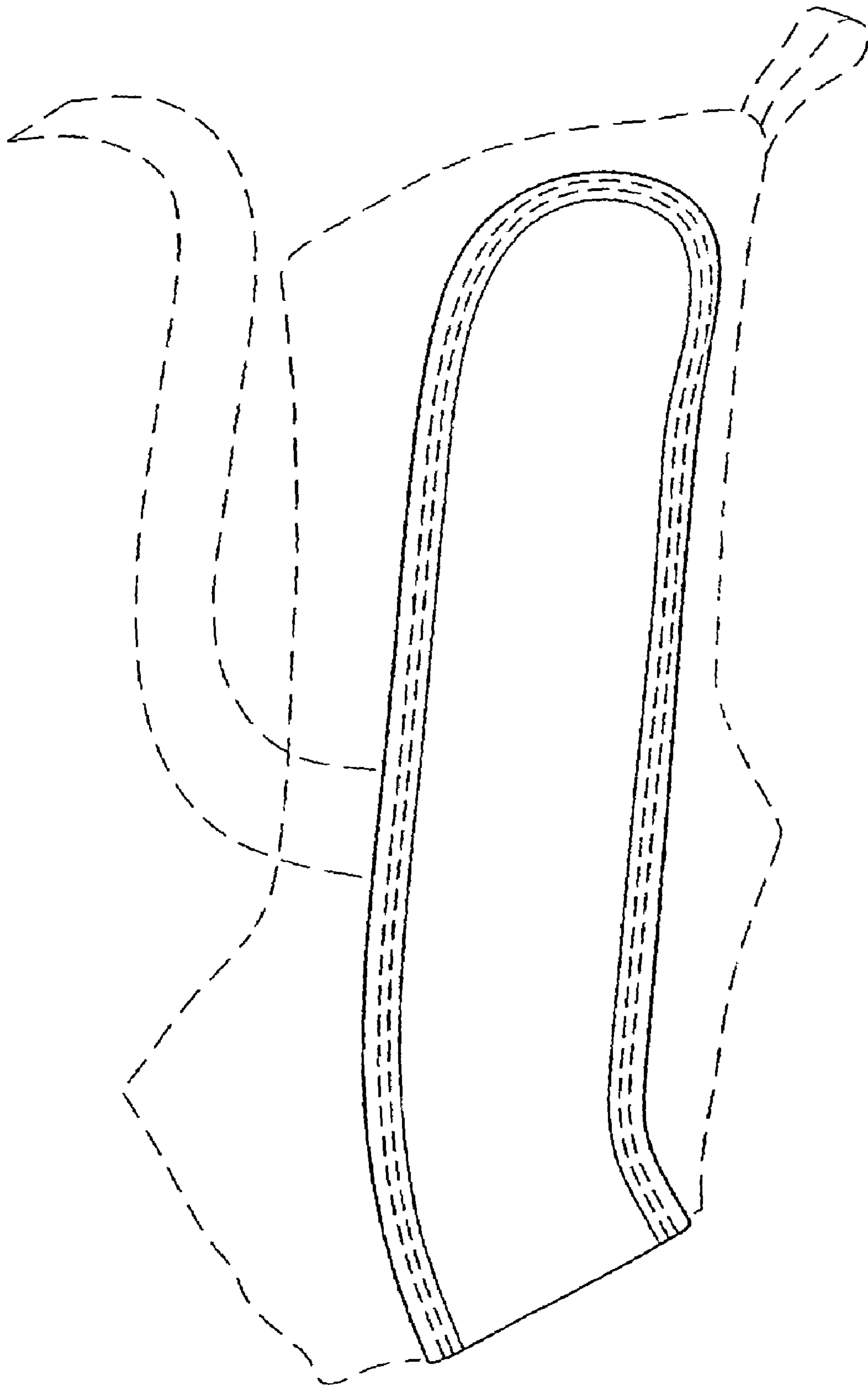

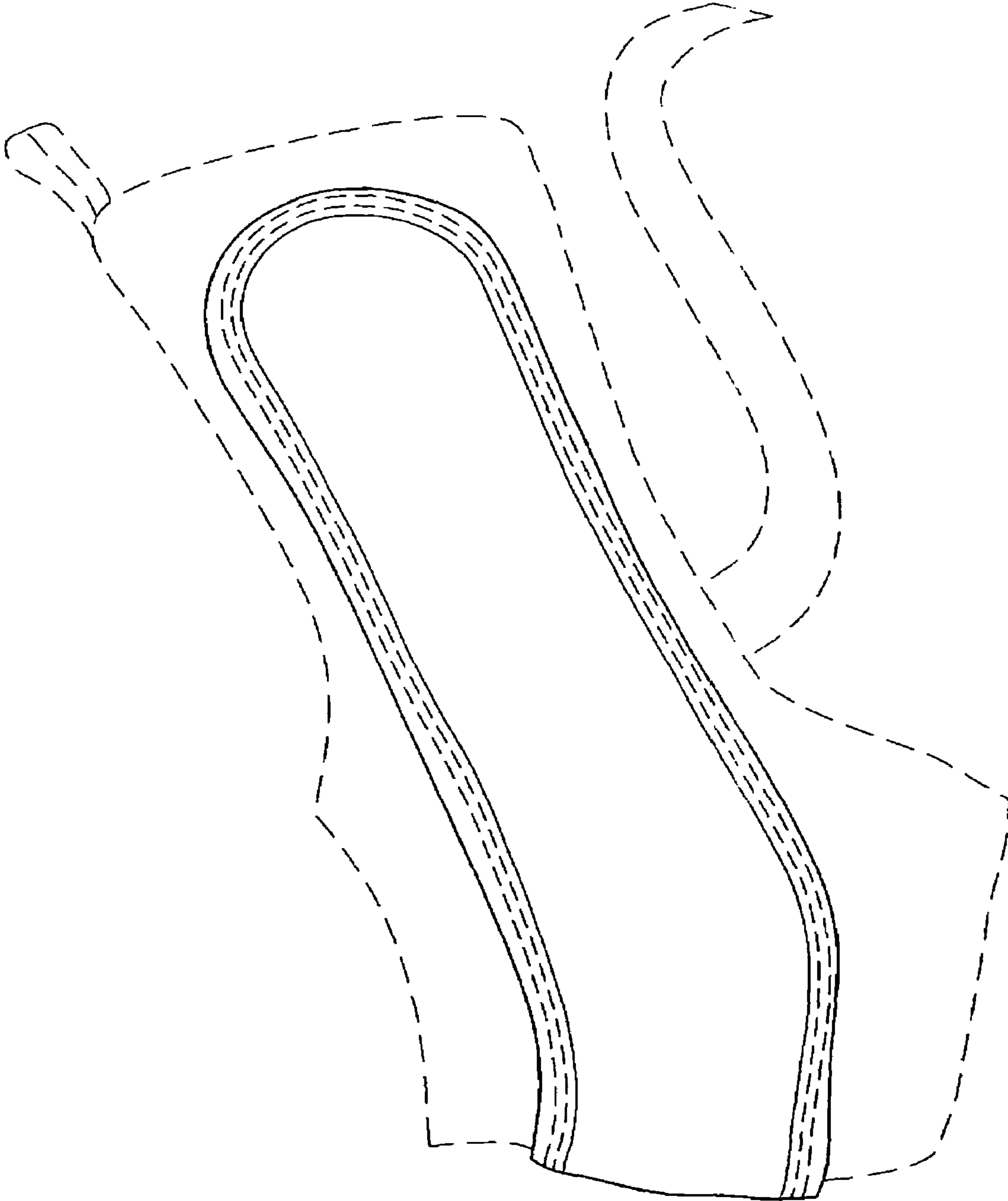

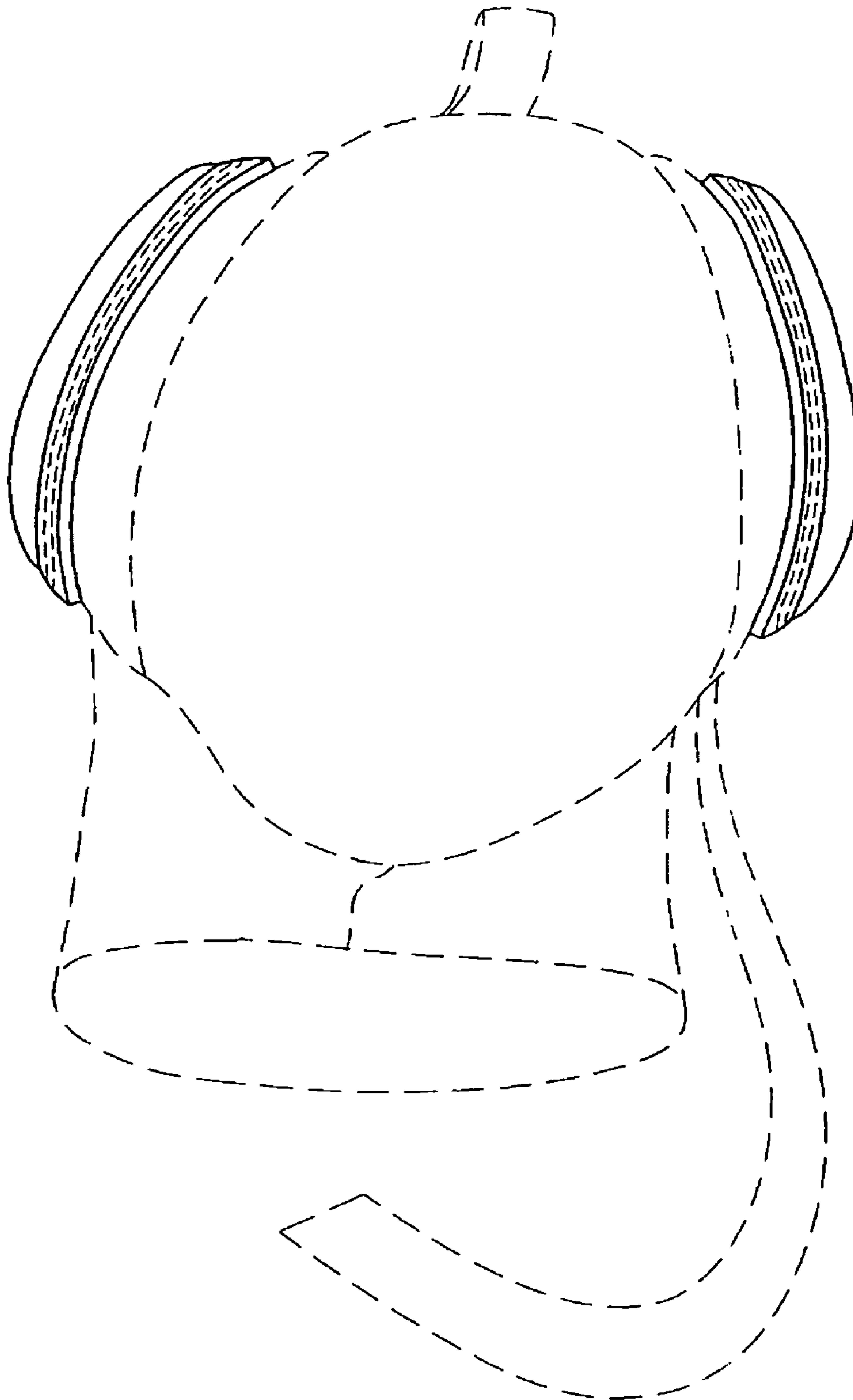

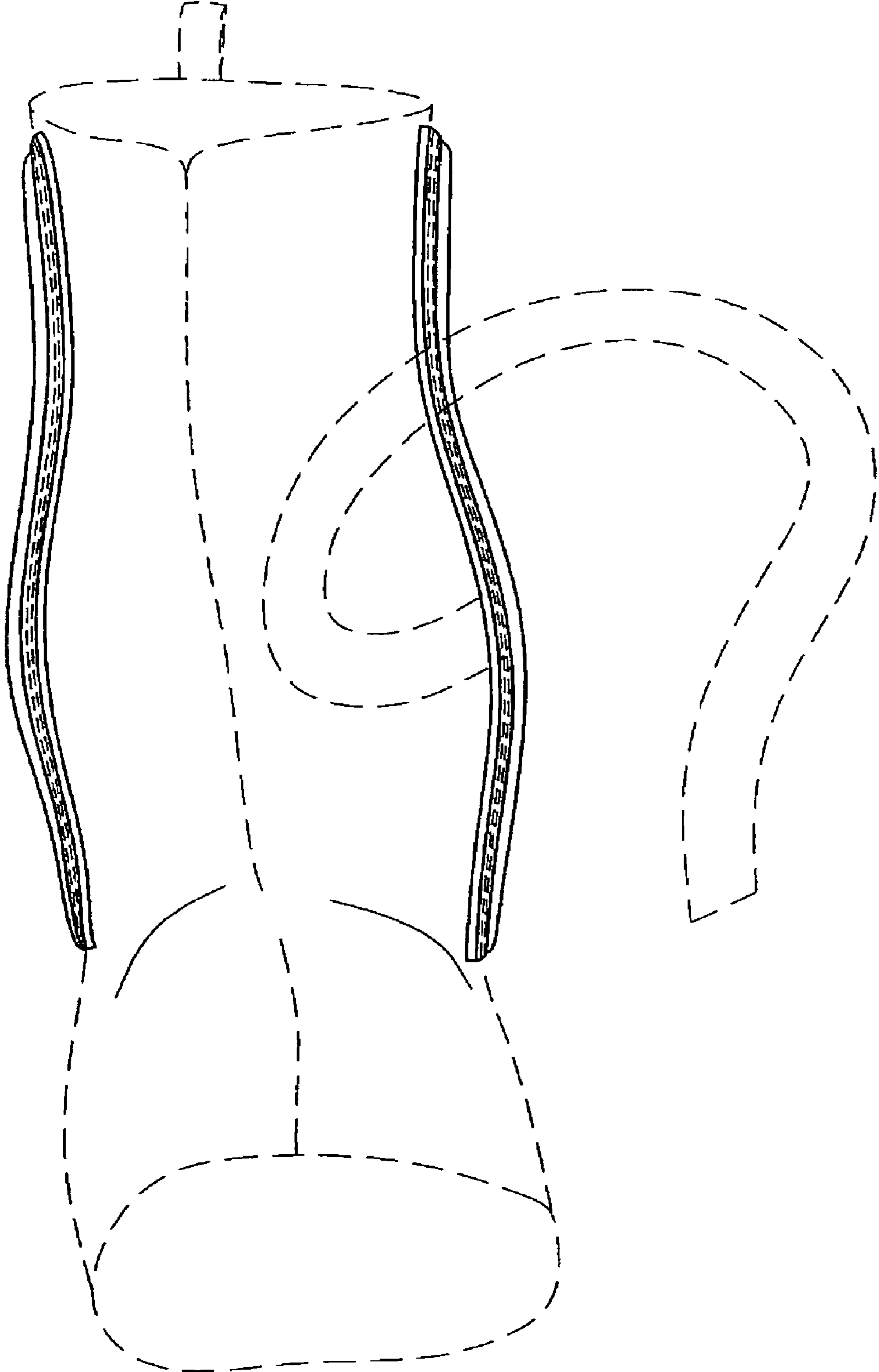

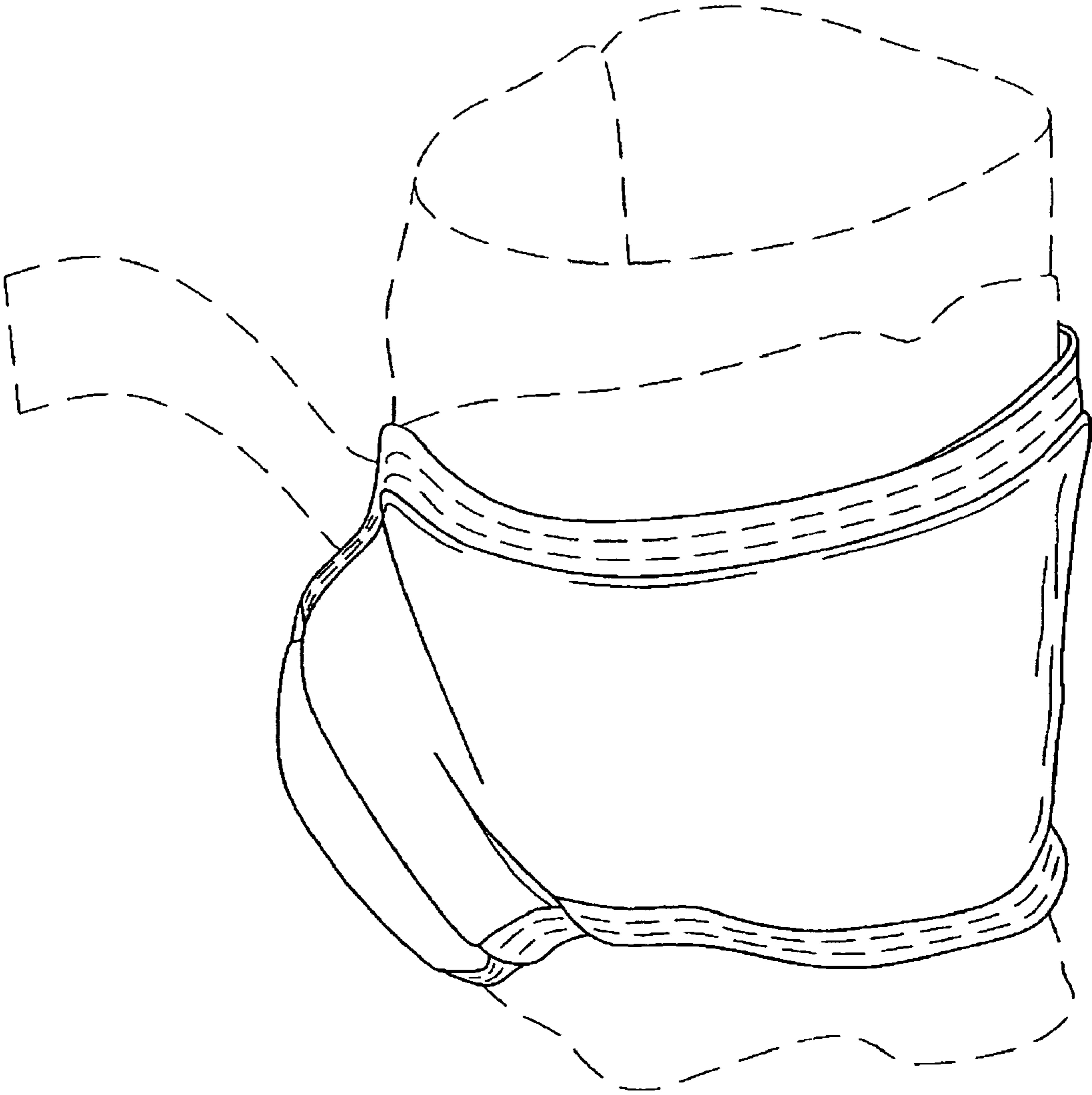

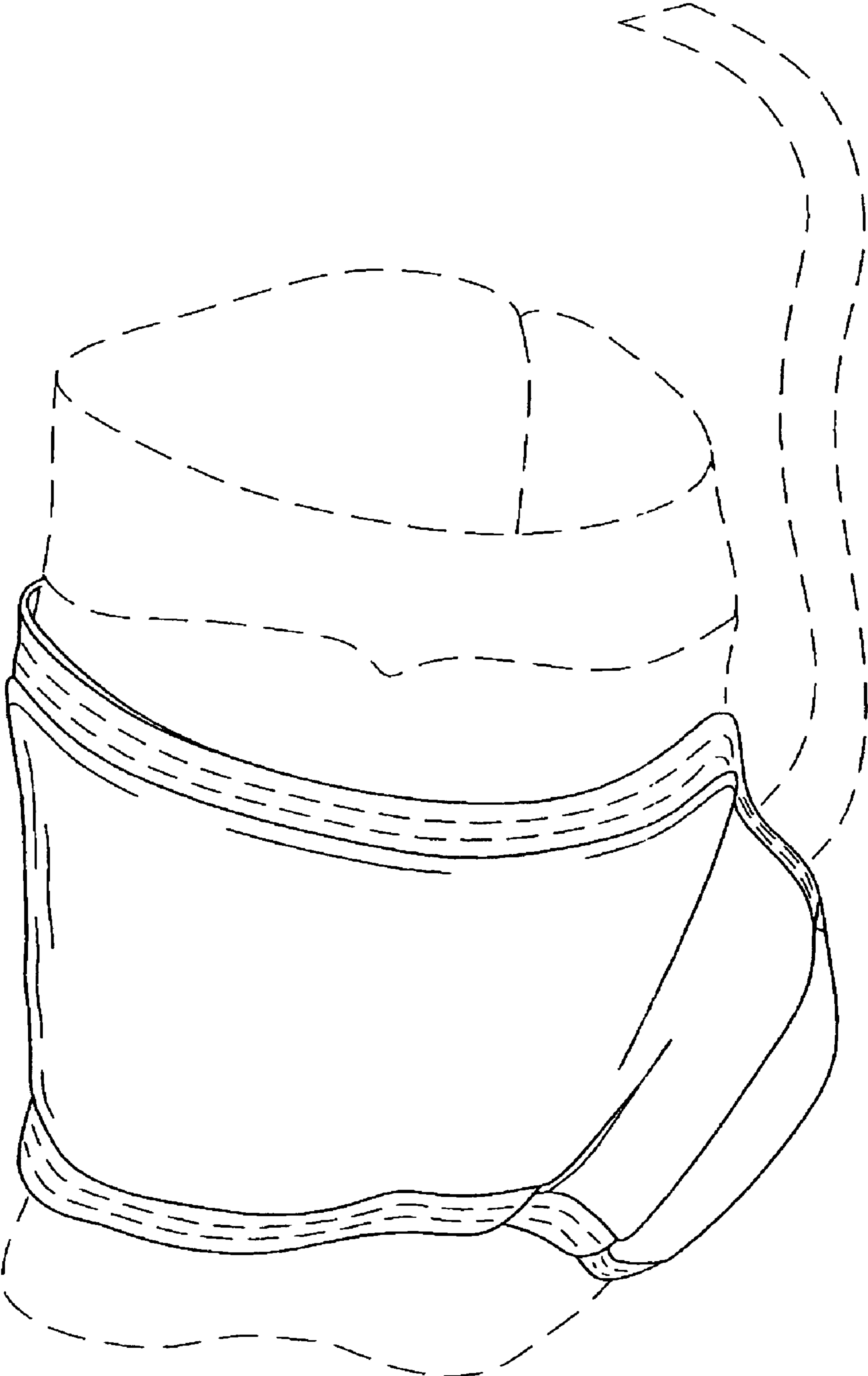

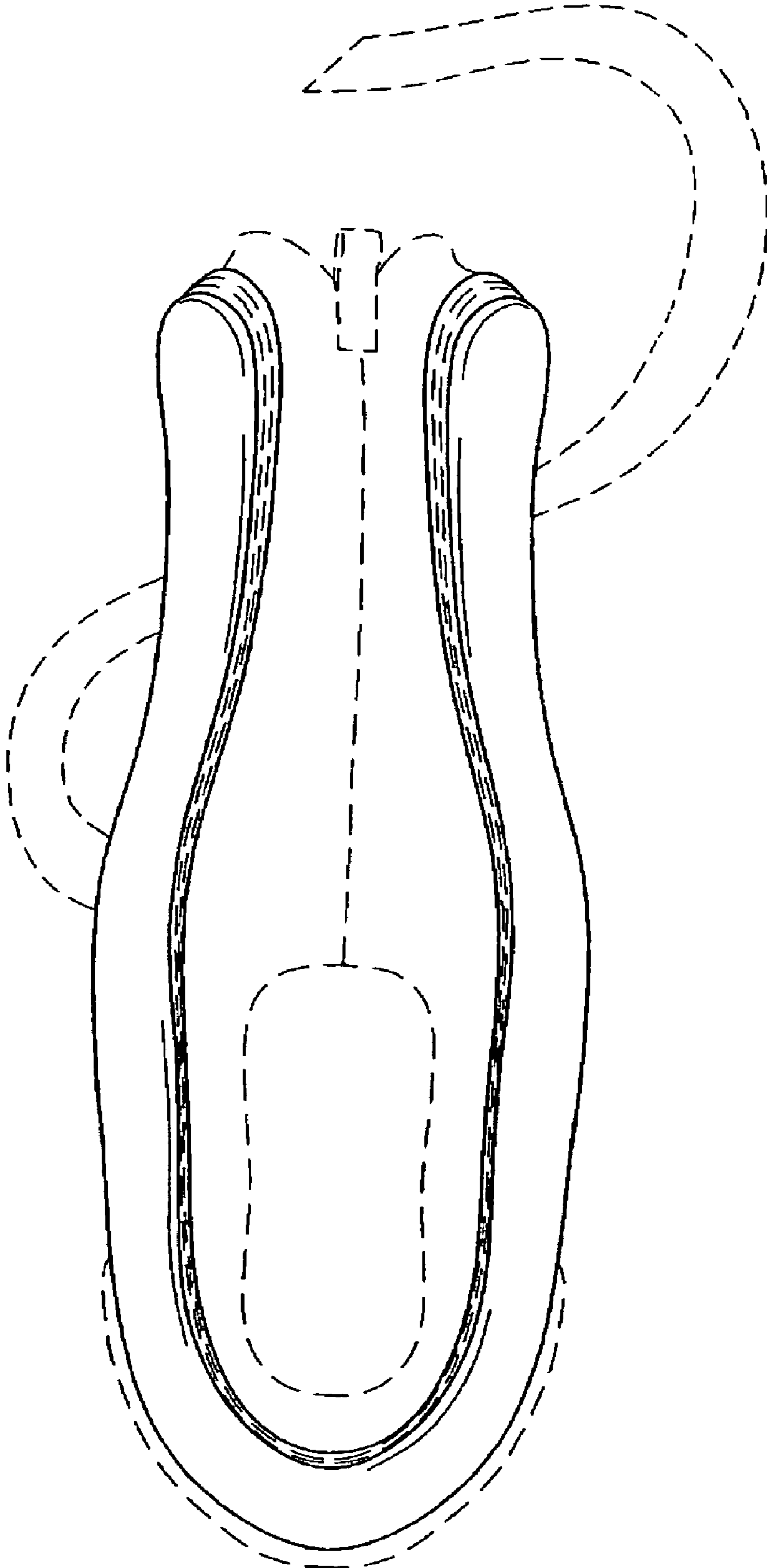
