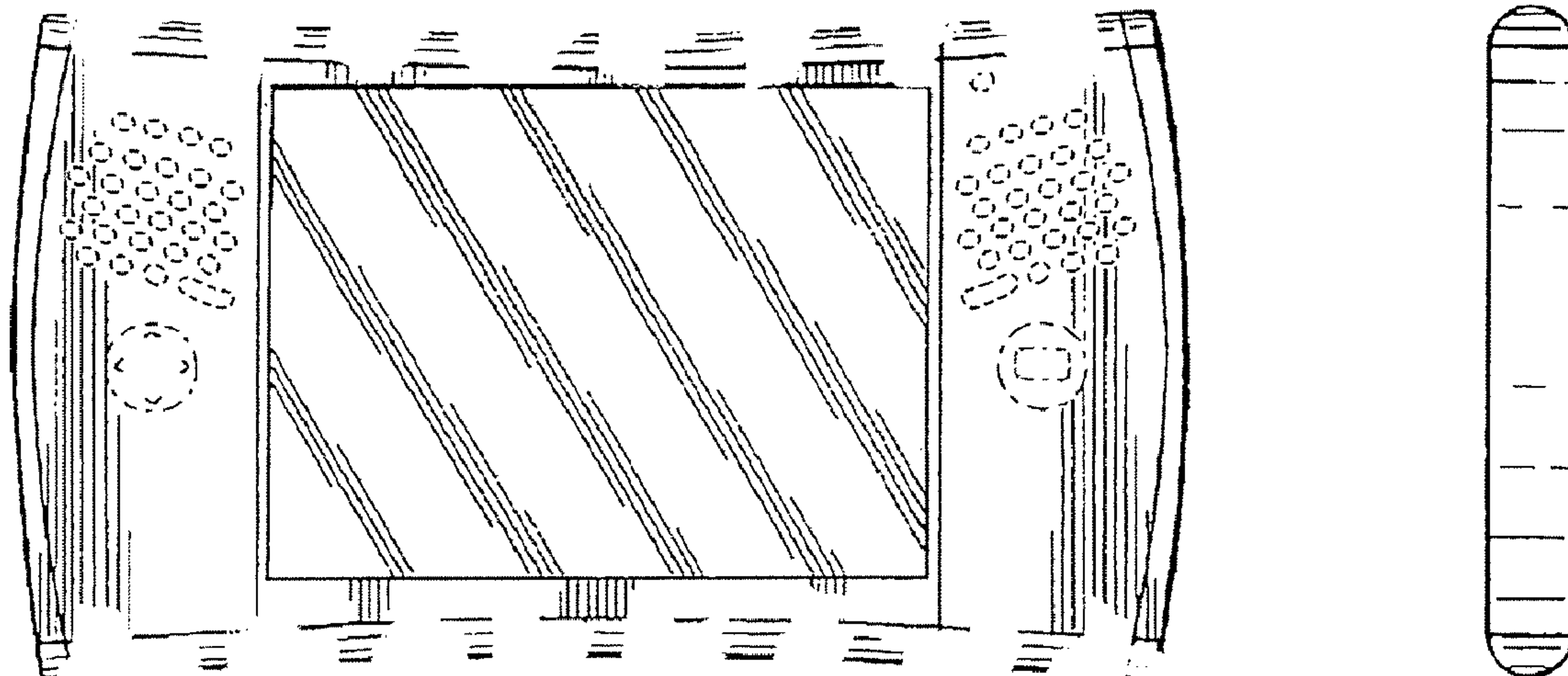
The ornamental design for a hand-held computer, as shown and described.

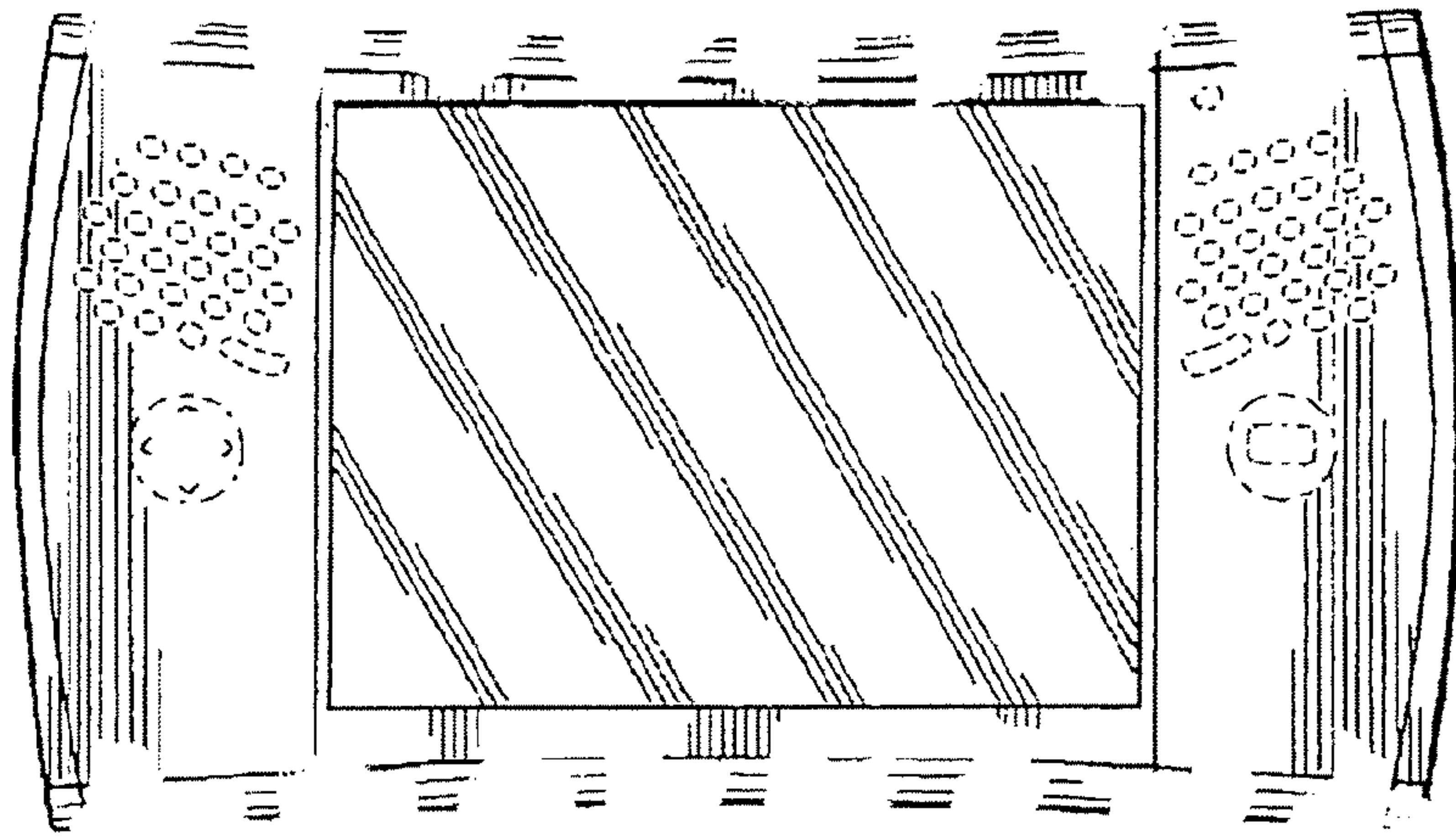
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a hand-held computer; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

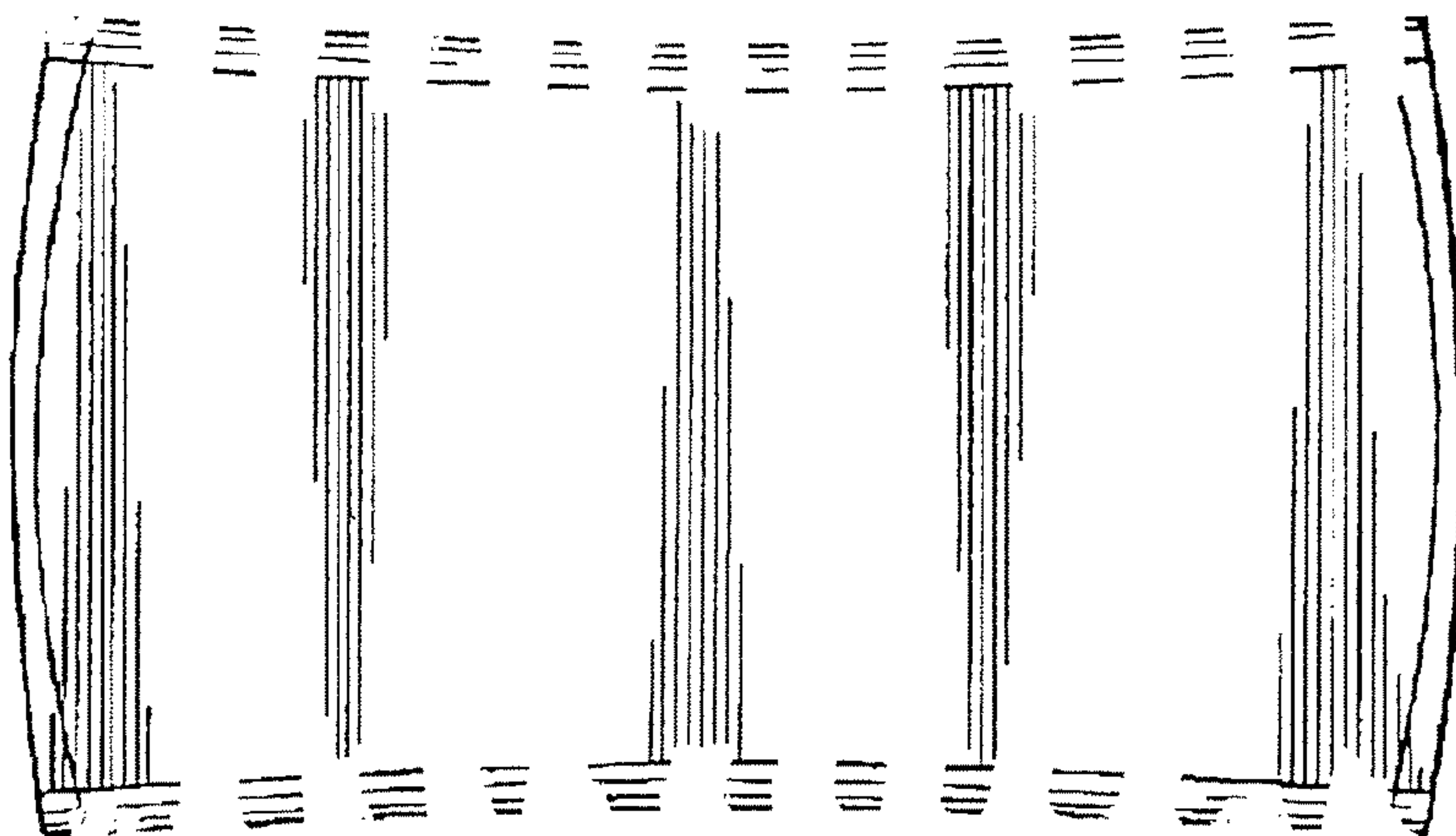




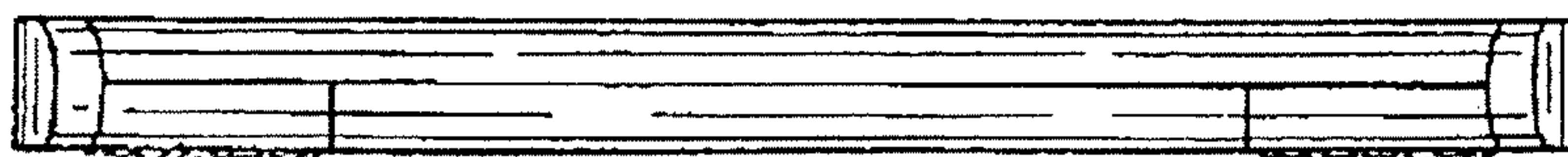

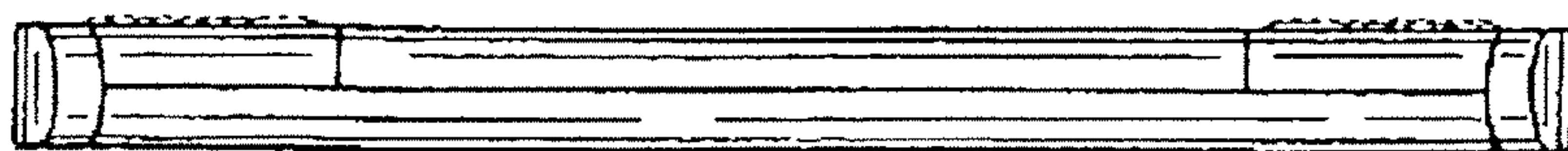
