FIG. 4 is an elevated front view of the pretzel chip shown in FIG. 1.

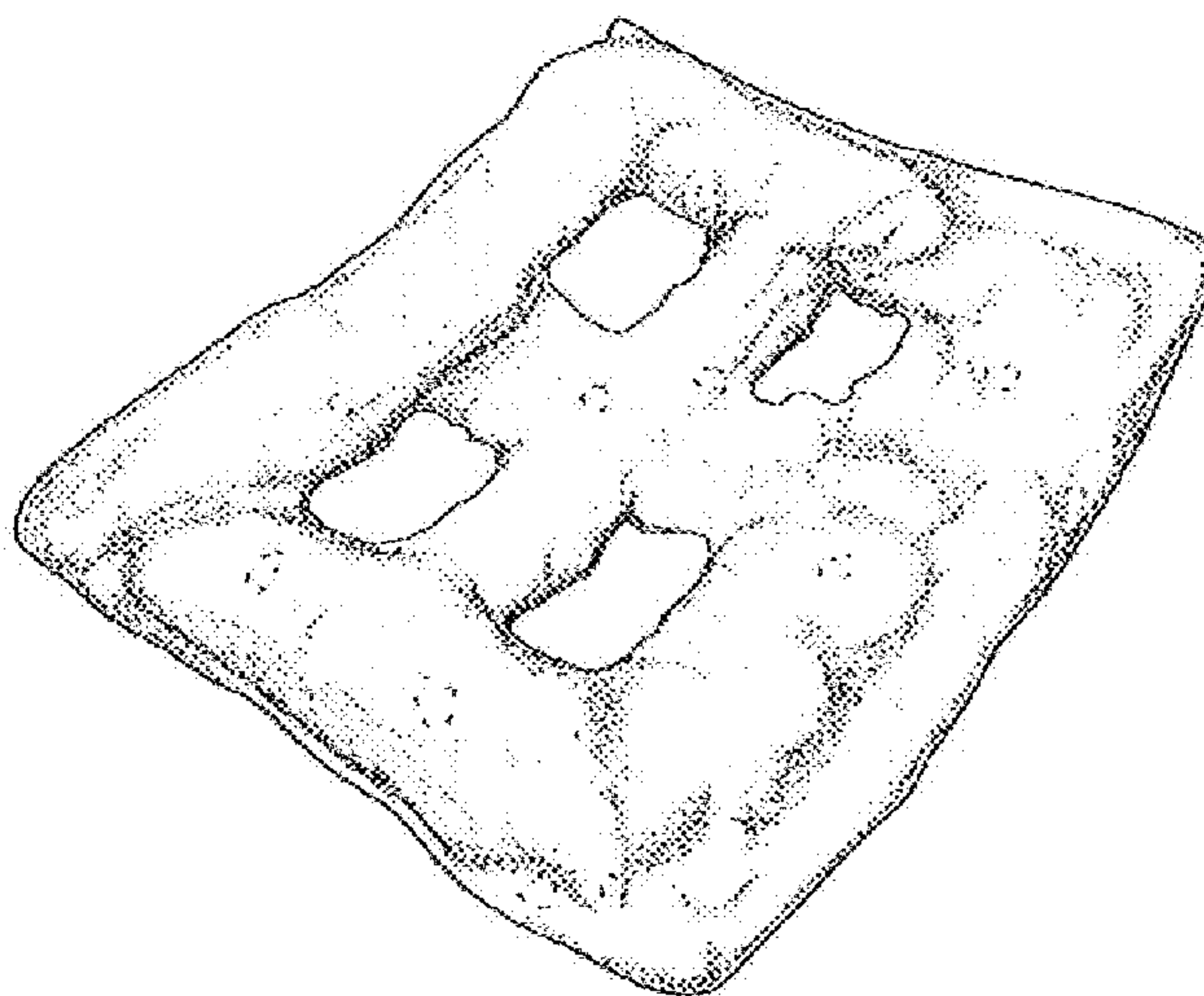
FIG. 5 is an elevated right side view of the pretzel chip shown in FIG. 1.

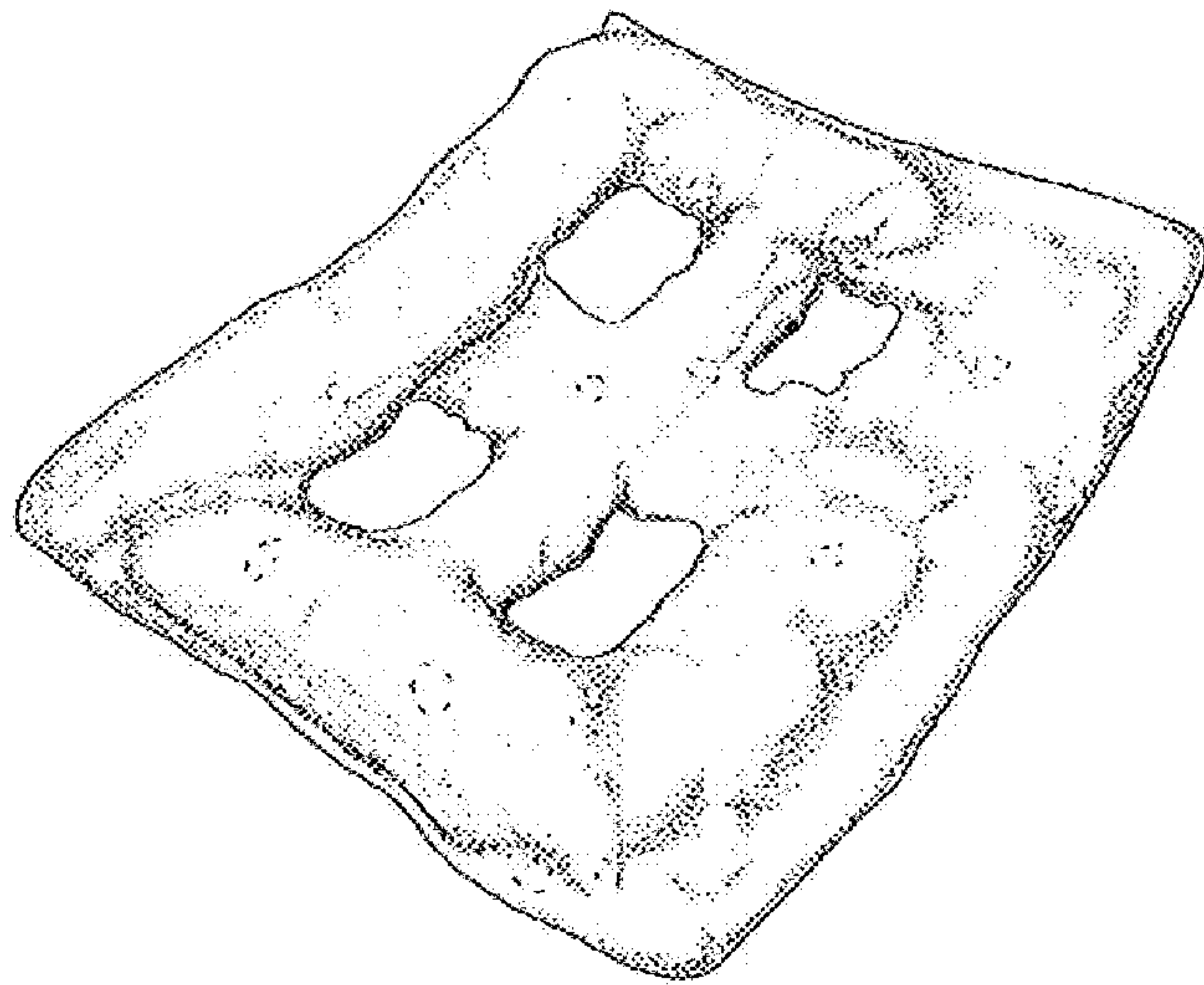

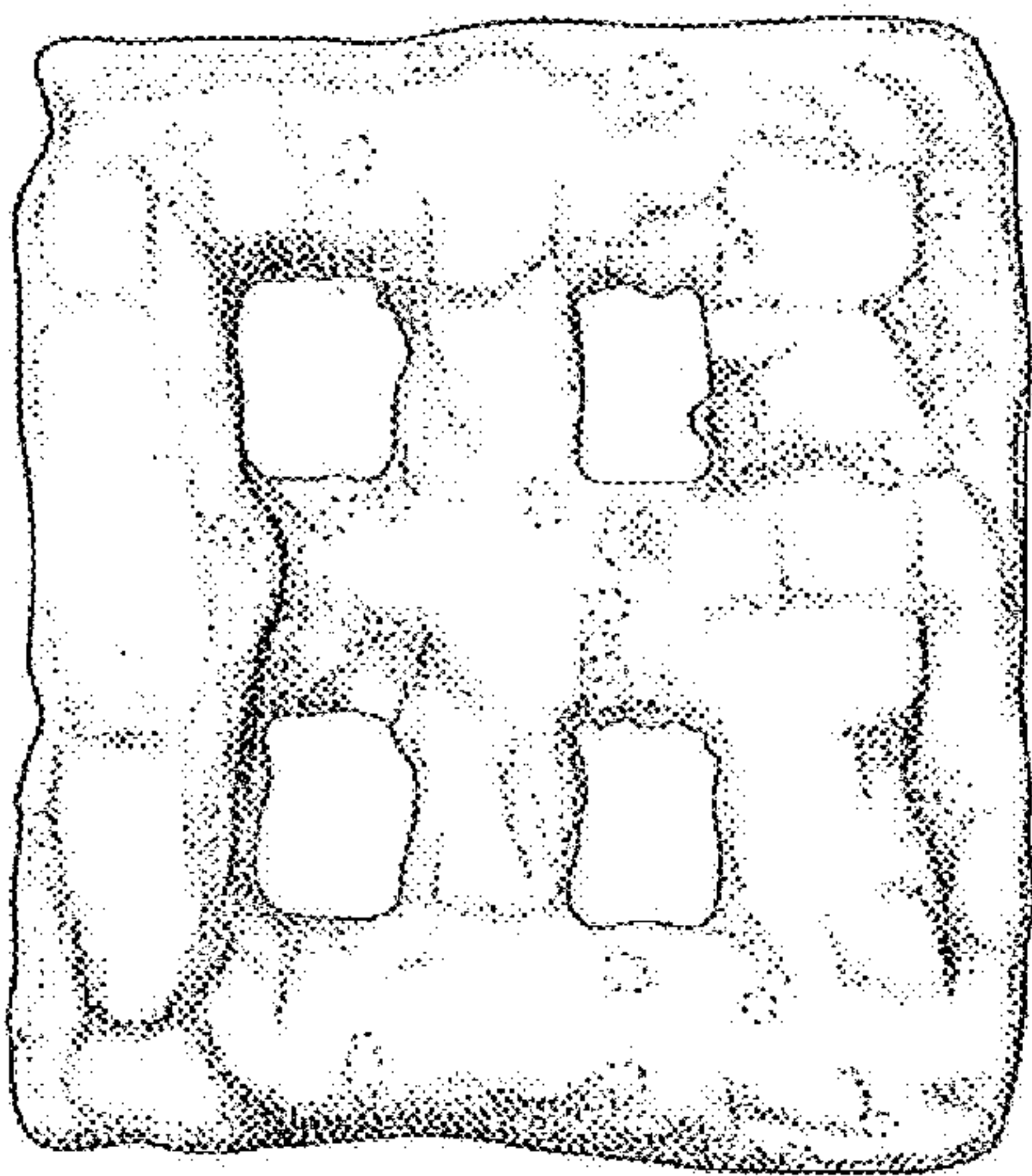

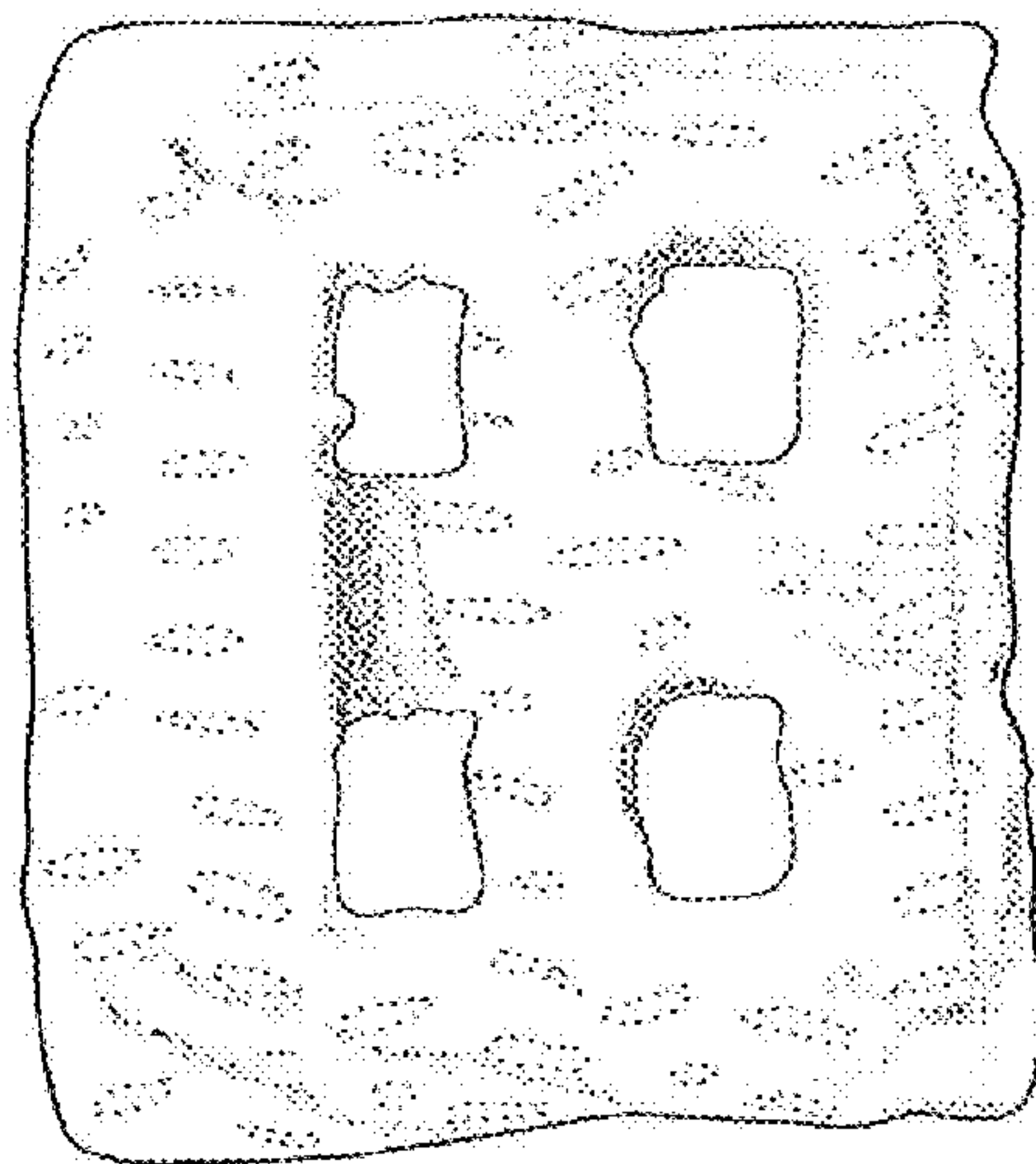

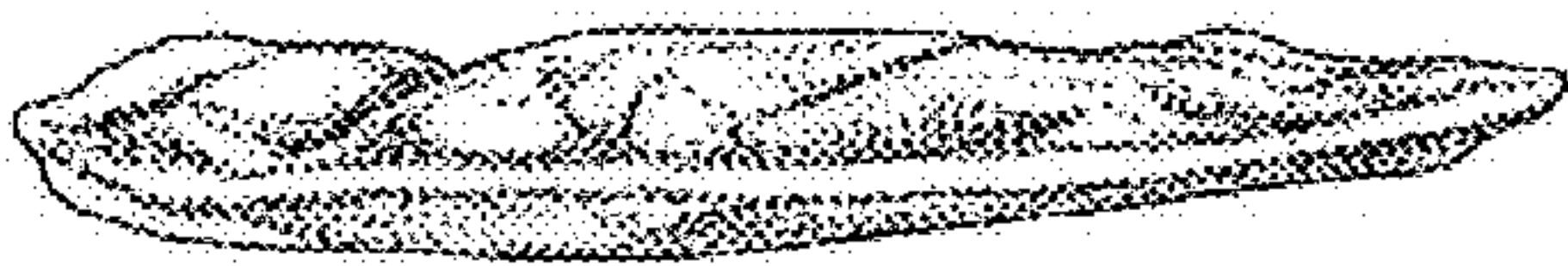

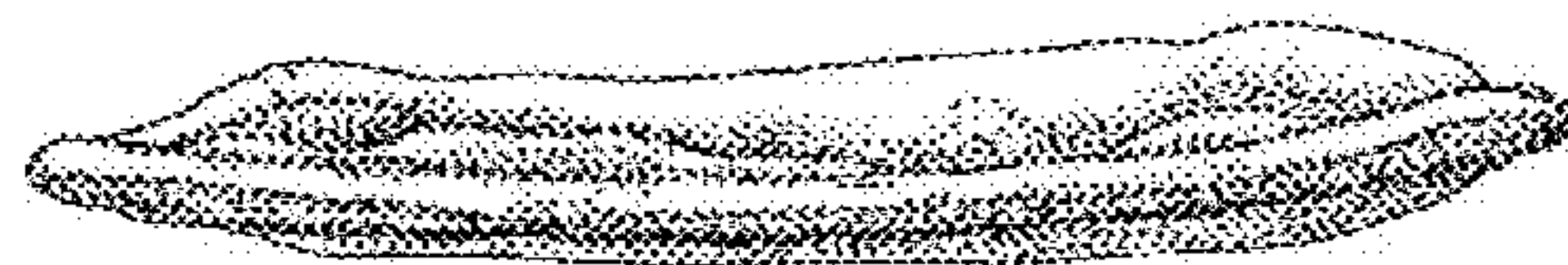

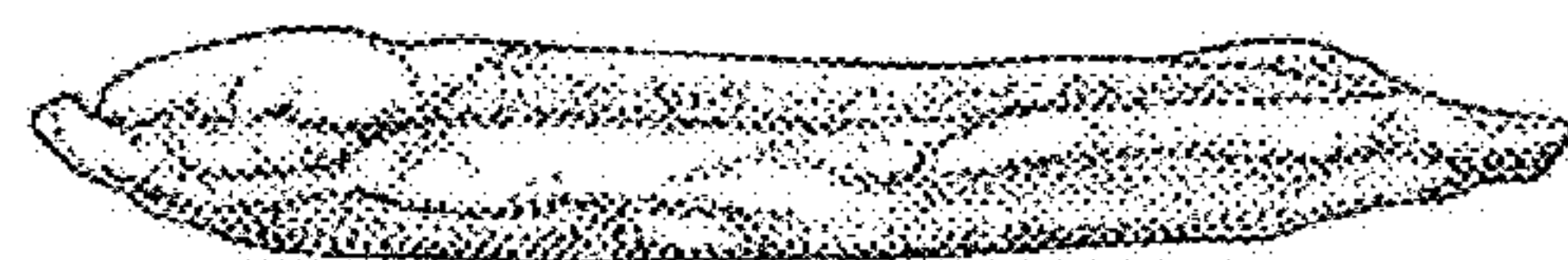
