FIG. 5 is a back elevational view thereof

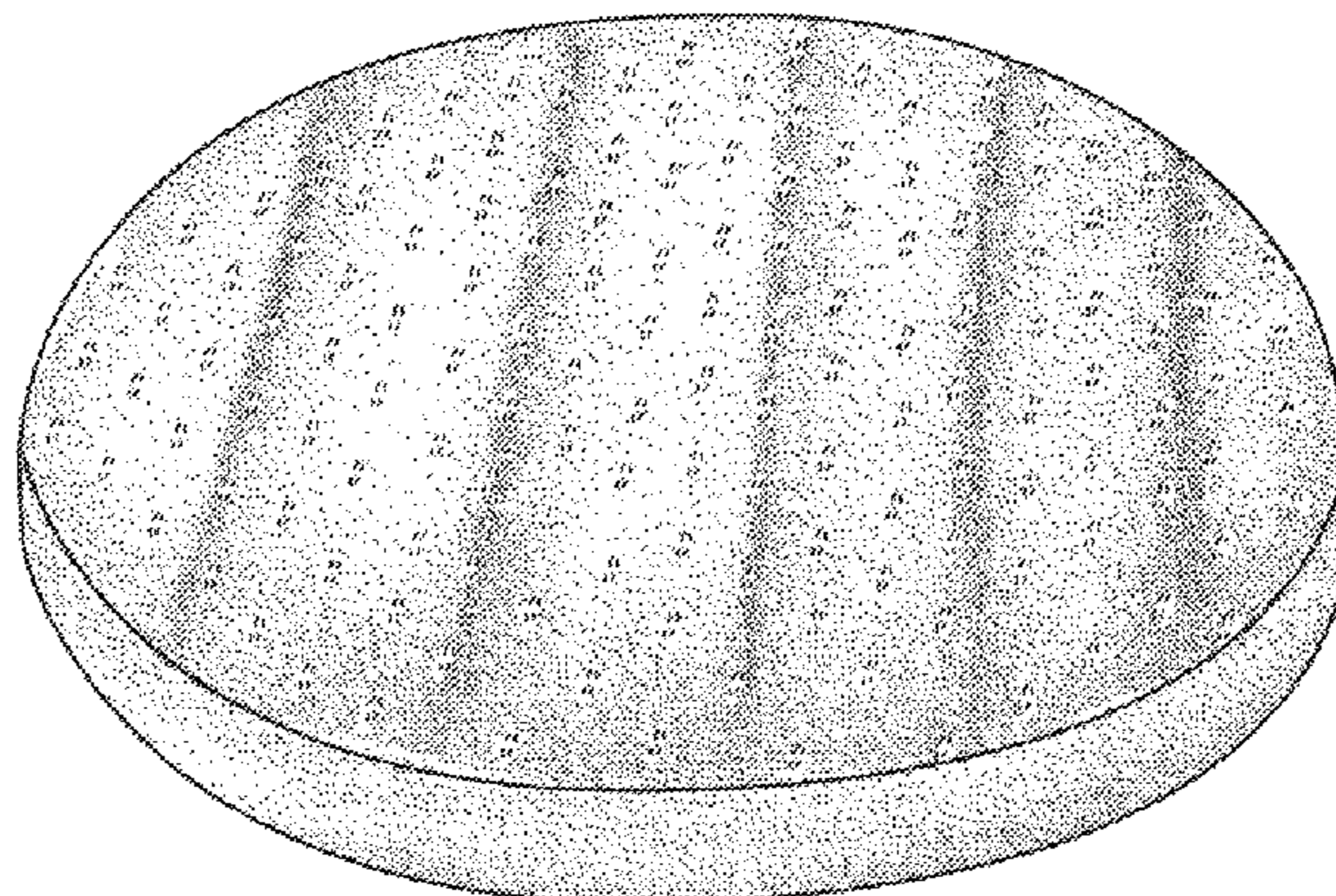
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof; and,

The various views of FIGS. 1–7 are described above in accor-
dance with the orientation of the drawing sheet. It should be
understood, however, that the food patty may be oriented such
that the top surface of FIG. 1 faces either up or down, as
desired.

The broken lines showing of the surface treatment on the top
and bottom of the food patty are for the purpose of illustrating
environmental structure and form no part of the claimed
design.

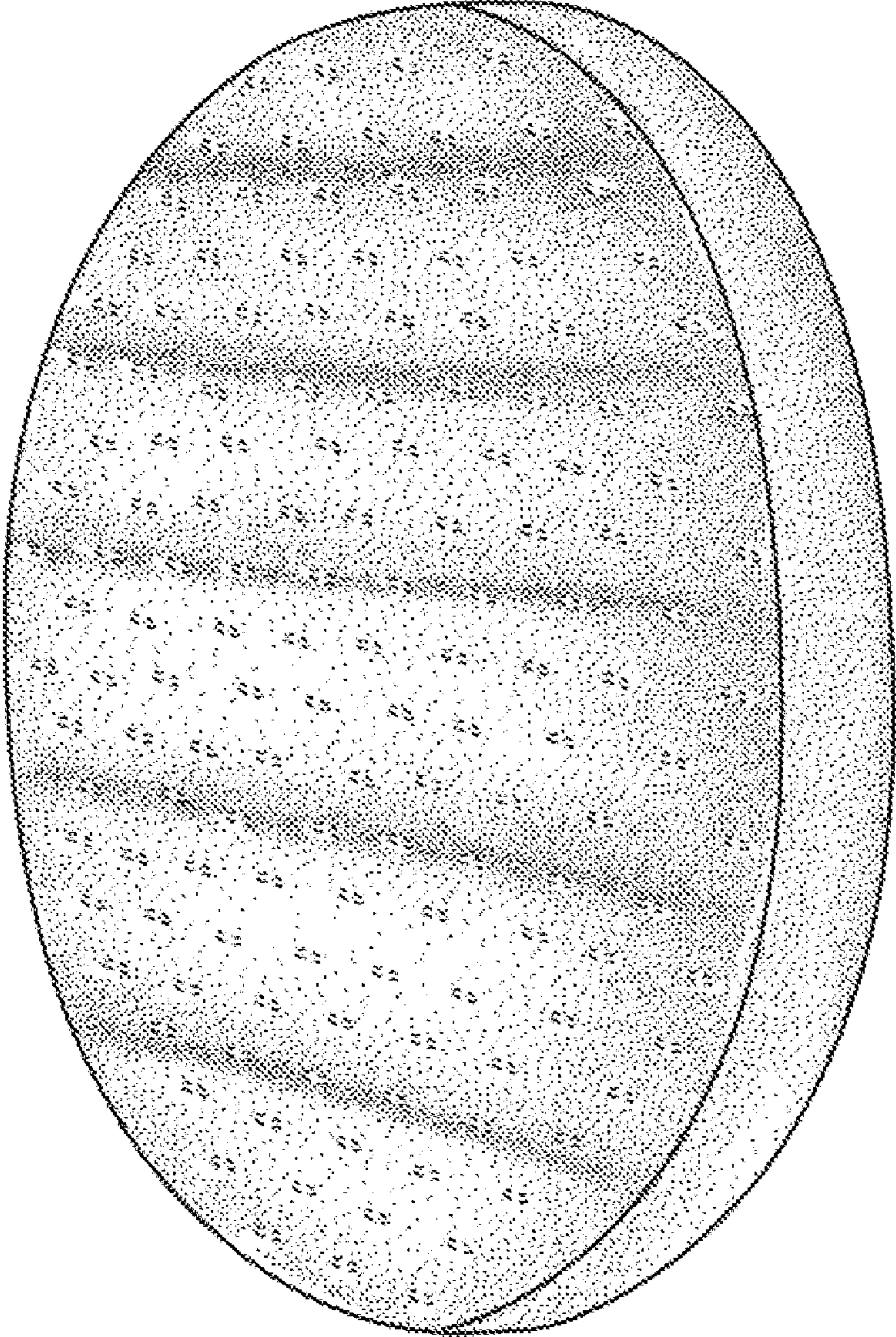

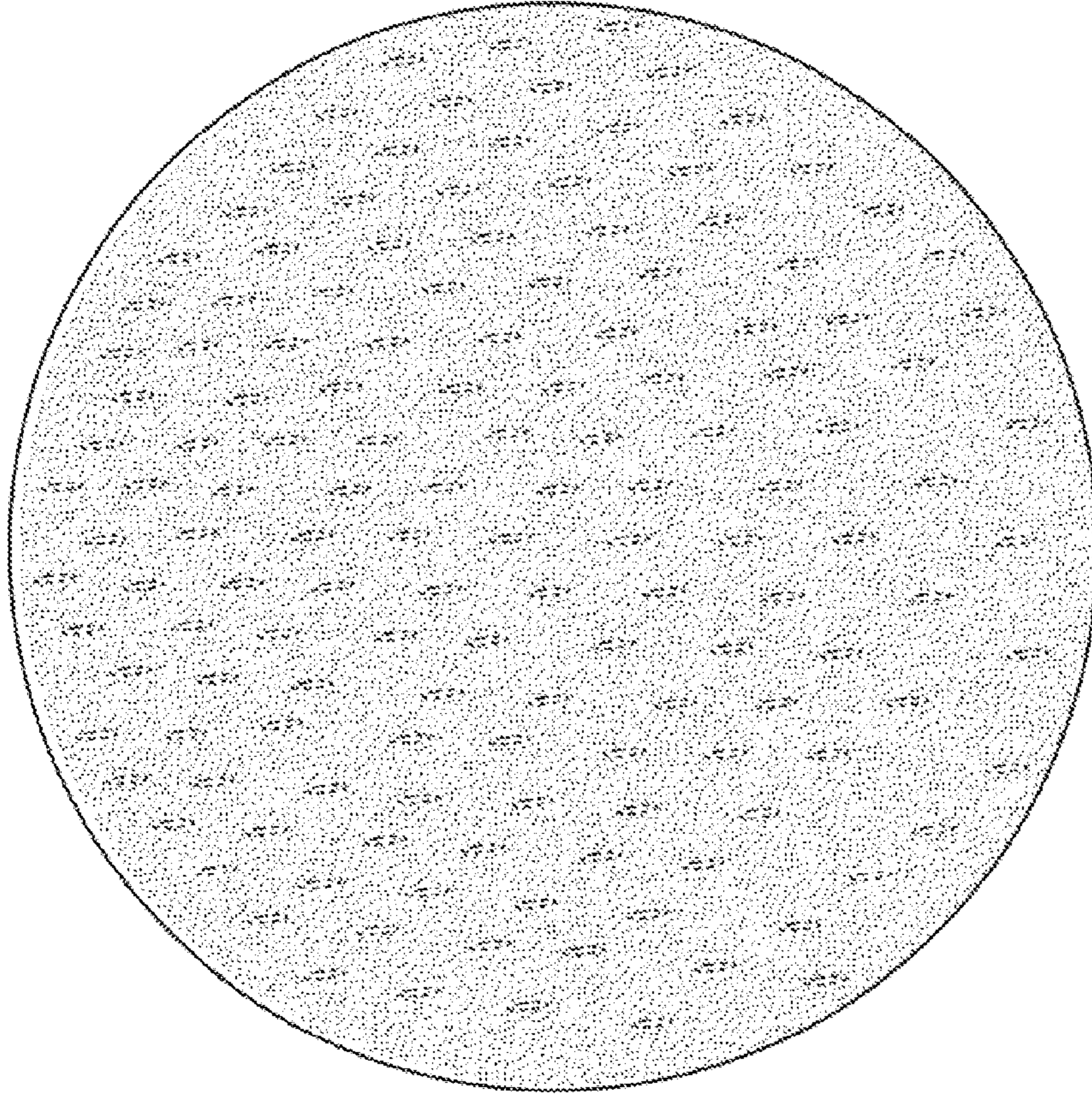

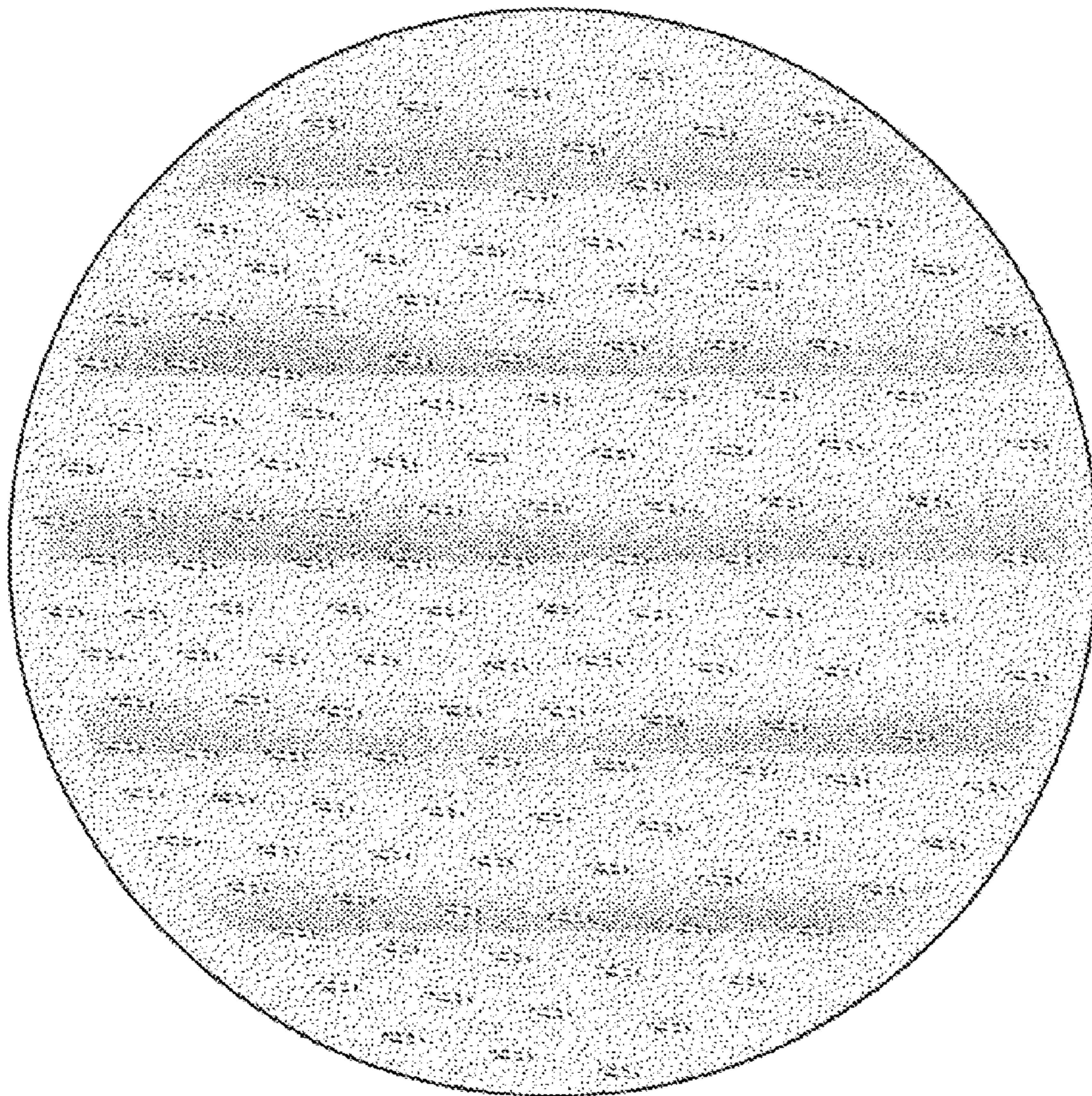

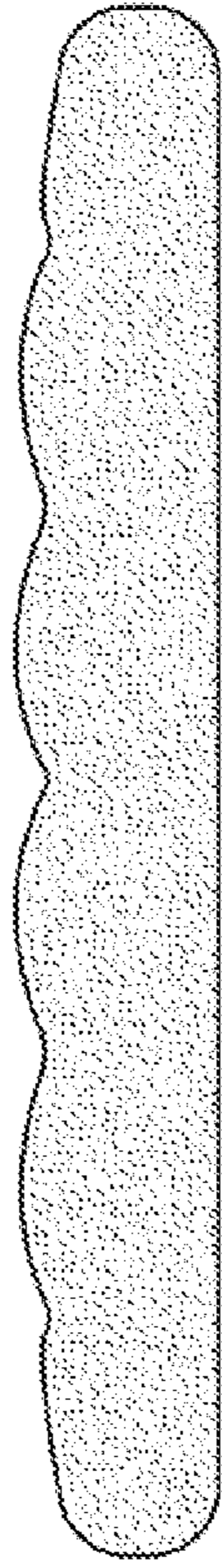

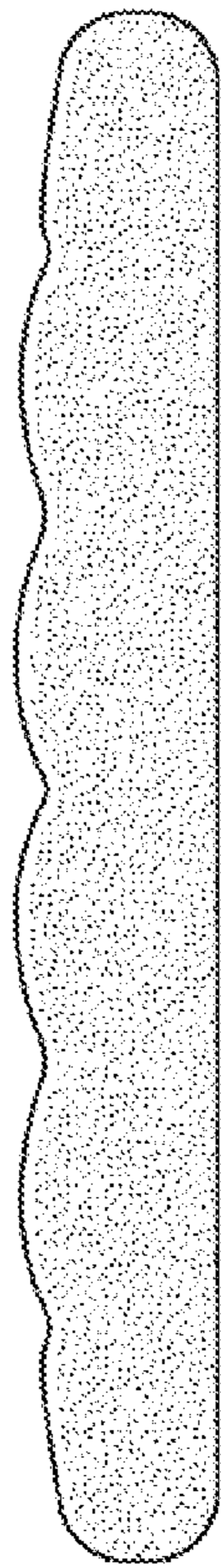

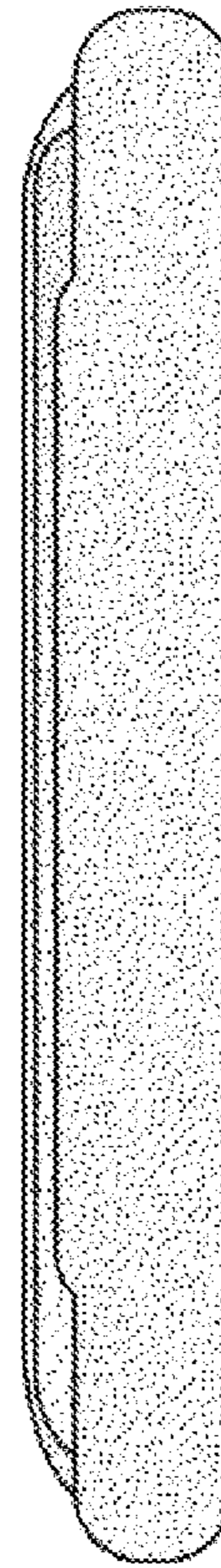

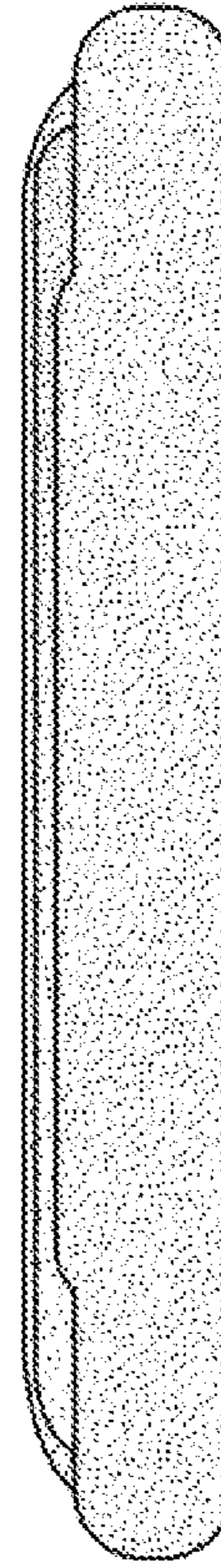
