FIG. 3 is a top planar view of the bicycle frame of FIG. 1;

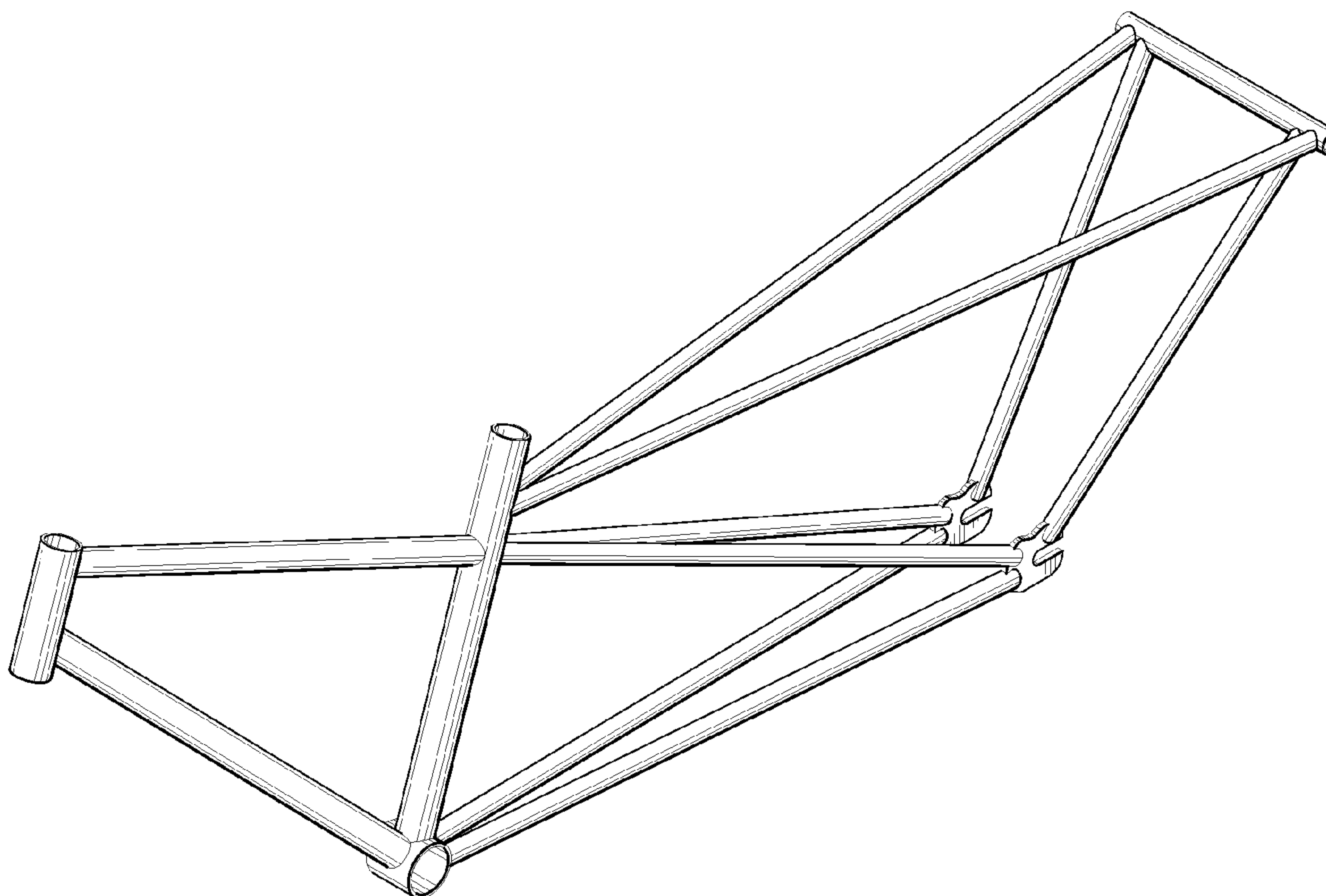
FIG. 4 is a side elevation view of the bicycle frame of FIG. 1;

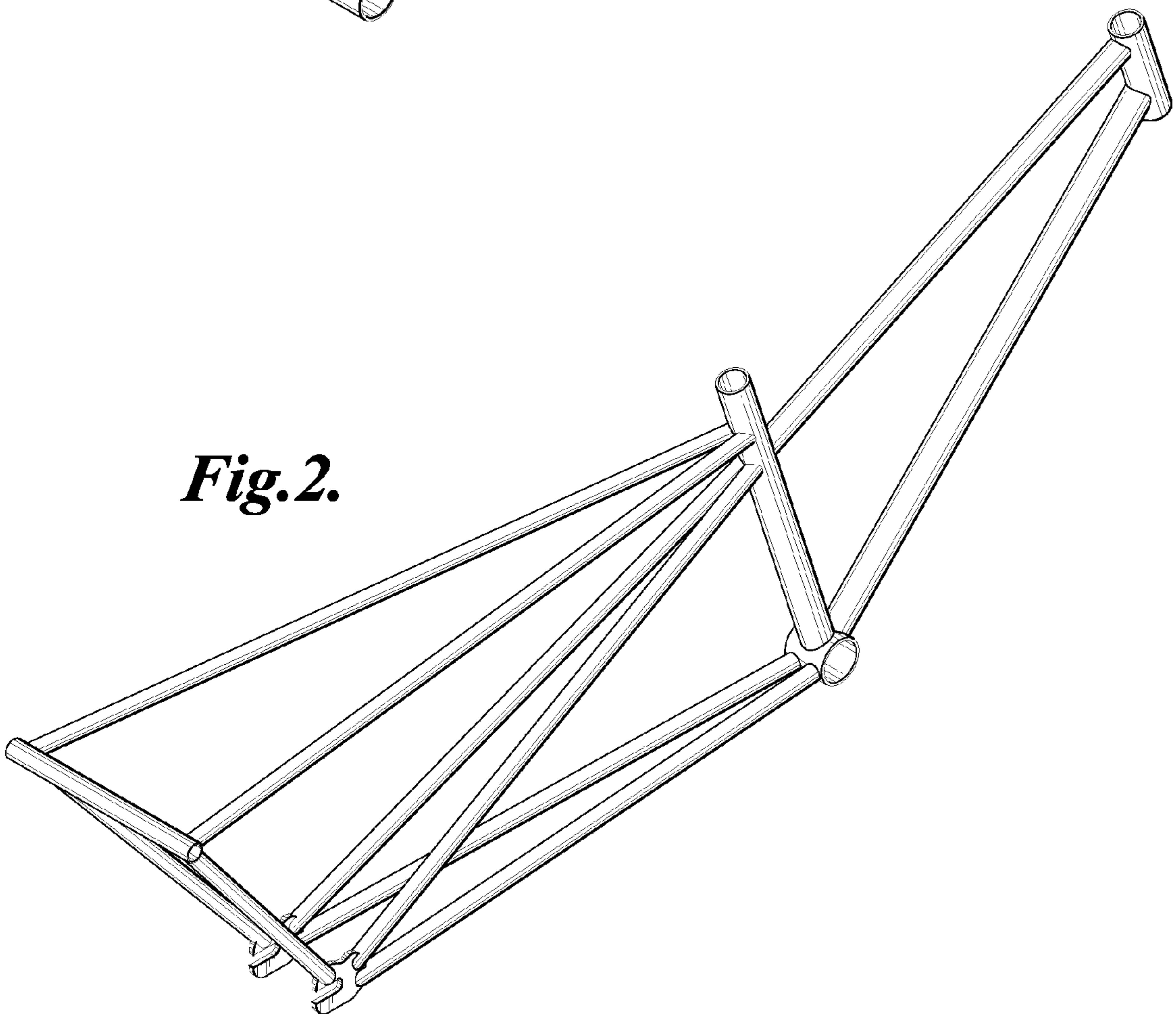
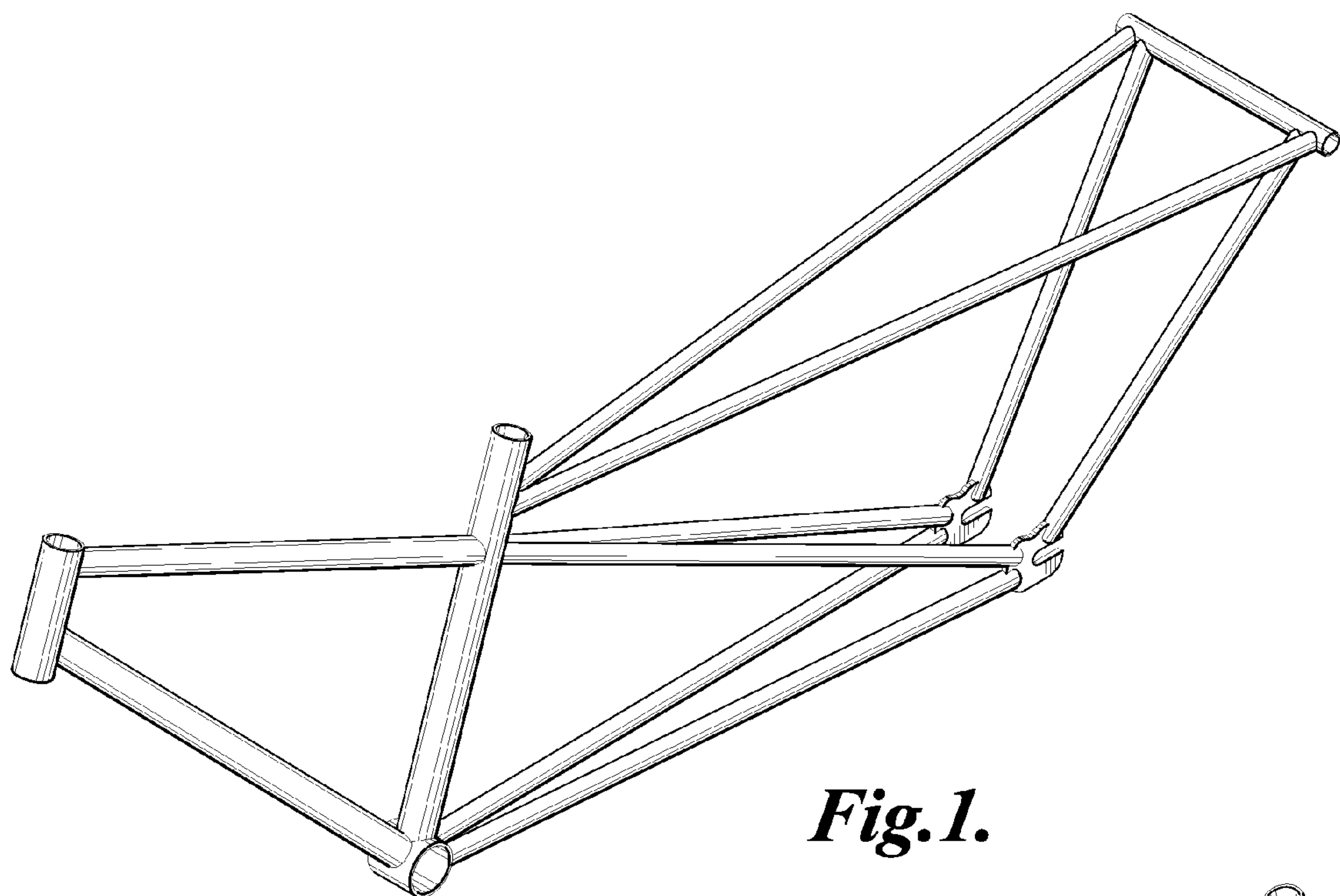

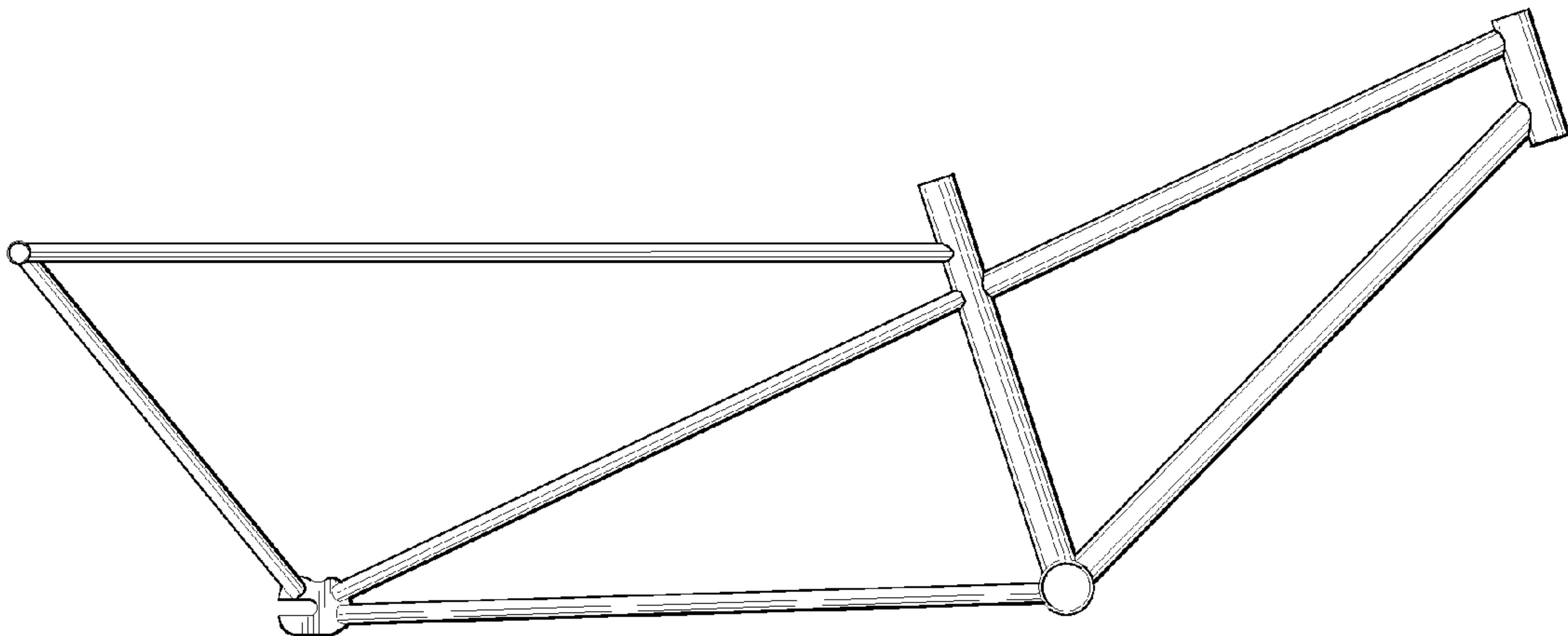

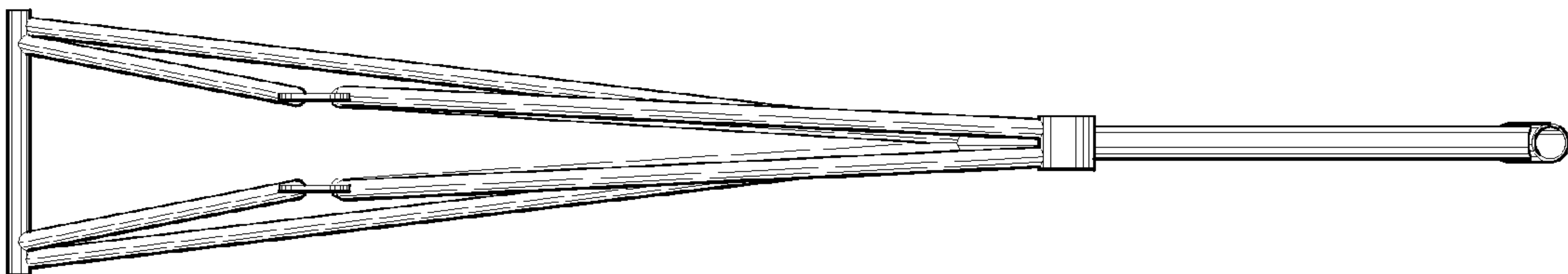

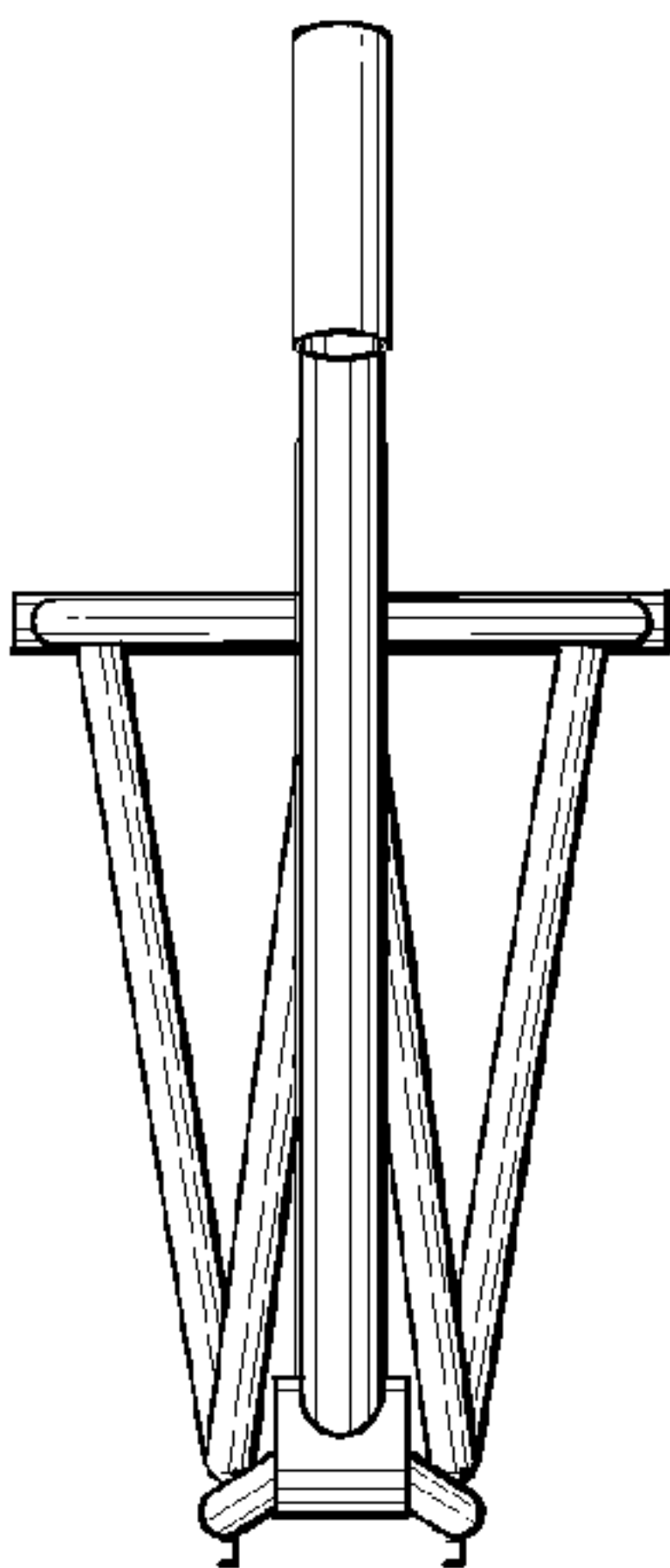

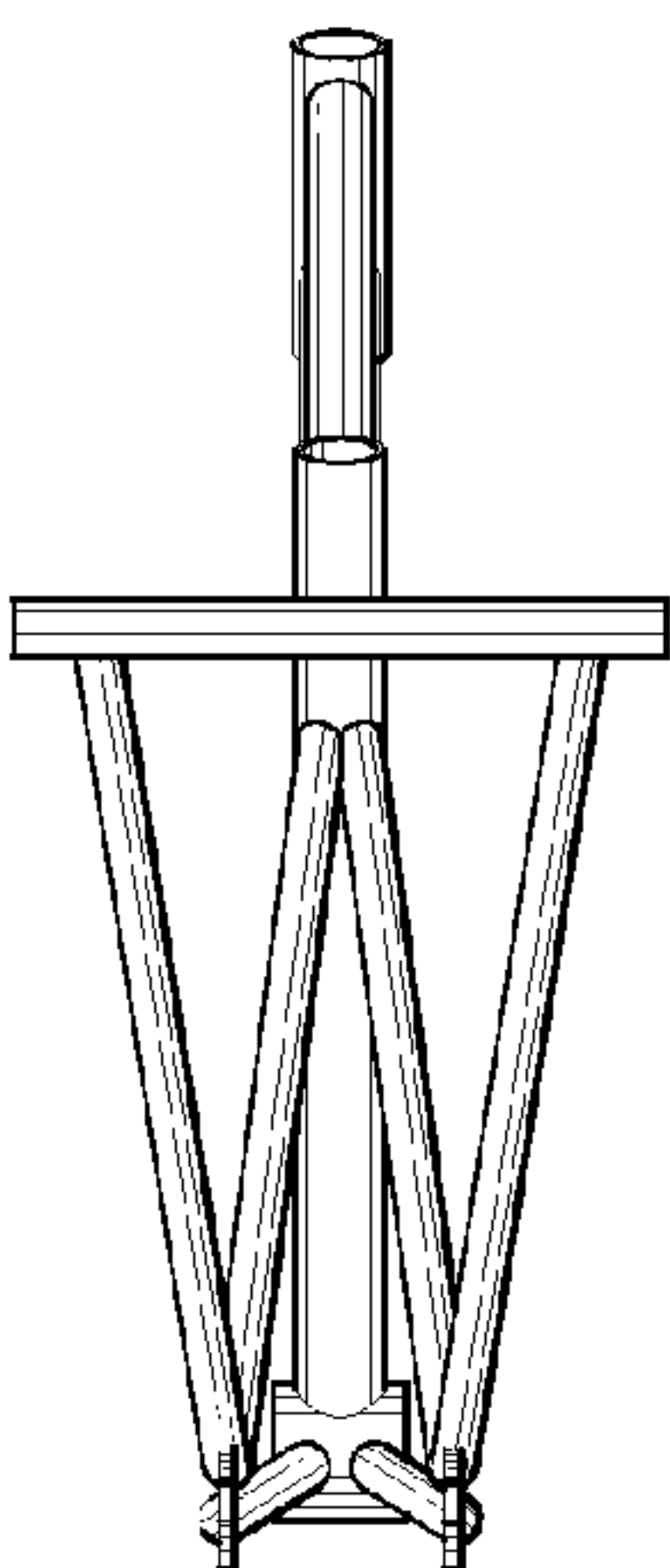
