FIG. 2 is a front view showing a second embodiment thereof.

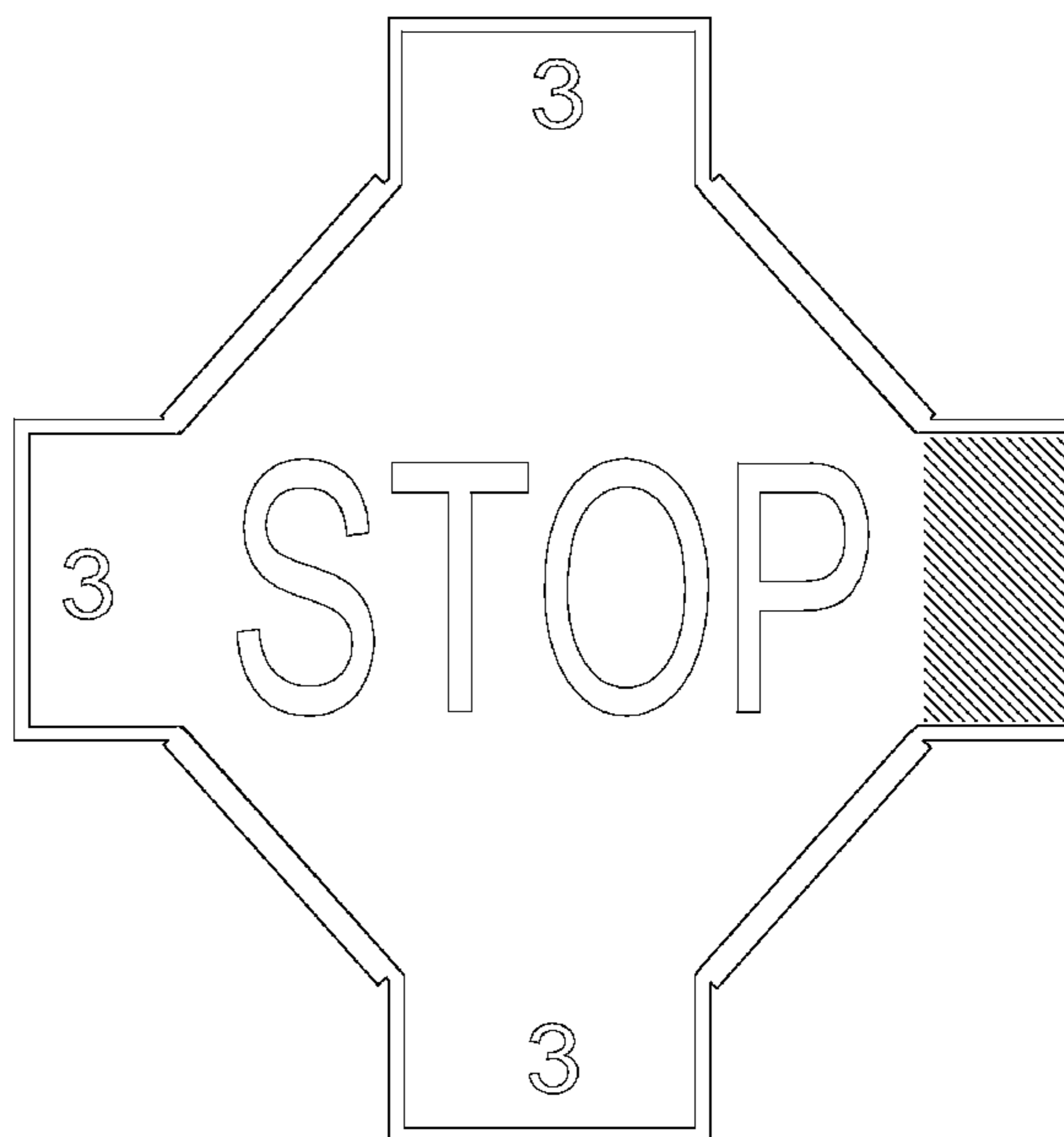
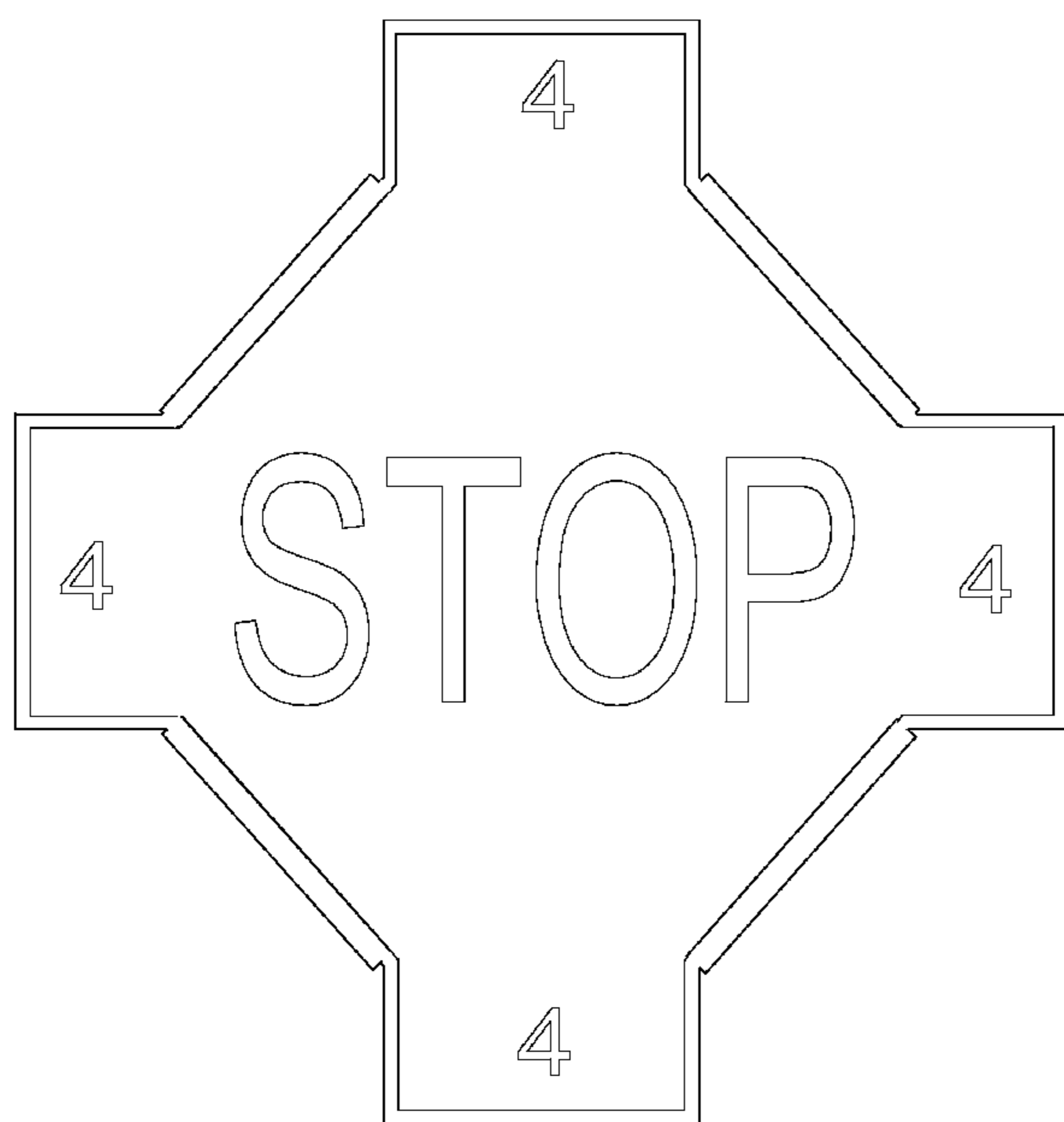
The shade lines in FIG. 2 represent the color green.

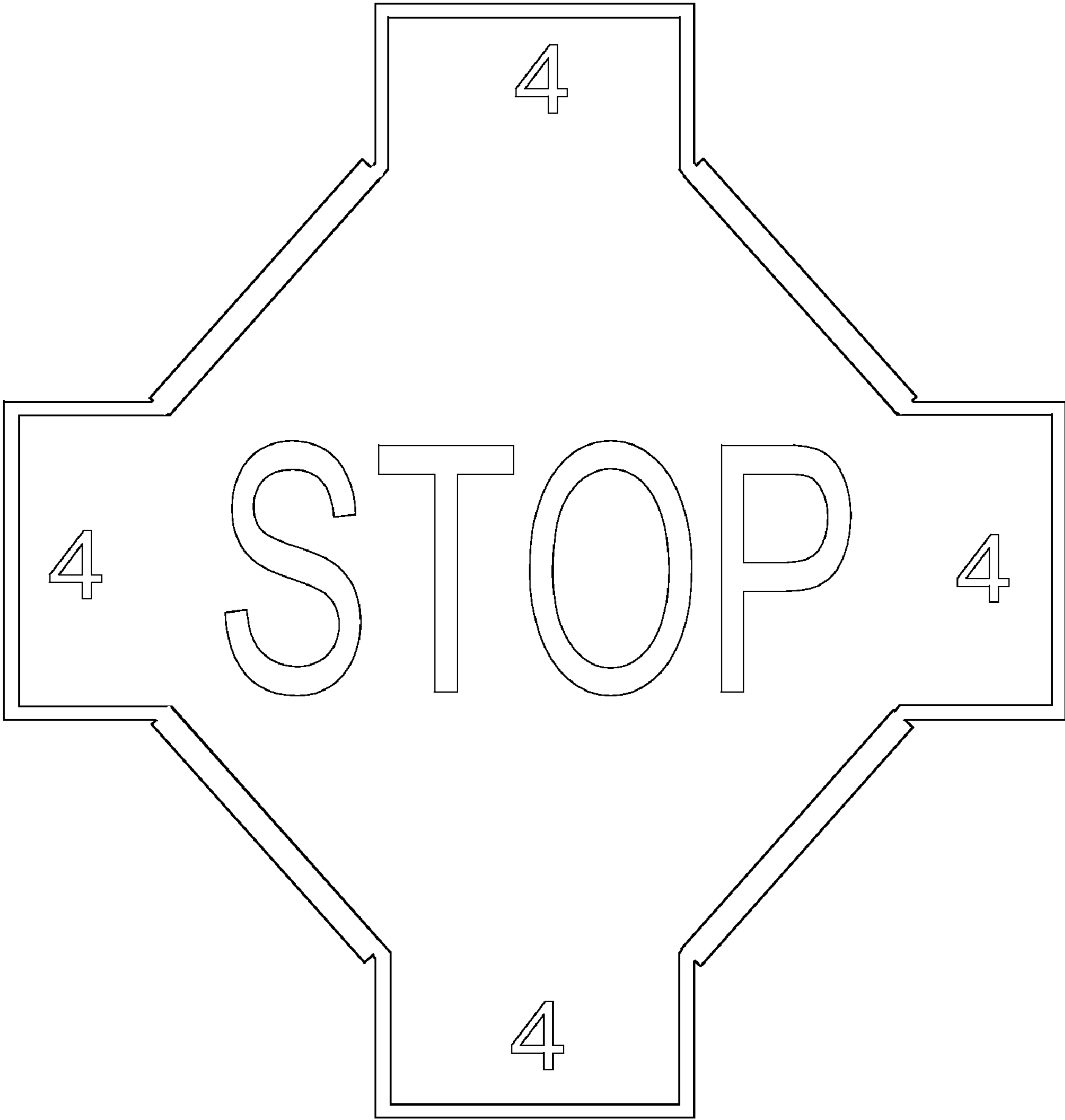

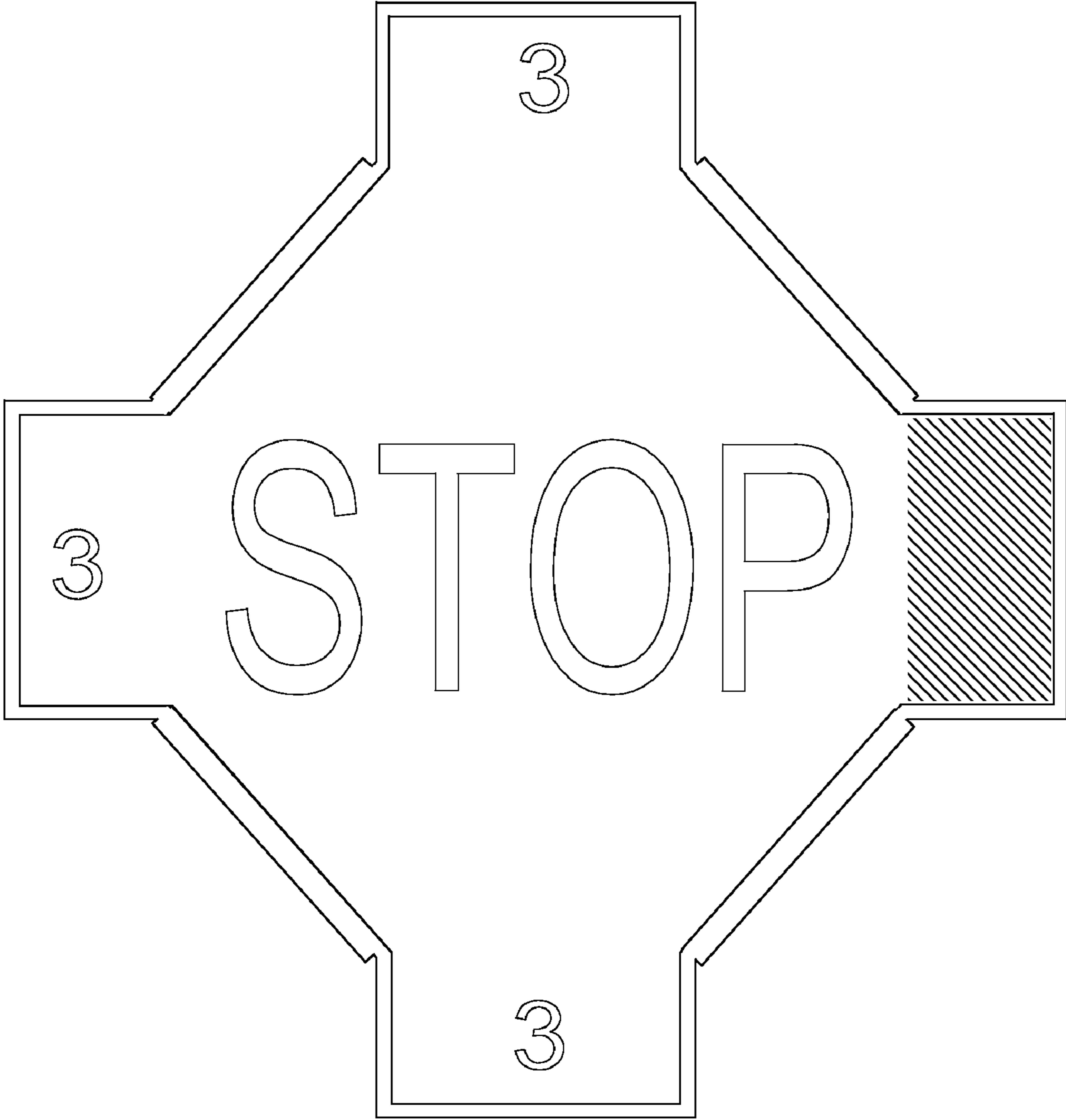
