FIG. 3 is a front view of the cutting board;

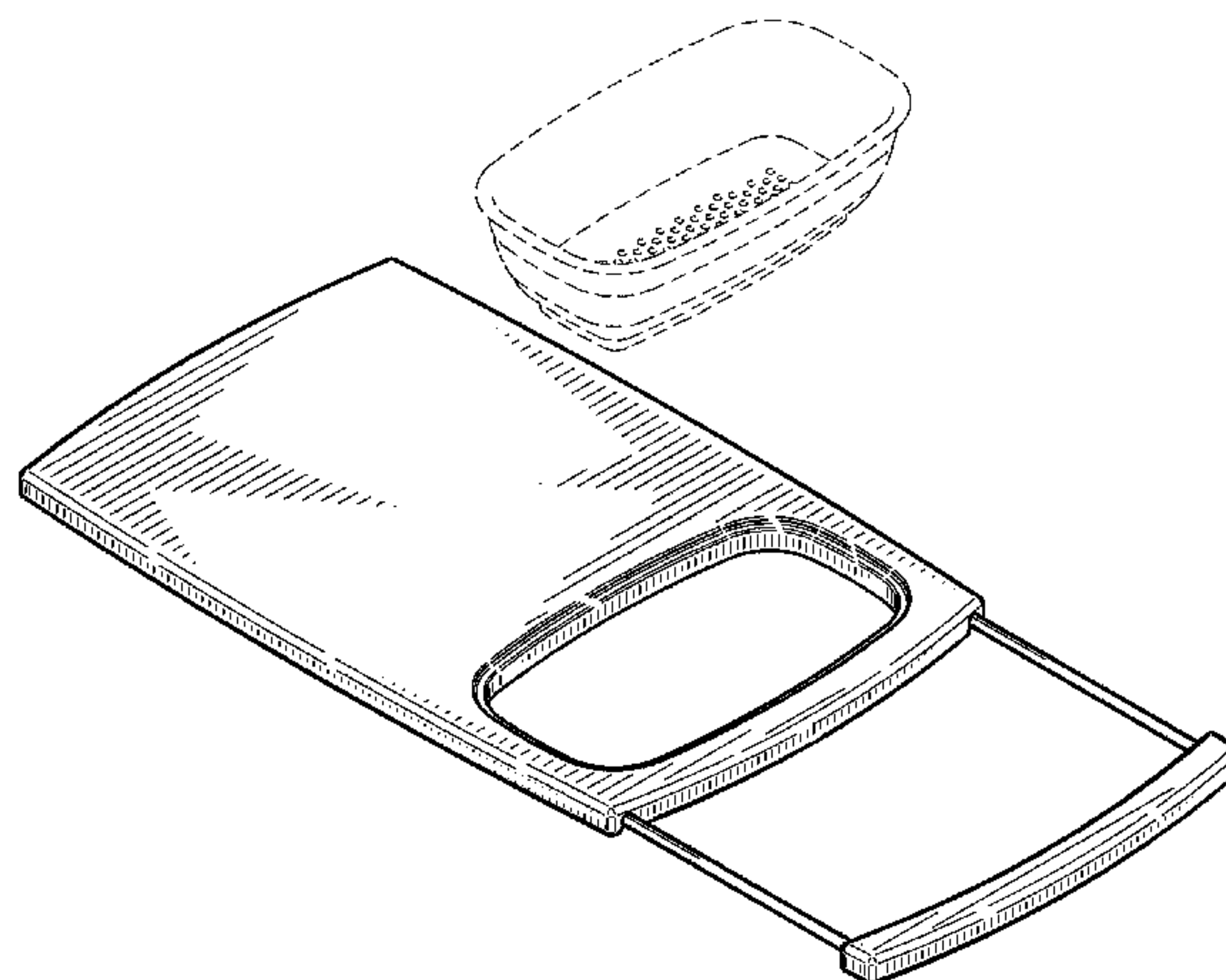
FIG. 4 is a right side view of the cutting board;

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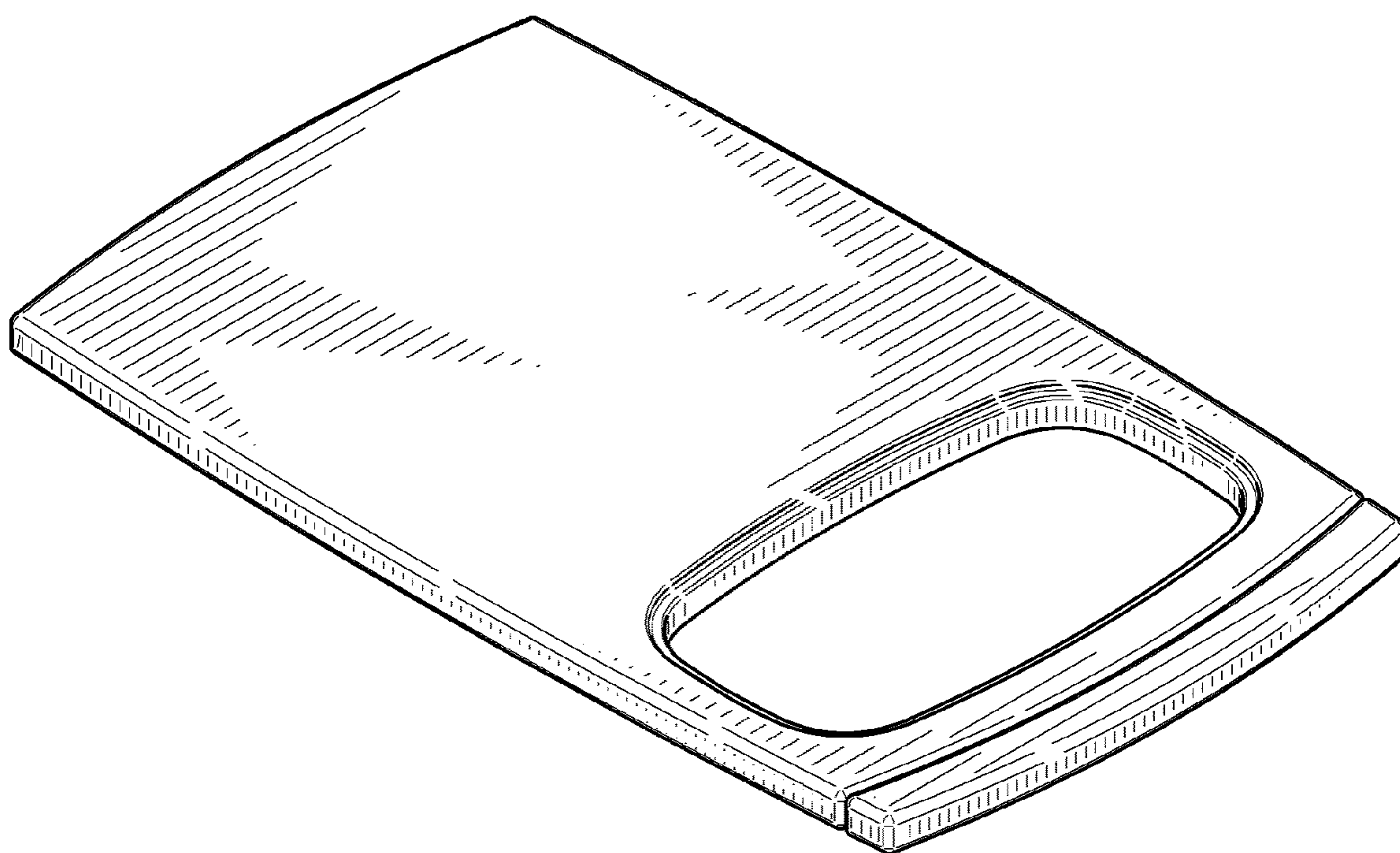

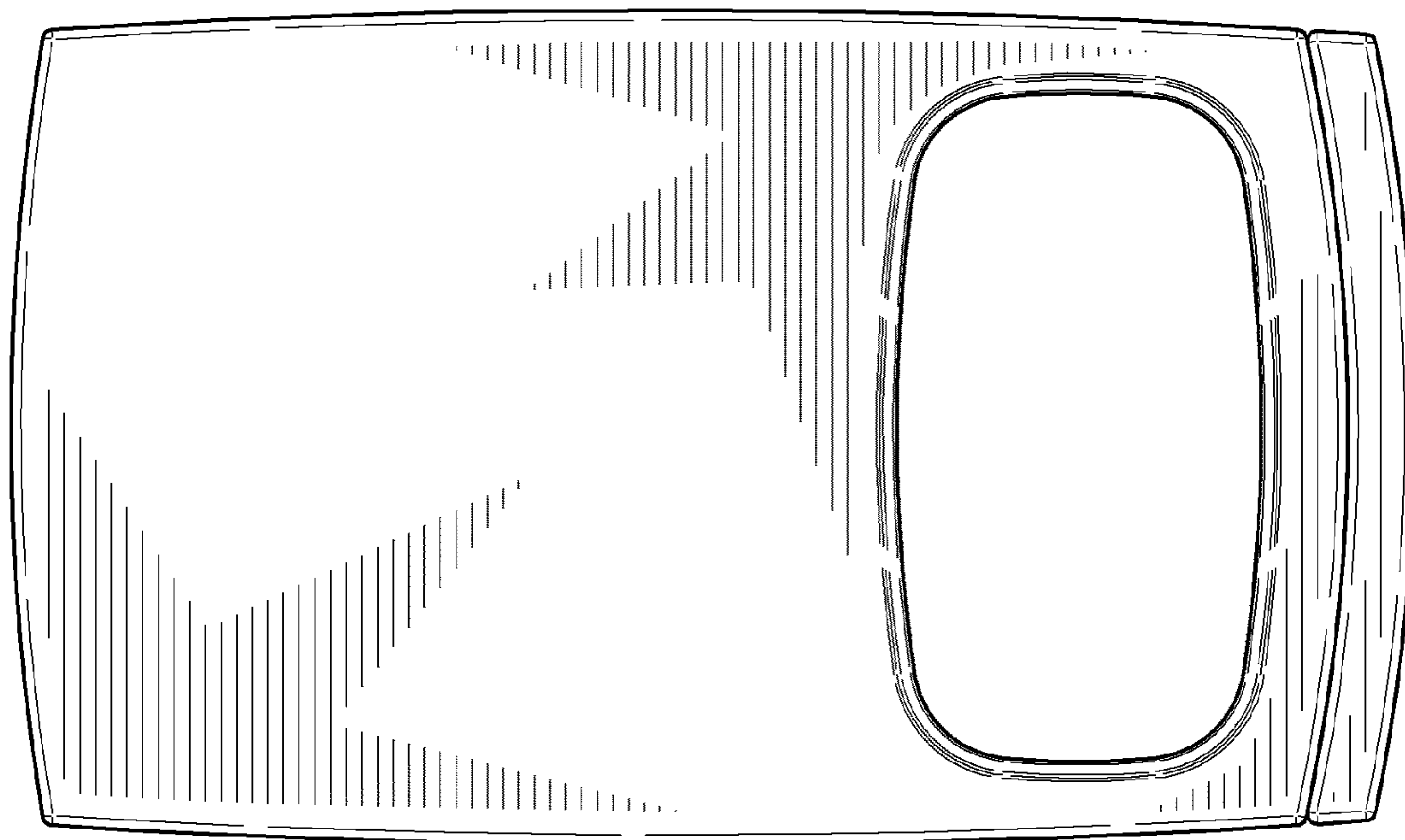

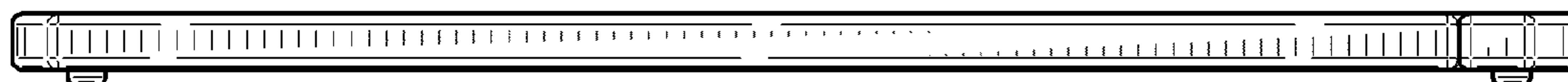

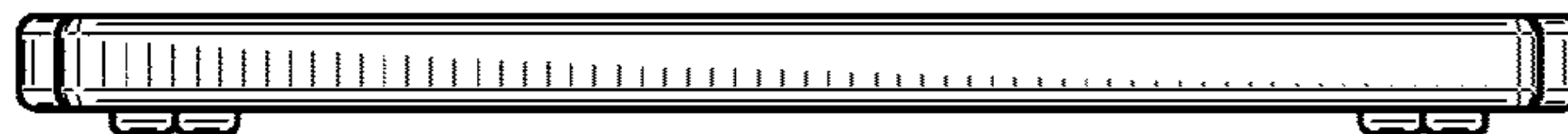

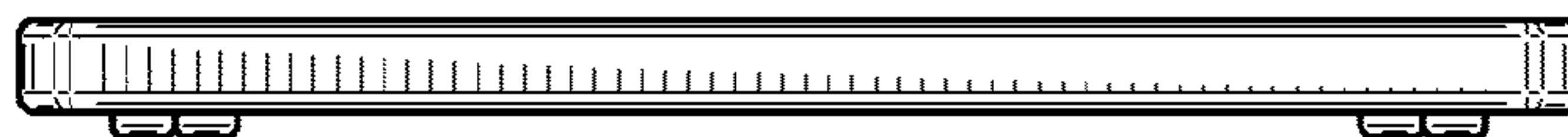

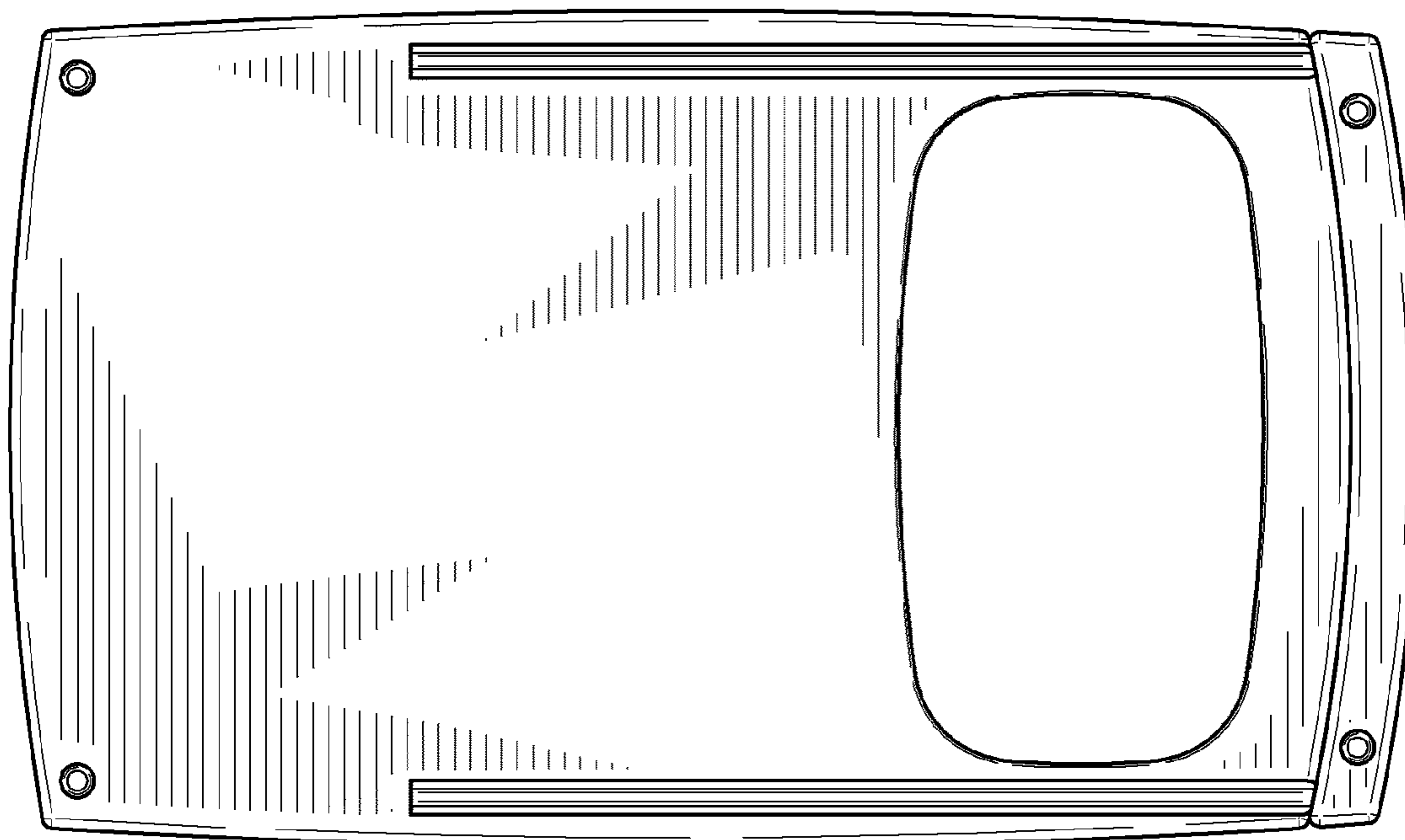
