FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a second embodiment thereof;

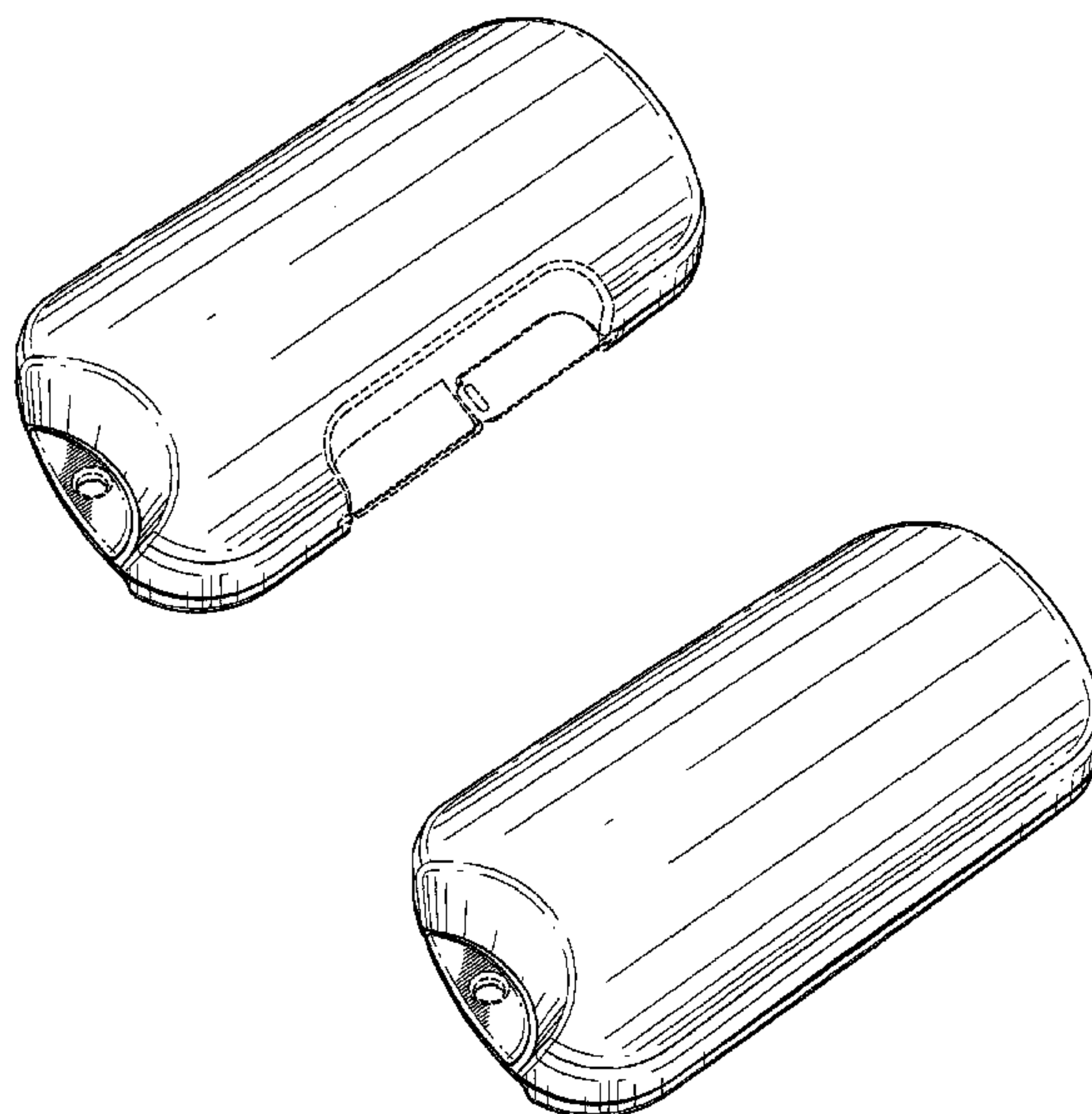
FIG. 6 is a front view of a second embodiment thereof;

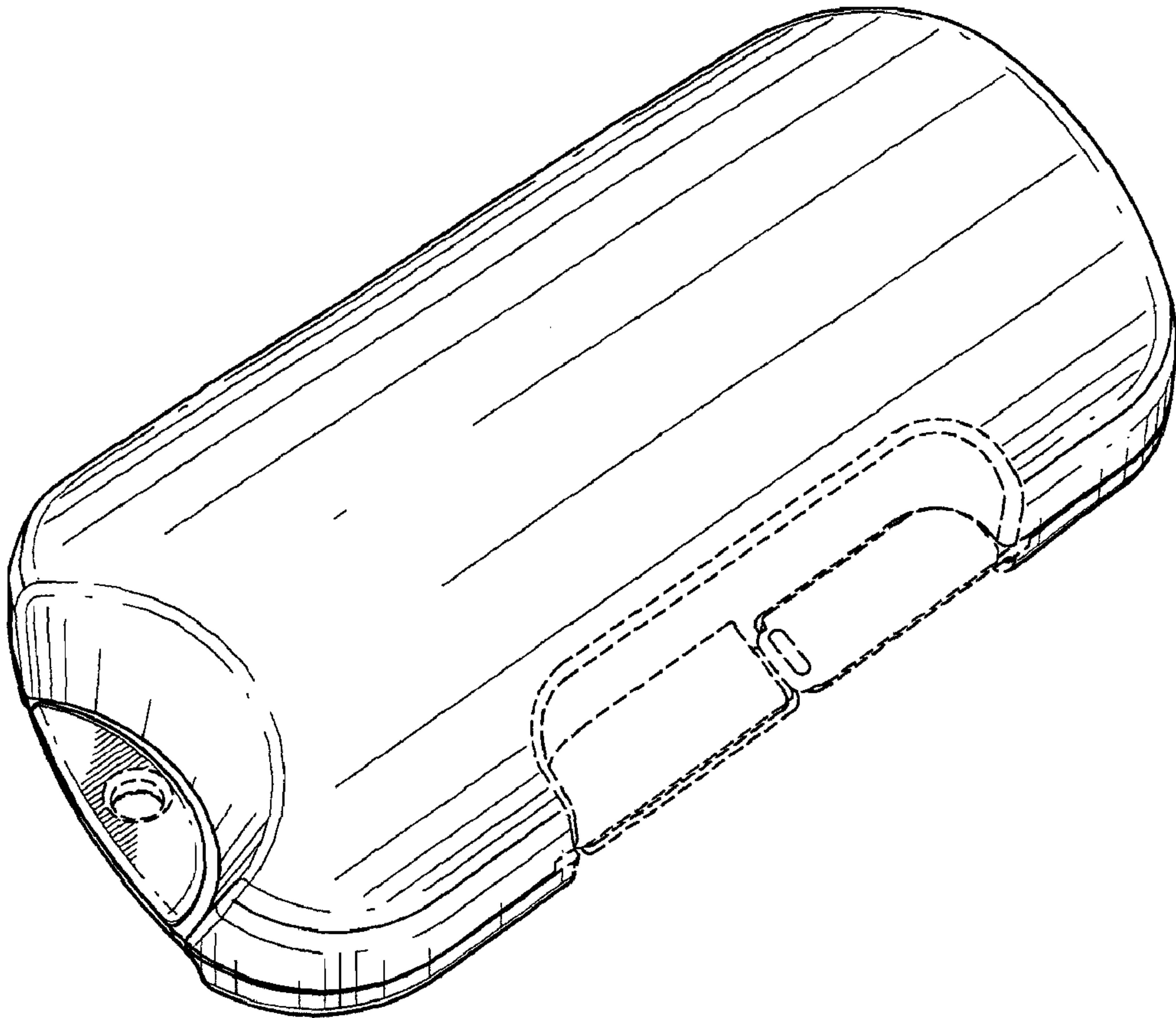

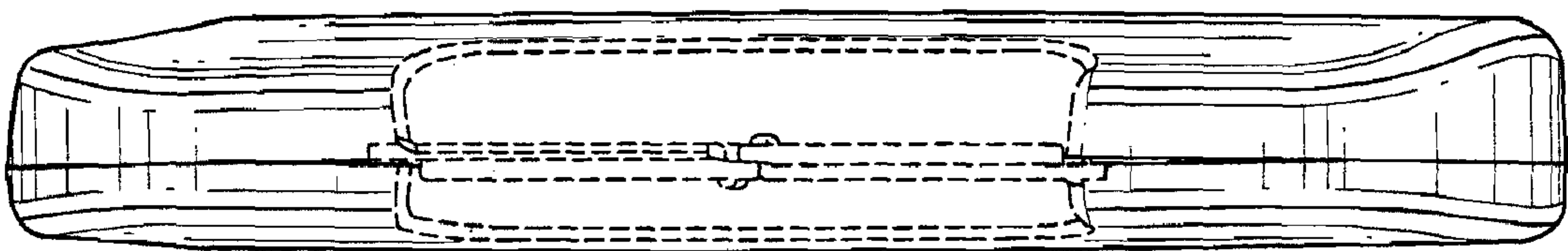

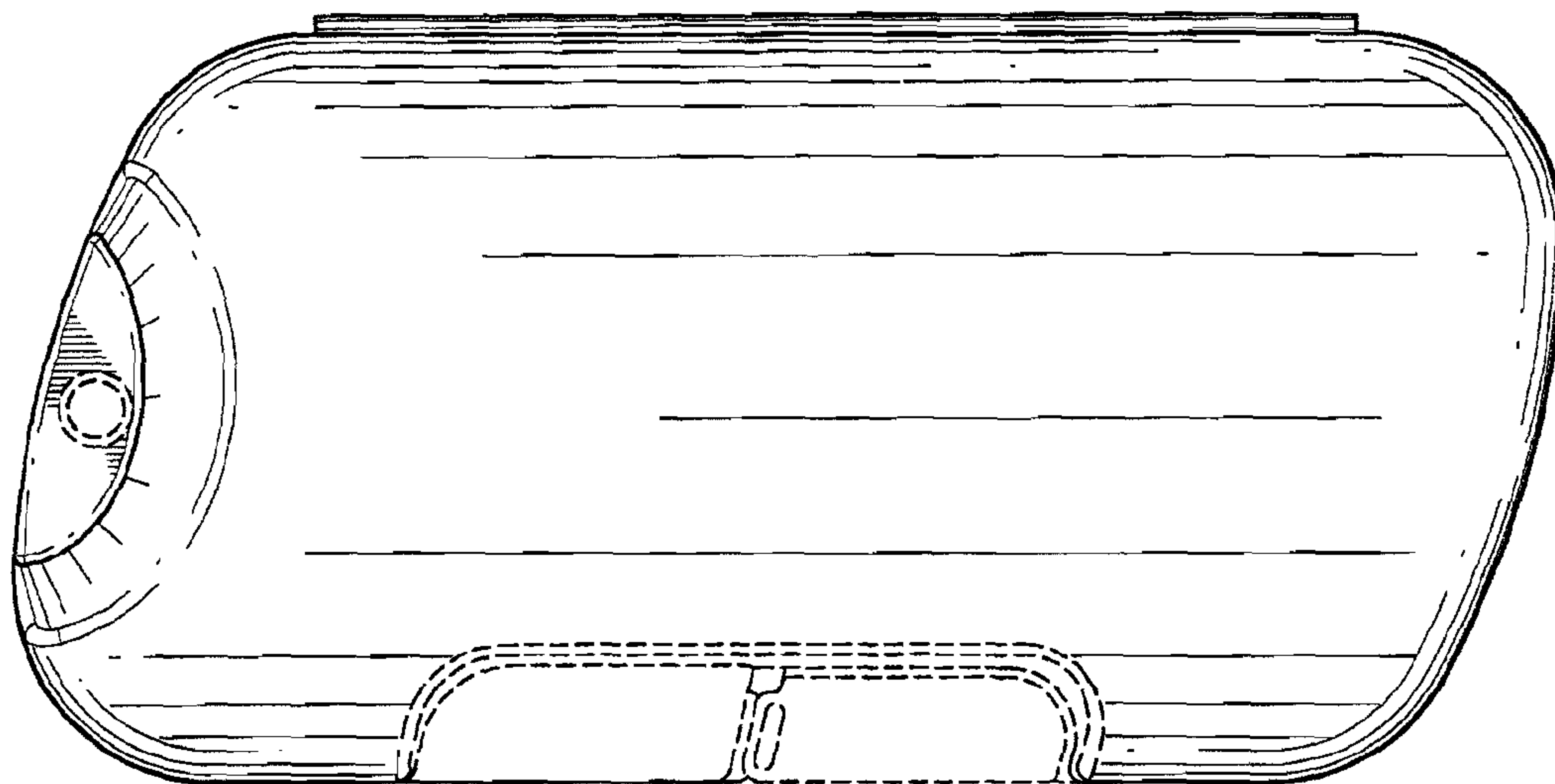

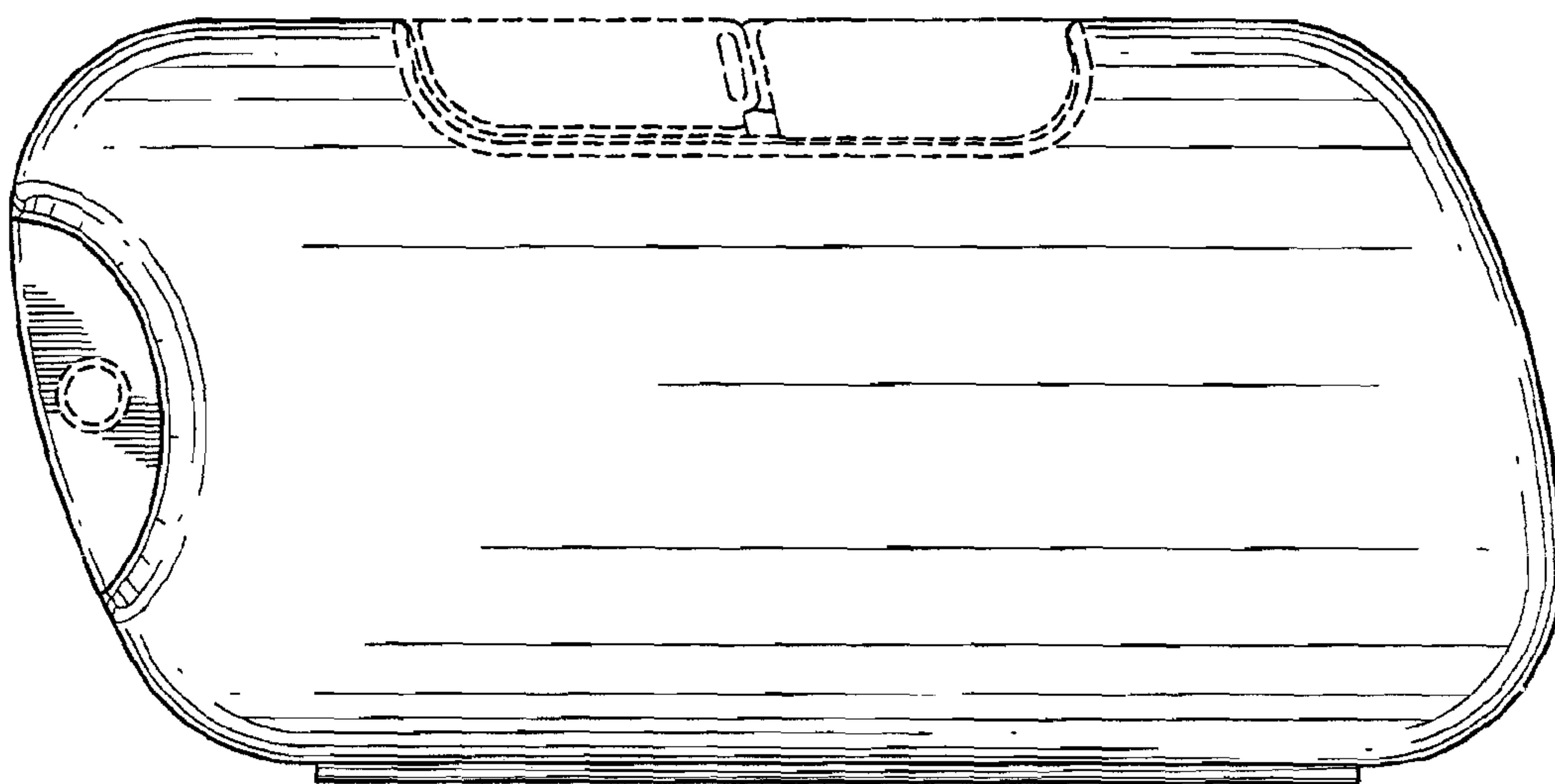

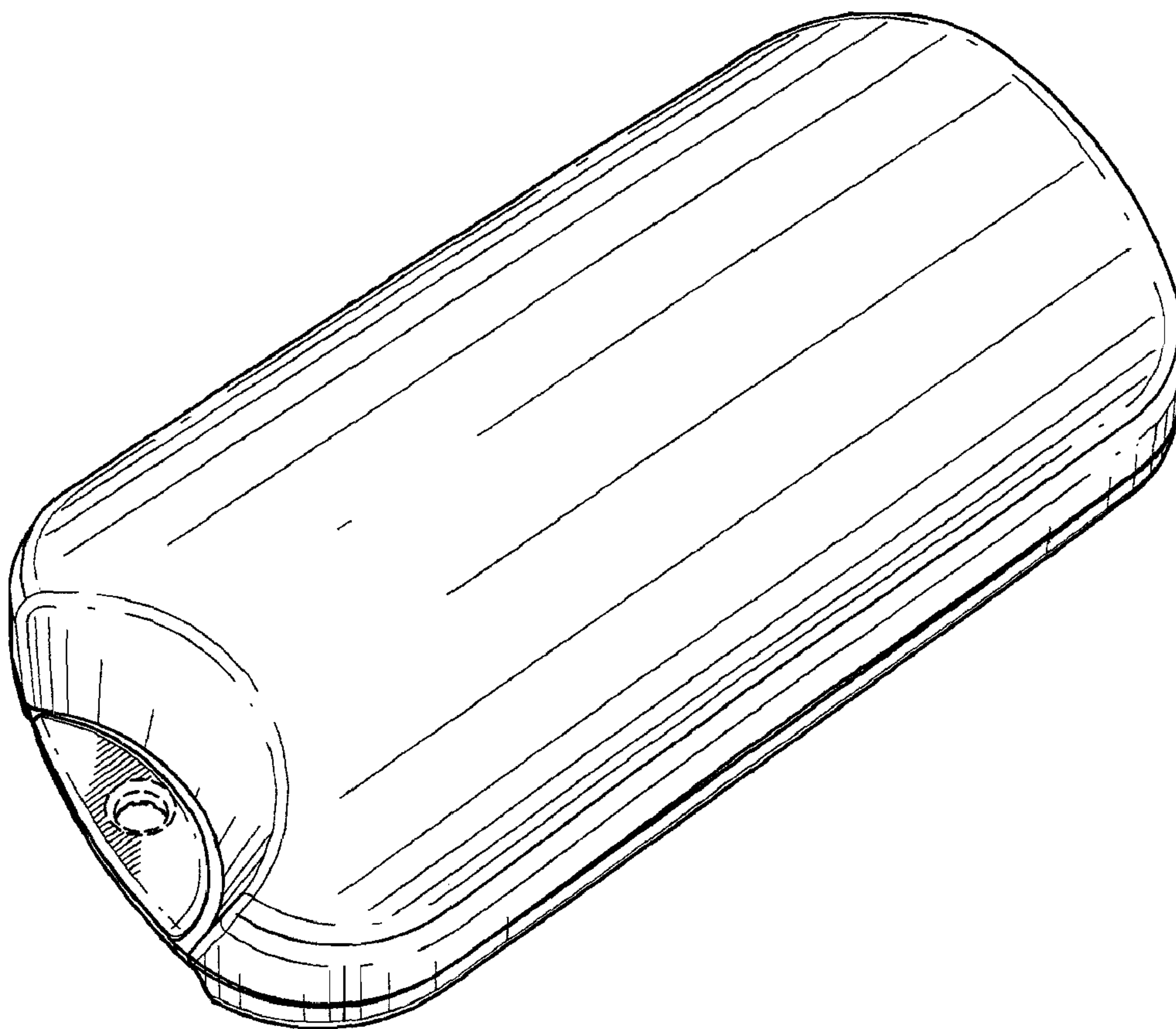

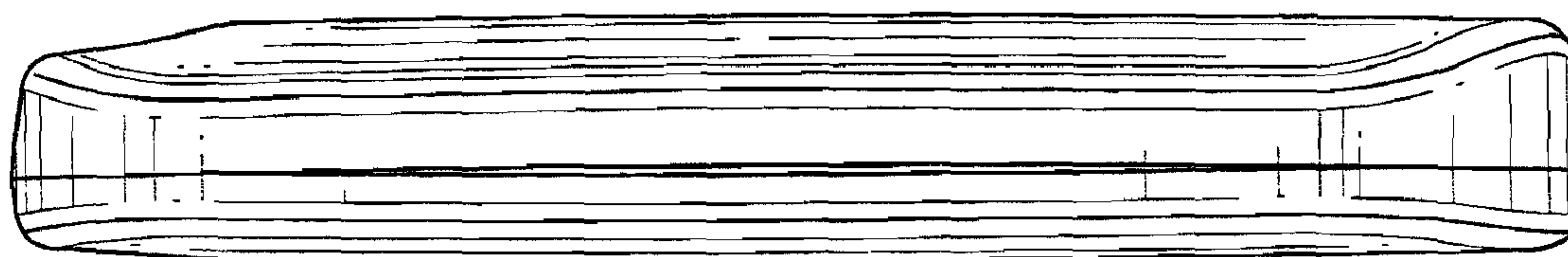

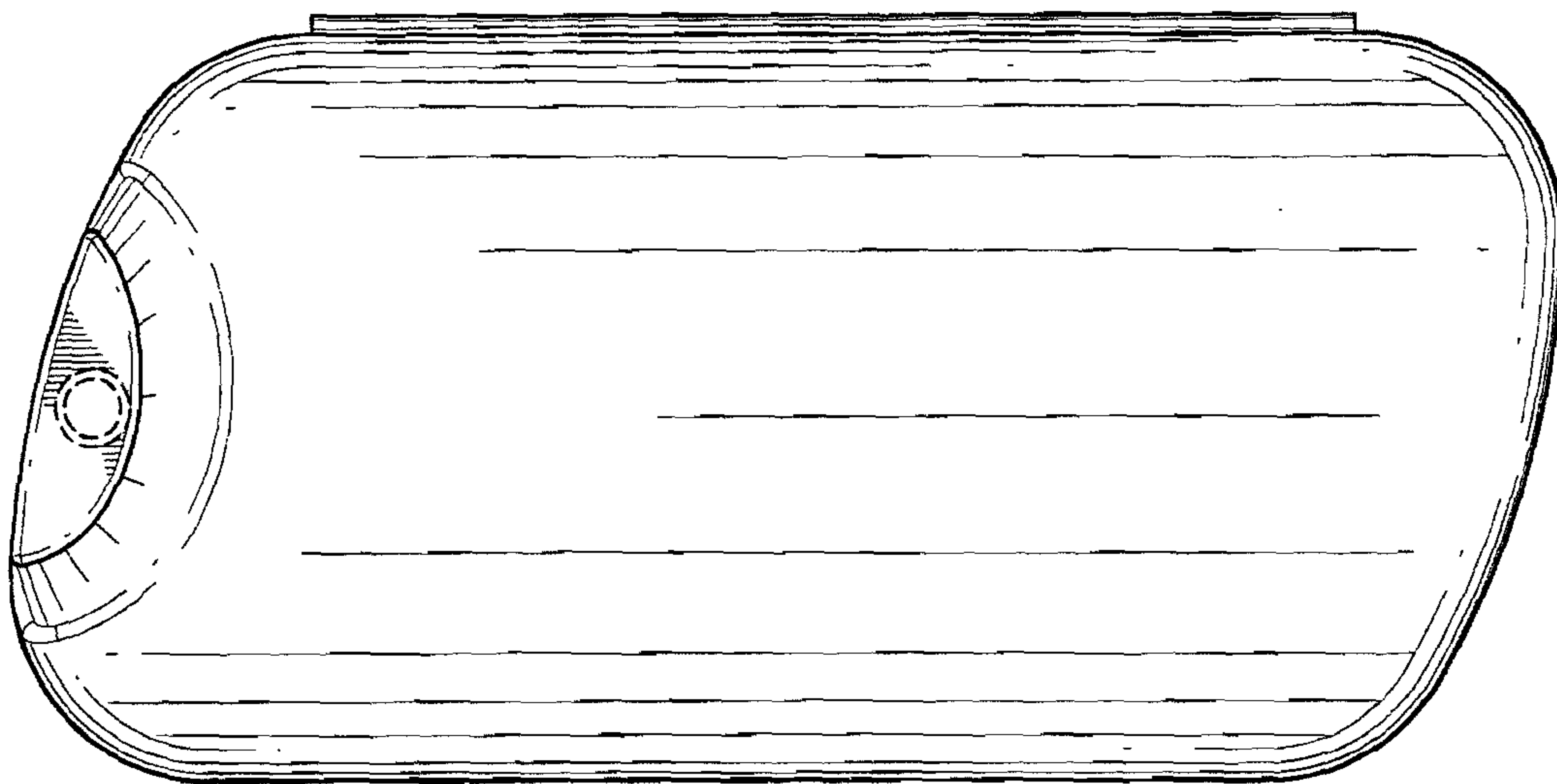

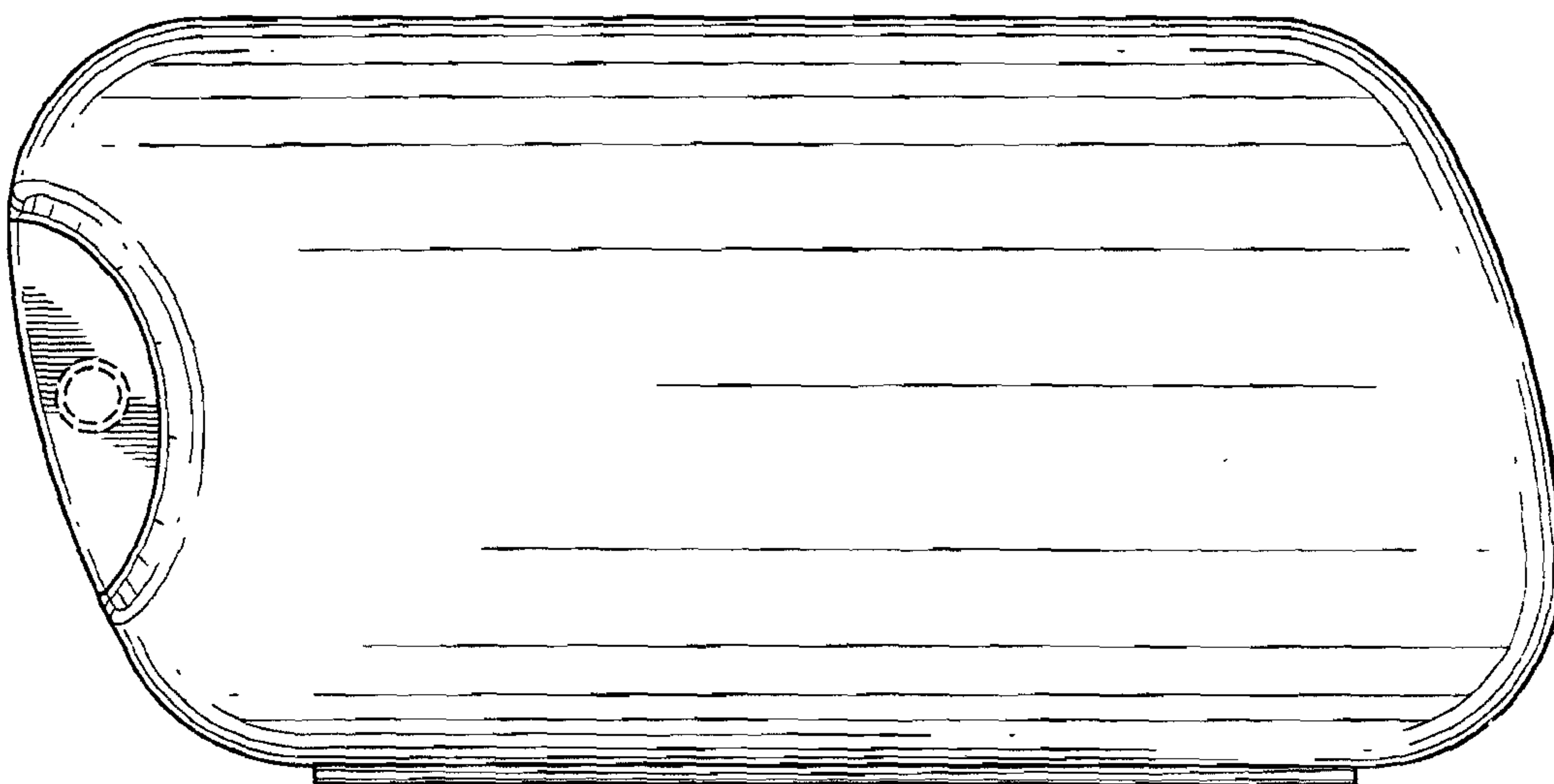
