FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

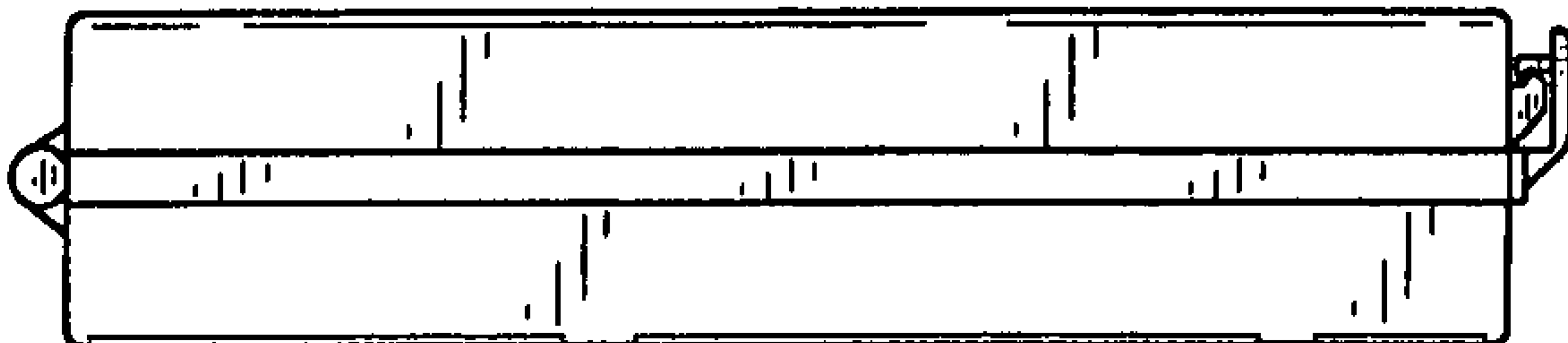
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof depicting the refillable

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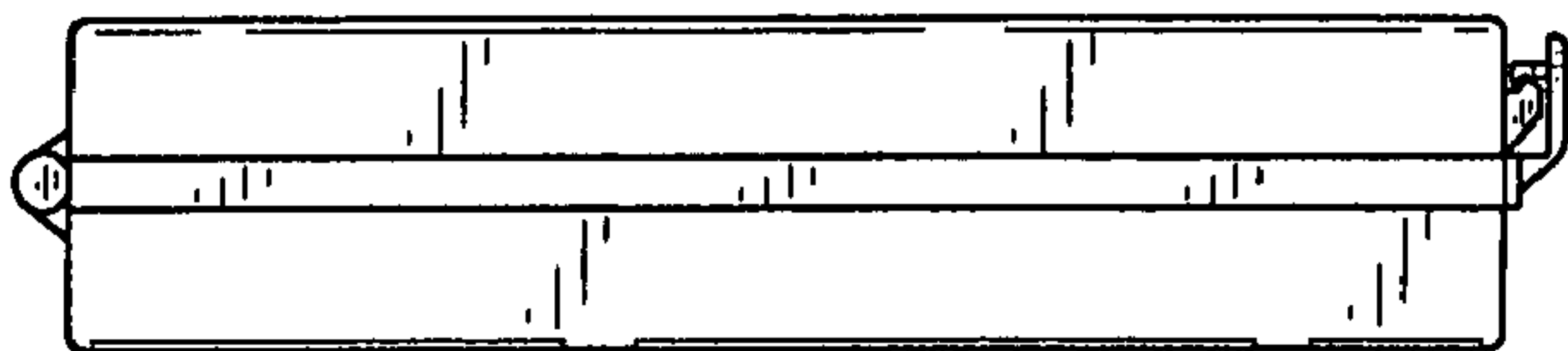

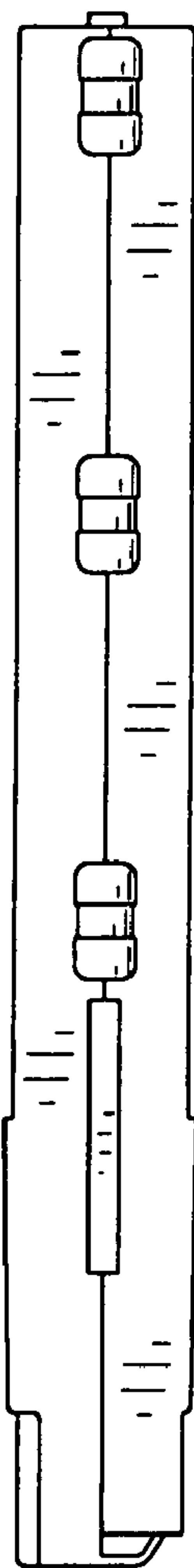

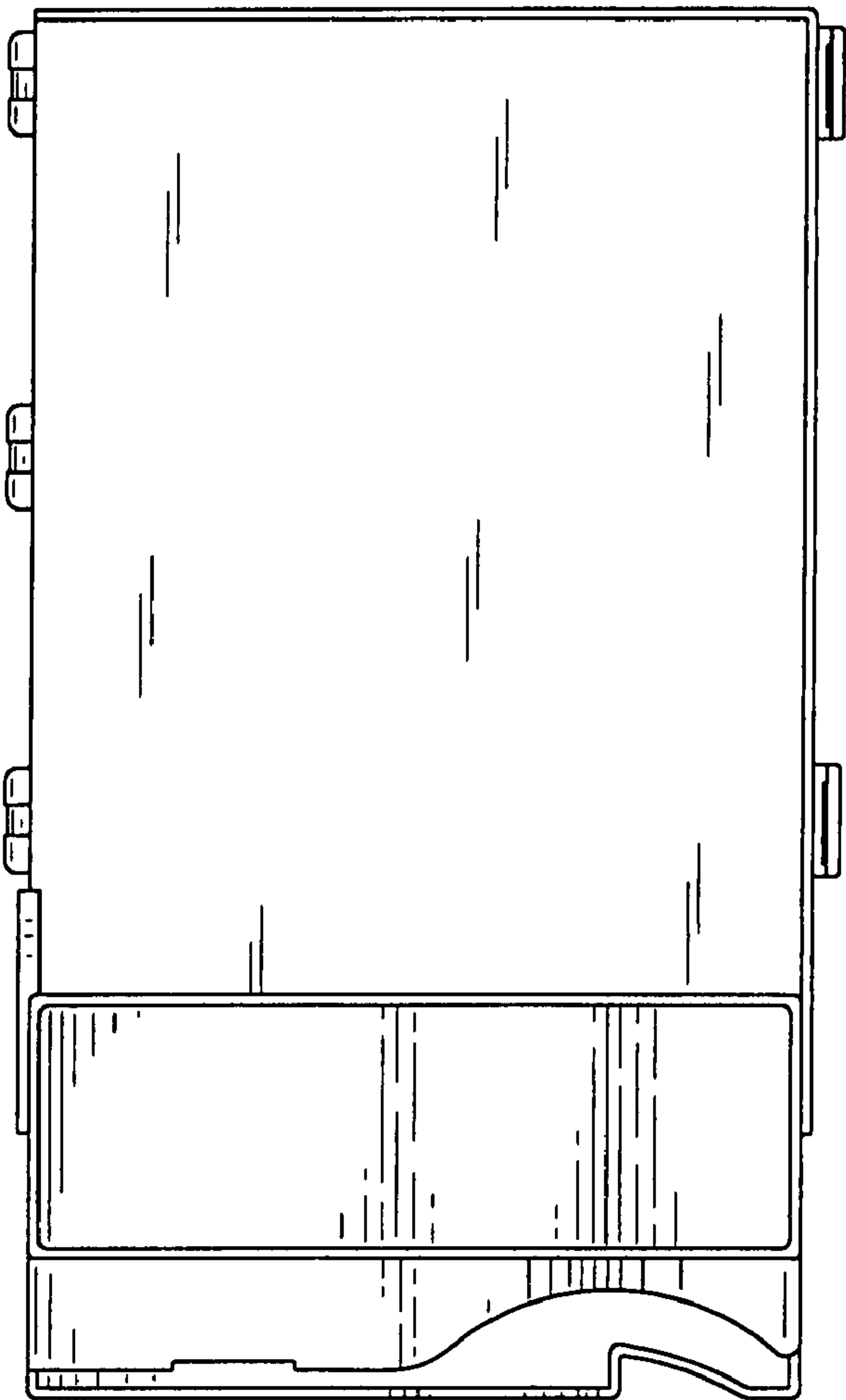

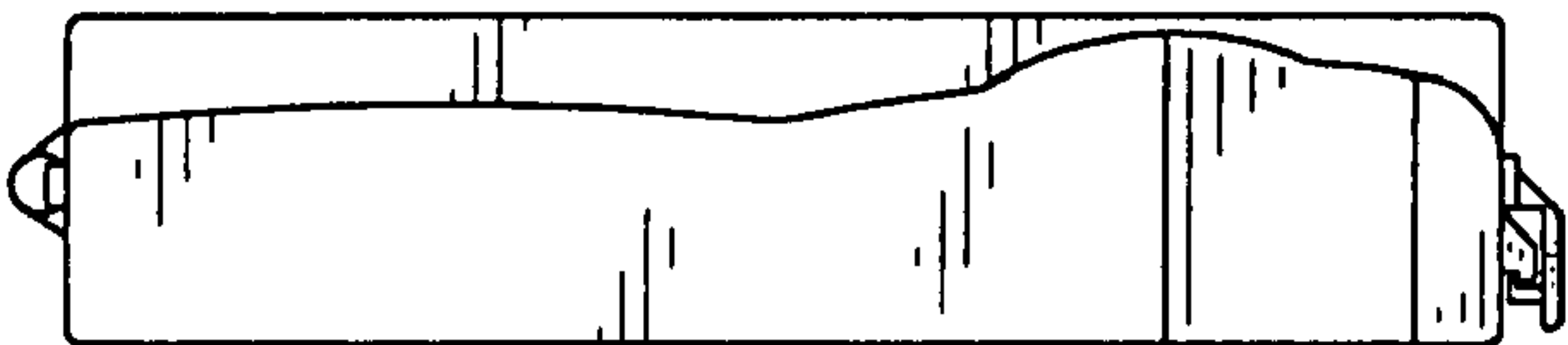

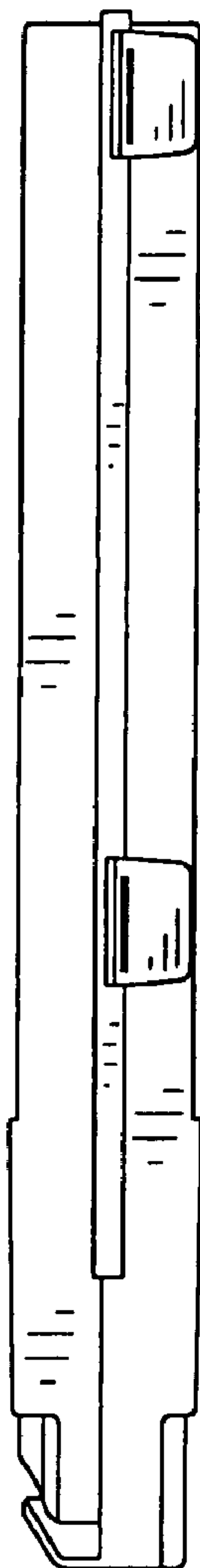

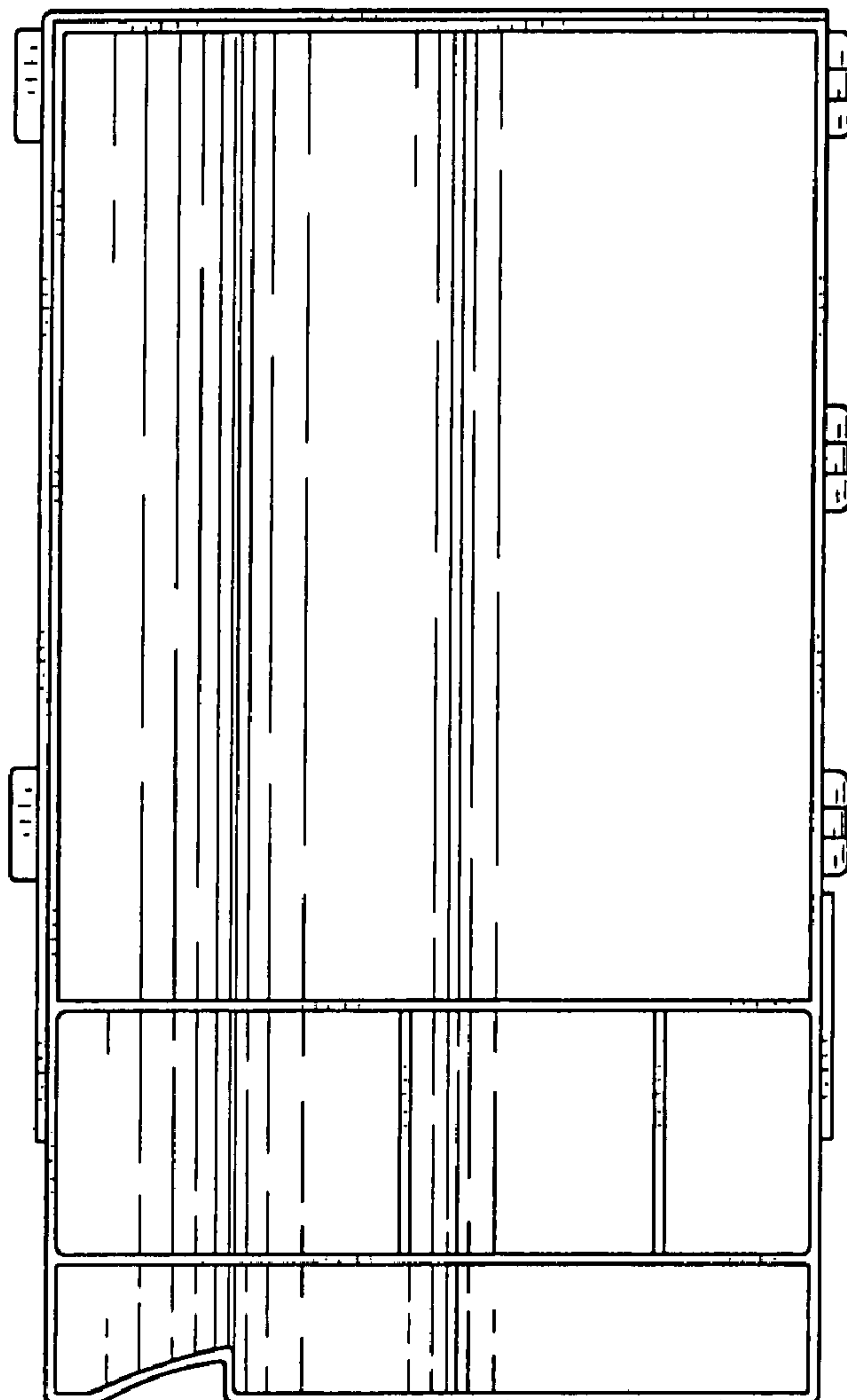

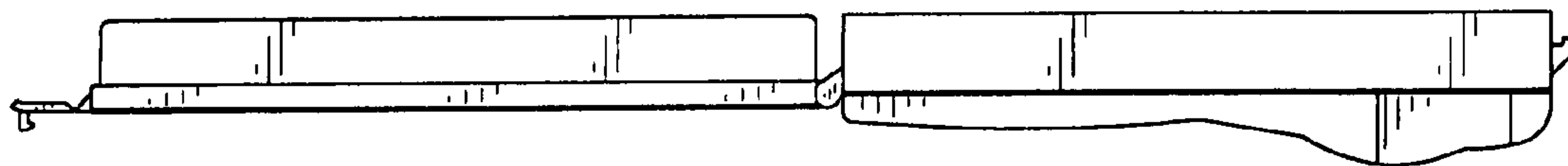

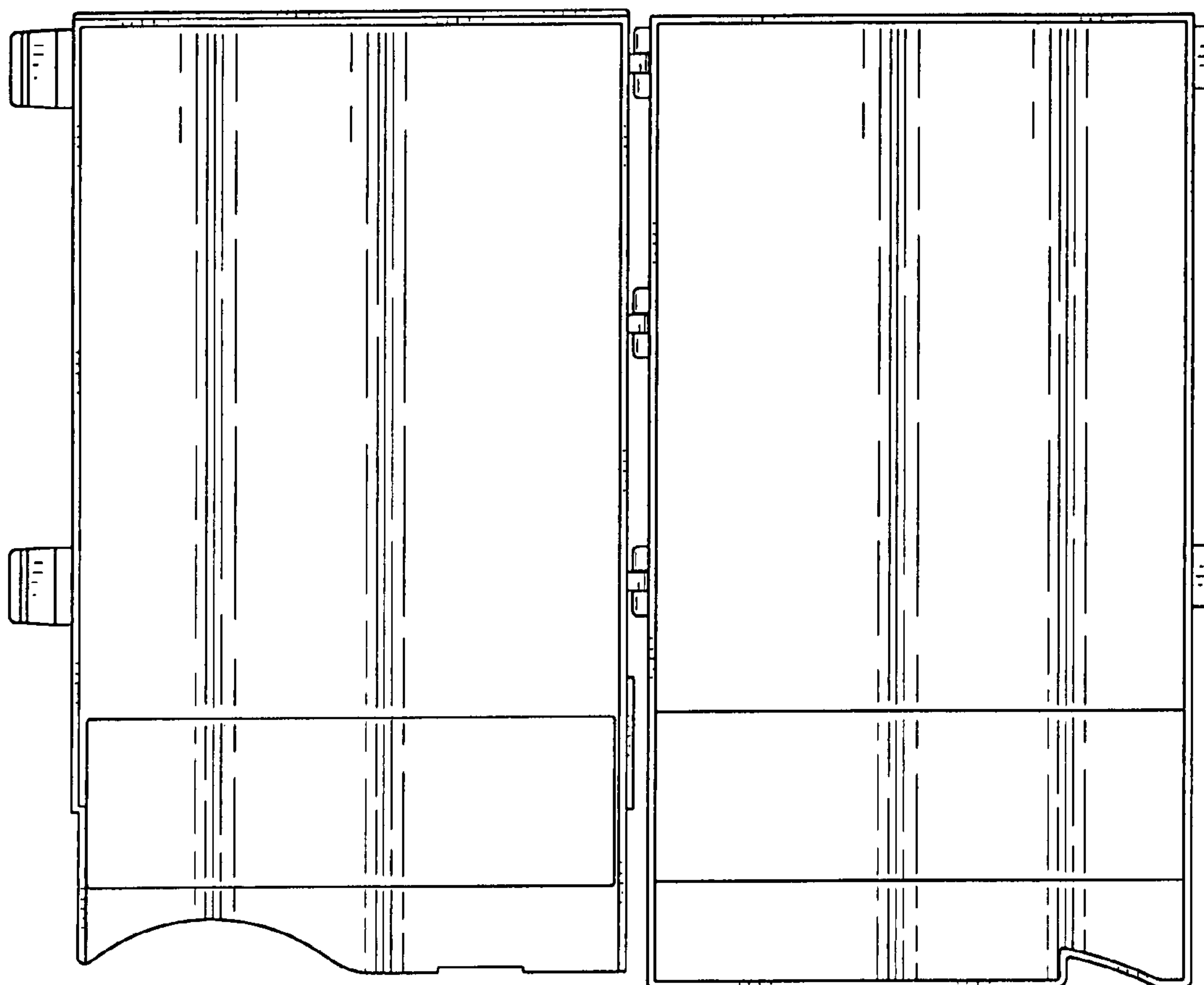

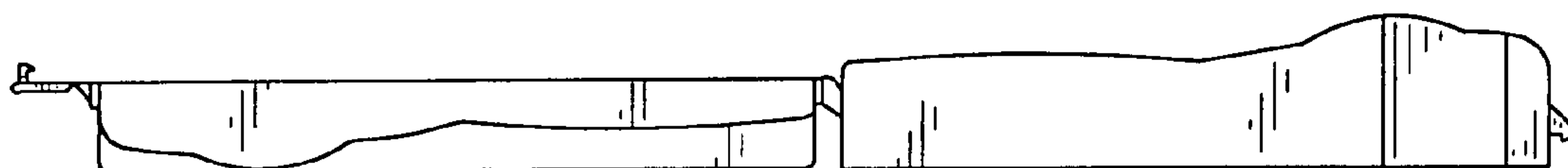

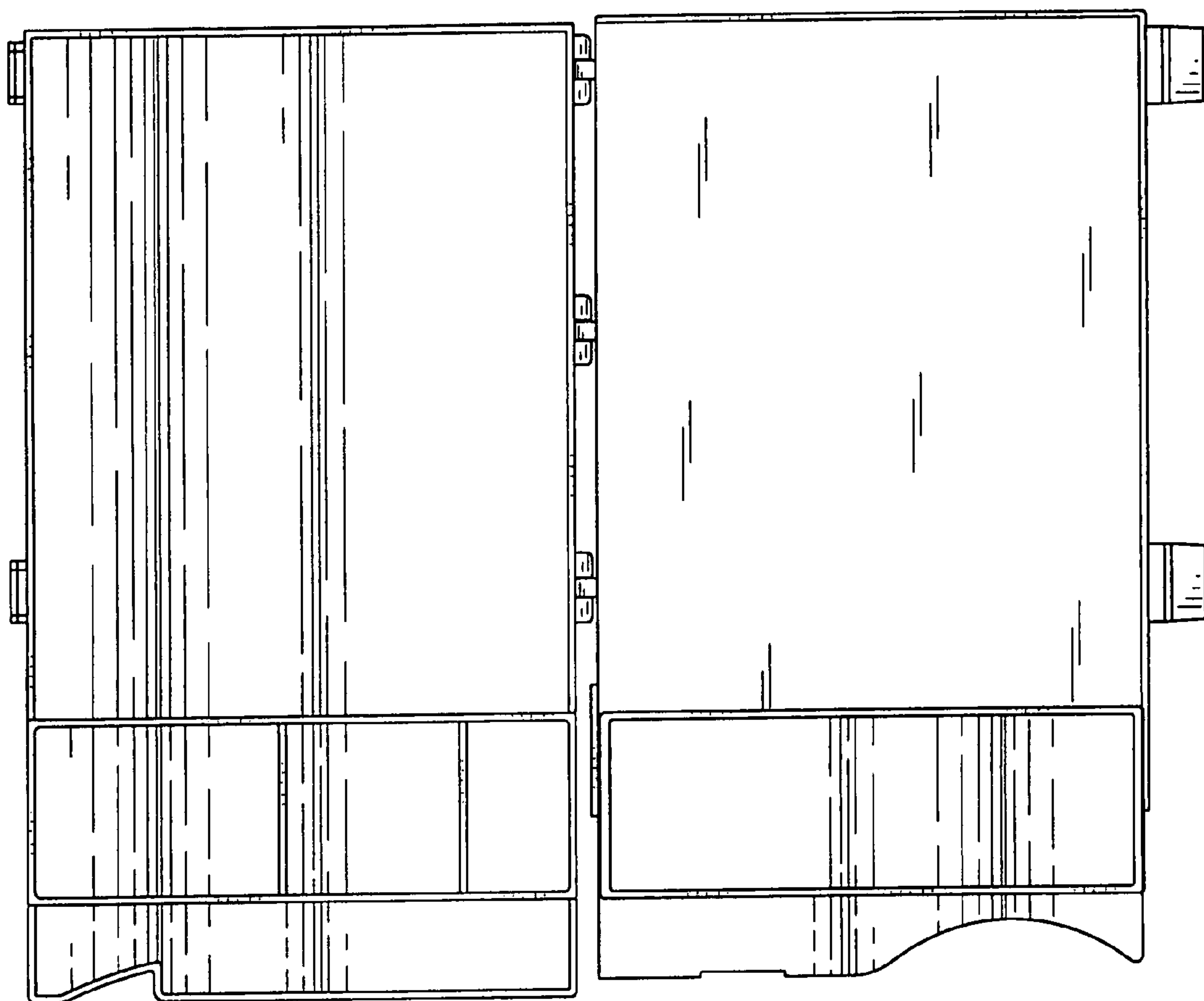
