(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a footwear outsole, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a right side perspective view of a footwear outsole showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

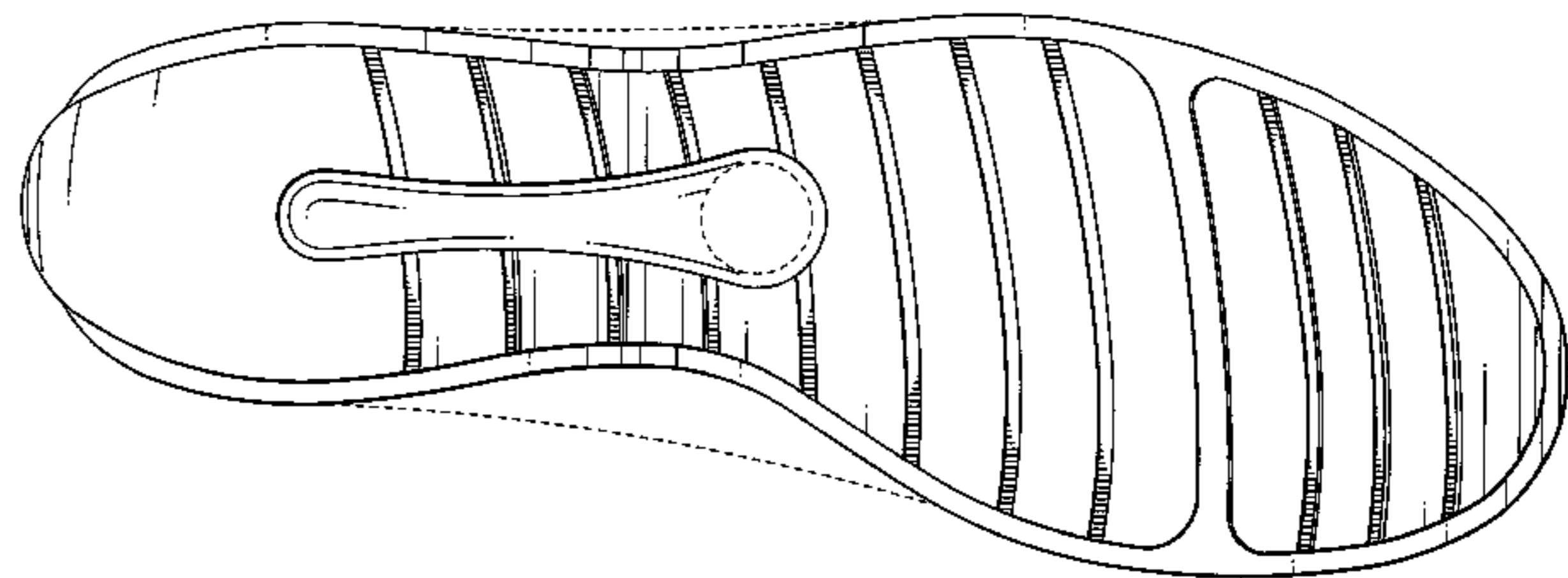
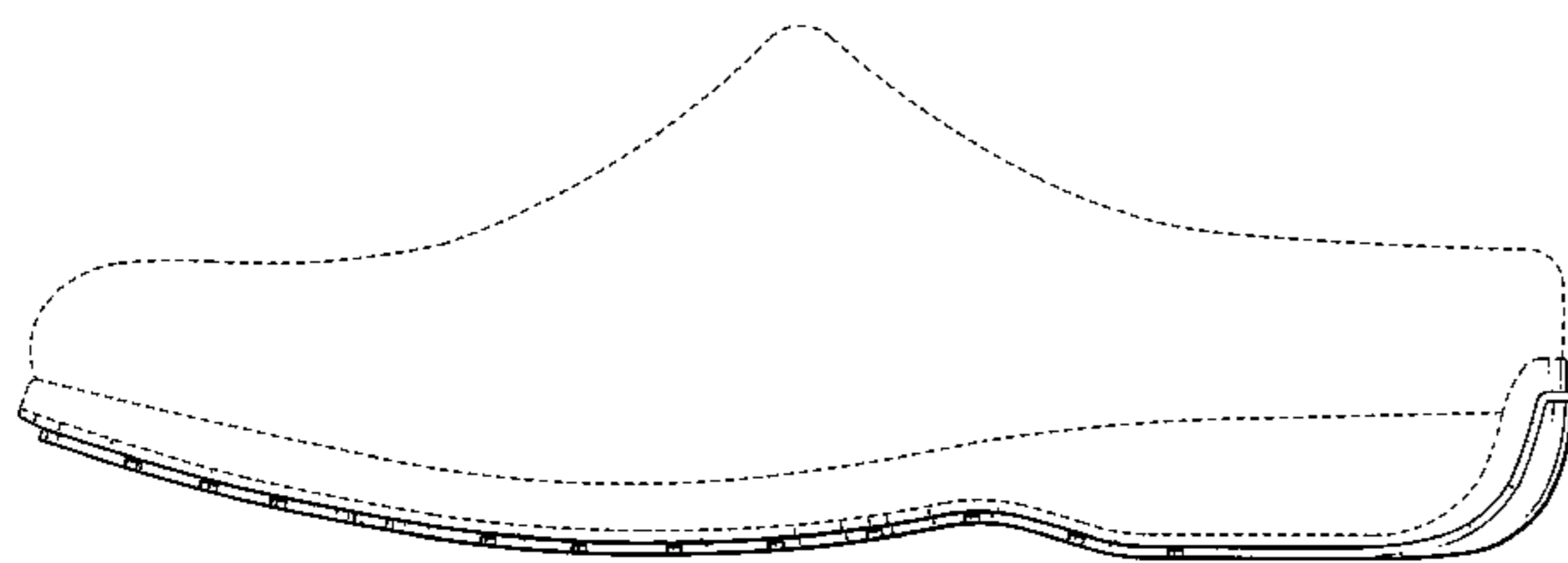
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof.

The broken lines immediately adjacent to the solid line representations in FIGS. 1–5 & 7, along with broken-line circle in FIGS. 1 & 6 represent the boundaries of the design. The broken lines showing the remainder of the sole and the upper illustrate the environment in which the design resides. The broken lines form no part of the claim.

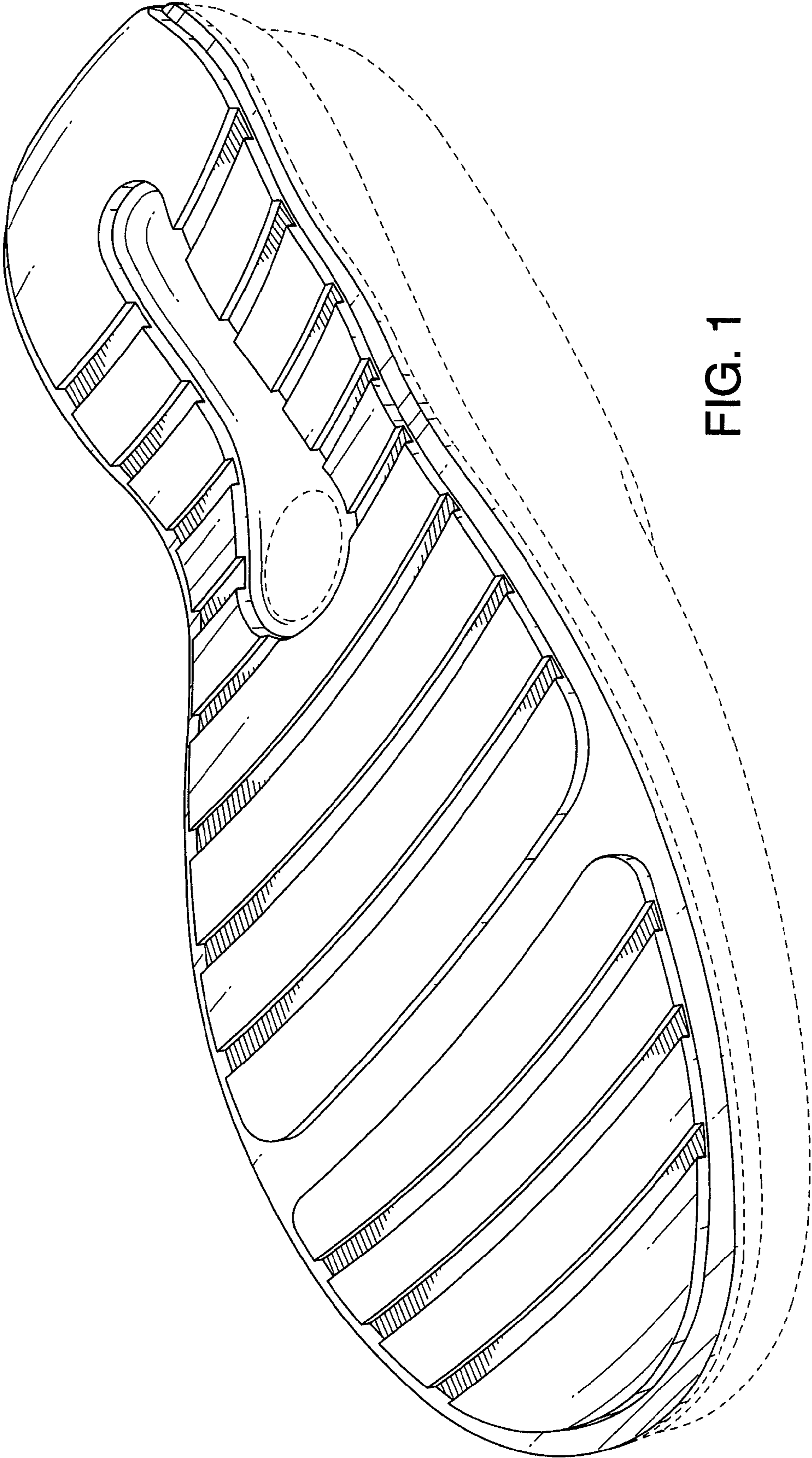

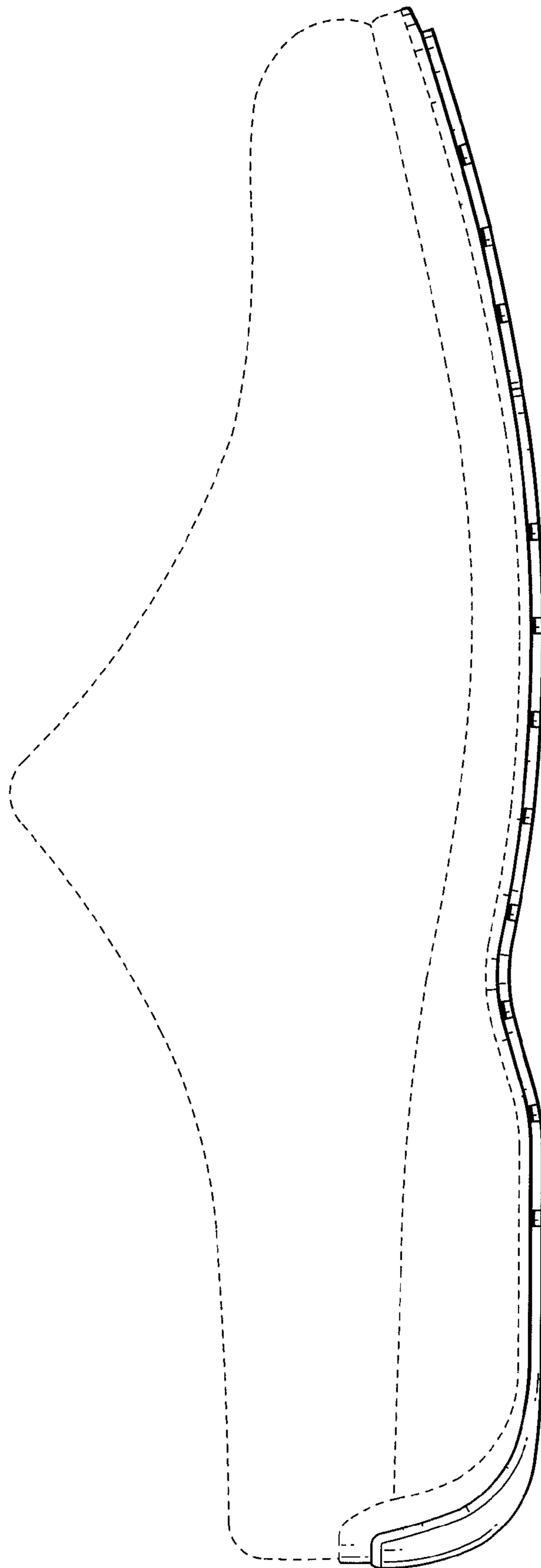

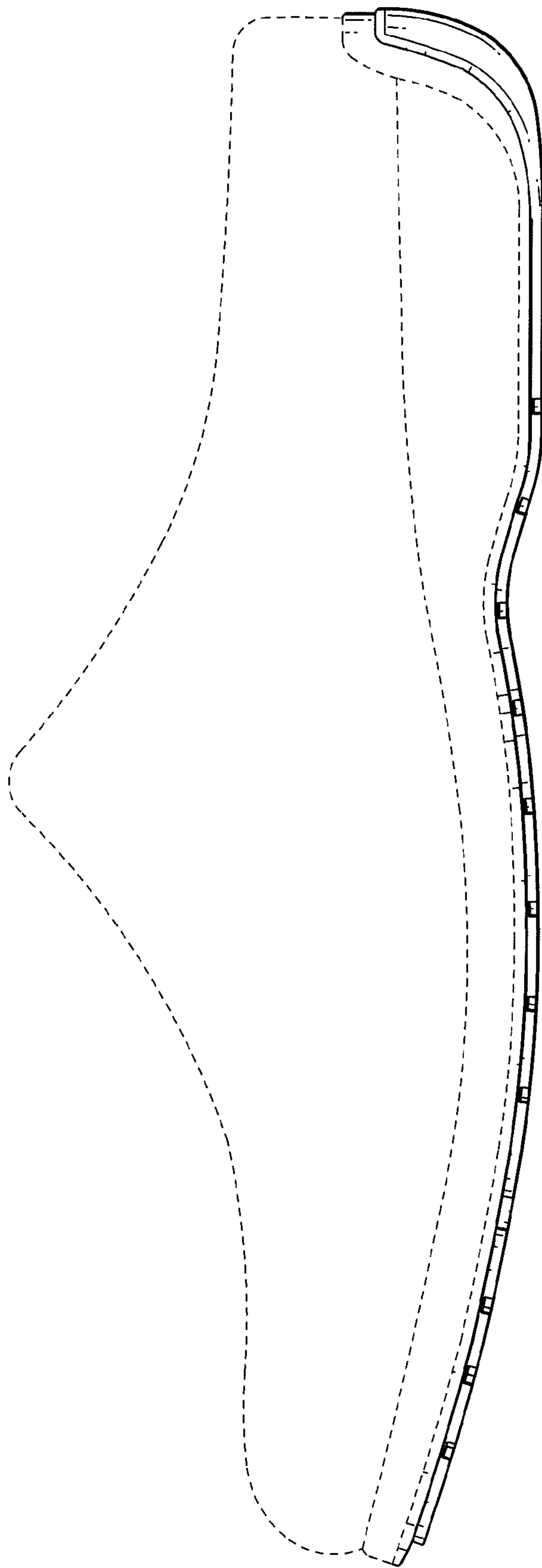

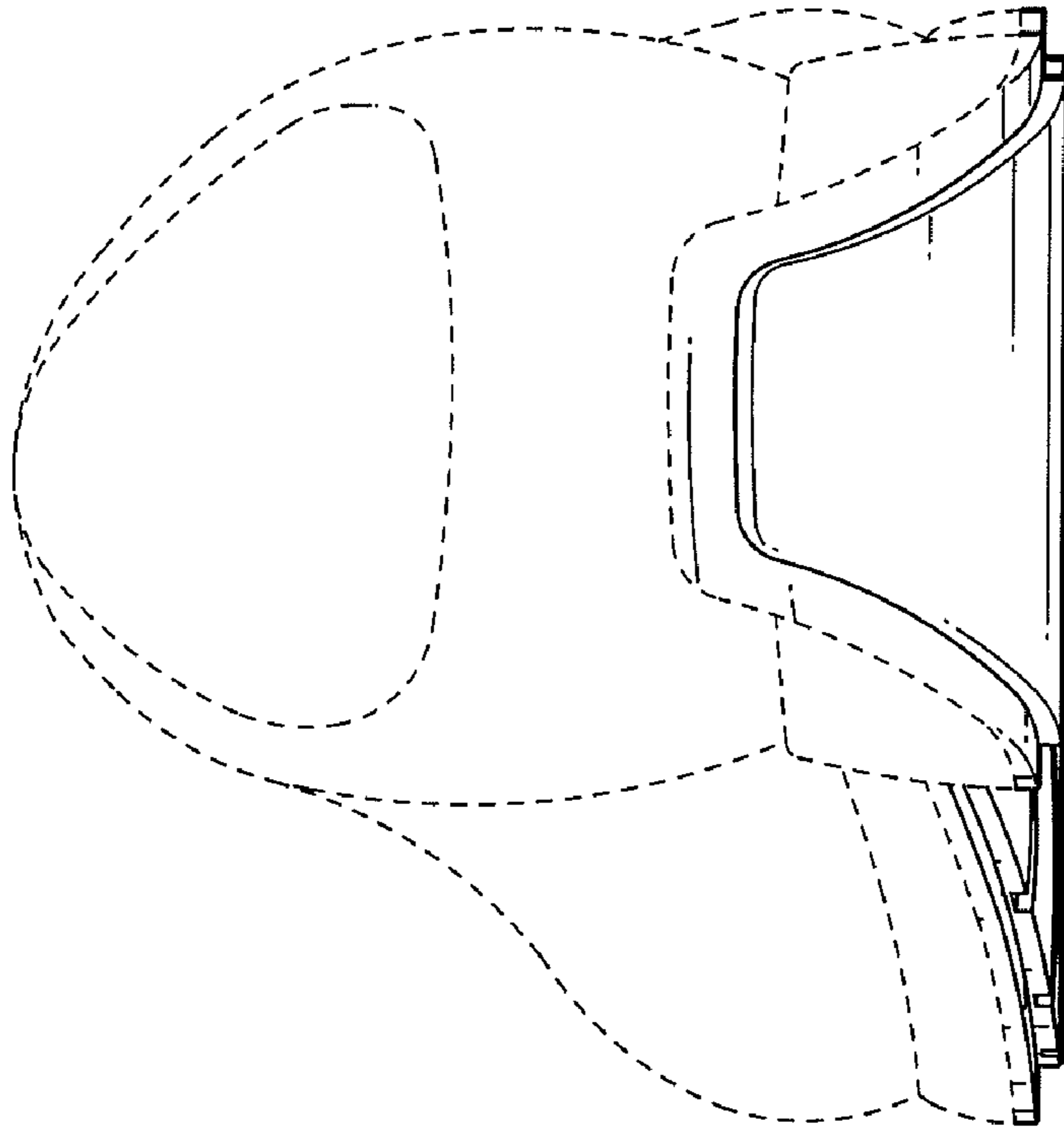

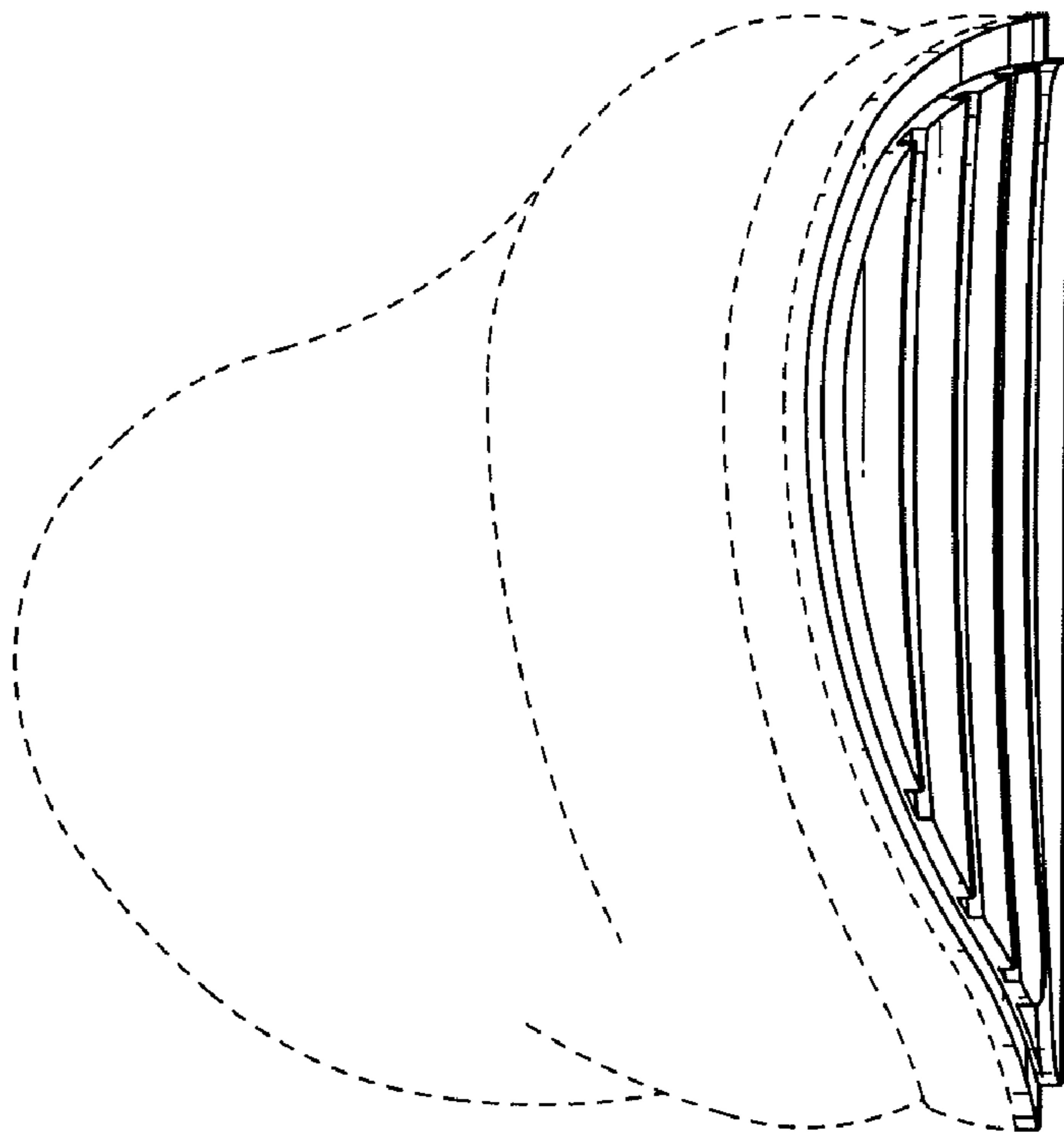

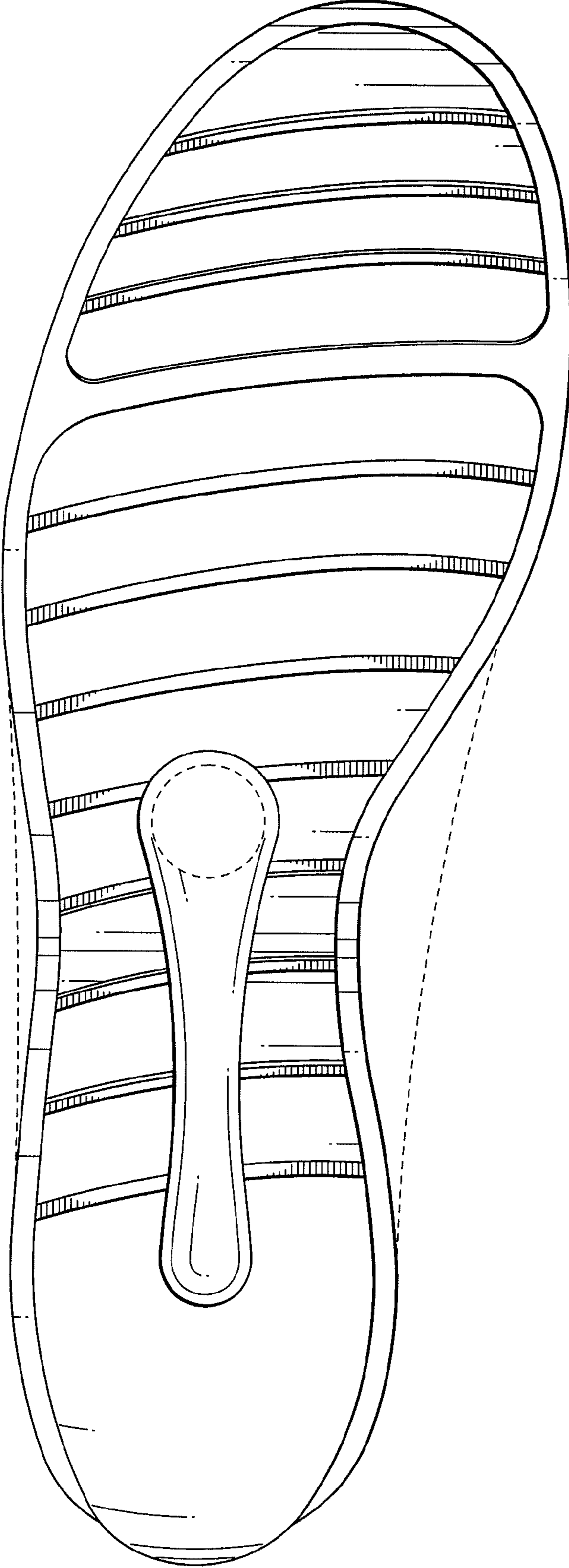

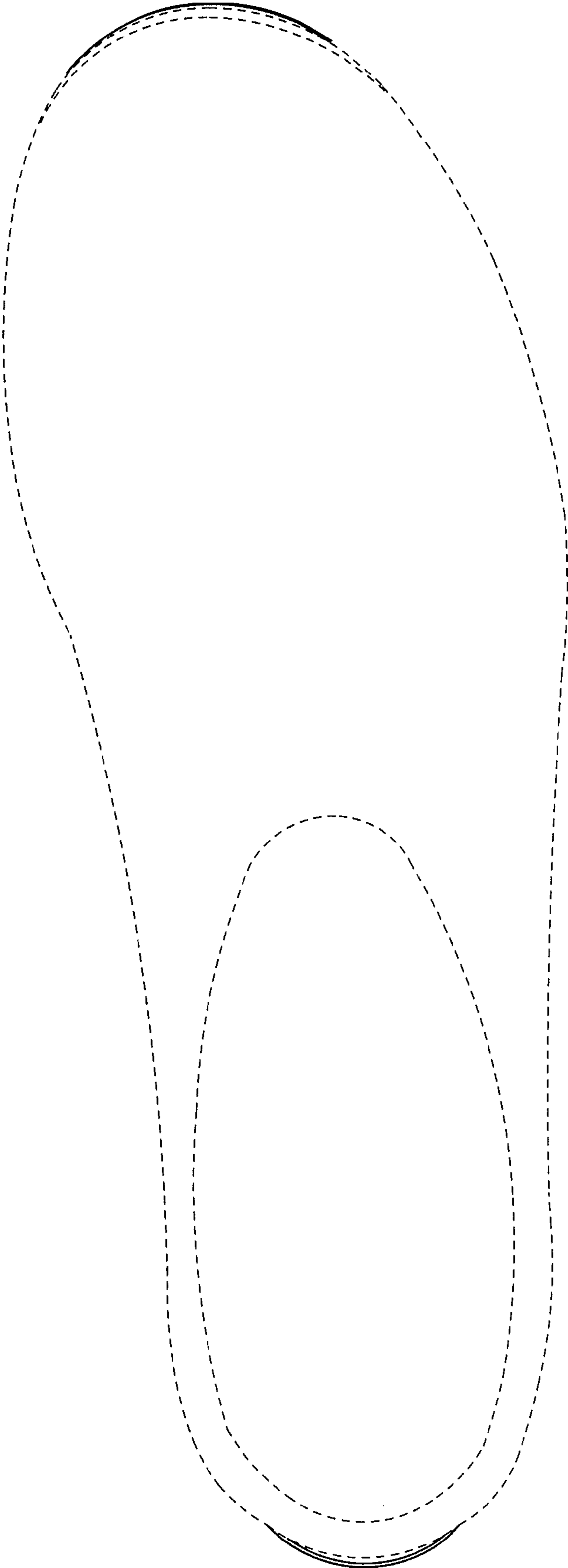
