(57) **CLAIM**

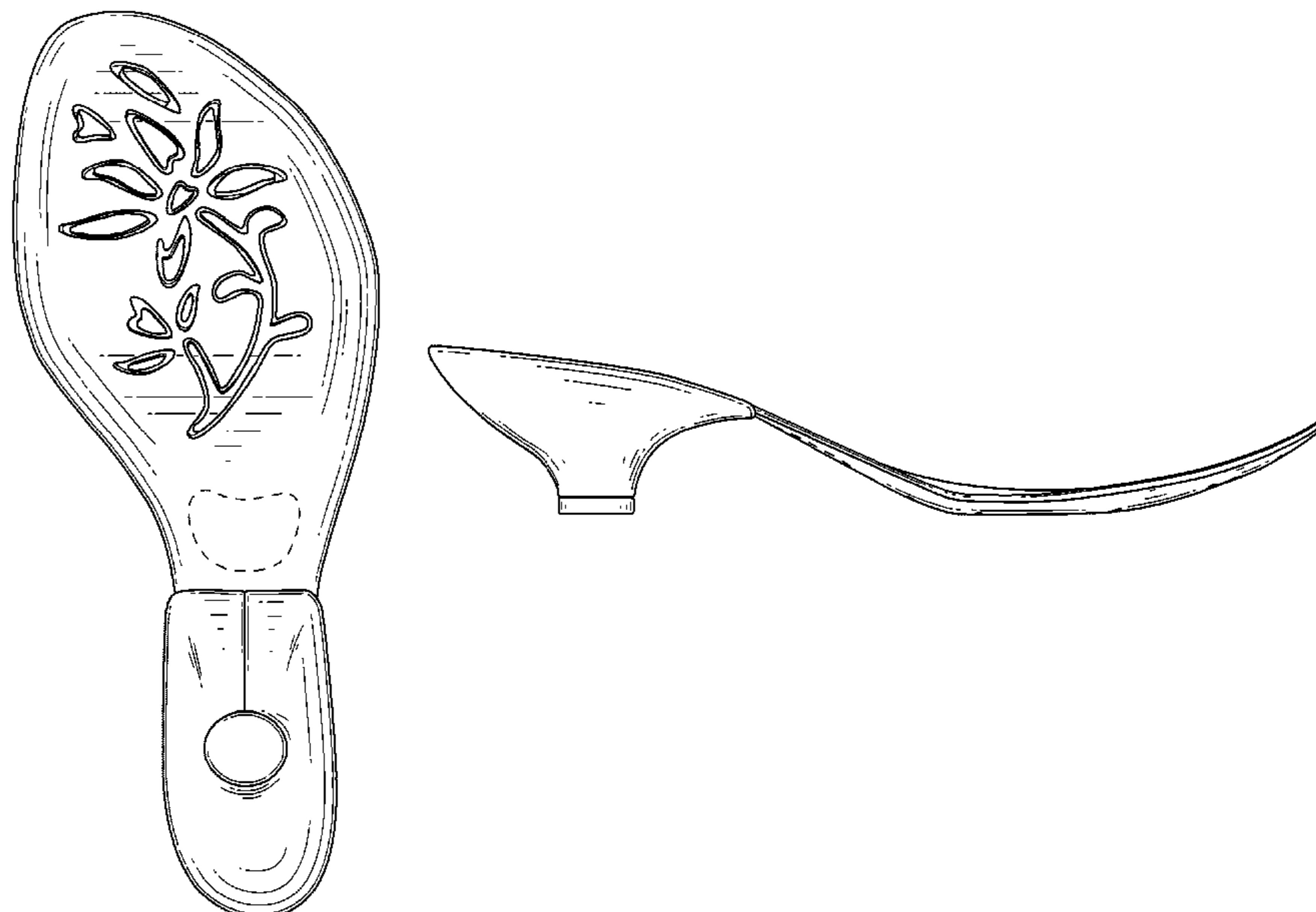
The ornamental design for the outsole for a shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of an outsole for a shoe showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is an enlarged perspective view of the area labeled “7” in FIG. 1.

The area indicated as broken lines shown in the arch area of FIGS. 1-4 represent boundaries of the design with the lines themselves and the areas within them forming no part of the claim.

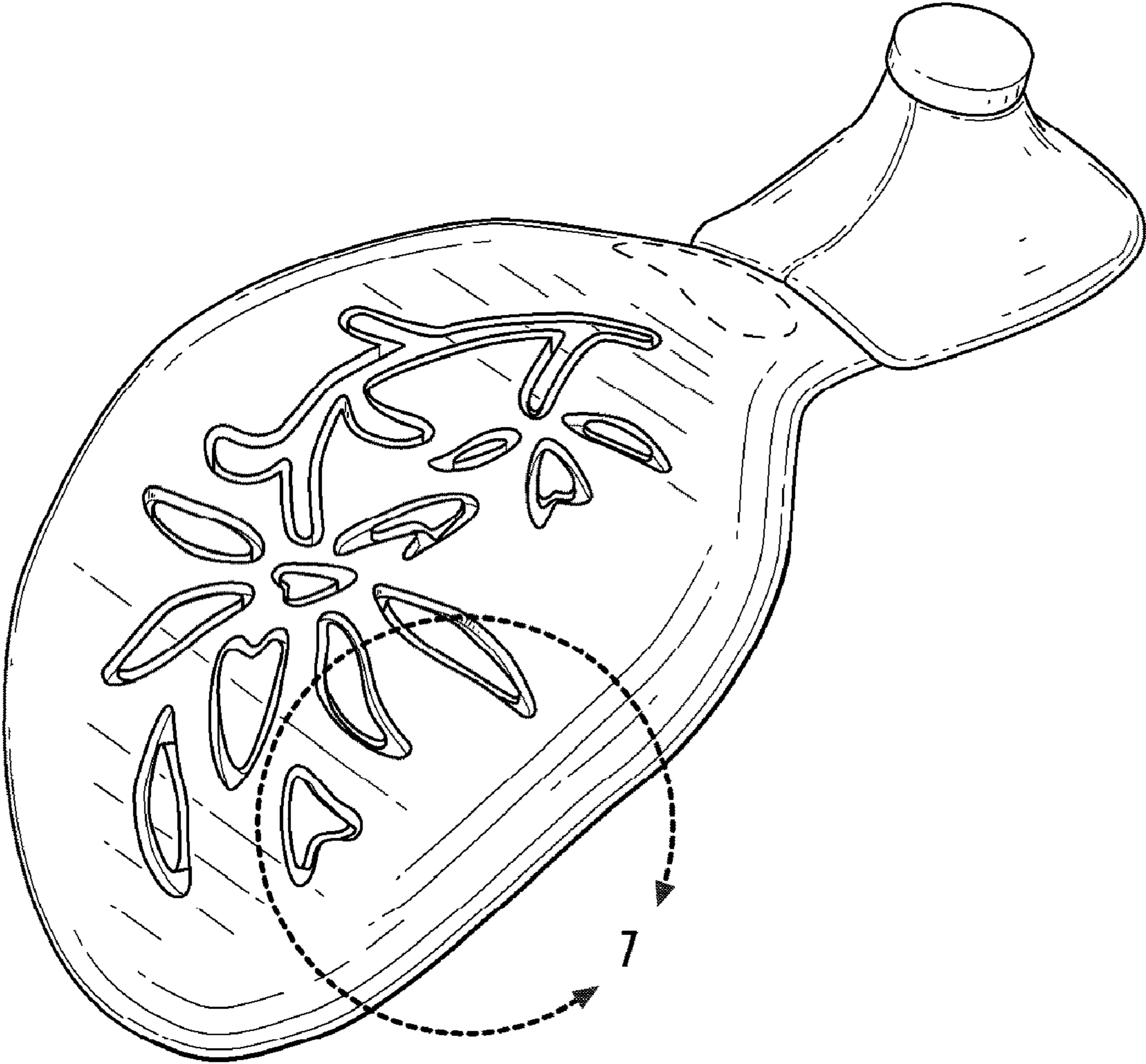

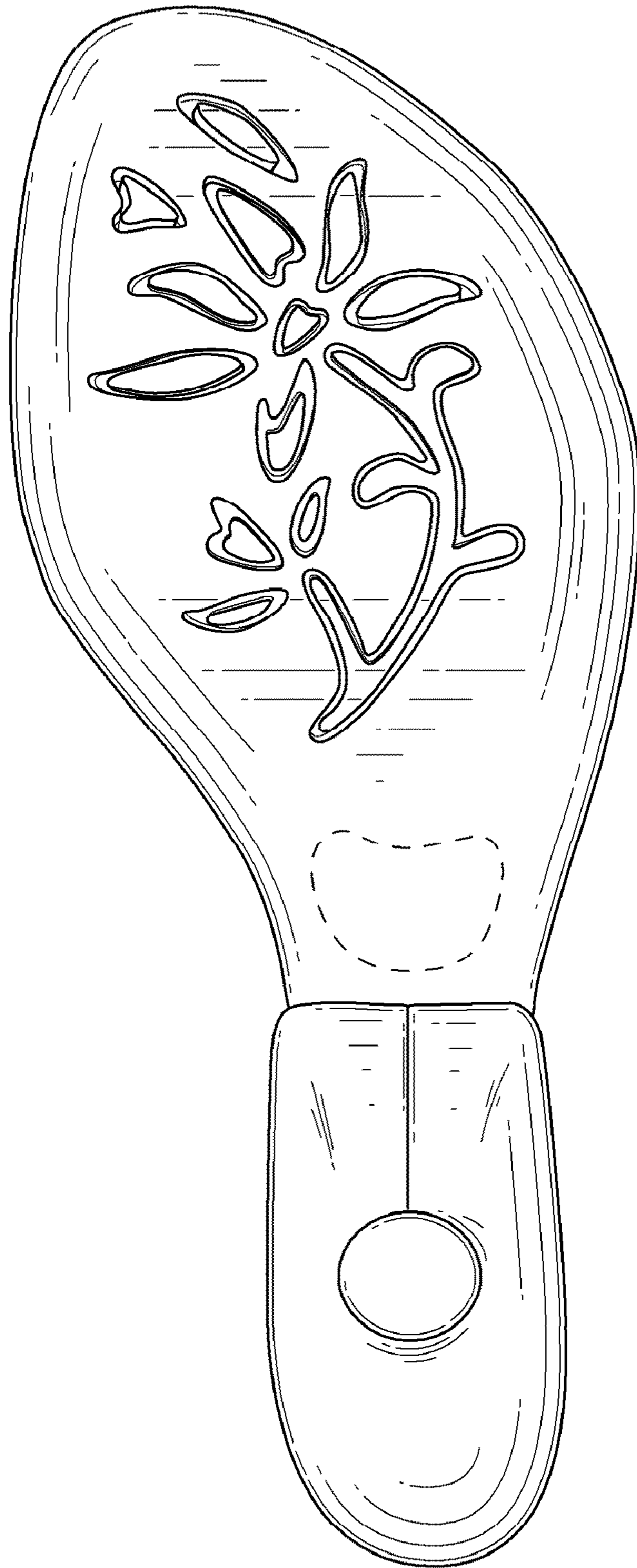

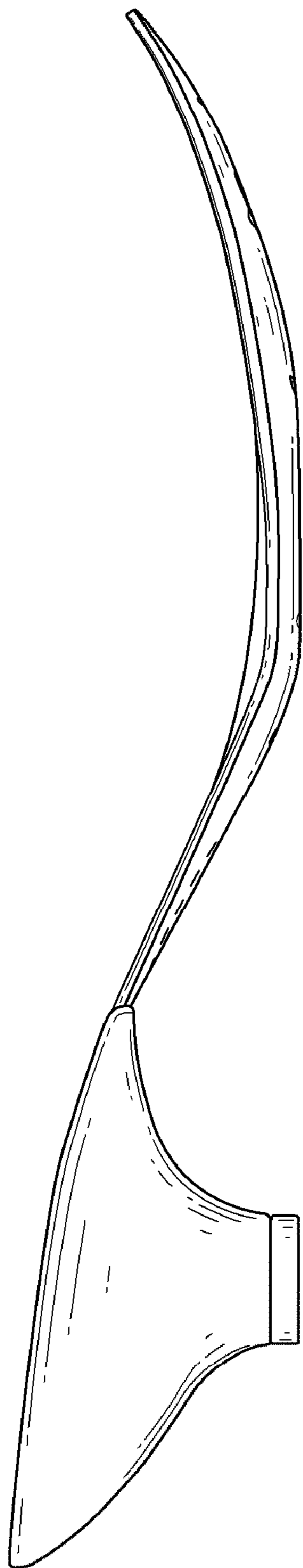

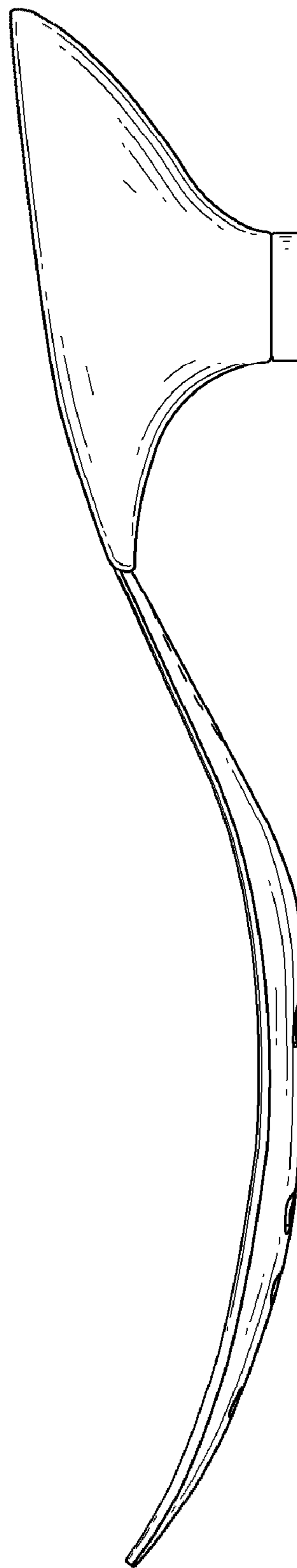

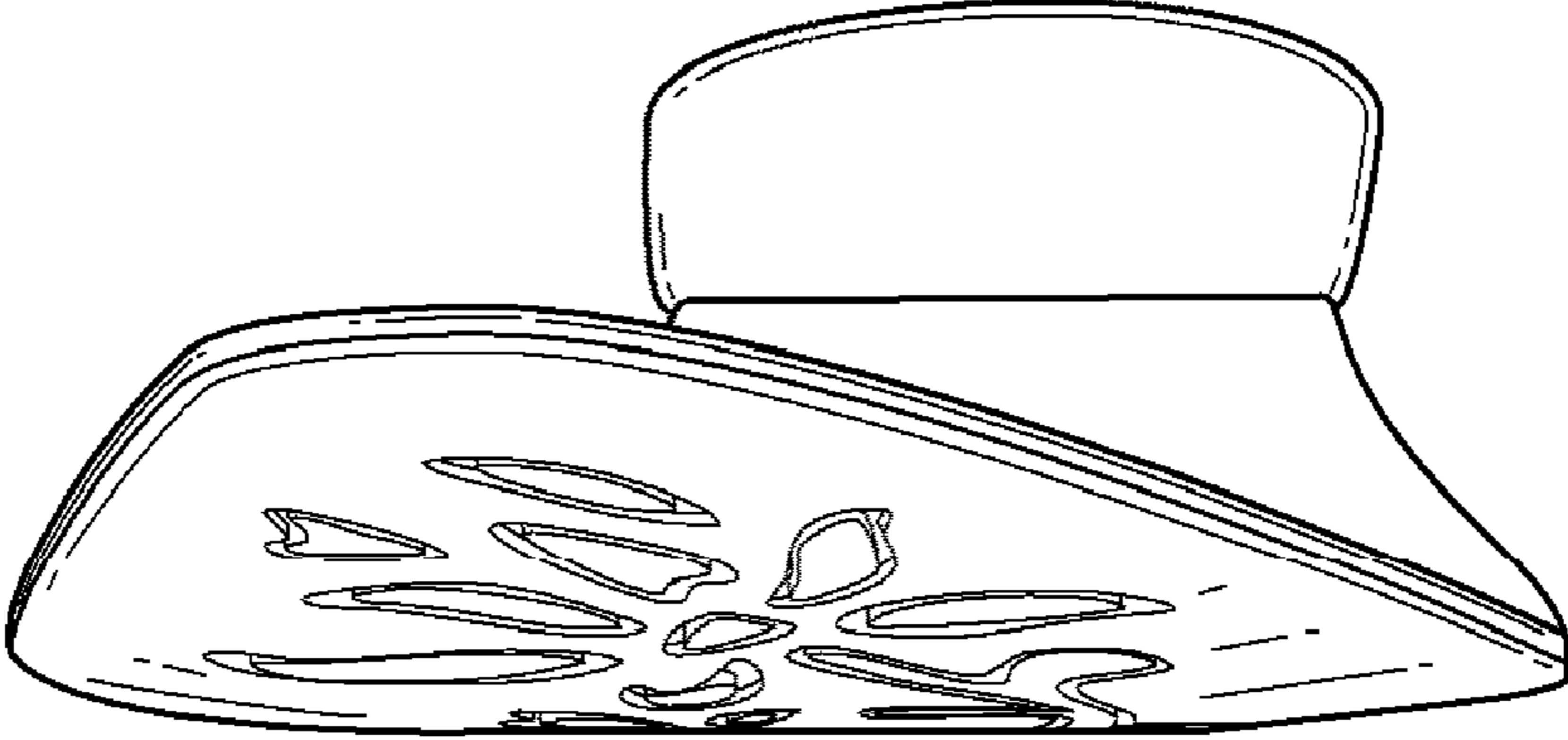

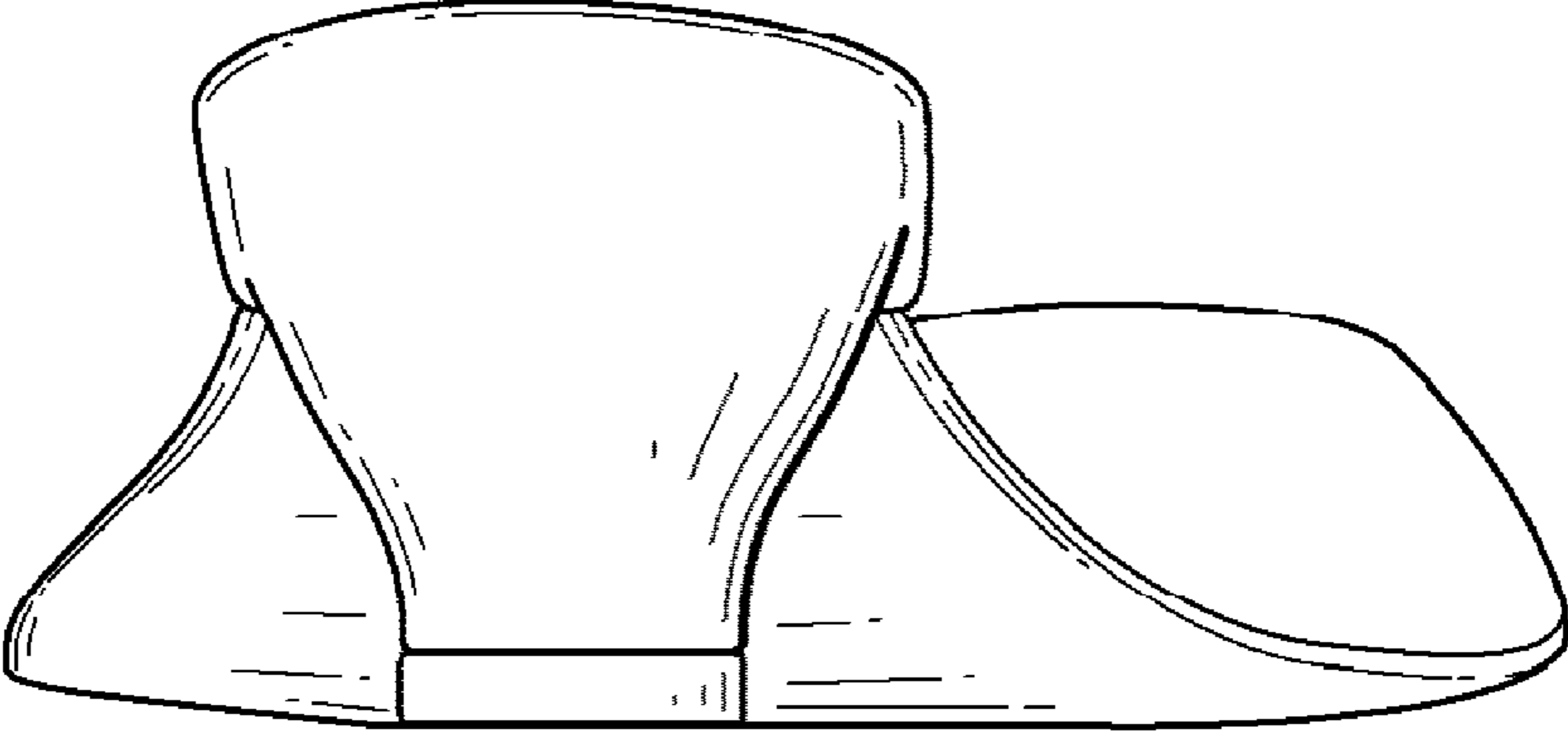

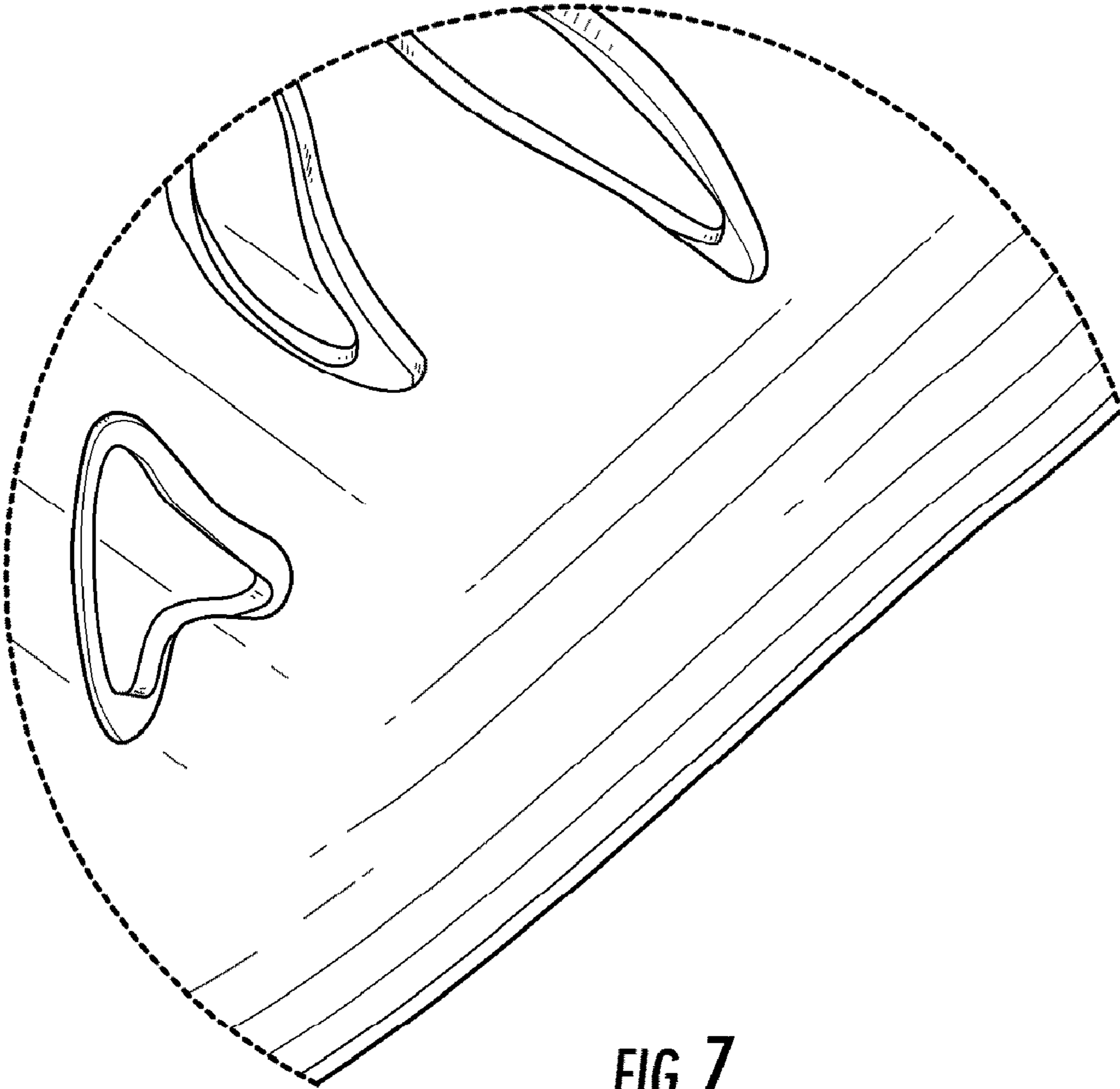
