FIG. 6 is an elevation view showing the back of my invention;

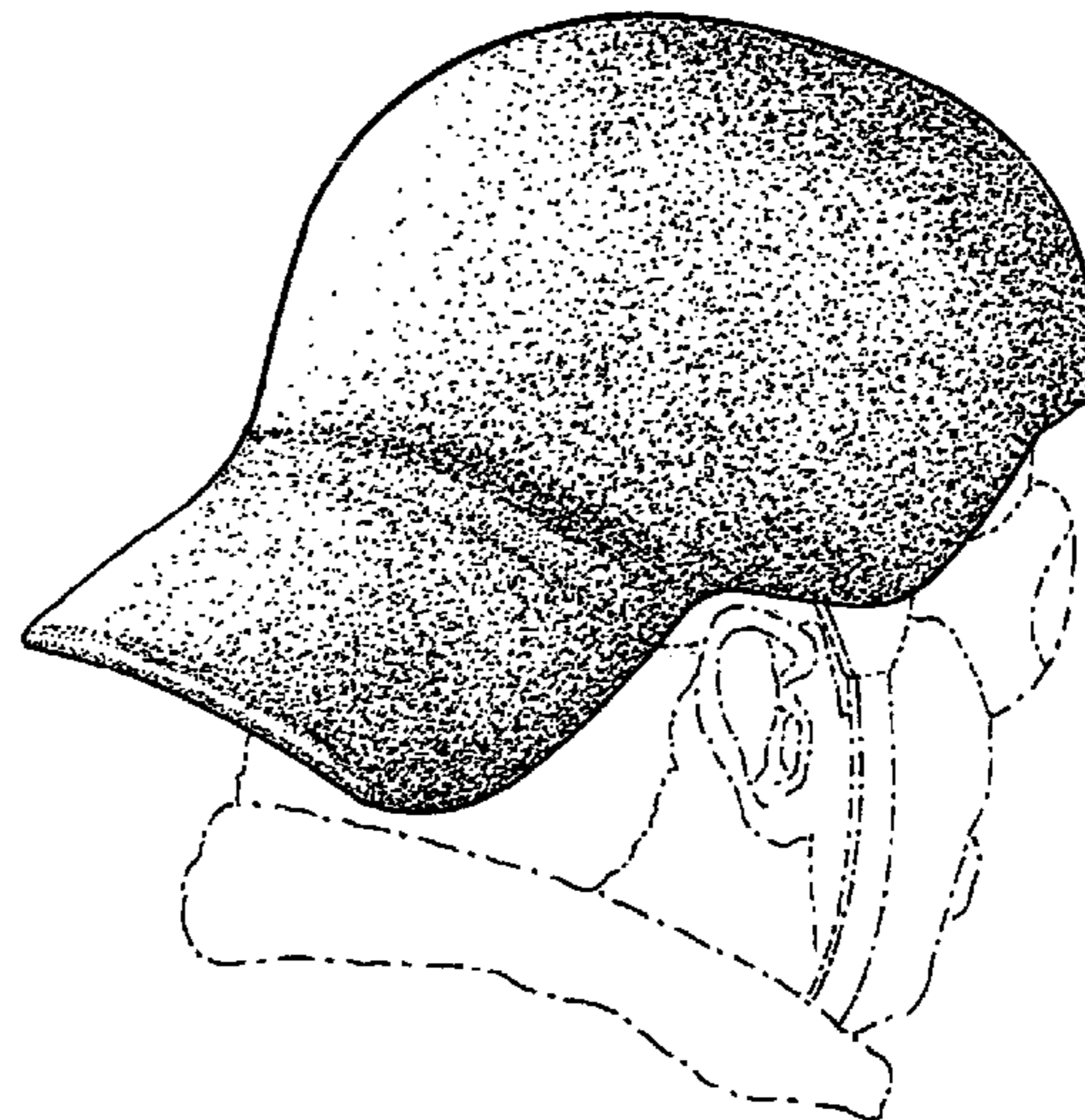
FIG. 7 is an elevation view showing the top of my invention;

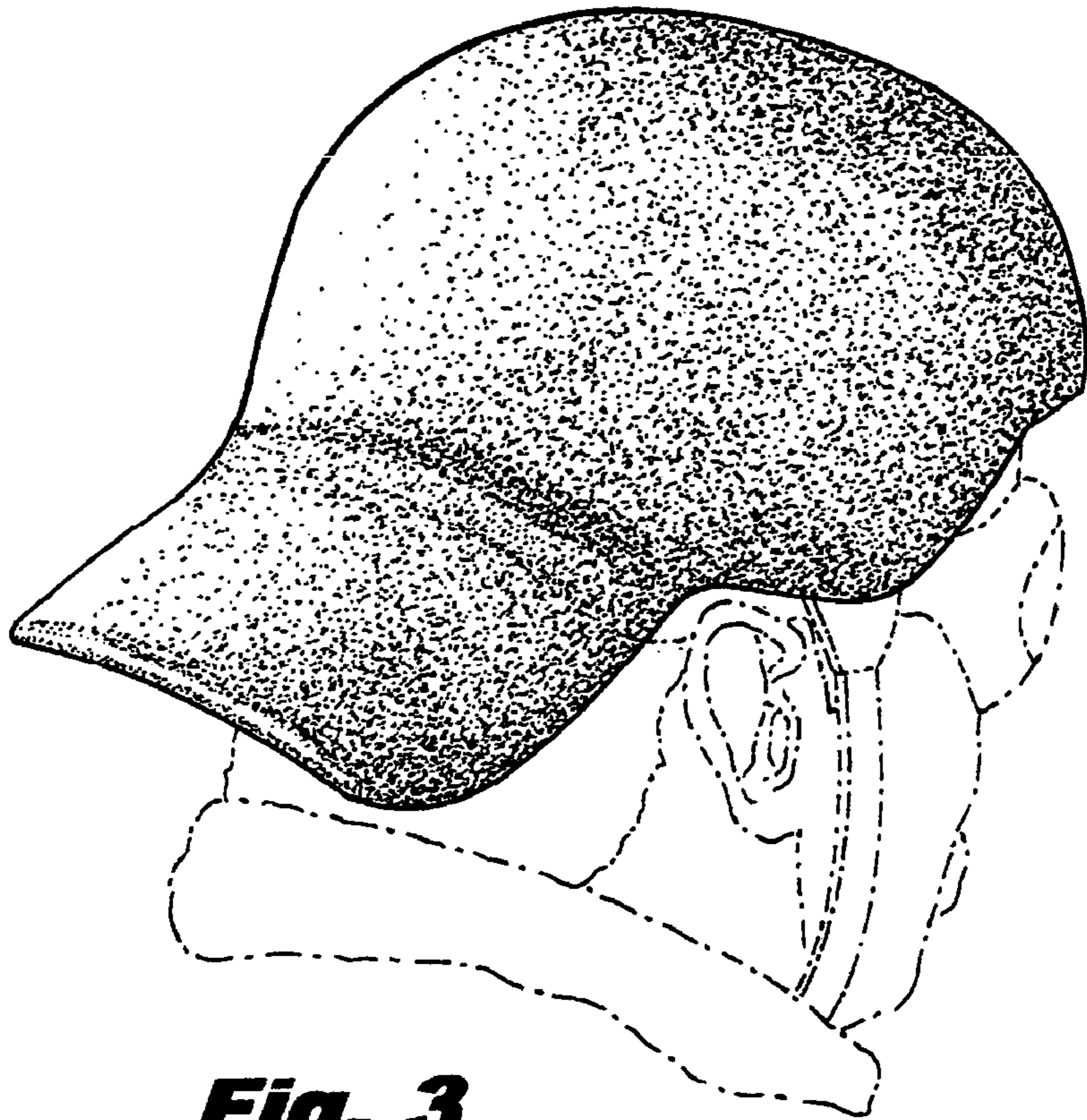




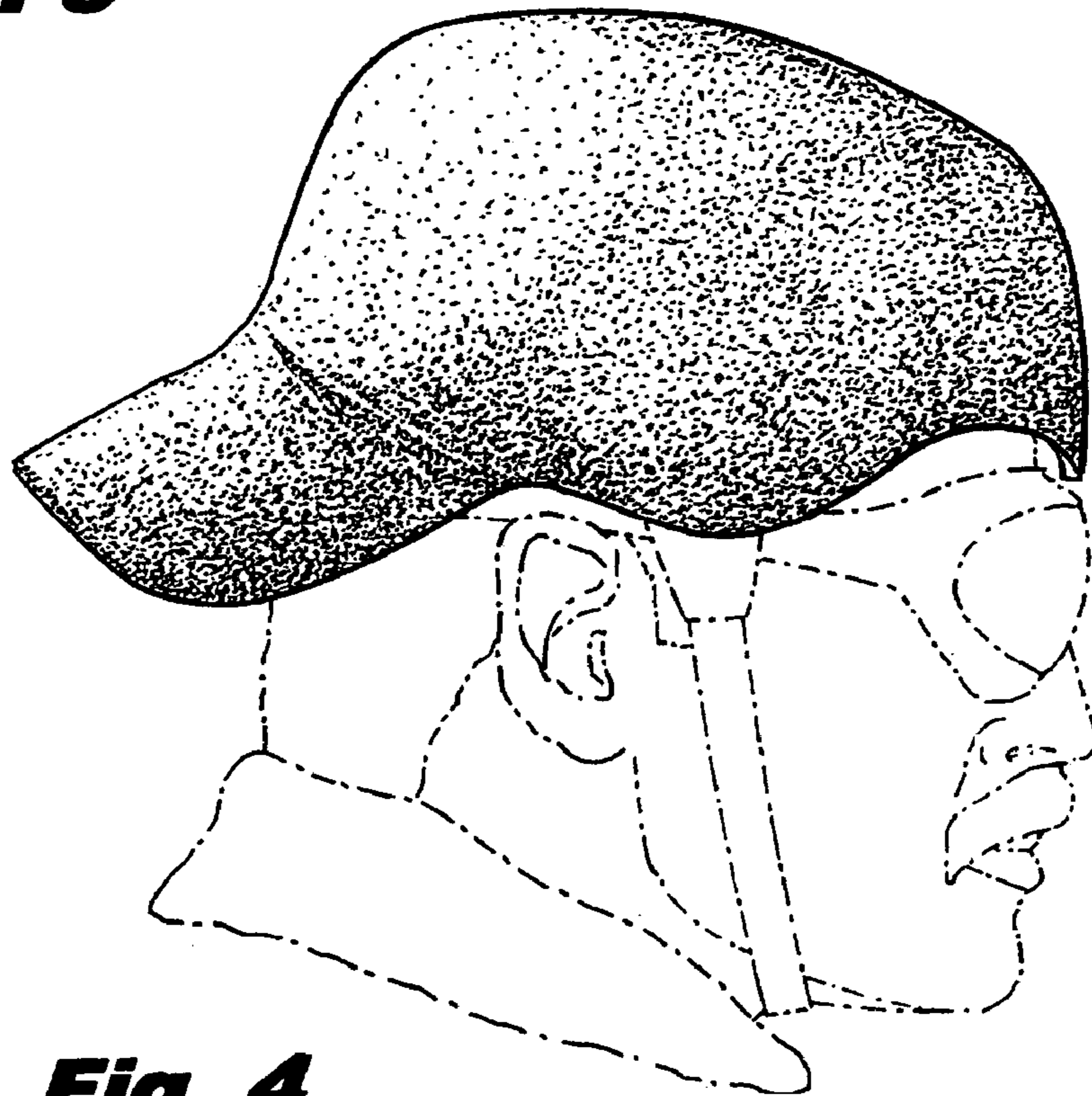

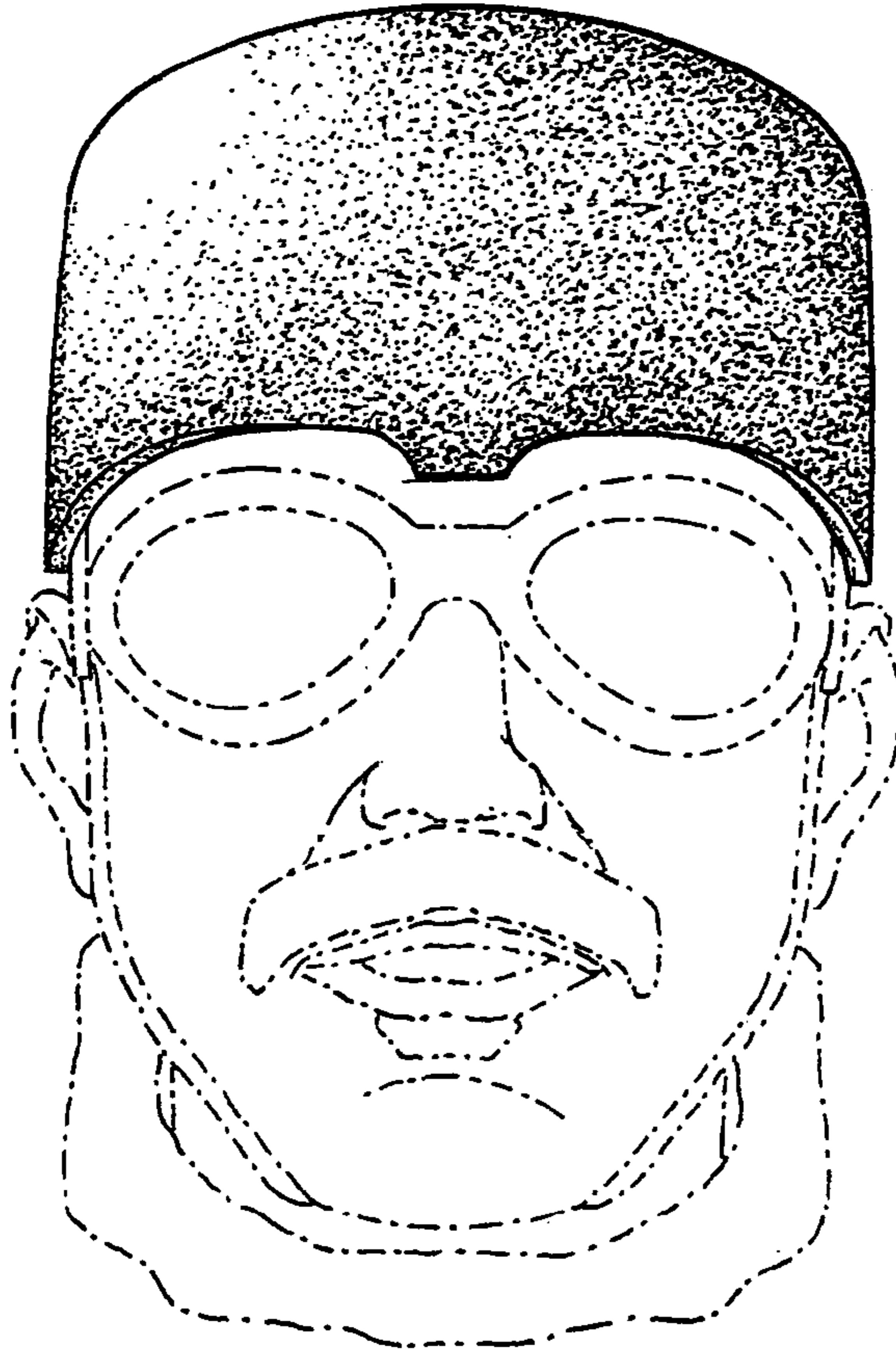

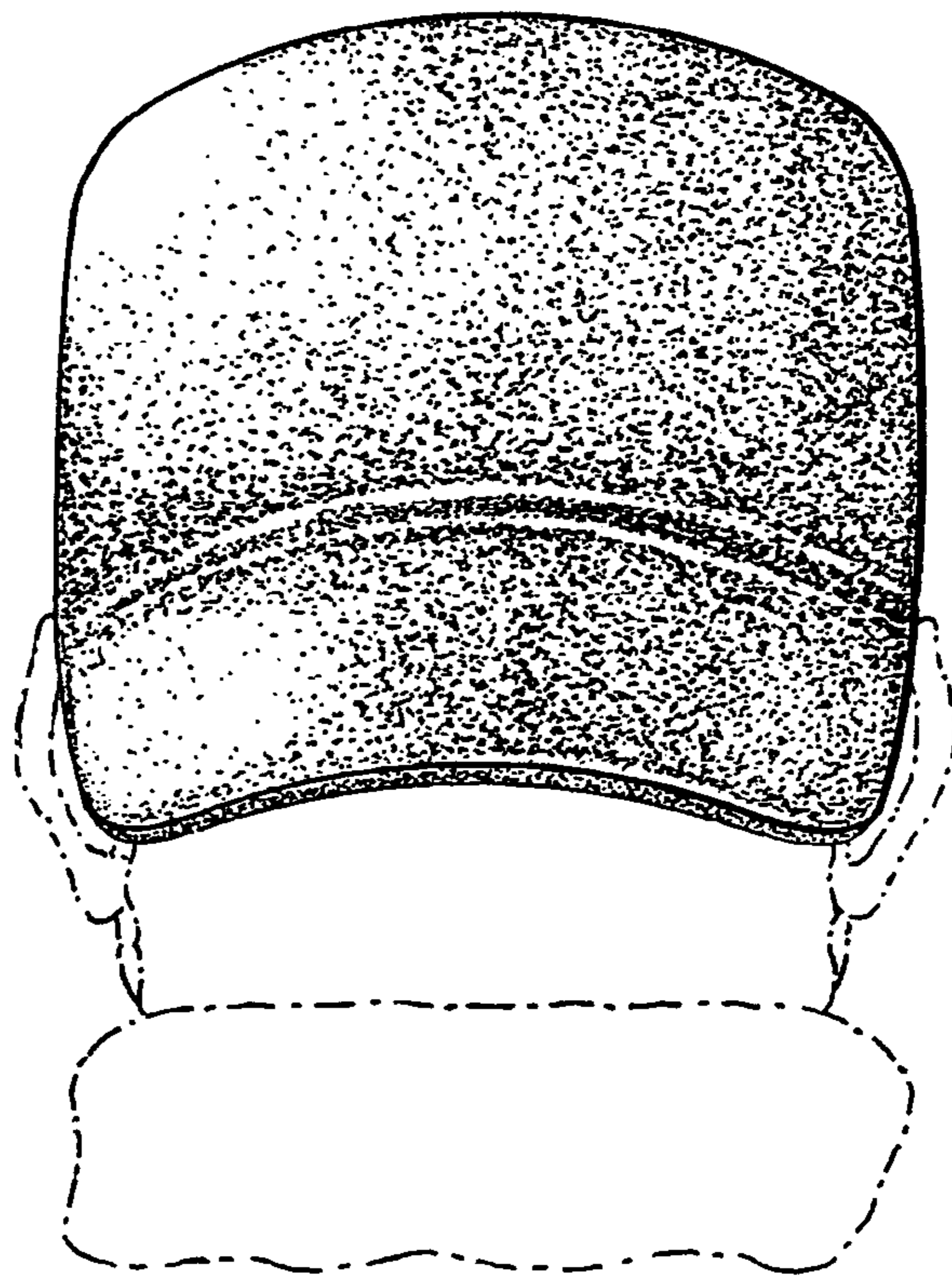

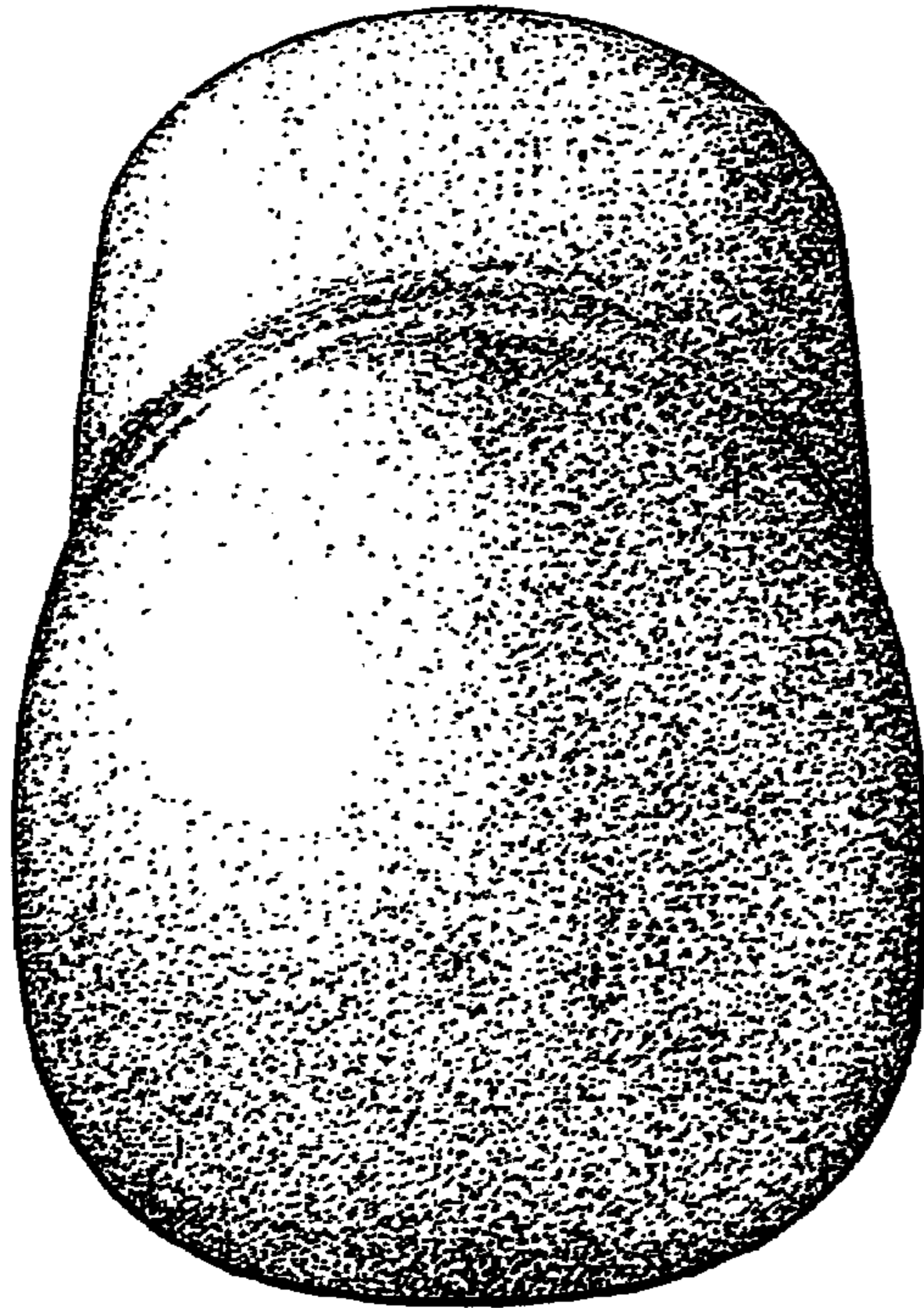

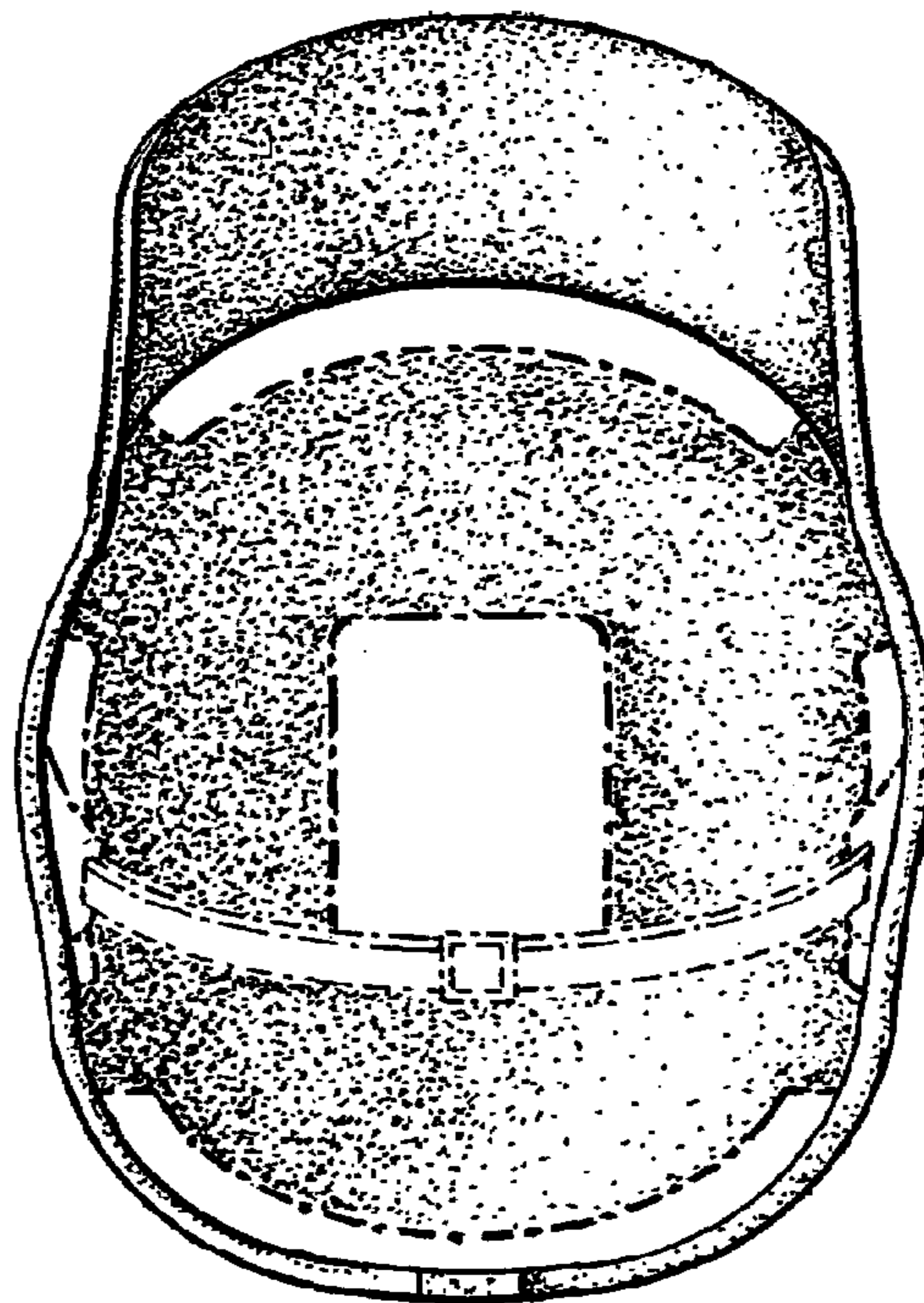
