FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view;

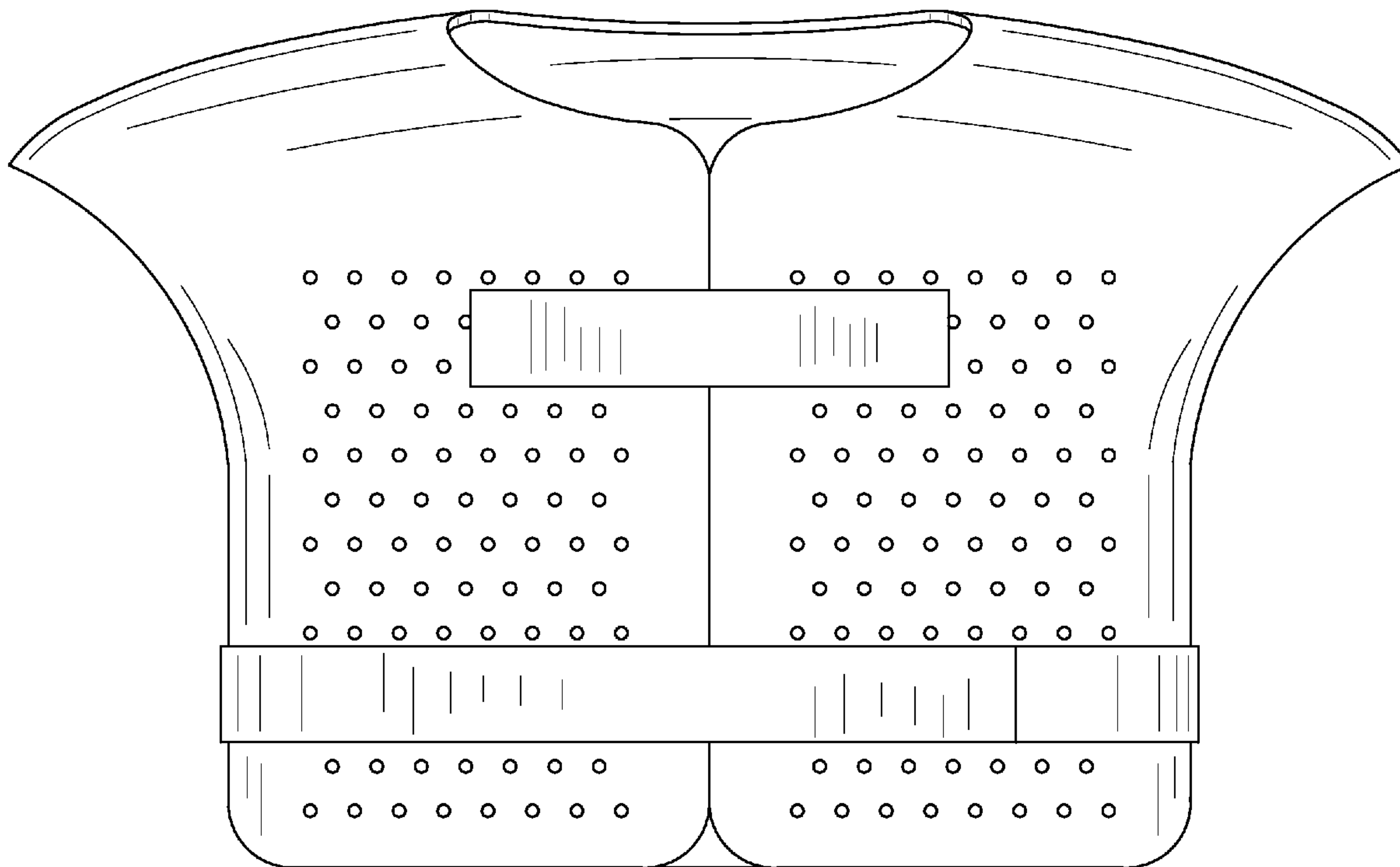
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view;

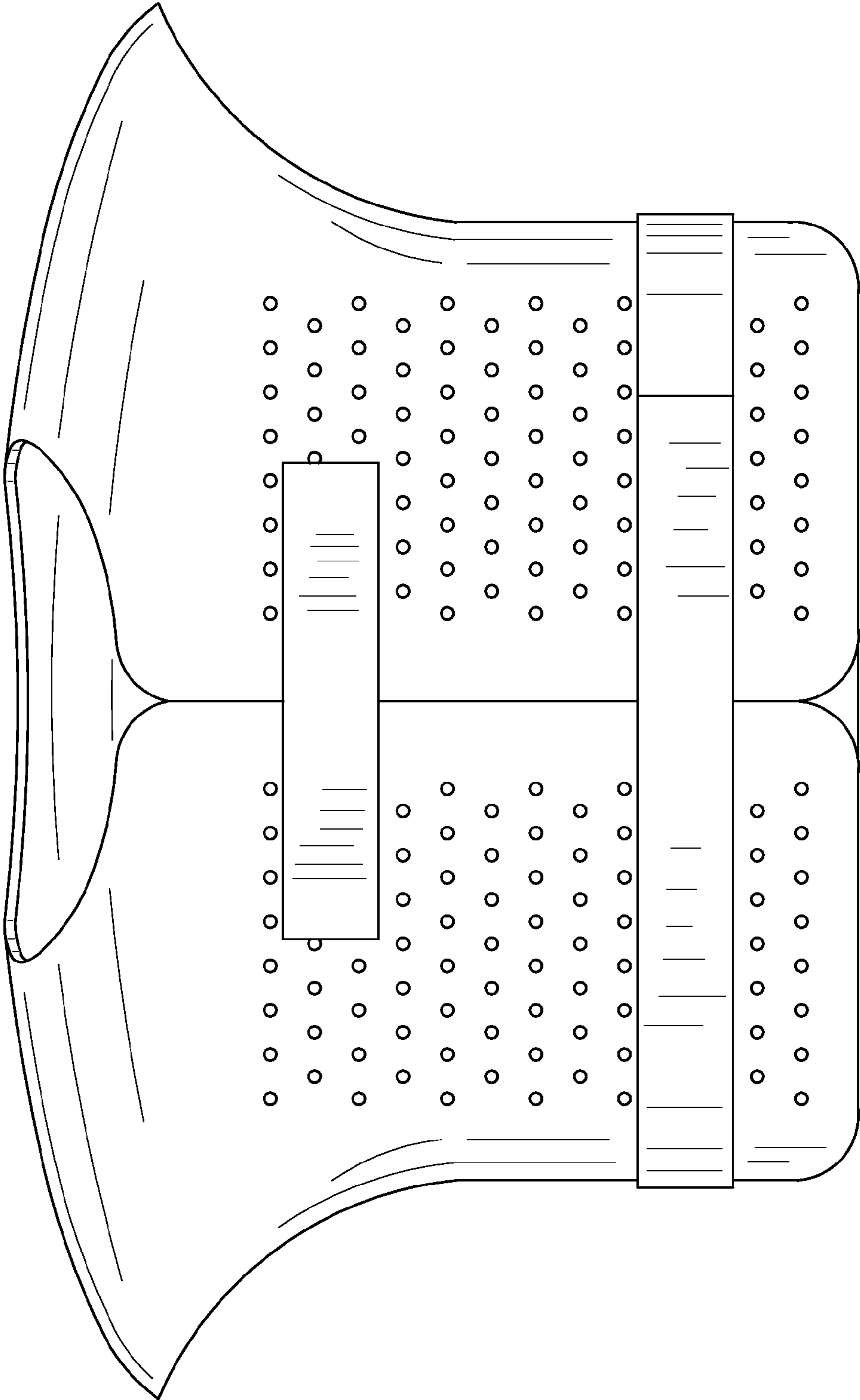

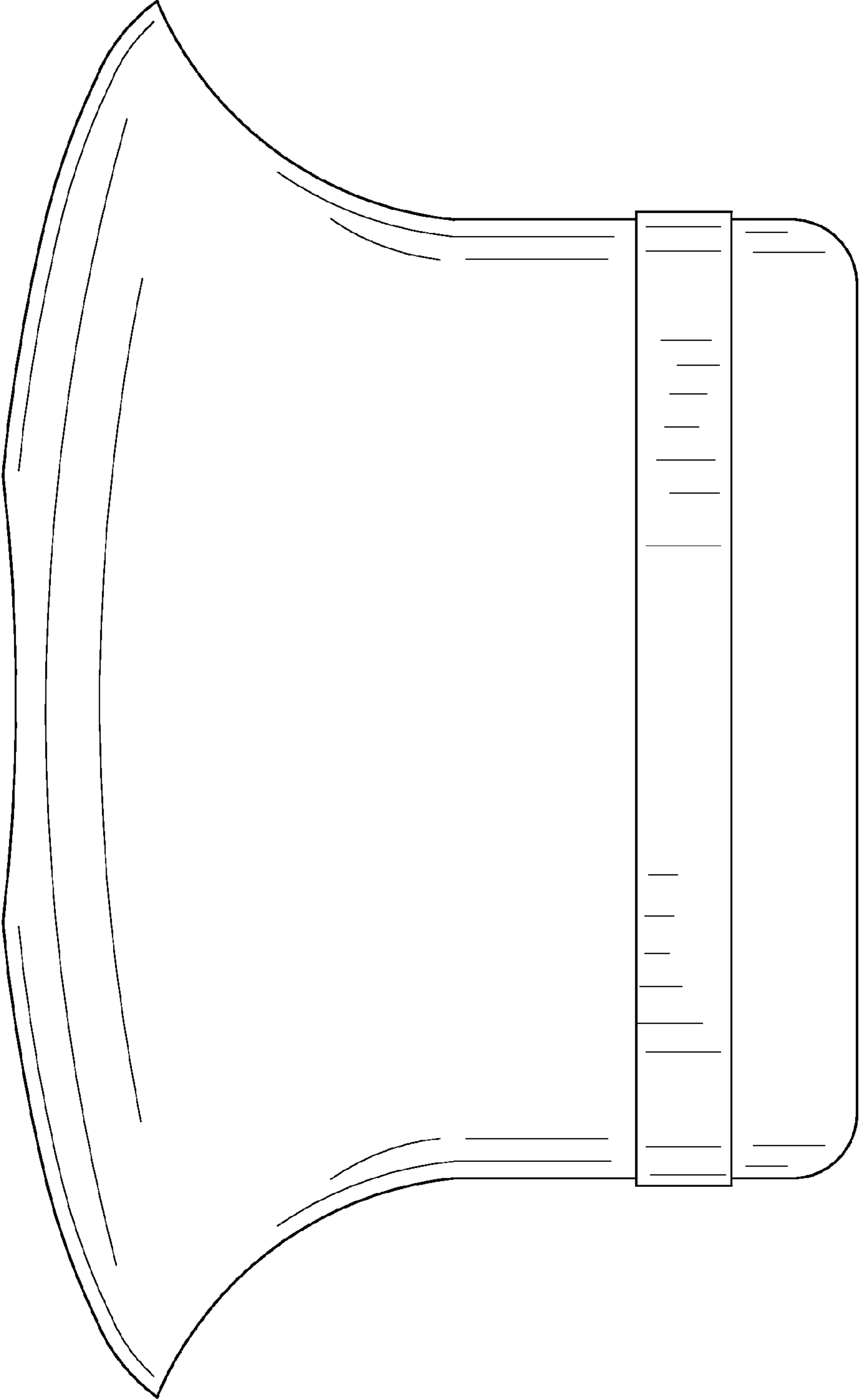

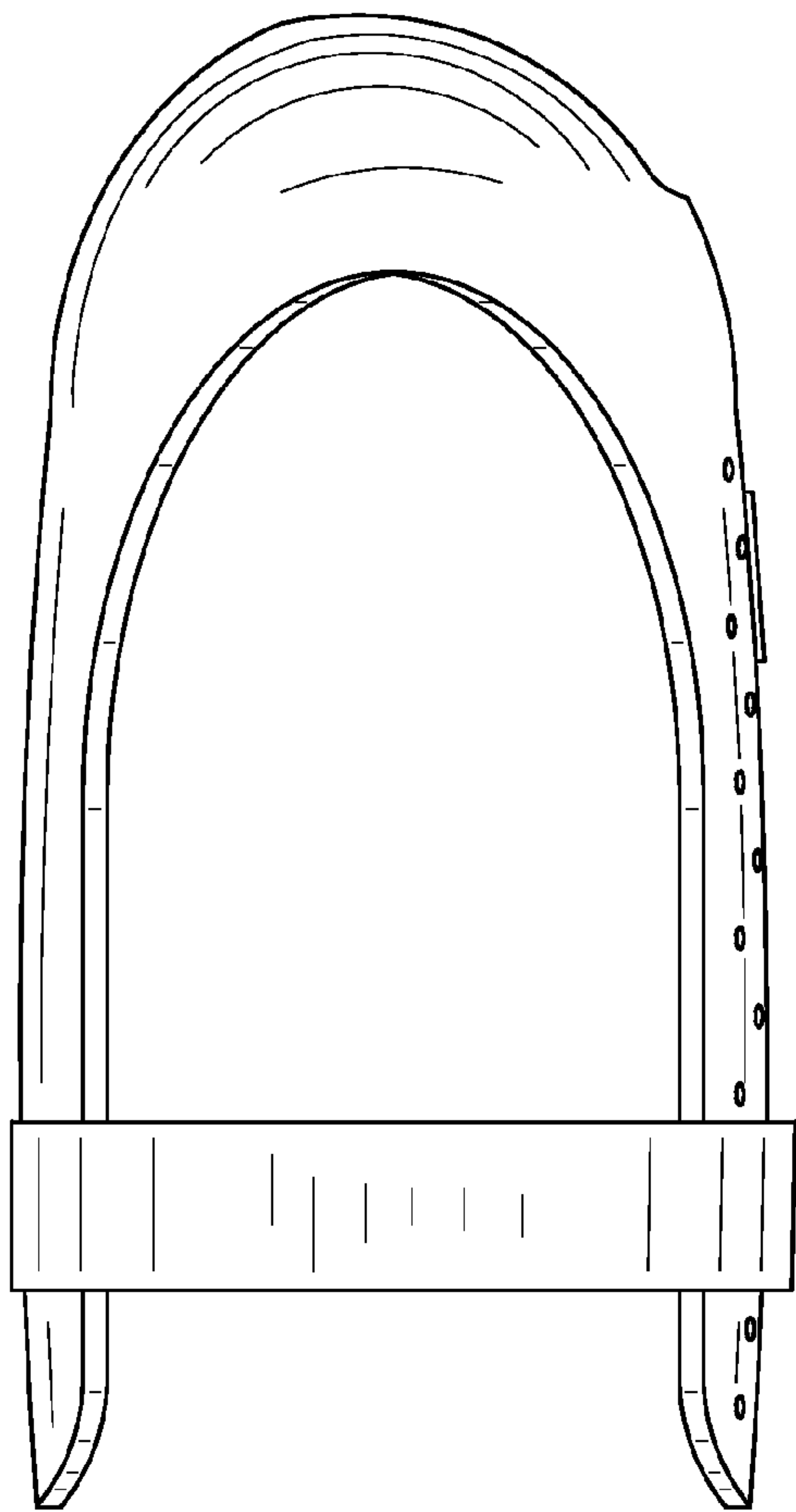

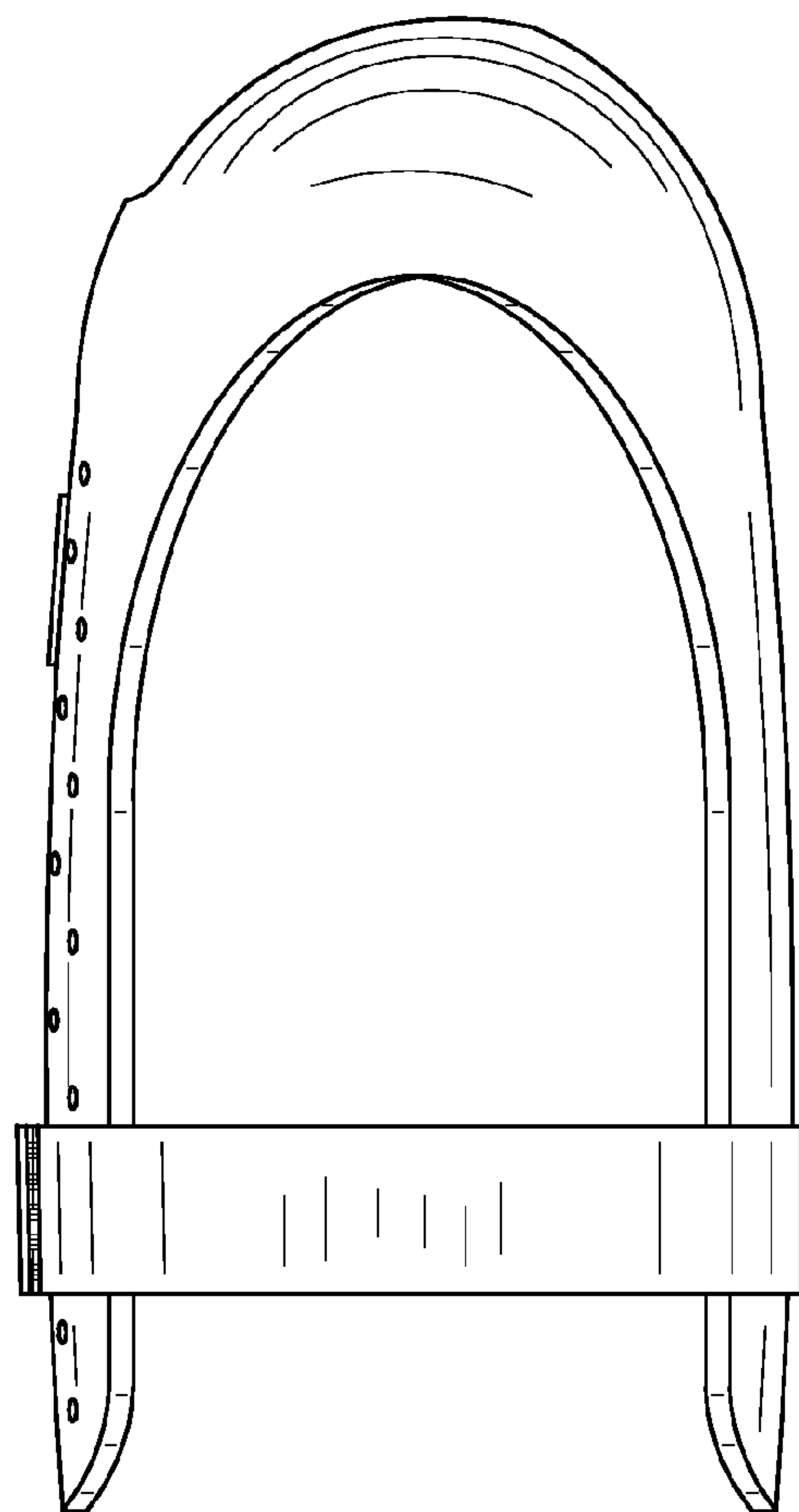

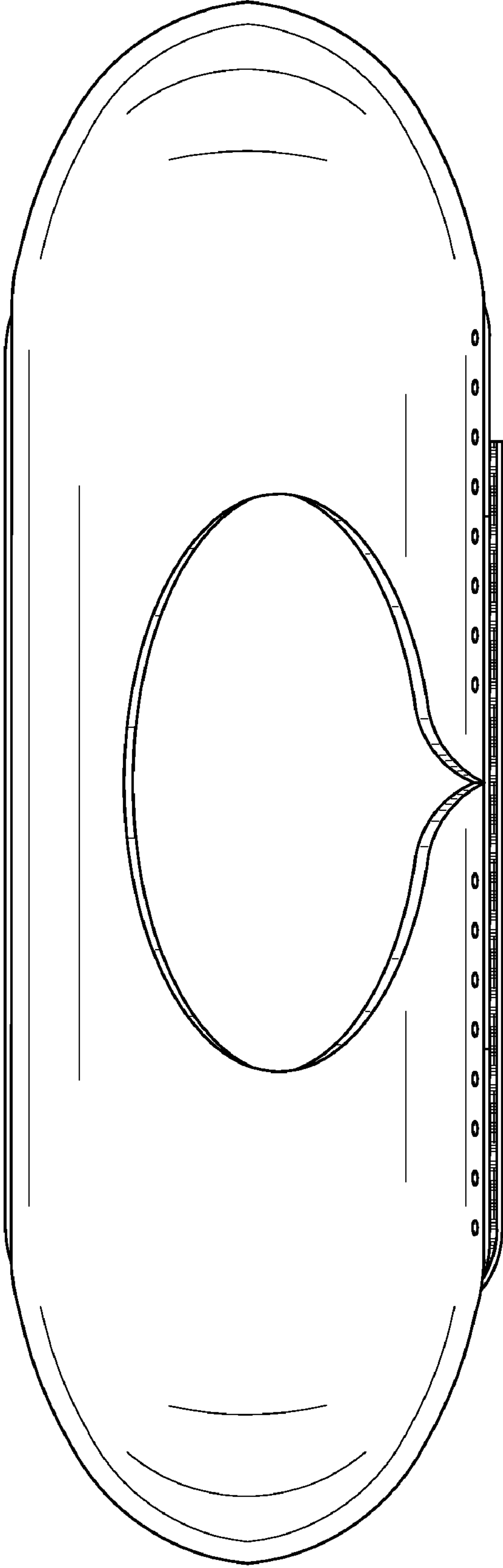

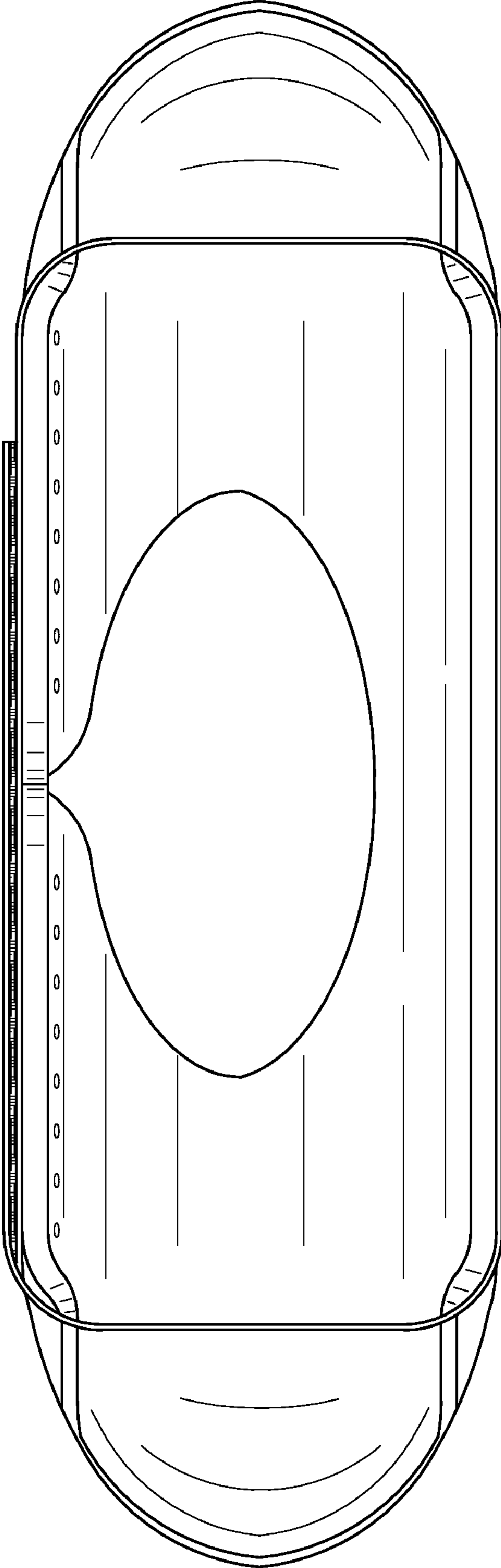
