FIG. 2 is another side perspective view of the off-road vehicle frame;

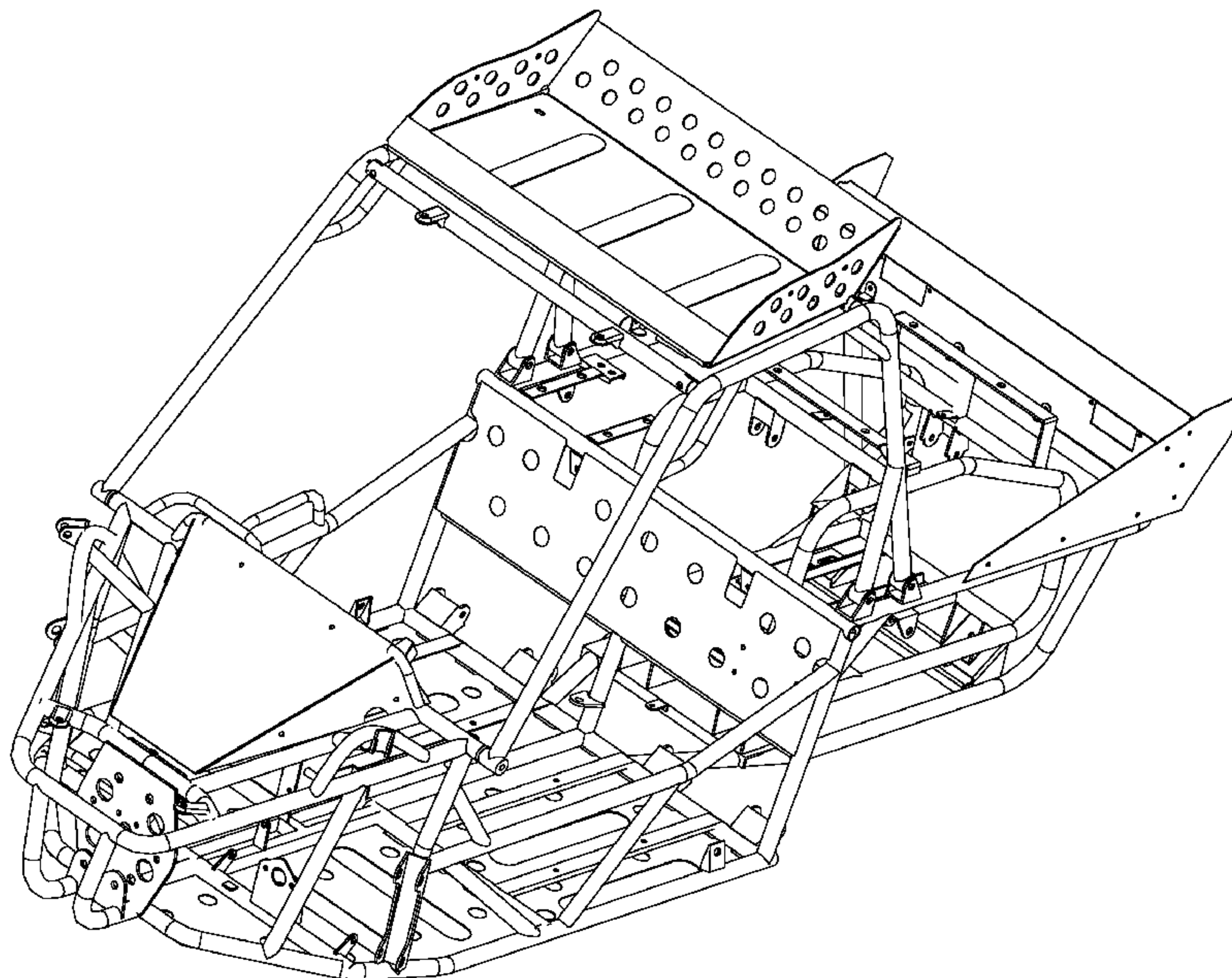
FIG. 3 is a front side elevation of the off-road vehicle frame;

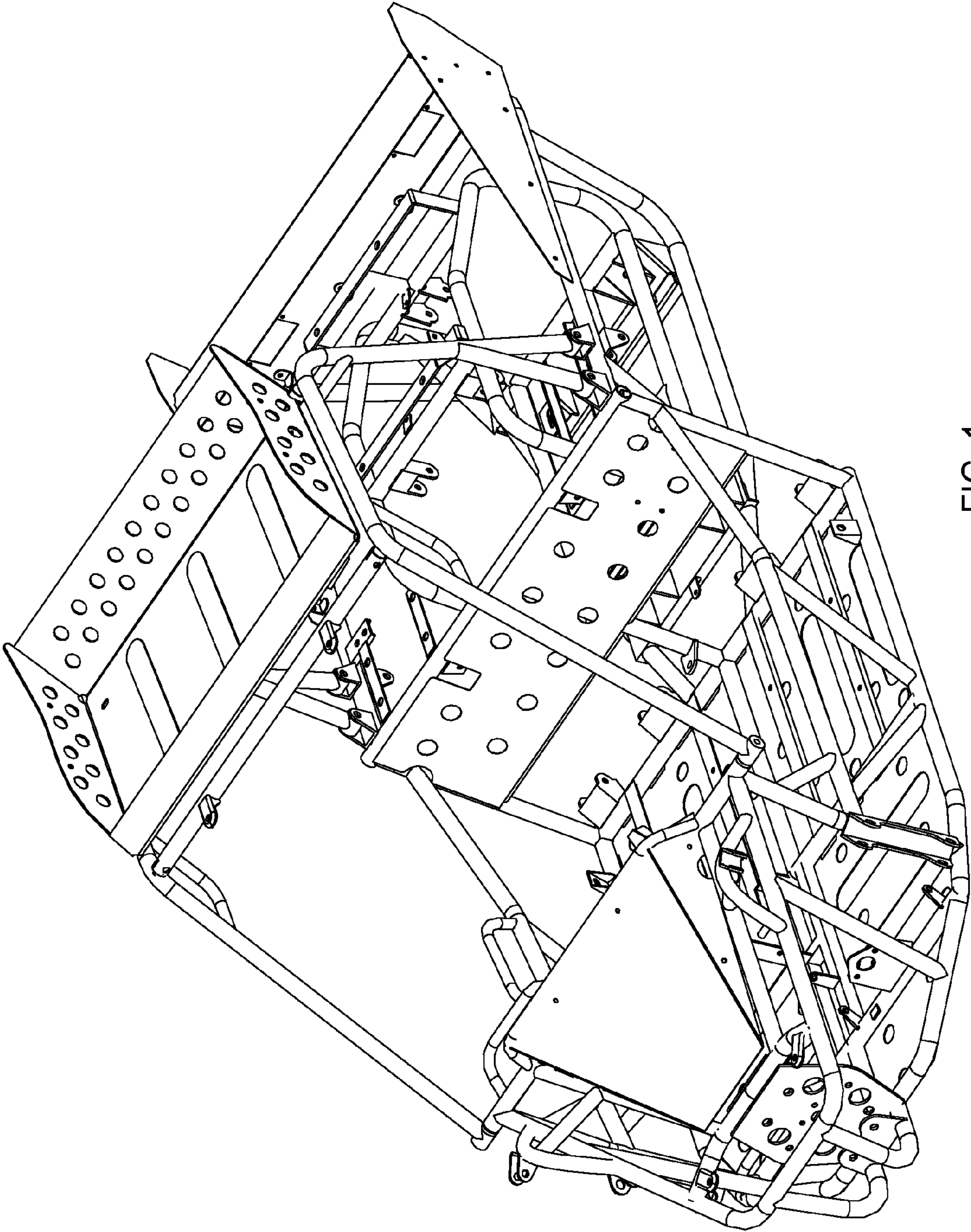

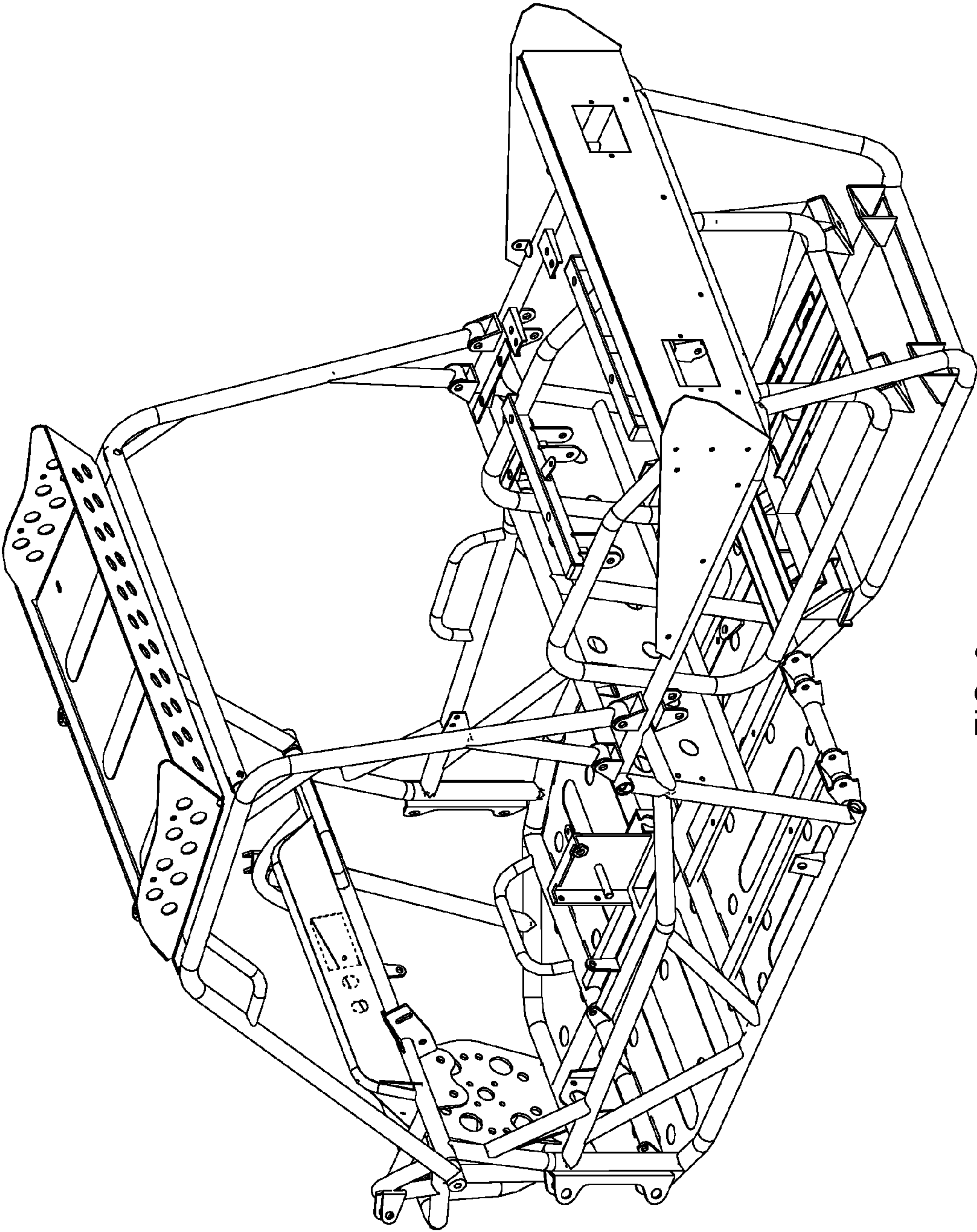

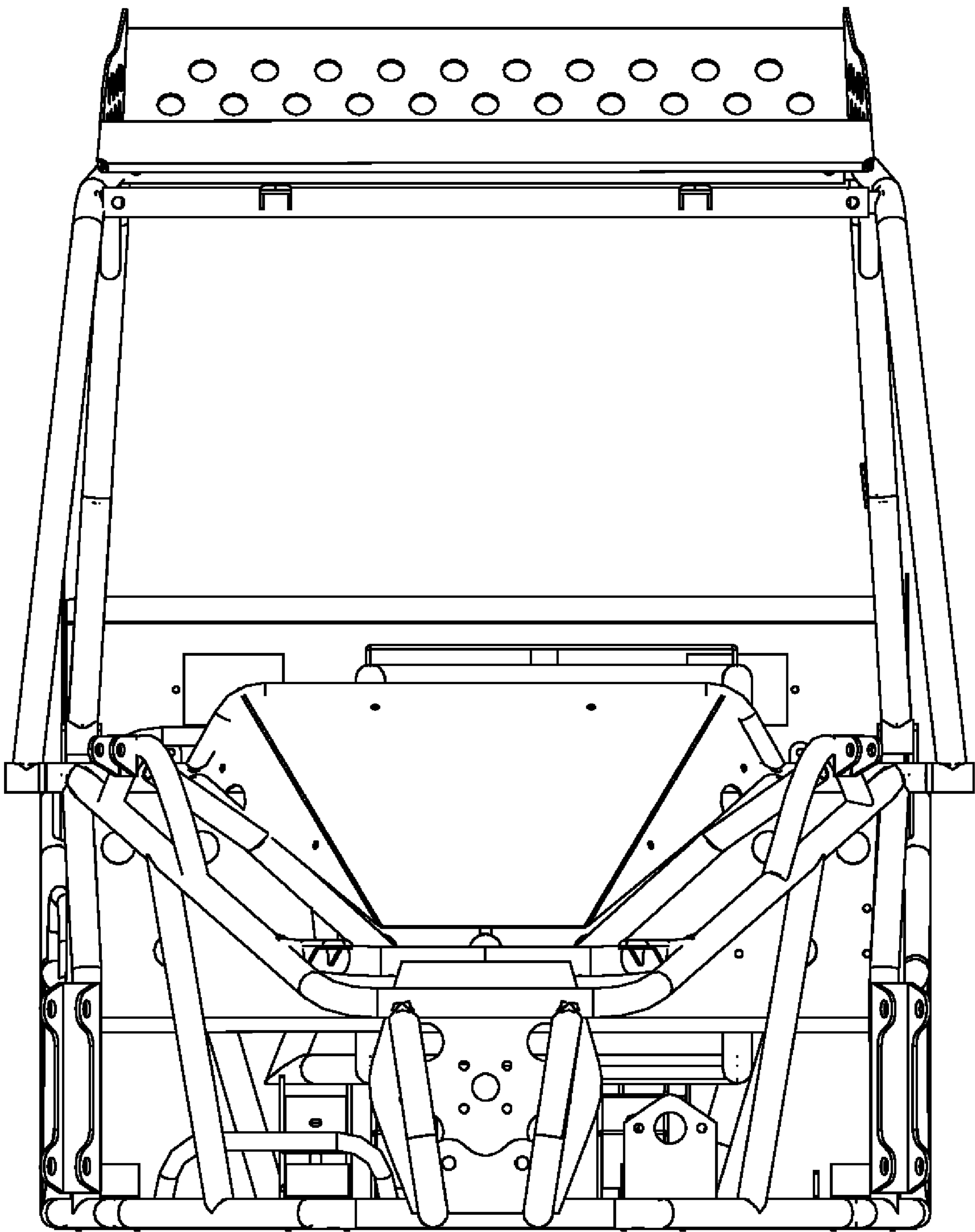

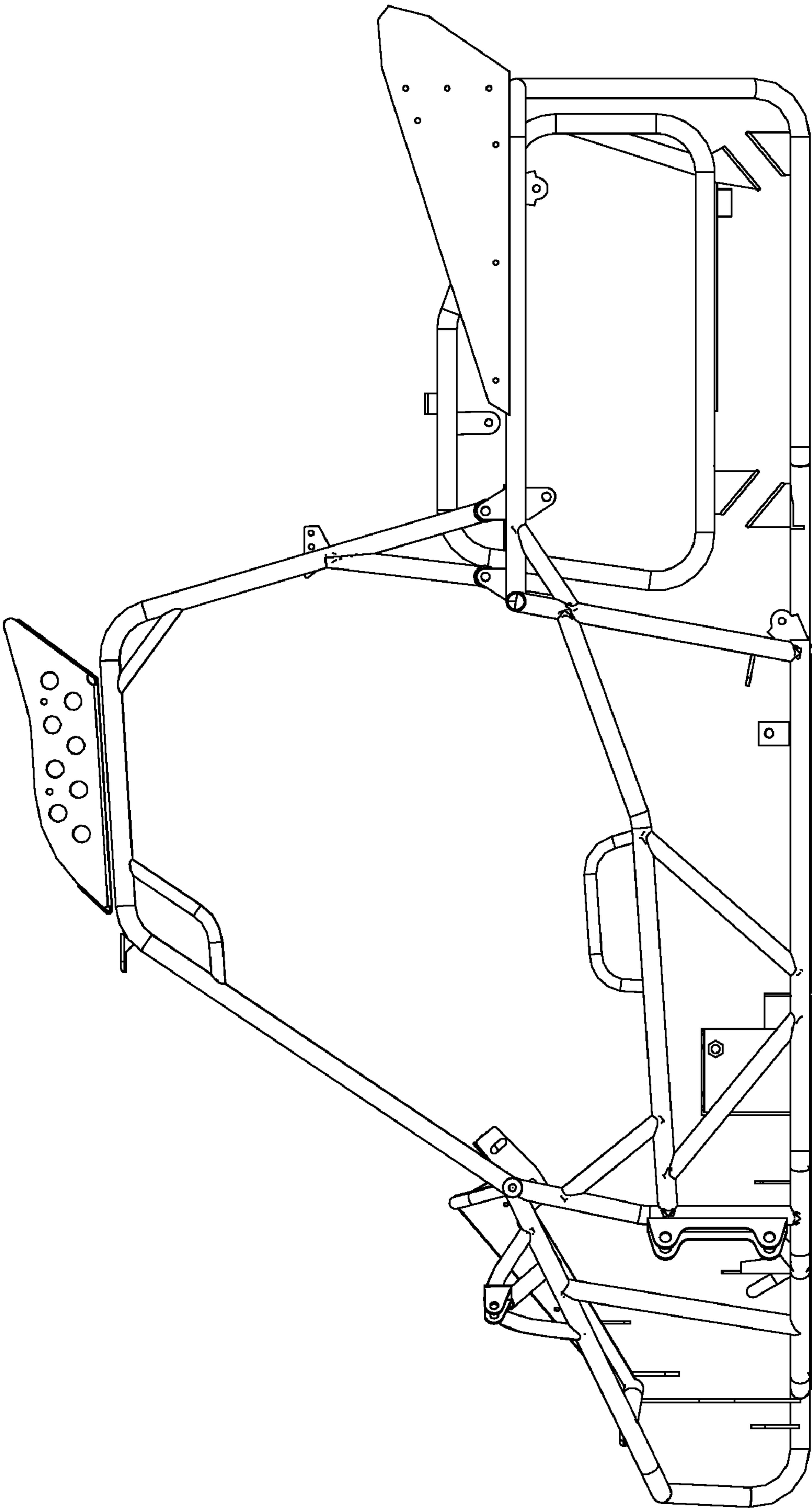

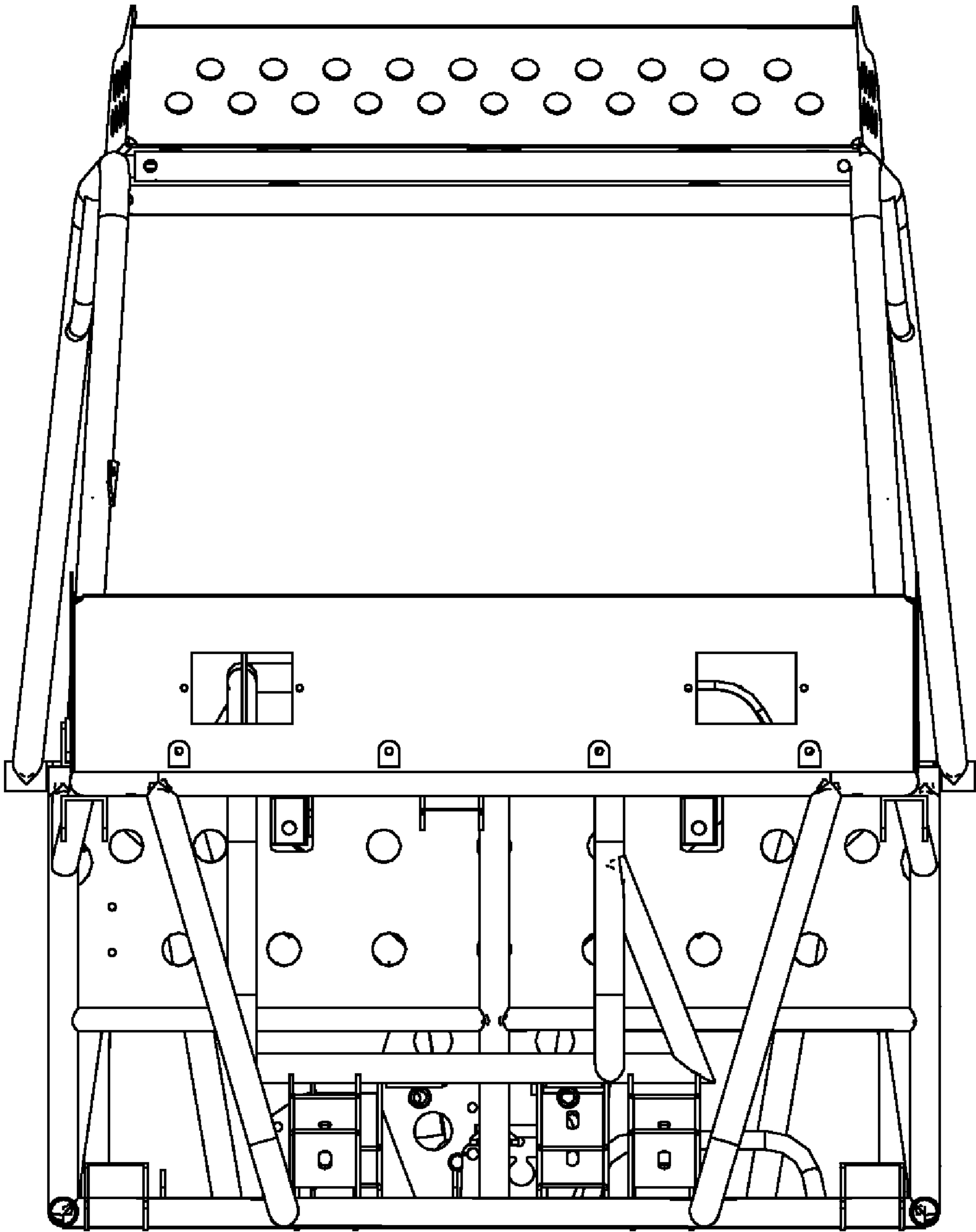

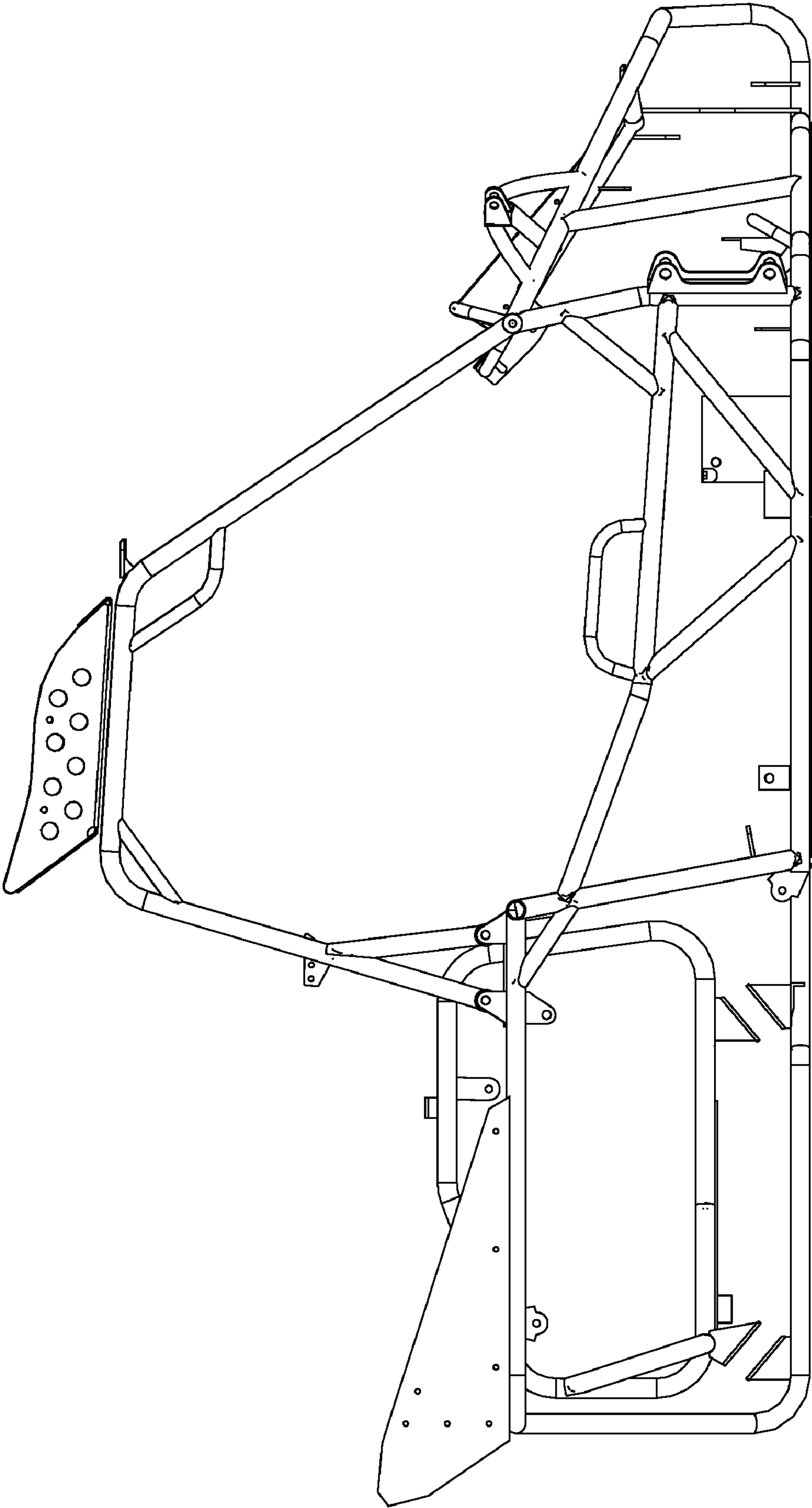

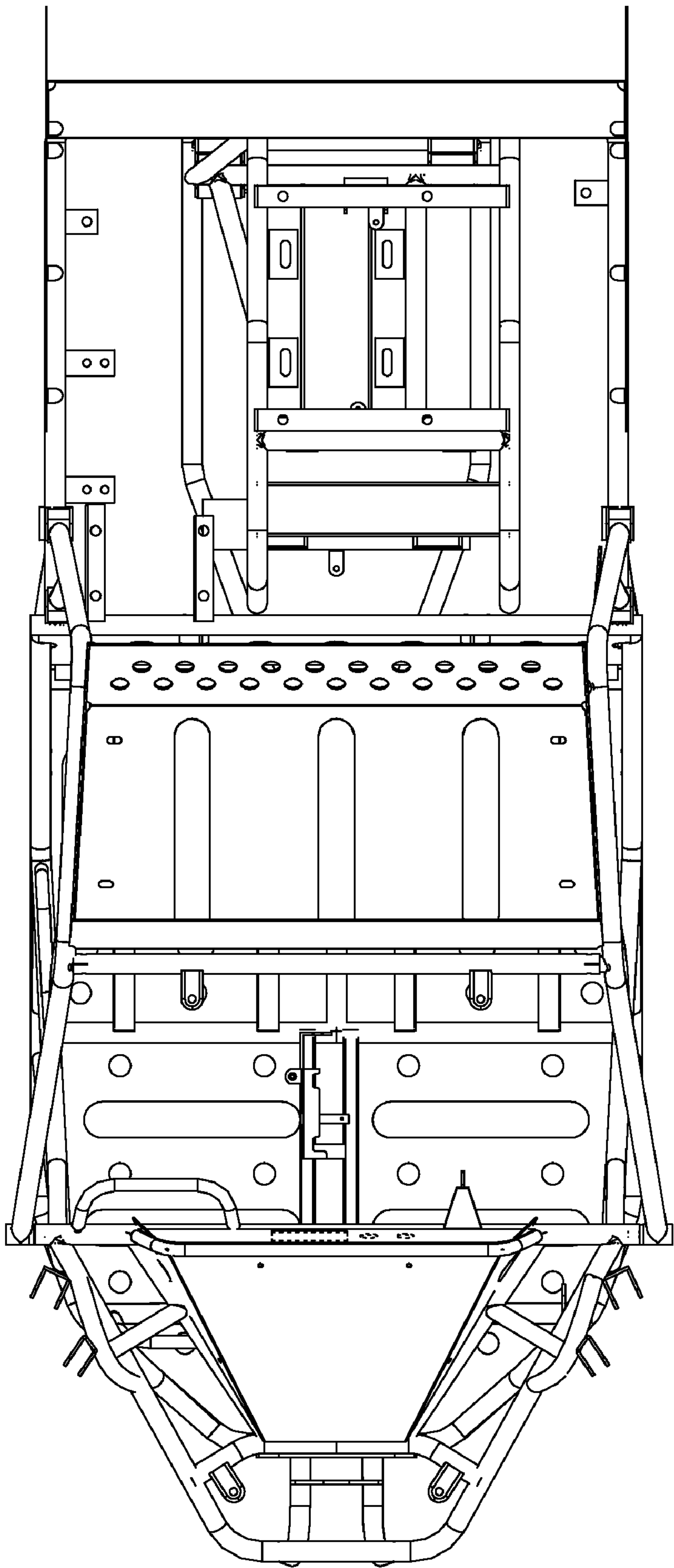

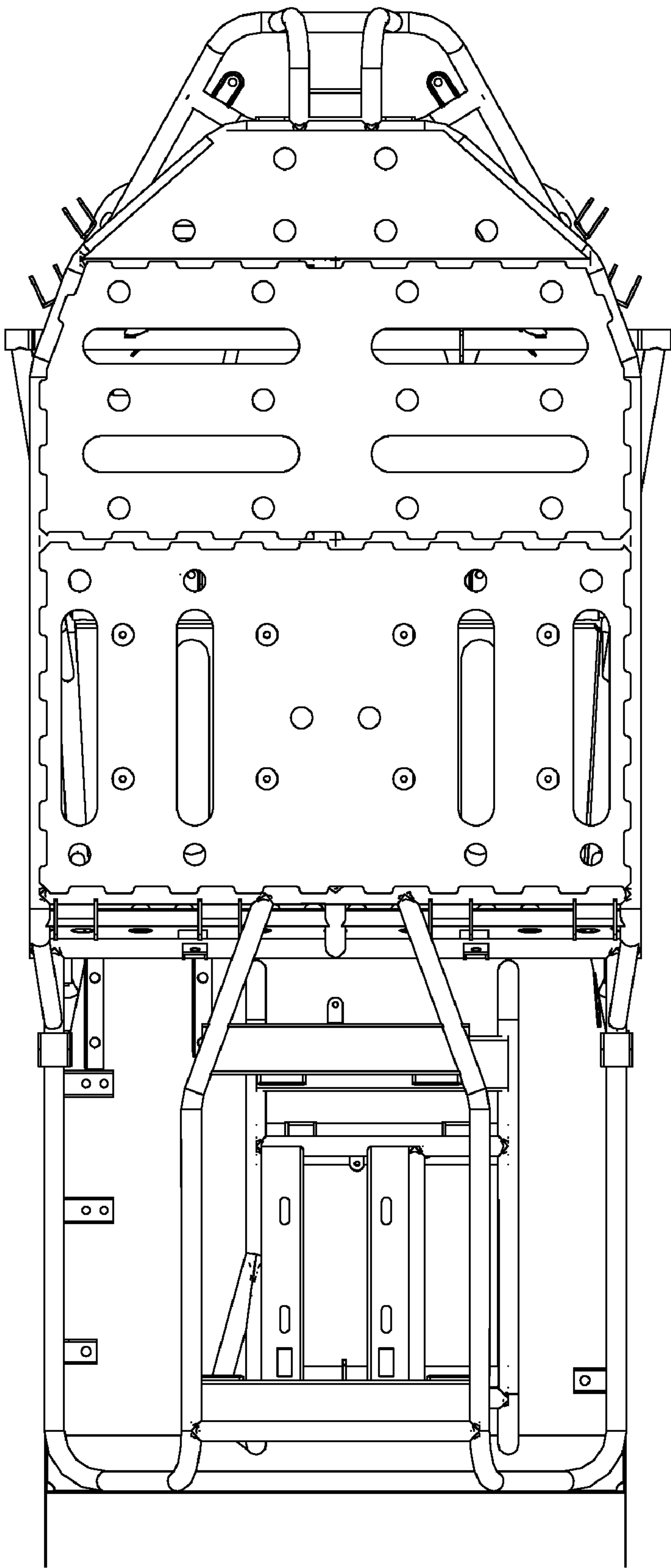

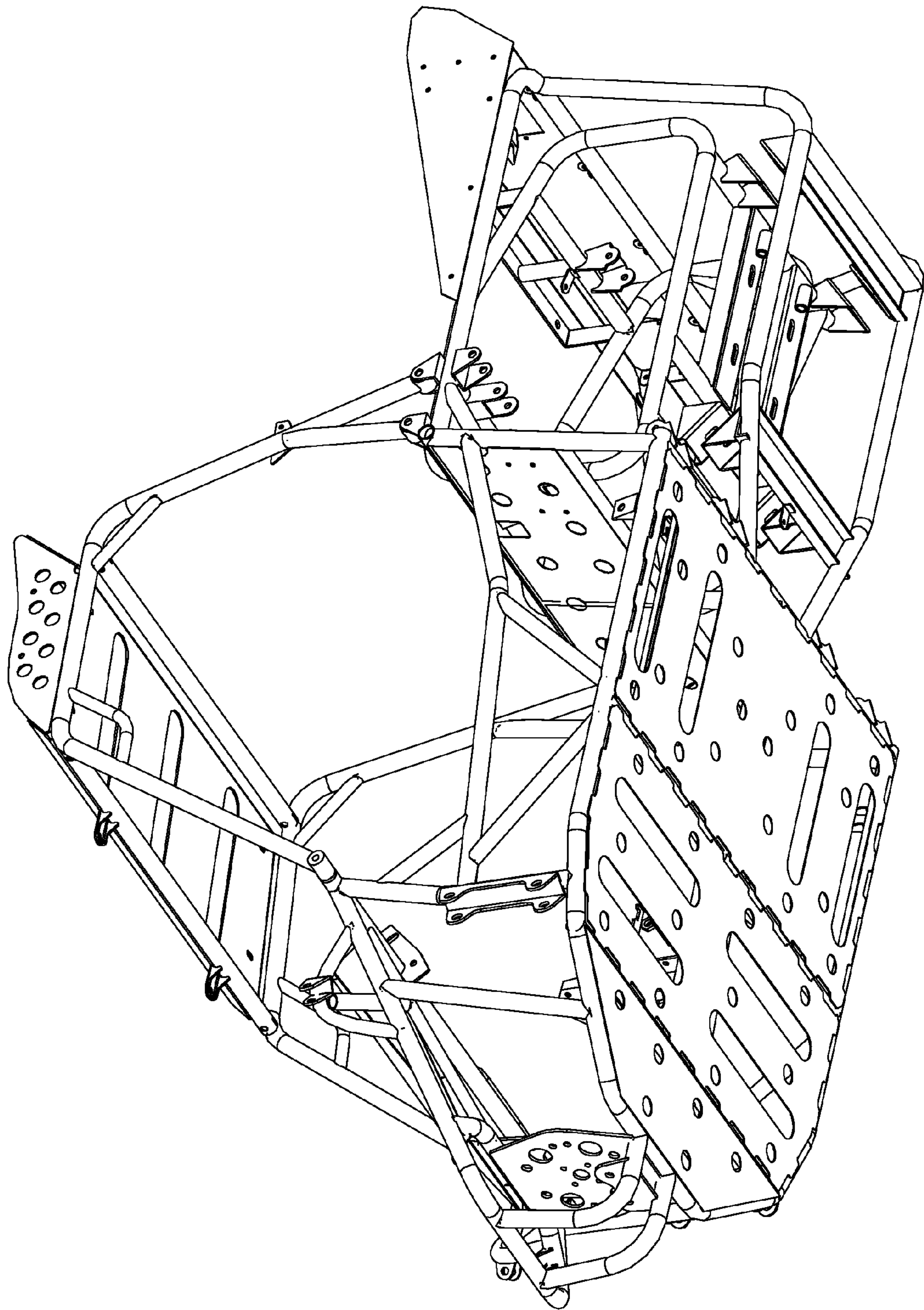

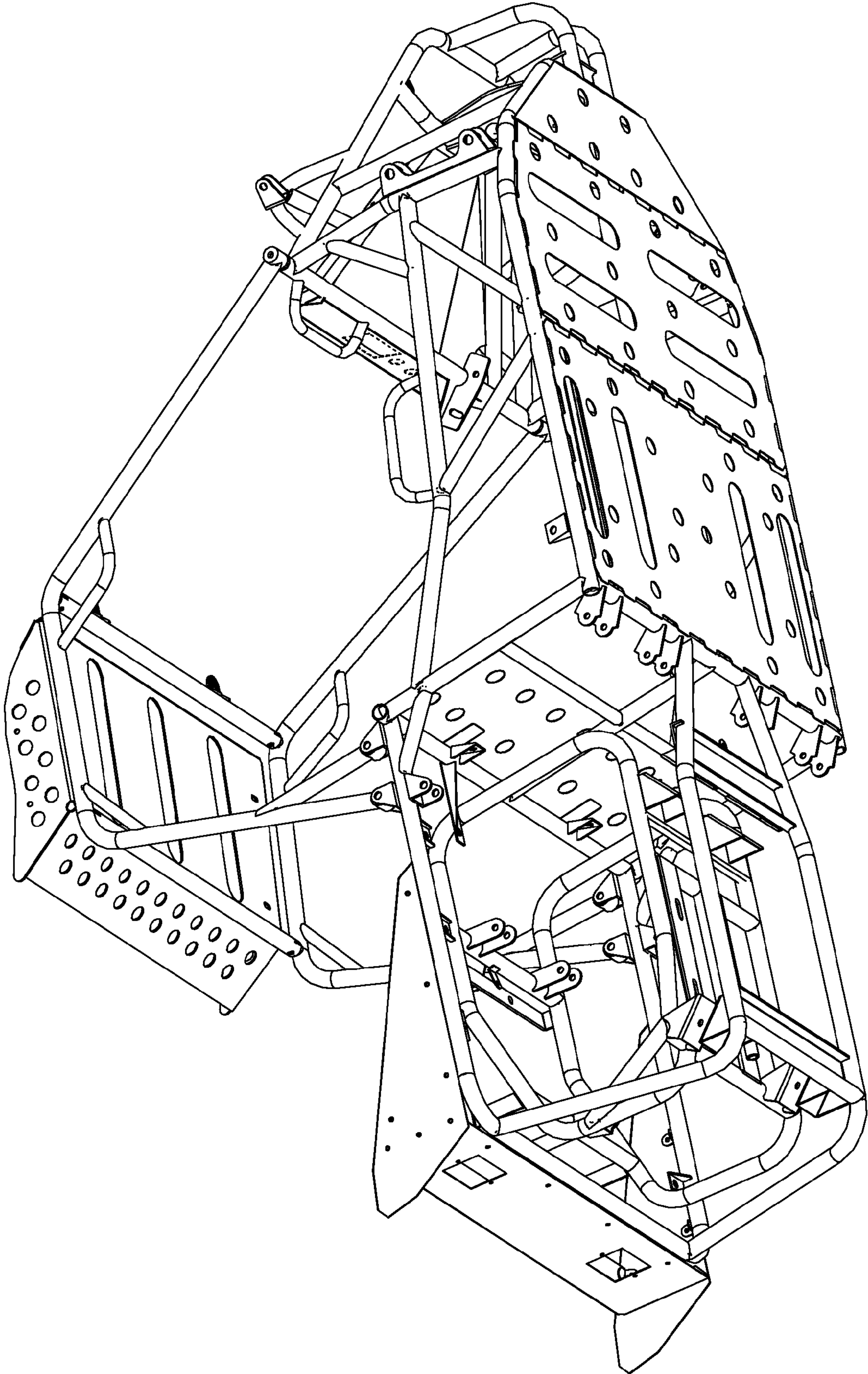
