FIG. 1 is a broken-away perspective view of a panel with repeating scalloped pattern for wall or ceiling showing my design;

FIG. 2 is a right side view thereof, which is a mirror image of the left side view;

FIG. **3** is a top view thereof, which is a mirror image of the bottom view; and,

FIG. 4 is a front view thereof.
