FIG. 4 is a rear side elevation view thereof;

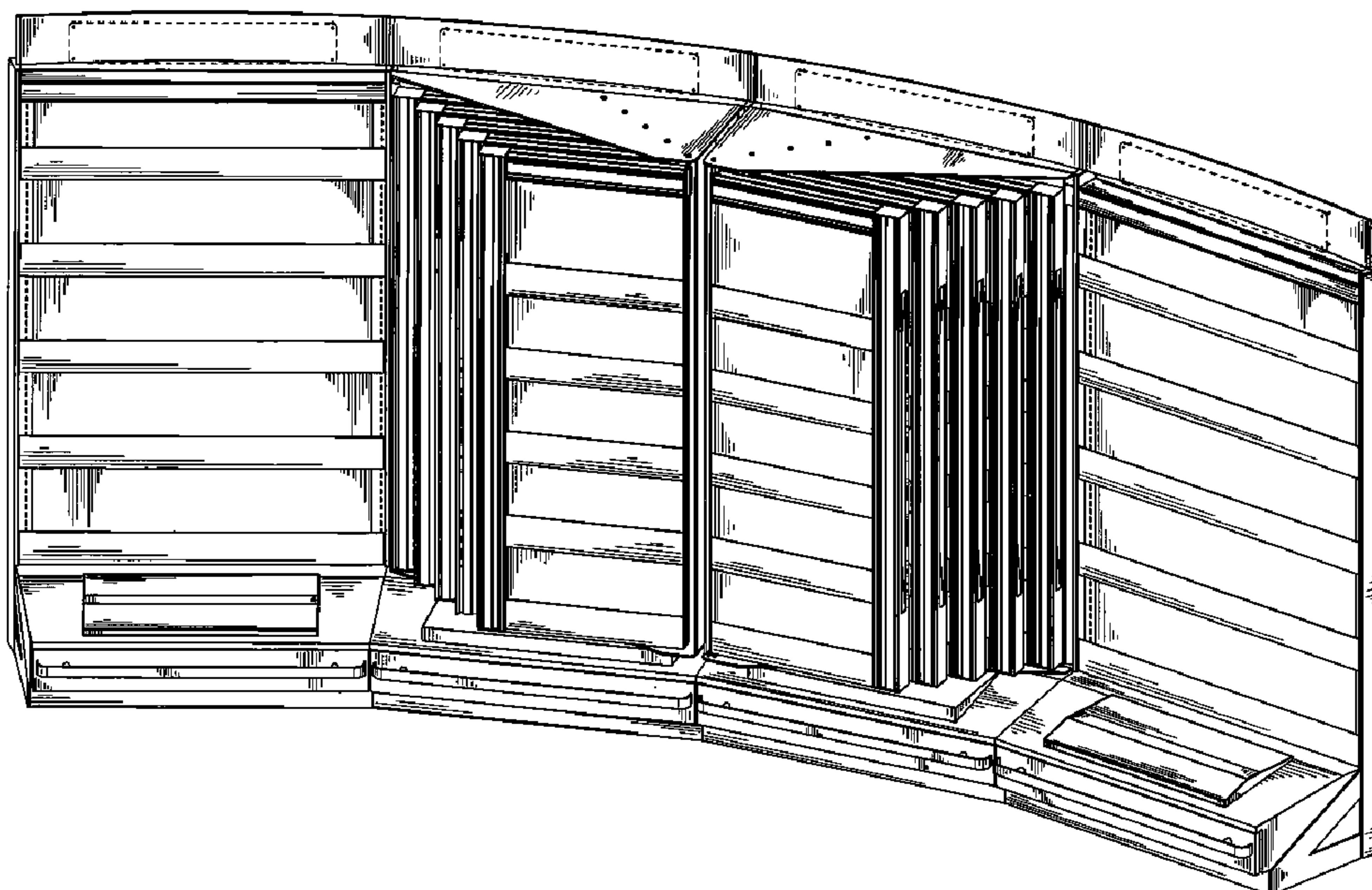
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

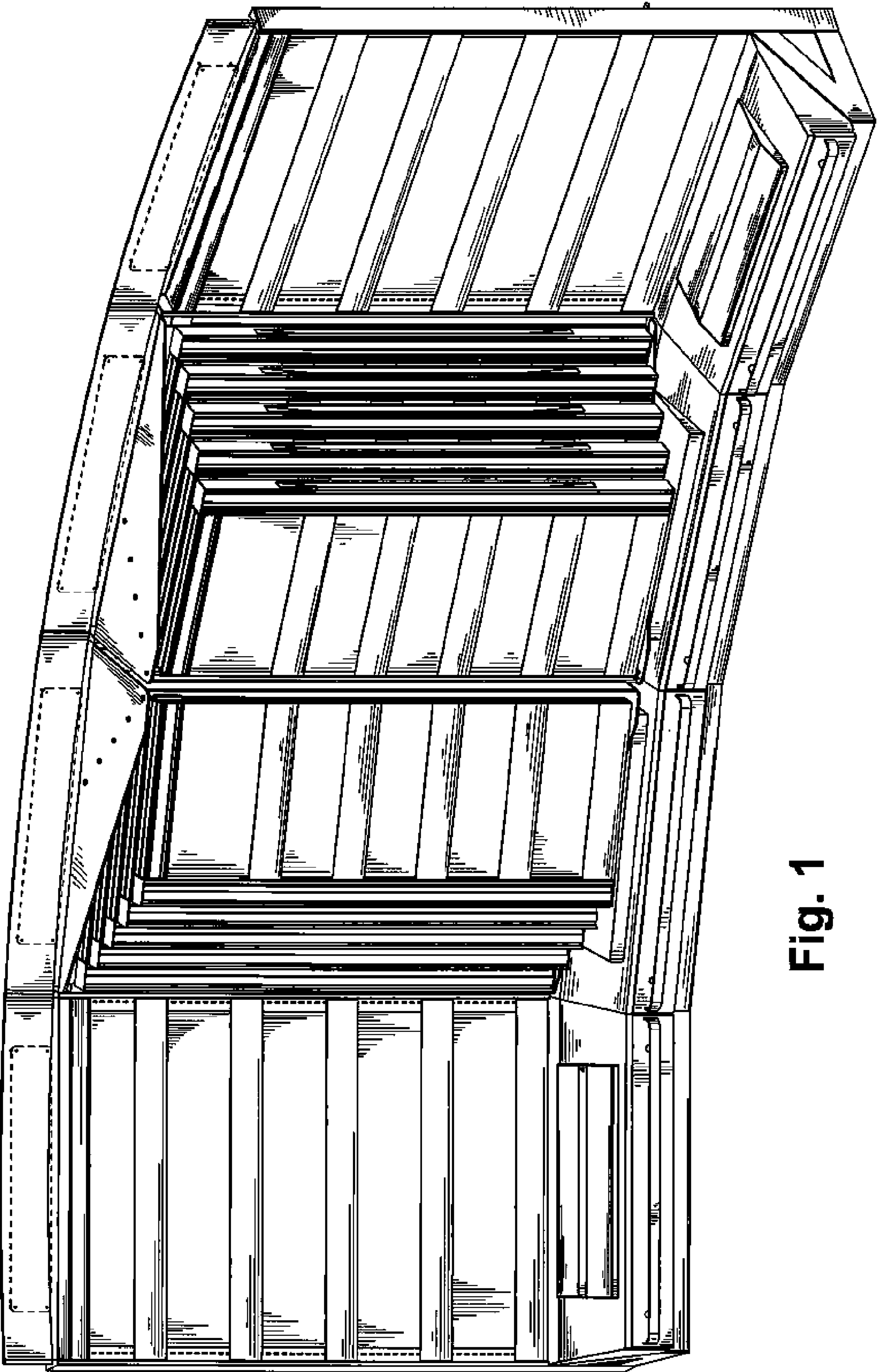

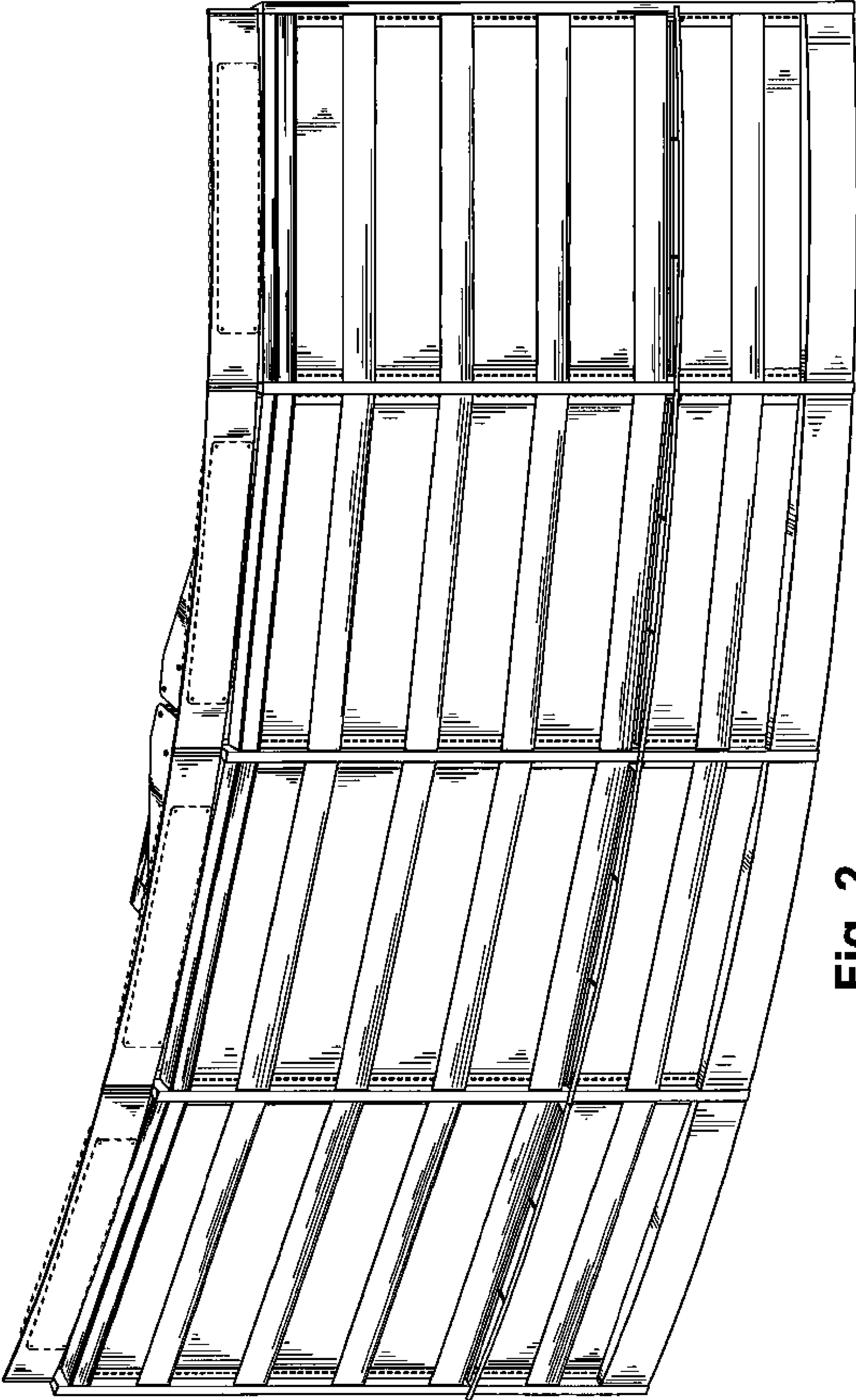

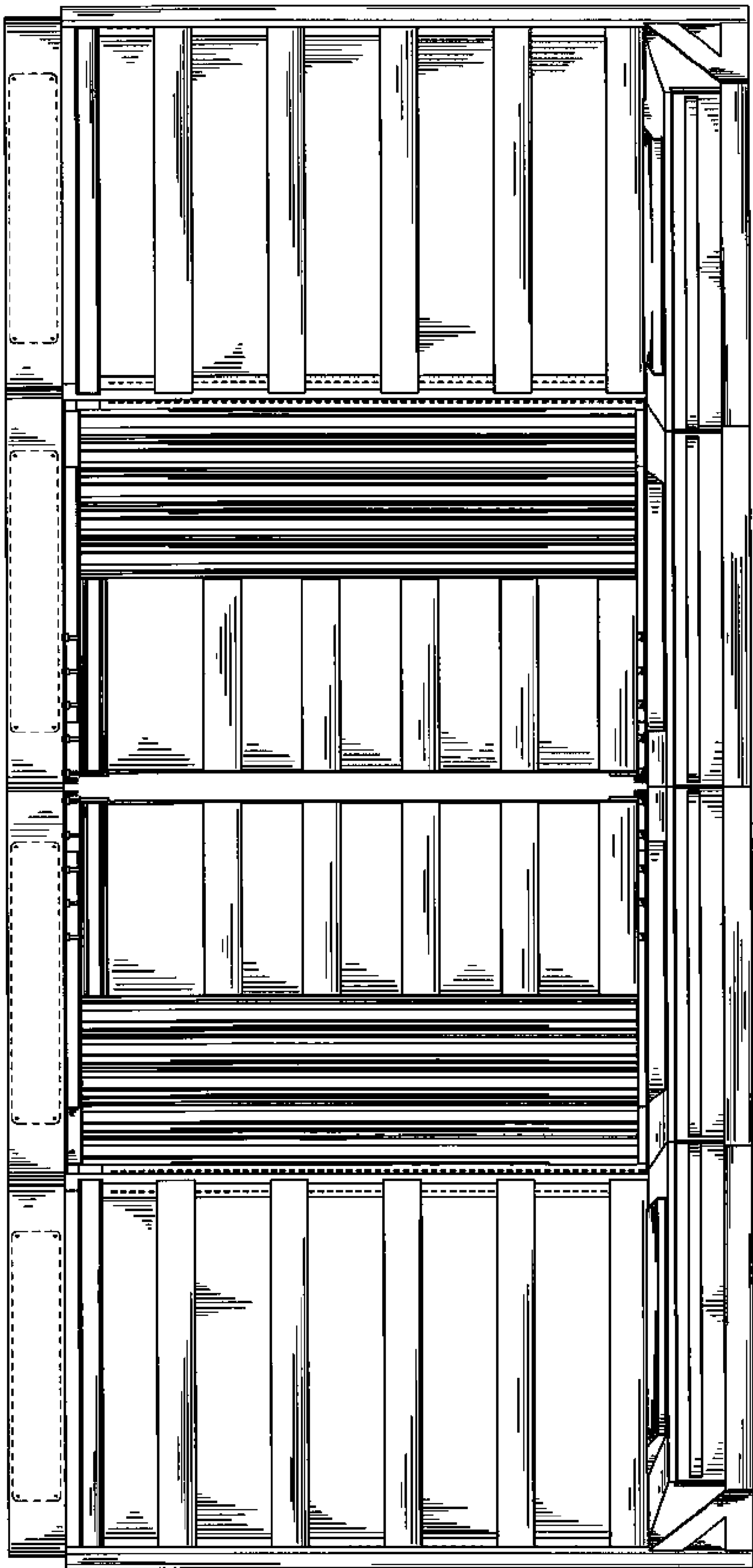

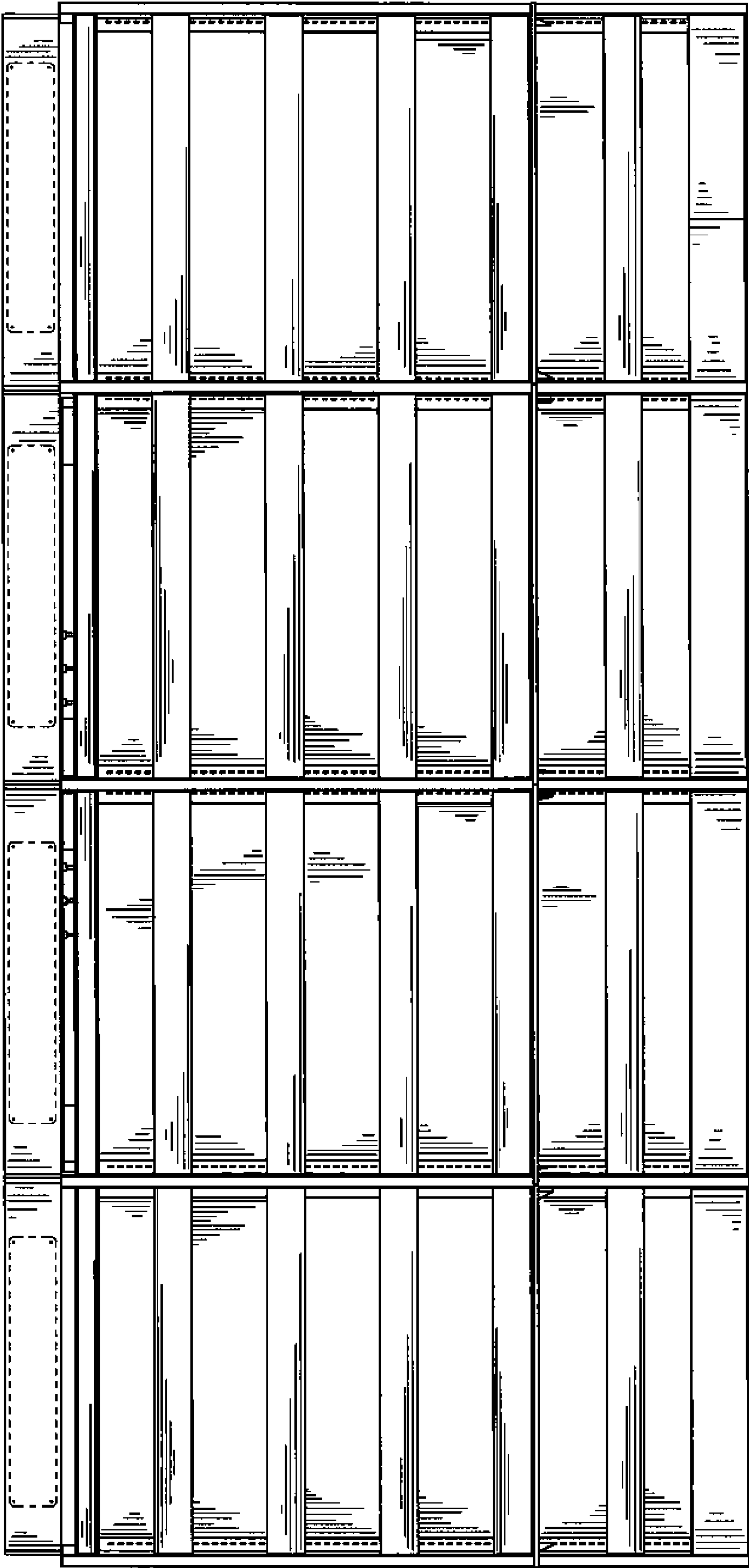

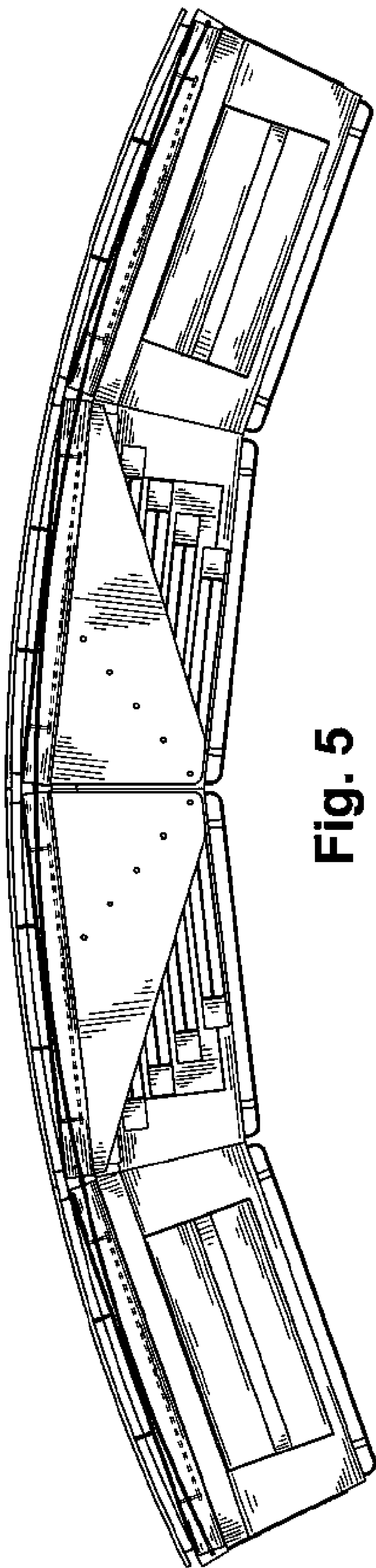

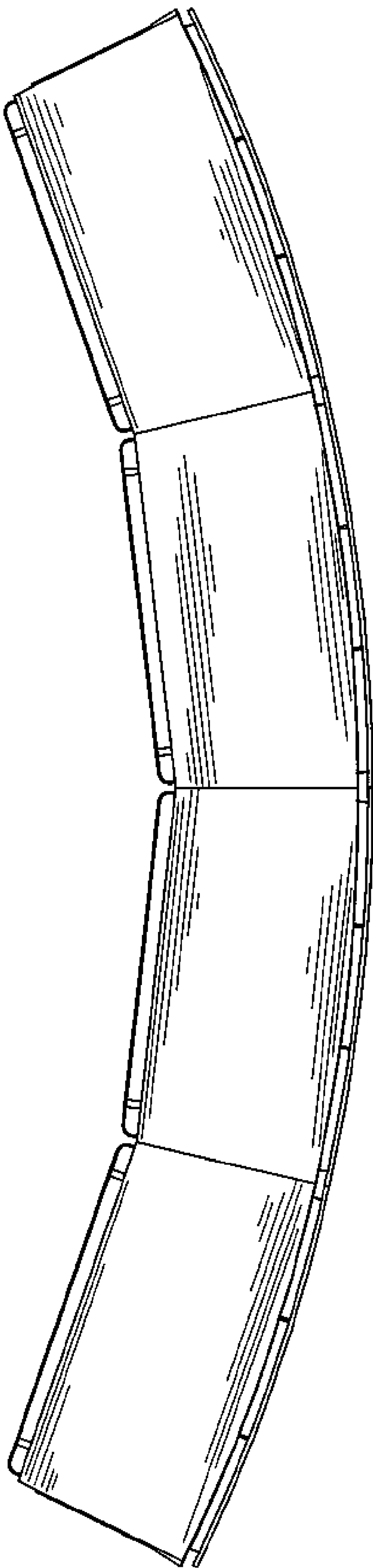

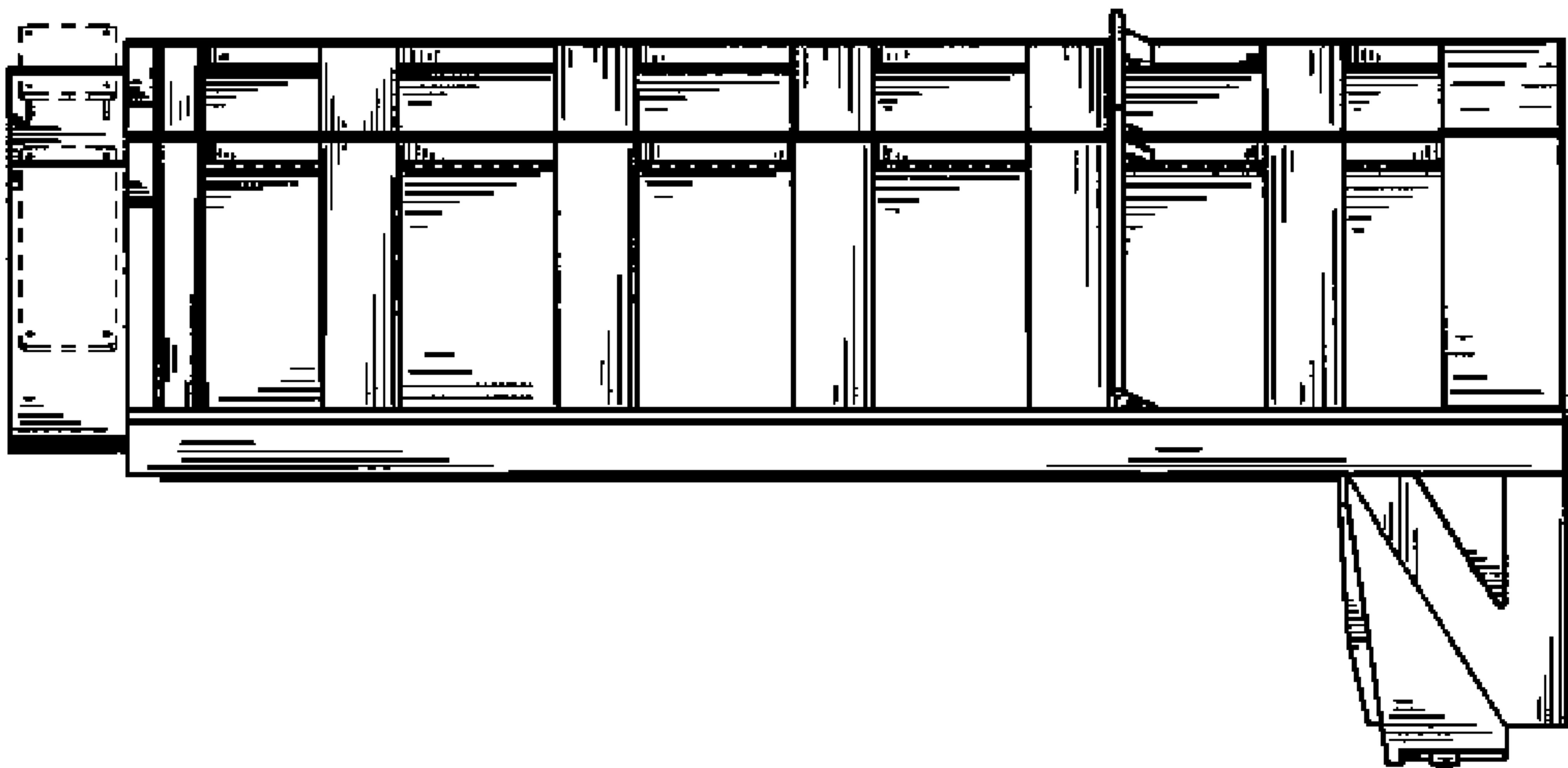
