FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the left side of the device.

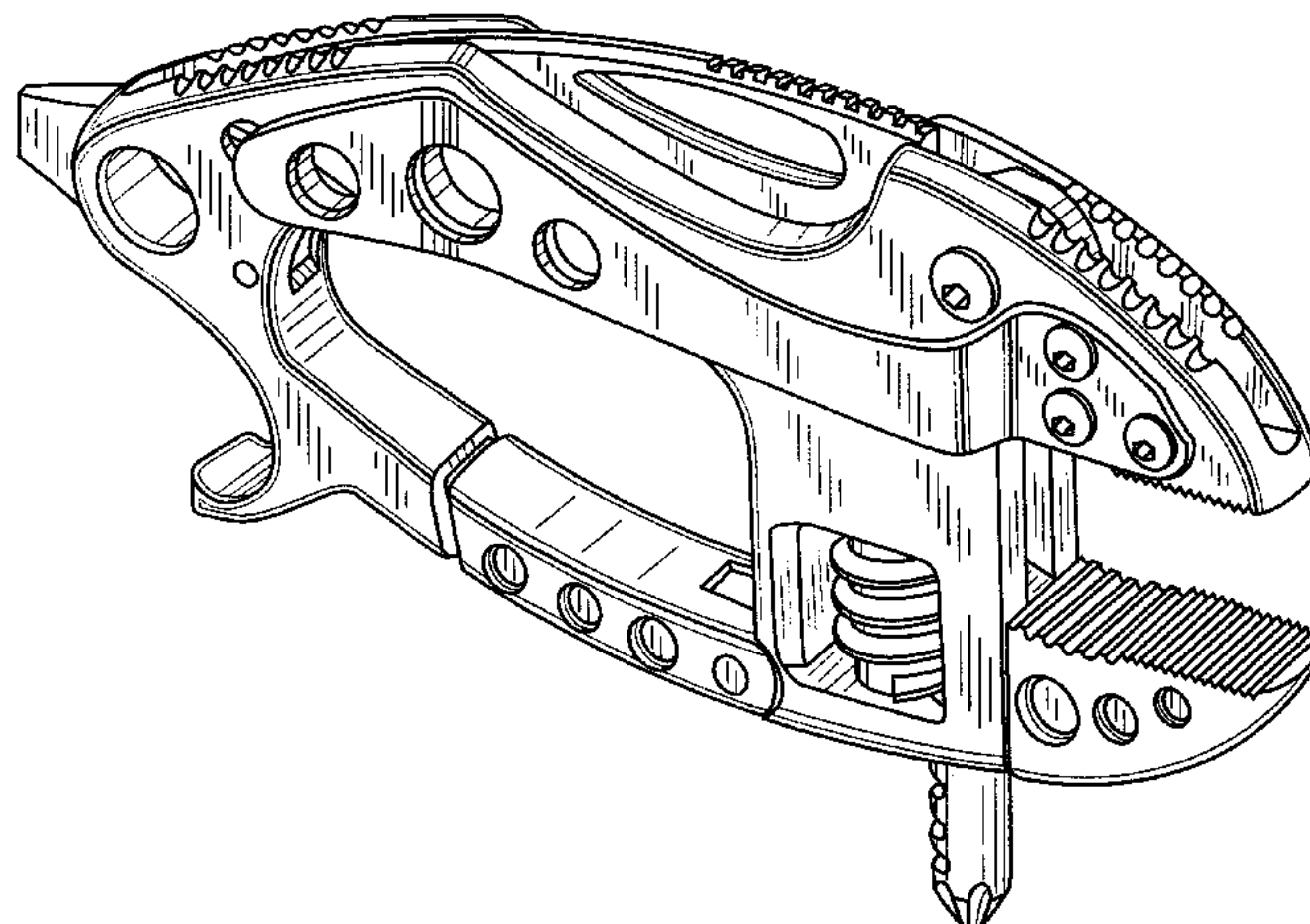
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the device.

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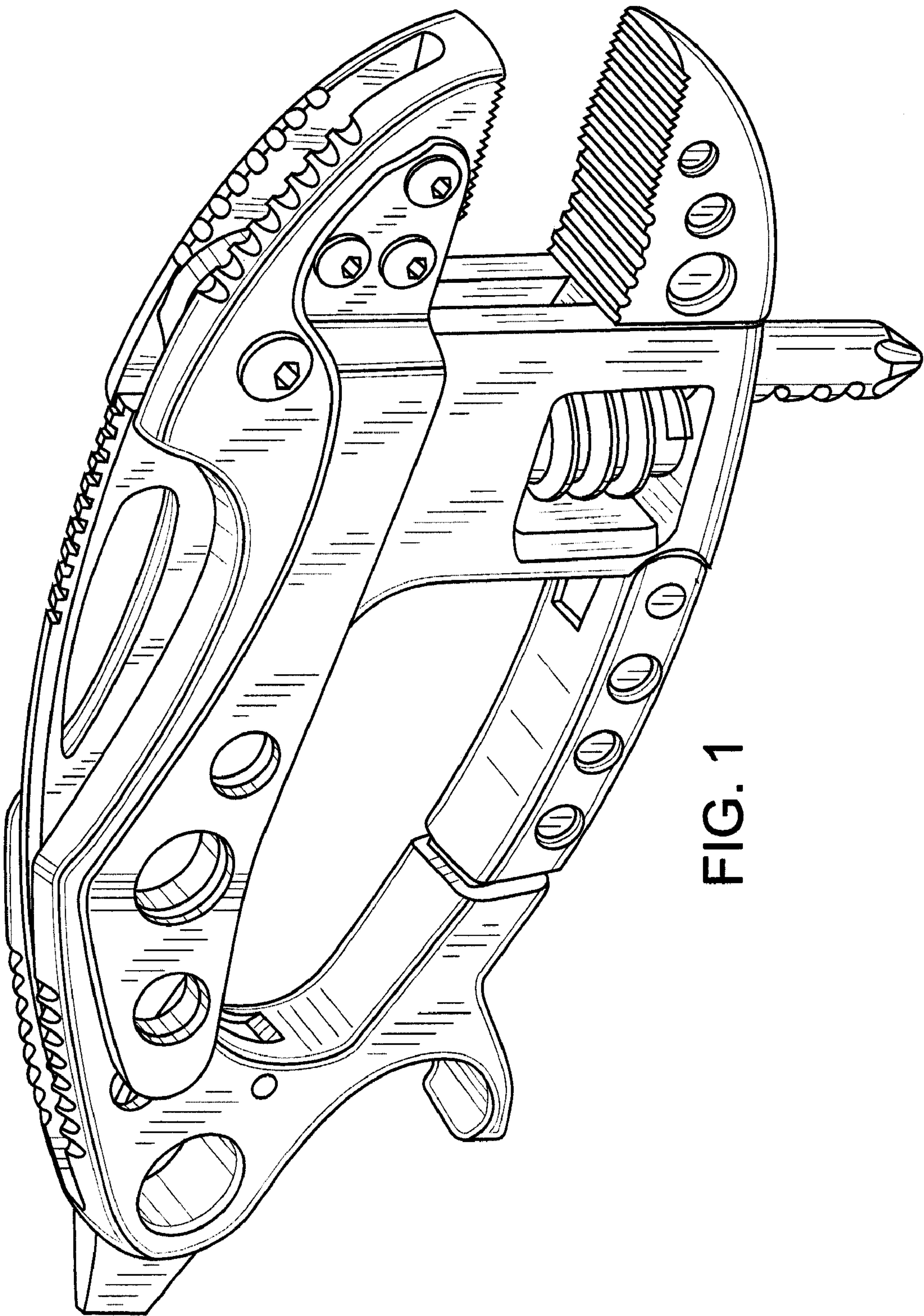

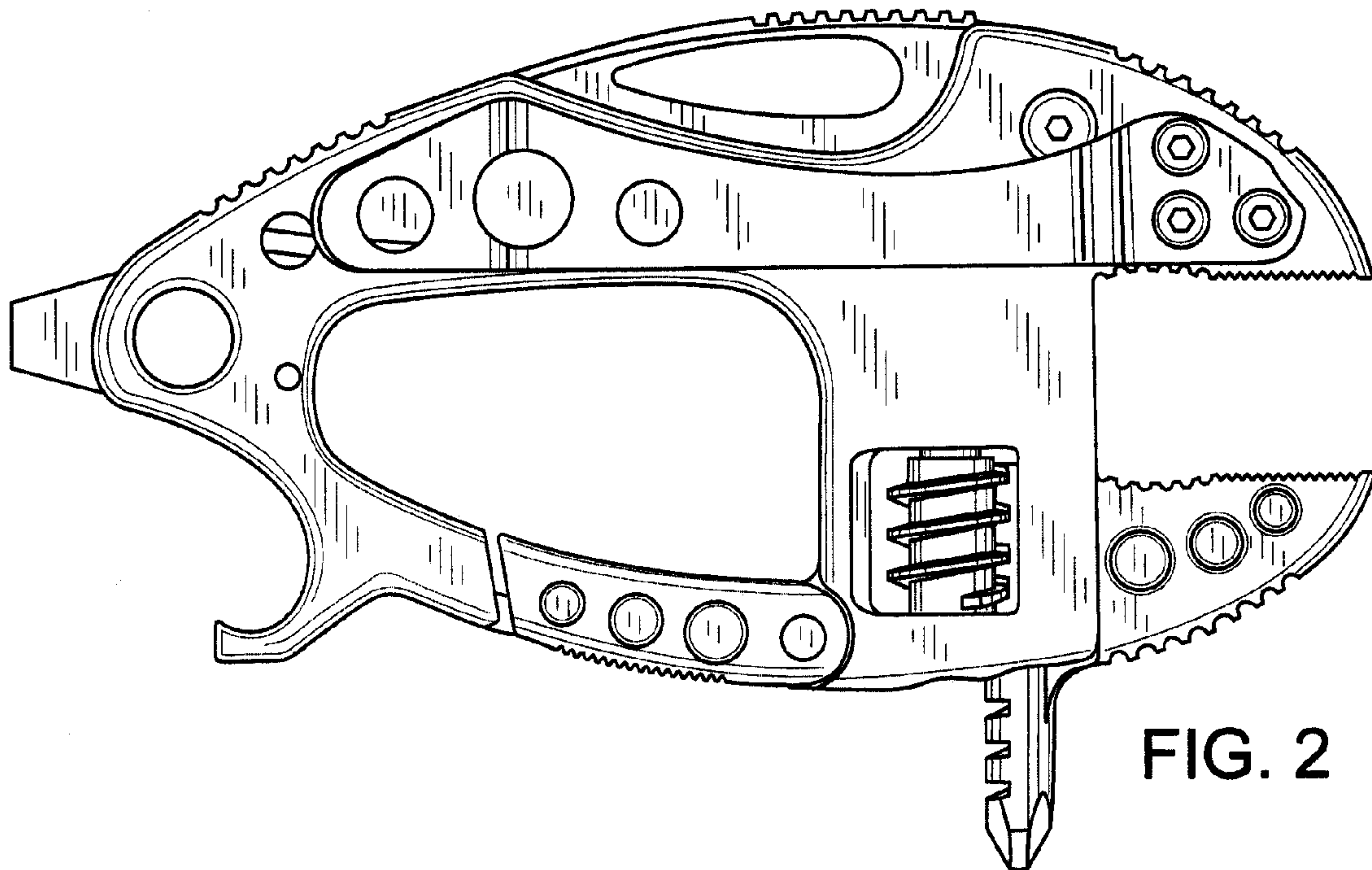

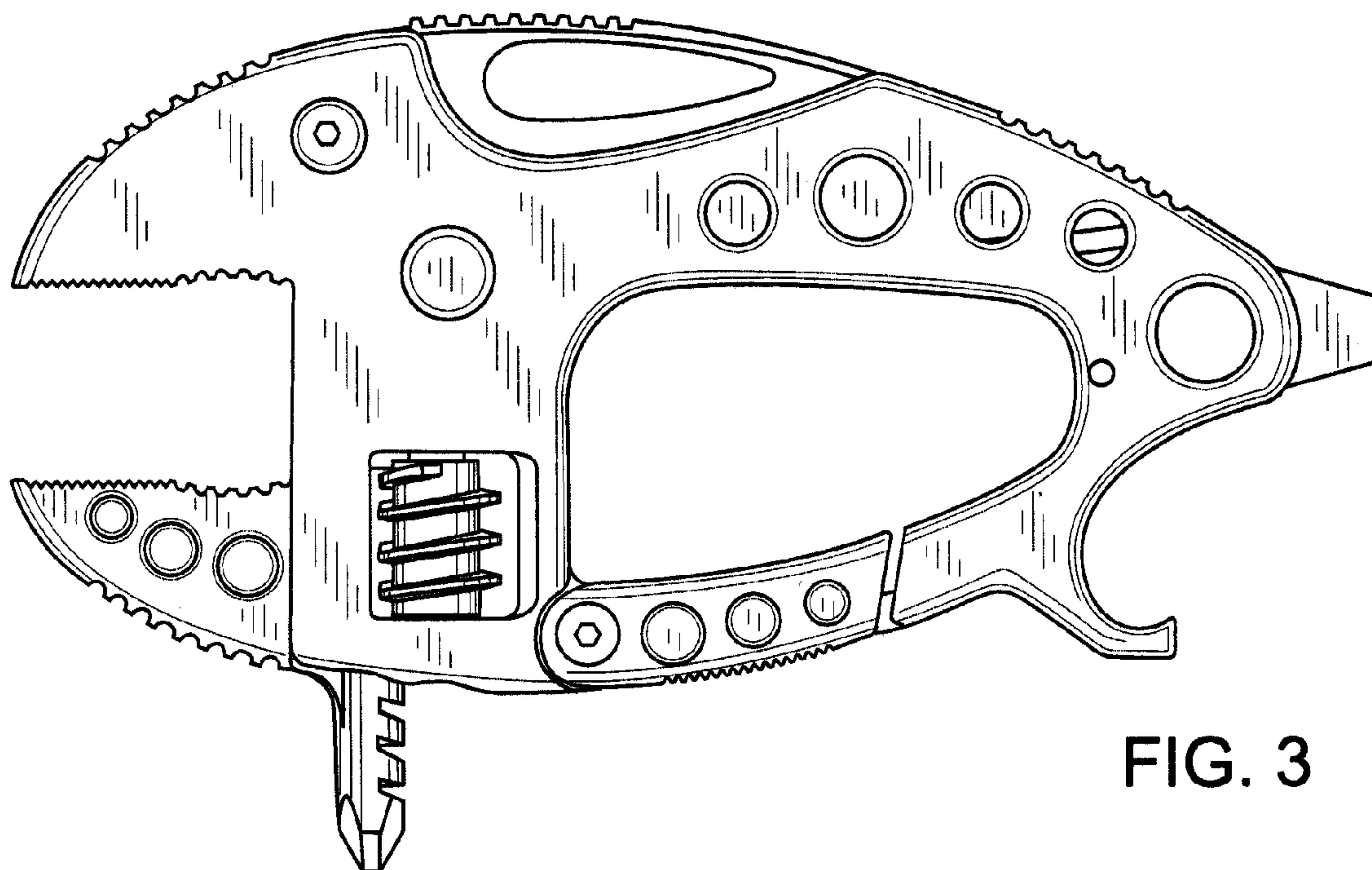

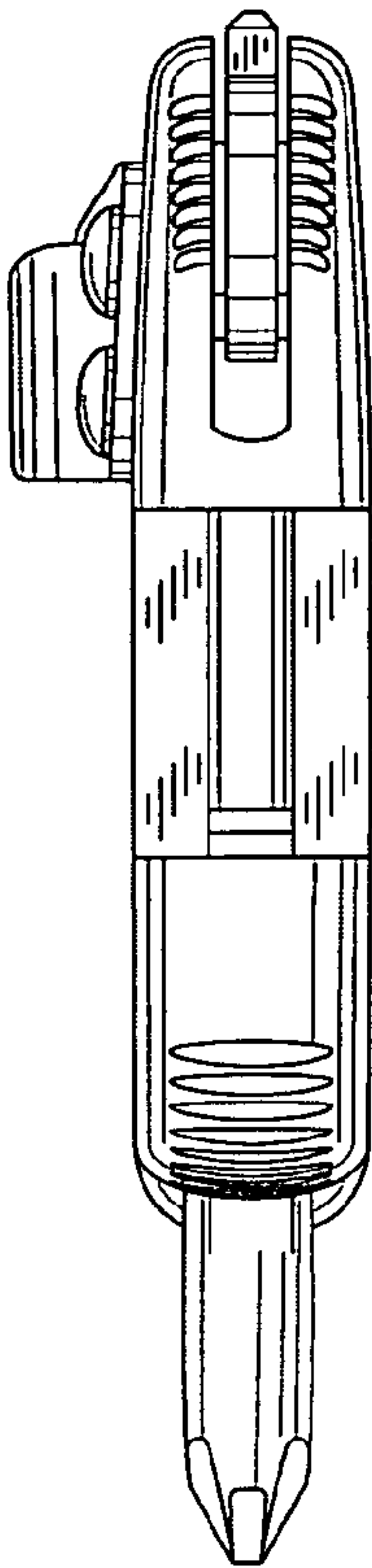

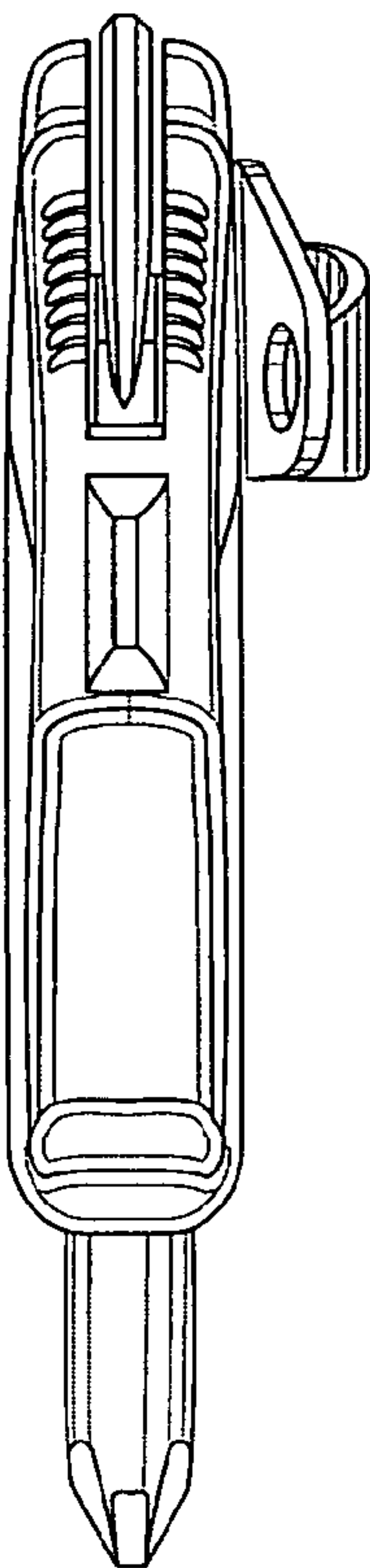

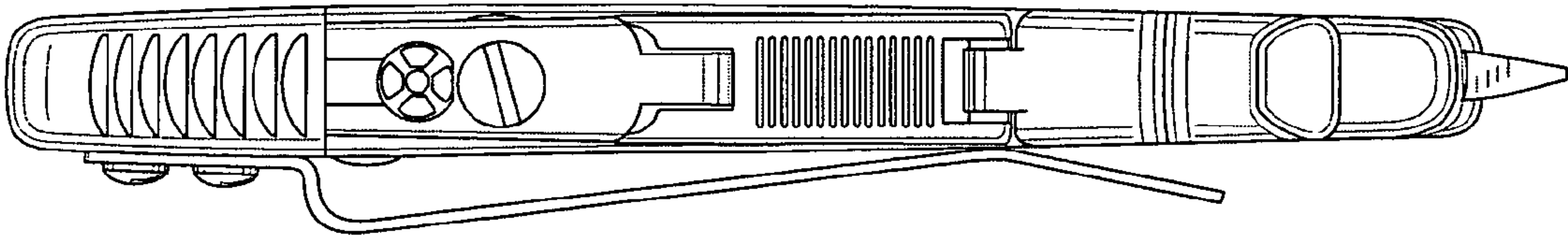

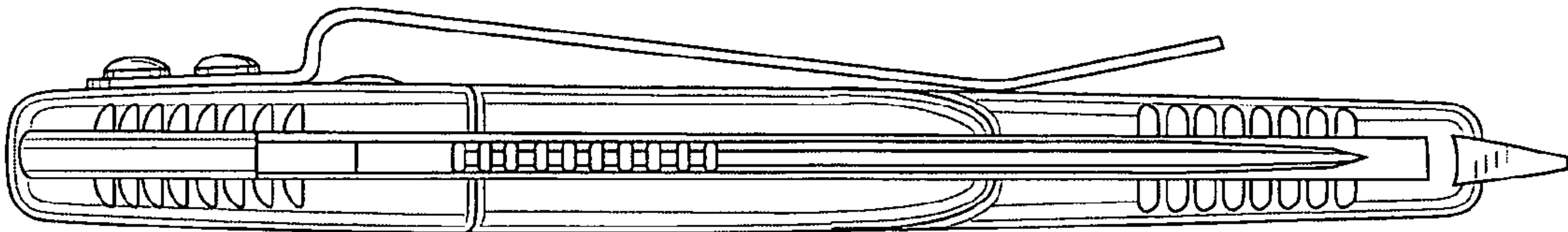
