FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof which is a mirror image of the left side thereof;

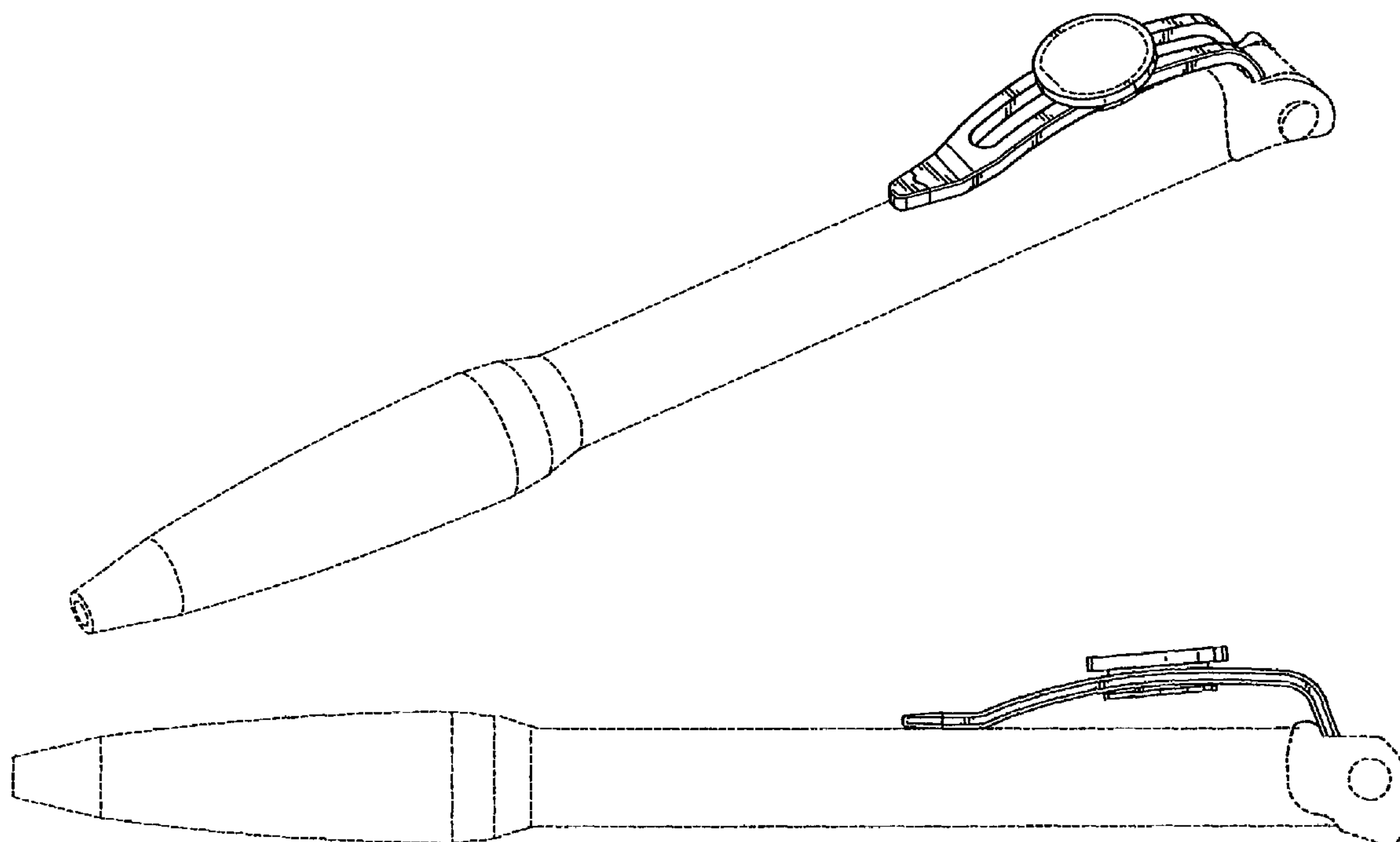
FIG. 4 is a back elevational view thereof;

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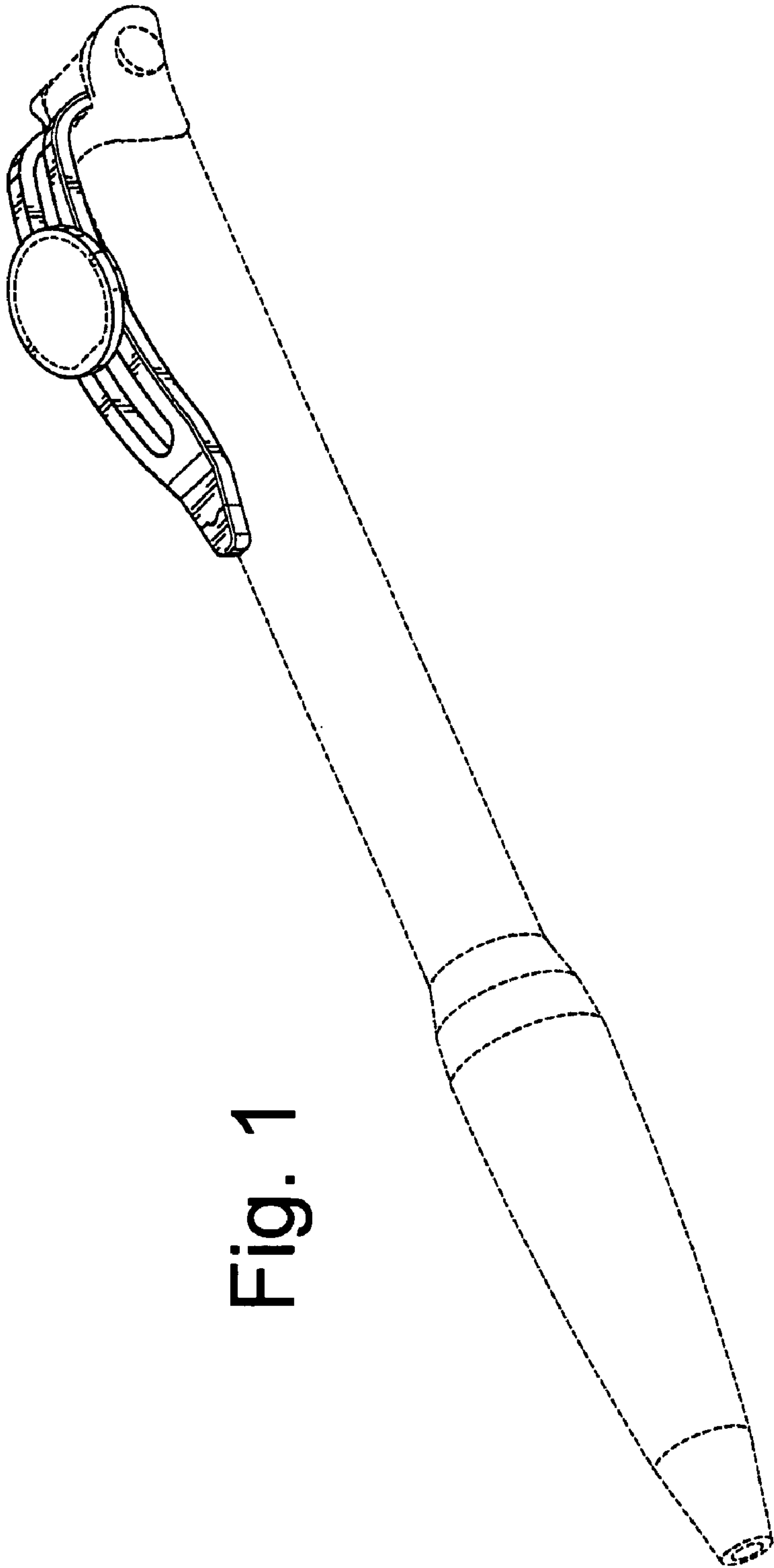
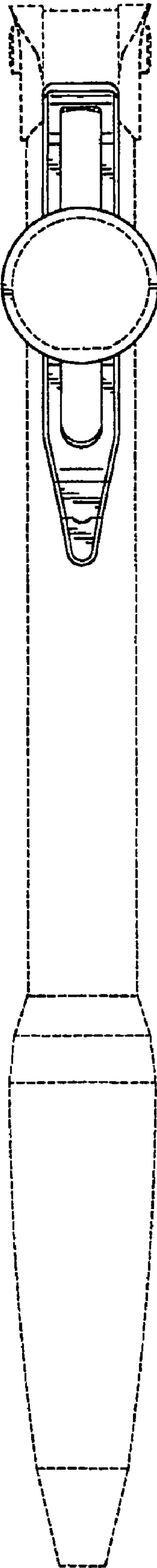

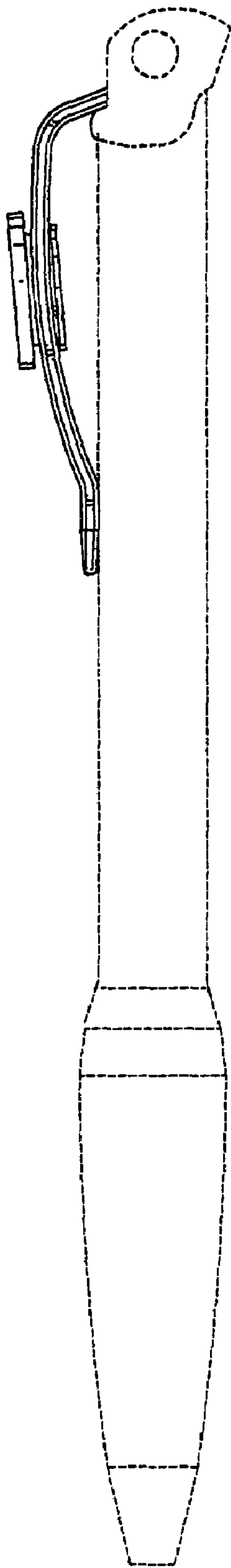

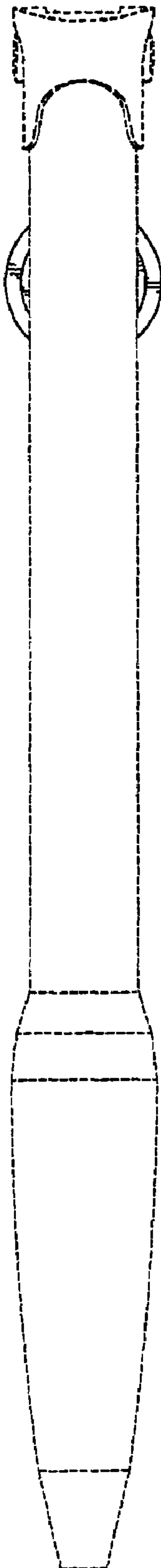

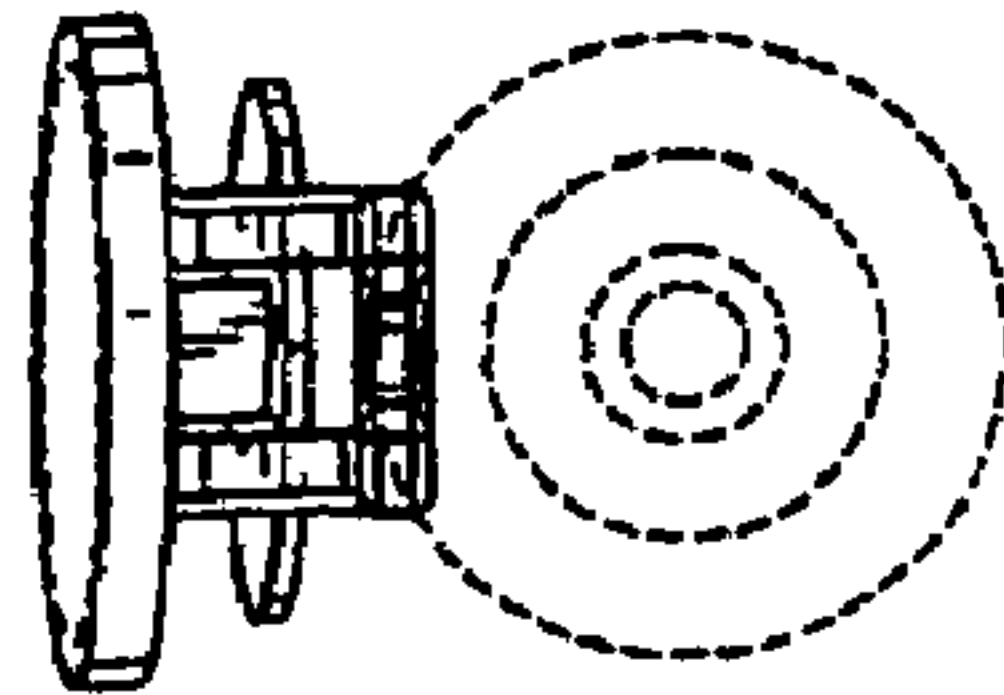

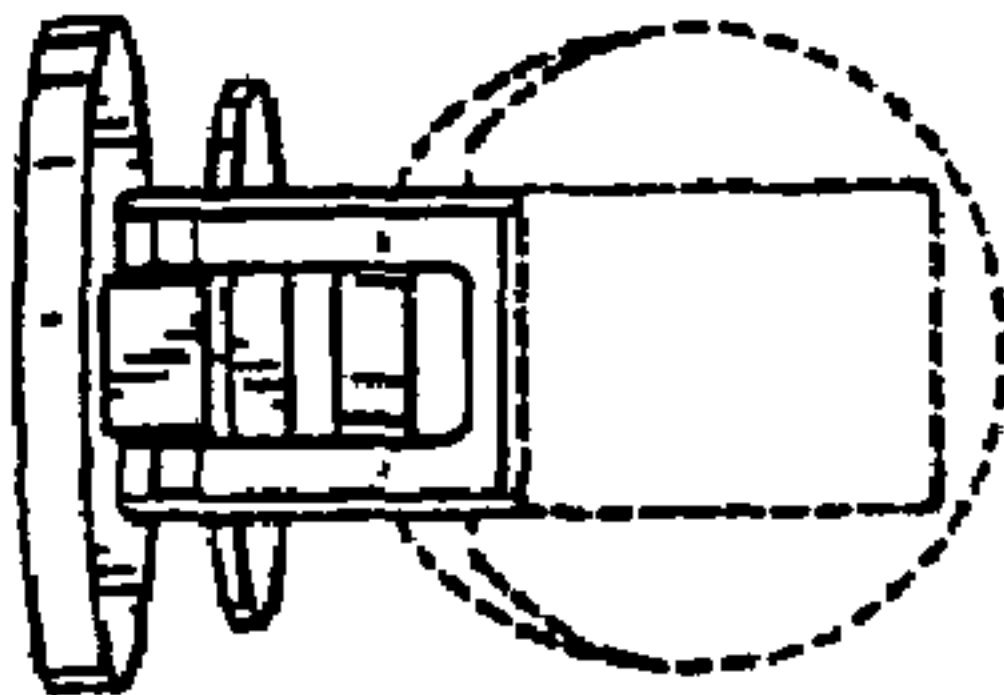
