FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, the right side being a mirror image;

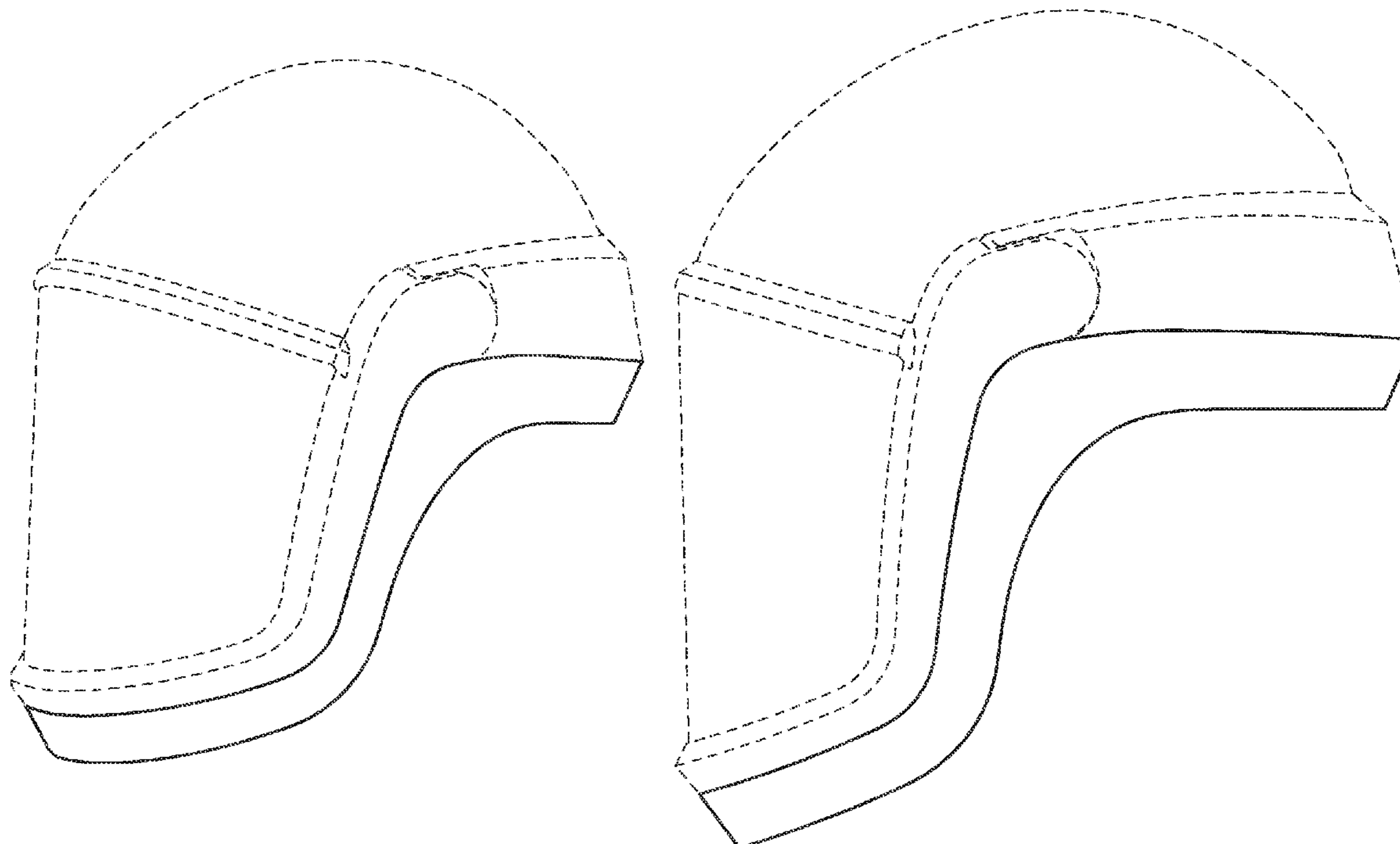
FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof;

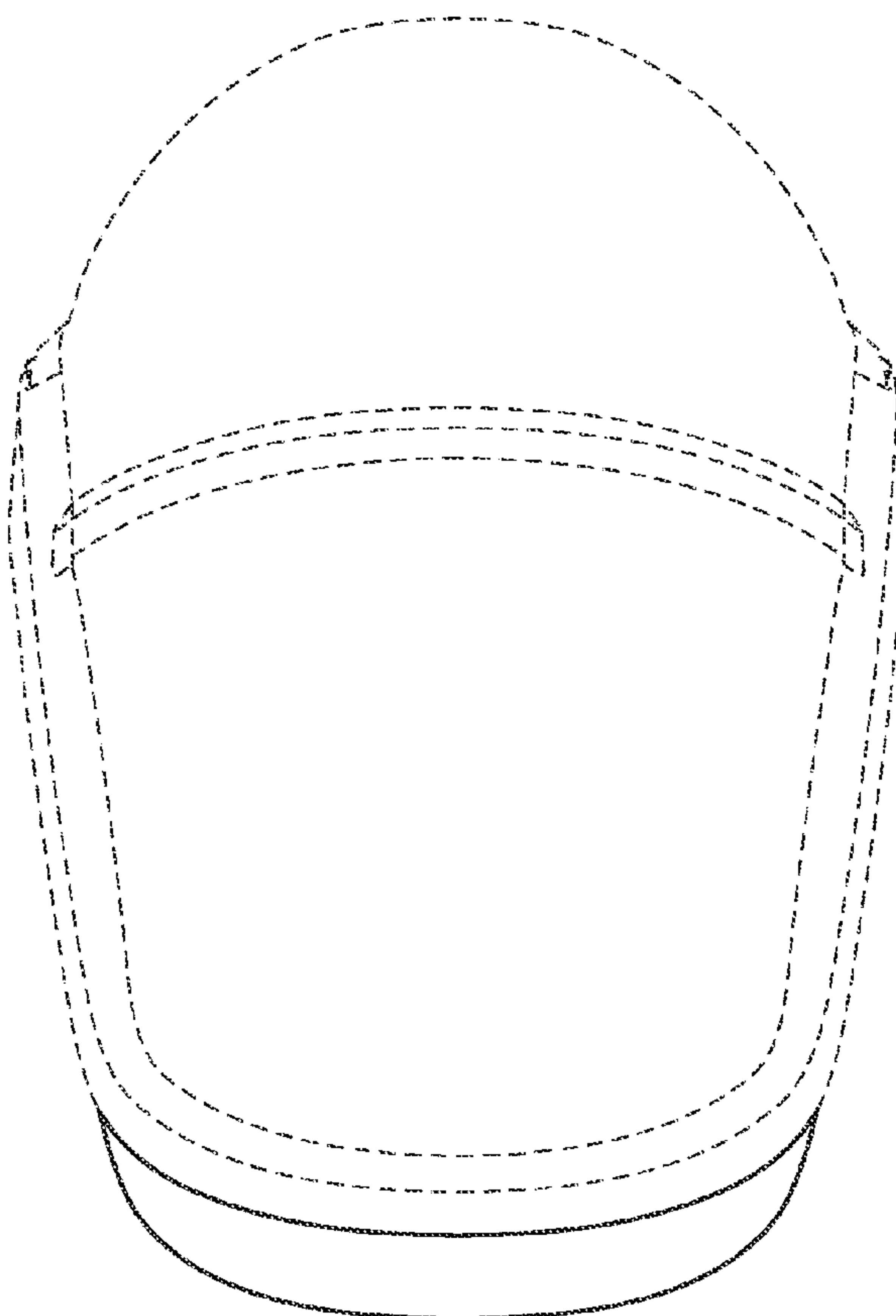
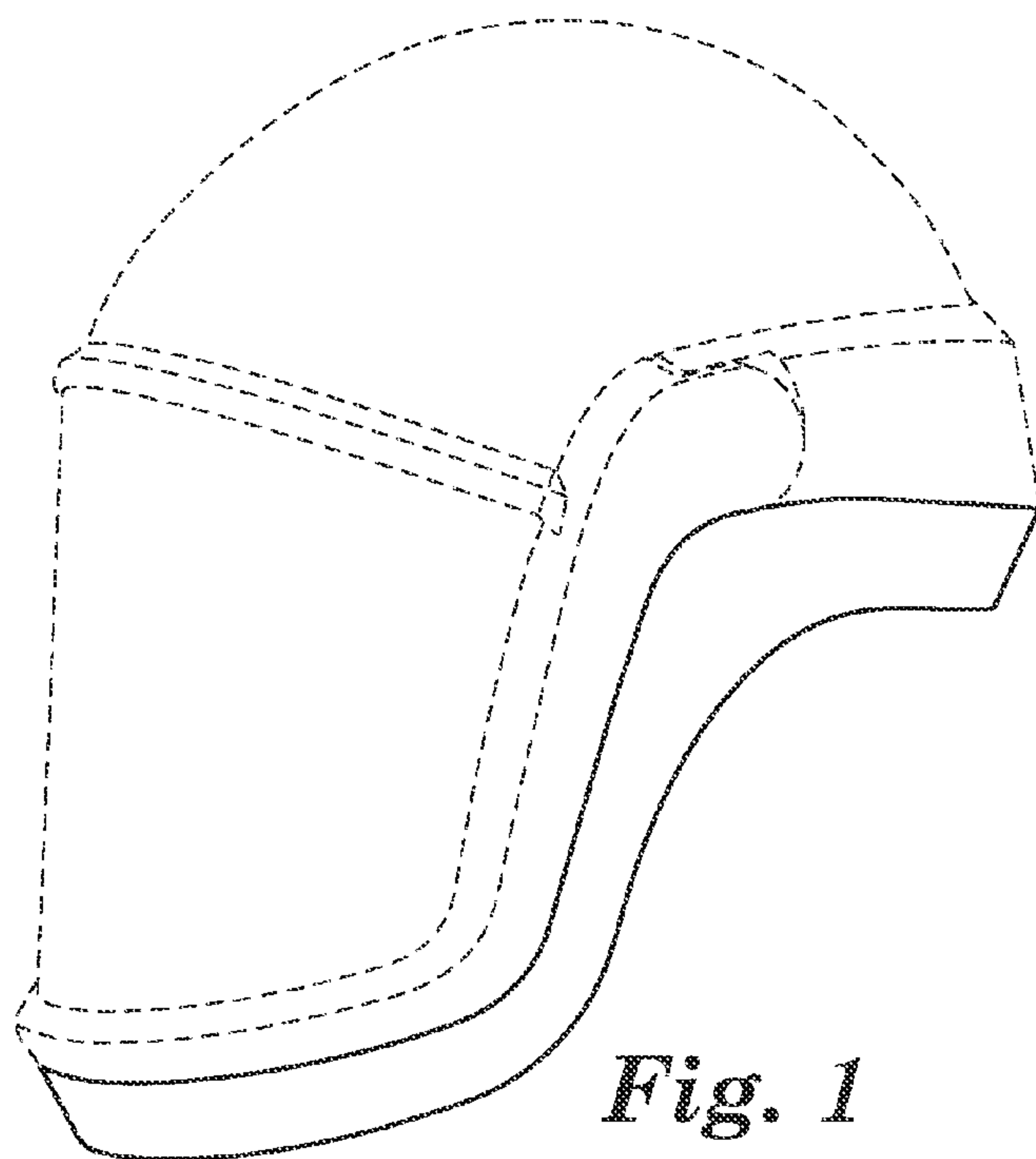

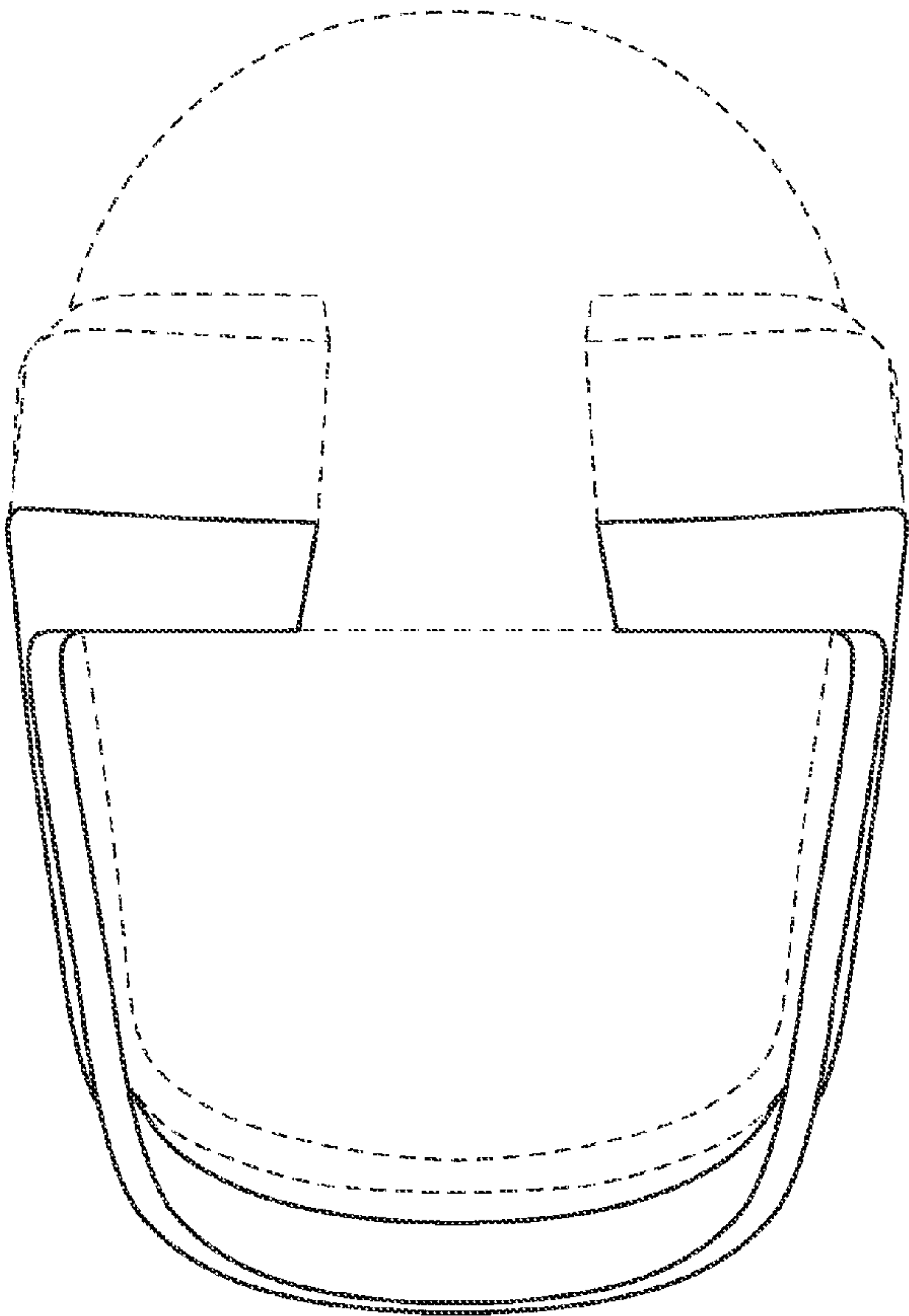
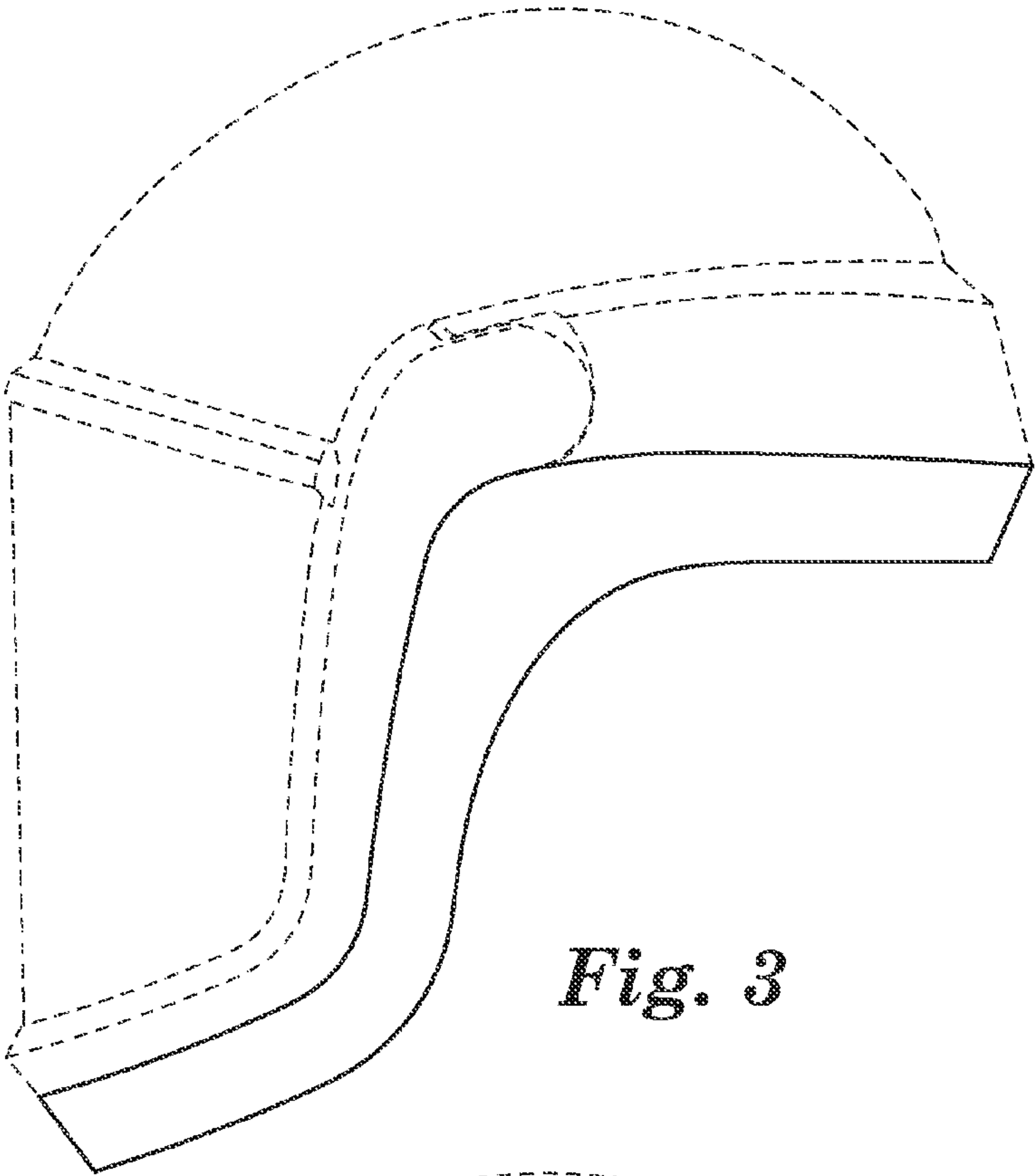

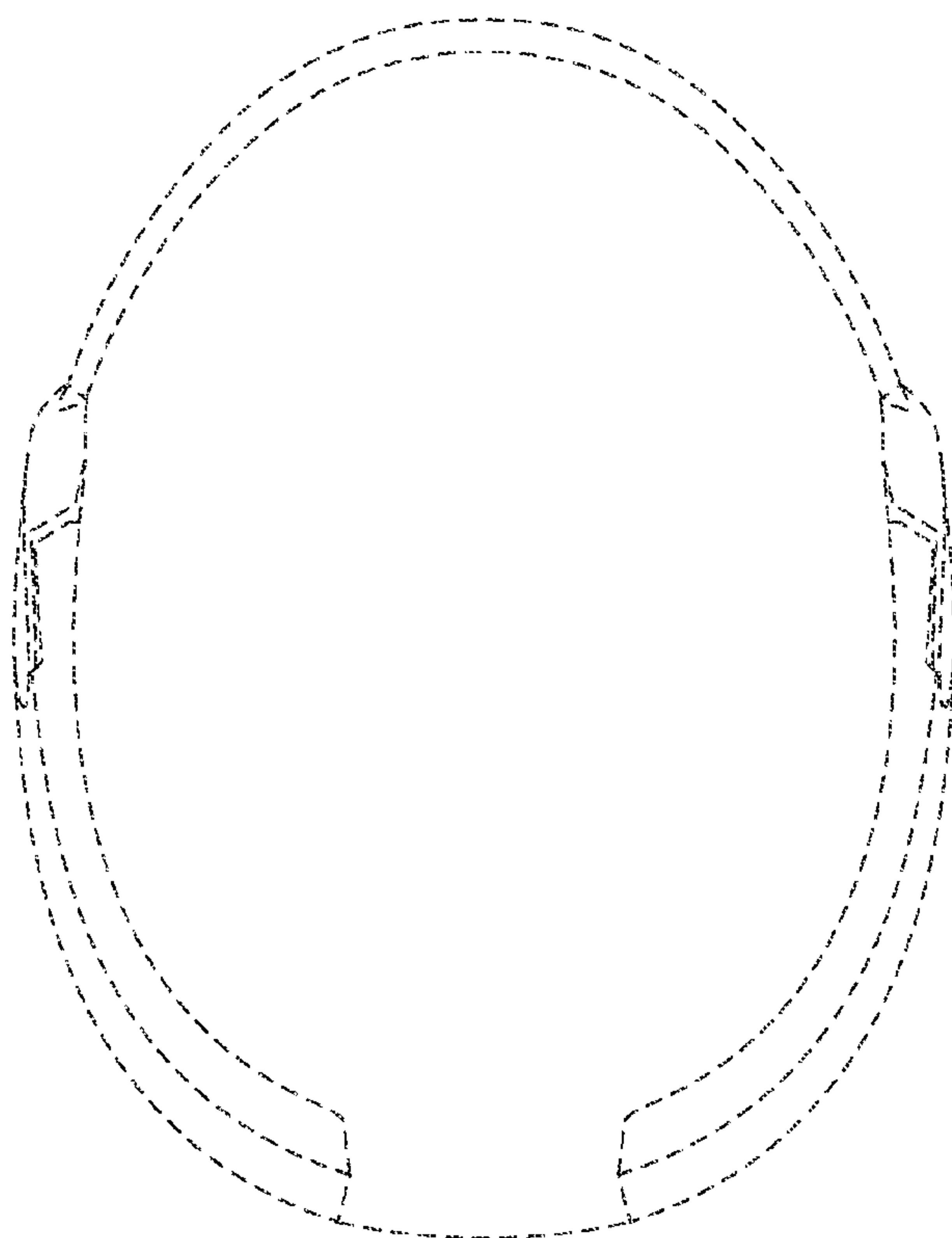

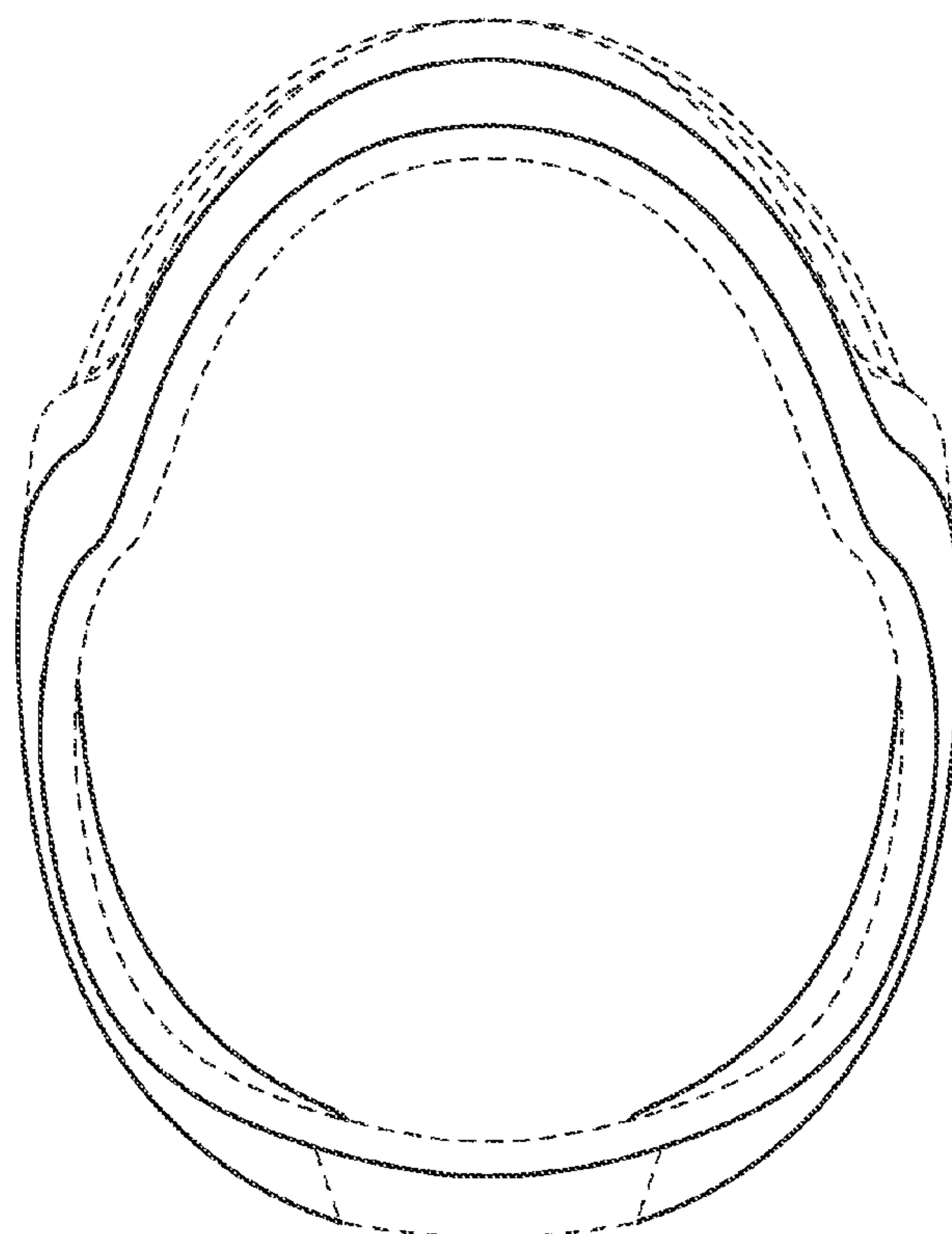
