(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pivoting support handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pivoting support handle.

FIG. 2 is a front view of the pivoting support handle;

FIG. 3 is a front view with the handle turned at a slight angle;

FIG. 4 is a front view with the handle turned 90°;

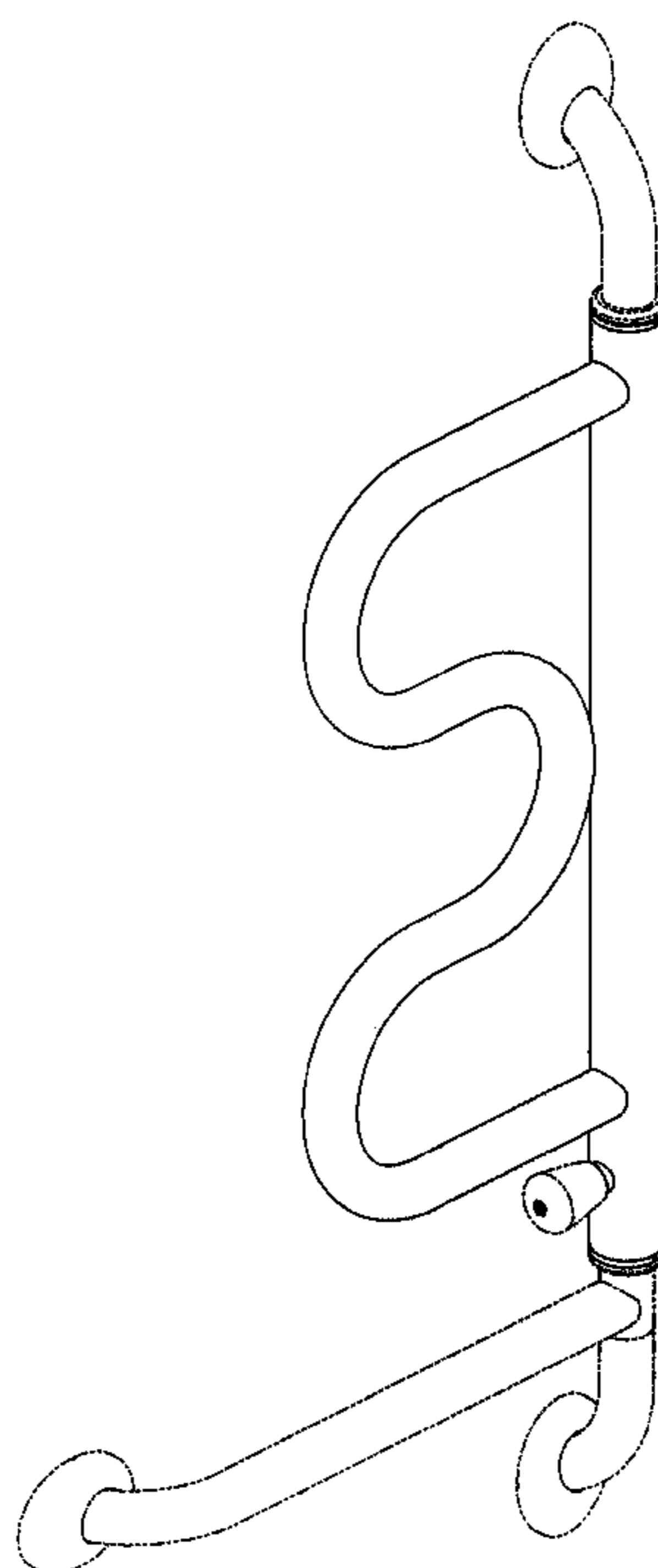
FIG. 5 is a front view of the handle turned at an angle to the right of FIG. 4;

FIG. 6 is a front view of the handle turned 180° from the view of FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 7 is a reduced scale, environmental perspective view thereof.

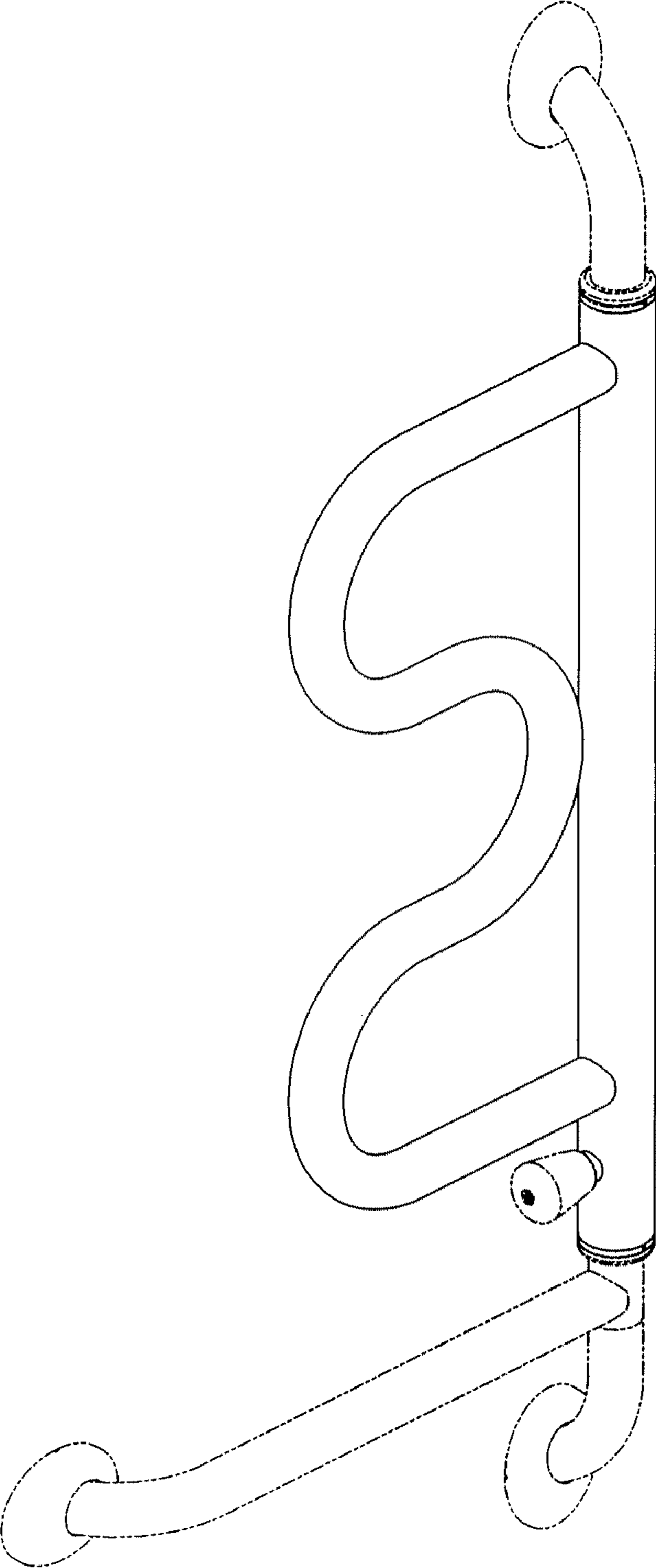

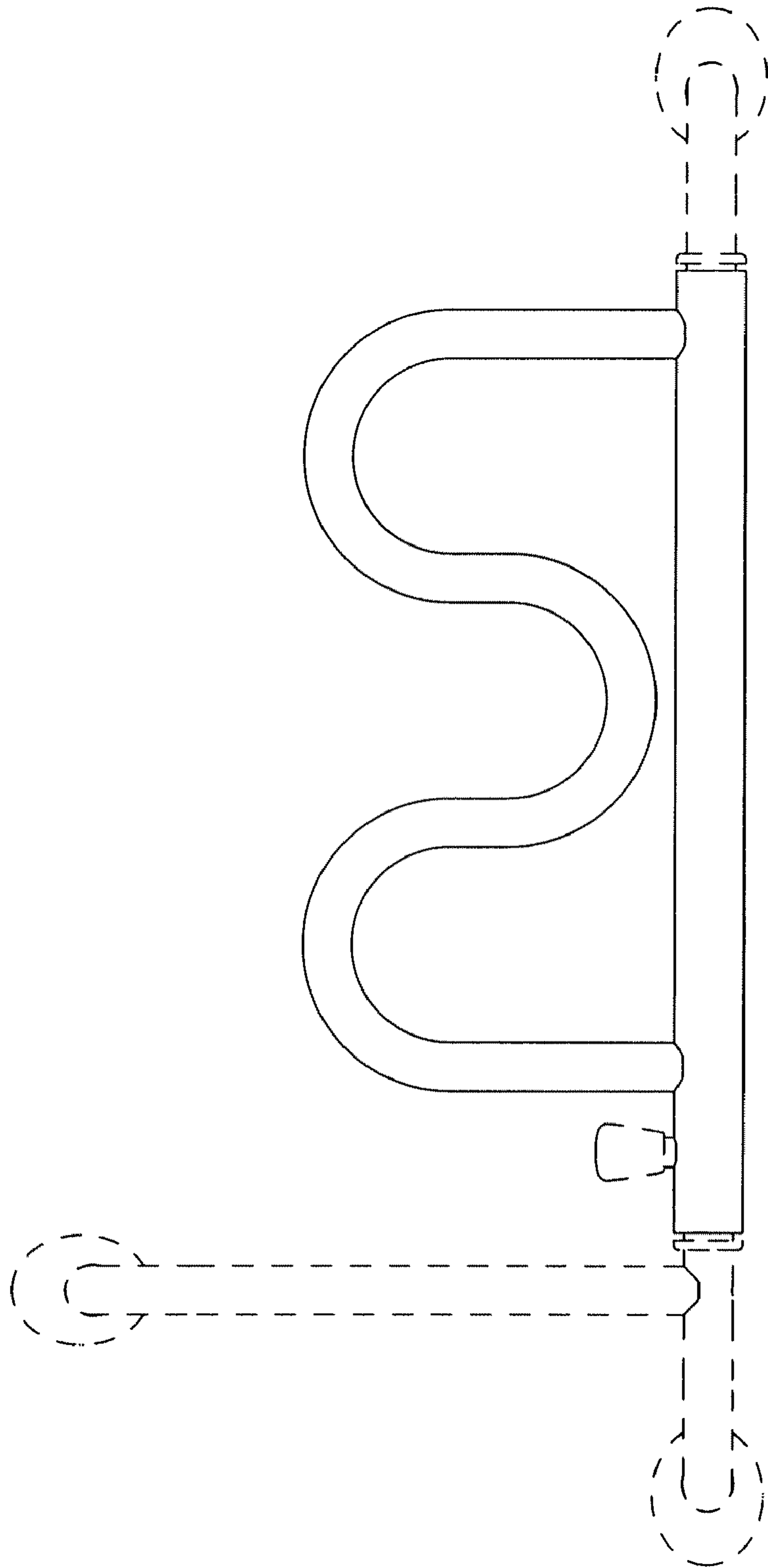

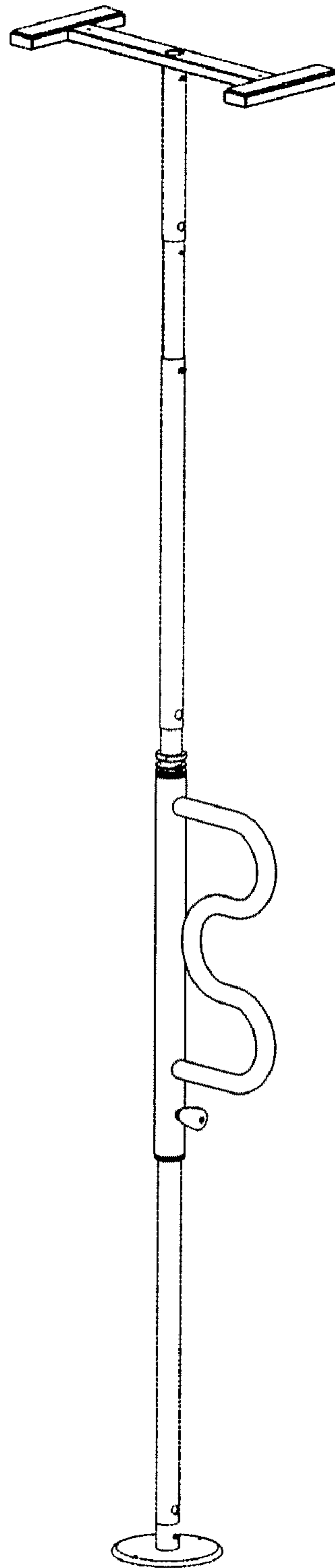

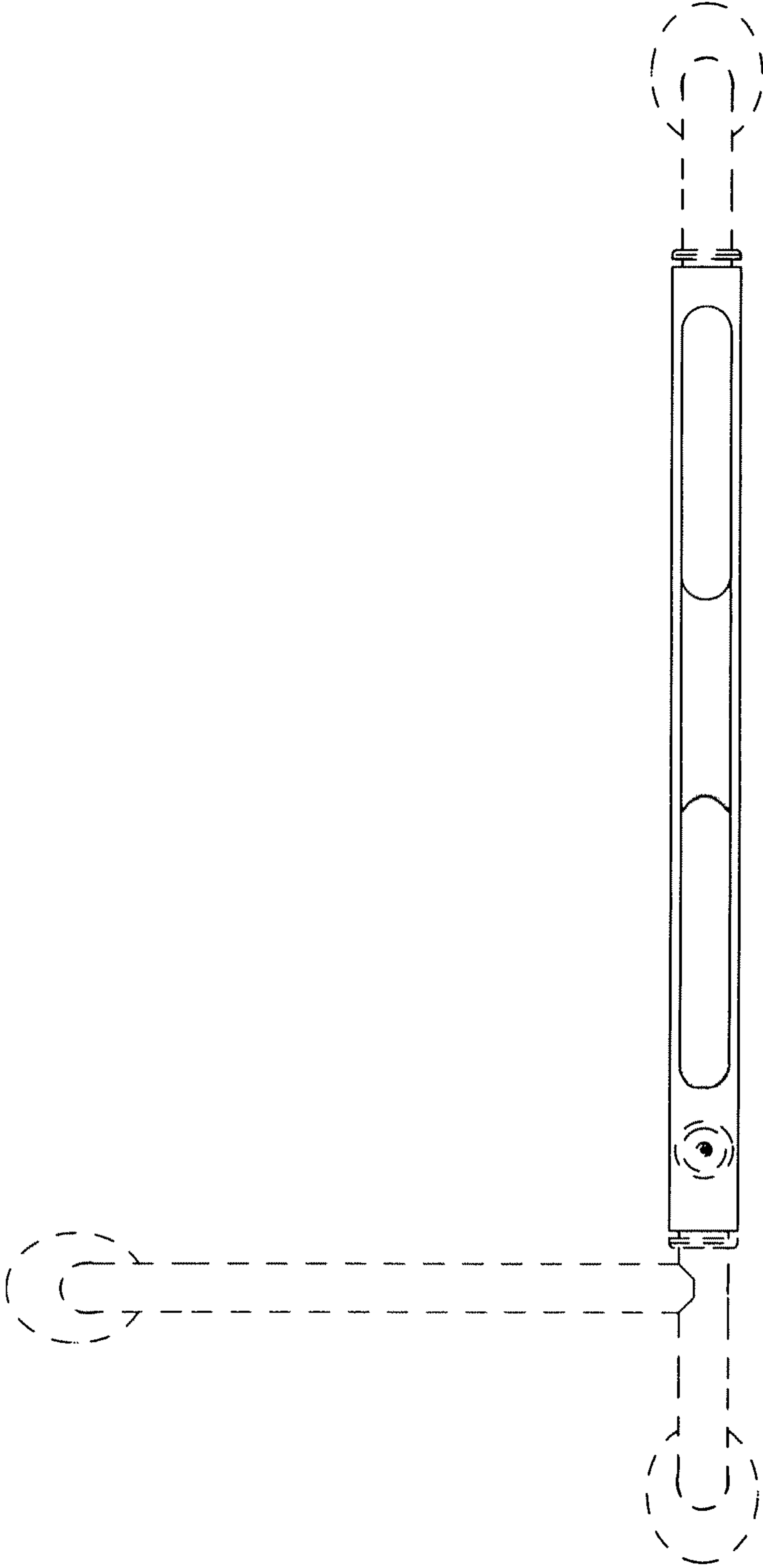

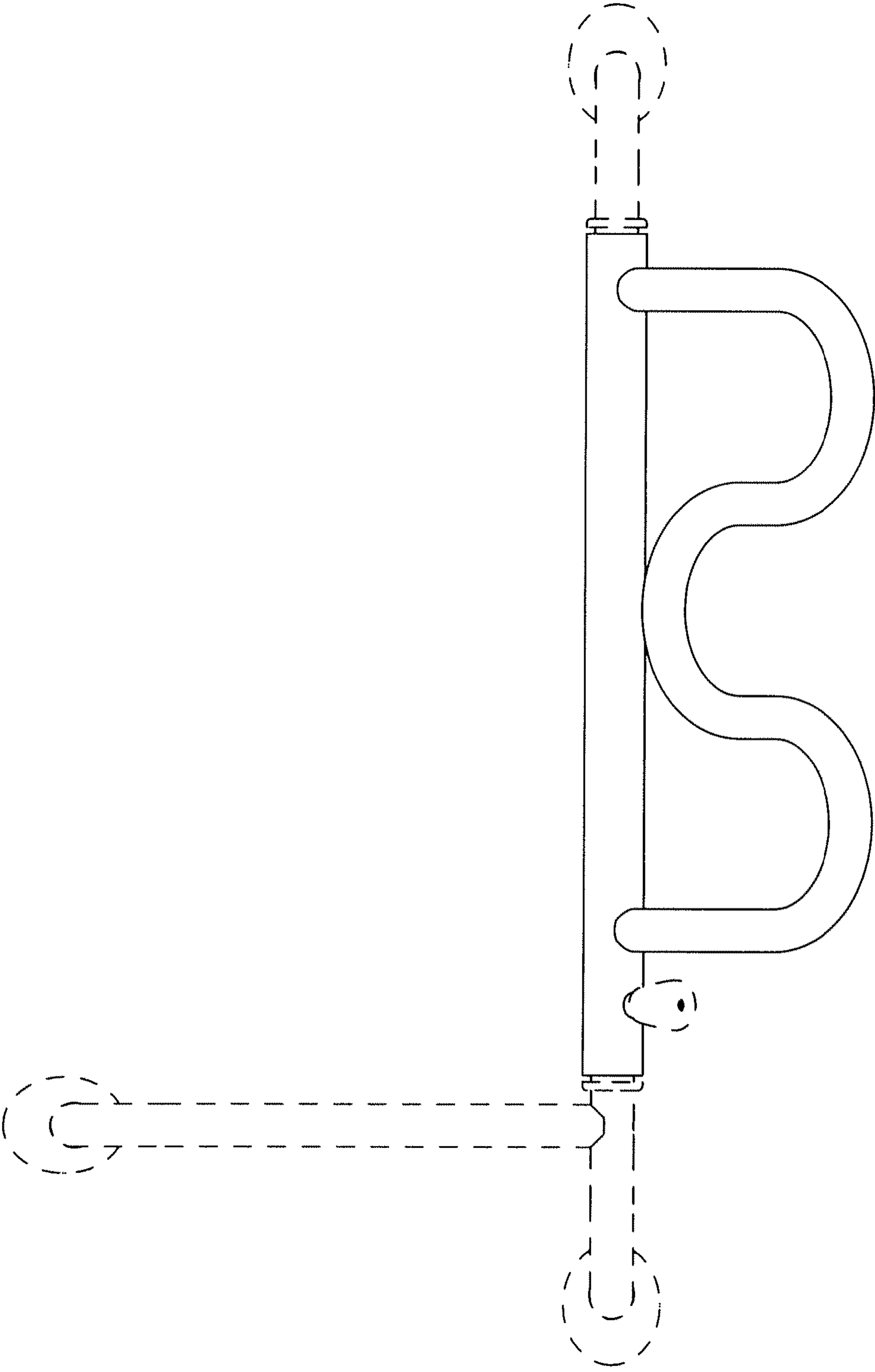

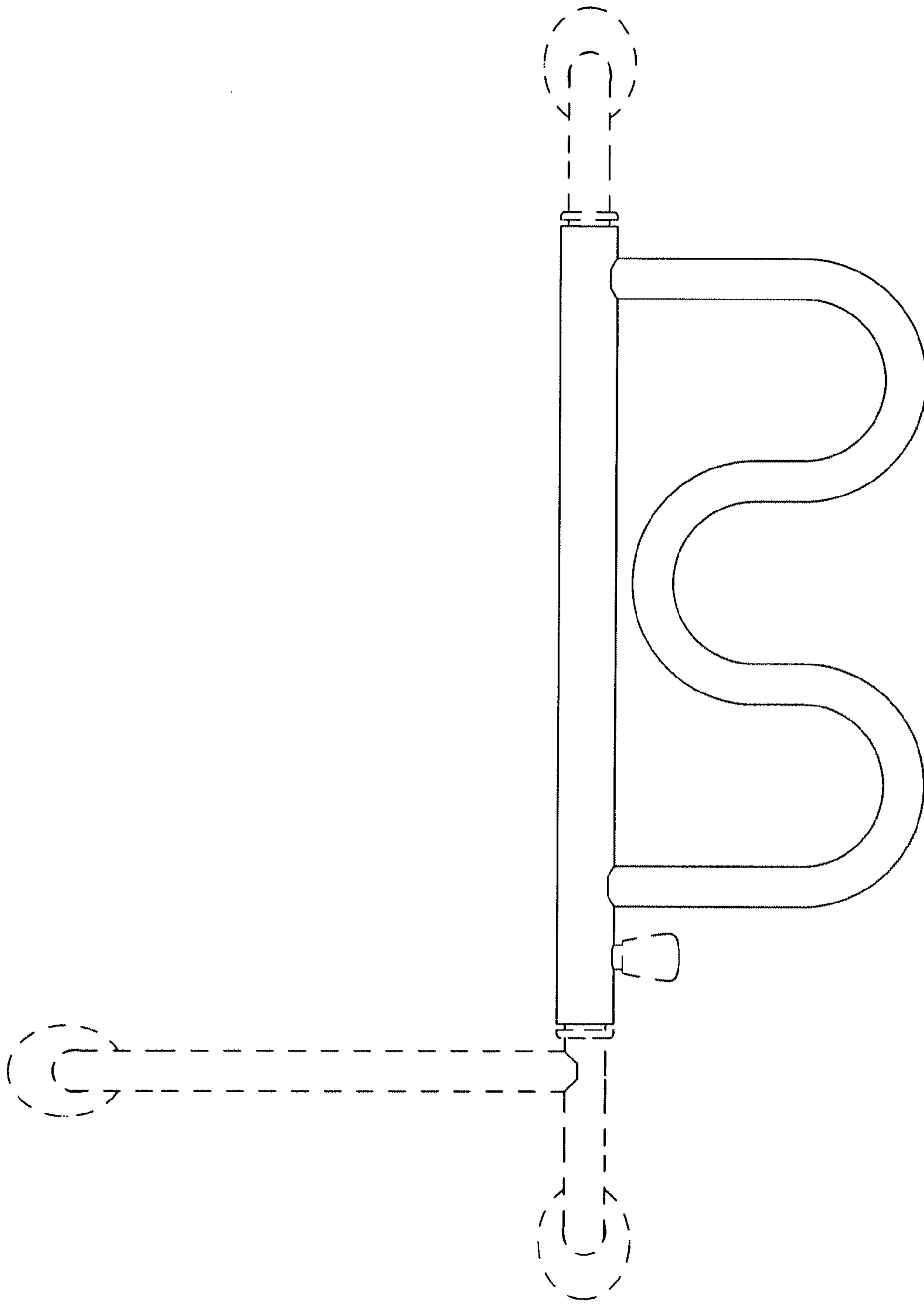

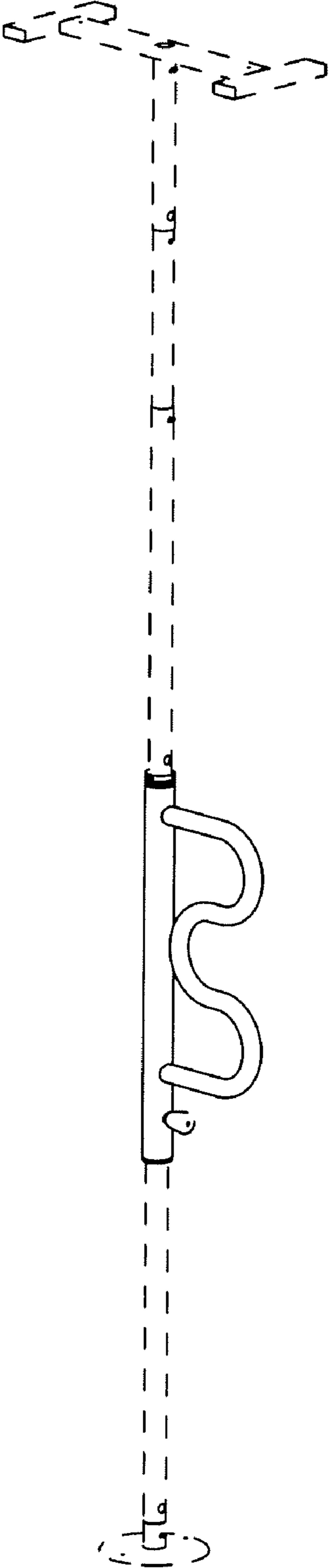
