FIGS. 4 and 5 show opposite side views of FIG. 1;

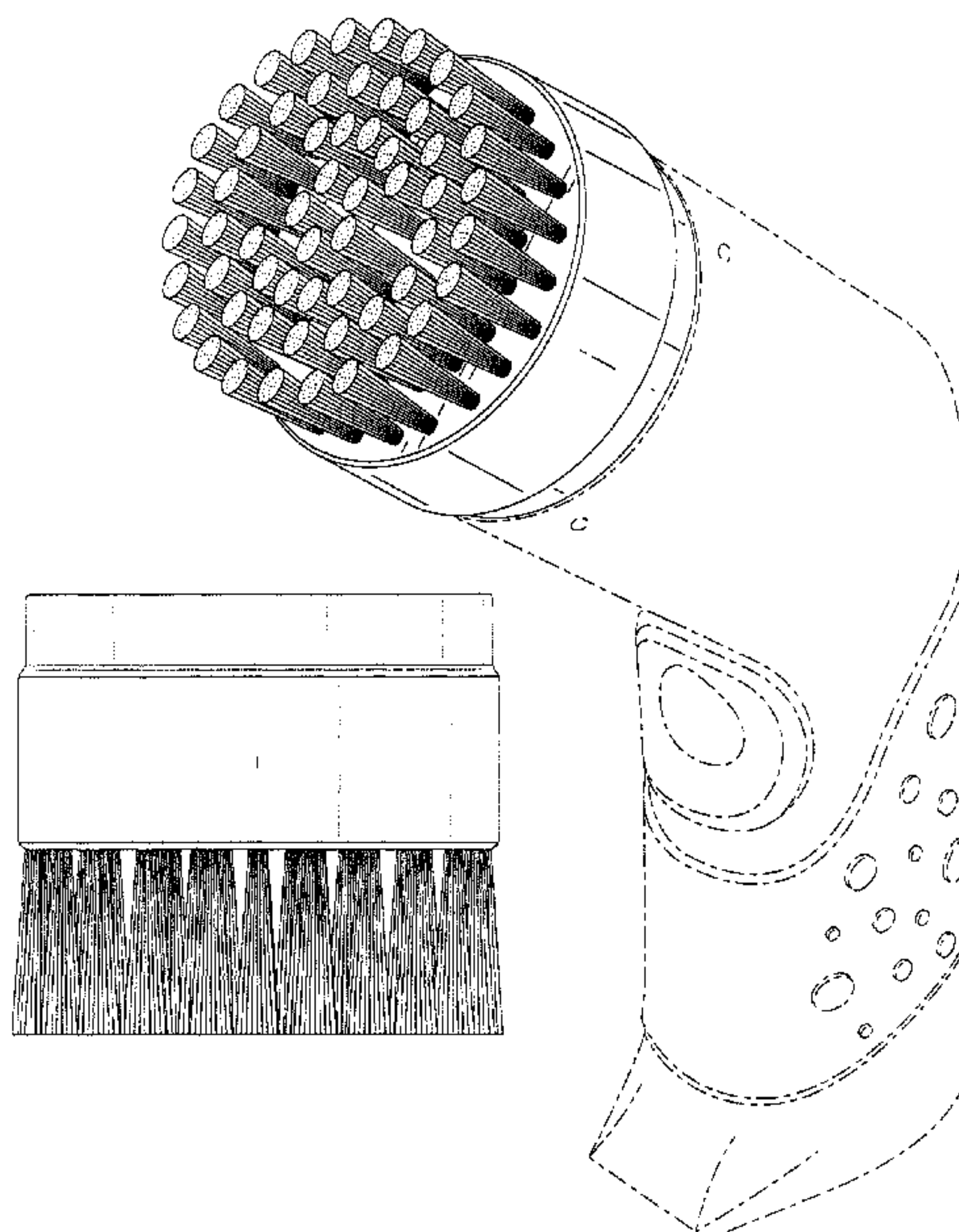
FIG. 6 shows a front view of FIG. 1;

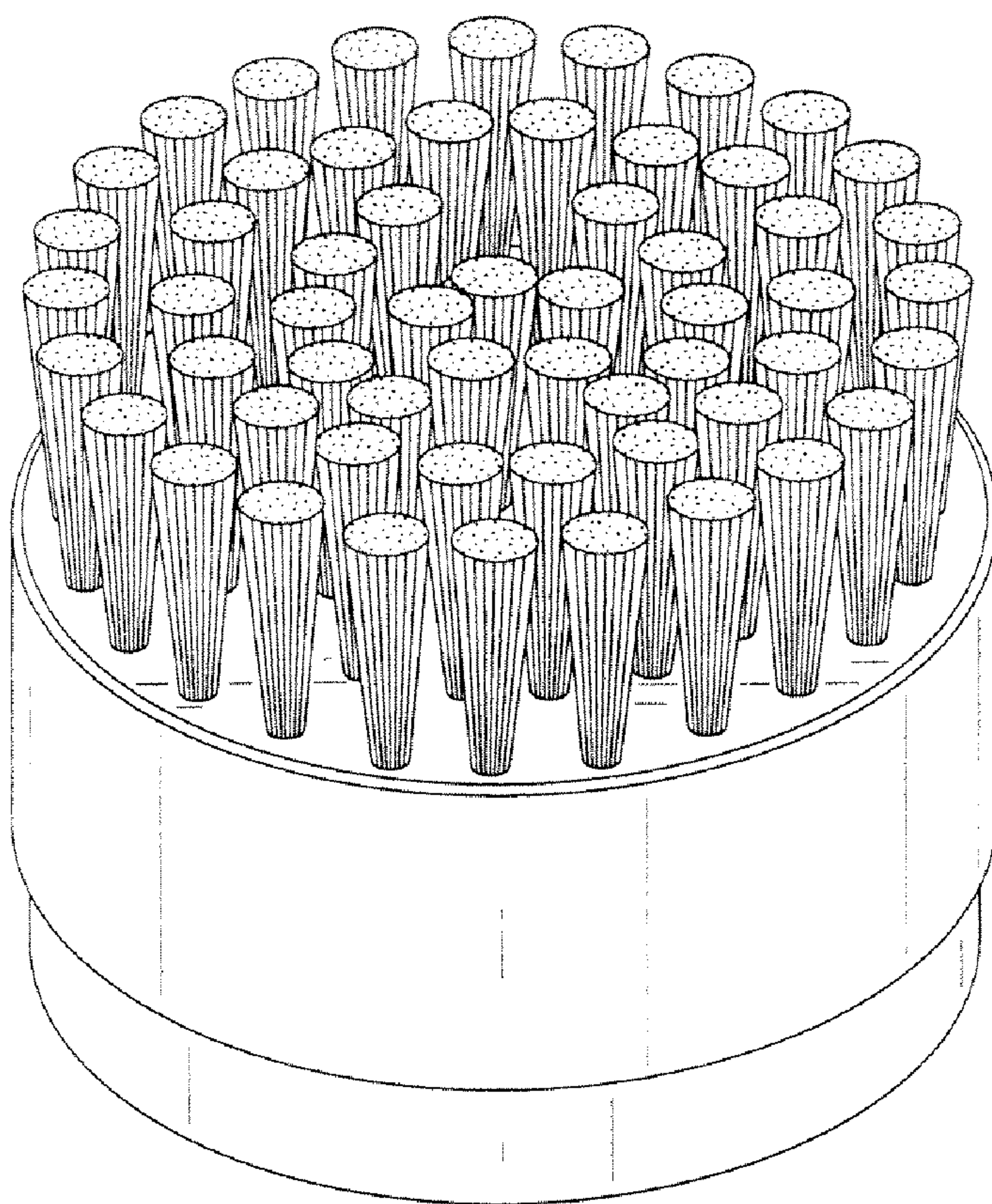

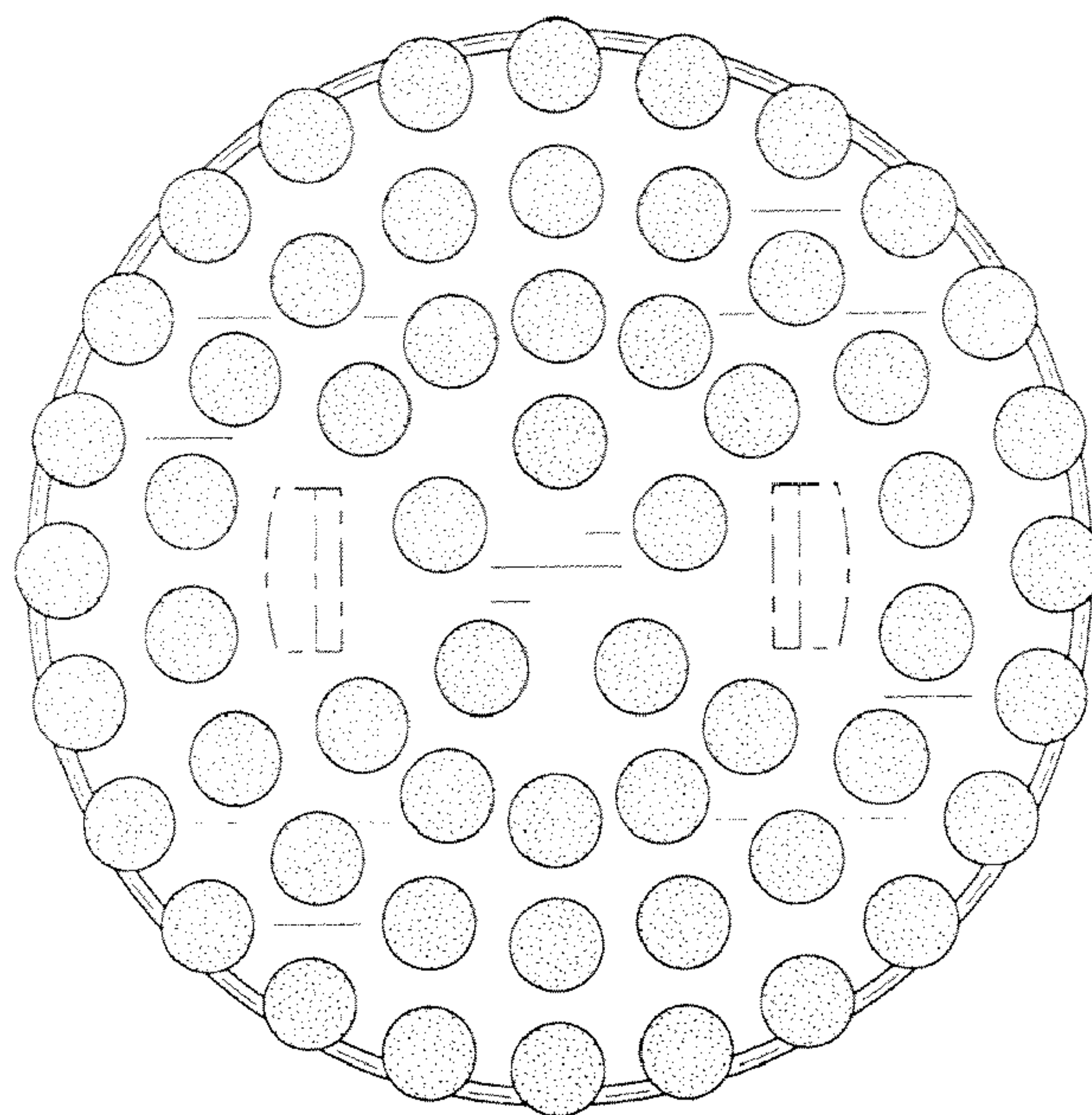

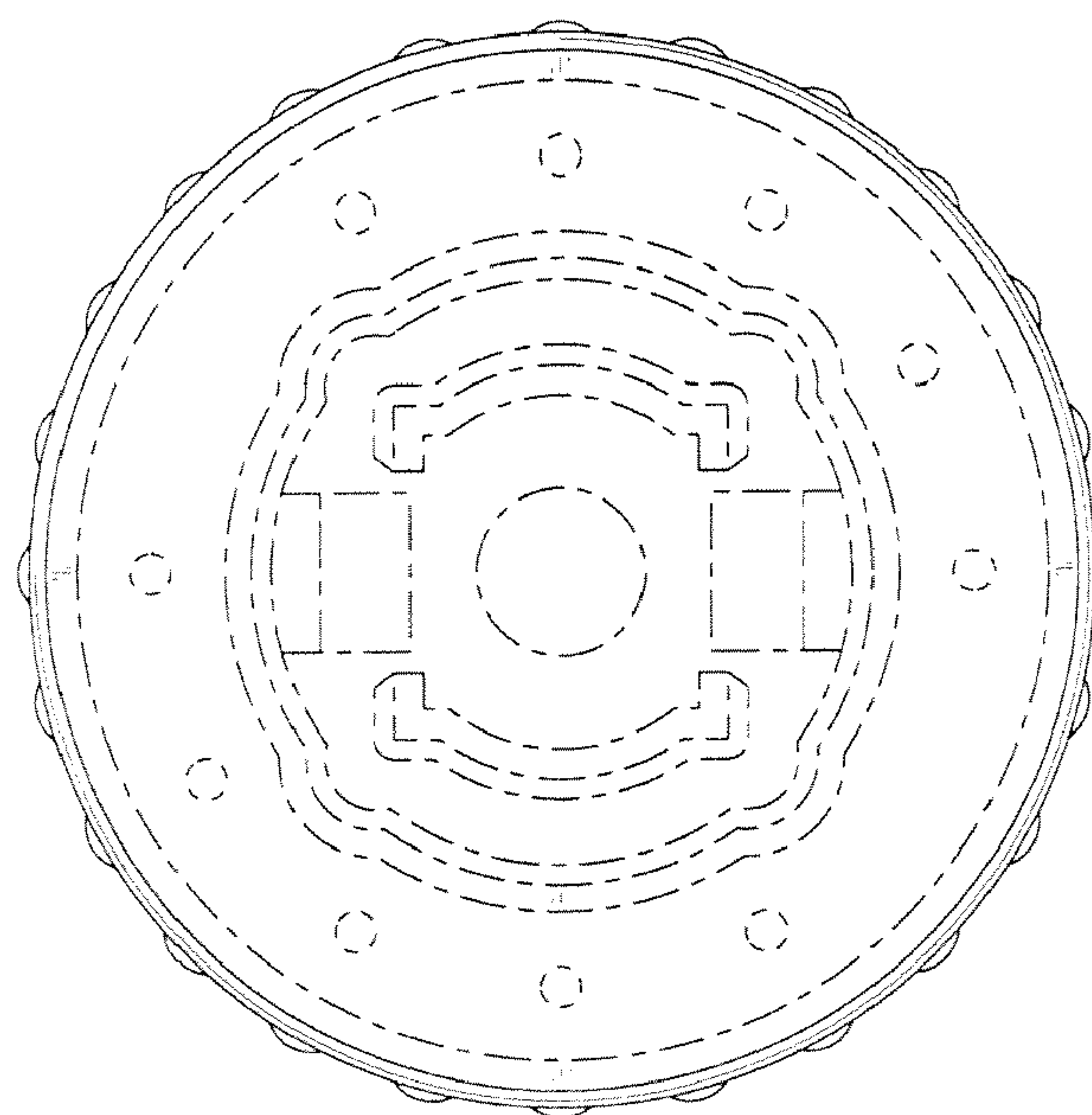

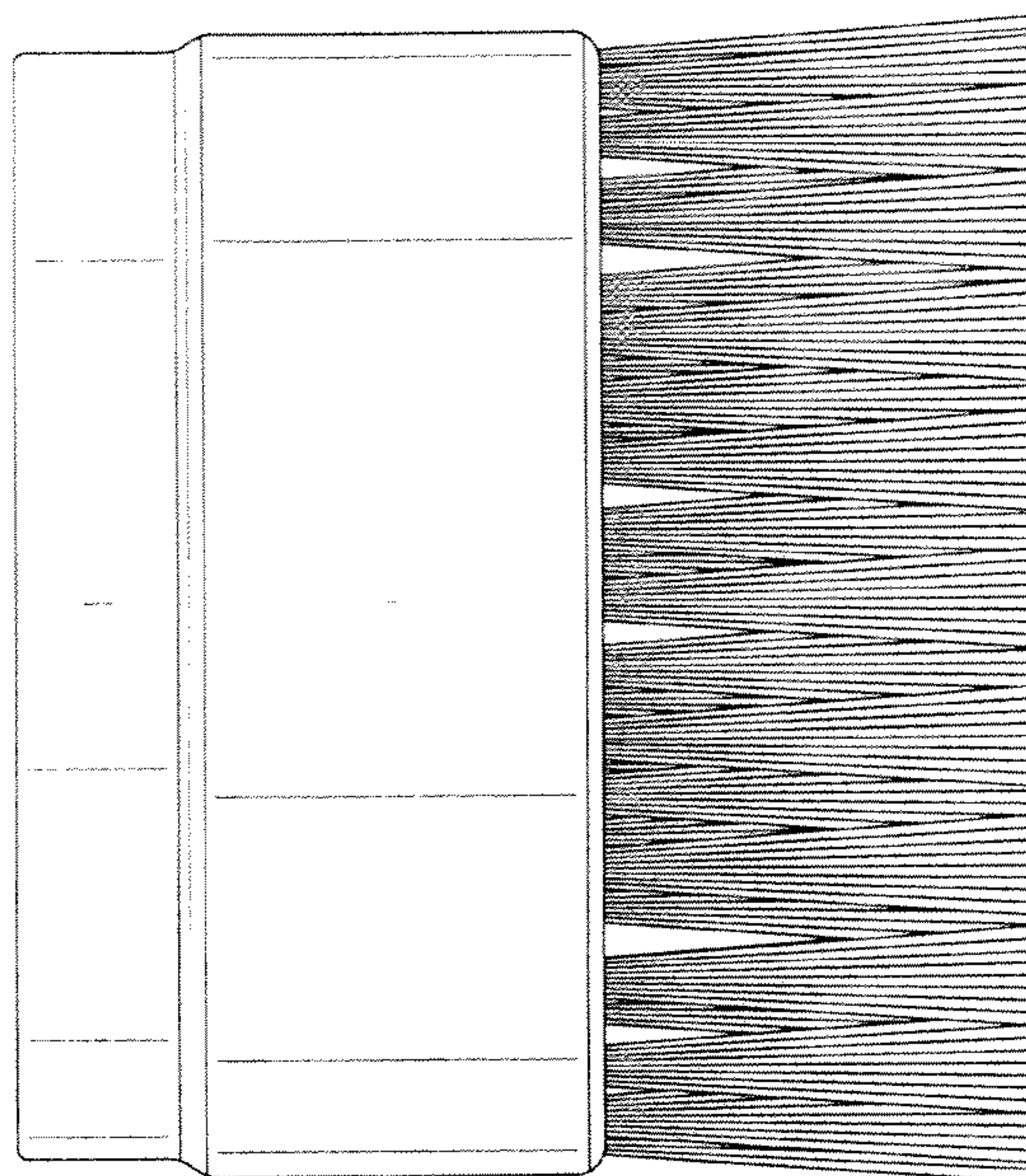

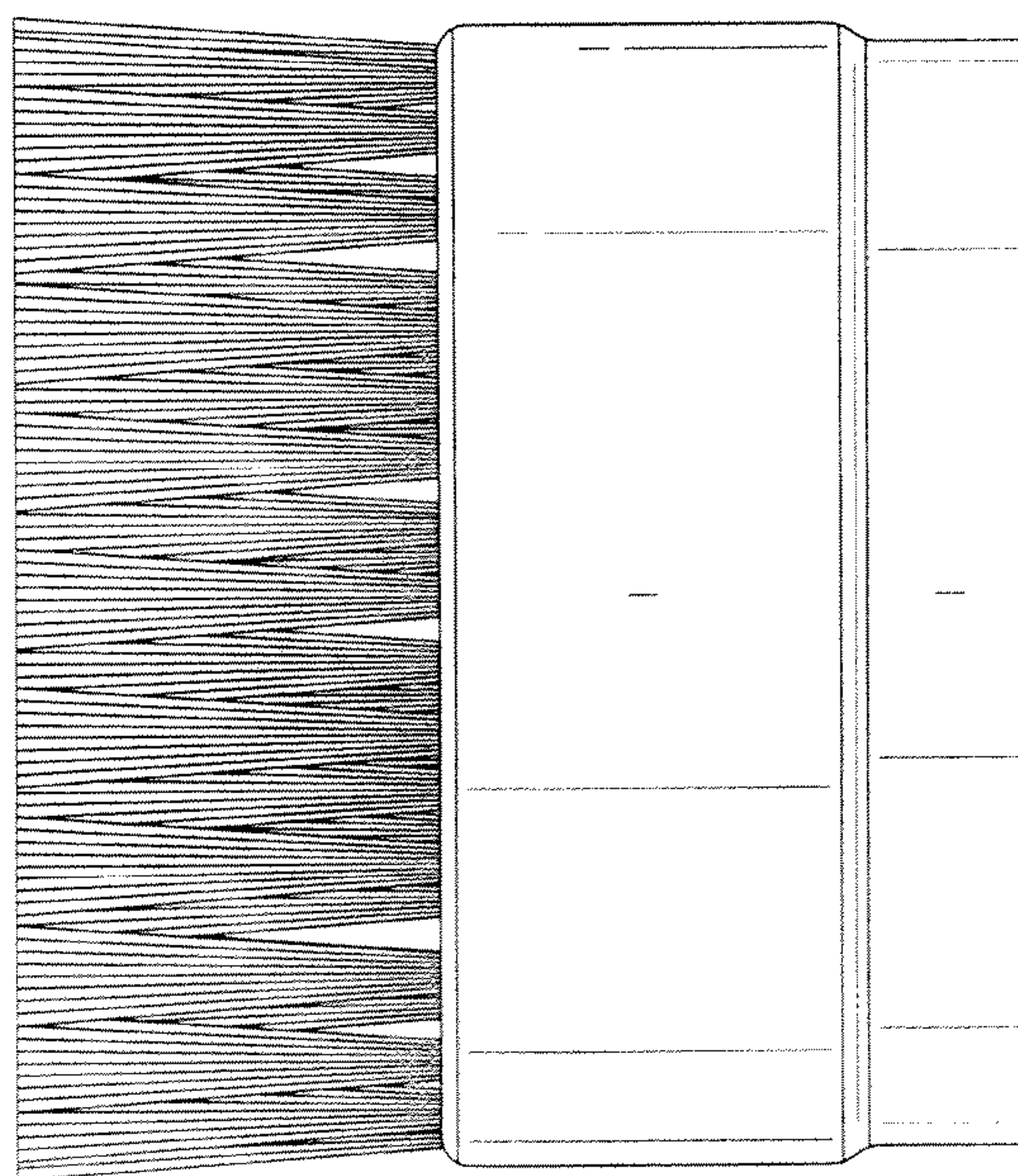

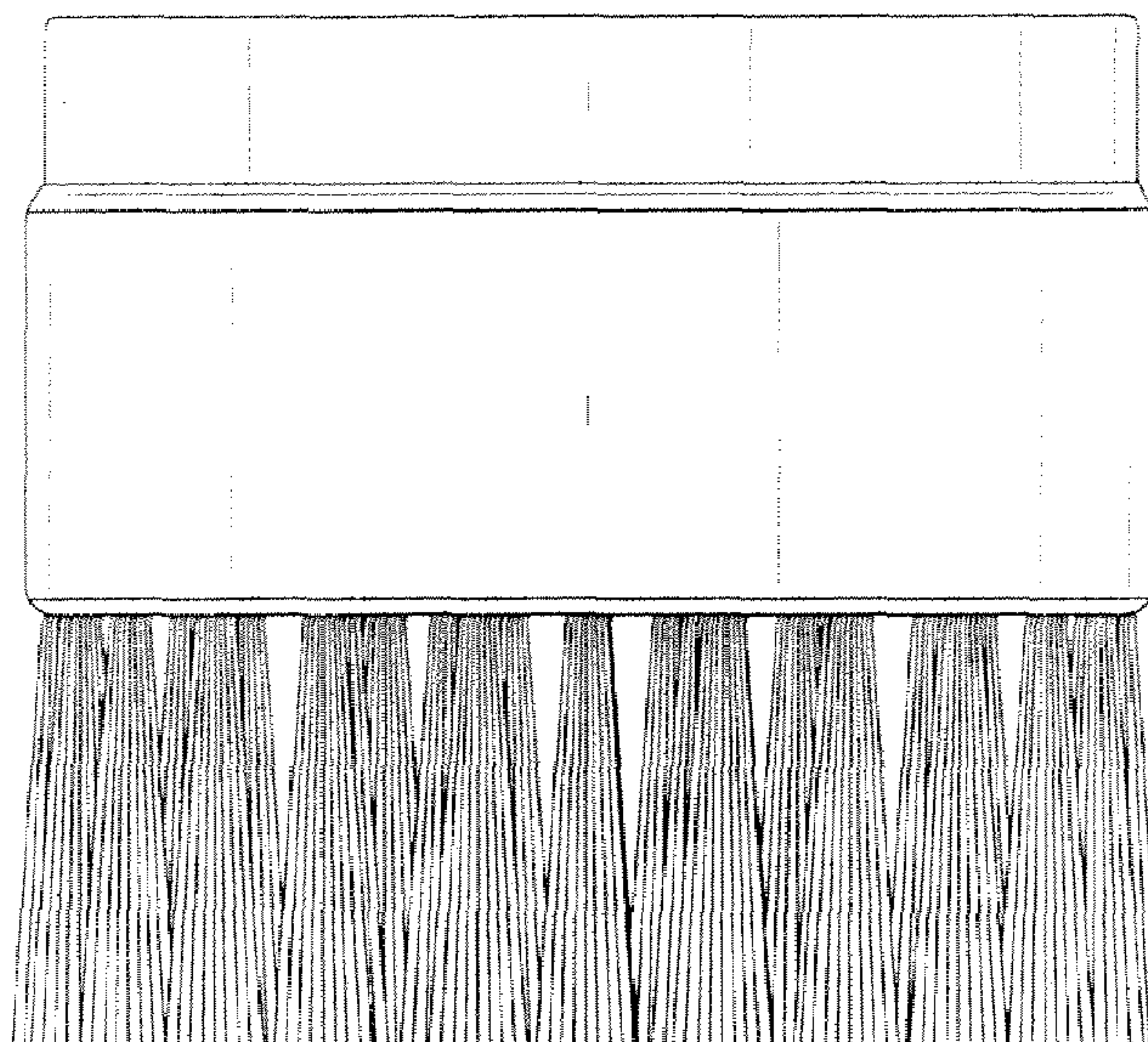

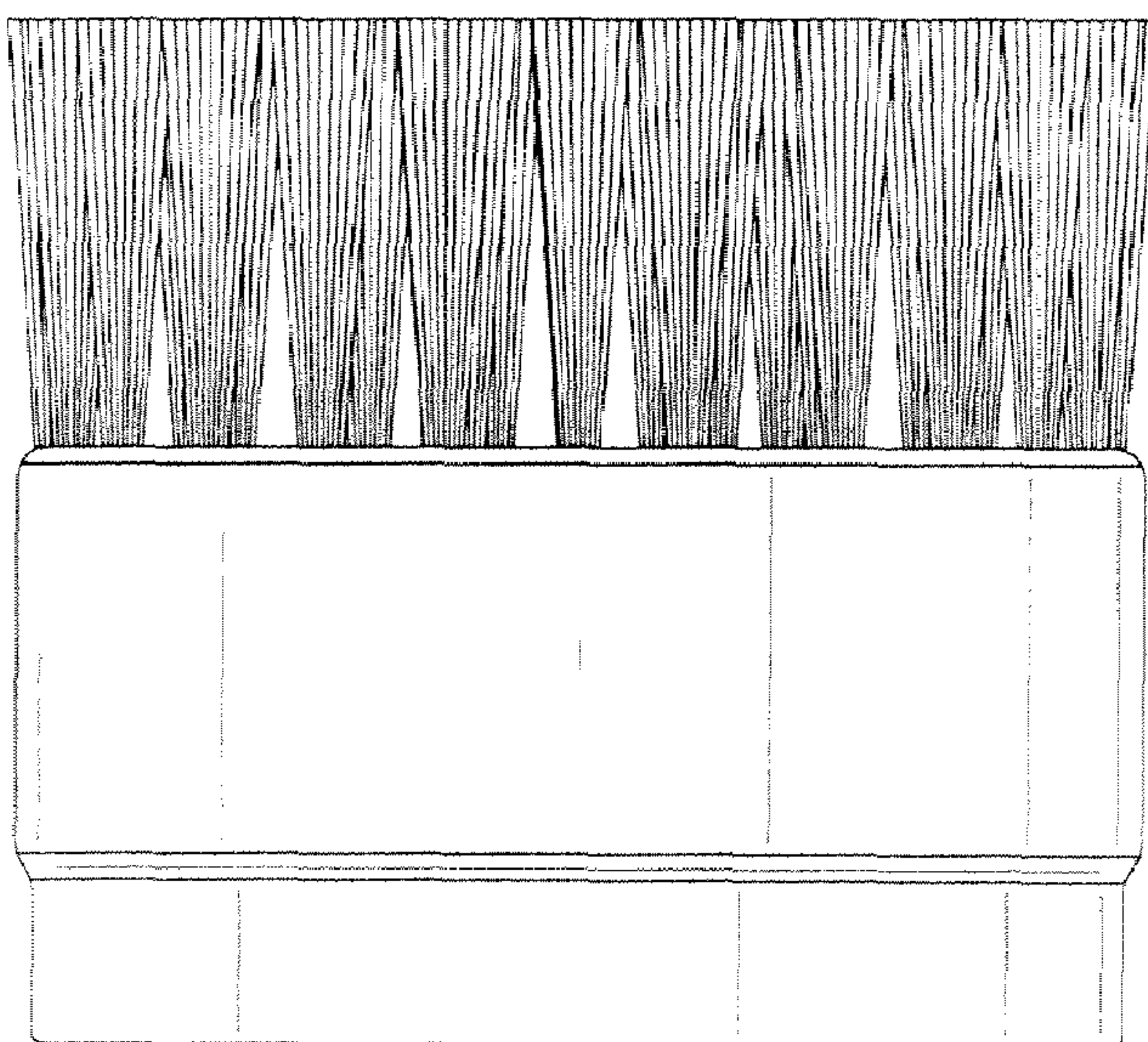

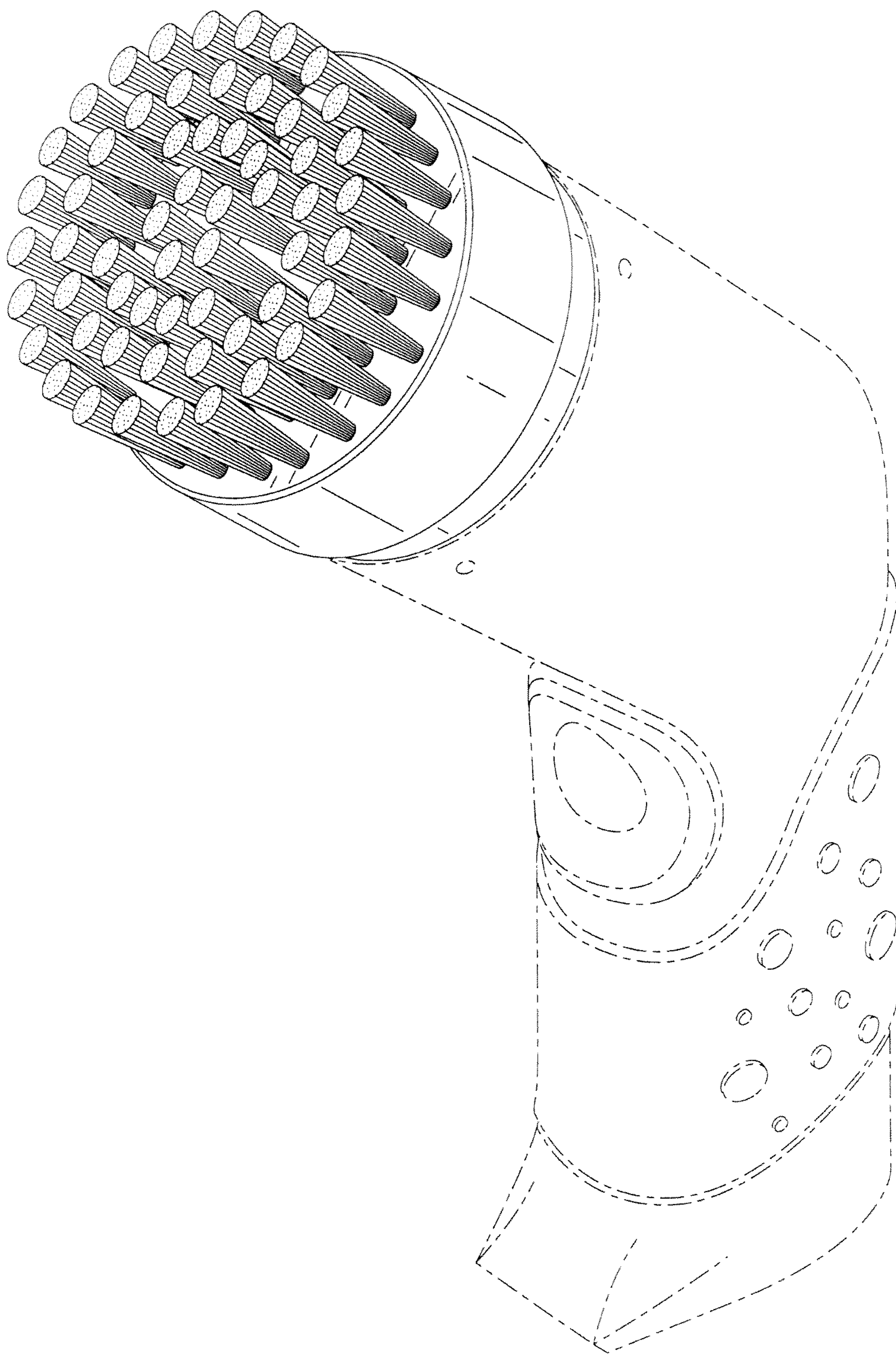
