**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 18 is a left side view of the alternative embodiment of the shoe shown

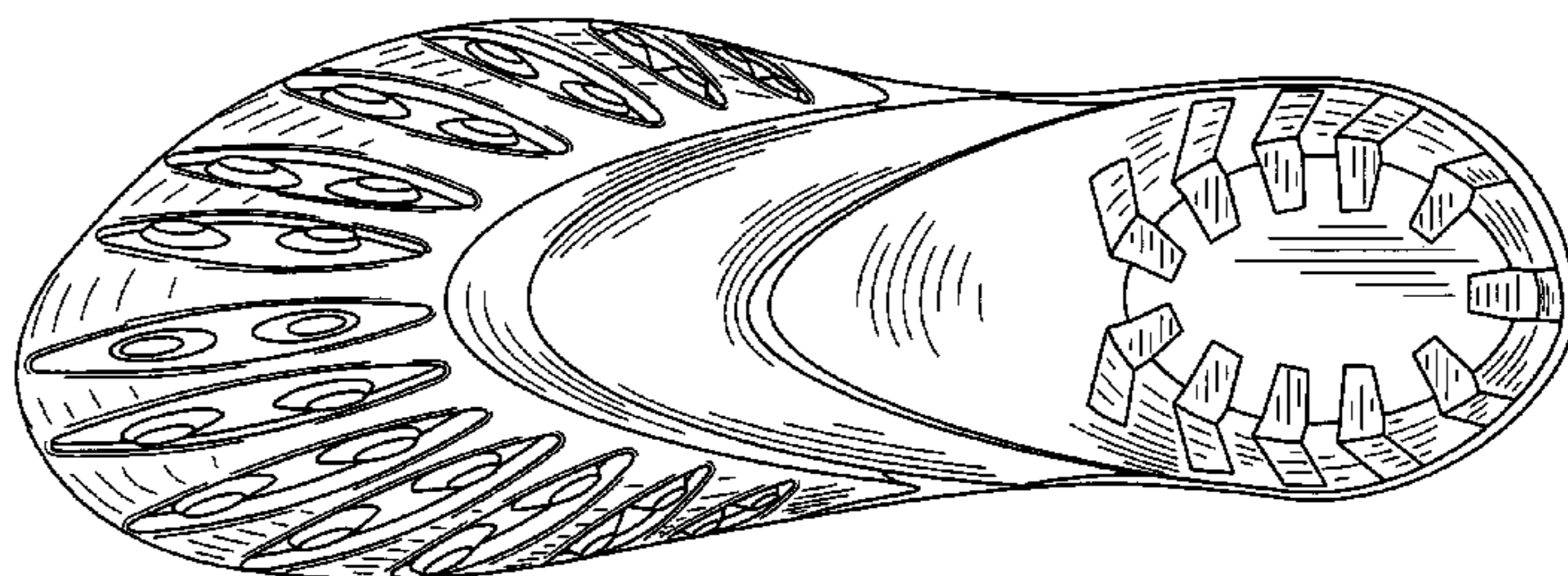
FIG. 19 is a right side view of the alternative embodiment of the shoe shown in FIG. 15;

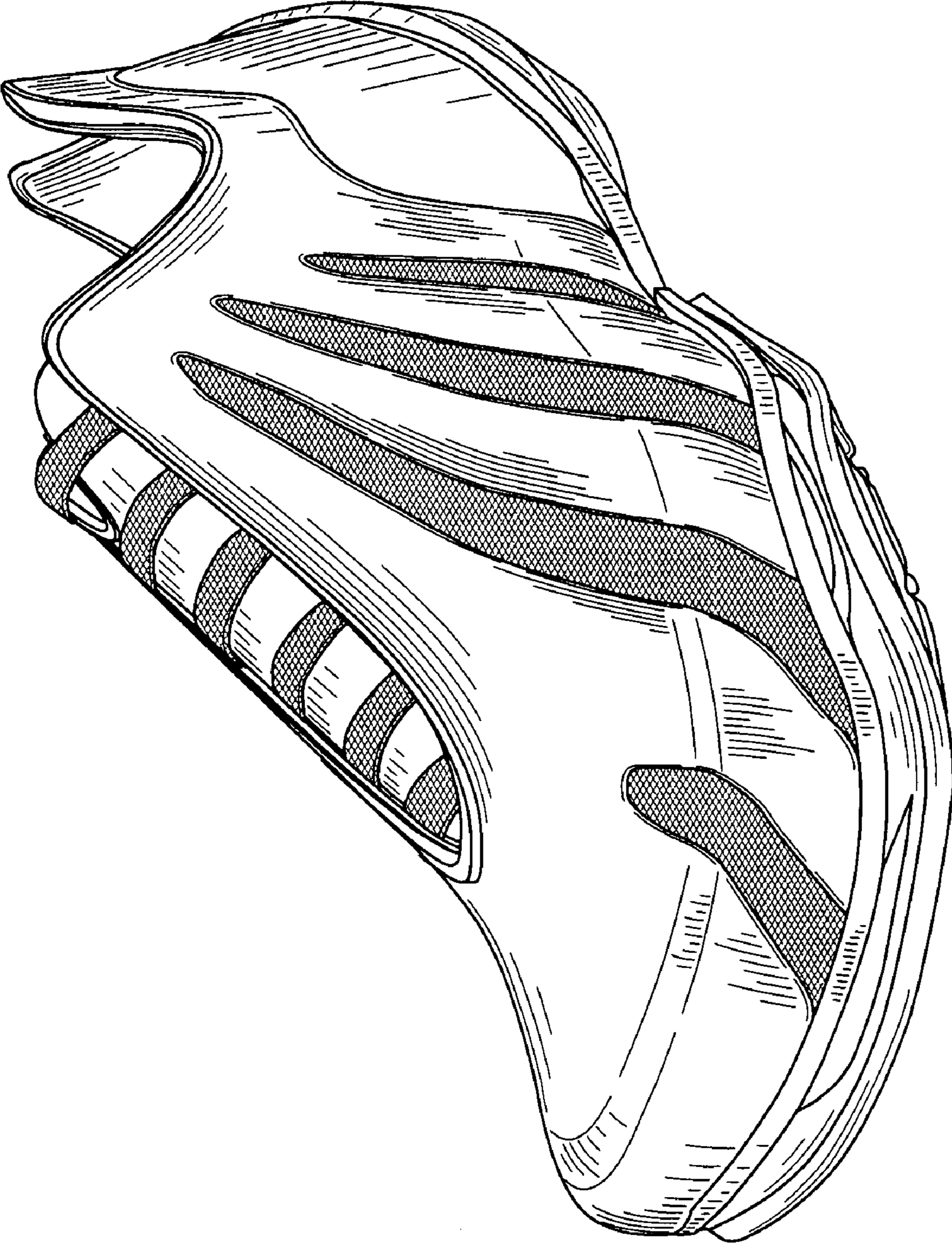

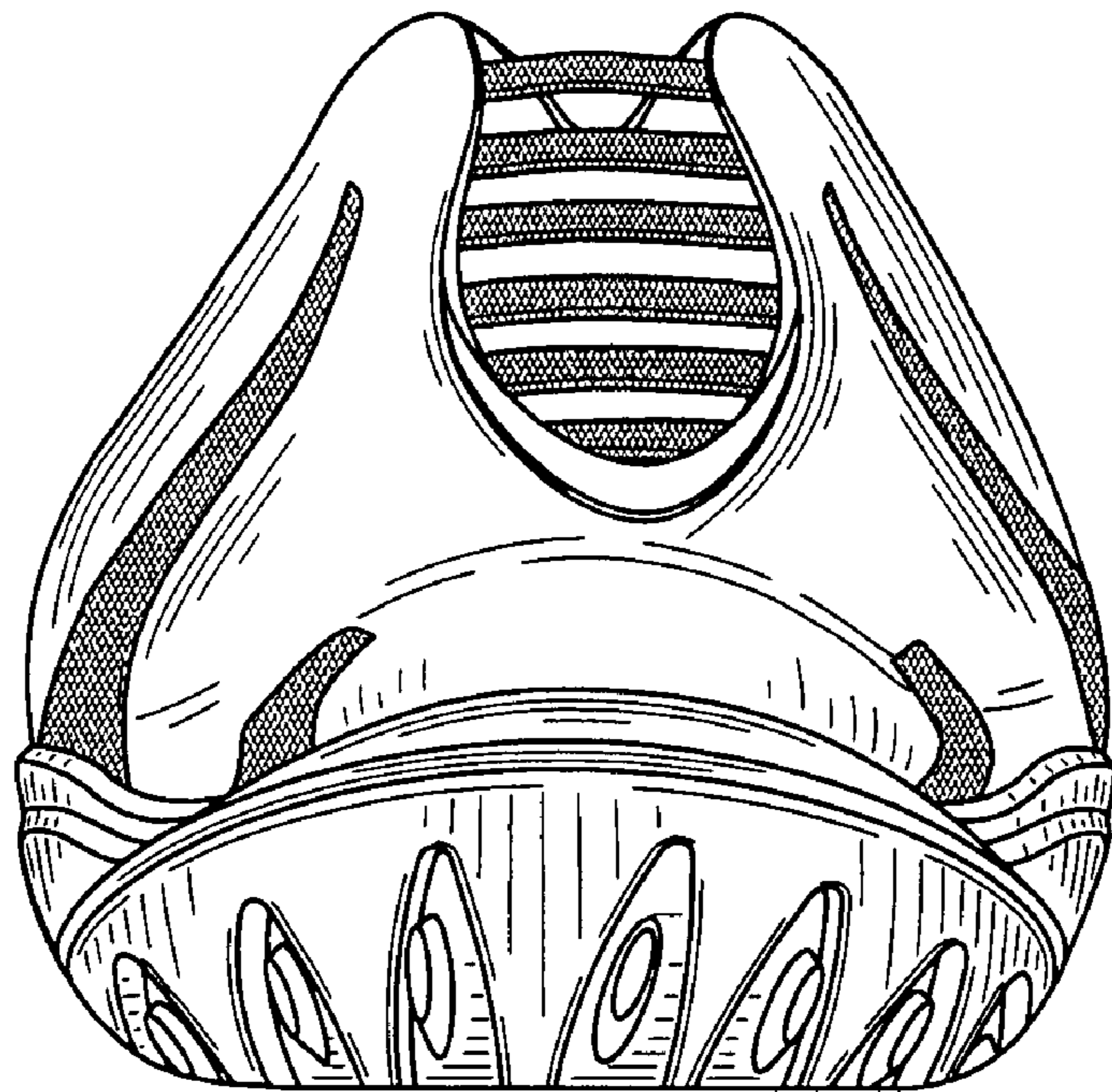

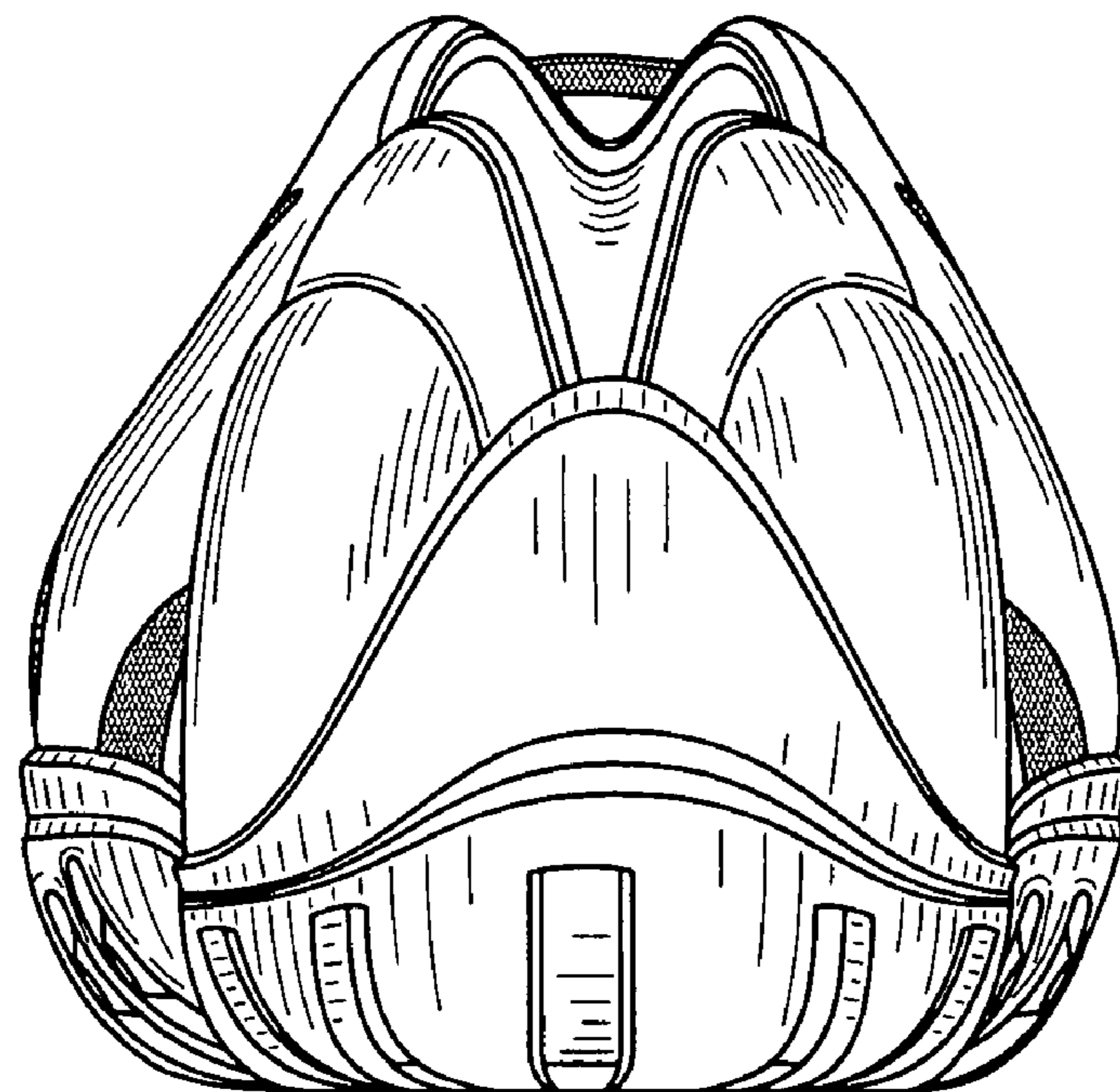

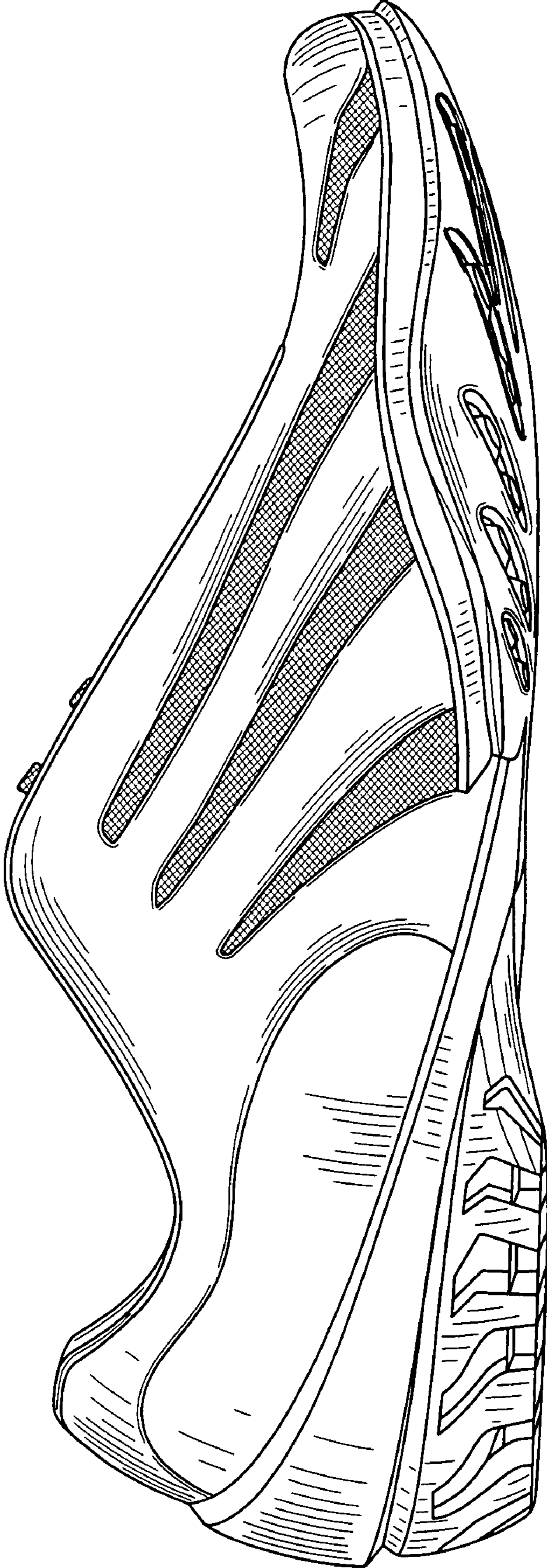

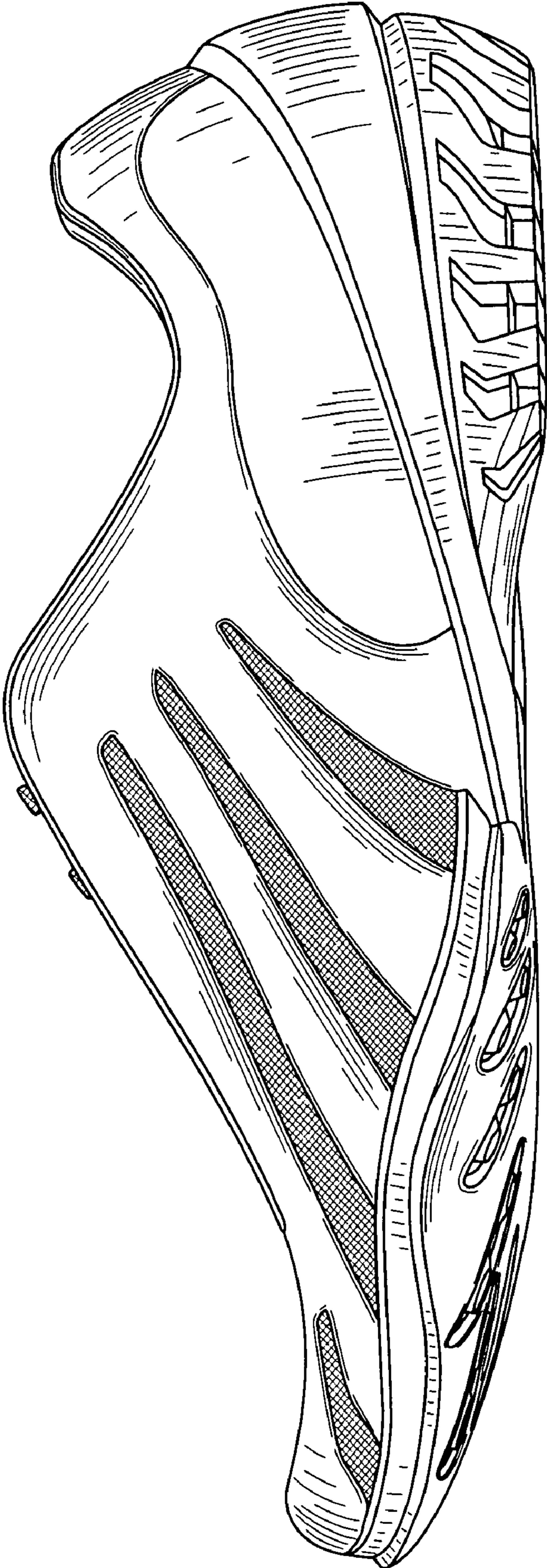

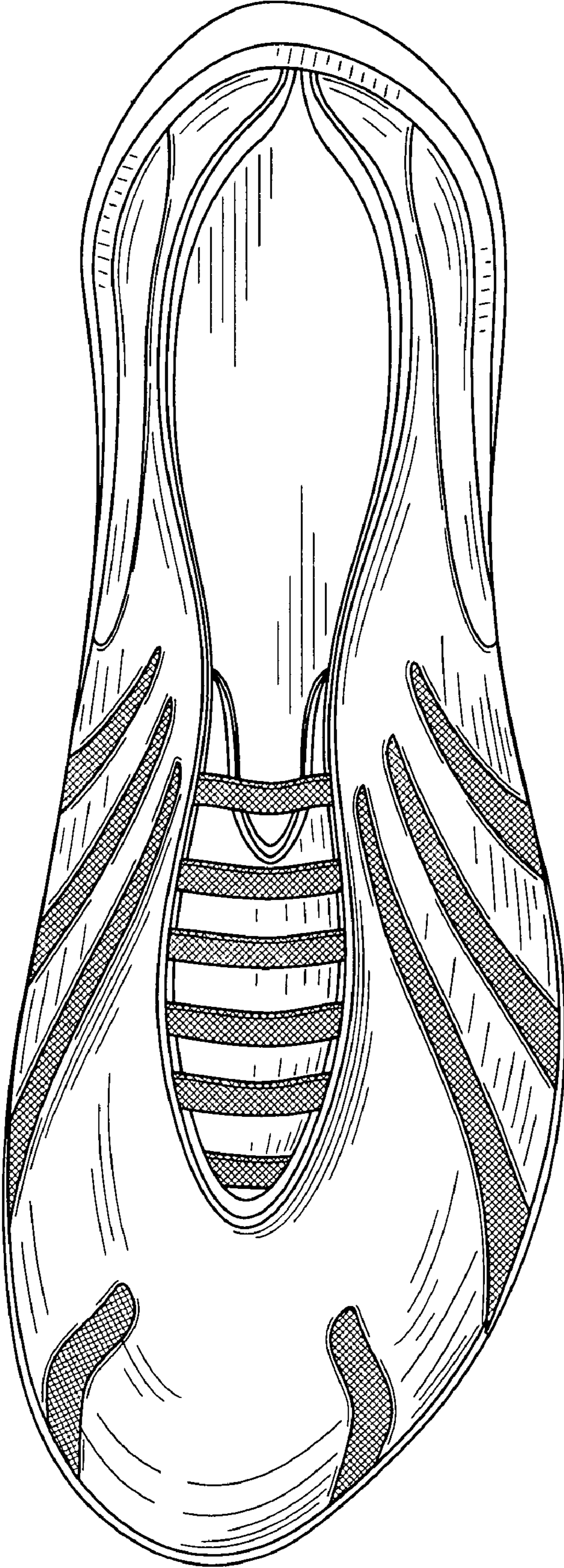

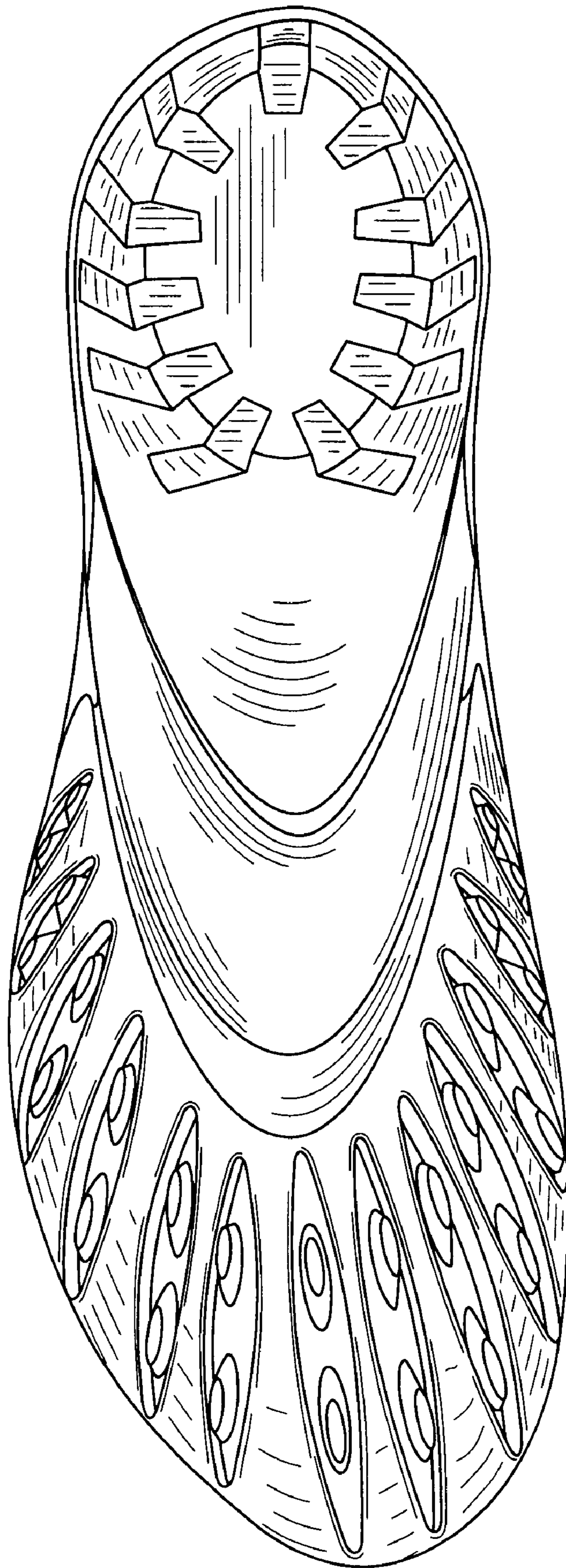

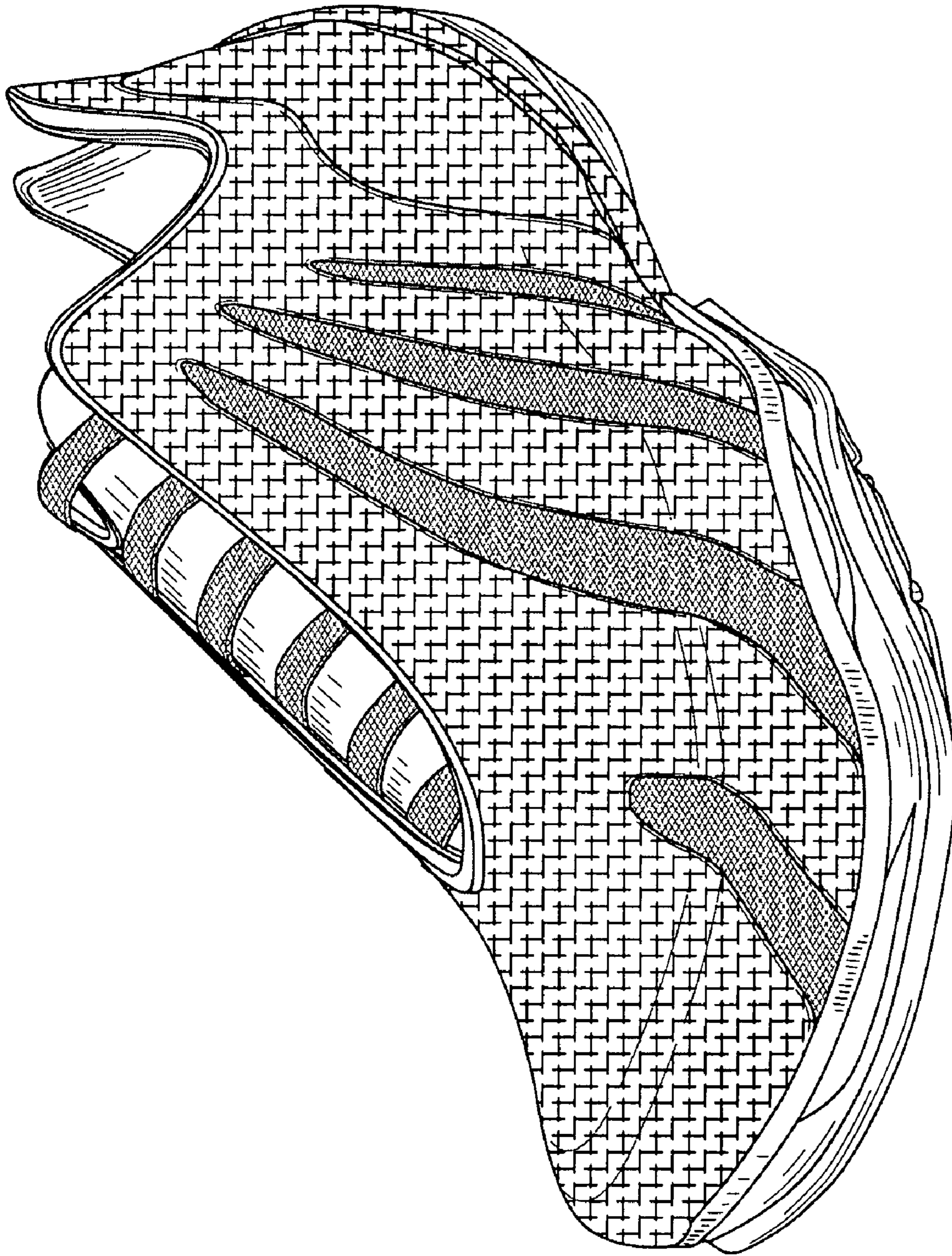

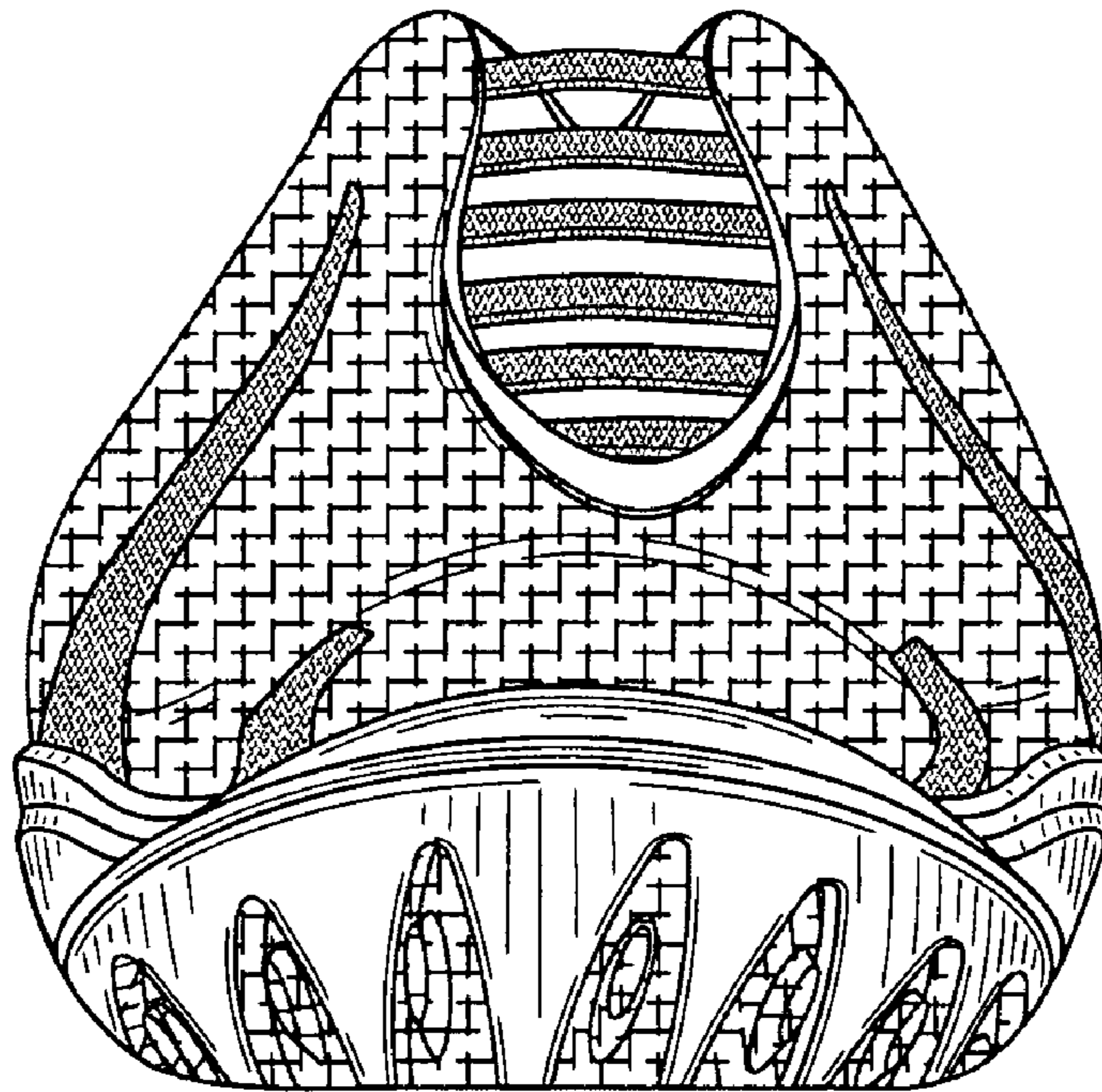

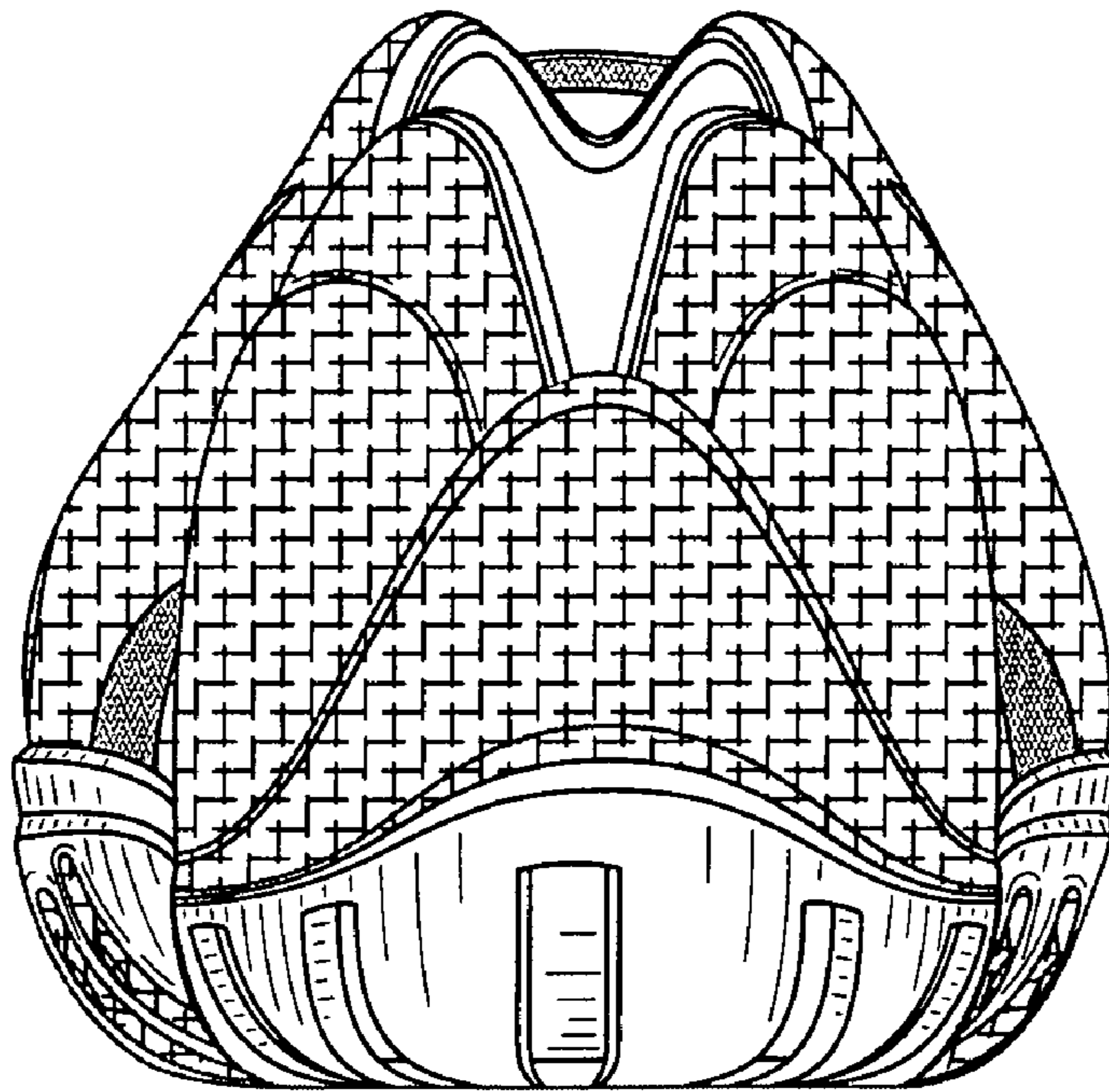

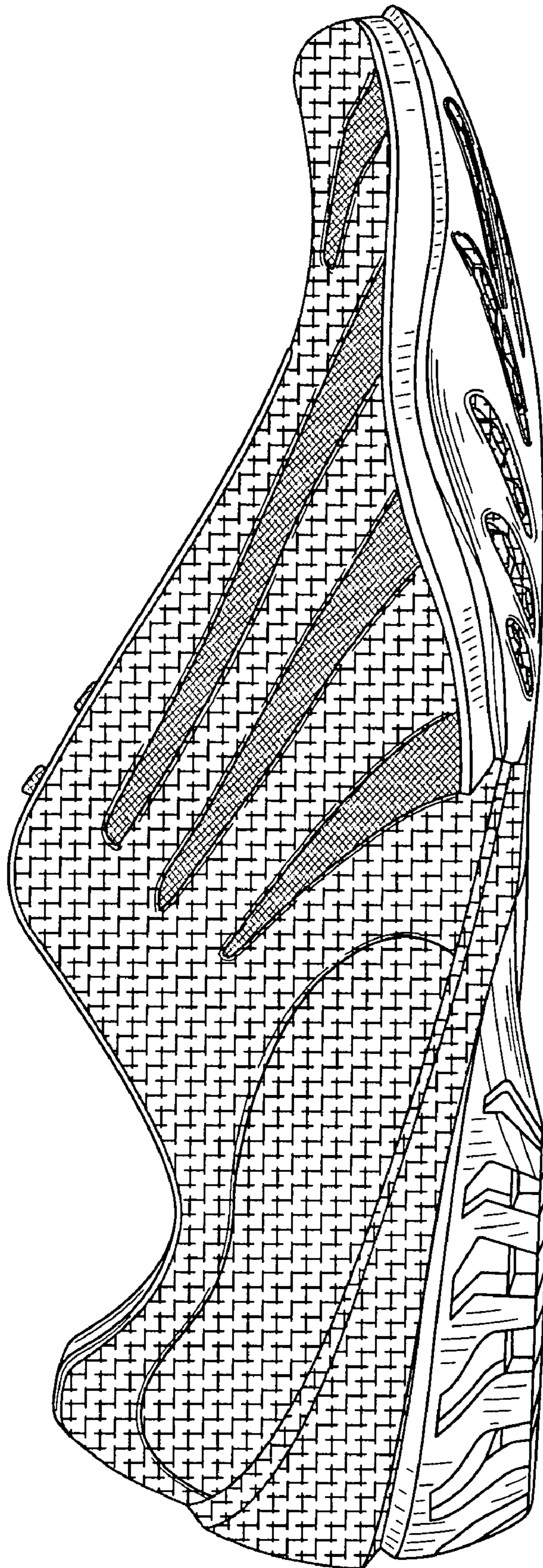

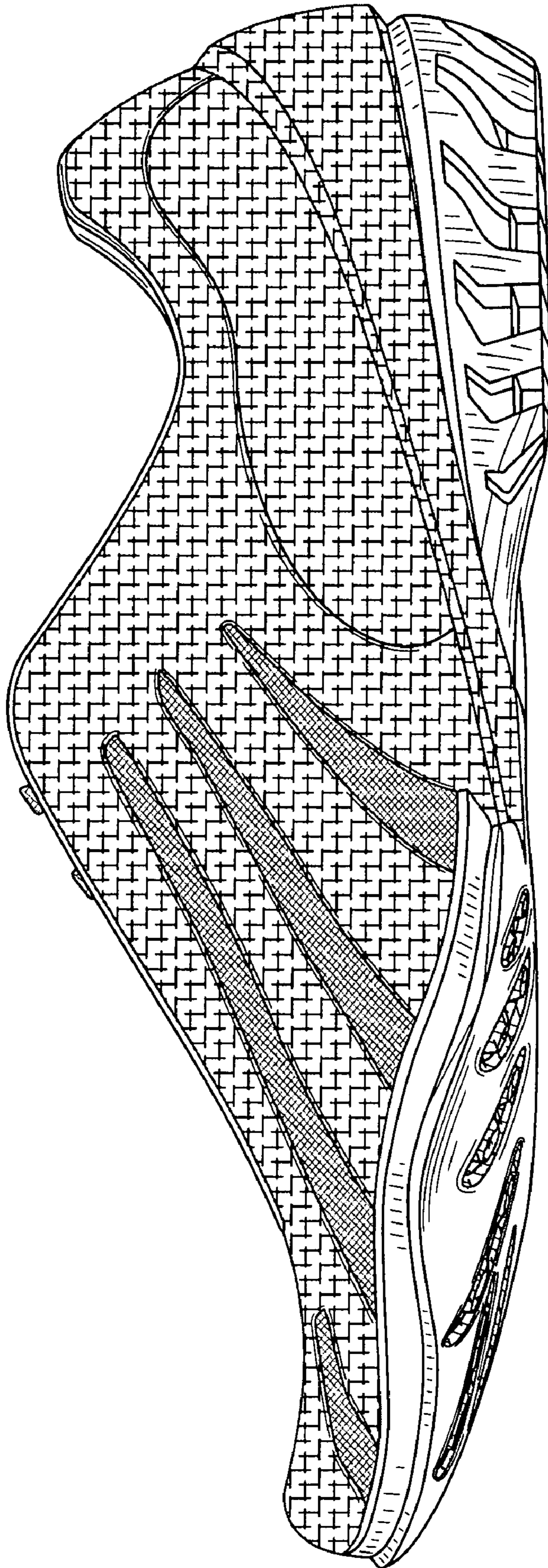

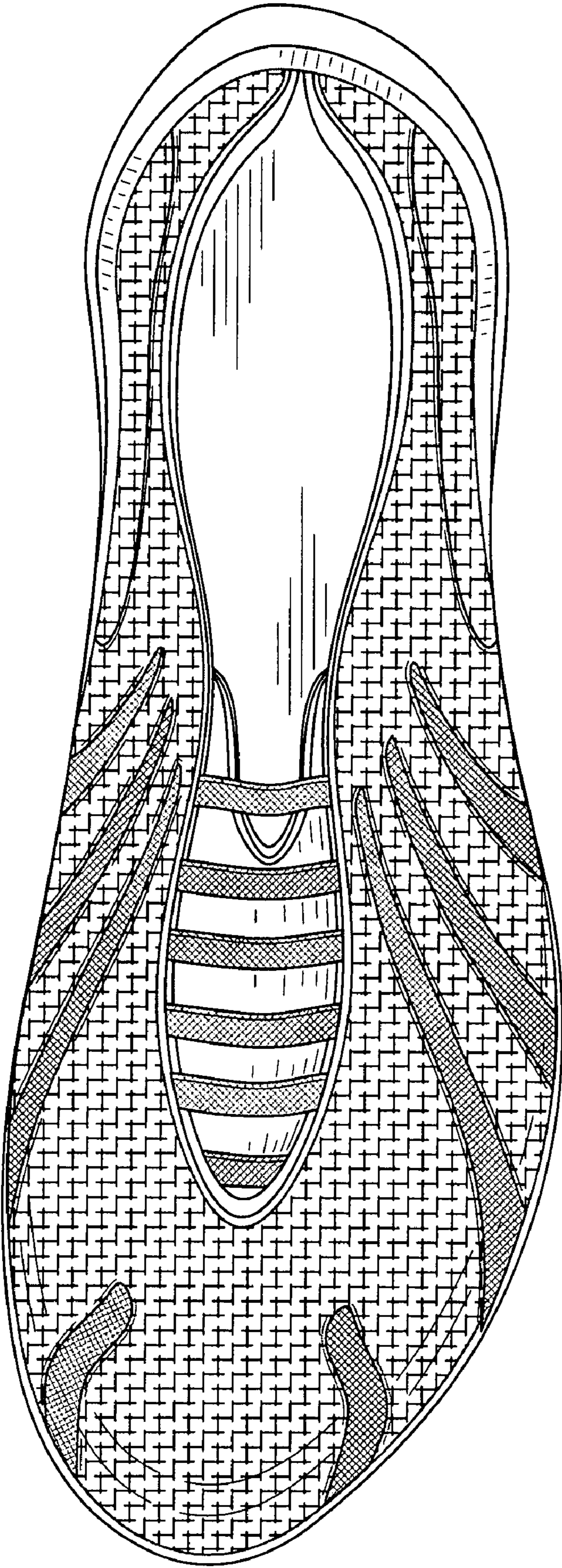

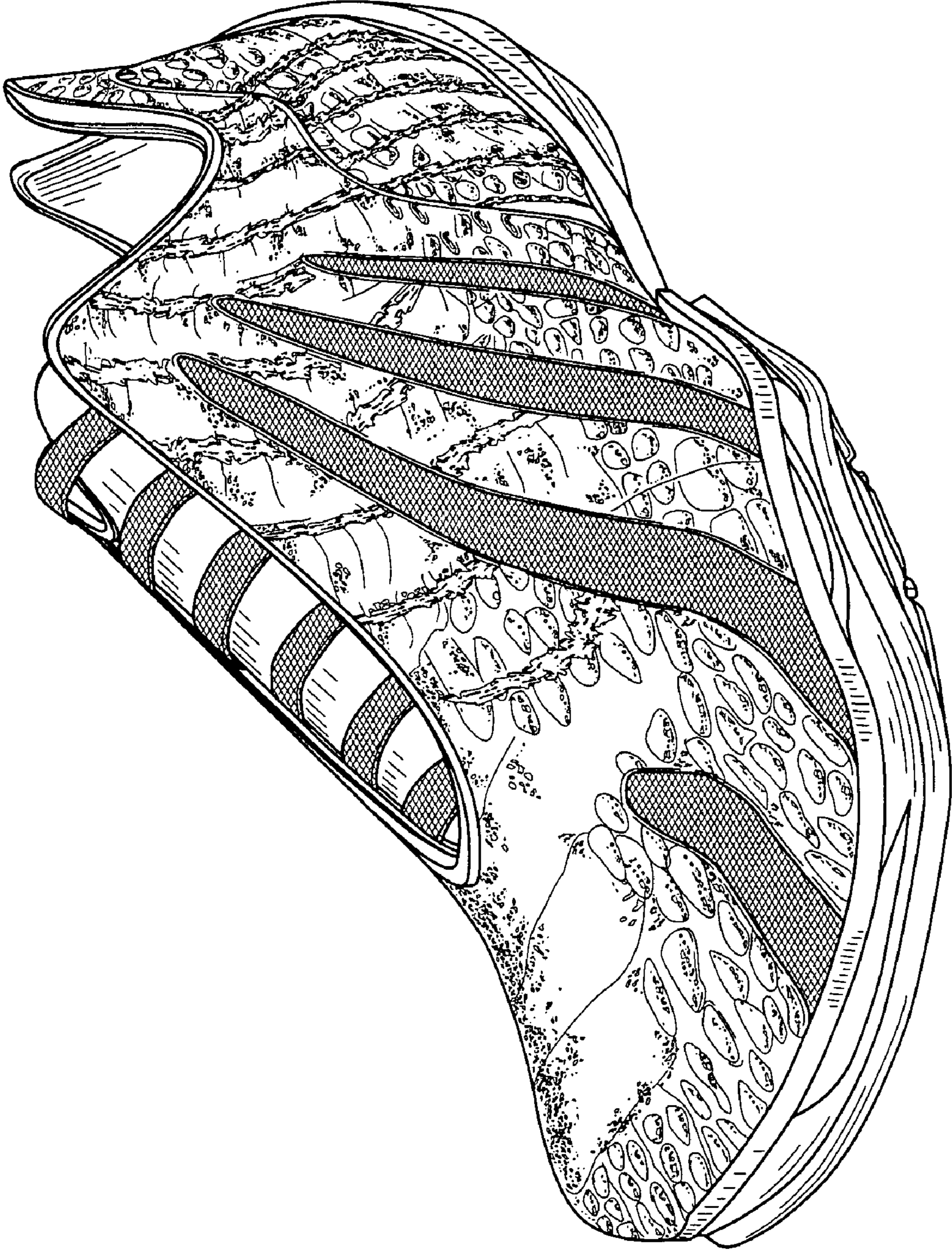

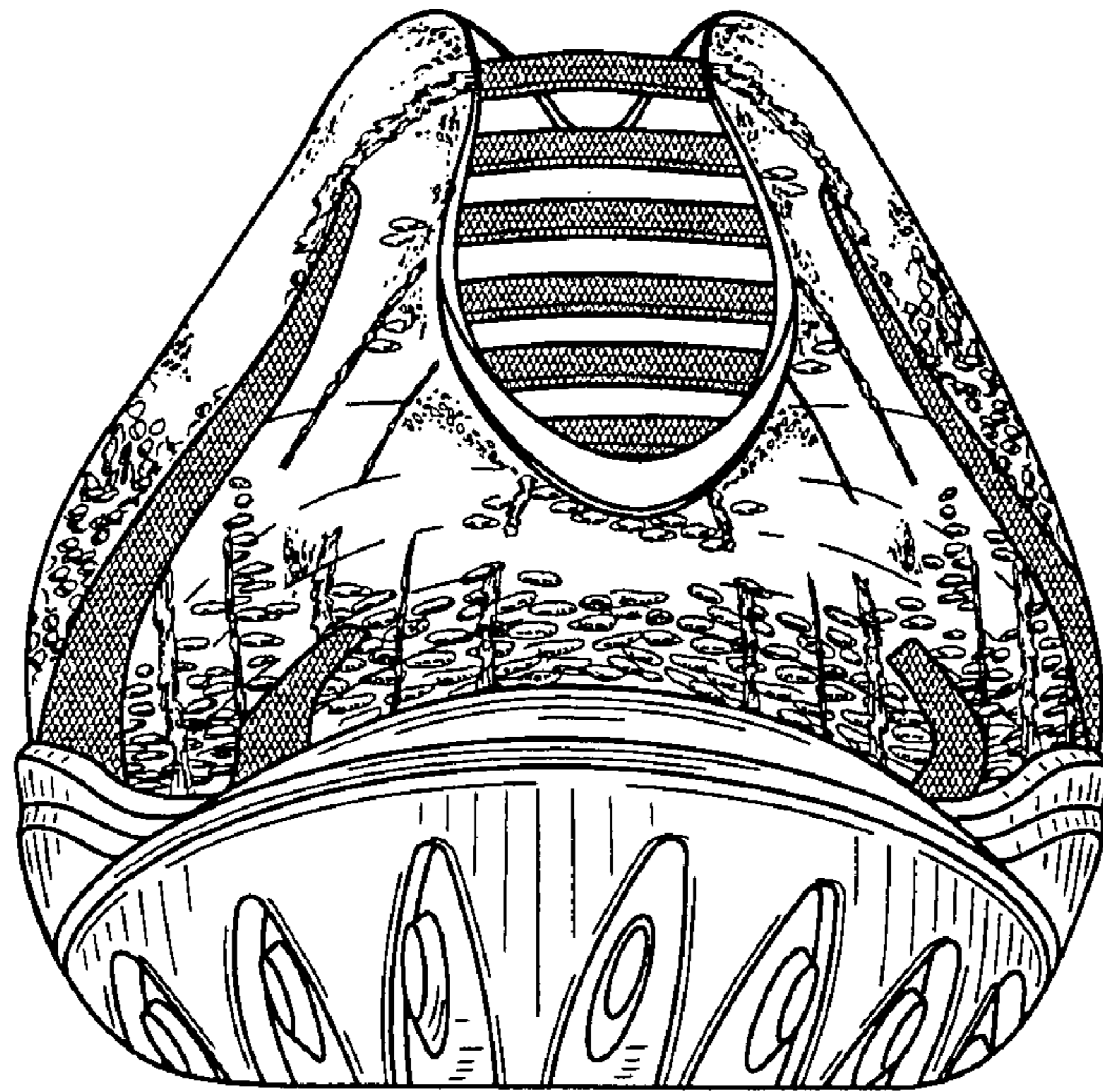

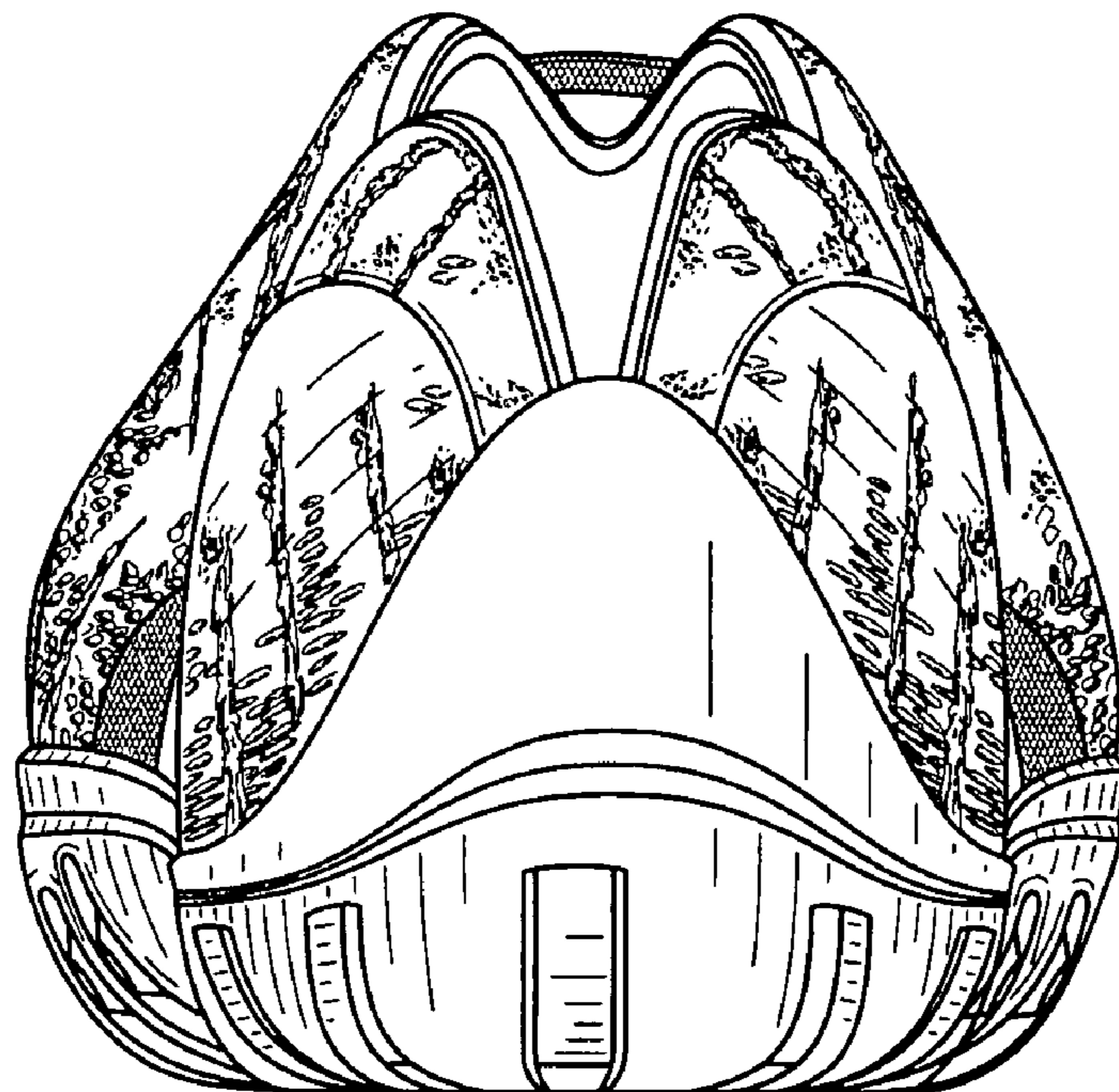

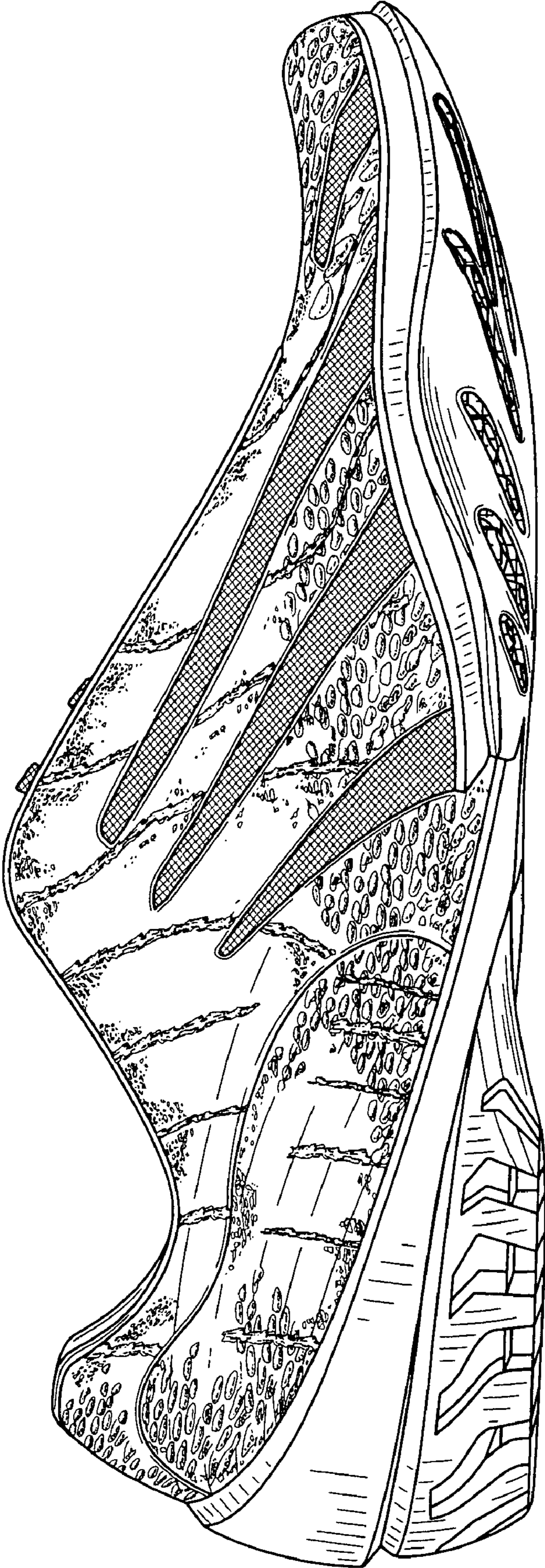

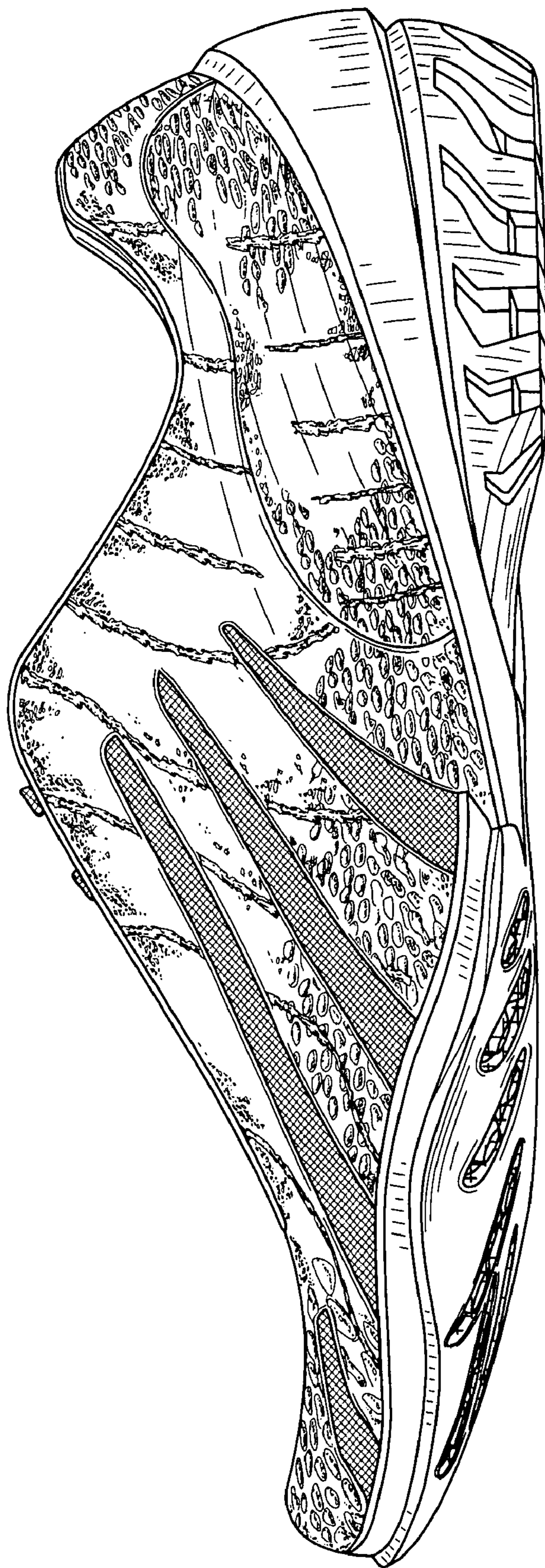

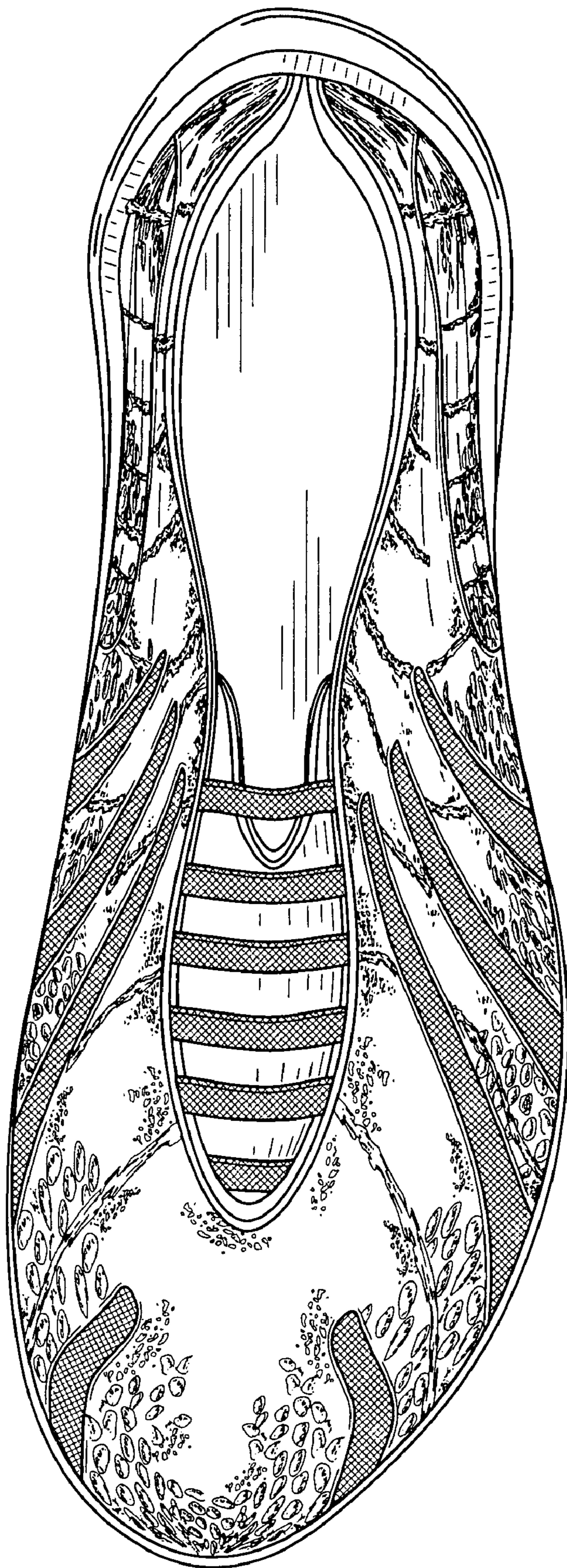

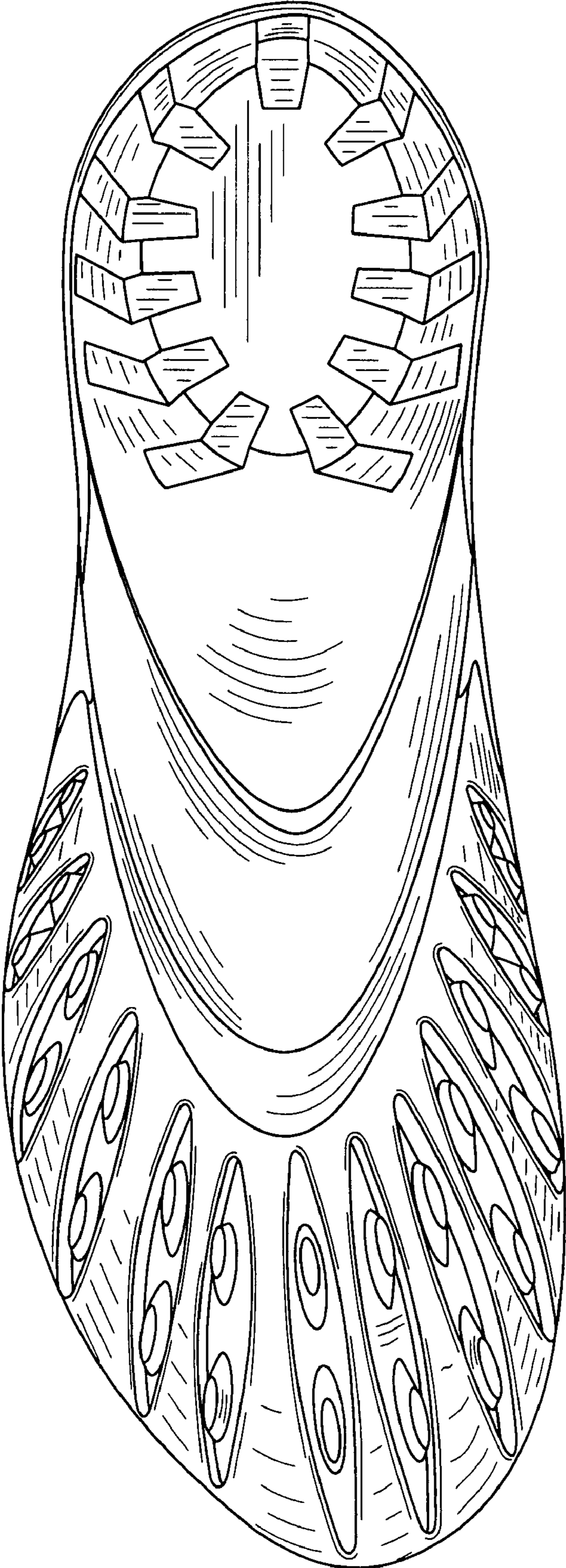
