(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a barbecue implement with multi tone hand grip, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a barbecue implement with multi tone hand grip showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is the opposite side view of the handle on the left side of FIG. 4 shown separately for the clarity of illustration, the opposite side of the handle on the right side of FIG. 4 being a mirror image thereof;

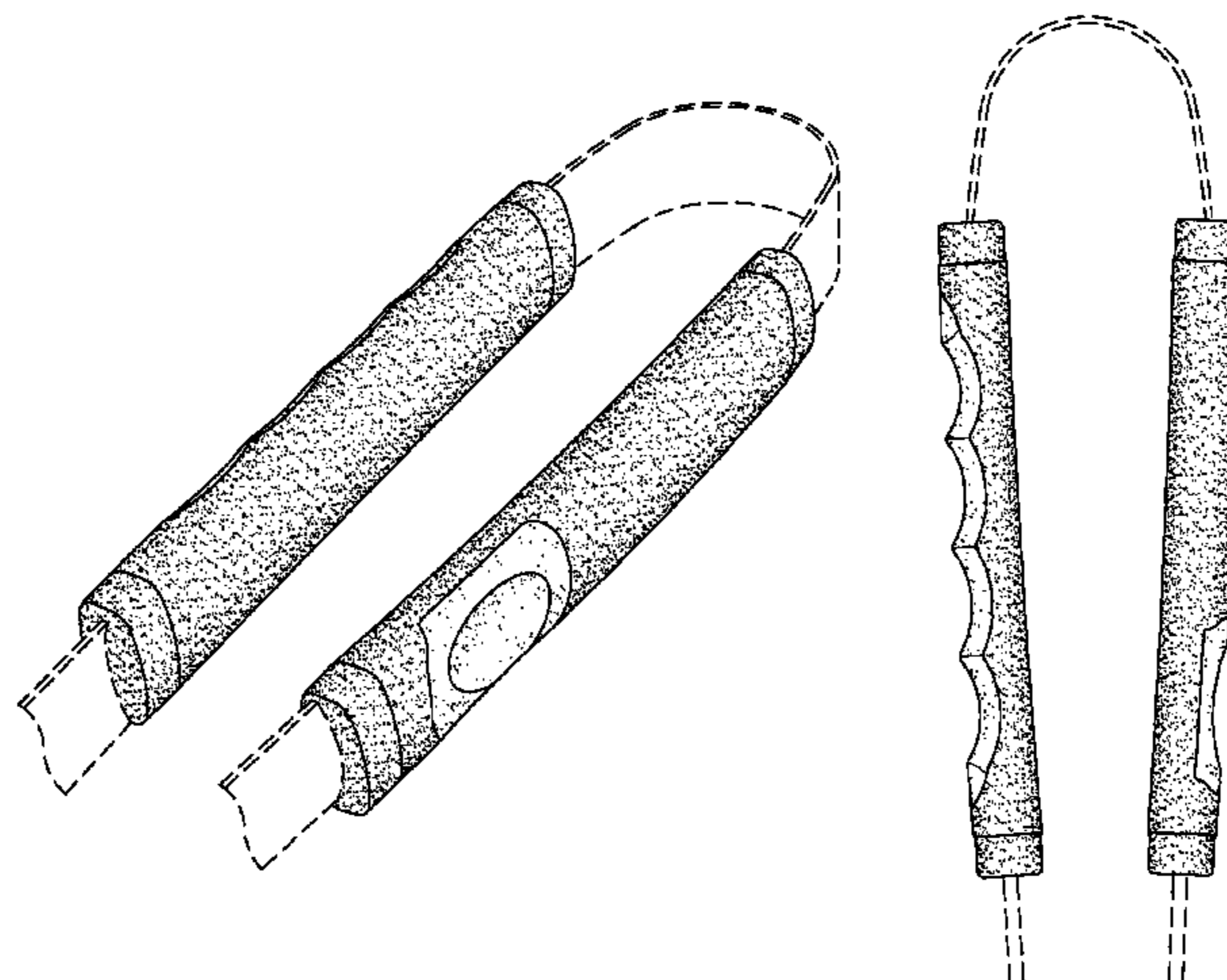
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof; and,

FIG. 8 is the top view of the handle on the left side of FIG. 4 shown separately for the clarity of illustration, the top view of the handle on the right side of FIG. 4 being a mirror image thereof.

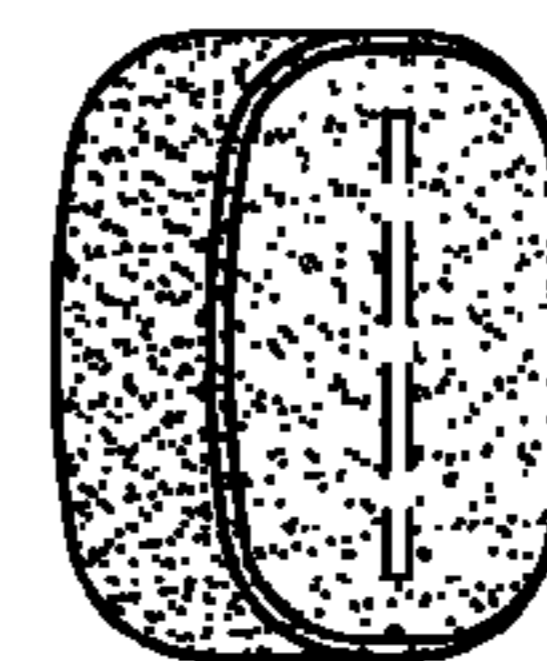
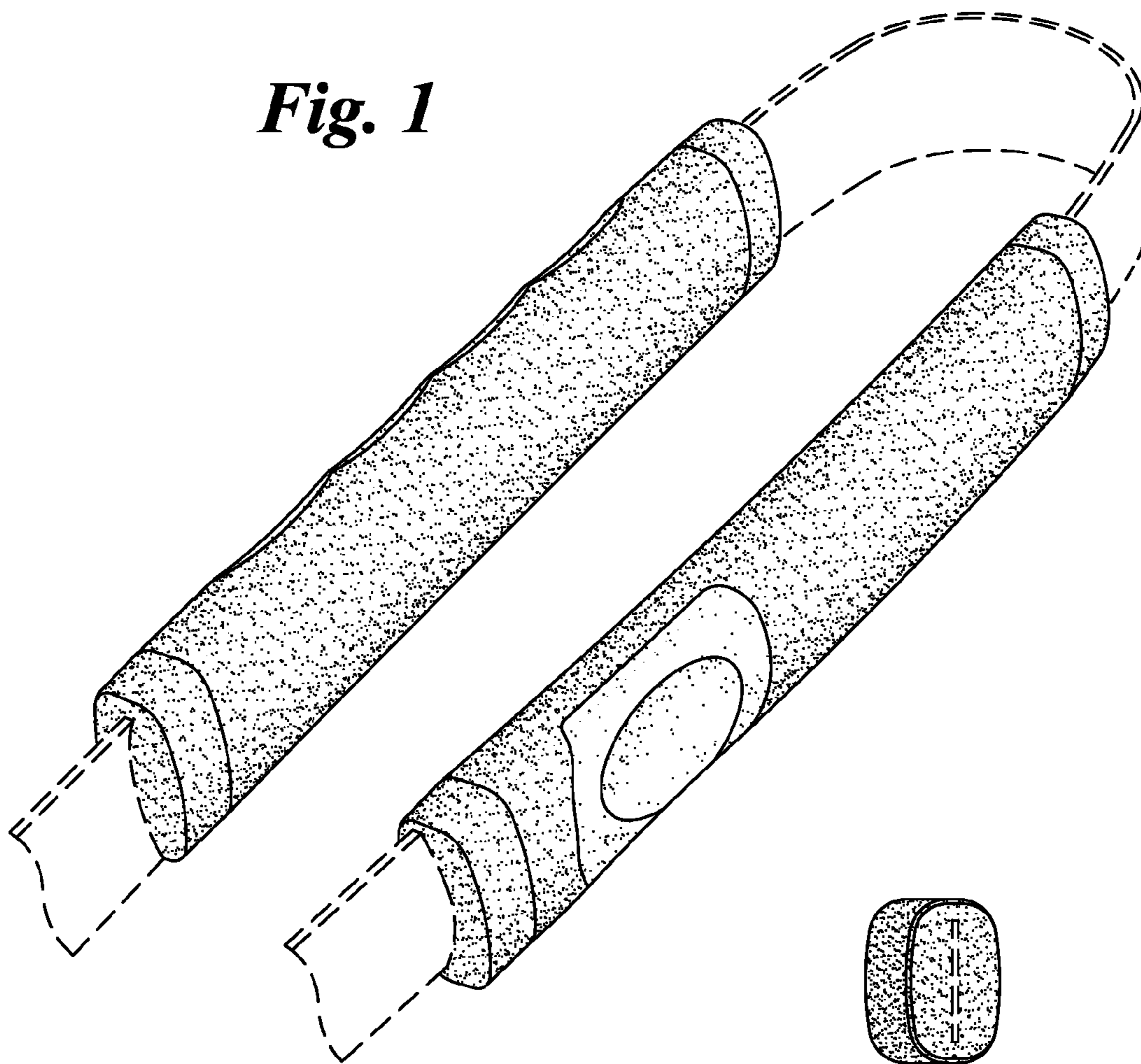

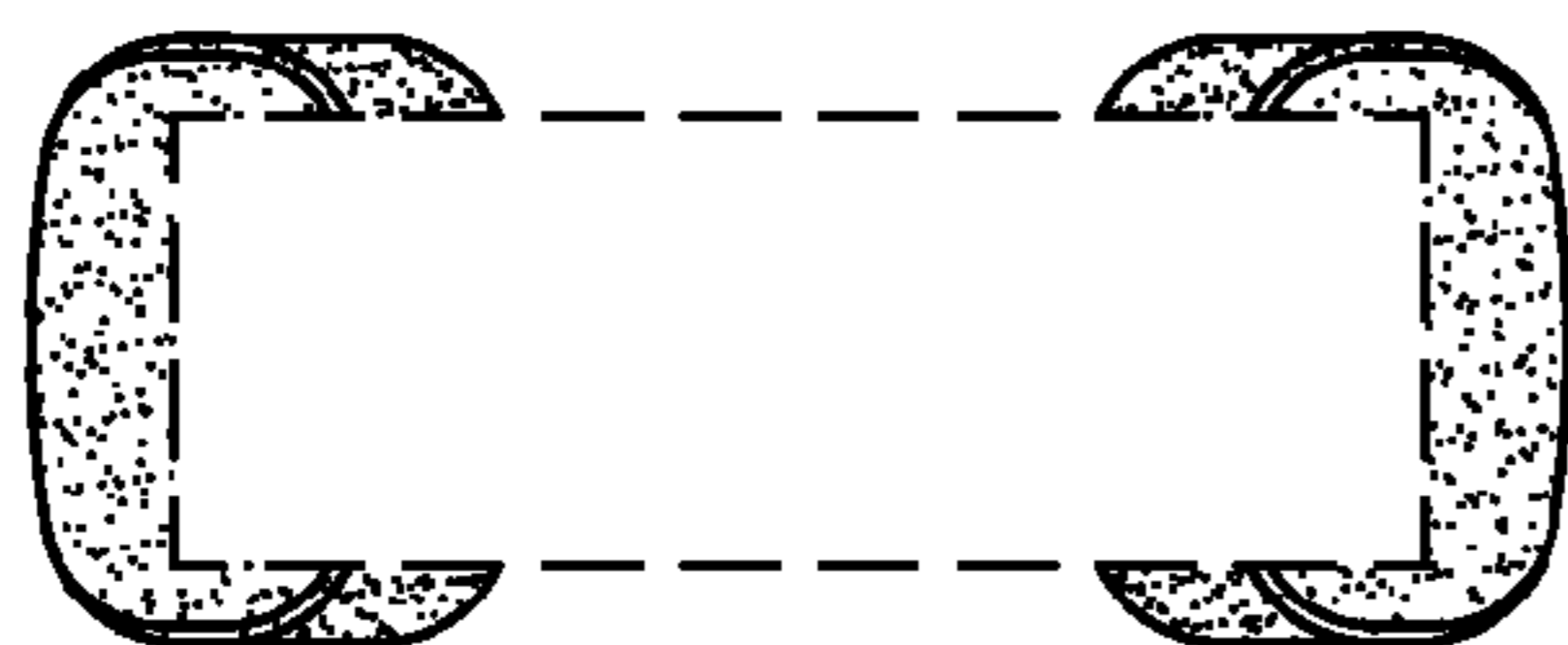

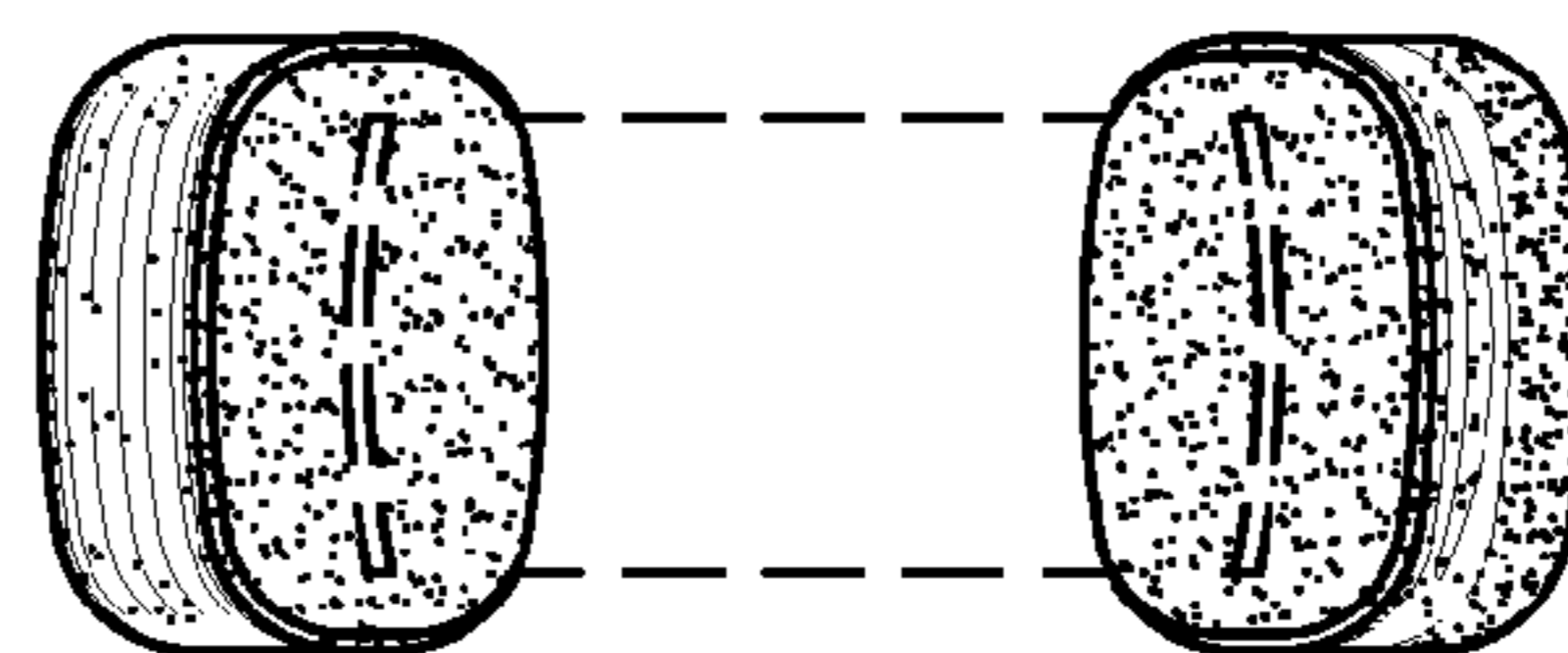

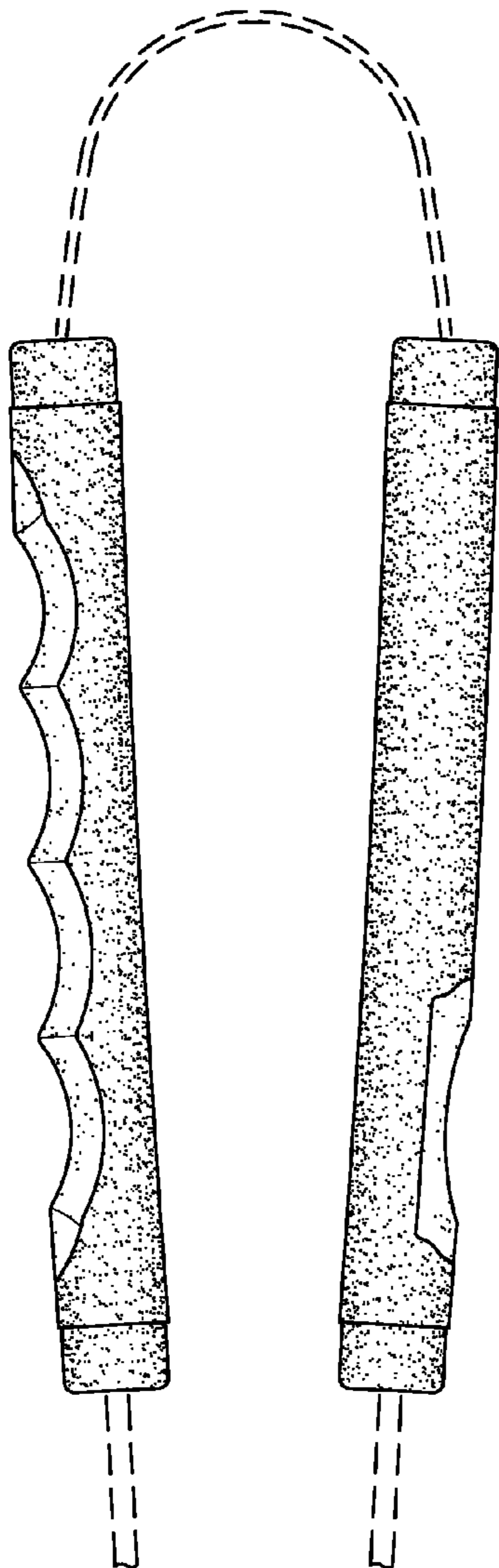

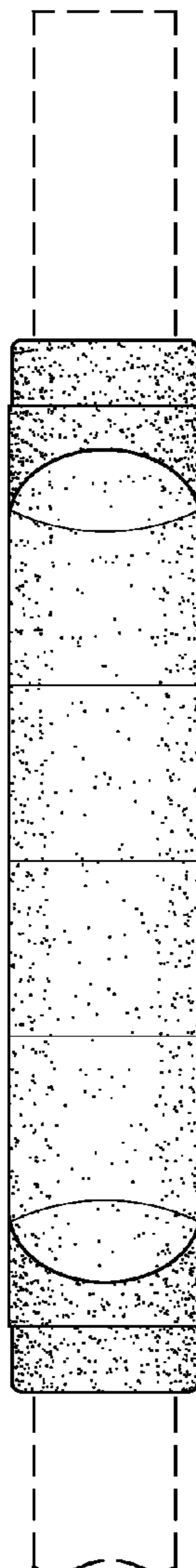

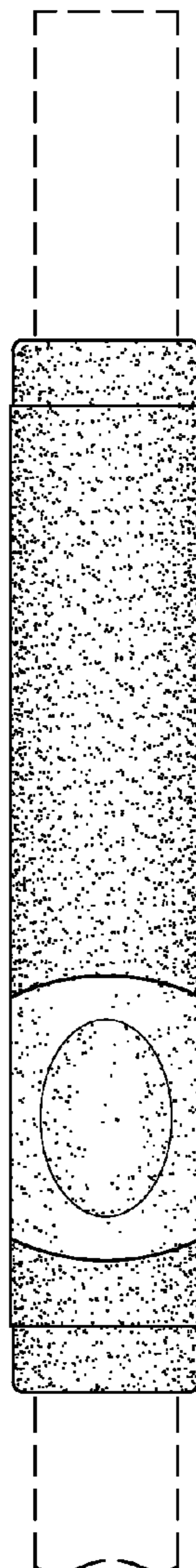
