DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front left perspective view of a portion of a squeegee showing our new design;

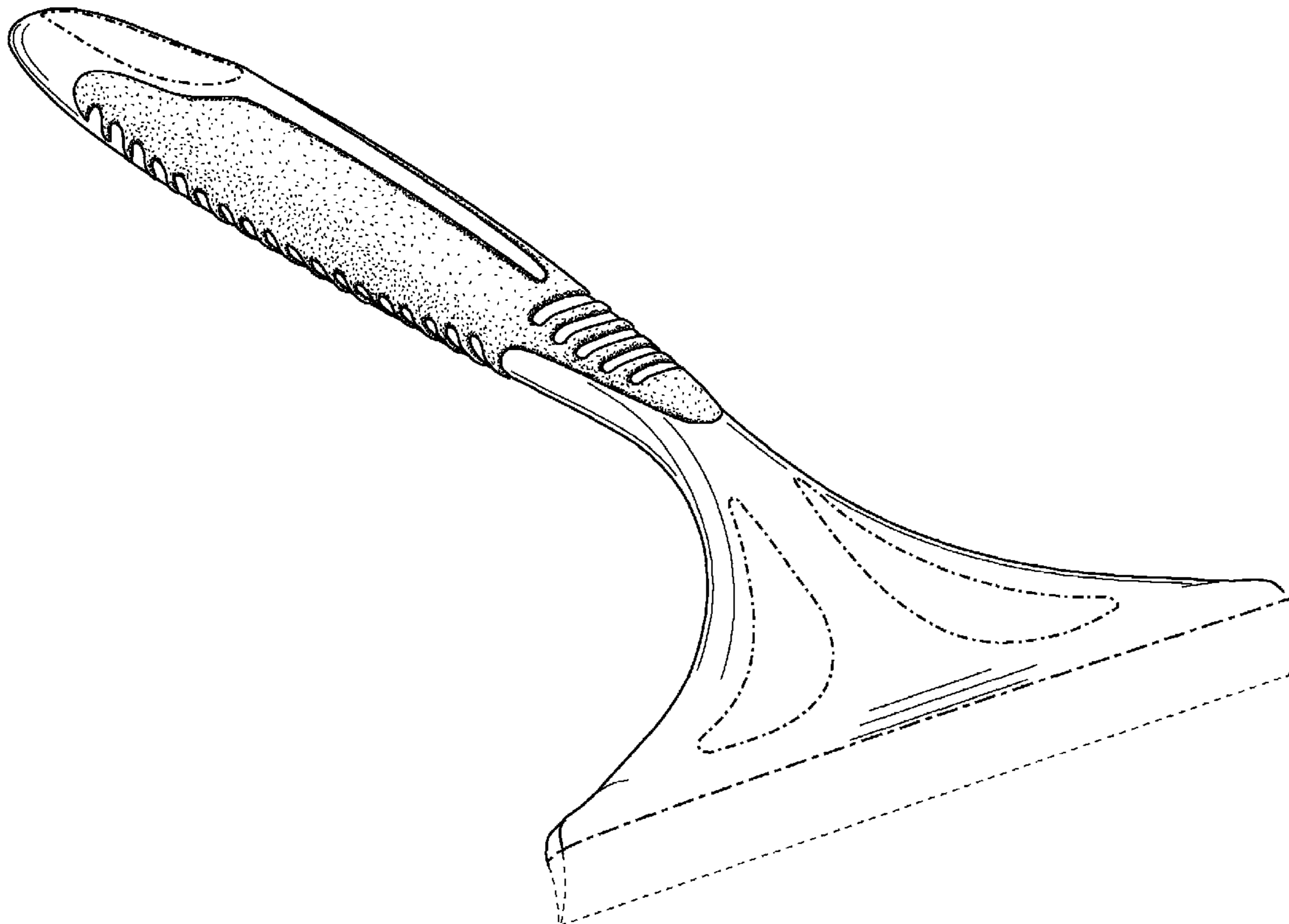

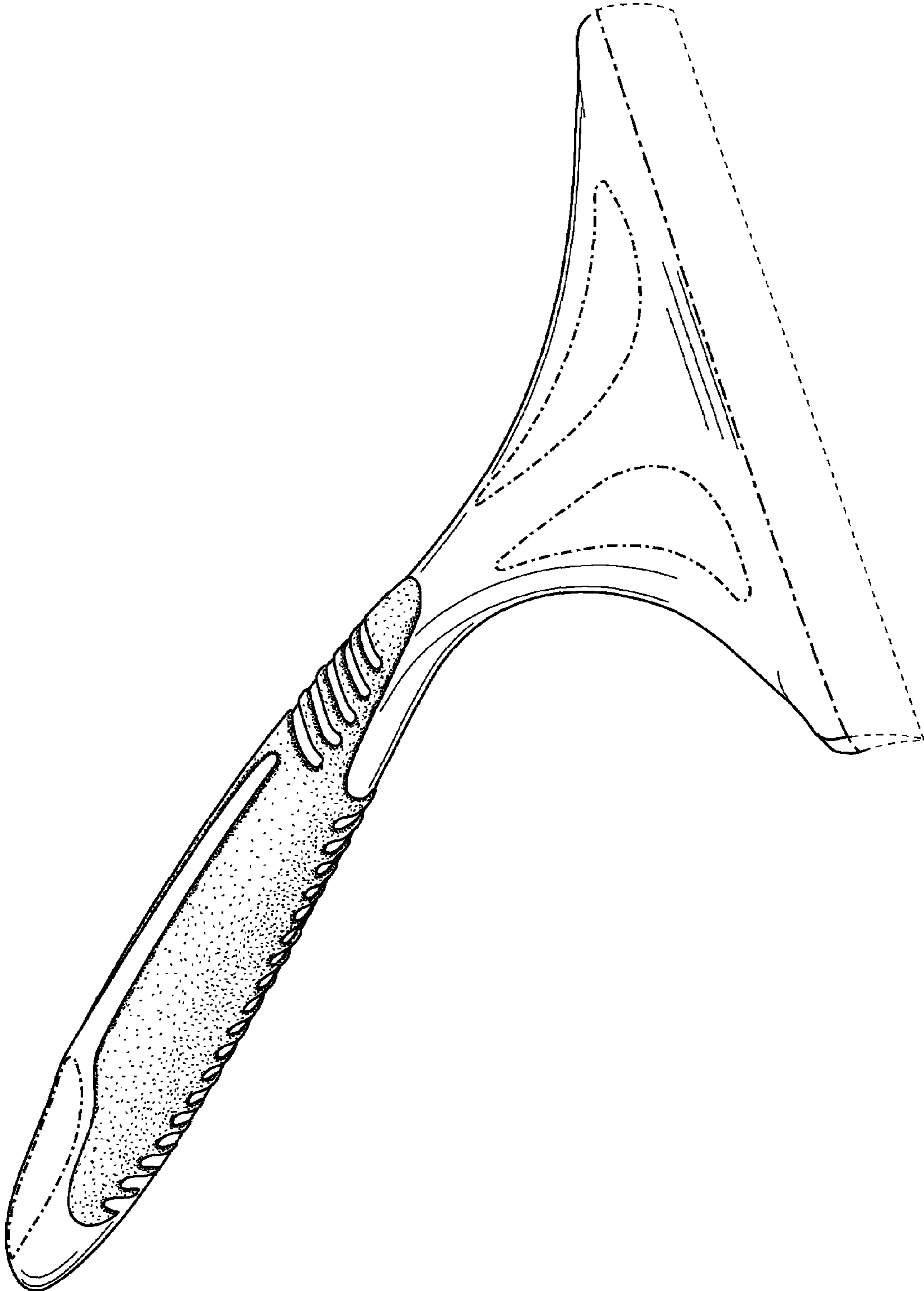

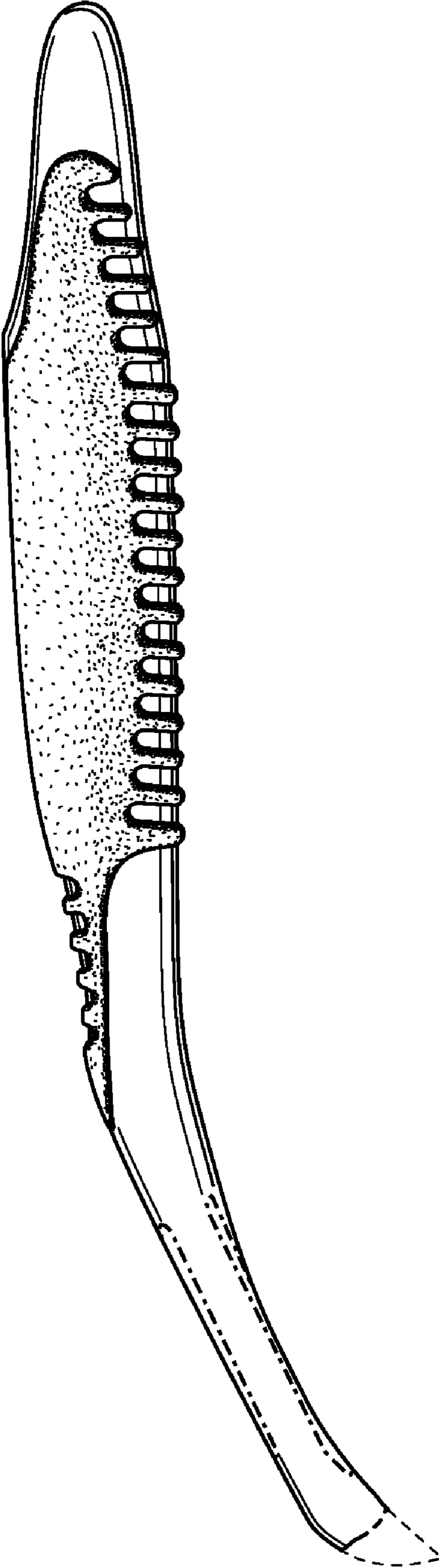

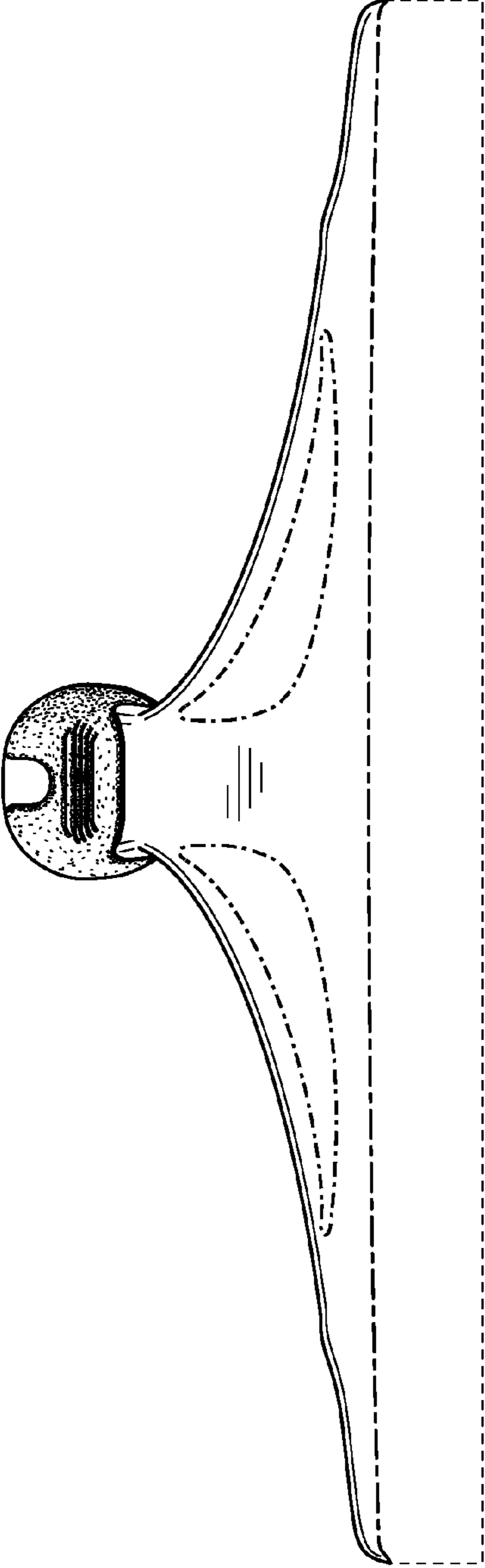

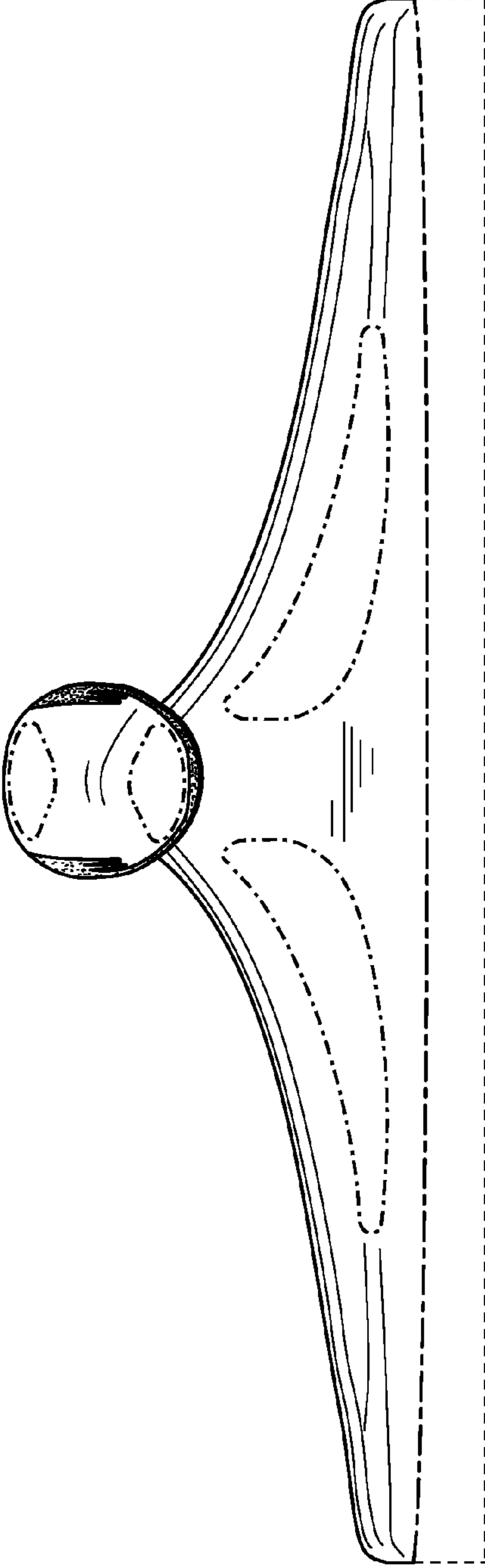

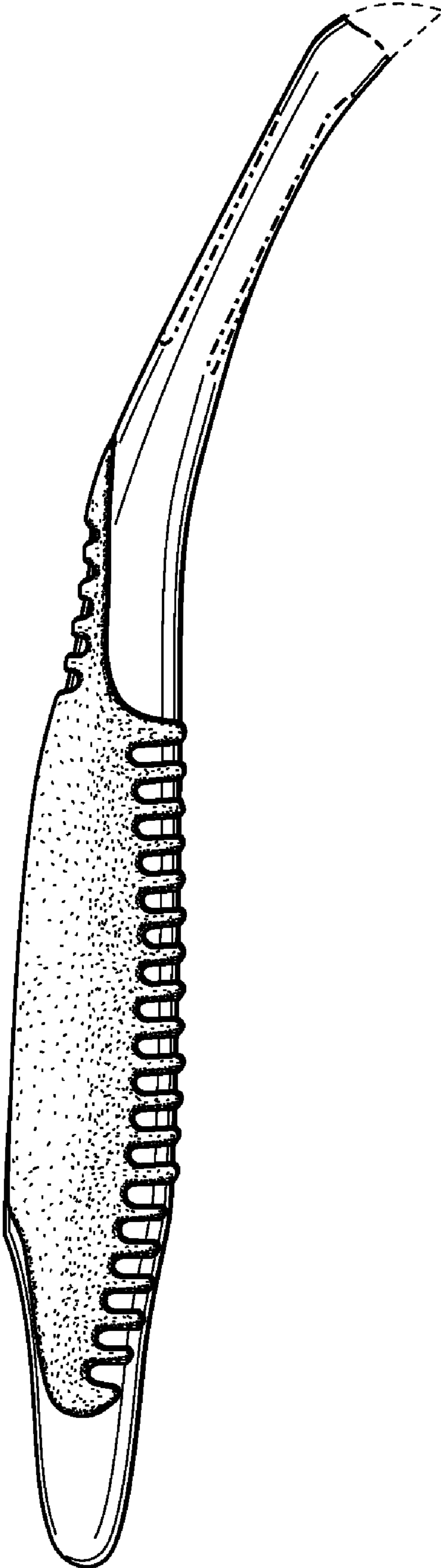

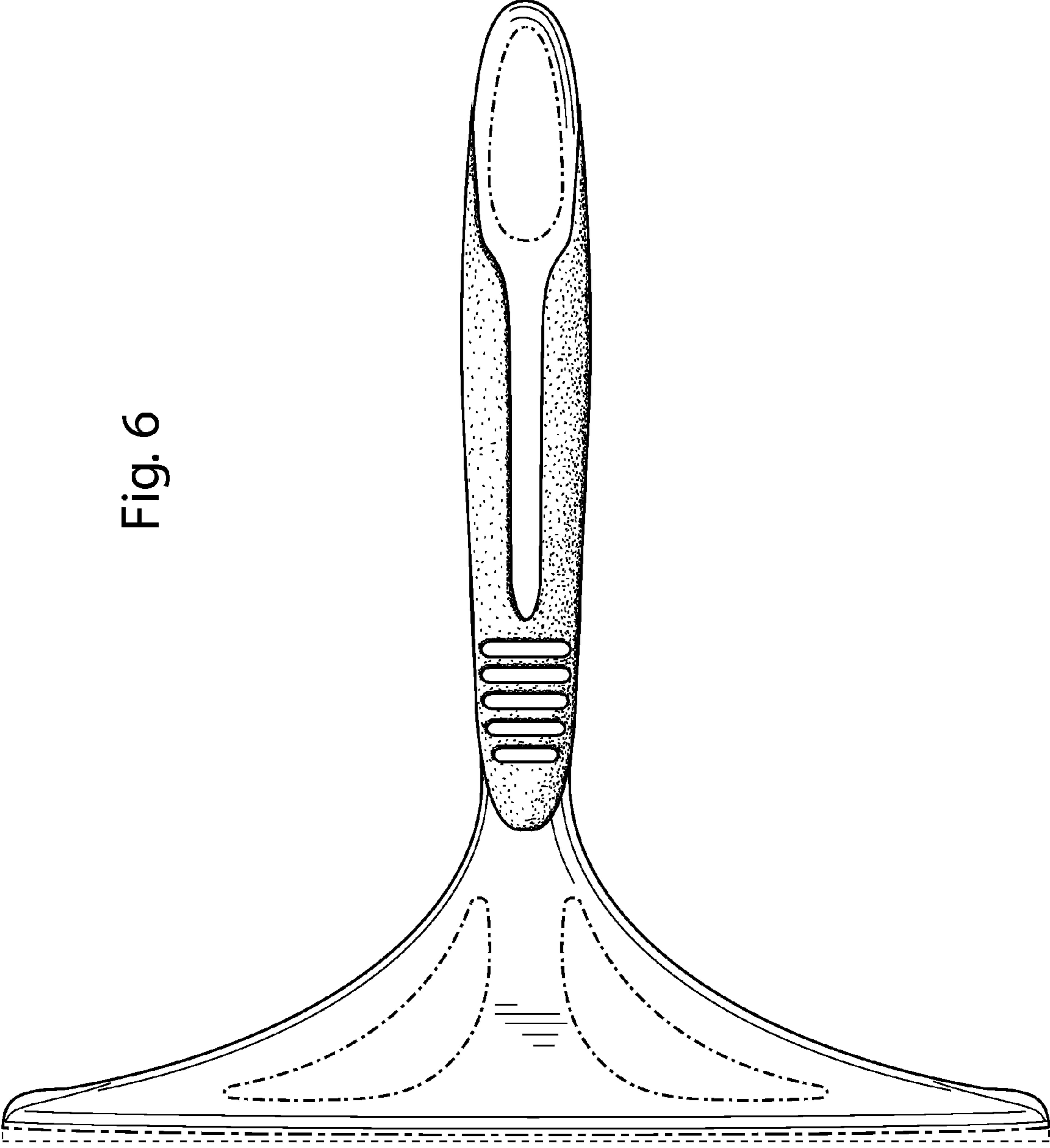
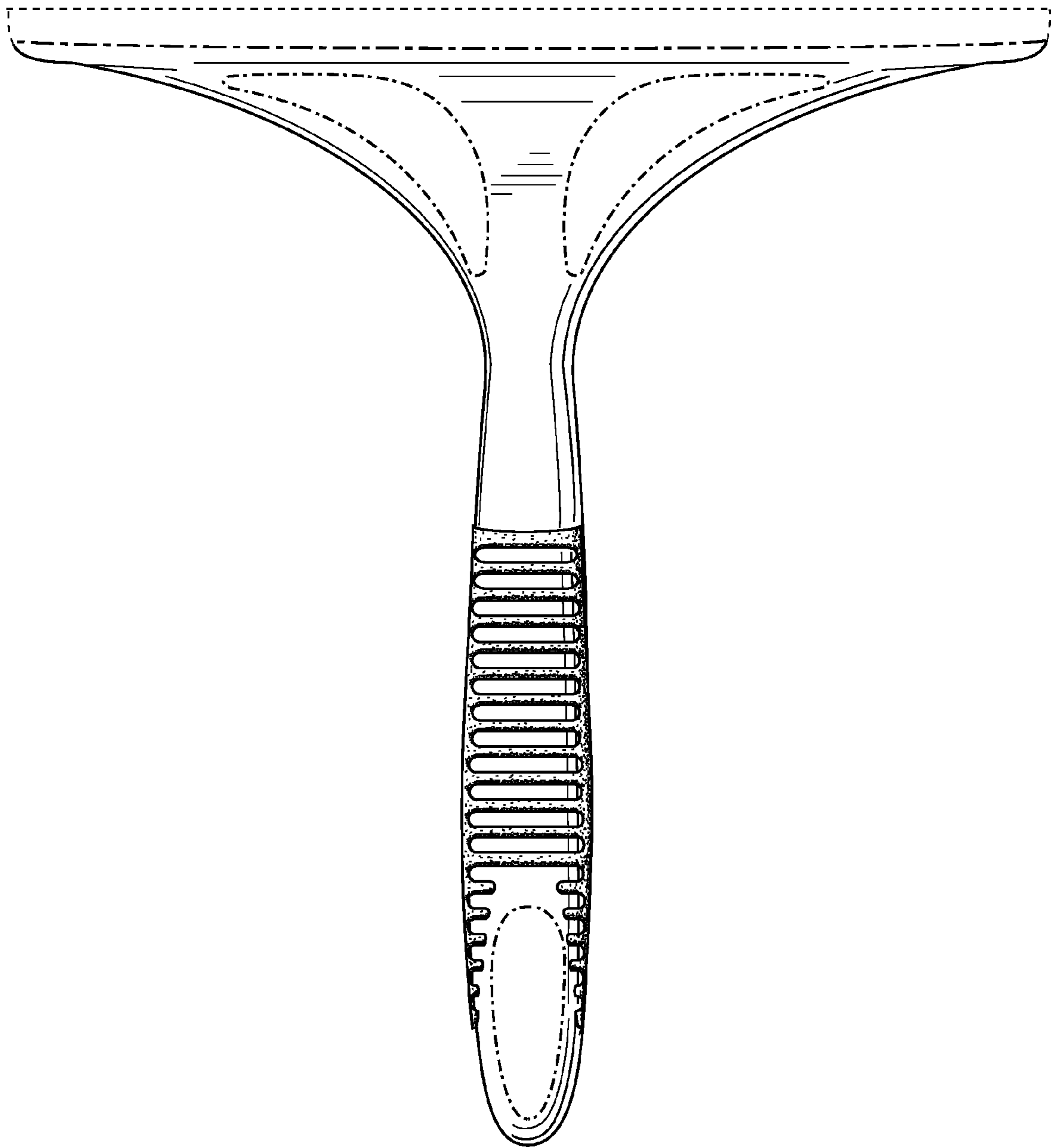

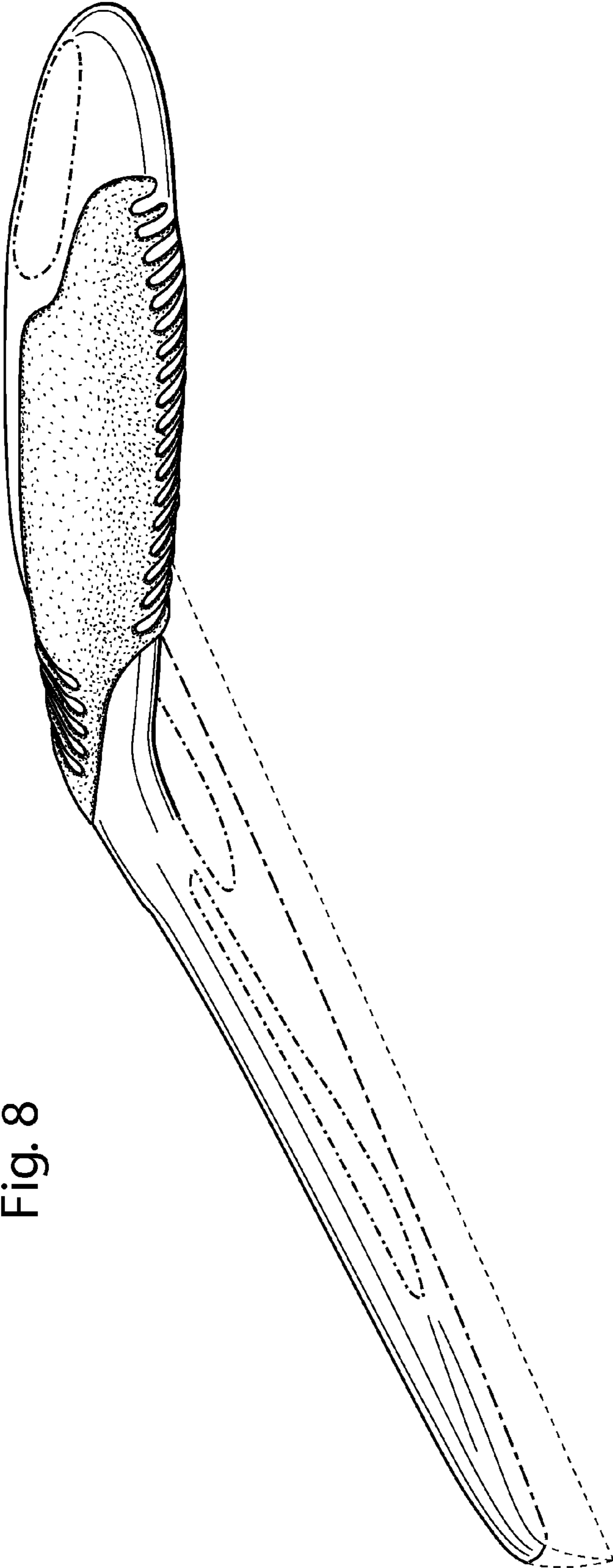
