The ornamental design for a footboard, as shown and described.

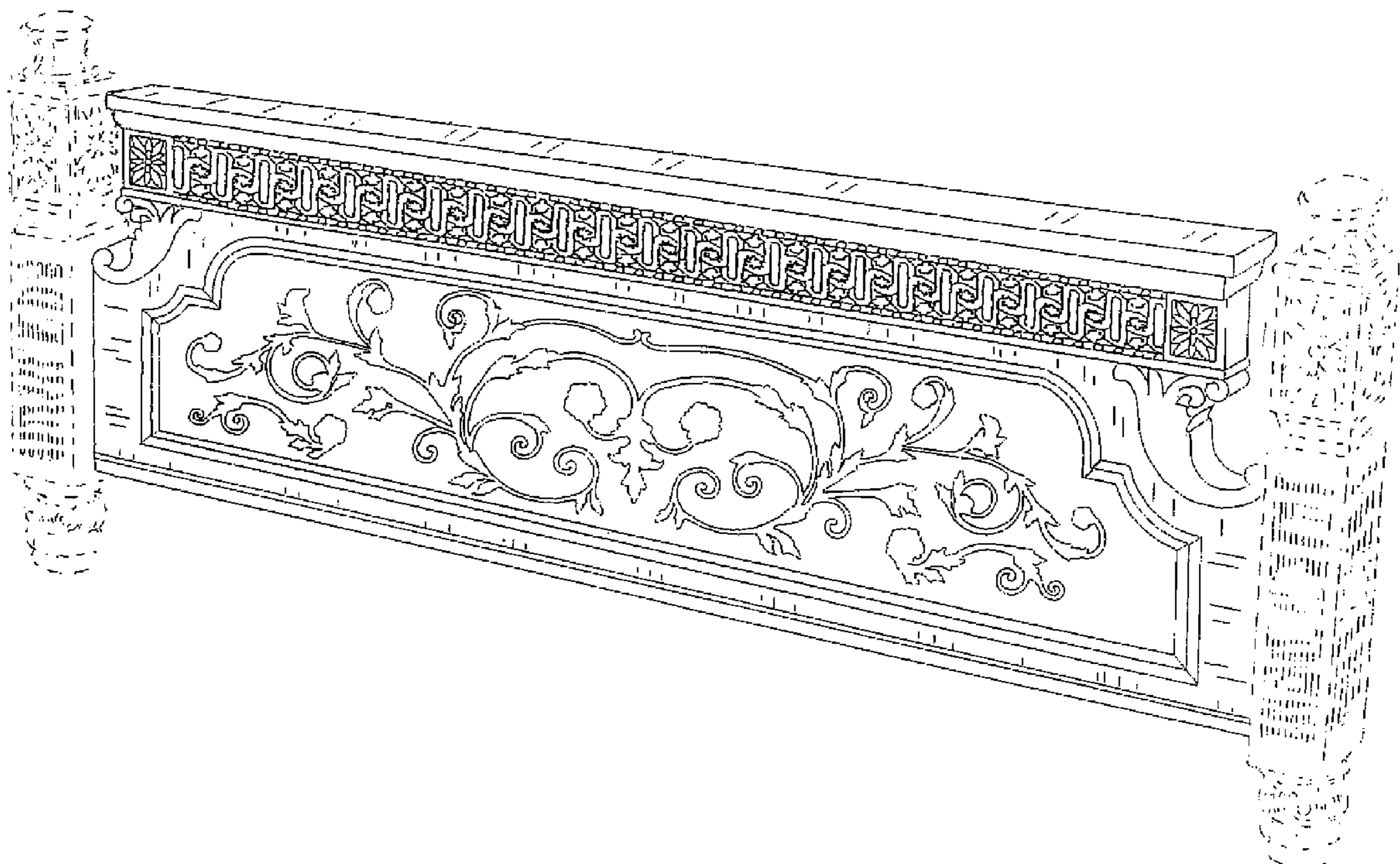
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a footboard according to an embodiment of the invention, the view from the opposite side being a mirror-image thereof; and,

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the footboard of a footboard according to an embodiment of the invention.

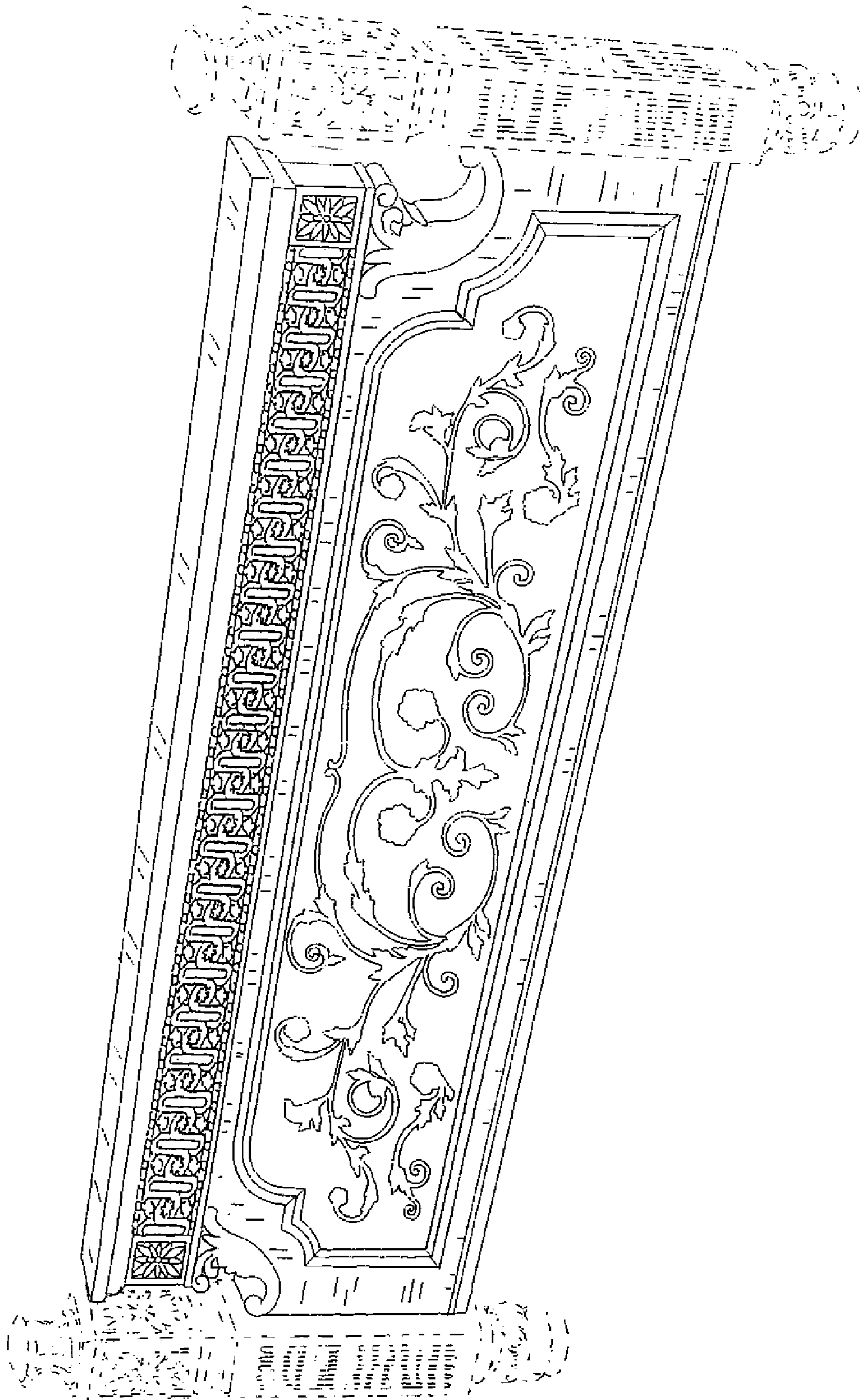

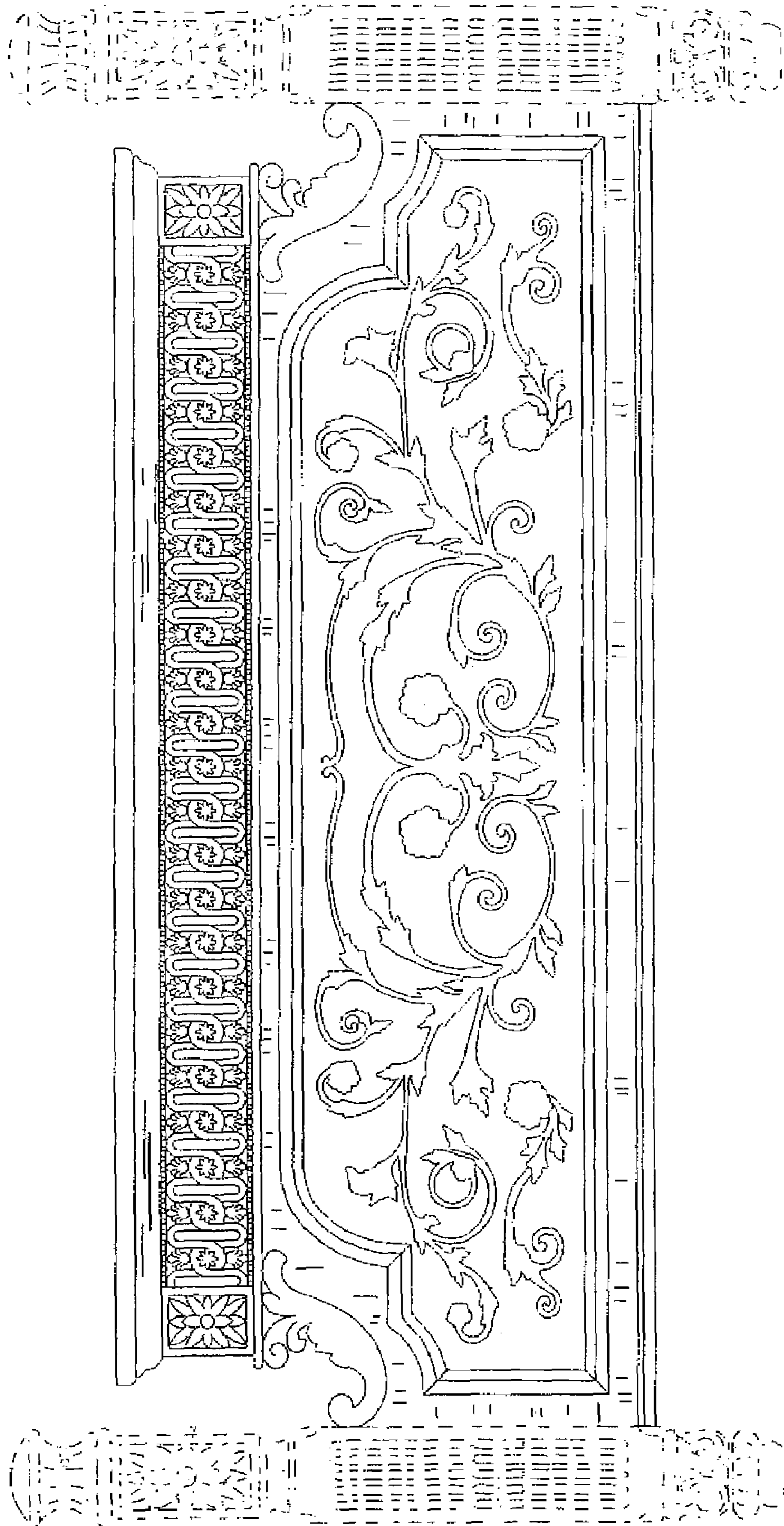
