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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a spout body, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

In a preferred embodiment, the nature of this product is a spout body for a plumbing fitting, such as a bidet faucet.

FIG. 1 is a left, top, front perspective view of a spout body according to my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

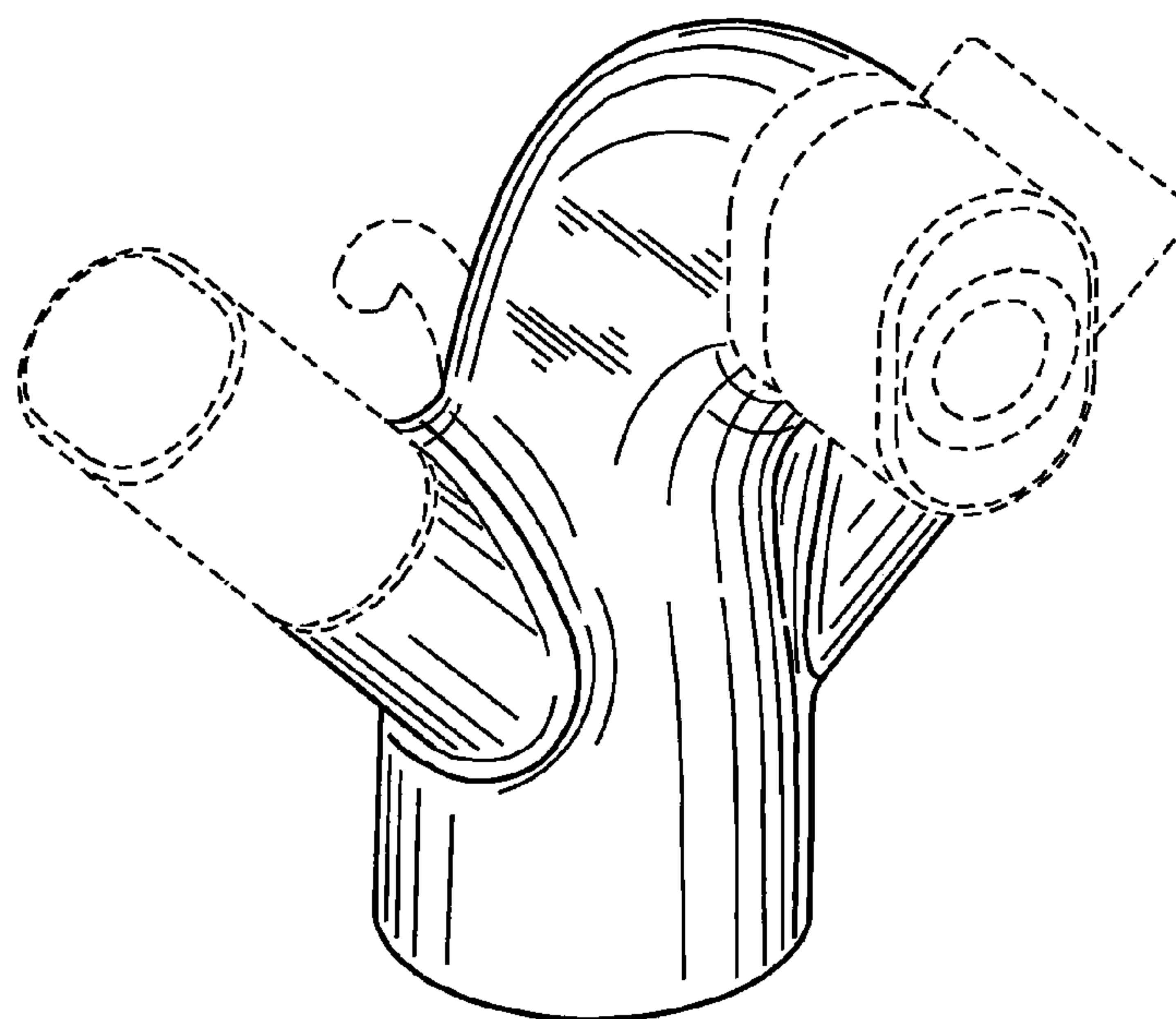
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view thereof being a mirror image of the left side shown;

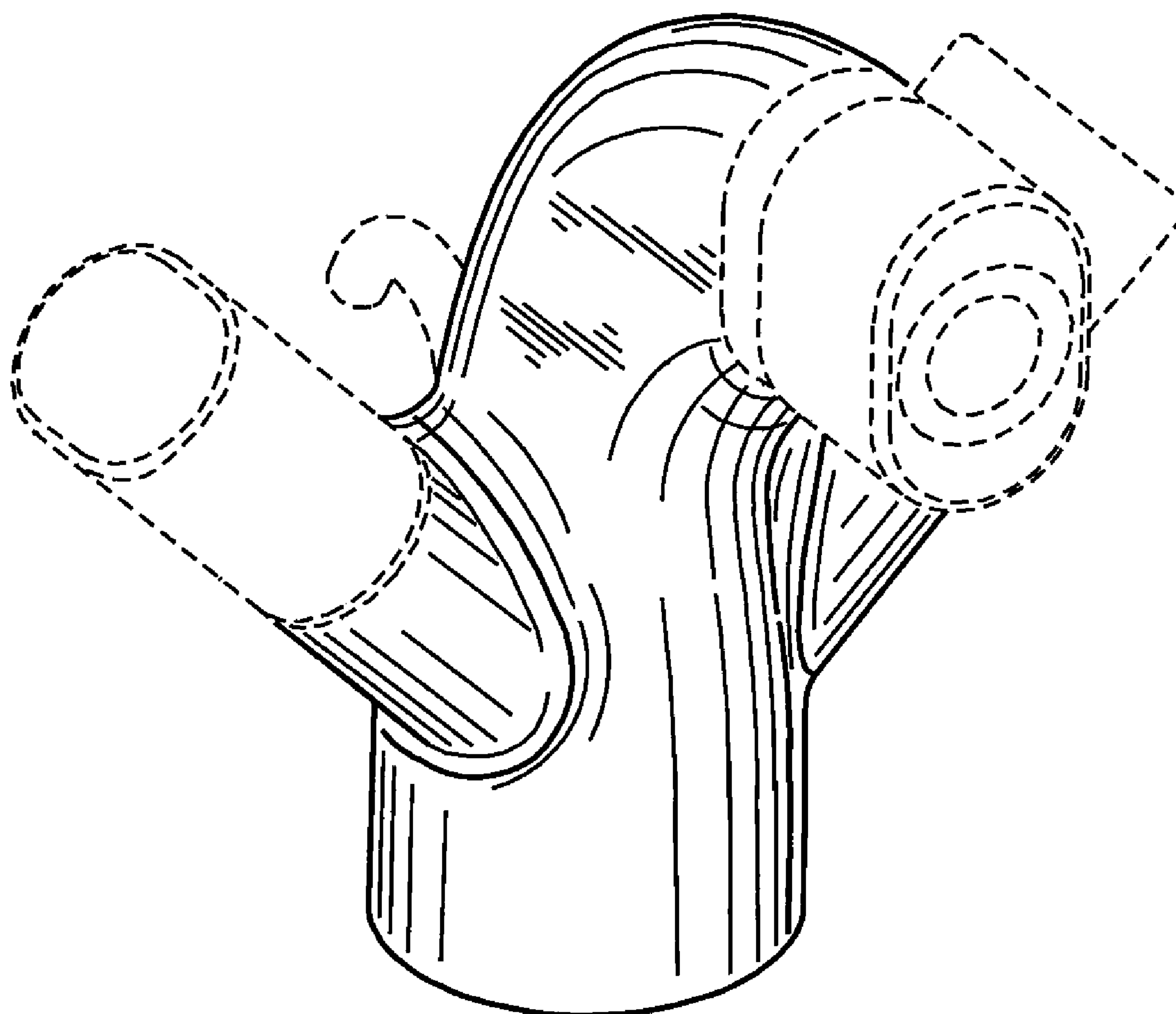

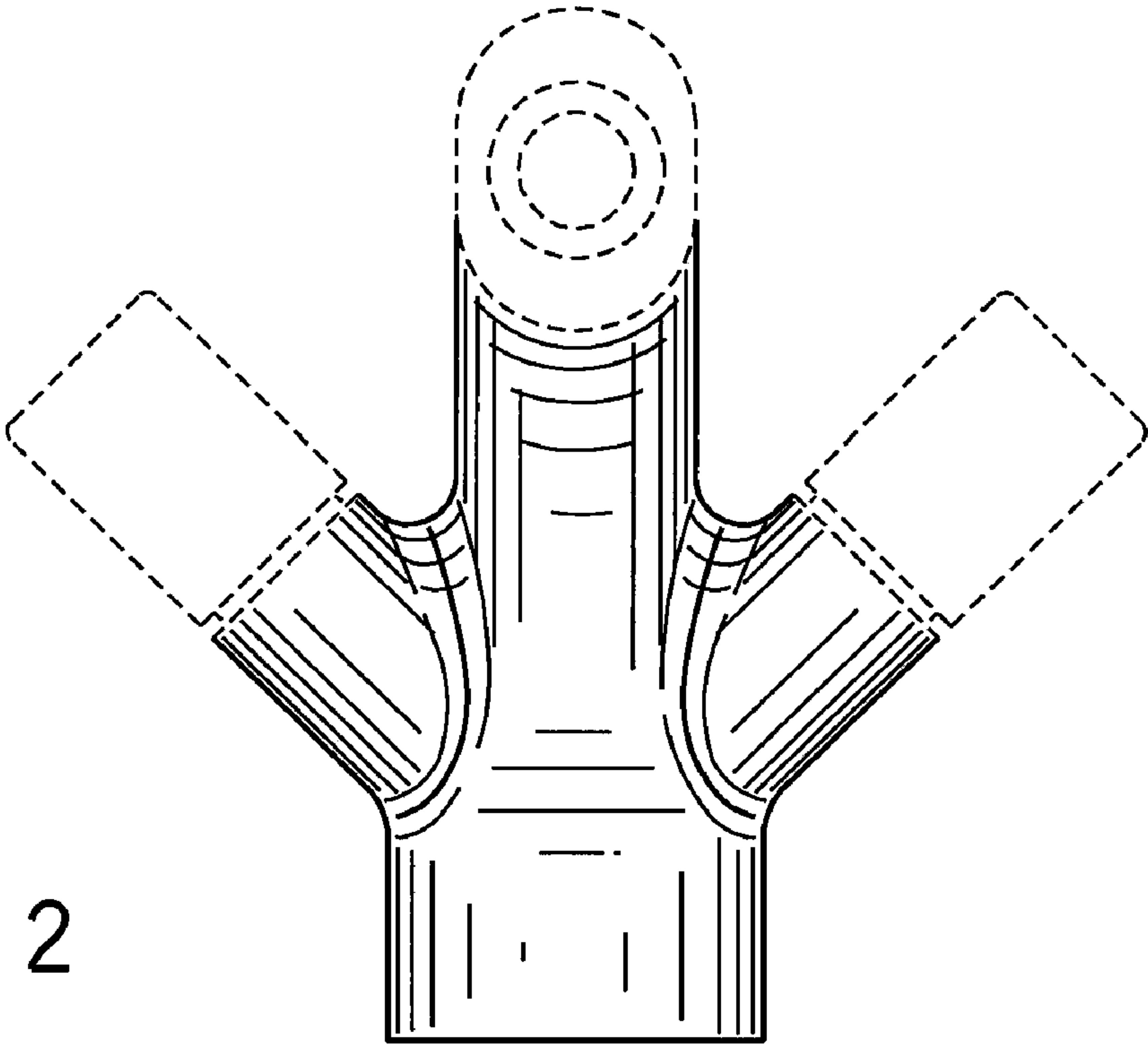
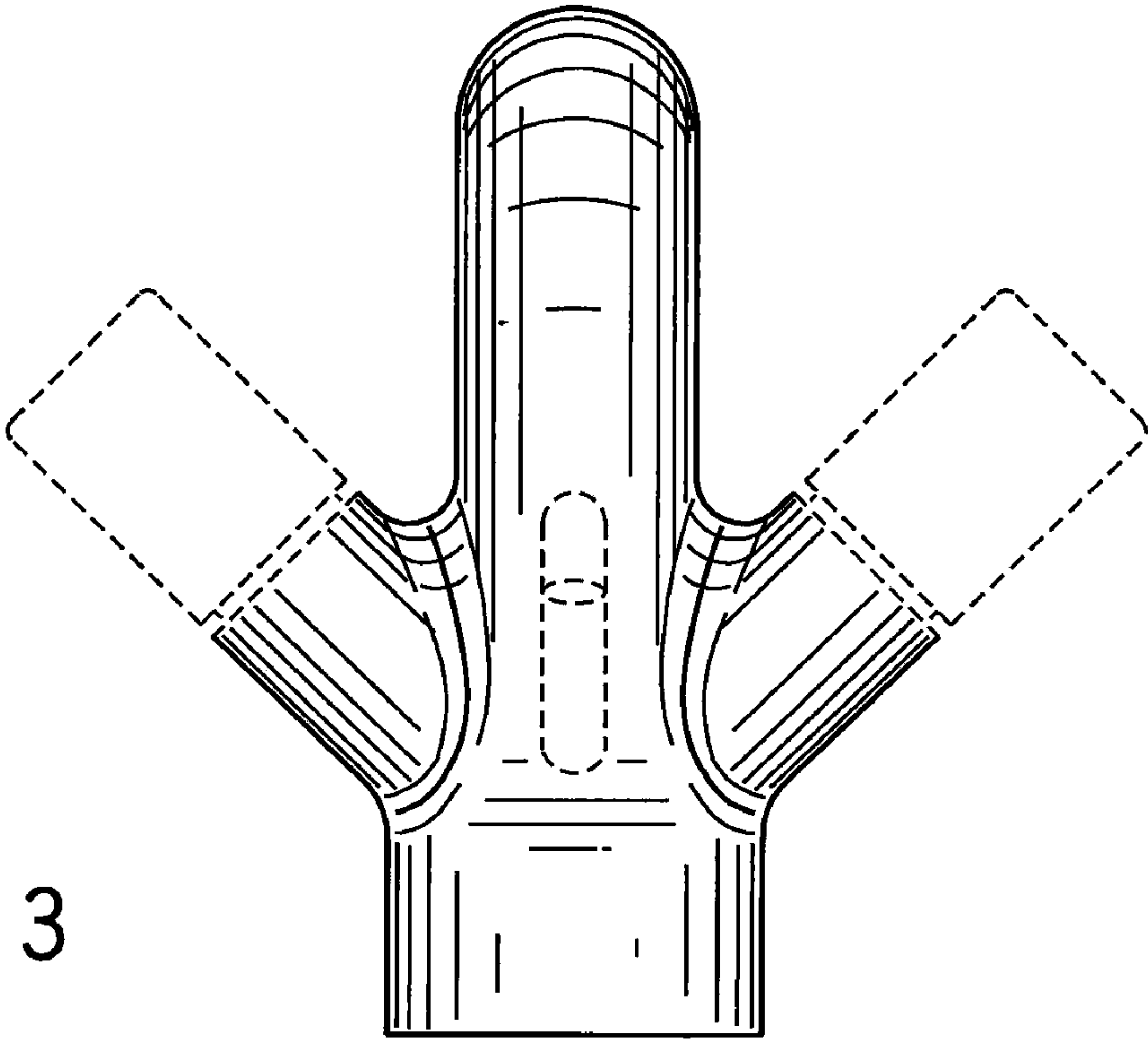

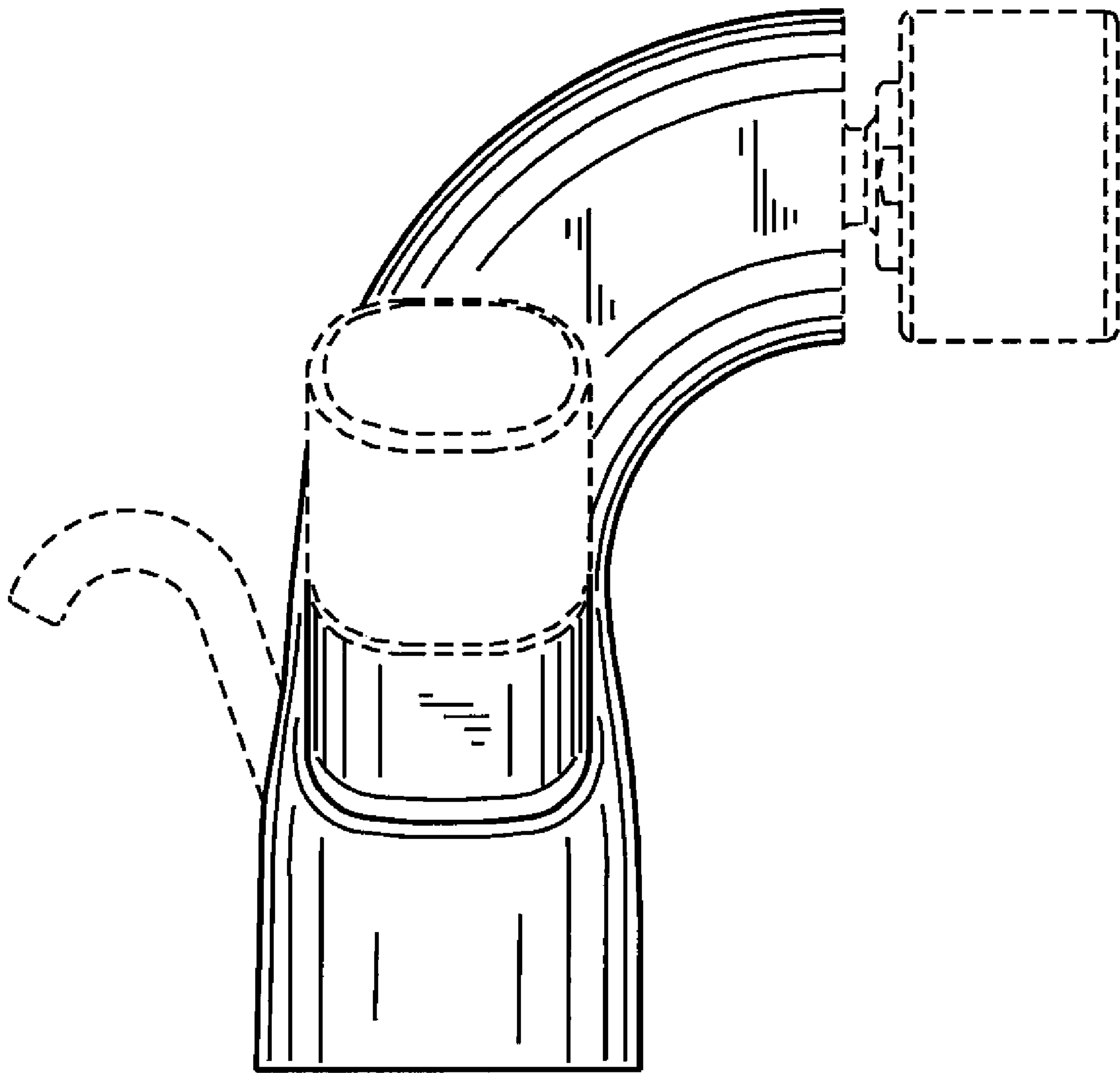

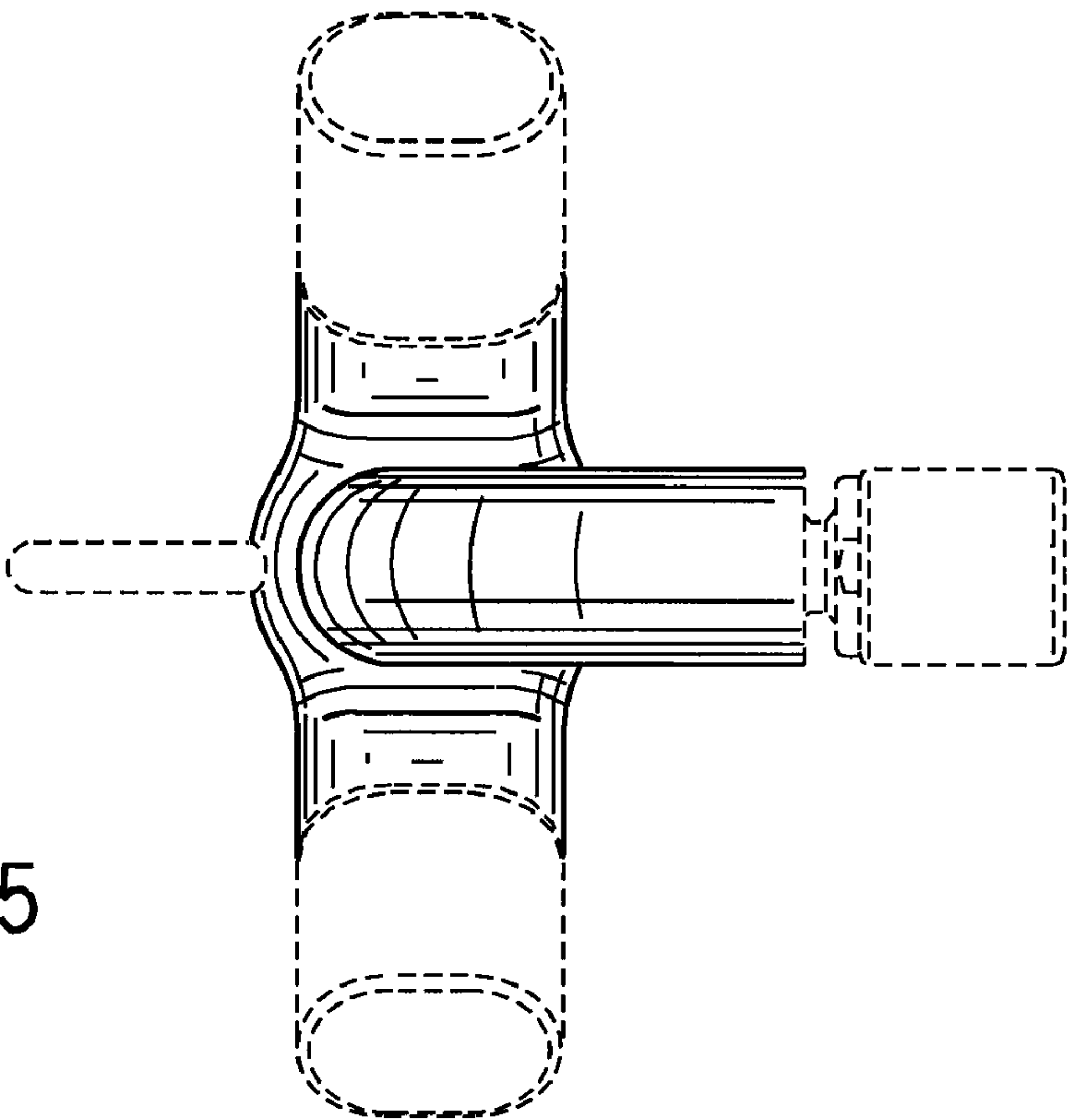
