FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the invention.

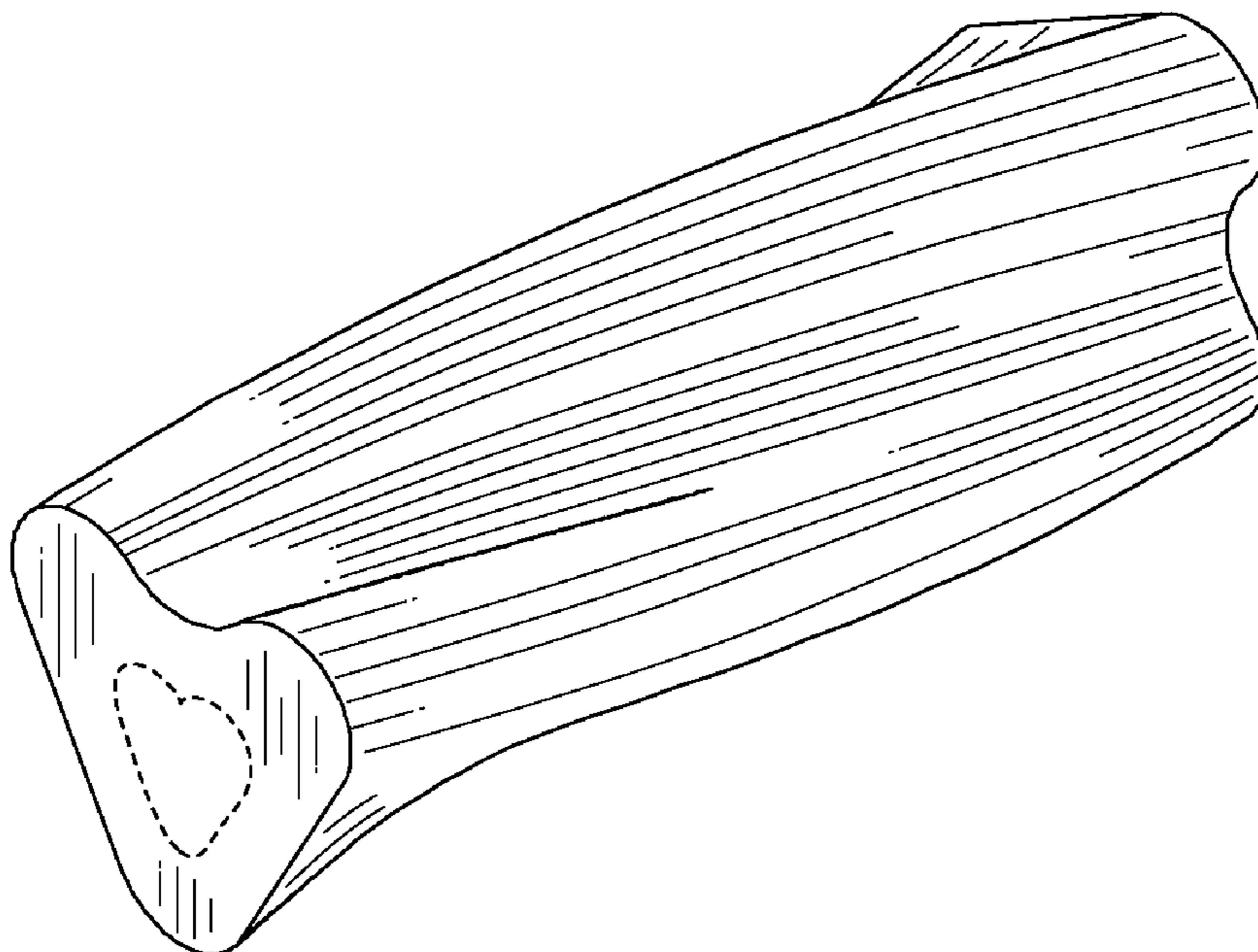
FIG. 5 is a rear view of the invention.

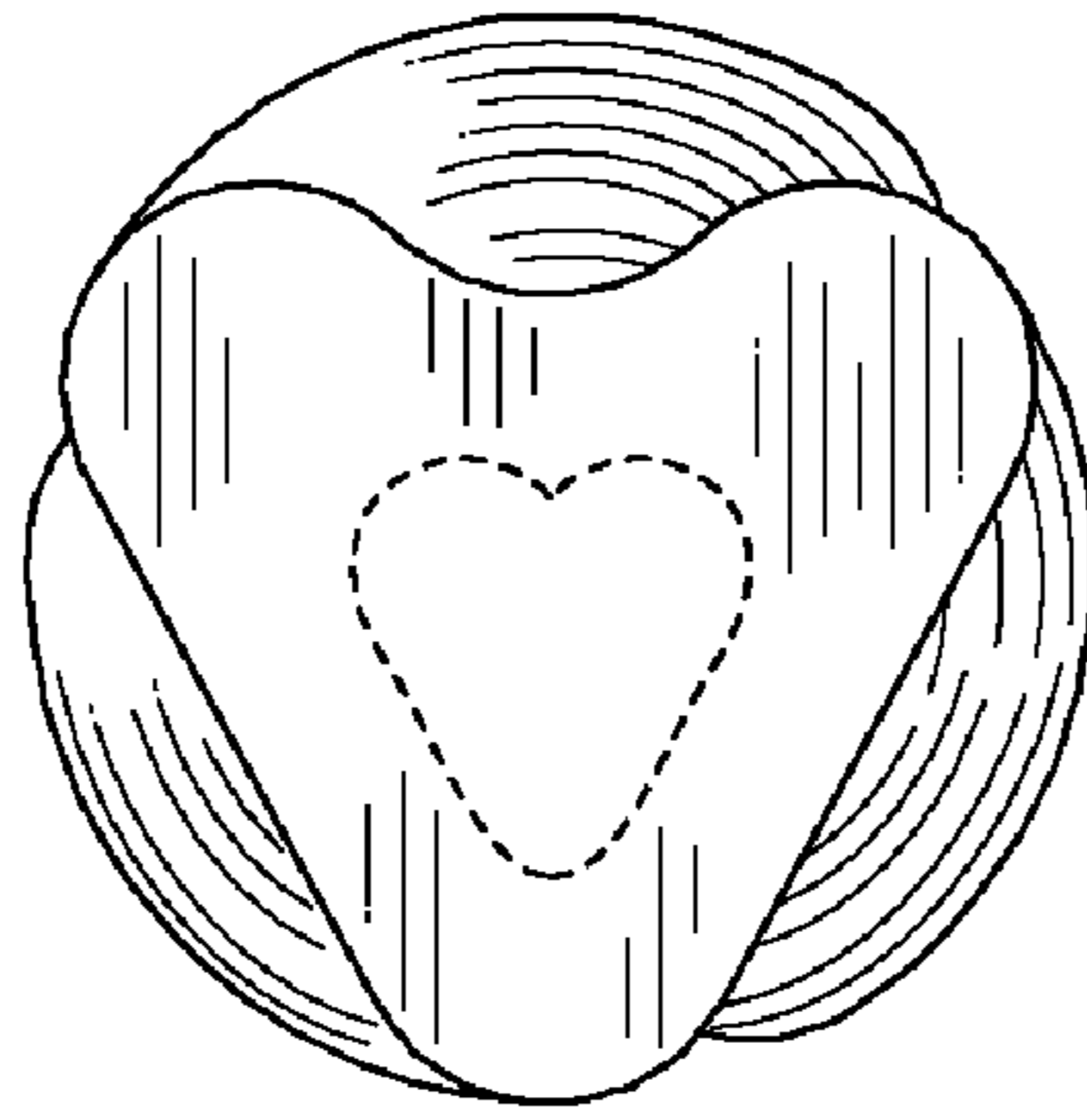

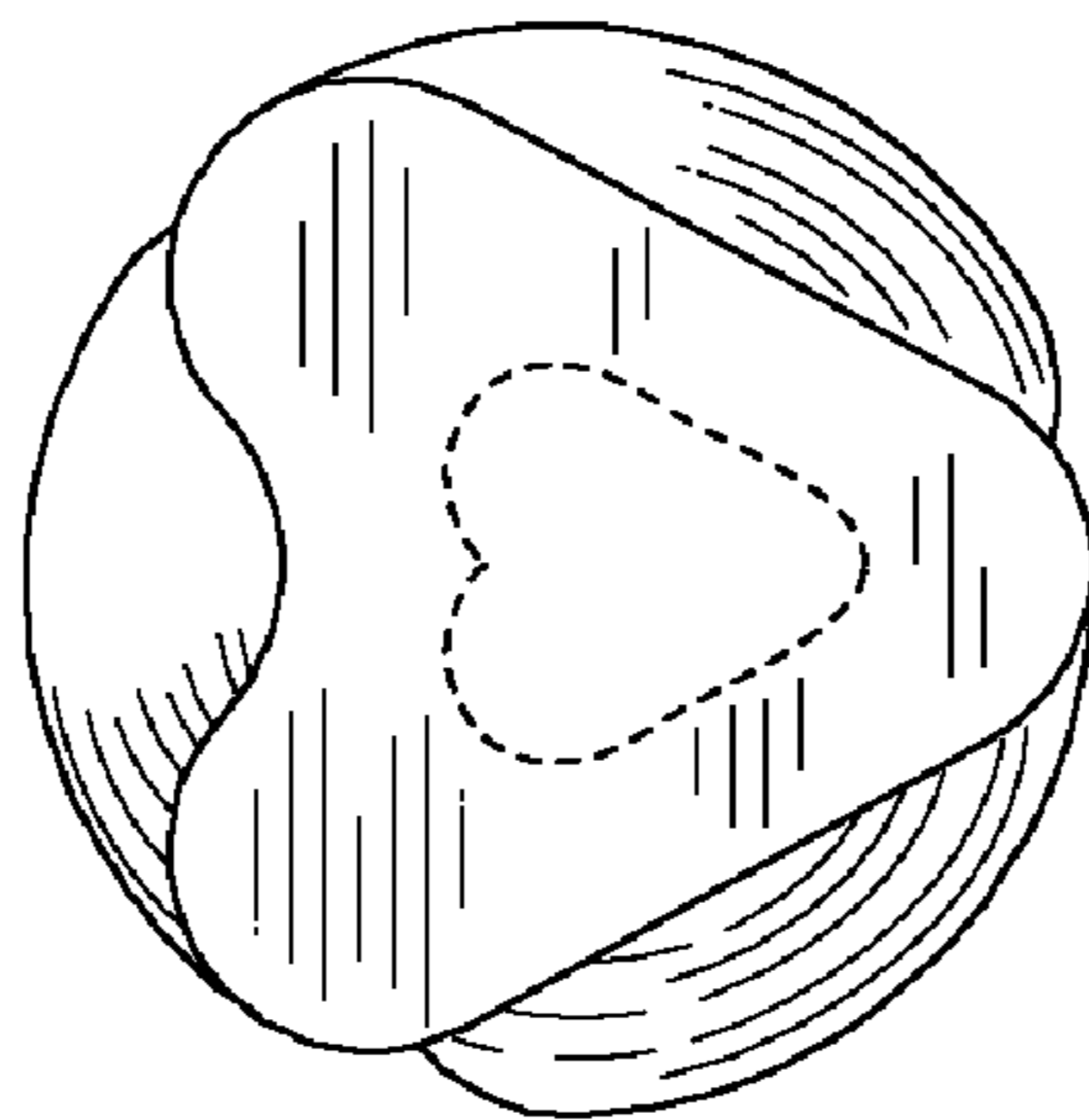

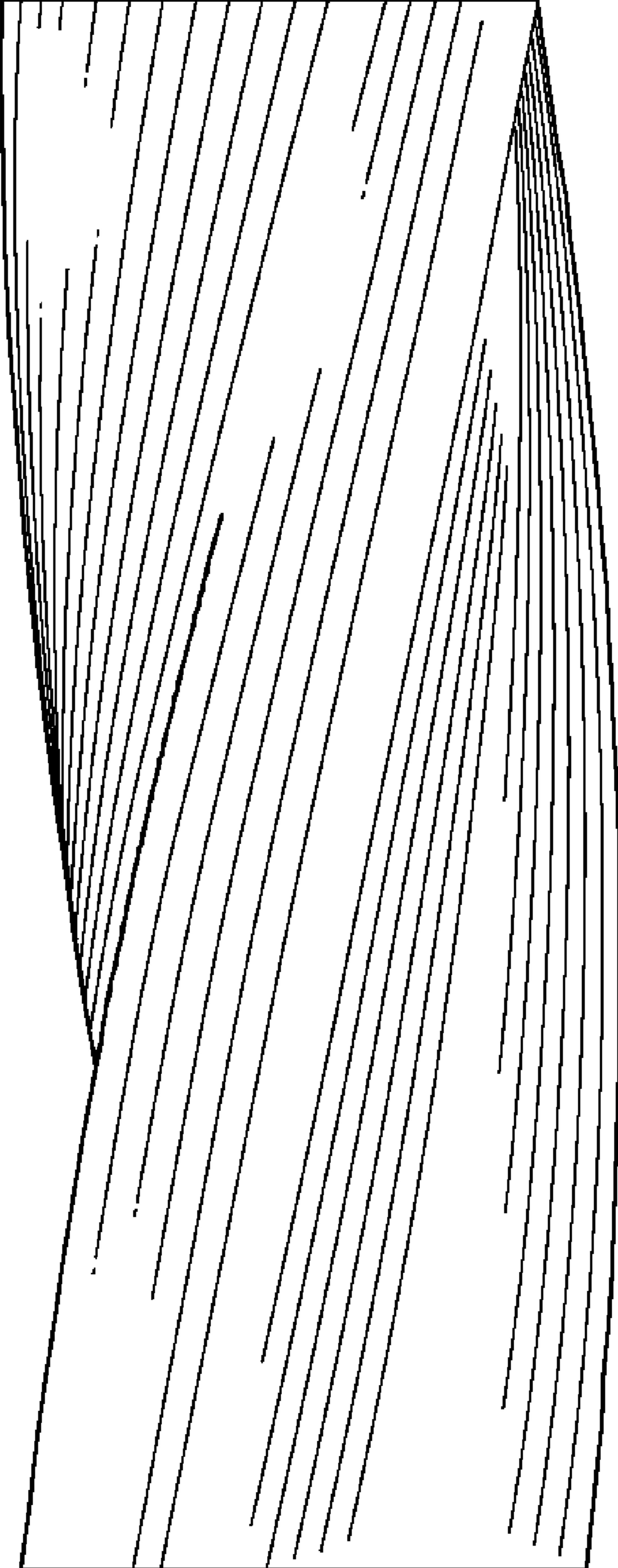

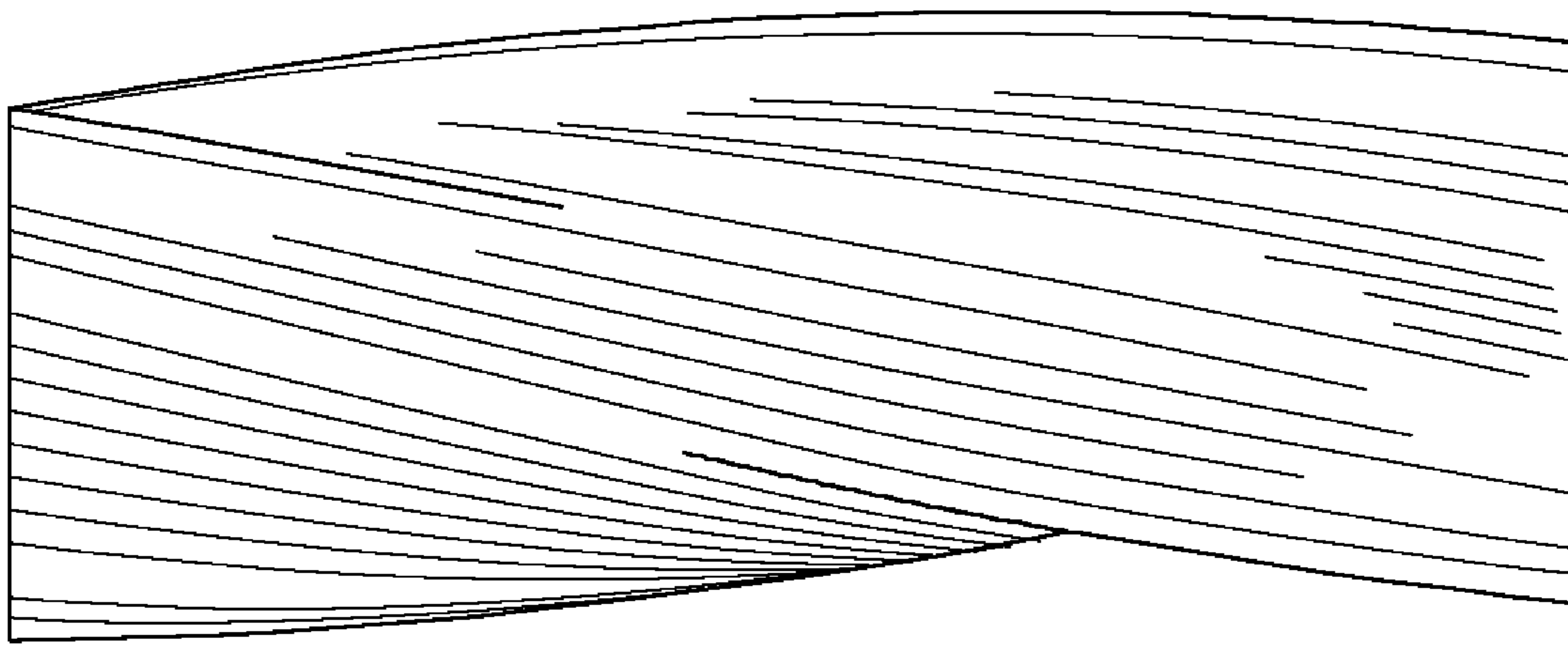

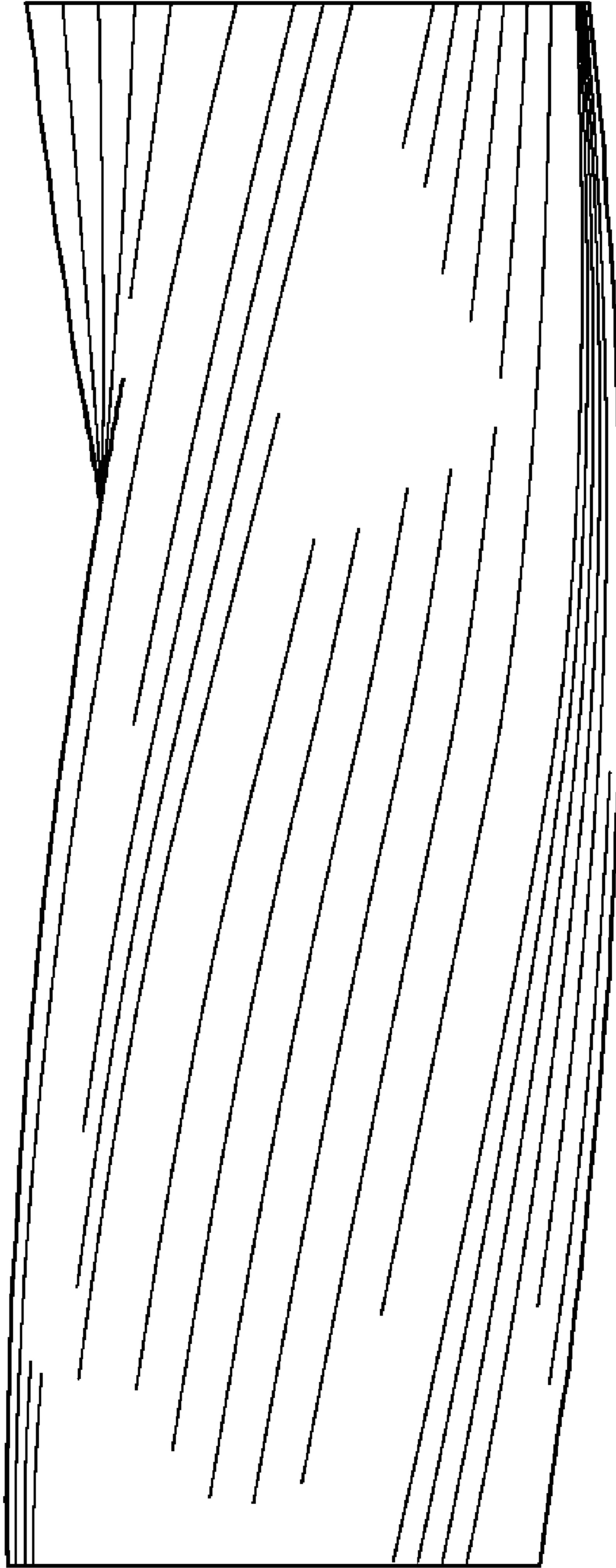

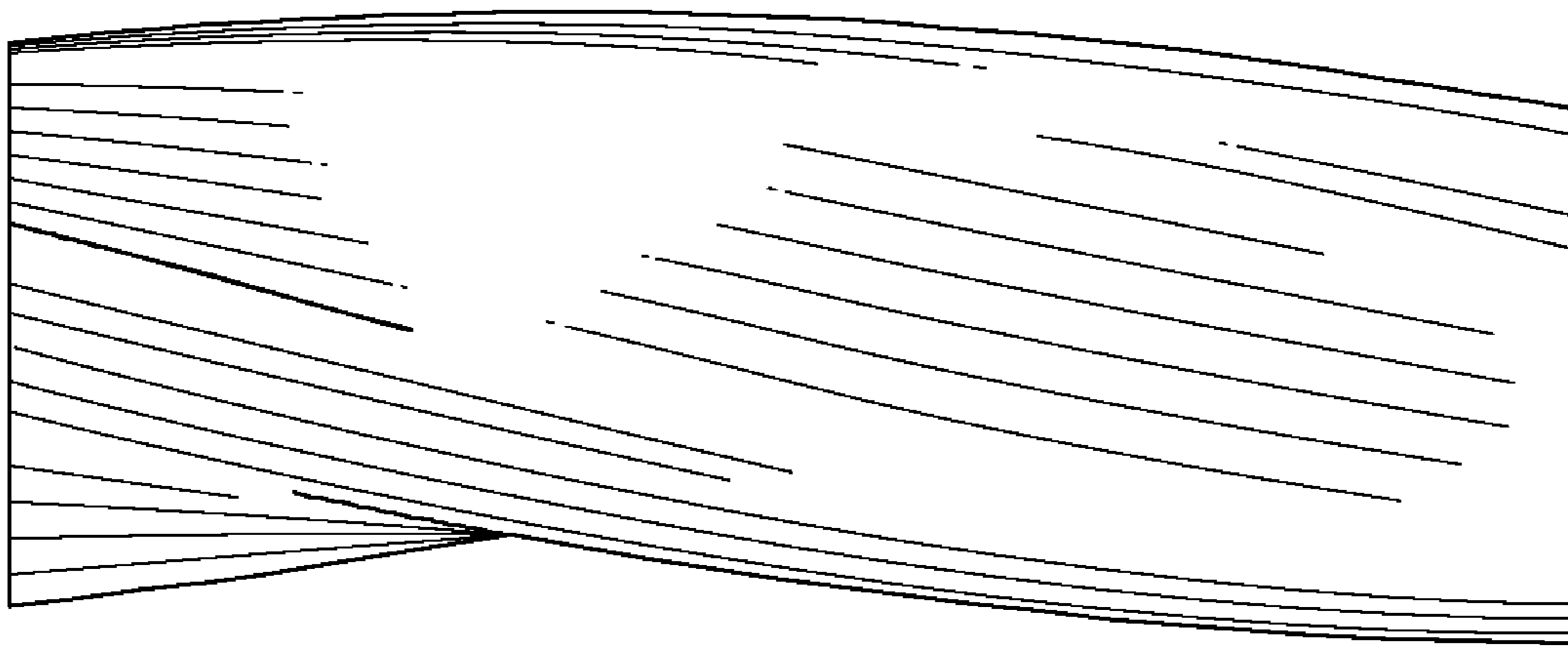

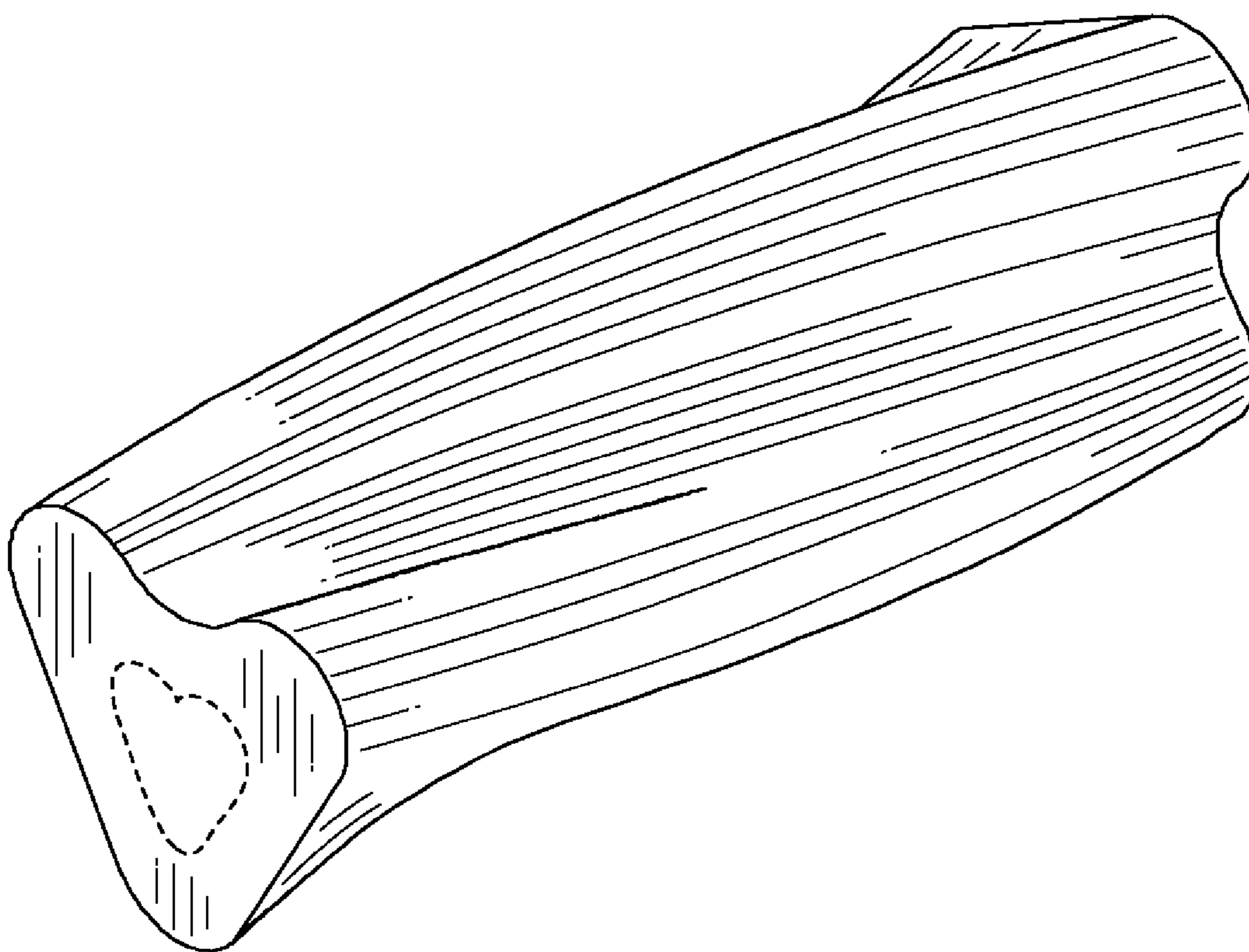
