FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a portion of a shirt showing my new design;

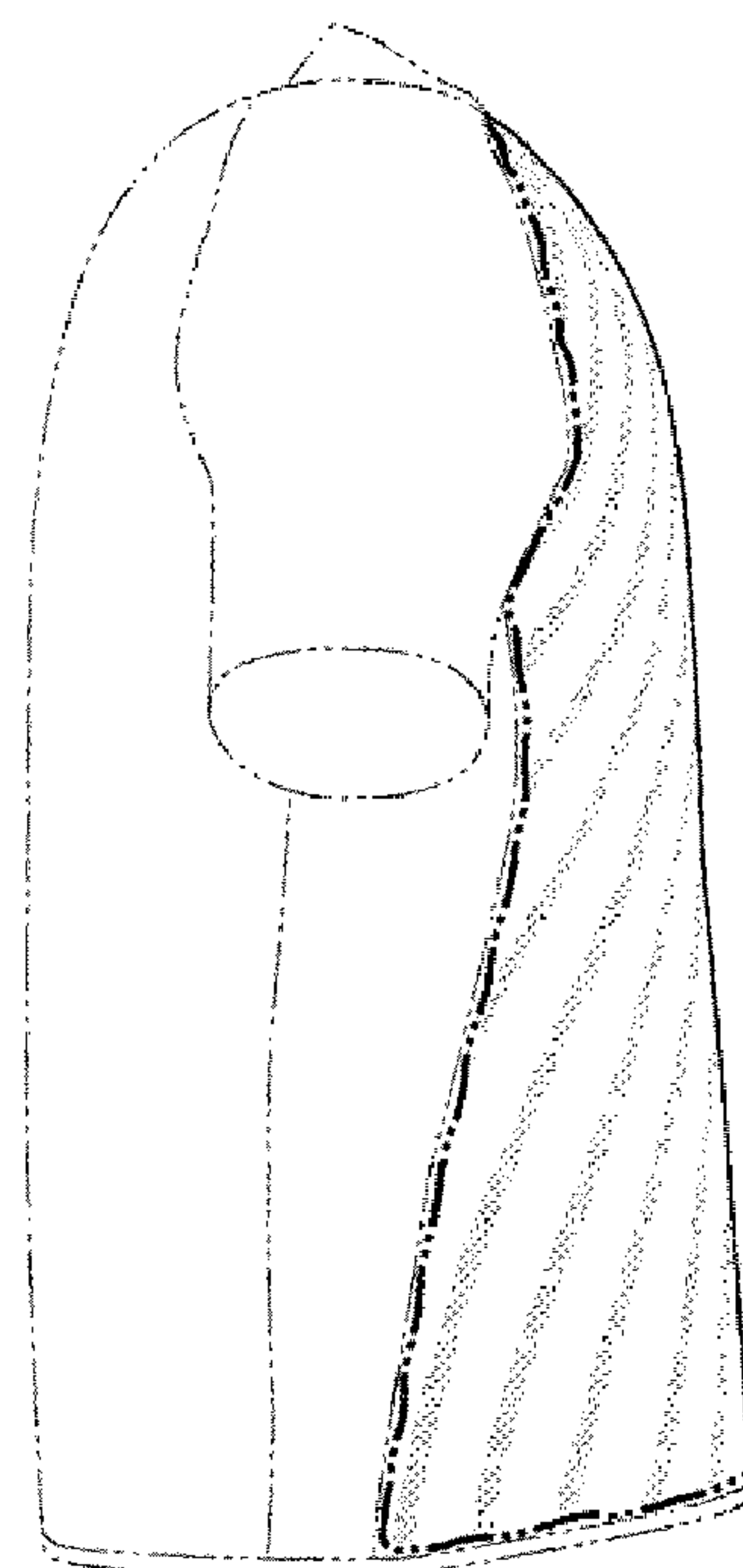
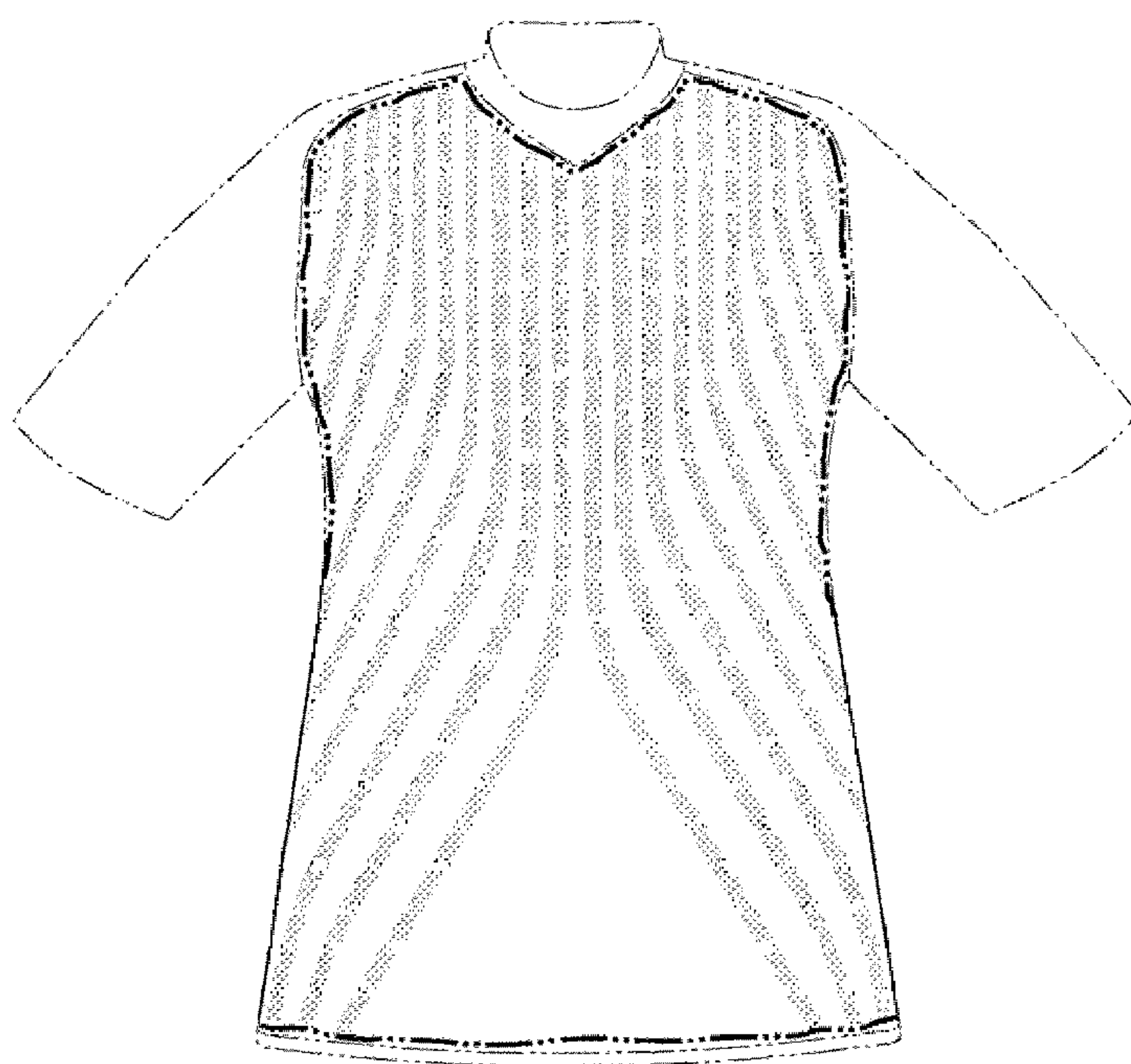
FIG. 2 is a front view of the portion of a shirt shown in FIG. 1;

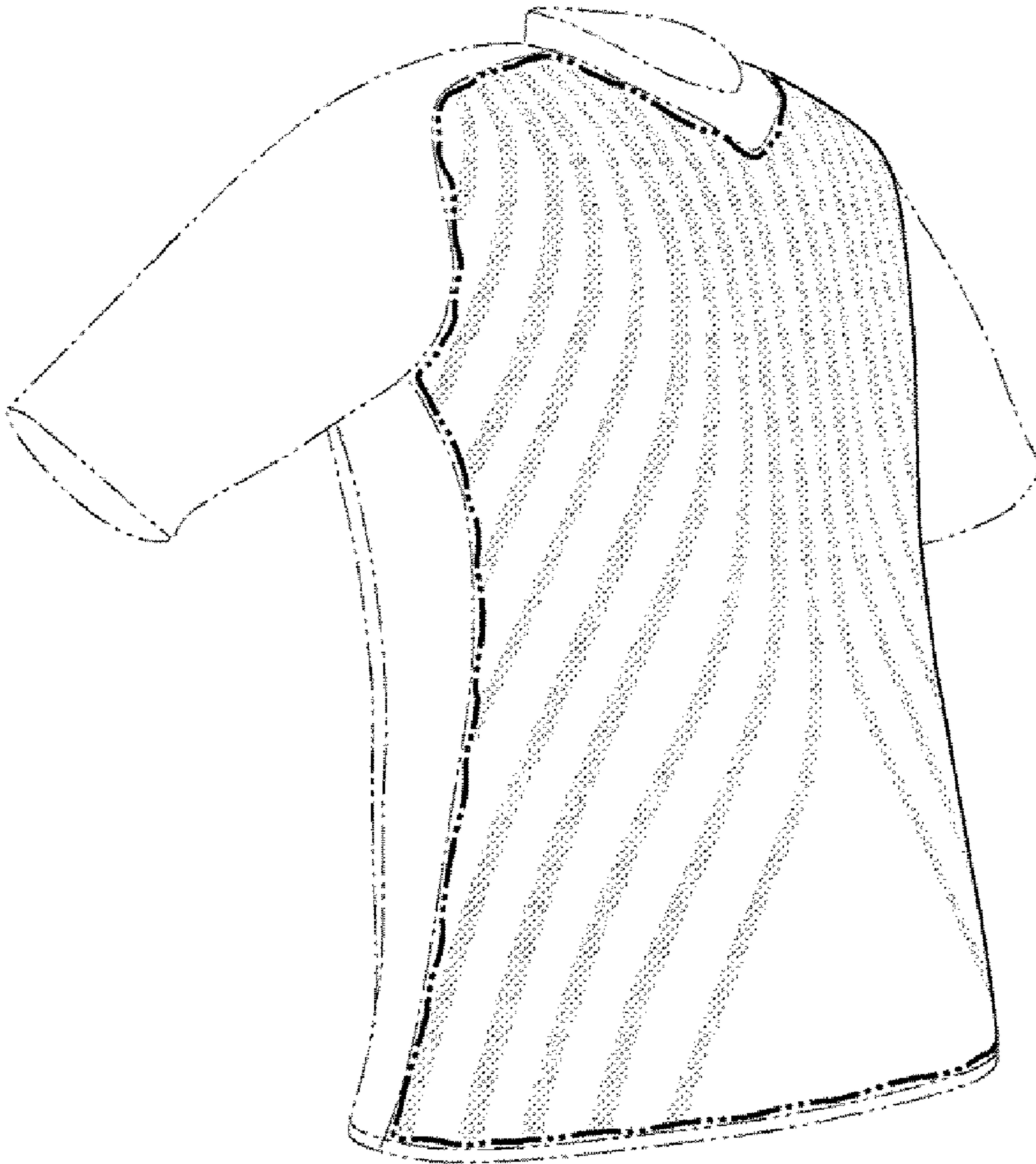

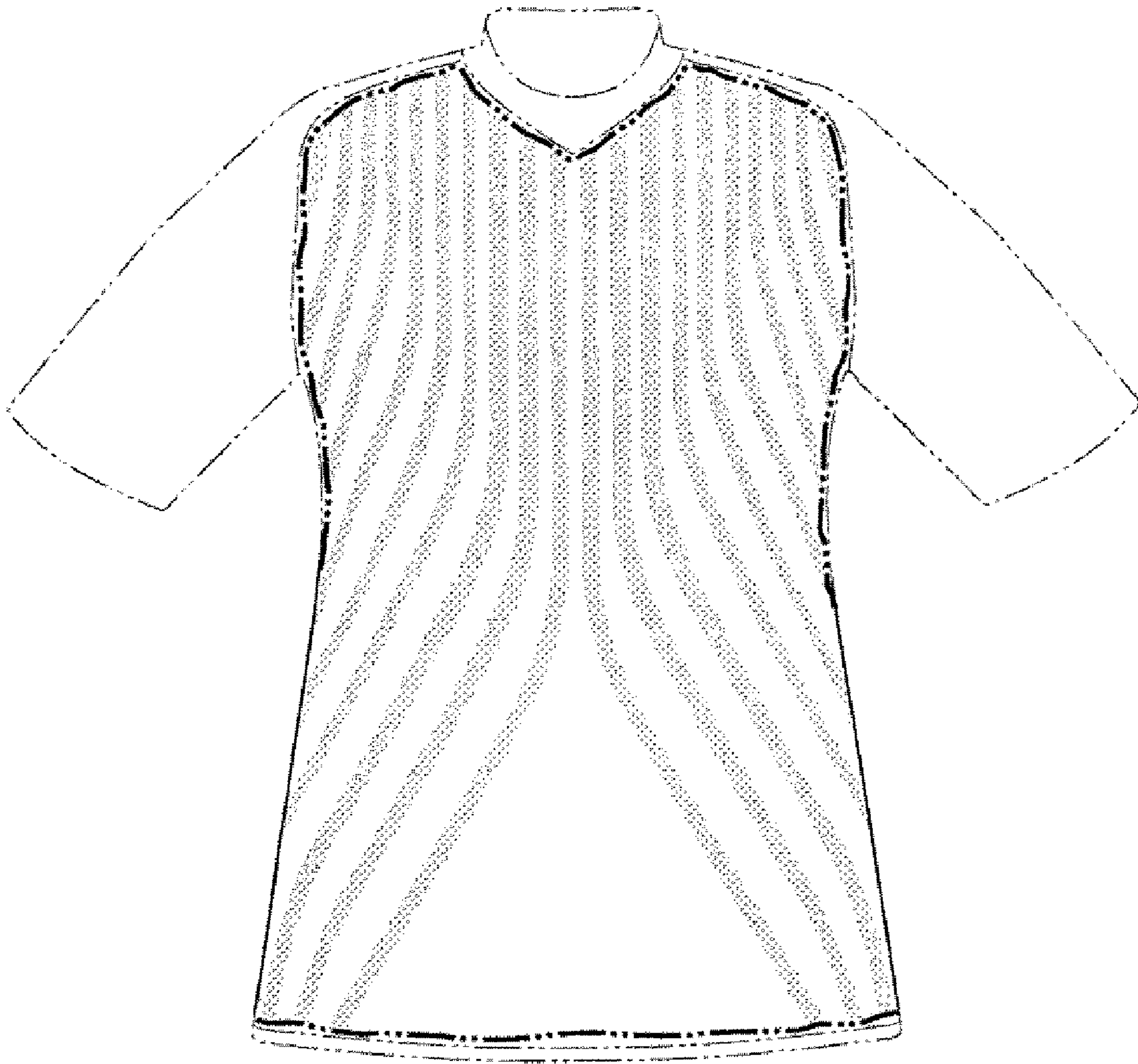

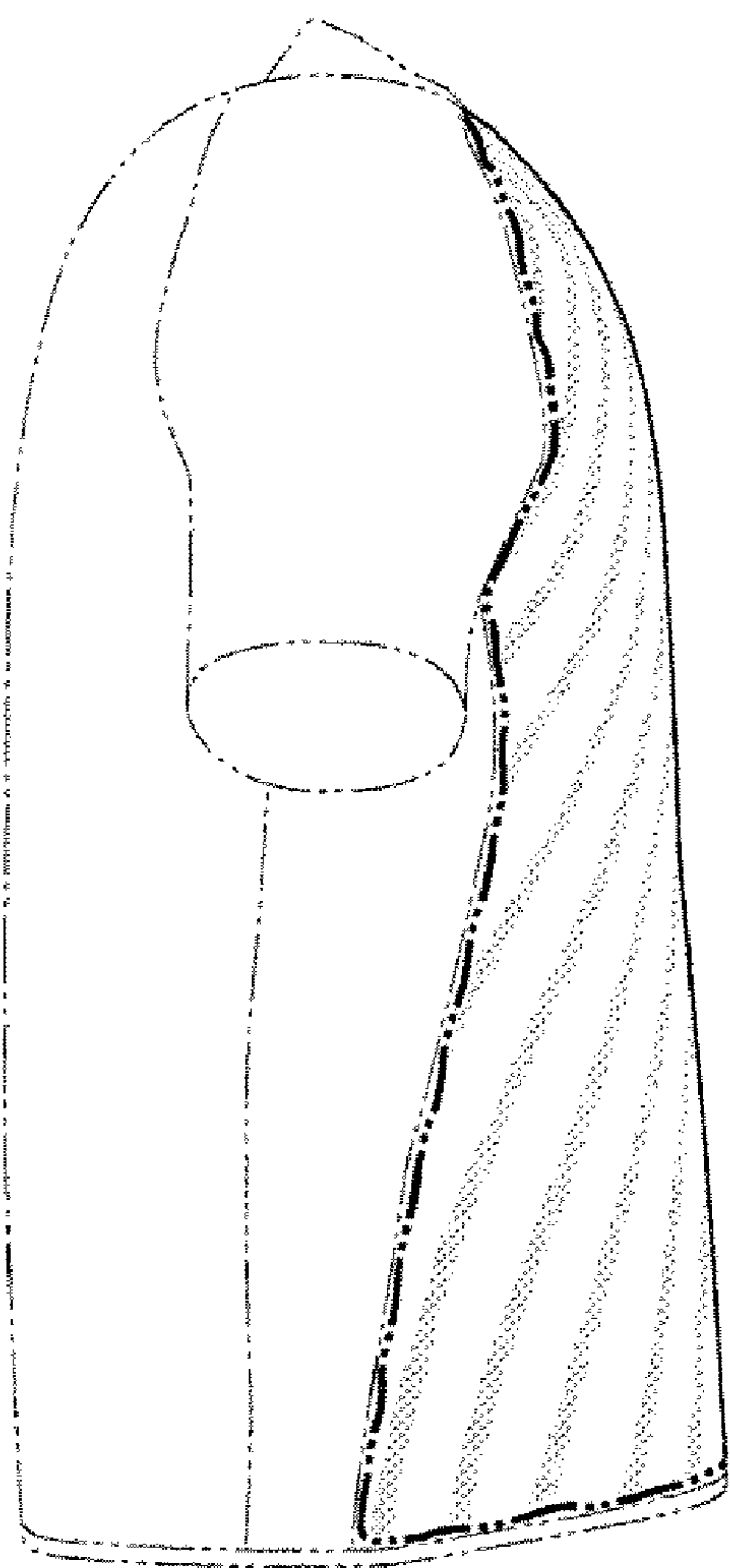

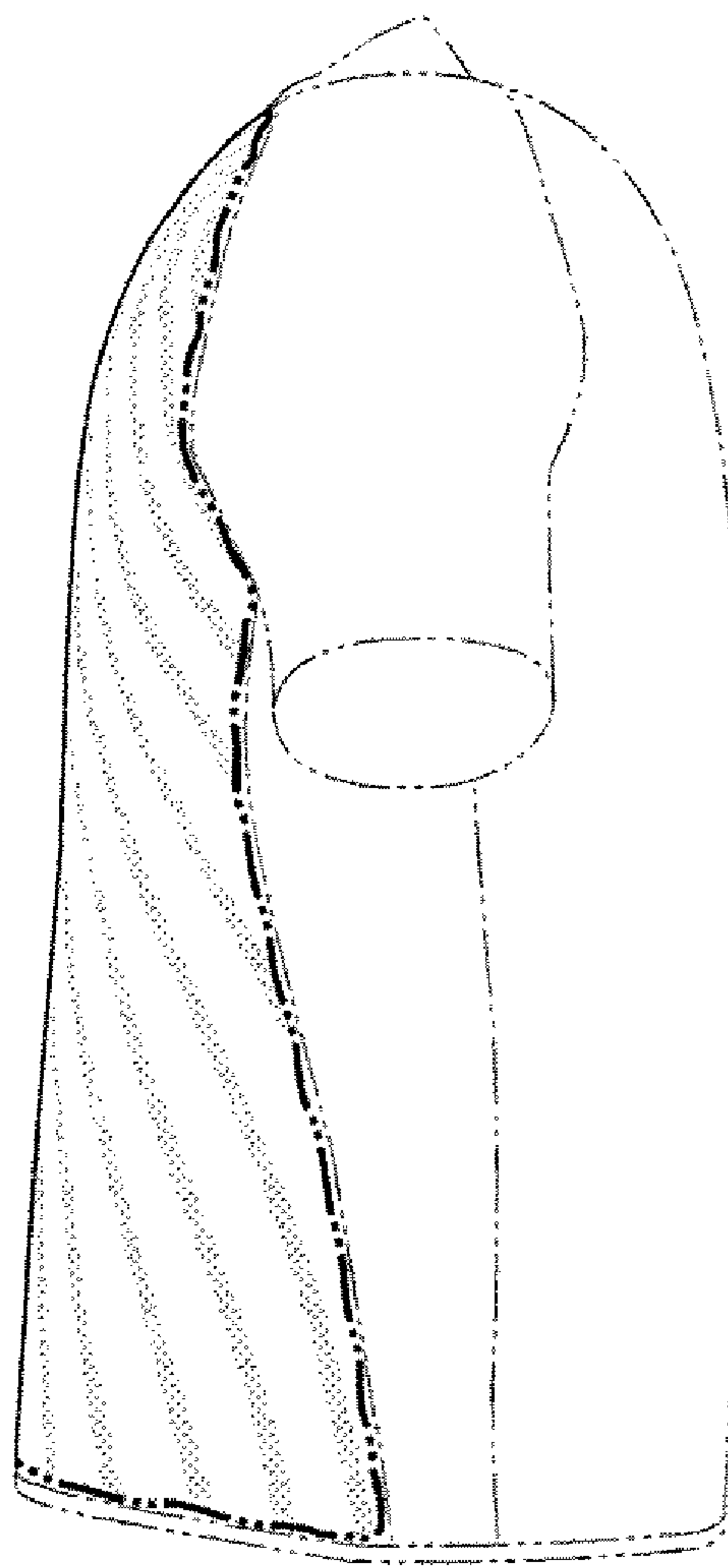

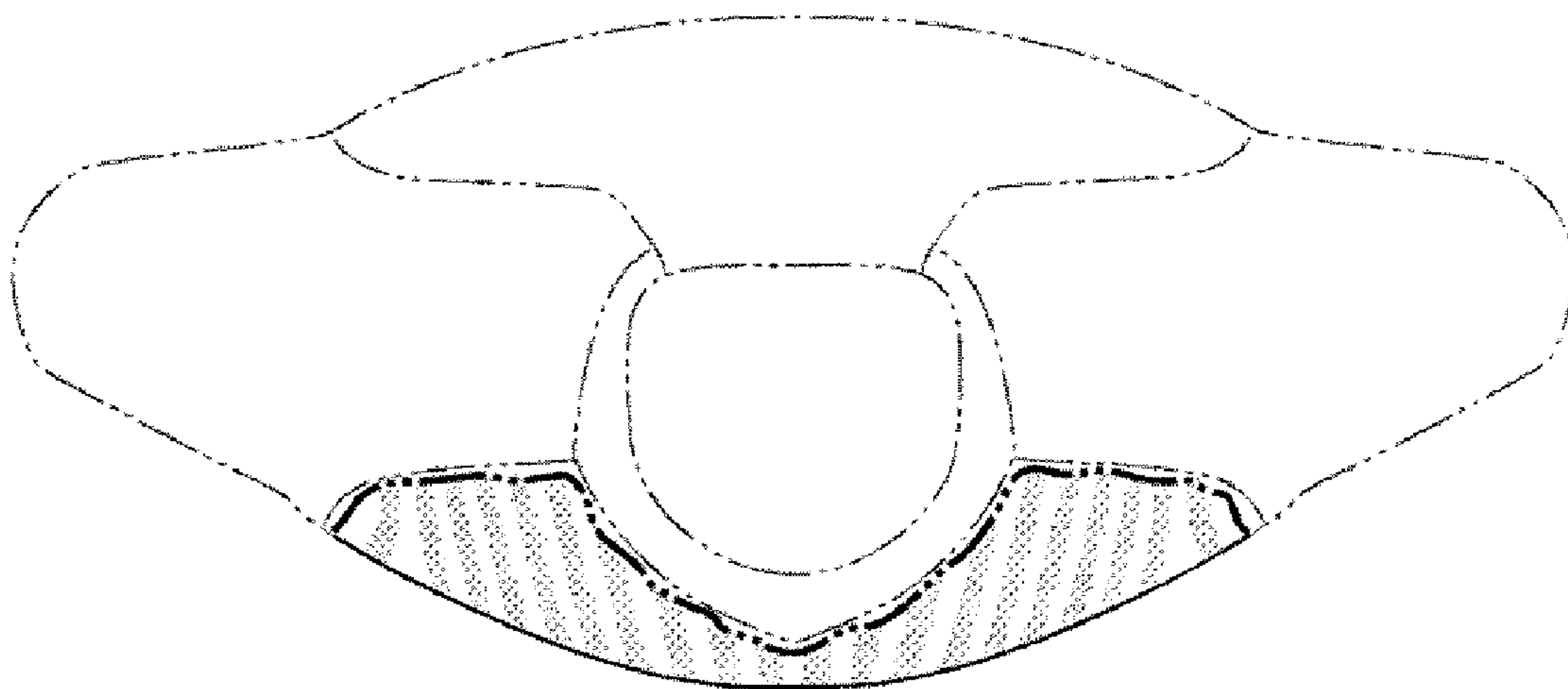
