(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a hospital gown, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a hospital gown showing my new design; the gown shown partially open on one side;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a view of the hospital gown fully opened to show both the front and rear of the hospital gown;

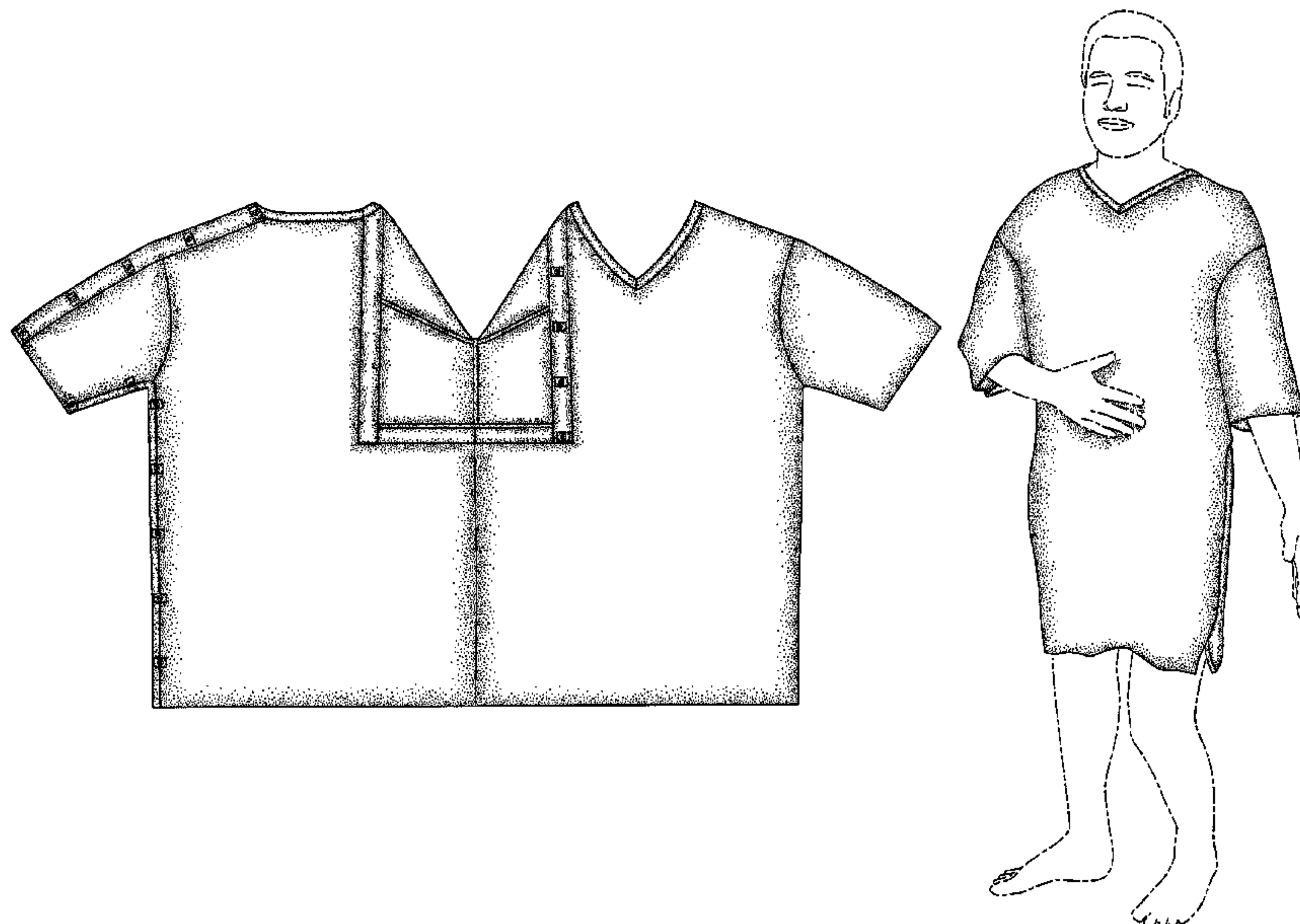
FIG. 4 is a front perspective view, showing the gown in use;

FIG. 5 is a side view thereof, showing the gown in use; and,

FIG. 6 is a rear perspective view thereof, showing the gown in use.

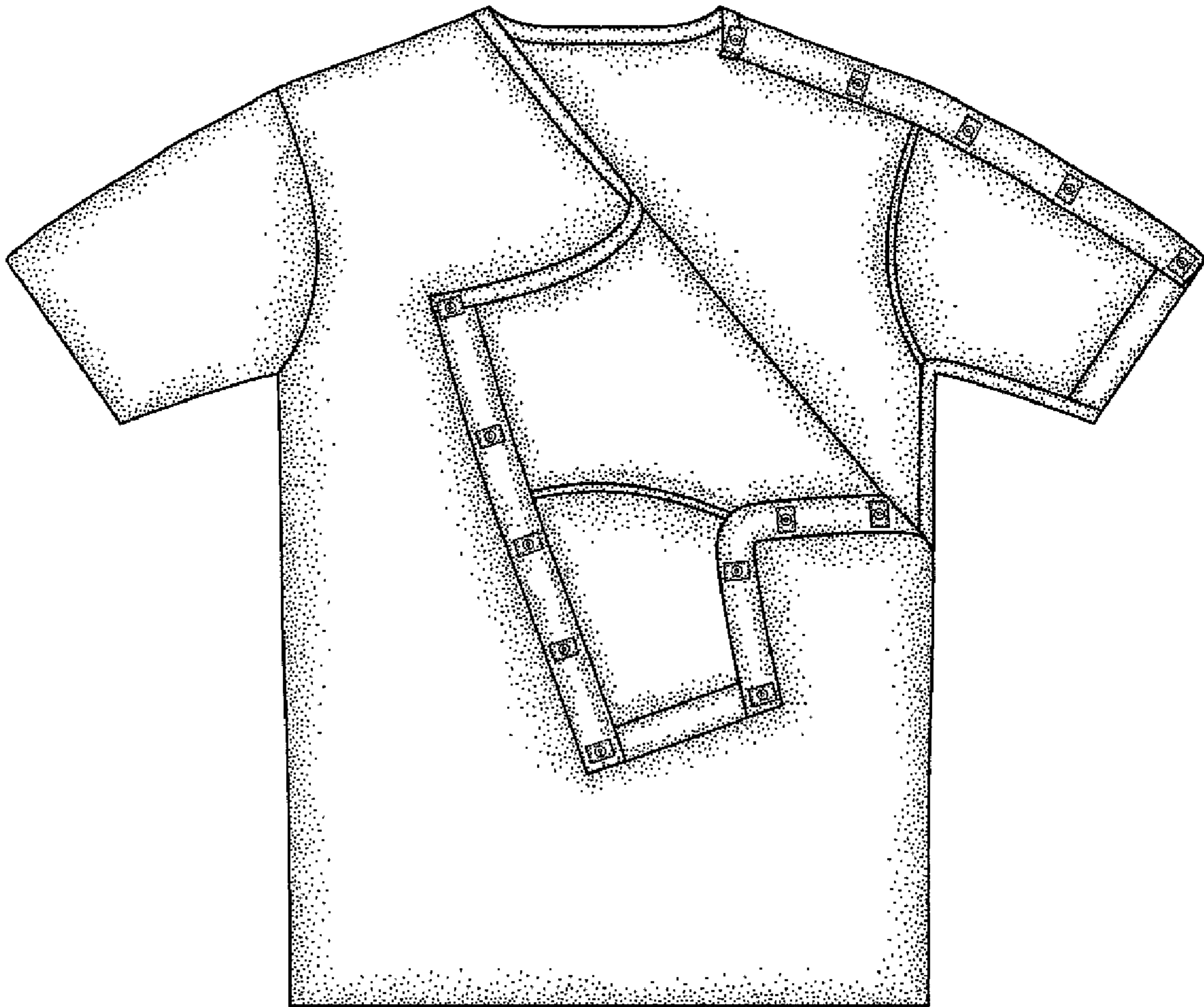

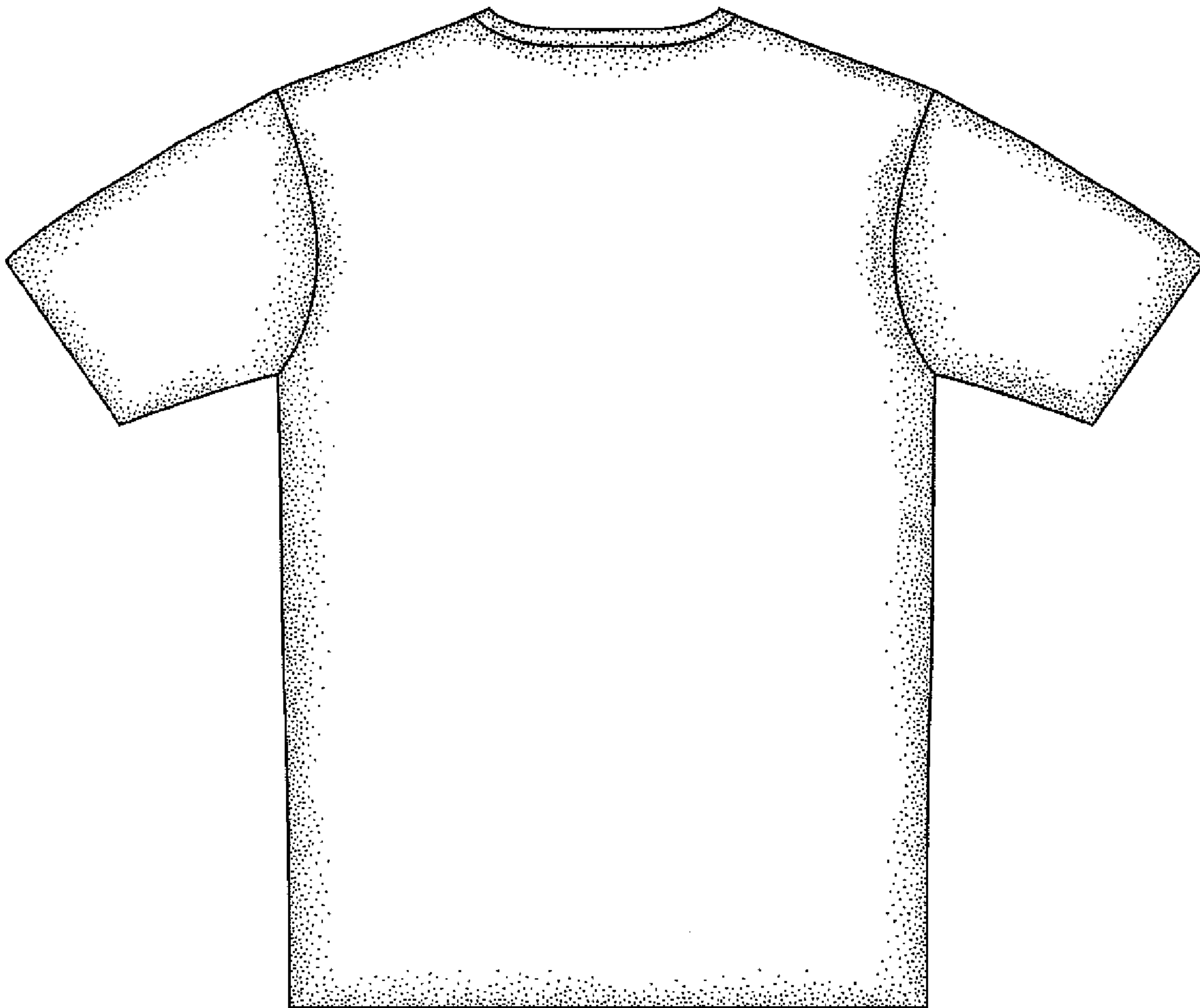

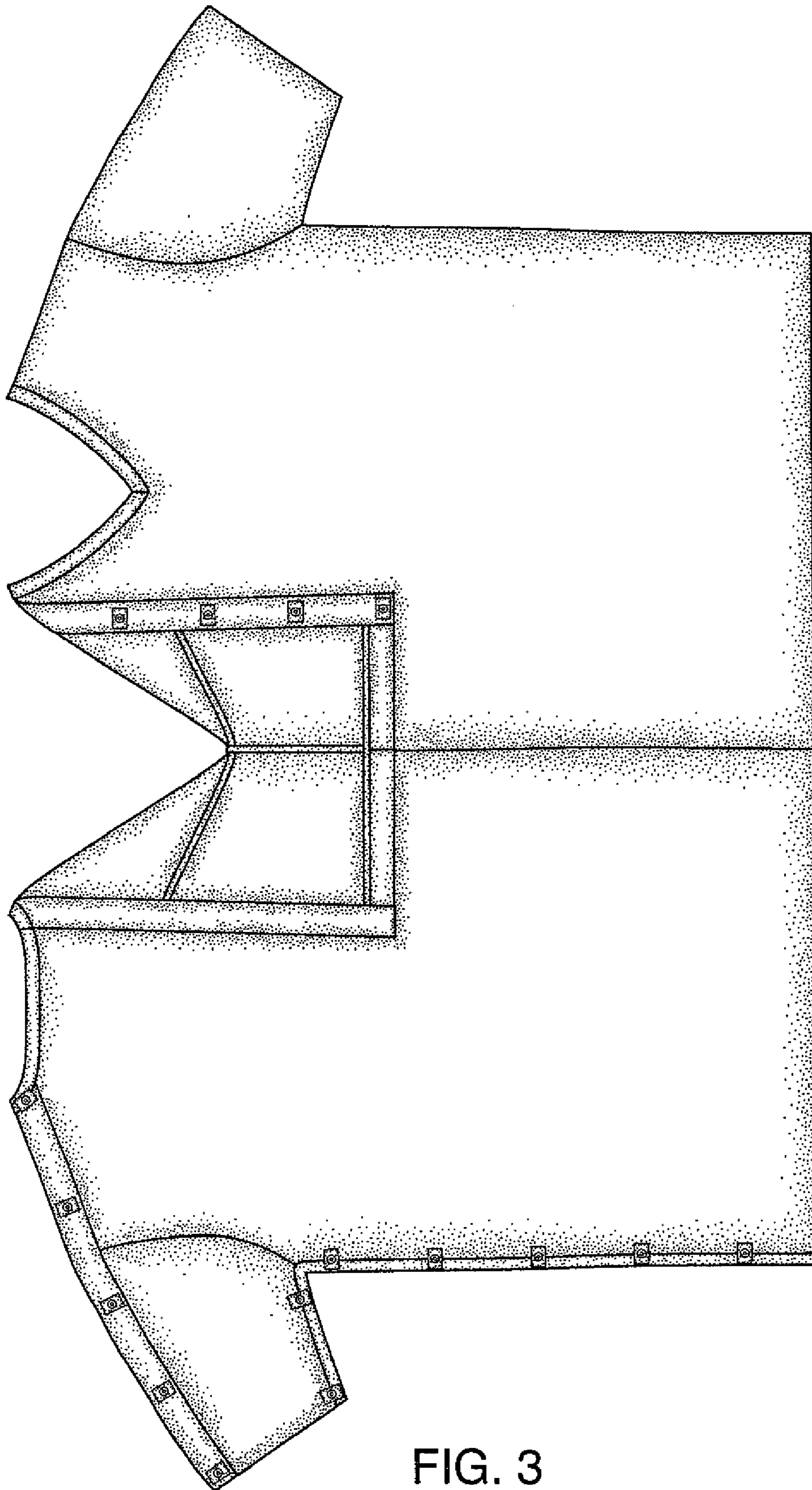

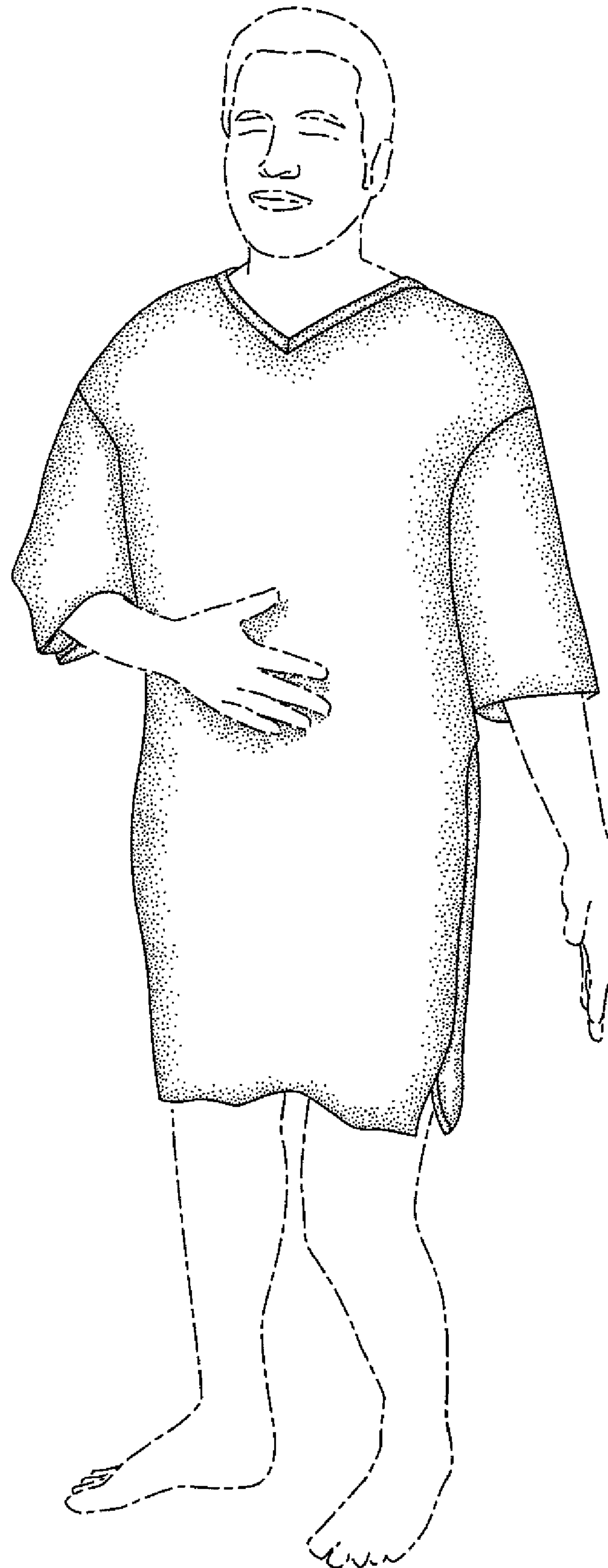

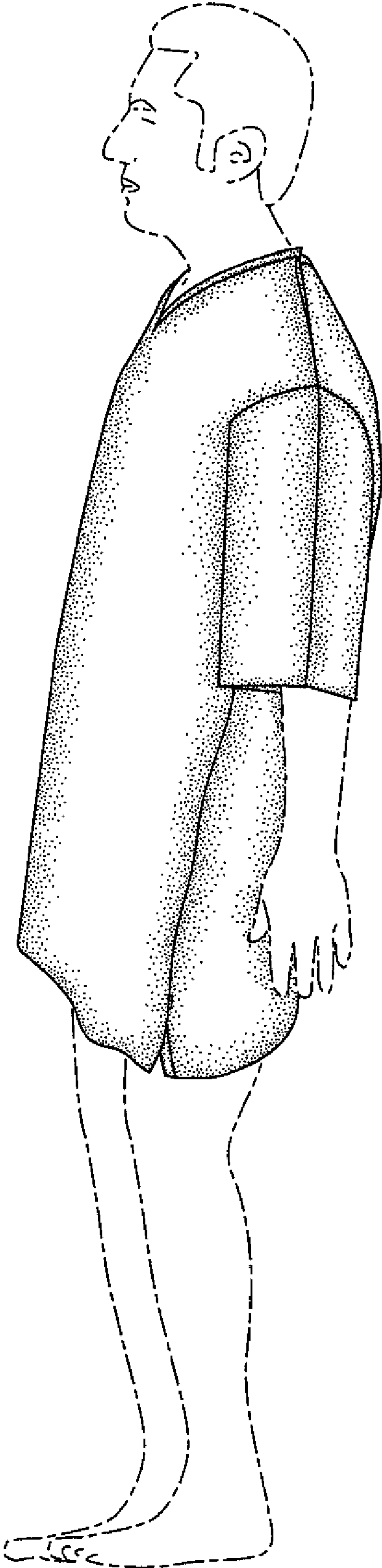

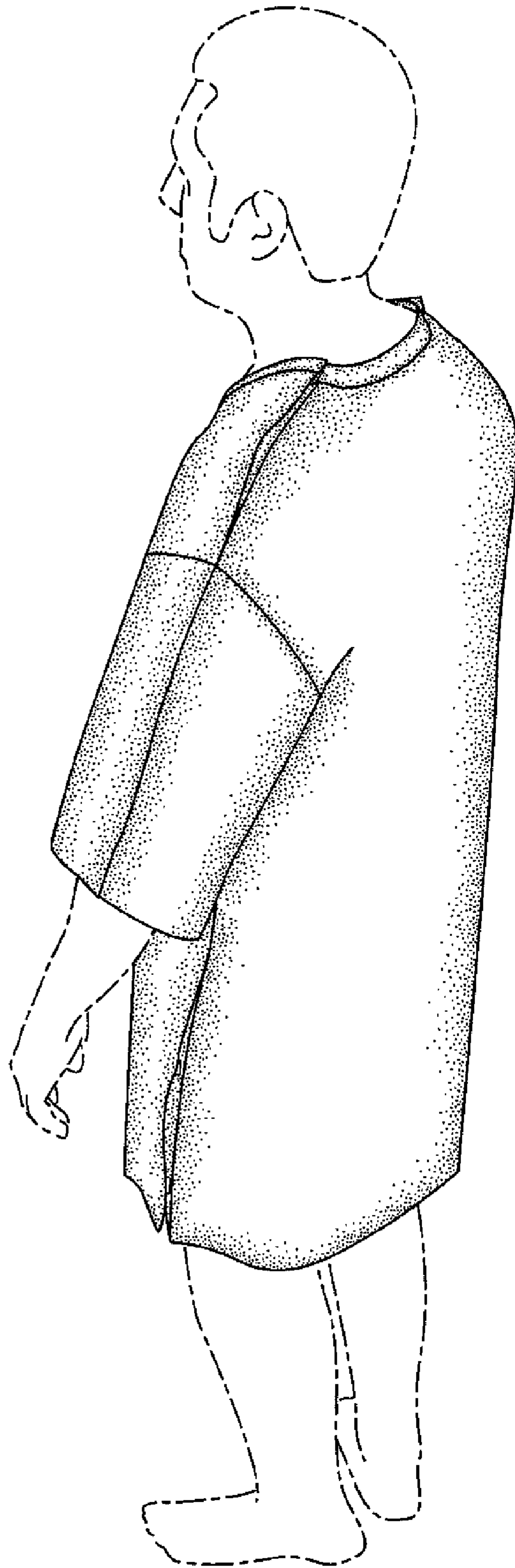
