(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a clothing article, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a clothing article, according to my new design; and,

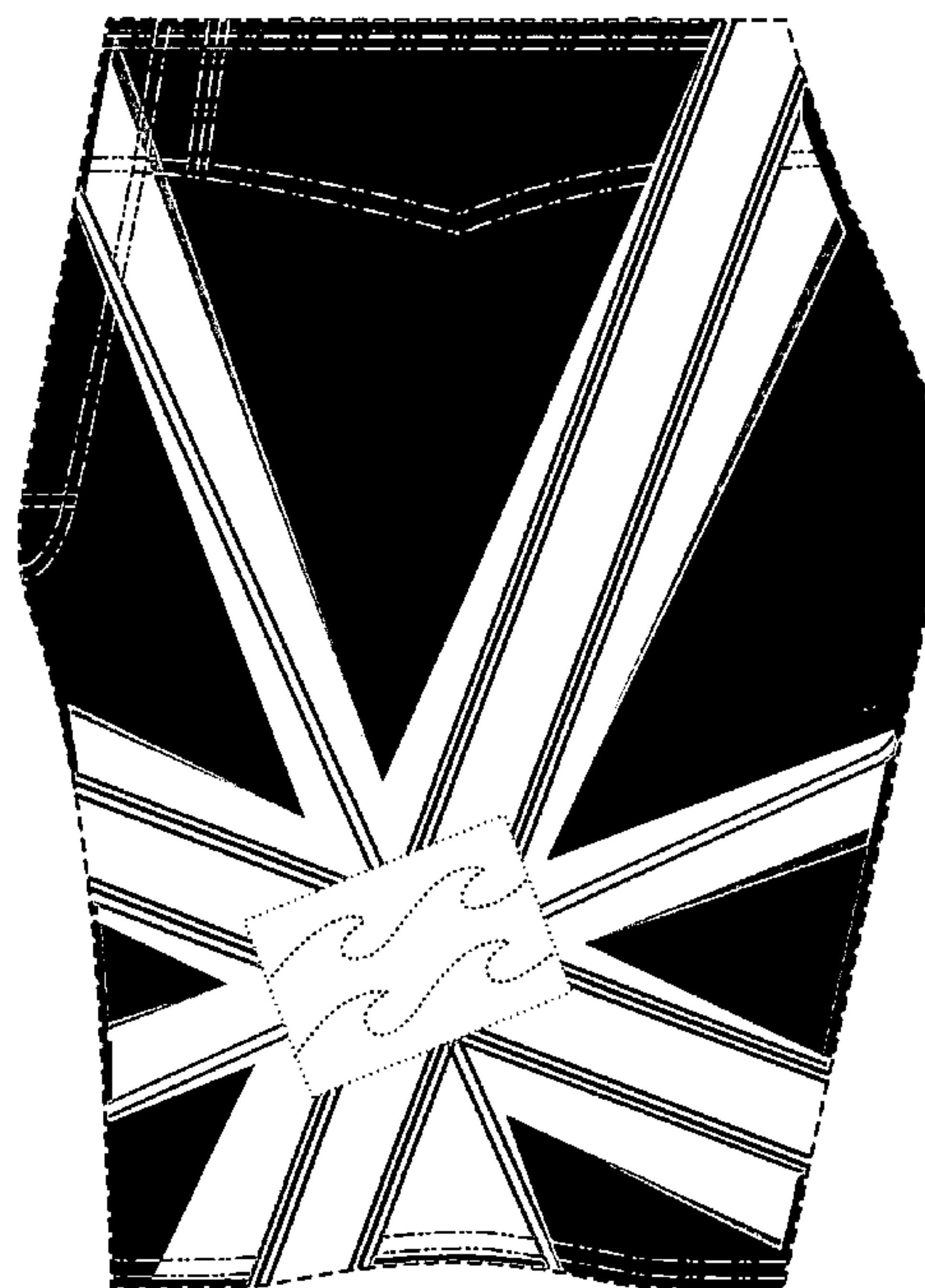
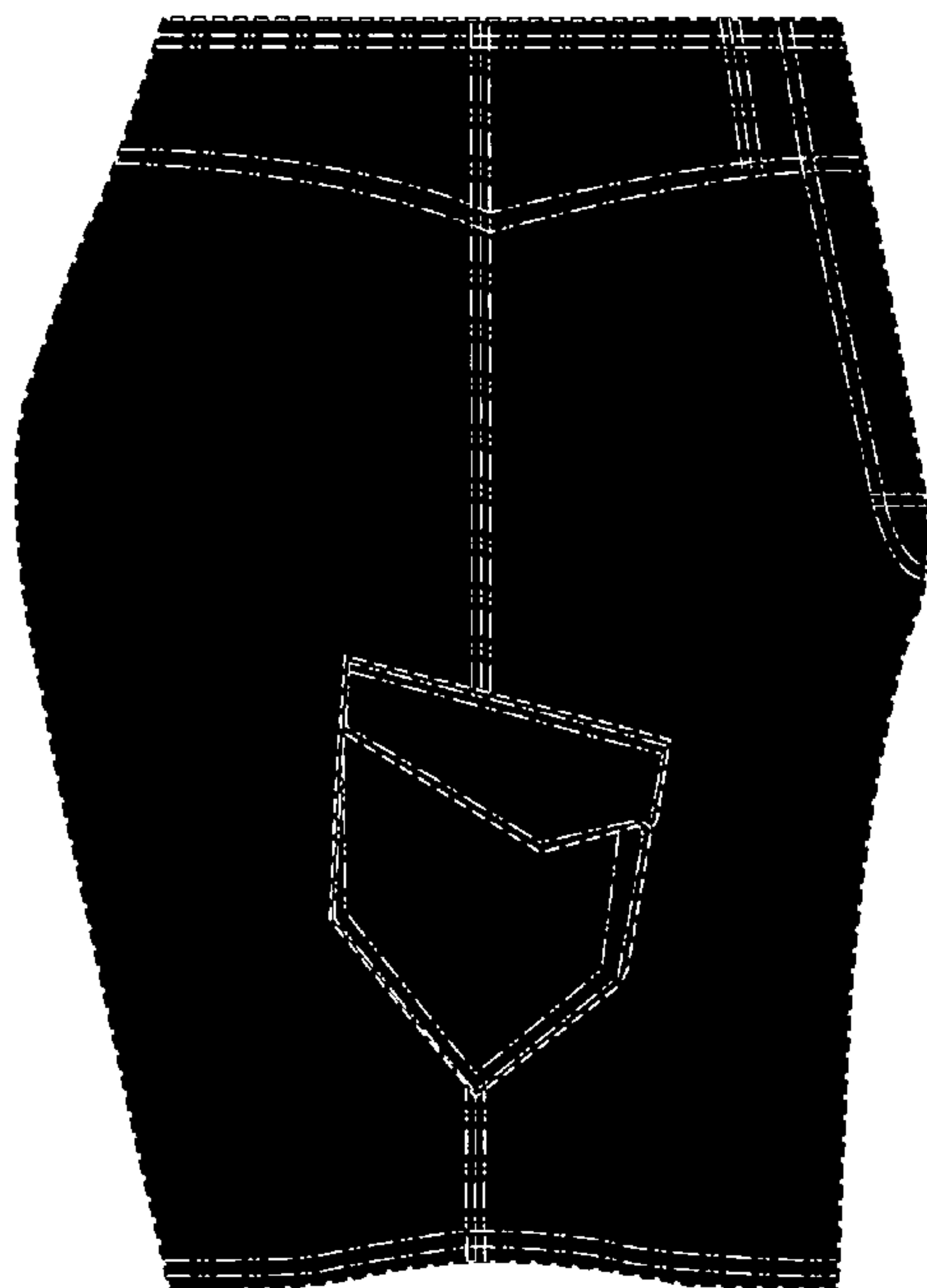
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof.

The grayscale shown in FIGS. 1-2 indicate a contrast in appearance with respect to the adjacent areas of the pattern and is not limited to any color, tone, or hue.

The dotted lines shown in the drawings represent the wave pattern logo and its surrounding border, forming no part of the claimed design.

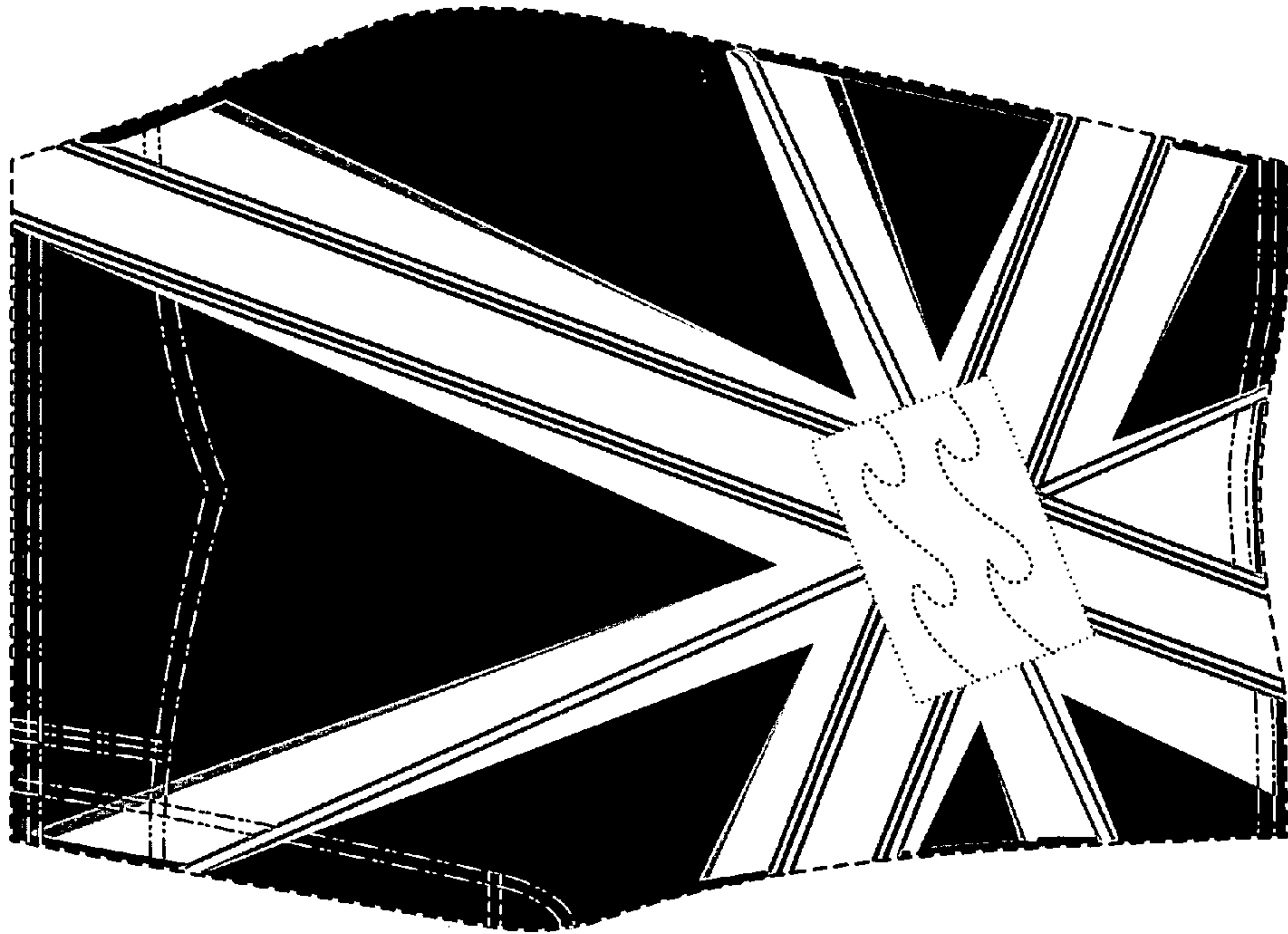

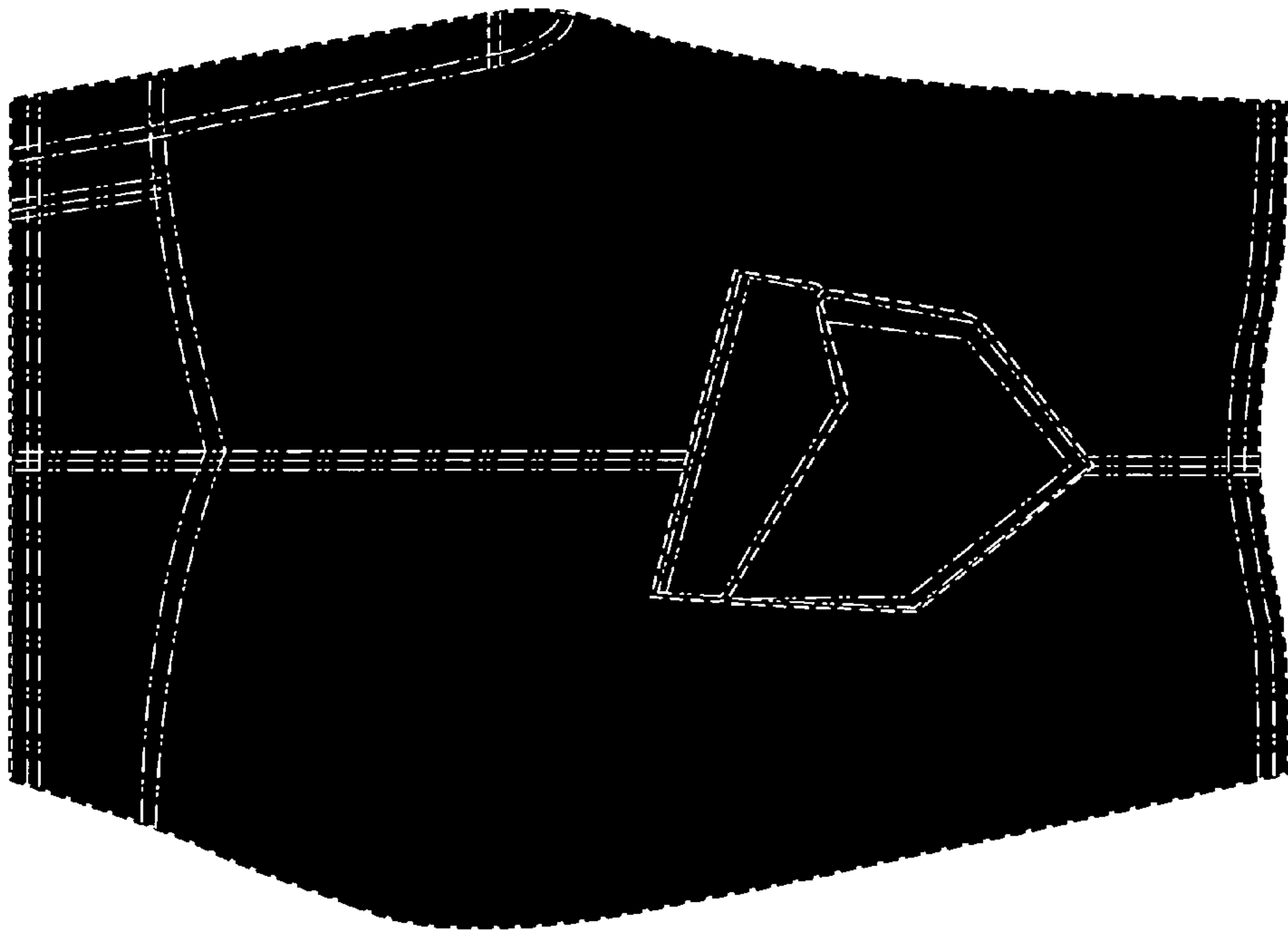
