FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the sling for leg support thereof;

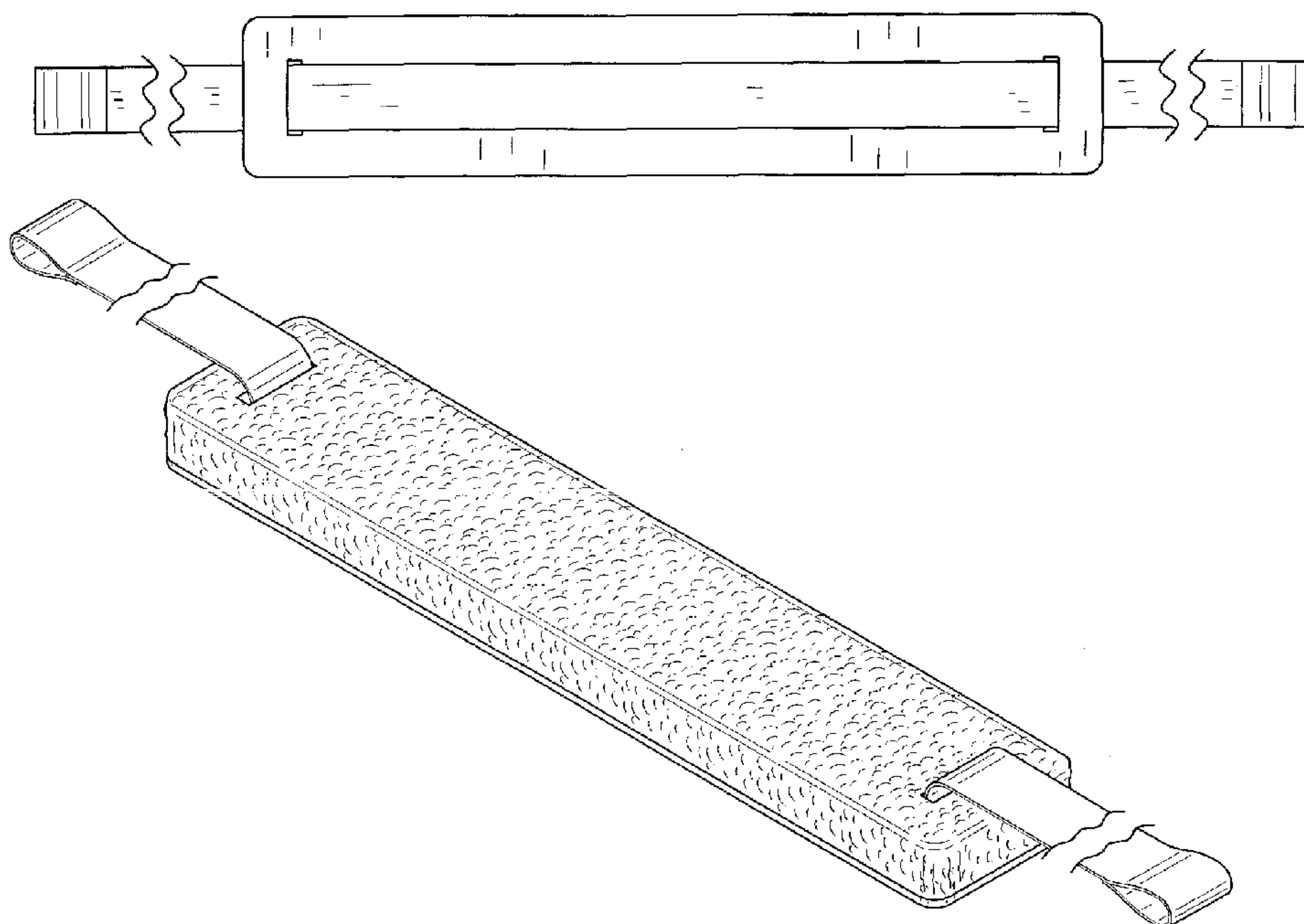
FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view of the sling for leg support thereof;

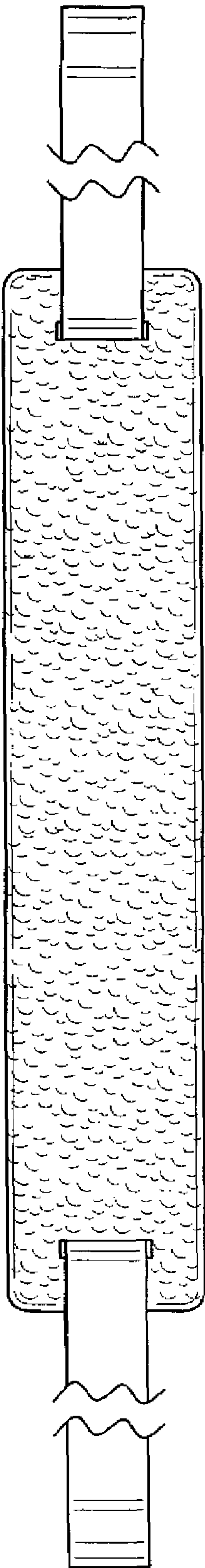

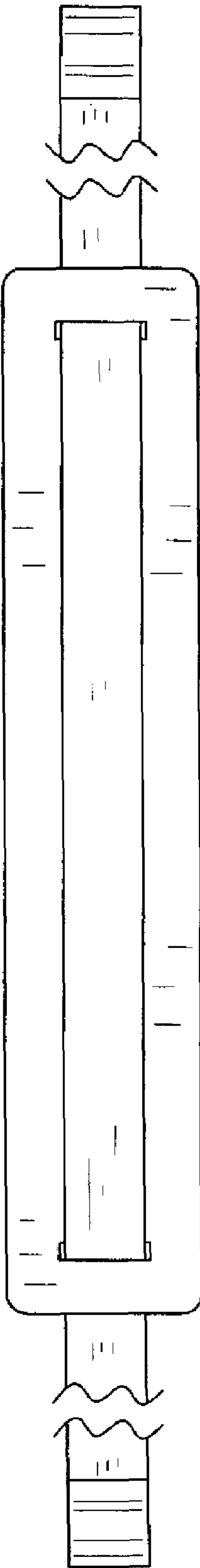

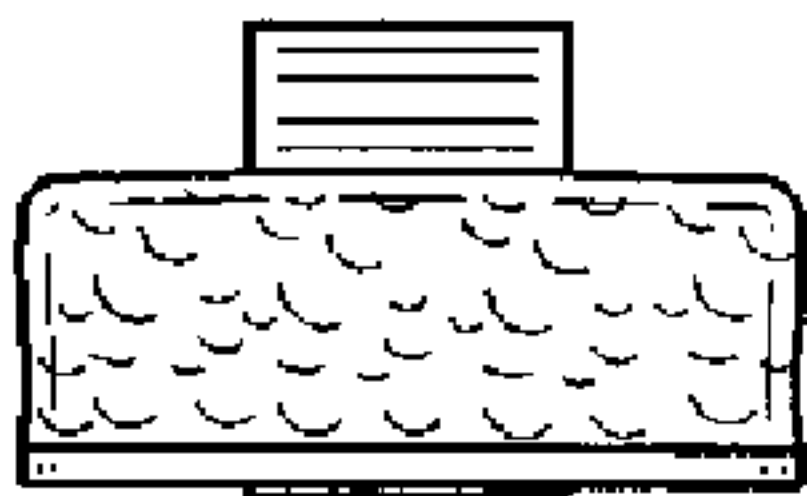

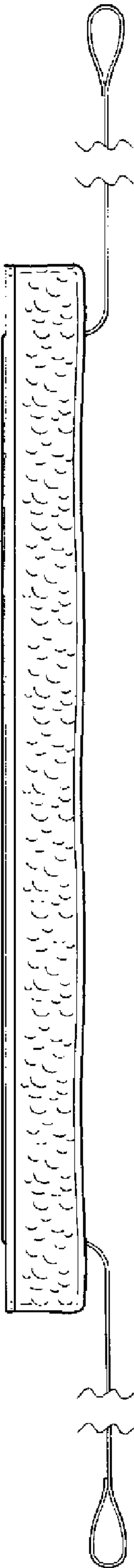

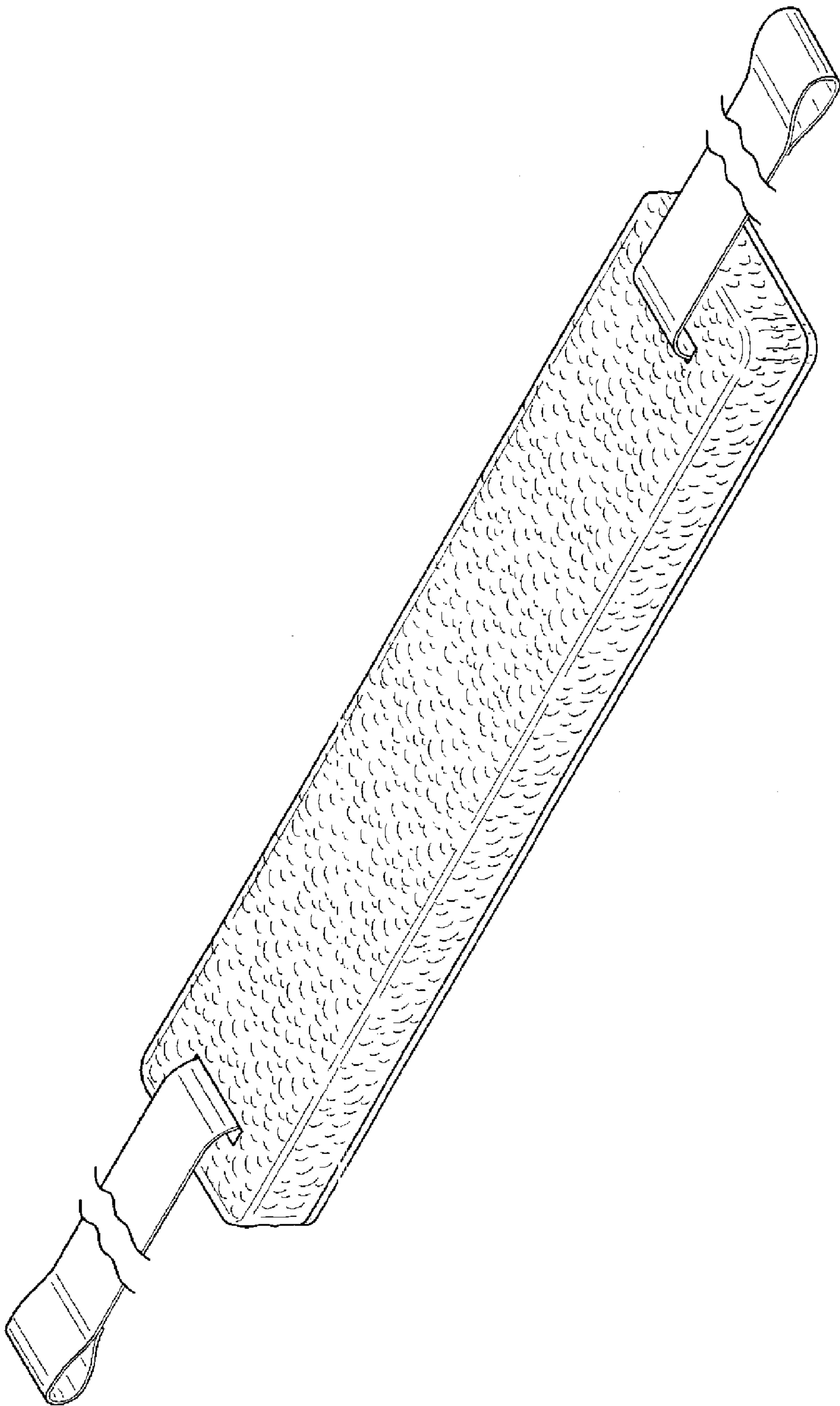
