The curved lines in FIGS. 4 and 5 represent a reduction in space between the sections.

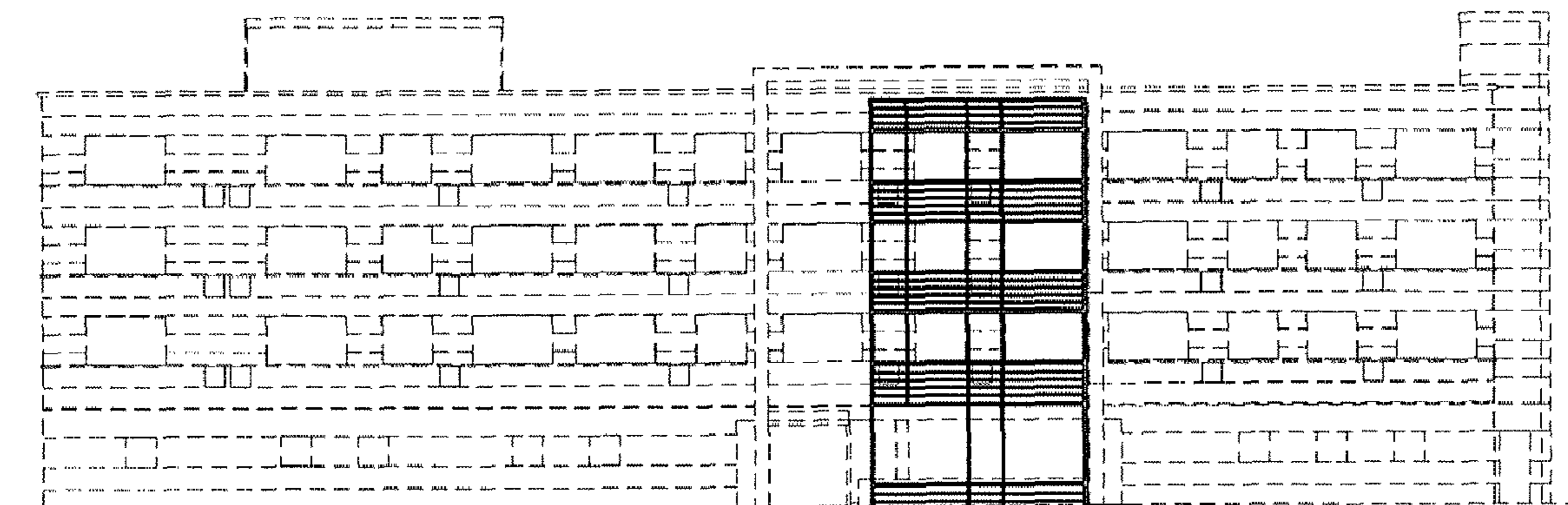

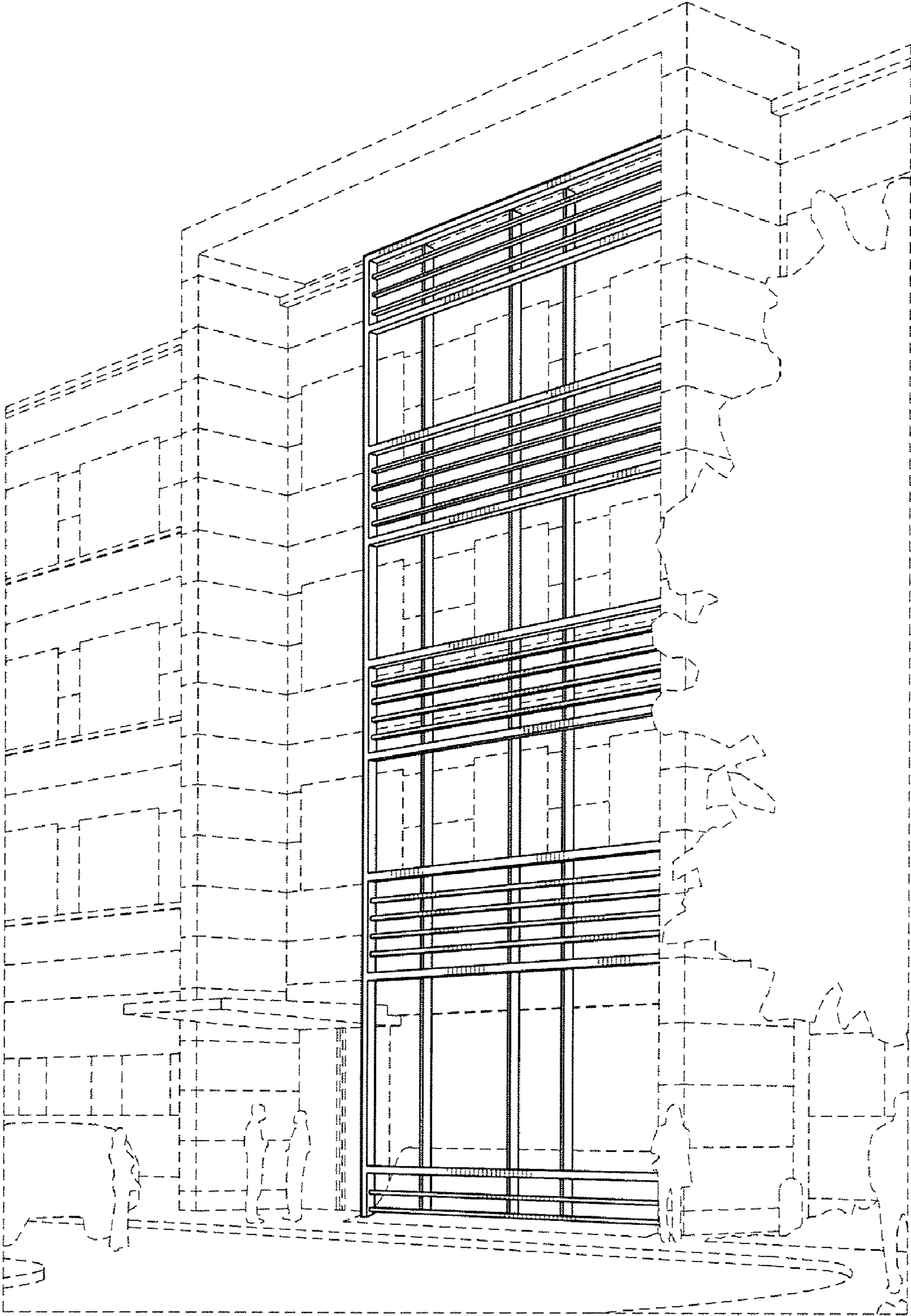

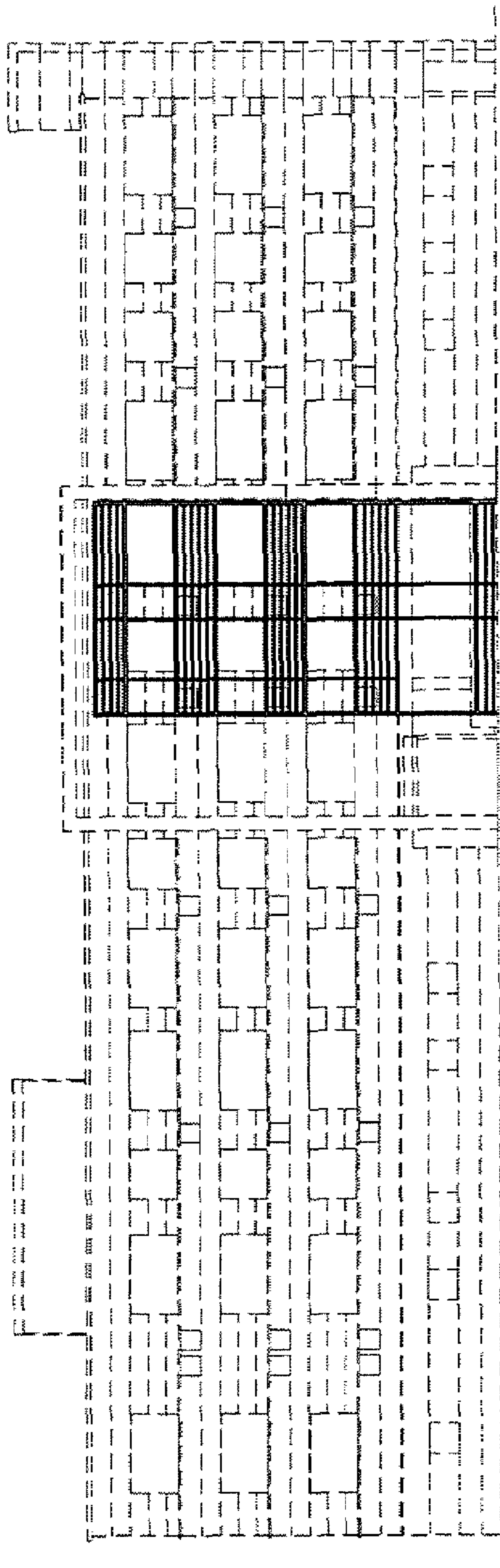

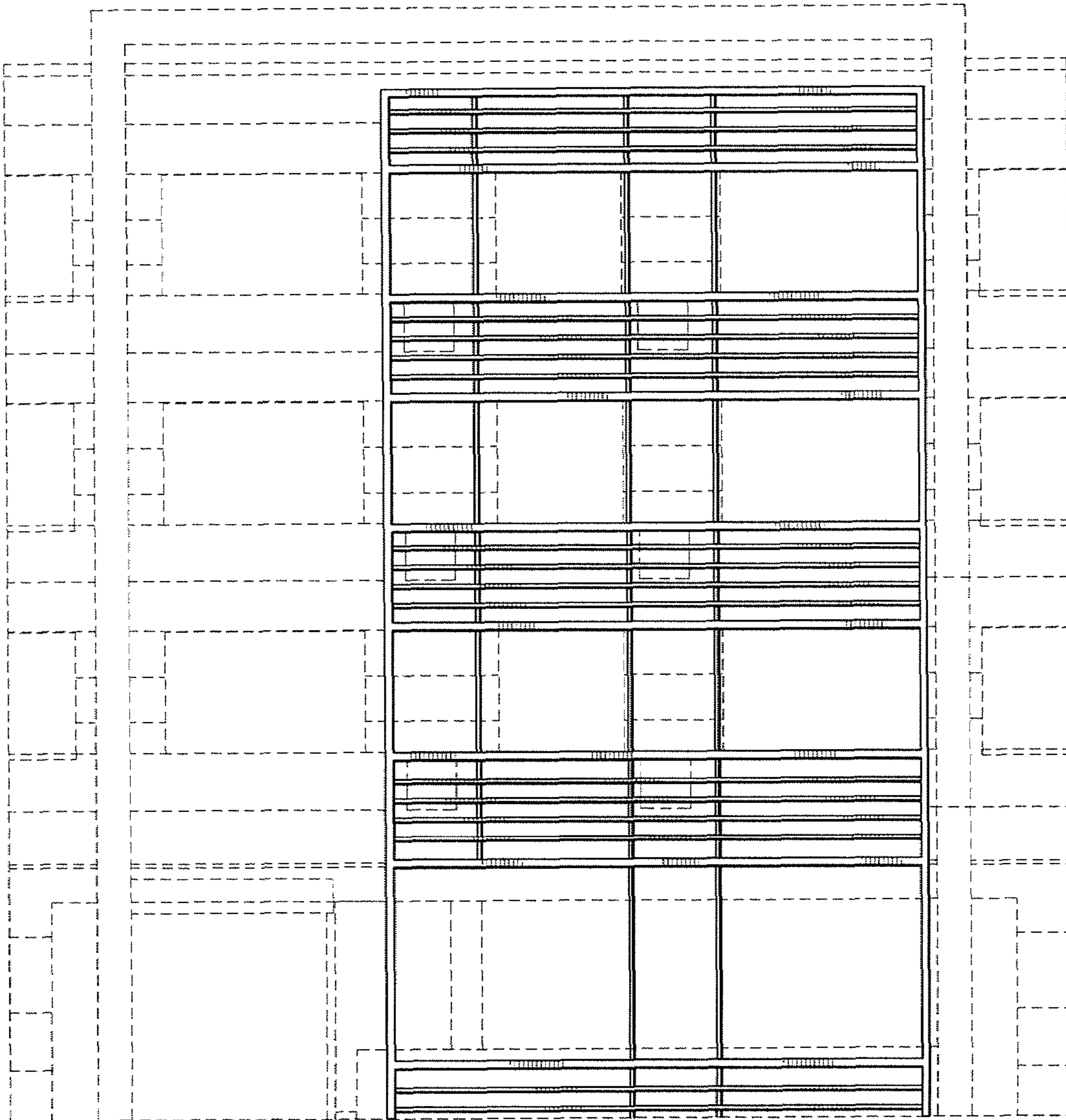

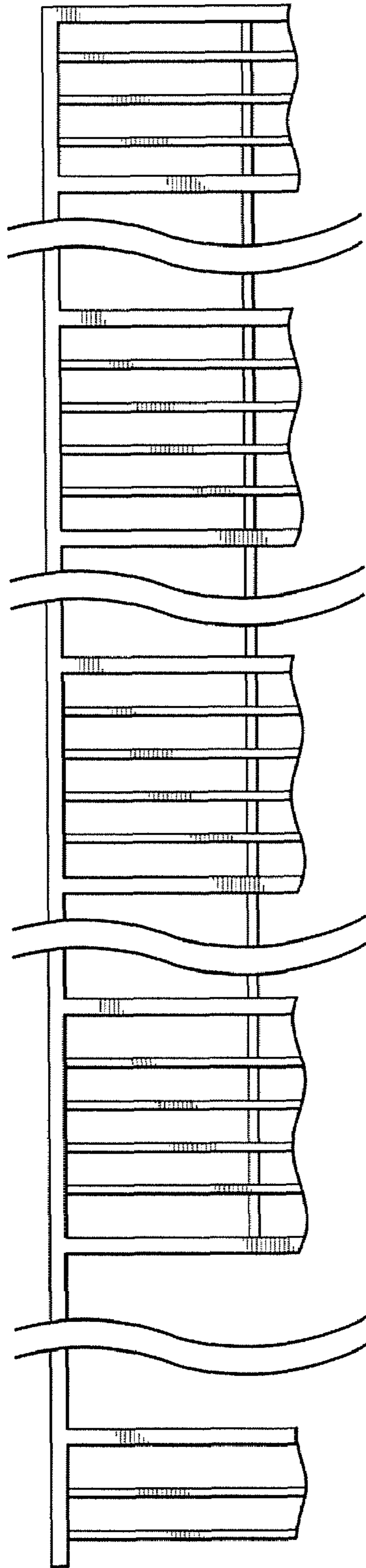

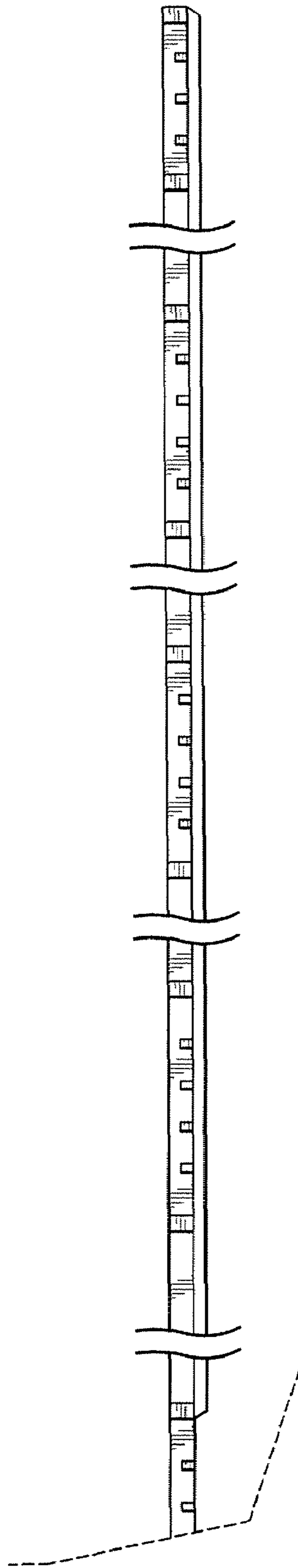

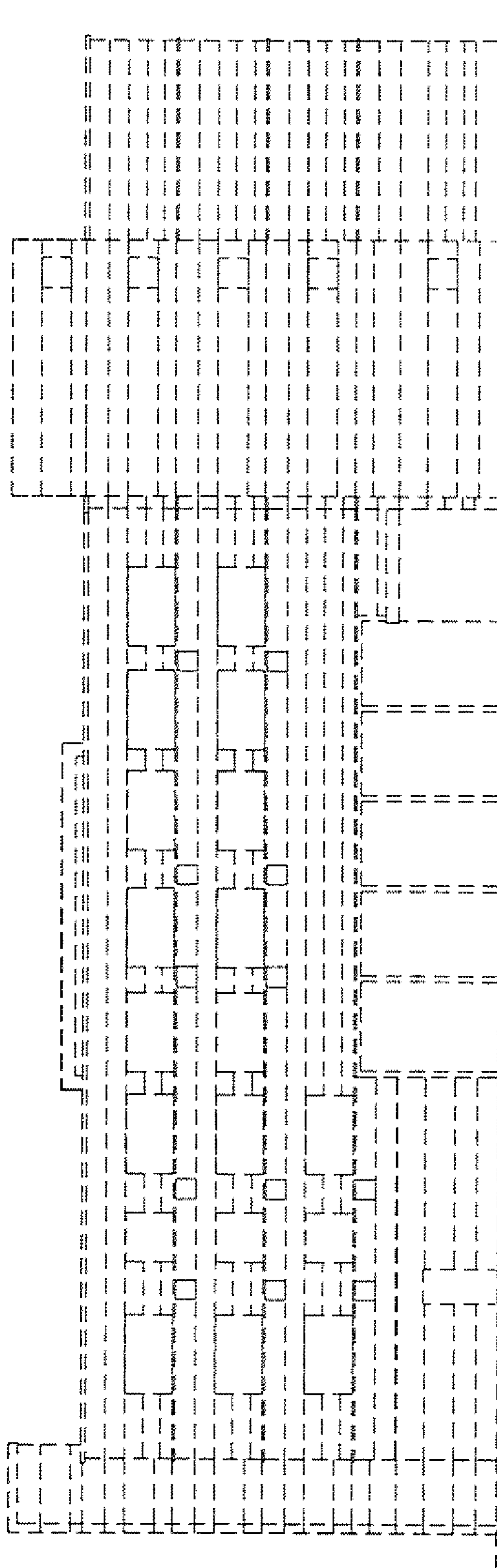

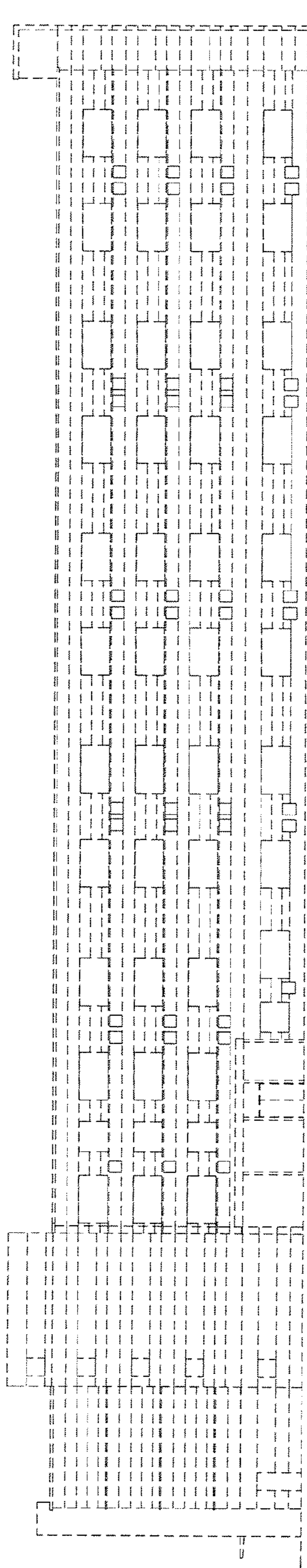

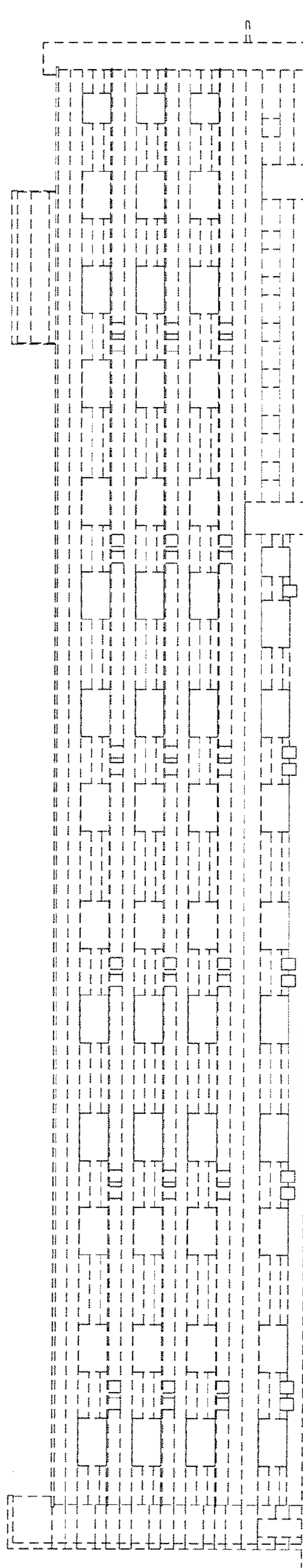
