DESCRIPTION

This application is related to design patent application Ser.
Nos. 29/305,603; 29/305,605; 29/305,606; 29/305,607;
29/305,610; 29/305,612; and 29/305,615, which are filed
concurrently herewith.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the front, left side, and
top of a chair base which forms my new design, the broken
lines of a chair and casters being for illustrative purposes only
and forming no part of my design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof.

The characteristic feature of the design resides in the appli-
cation of parts having the appearance of an automotive disk
brake and spring to the base of a chair.

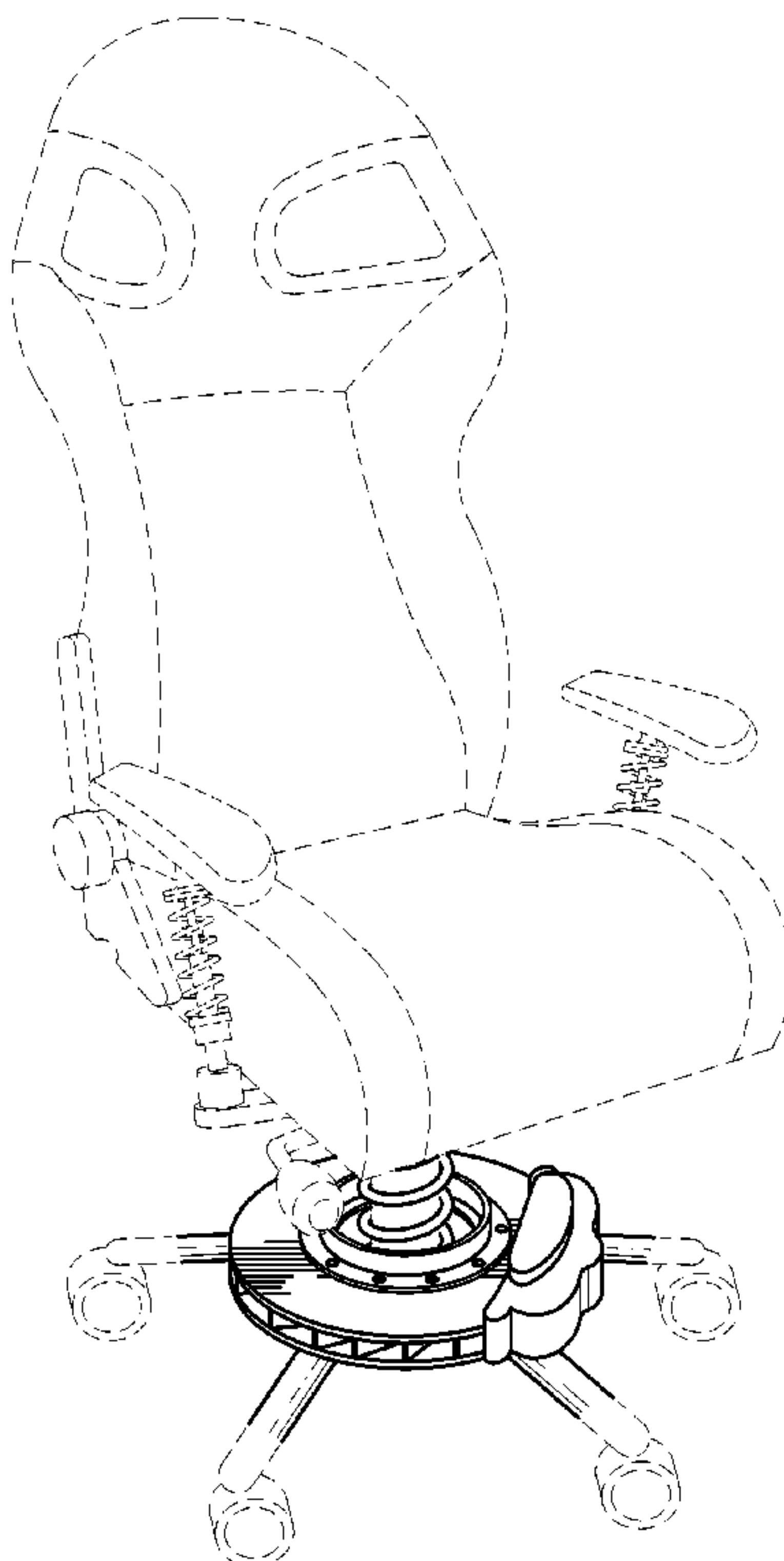
