(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for an applicator device, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an applicator device;

FIG. 2 is a side elevation view of the applicator device shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the applicator device shown in FIG. 1;

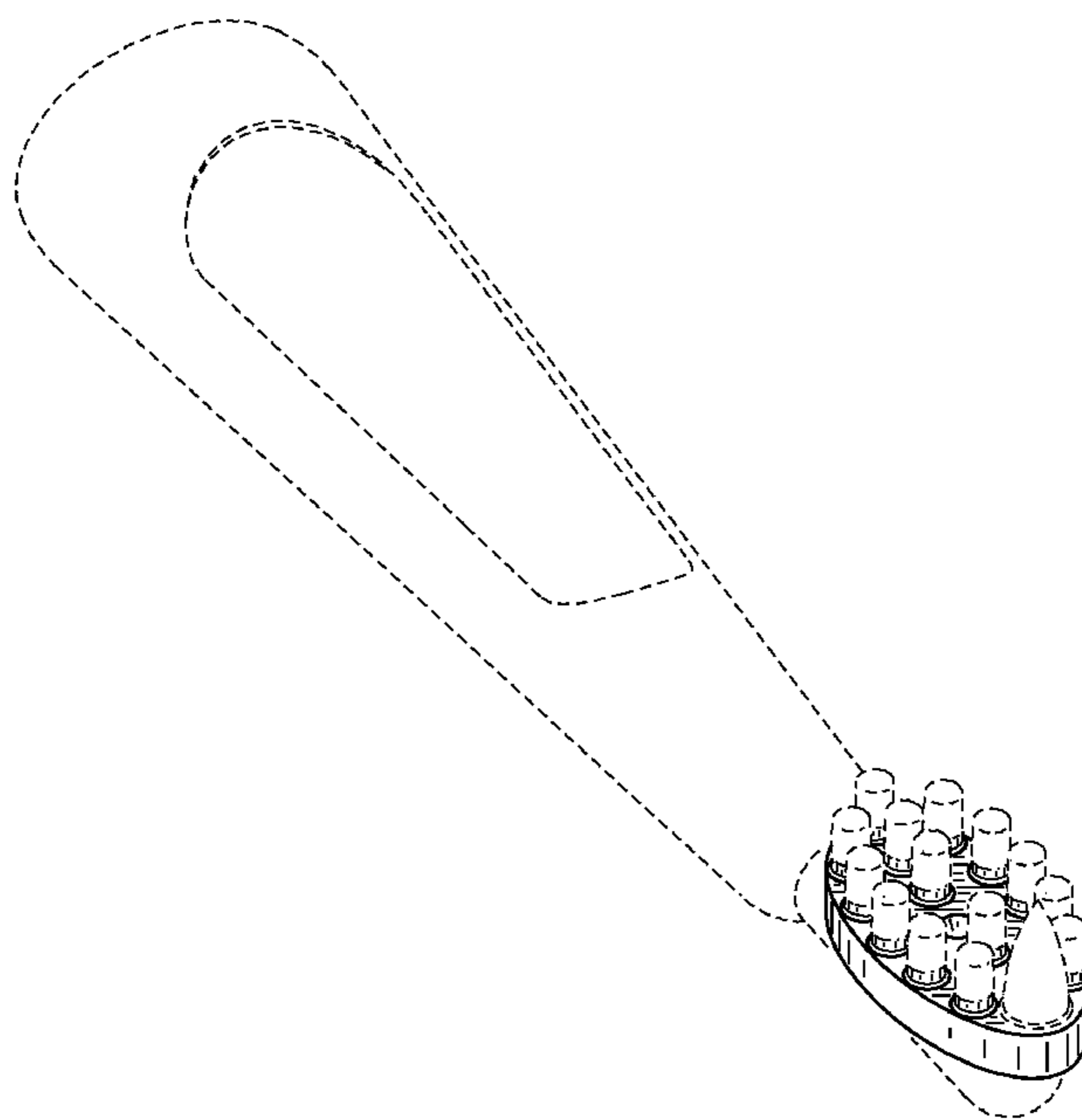
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of the applicator device shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top view of the applicator device shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the applicator device taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 2.

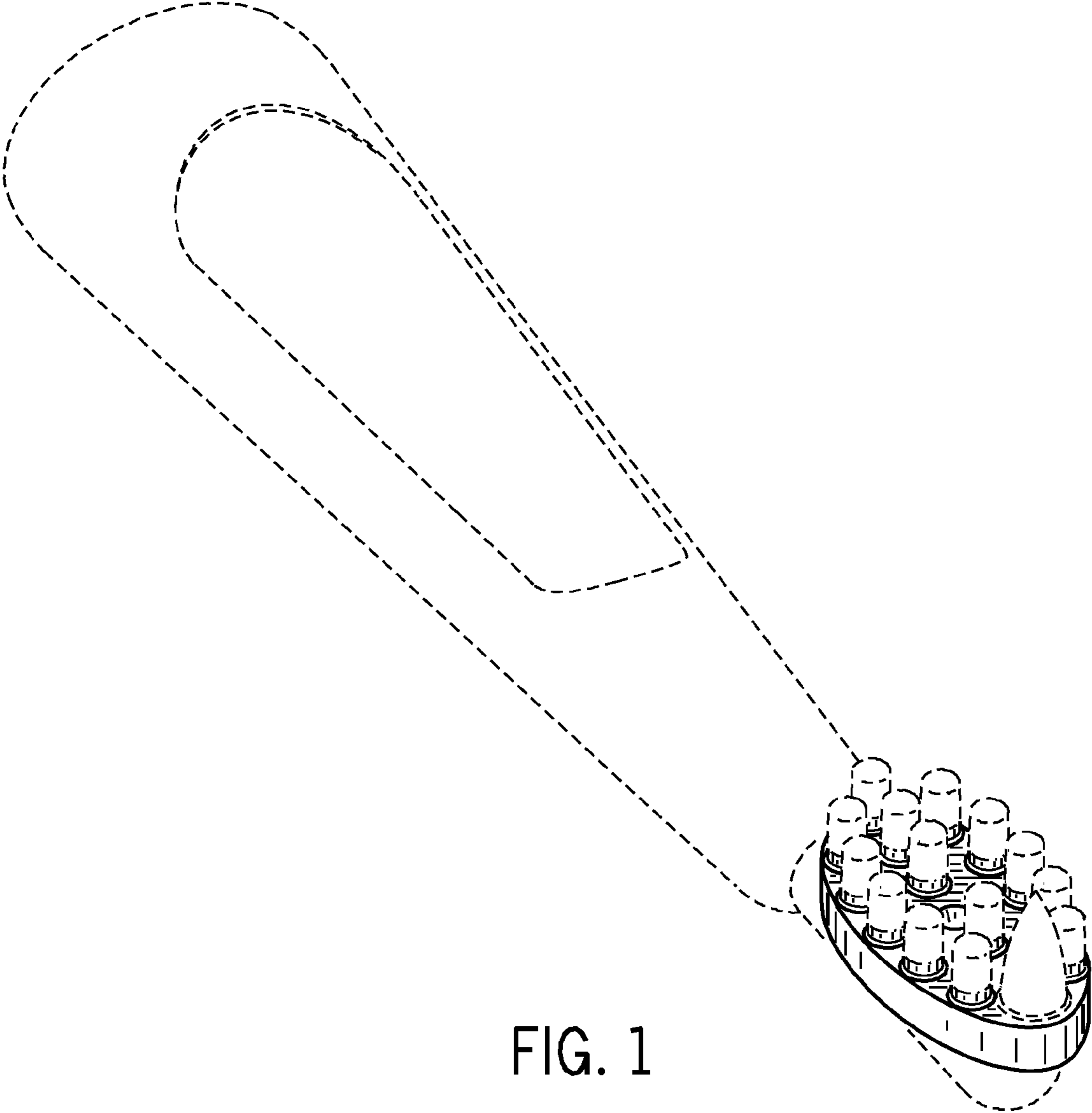

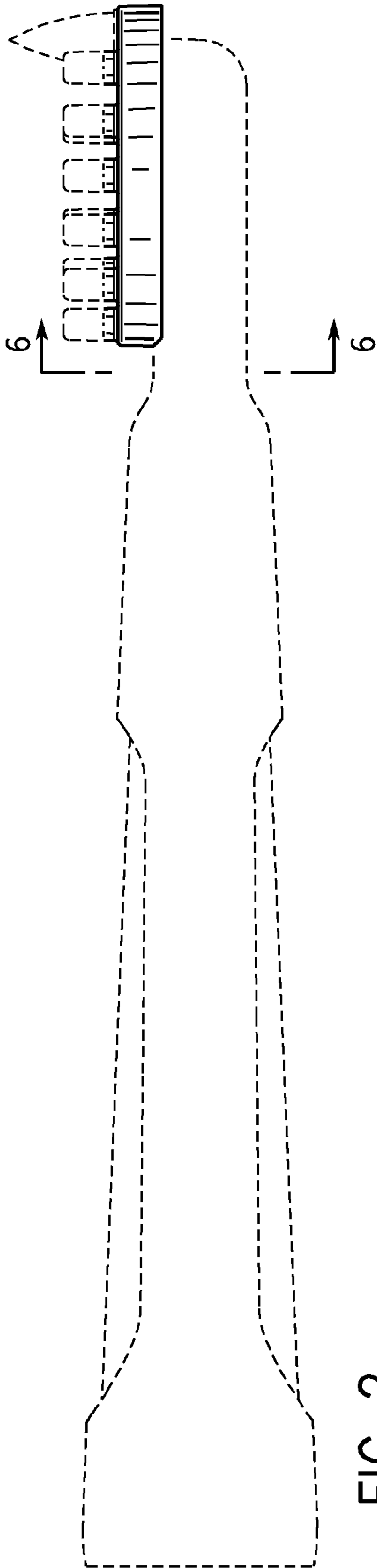

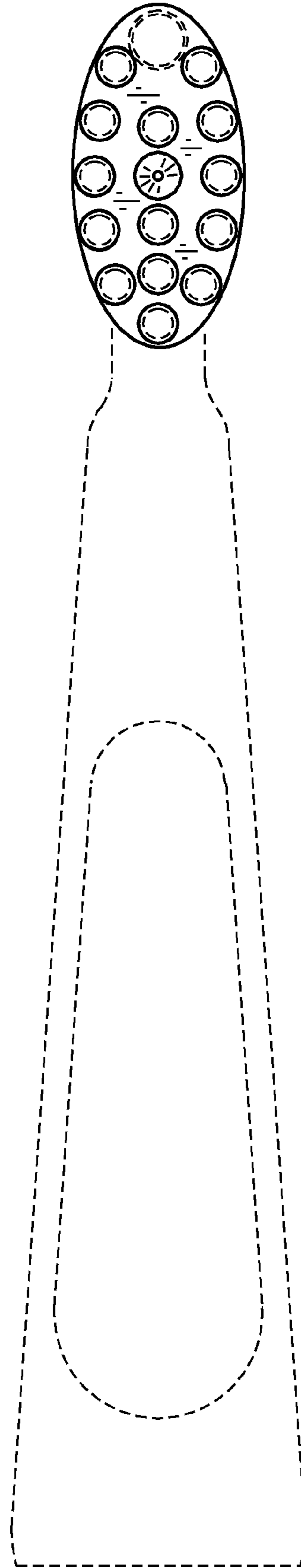

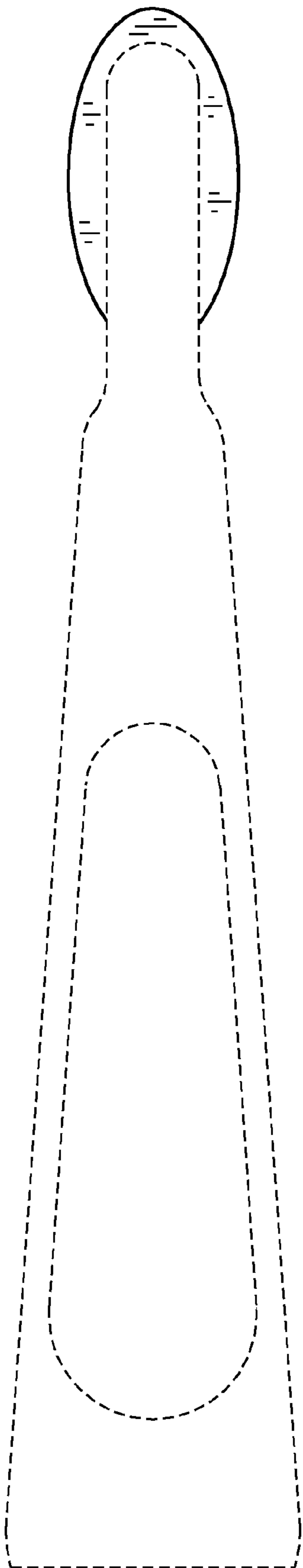

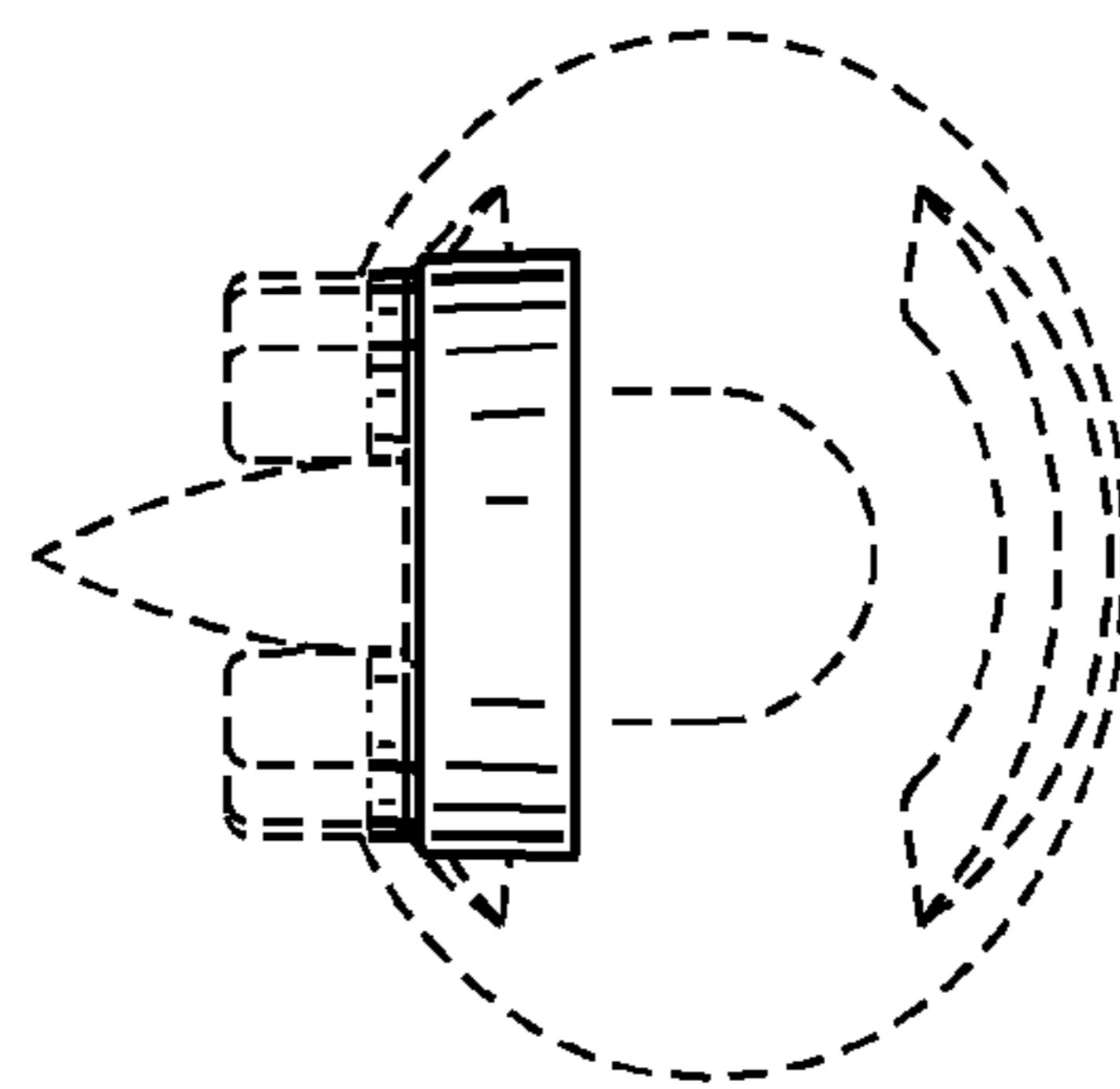

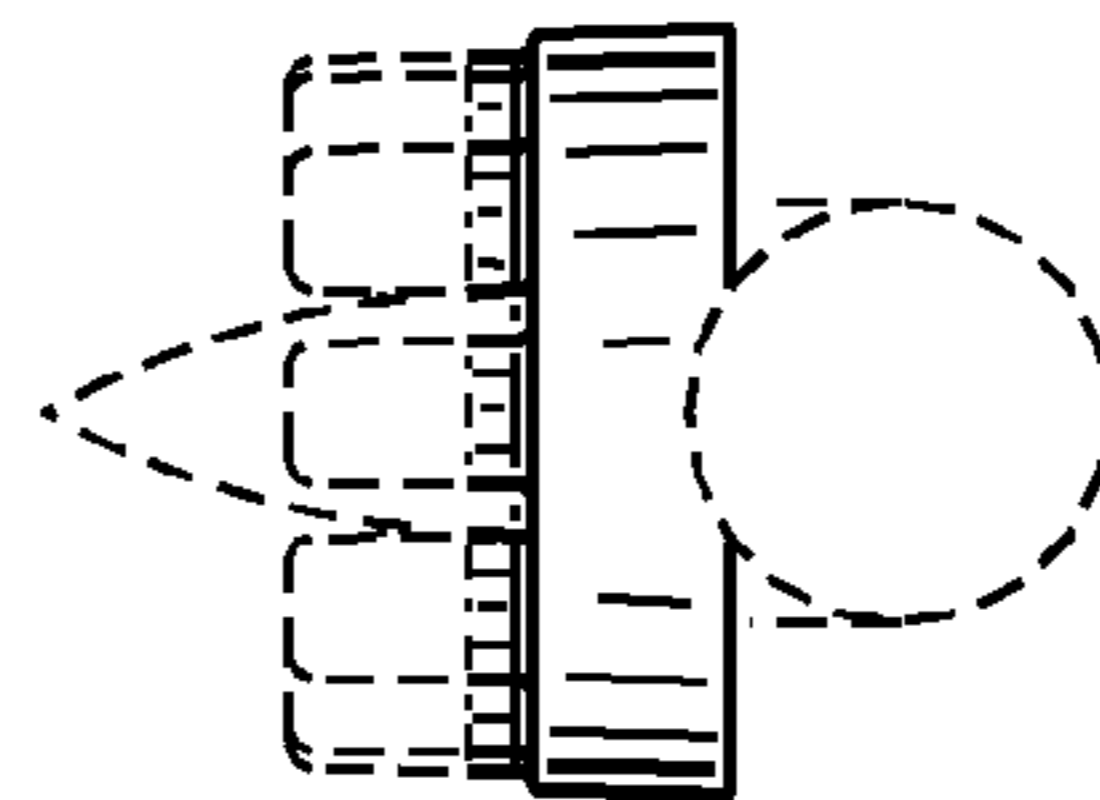
