DESCRIPTION

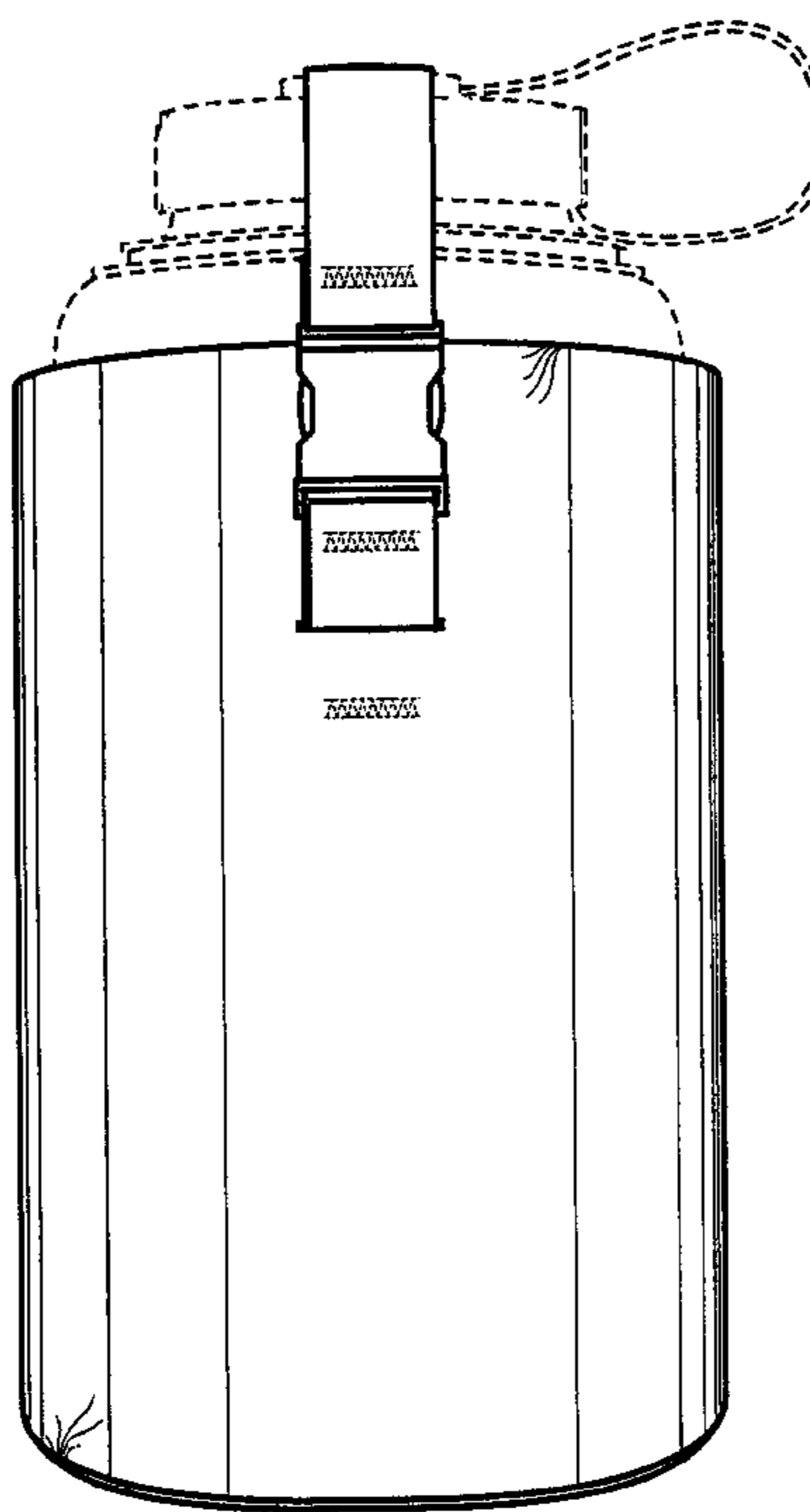
FIG. 1 is a right side view of a bottle carrier showing my new

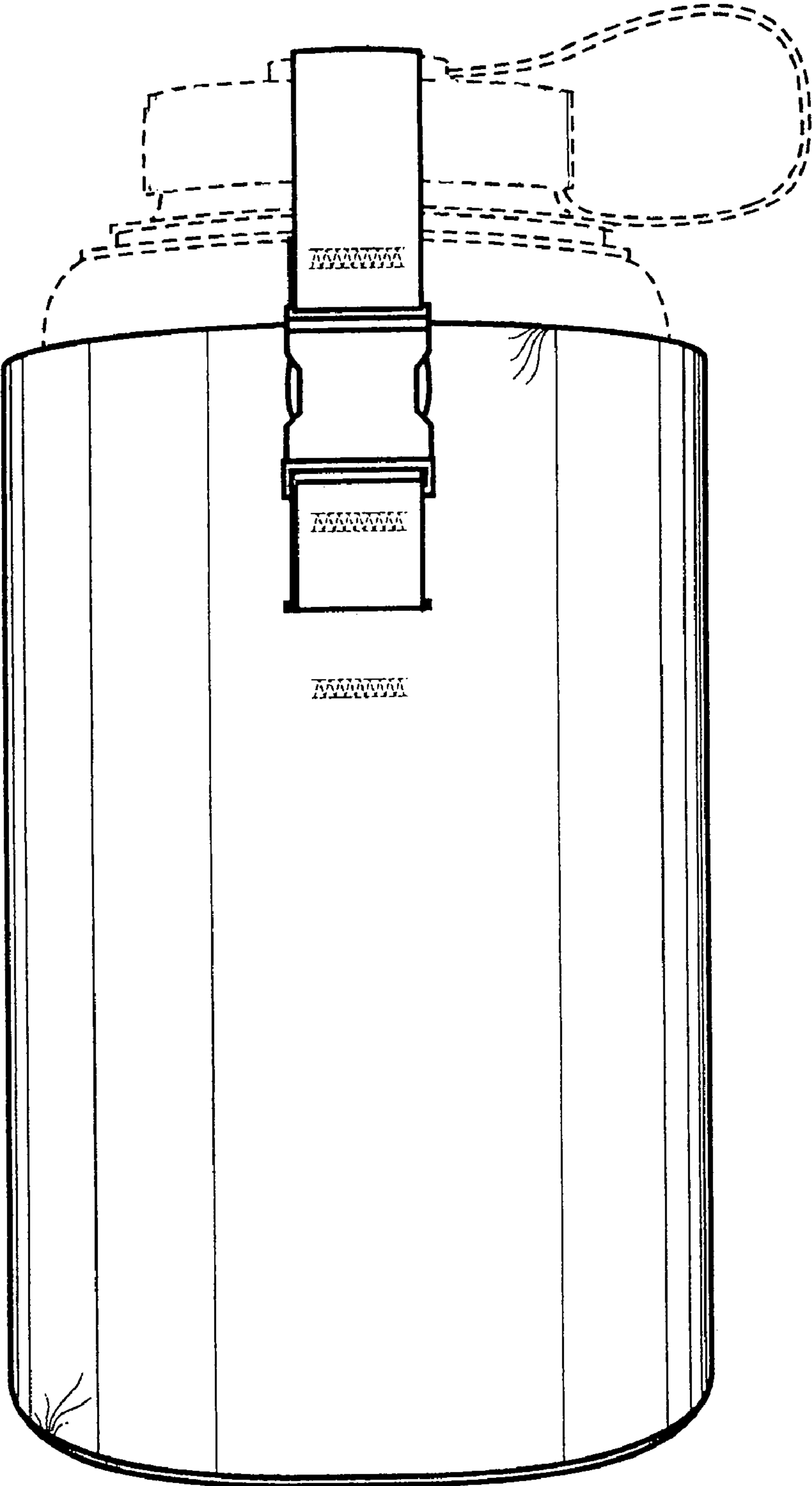

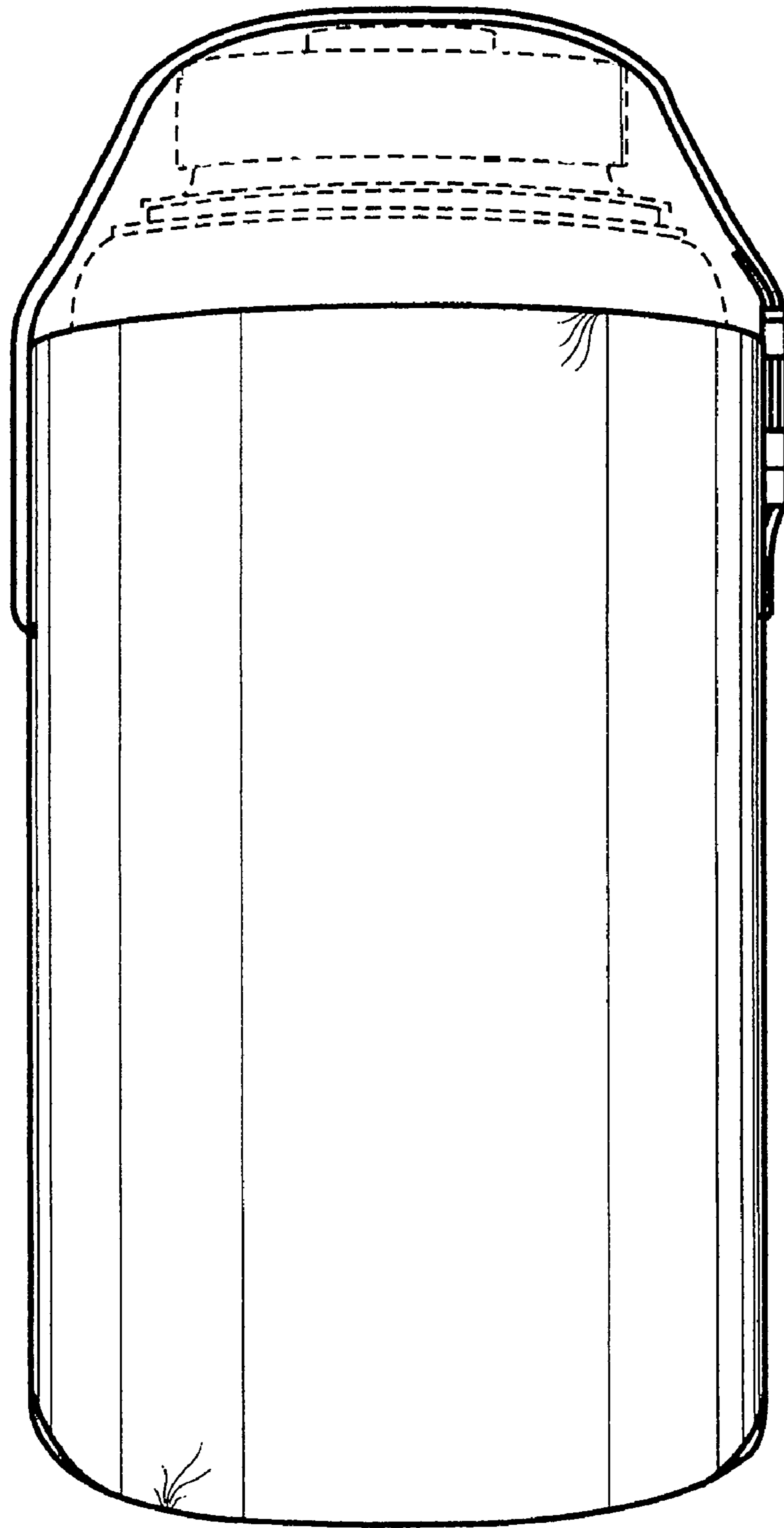

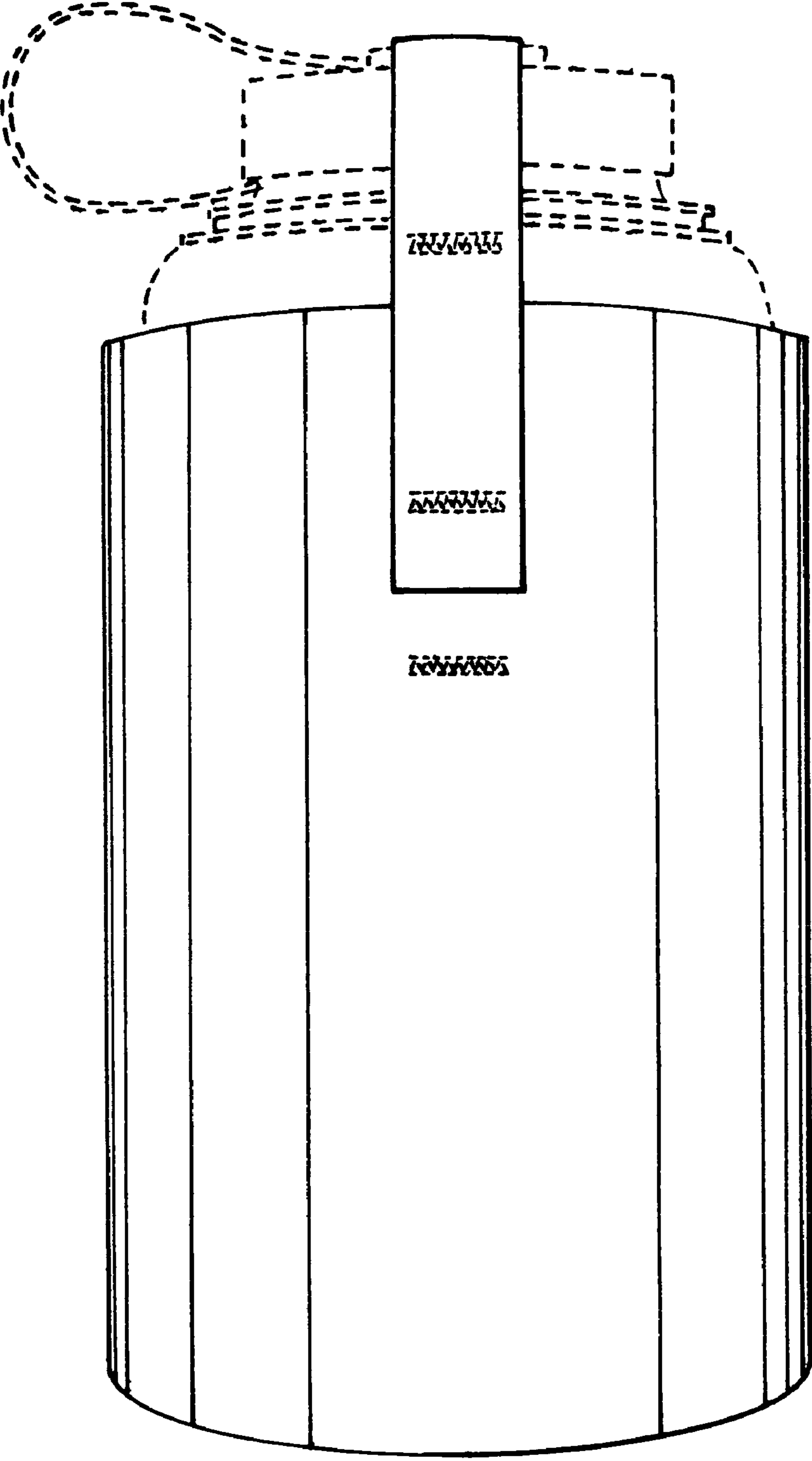
