site side being a mirror image thereof;

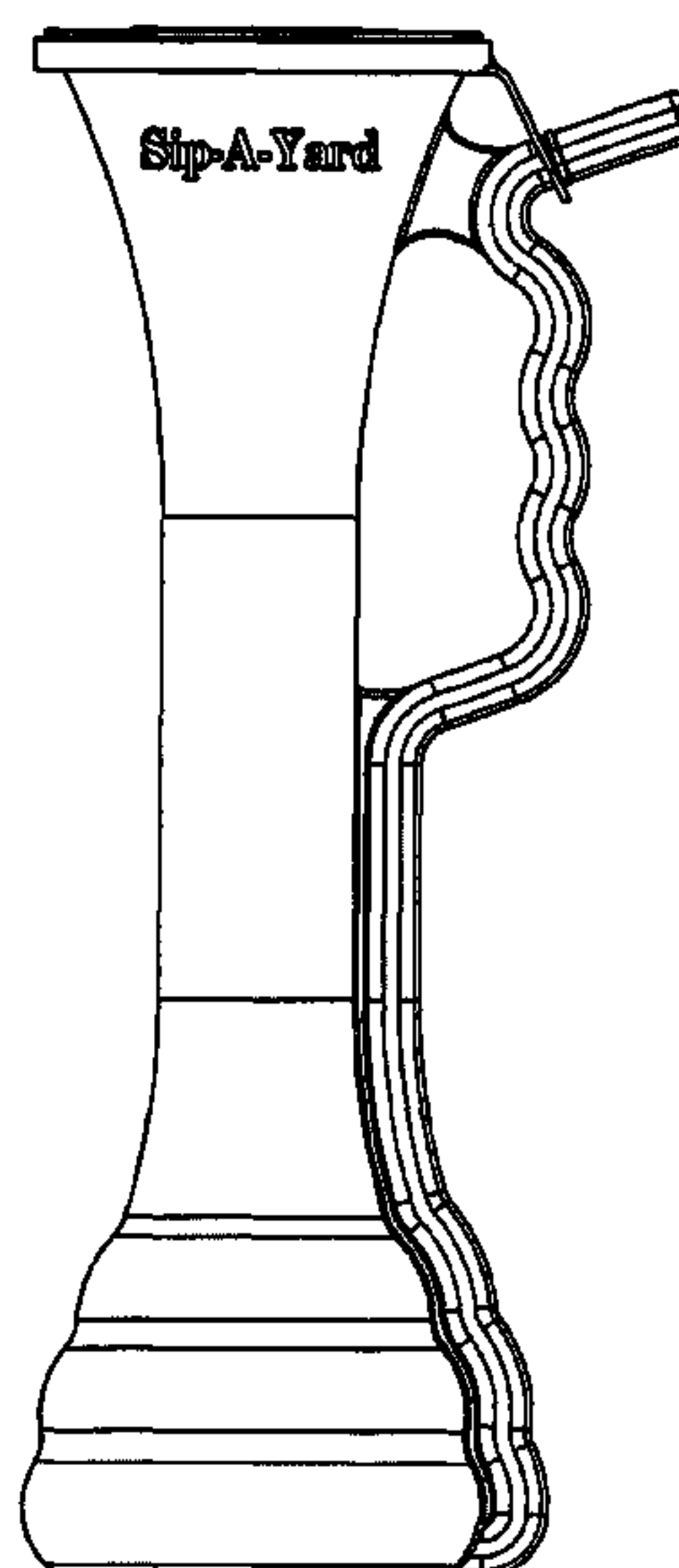
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;

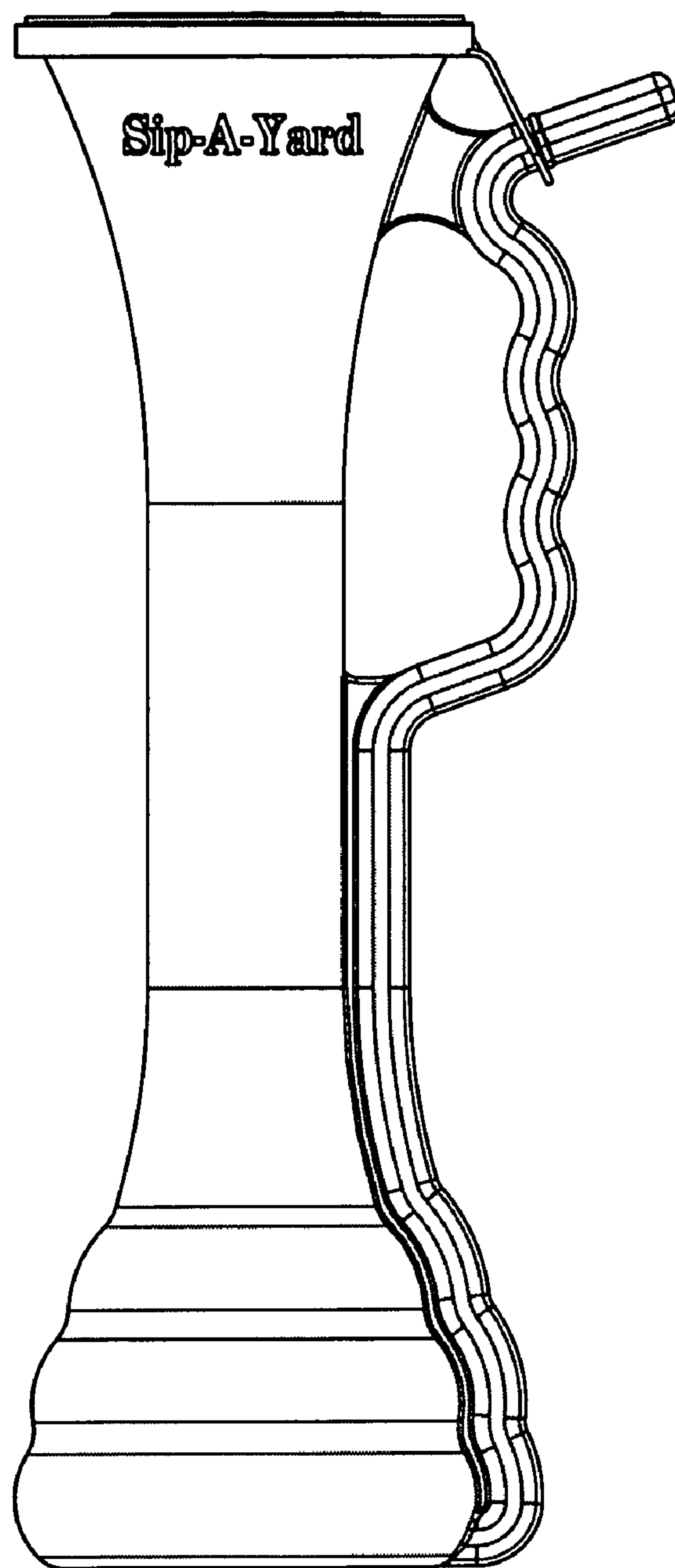

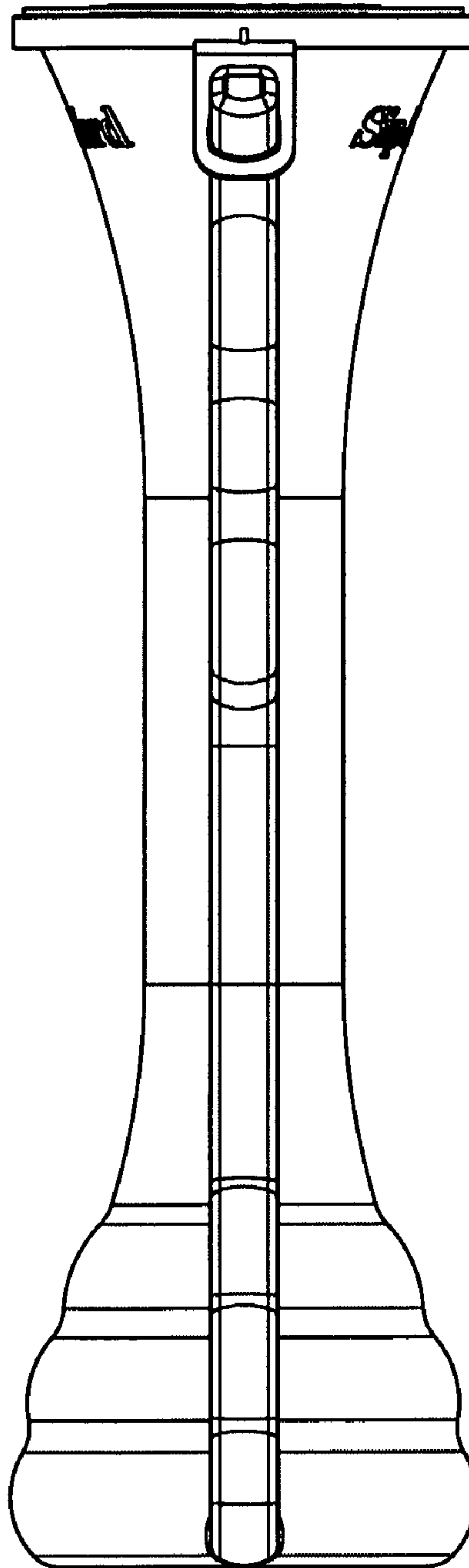

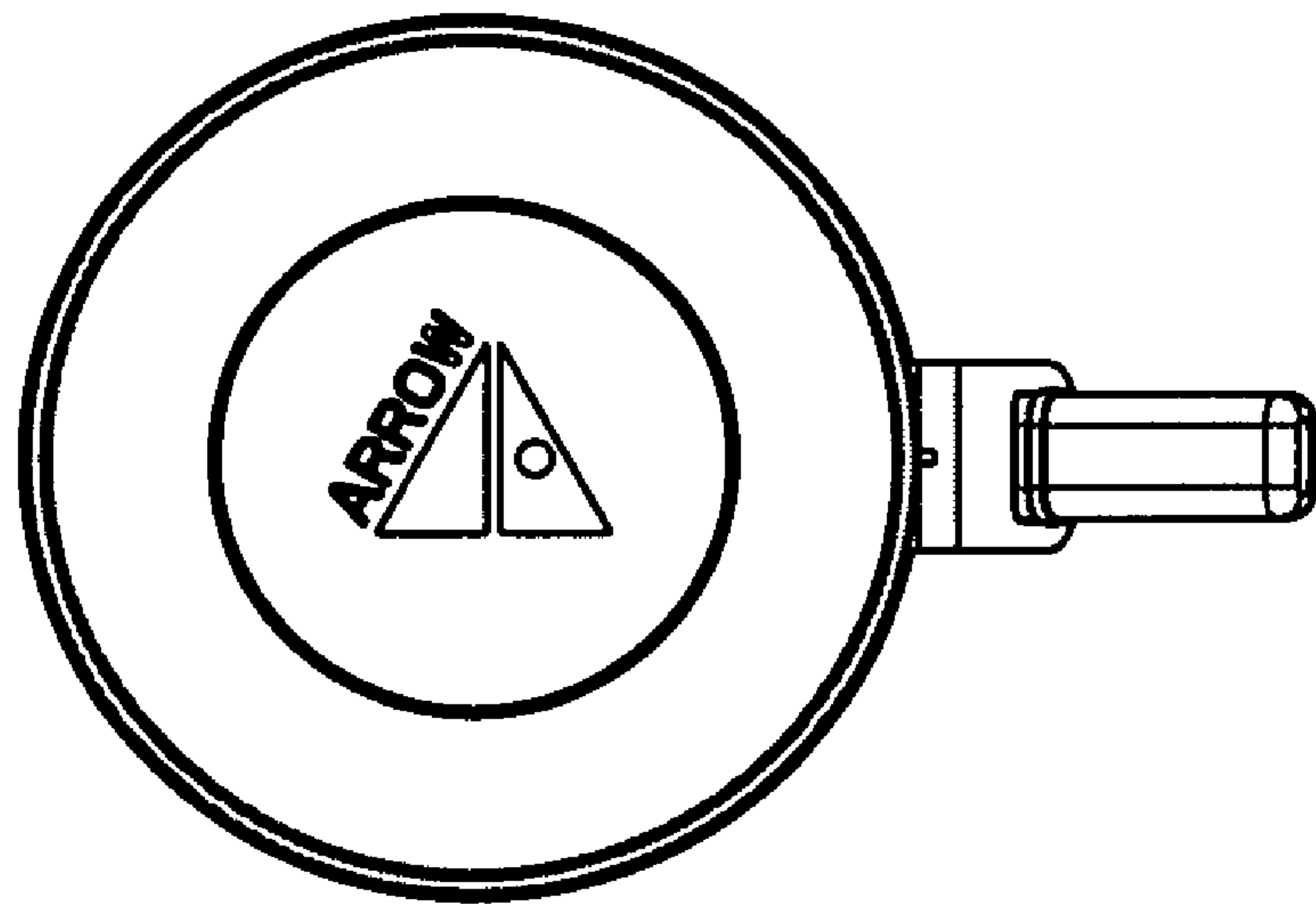

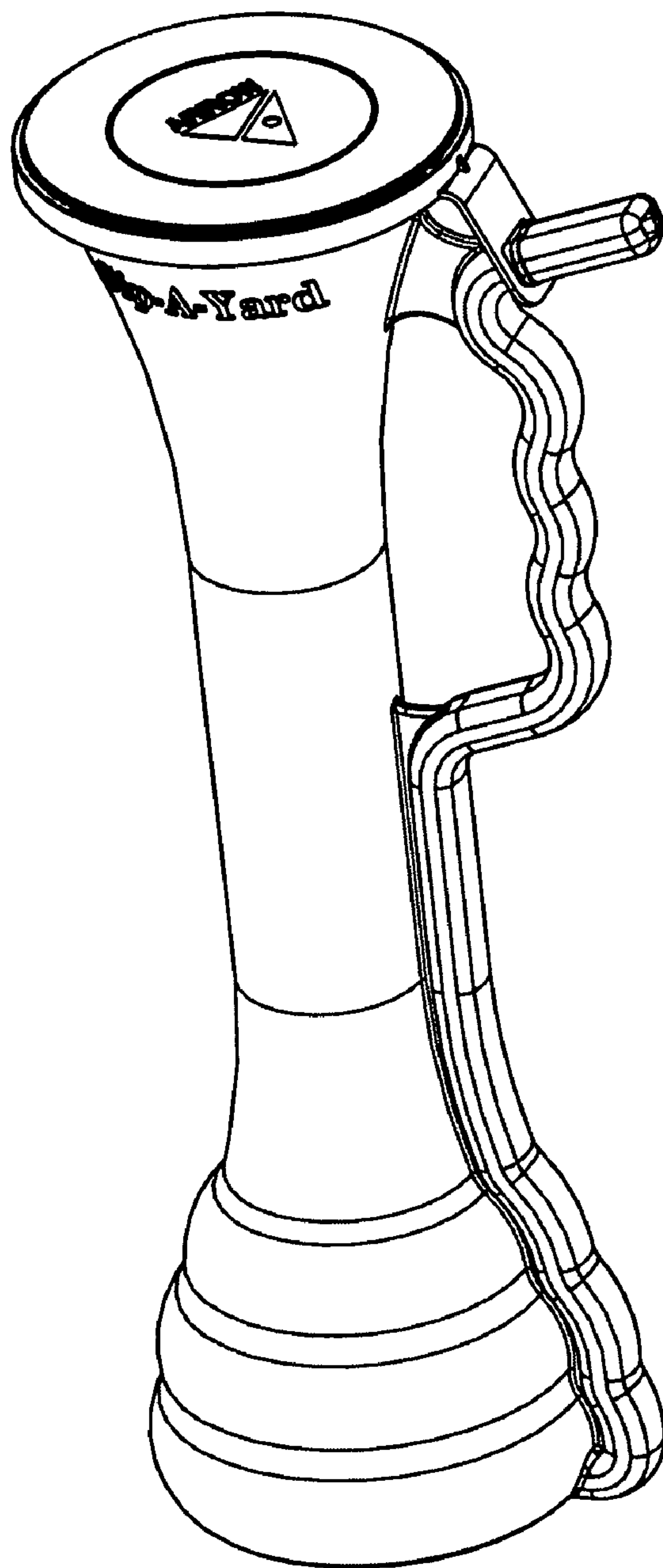

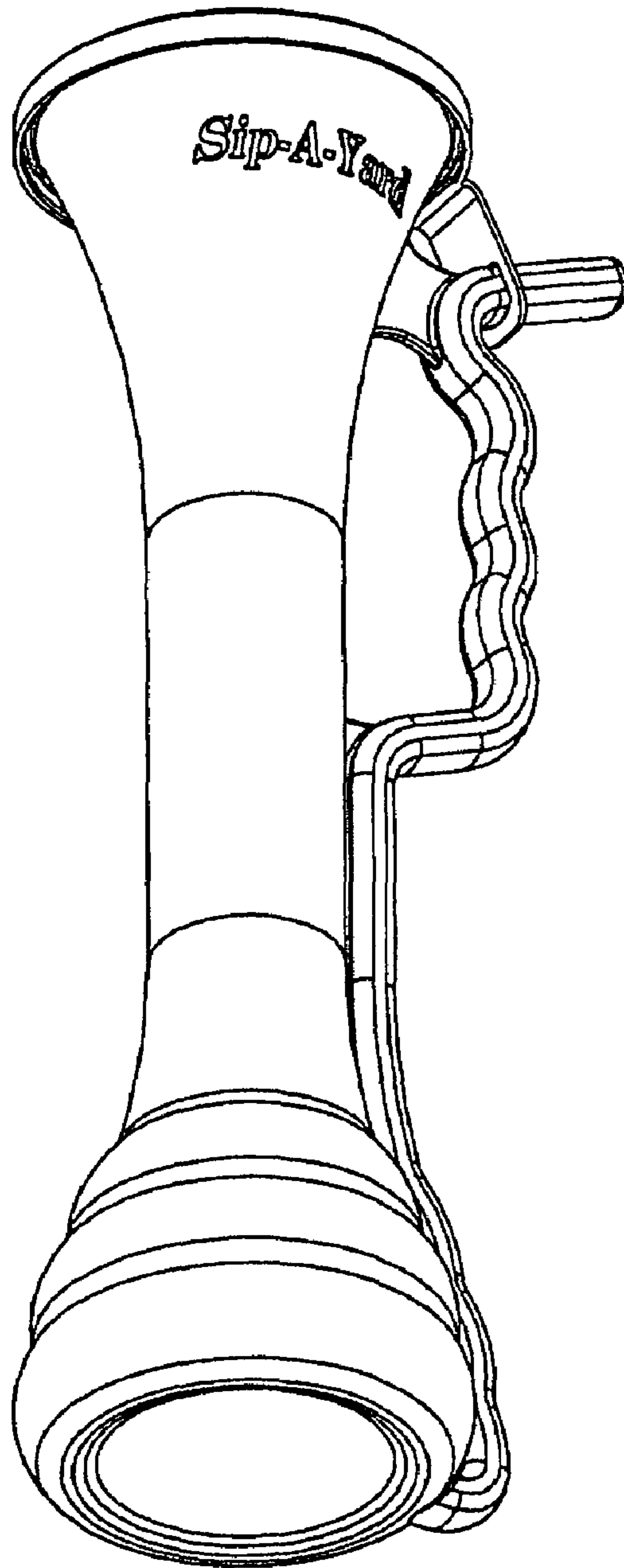

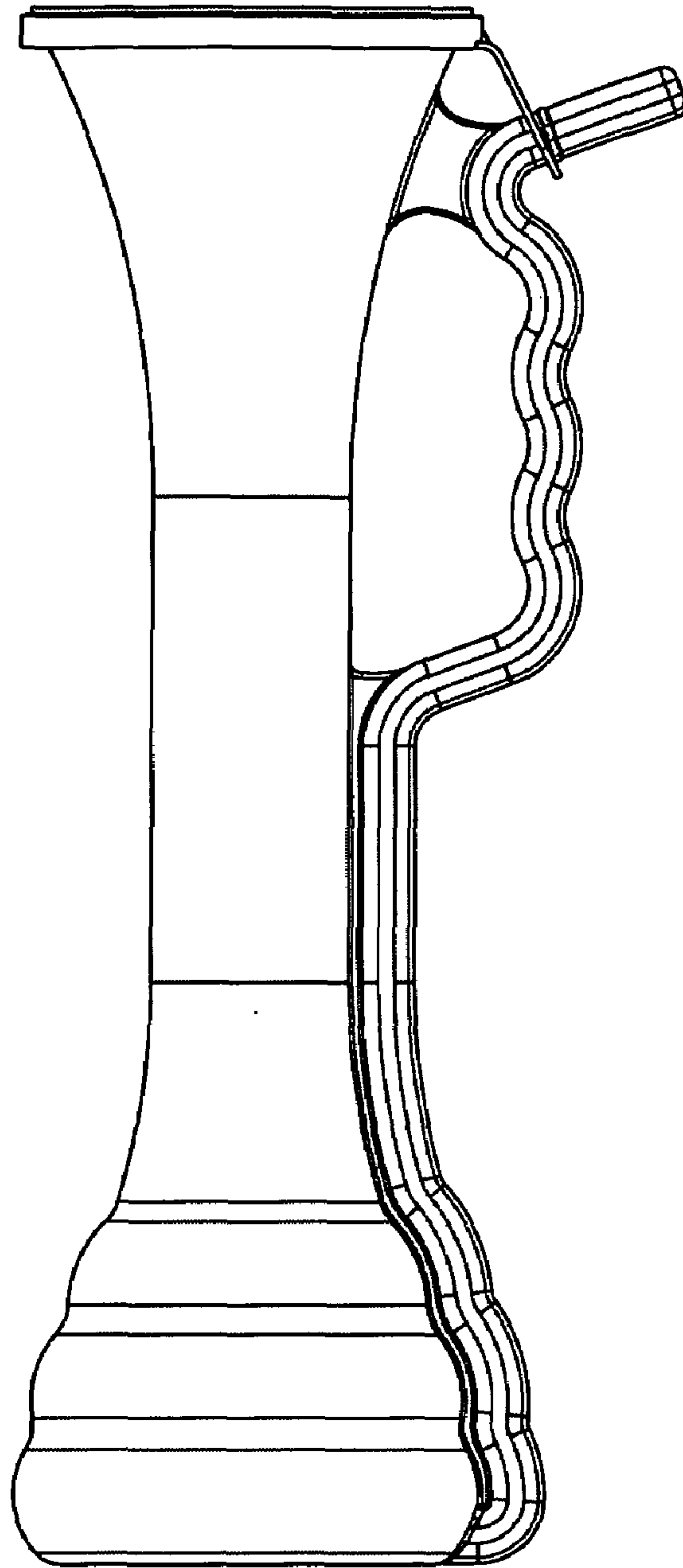

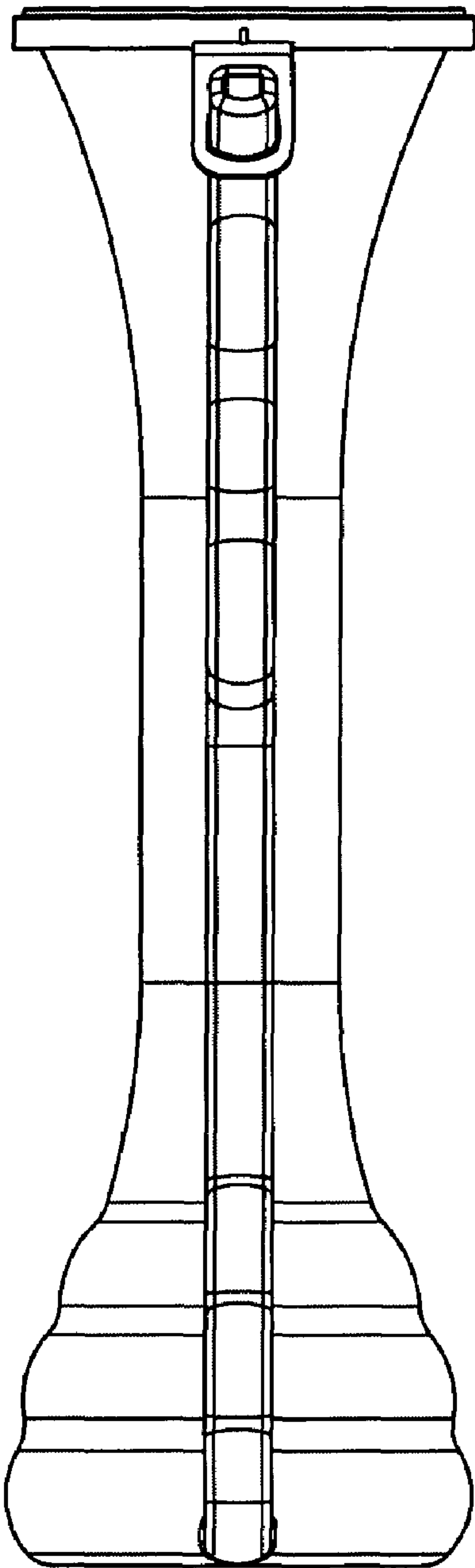

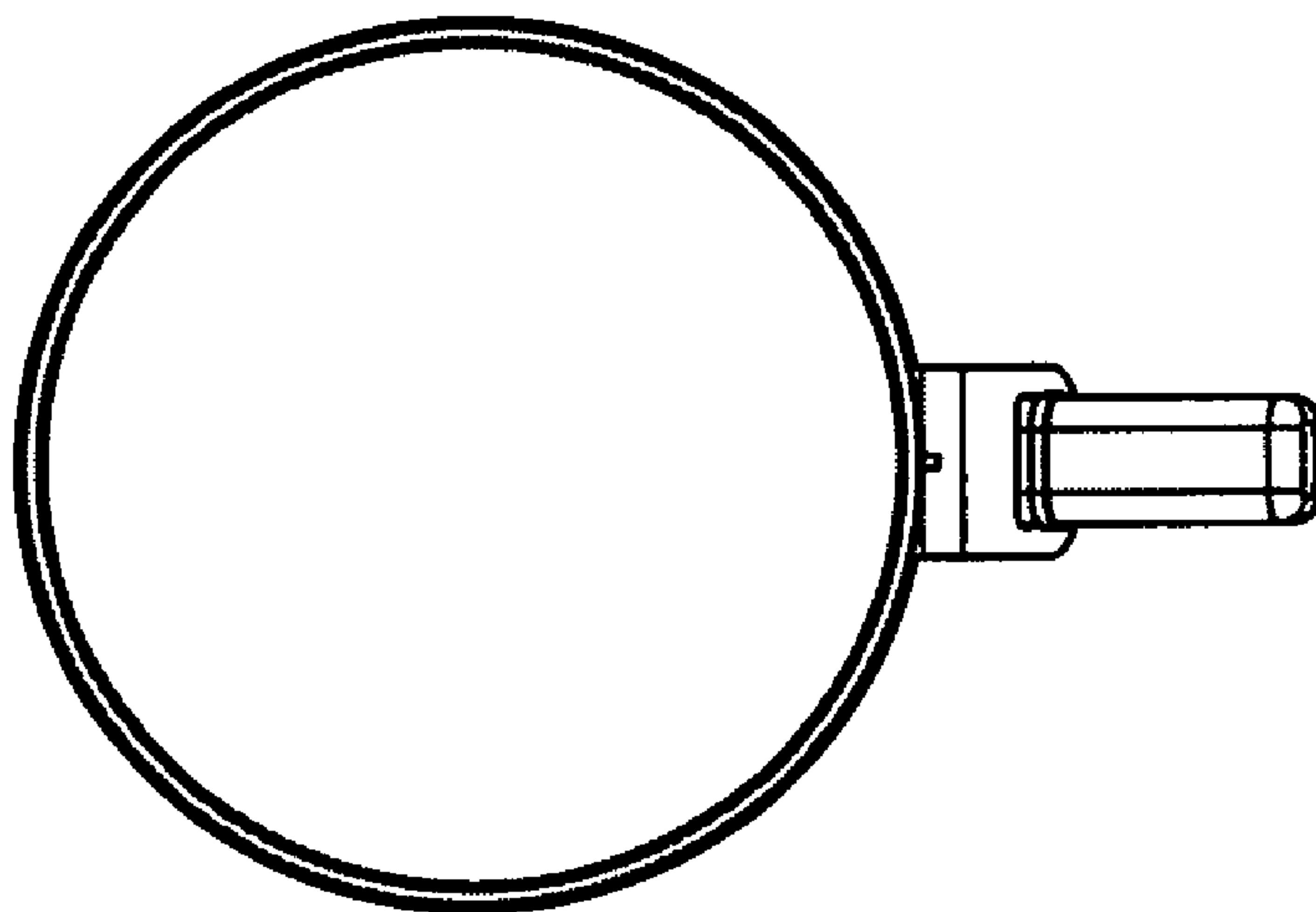

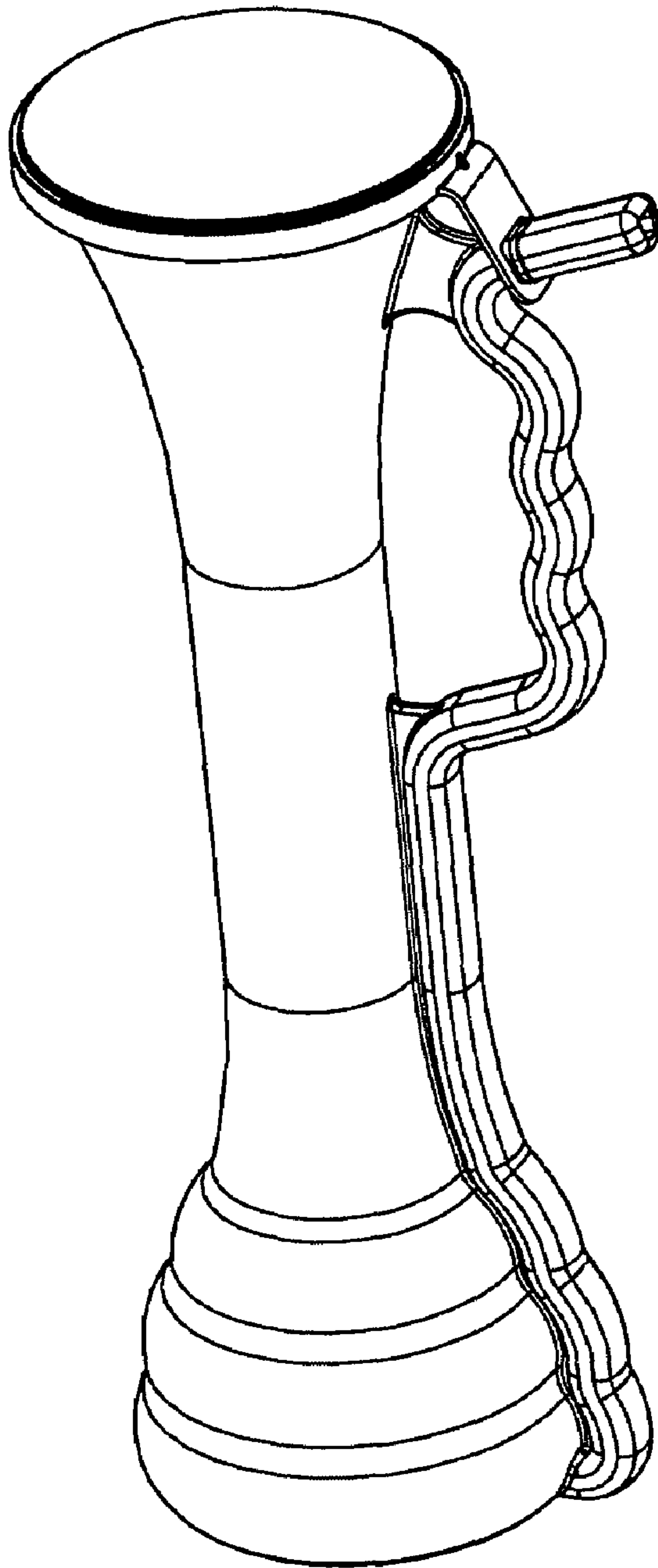

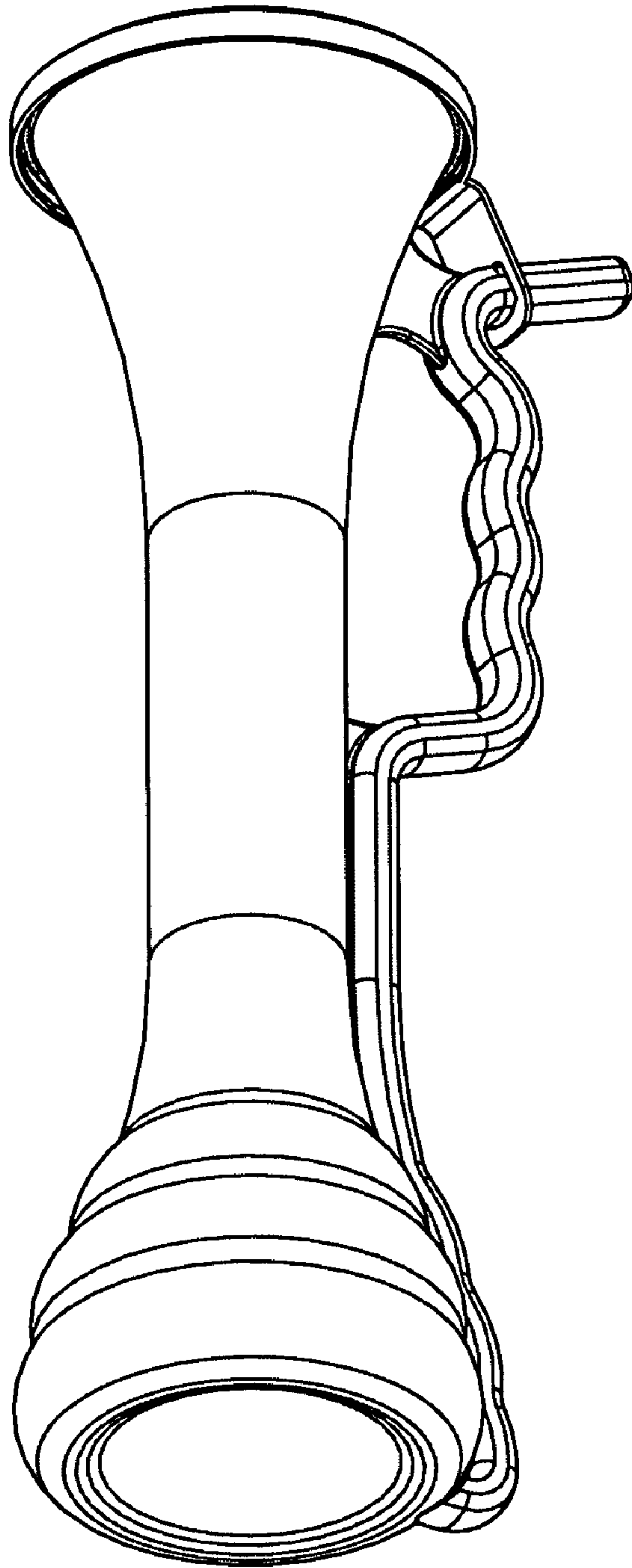
