for electronic equipment depicted in FIG. 1.

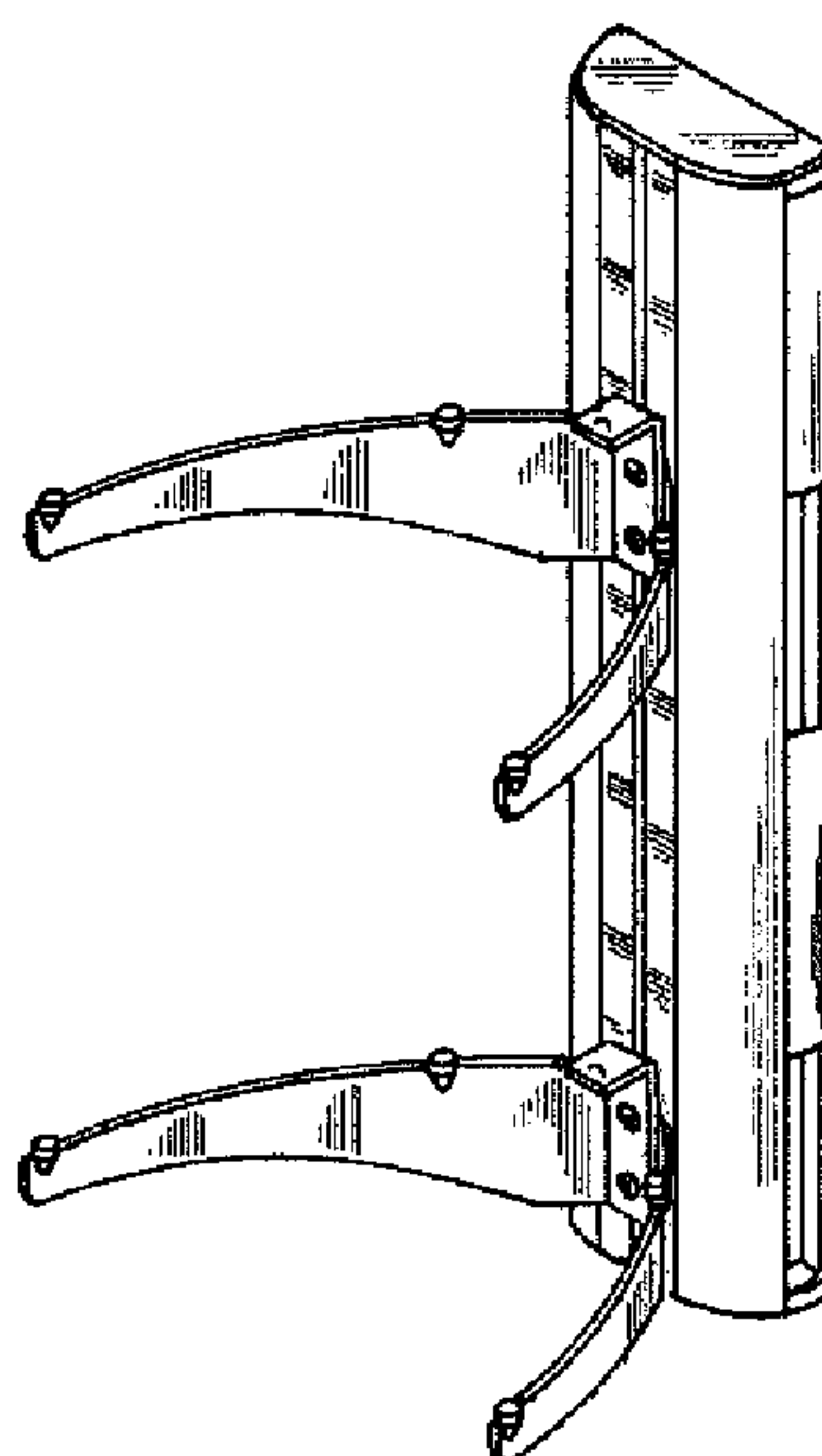

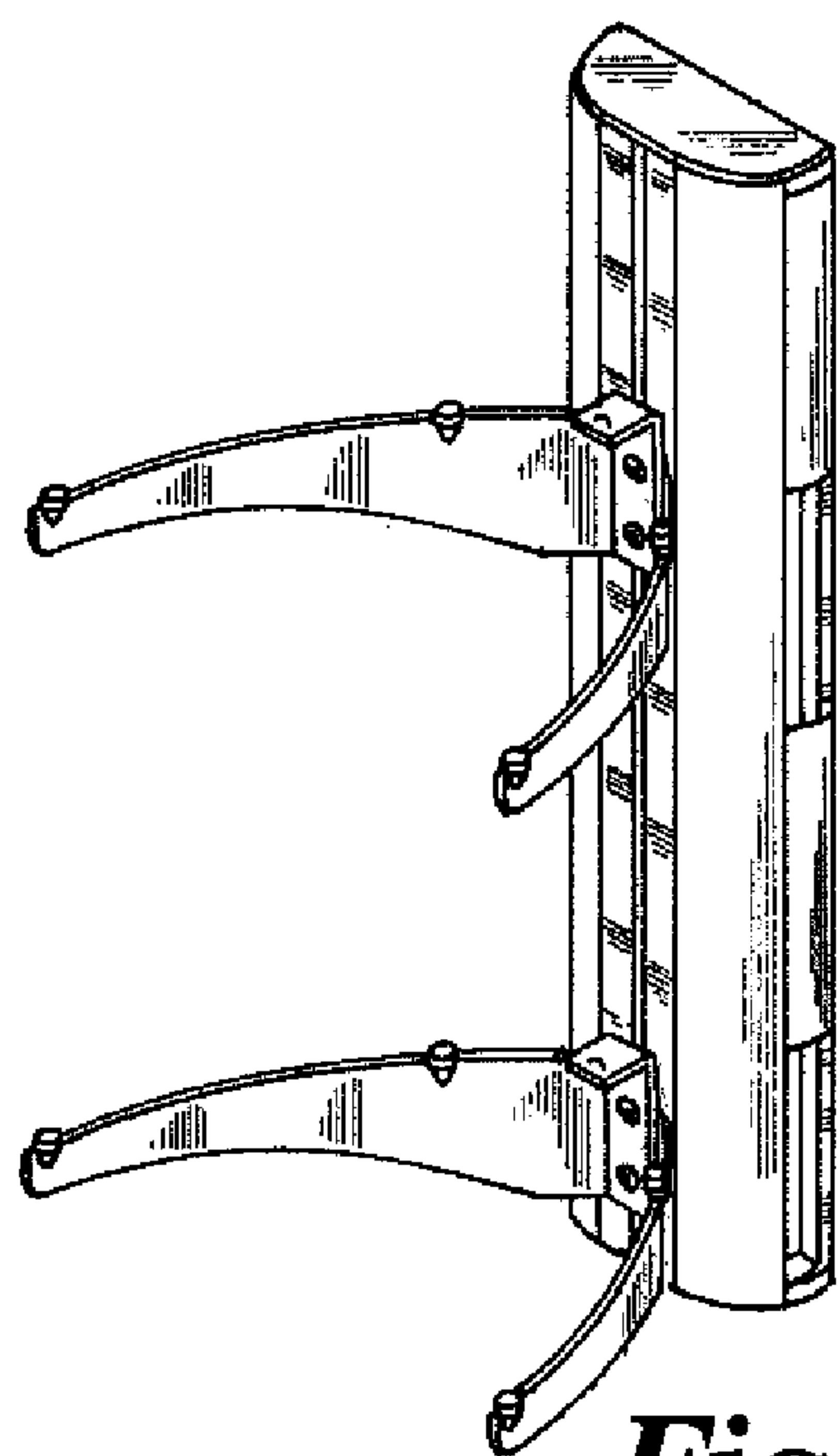

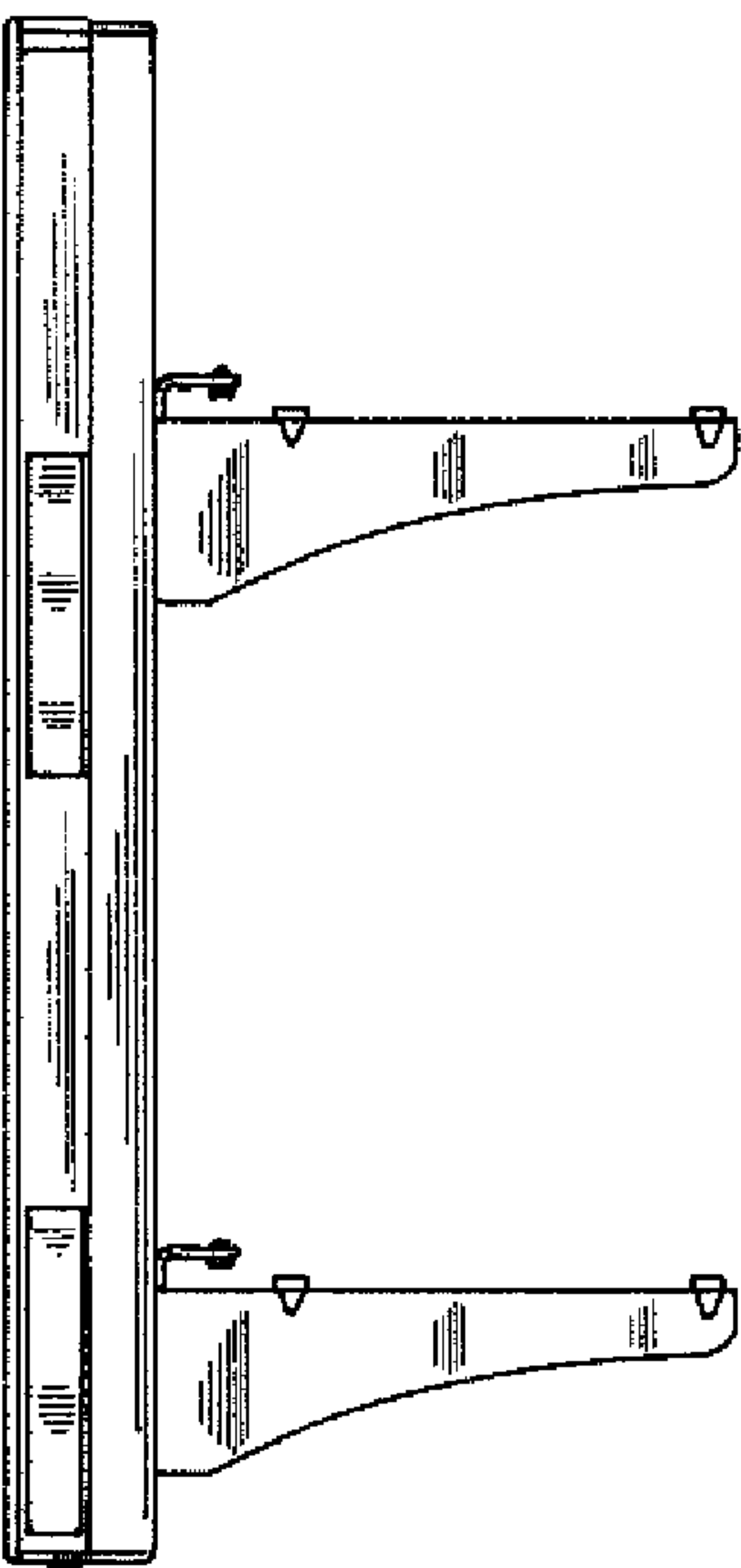

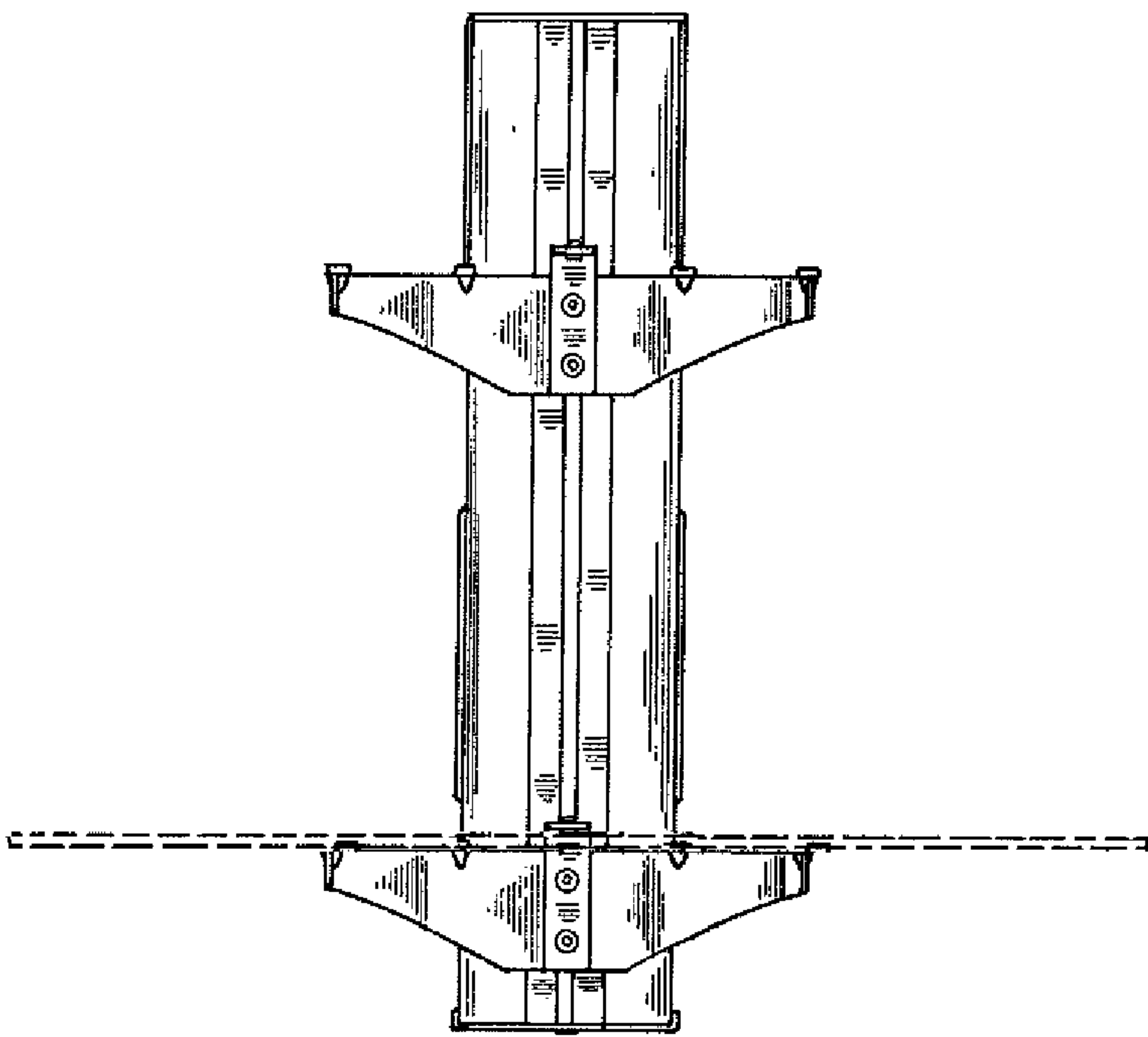

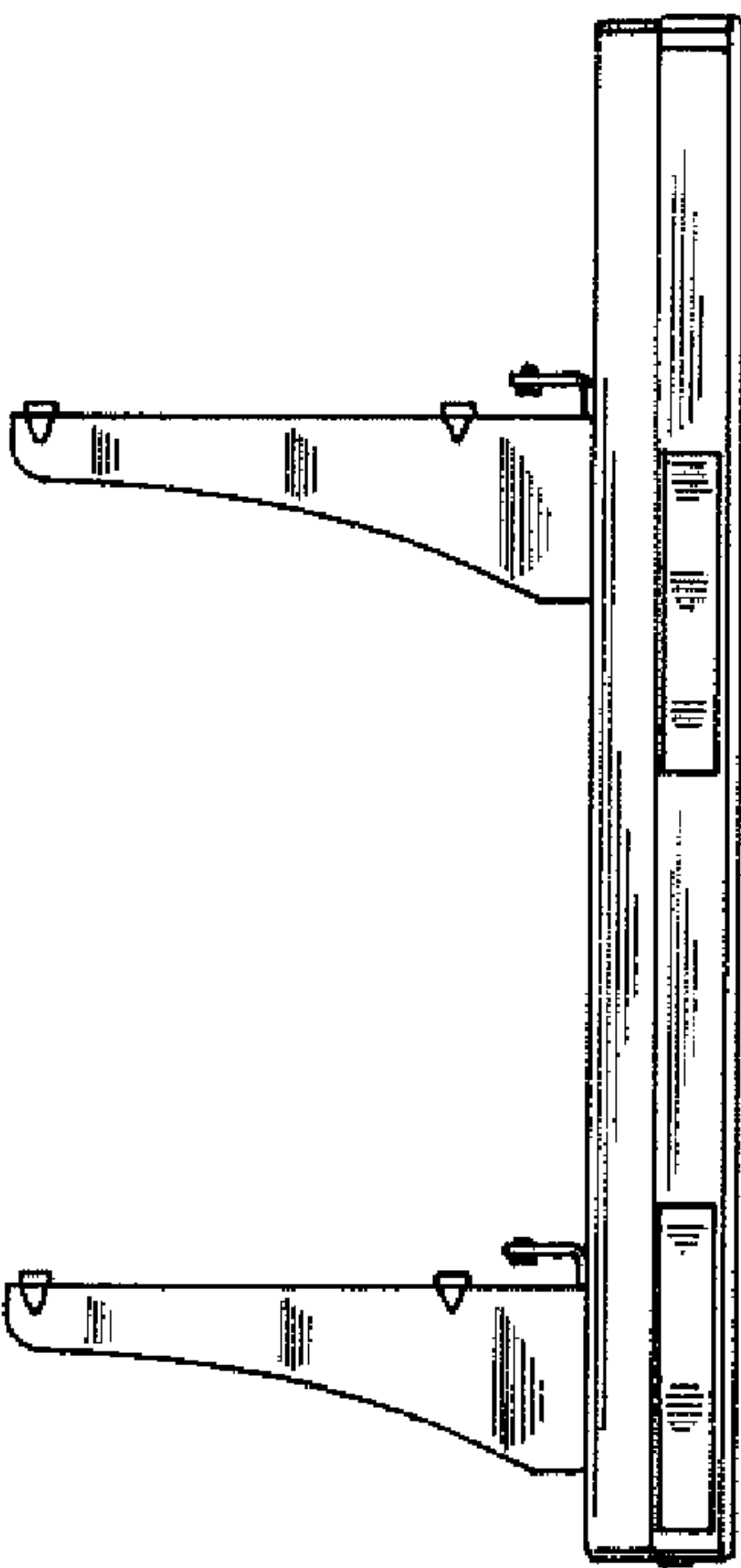

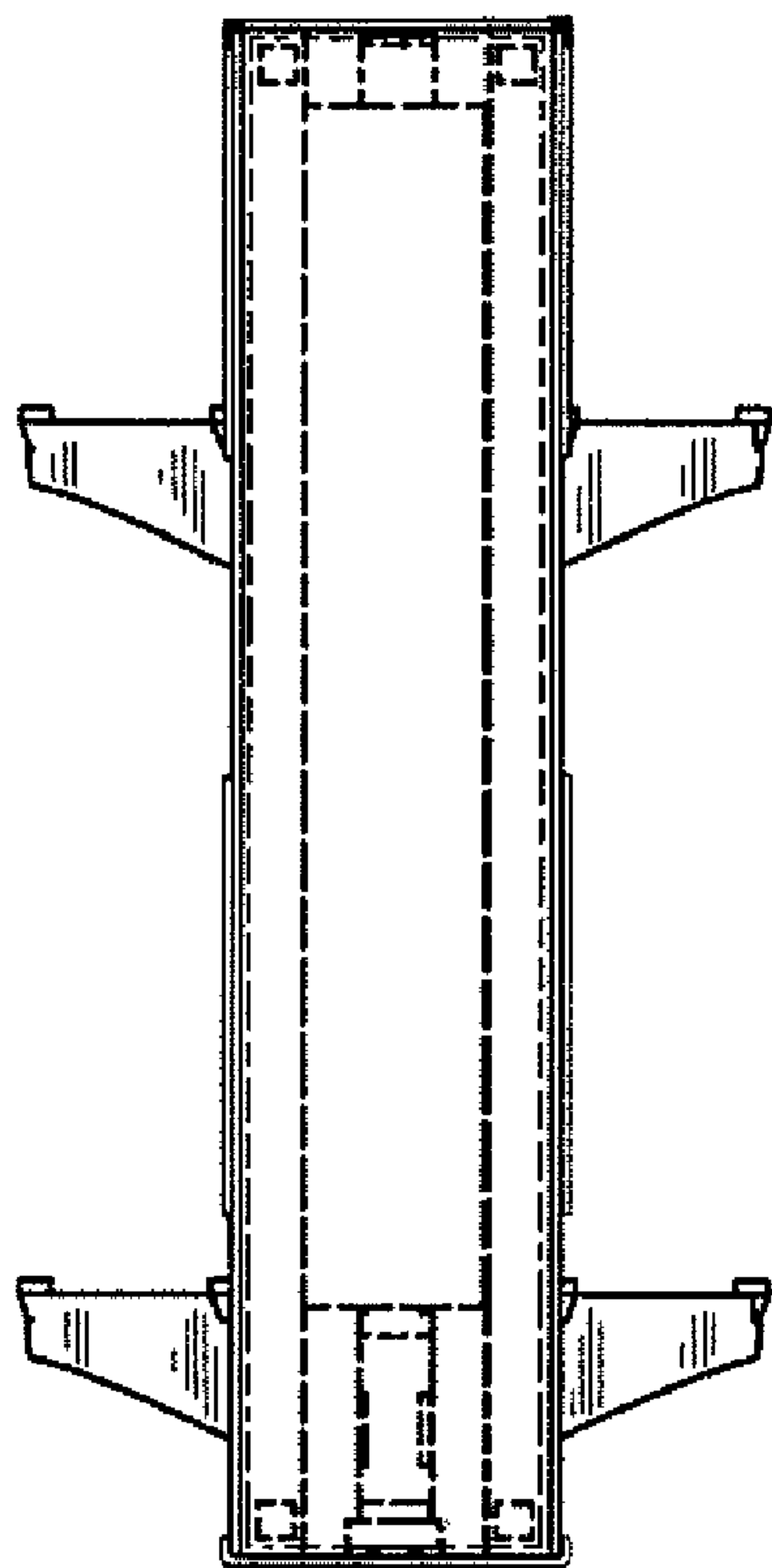

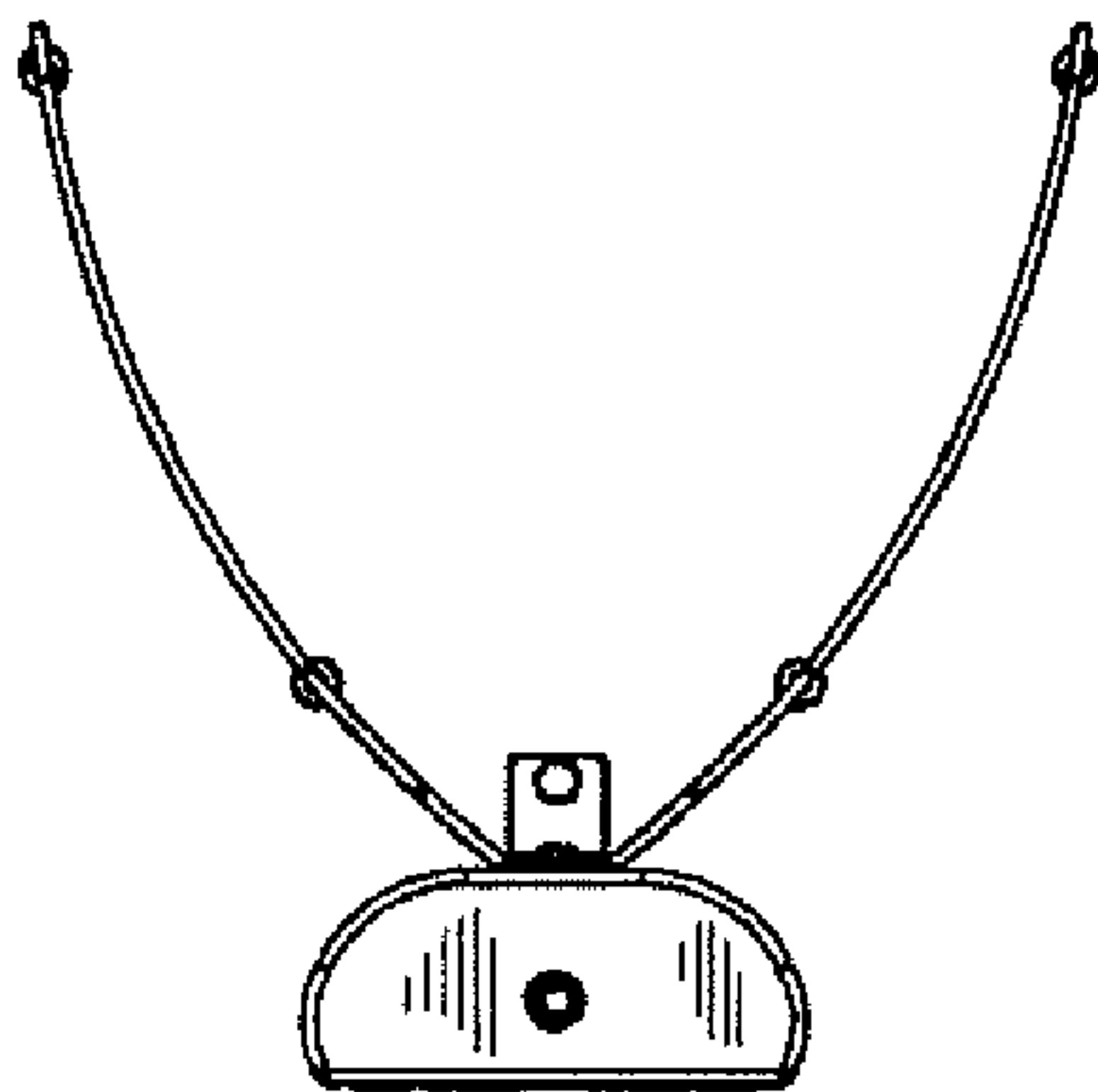

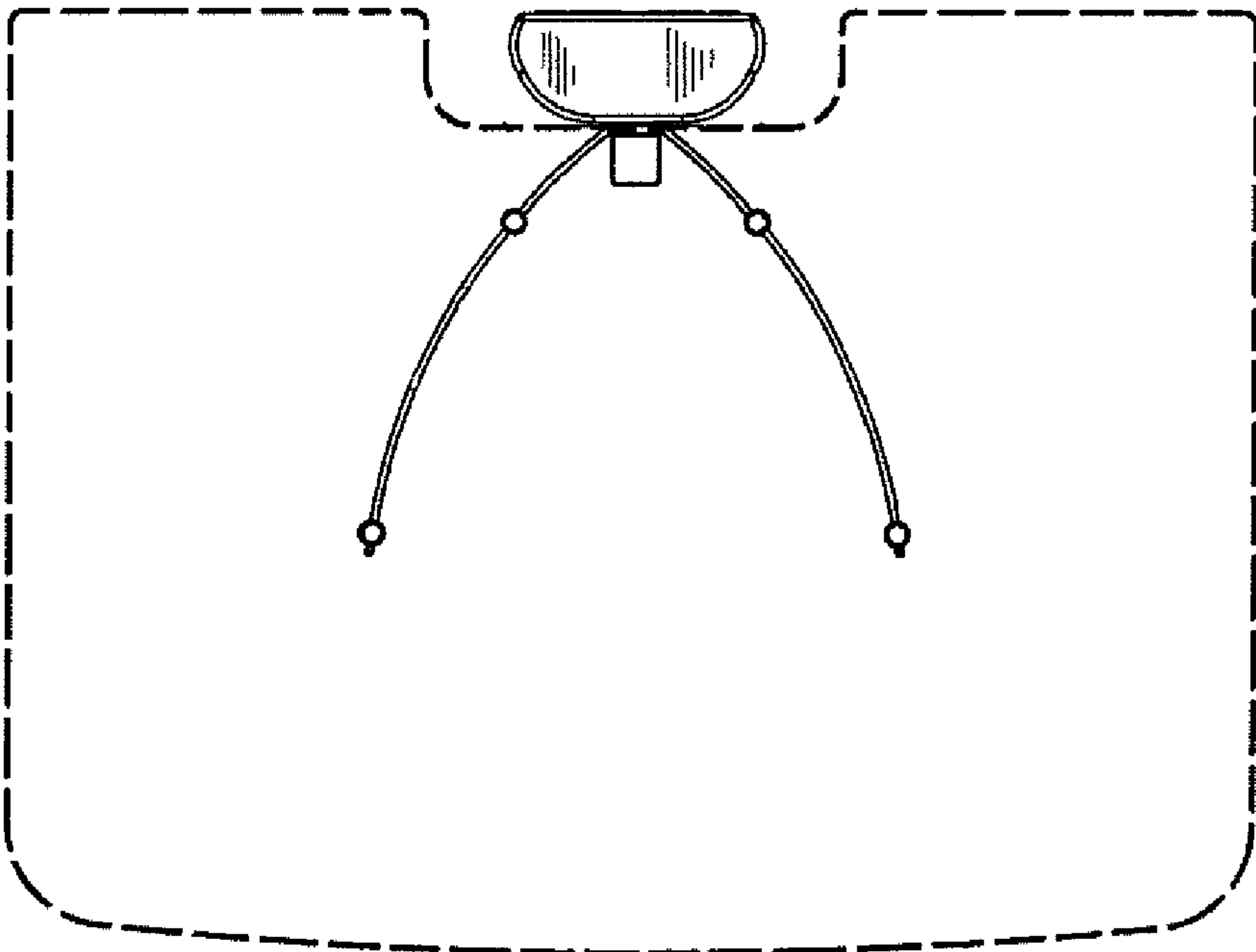
