FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

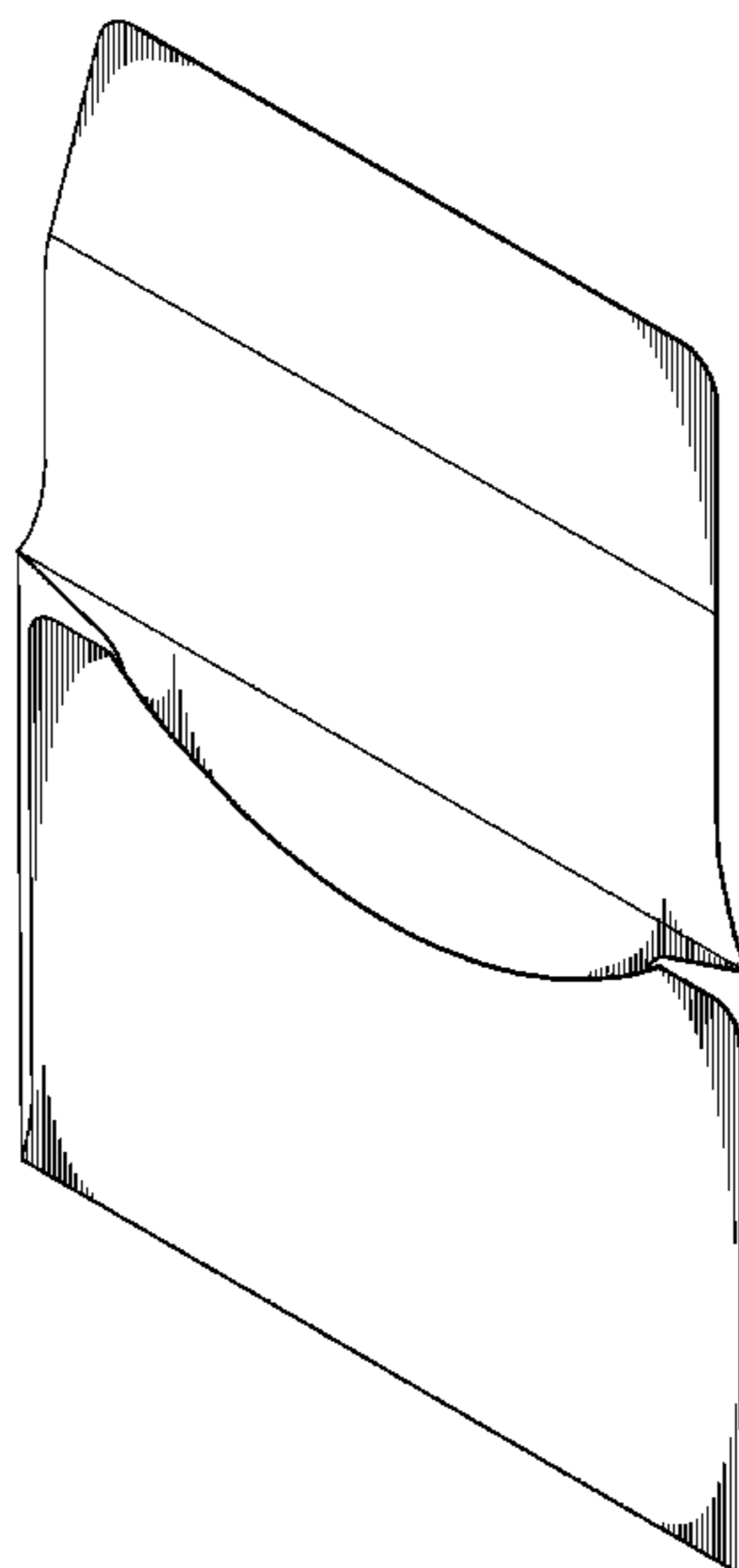
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof showing the envelope in a first partly folded condition;

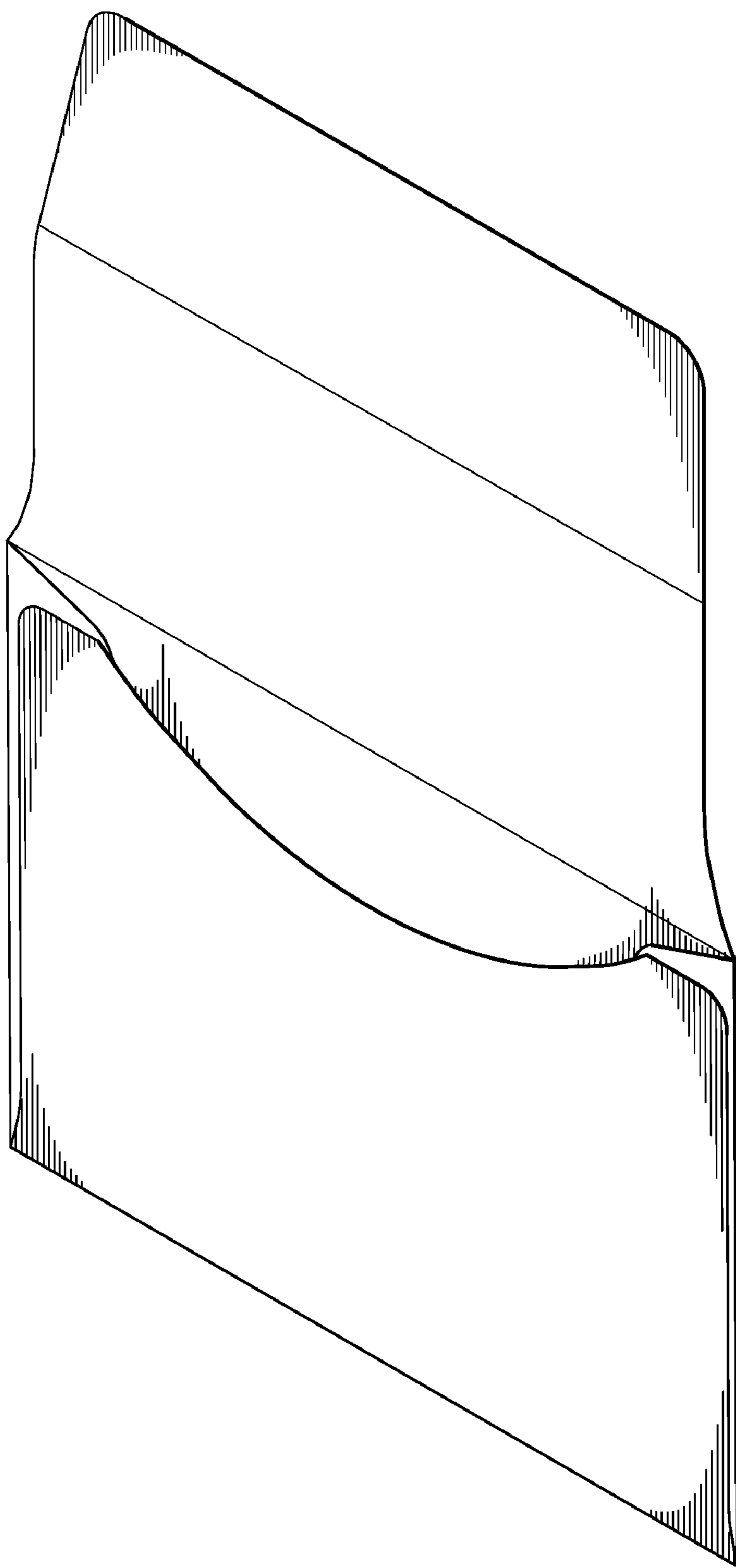
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof showing the envelope in the first partly folded condition;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof showing the envelope in a second folded condition; and,

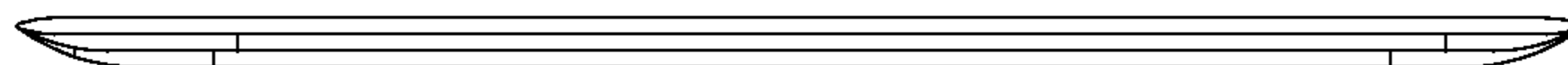
FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof showing the envelope in a third folded condition.

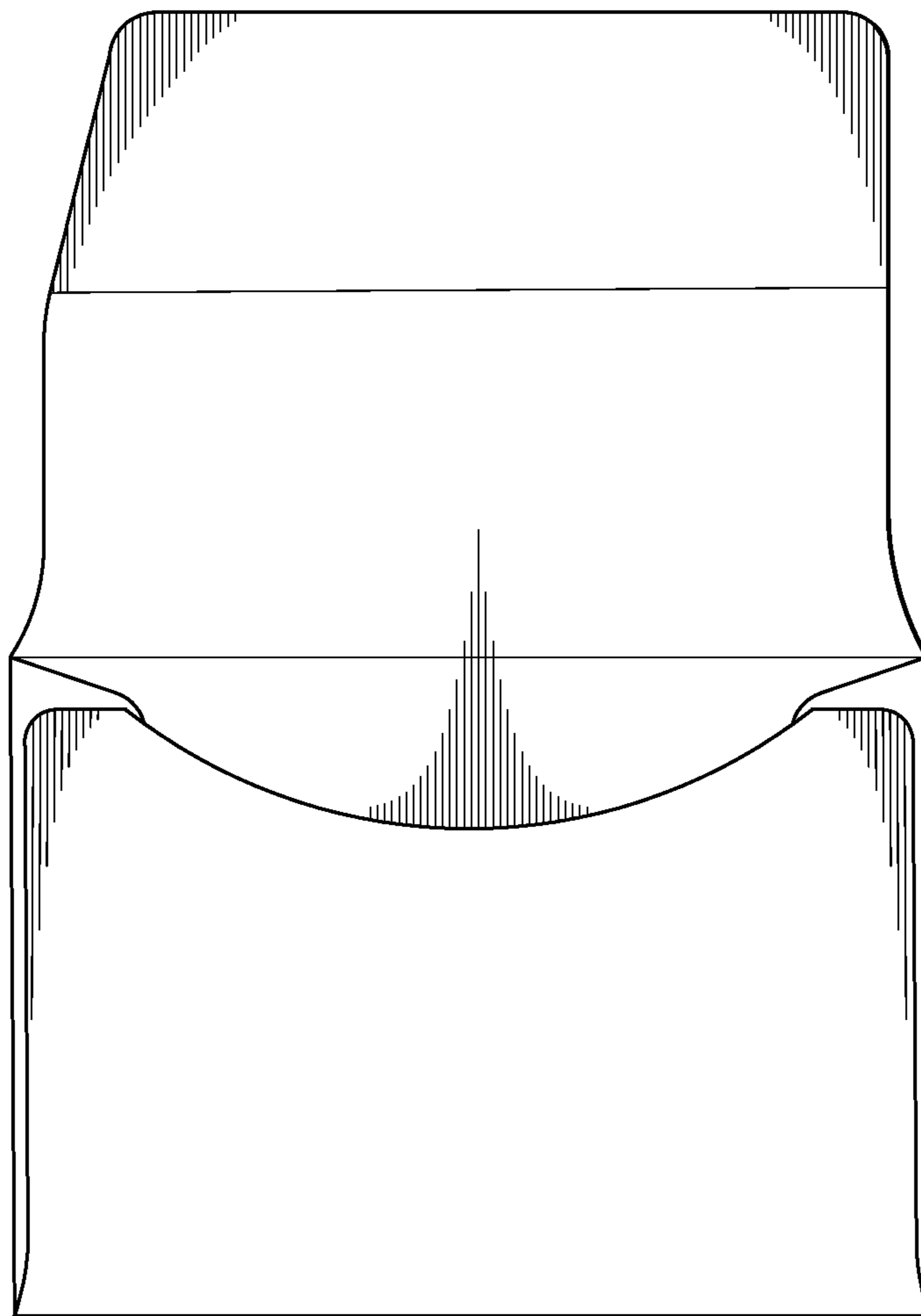




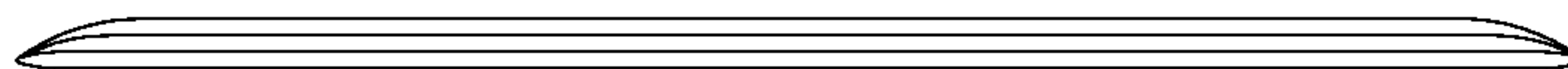

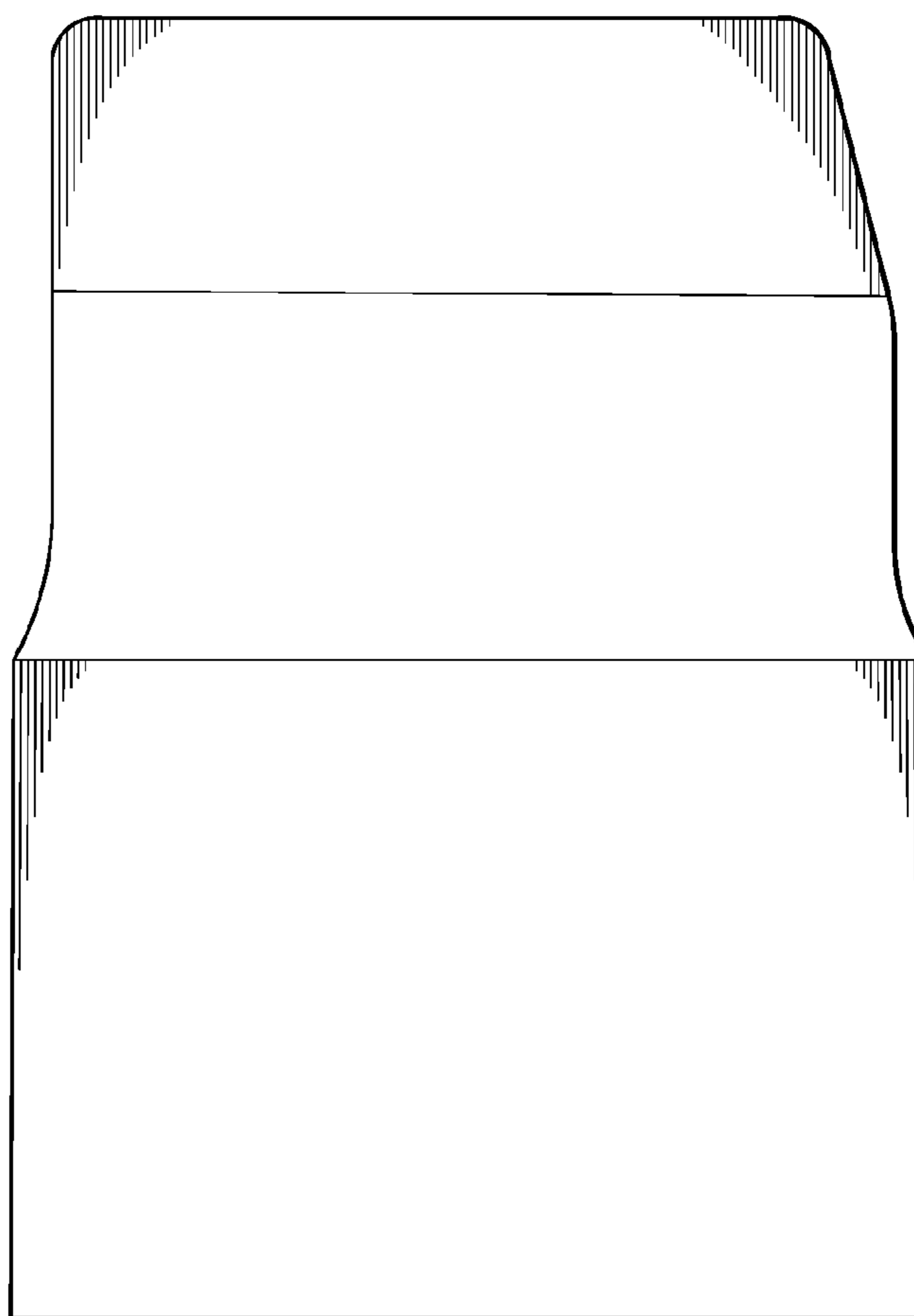

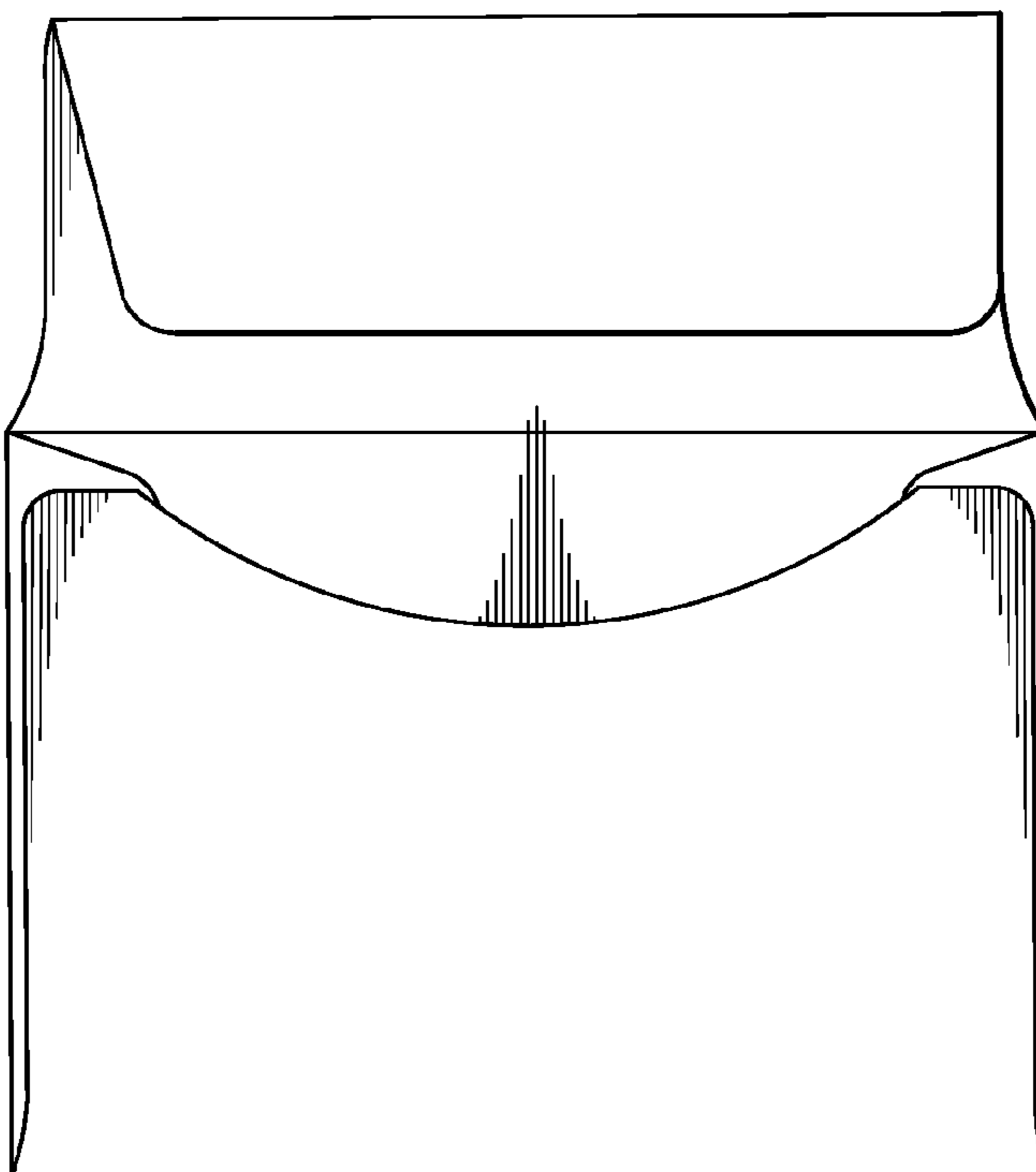


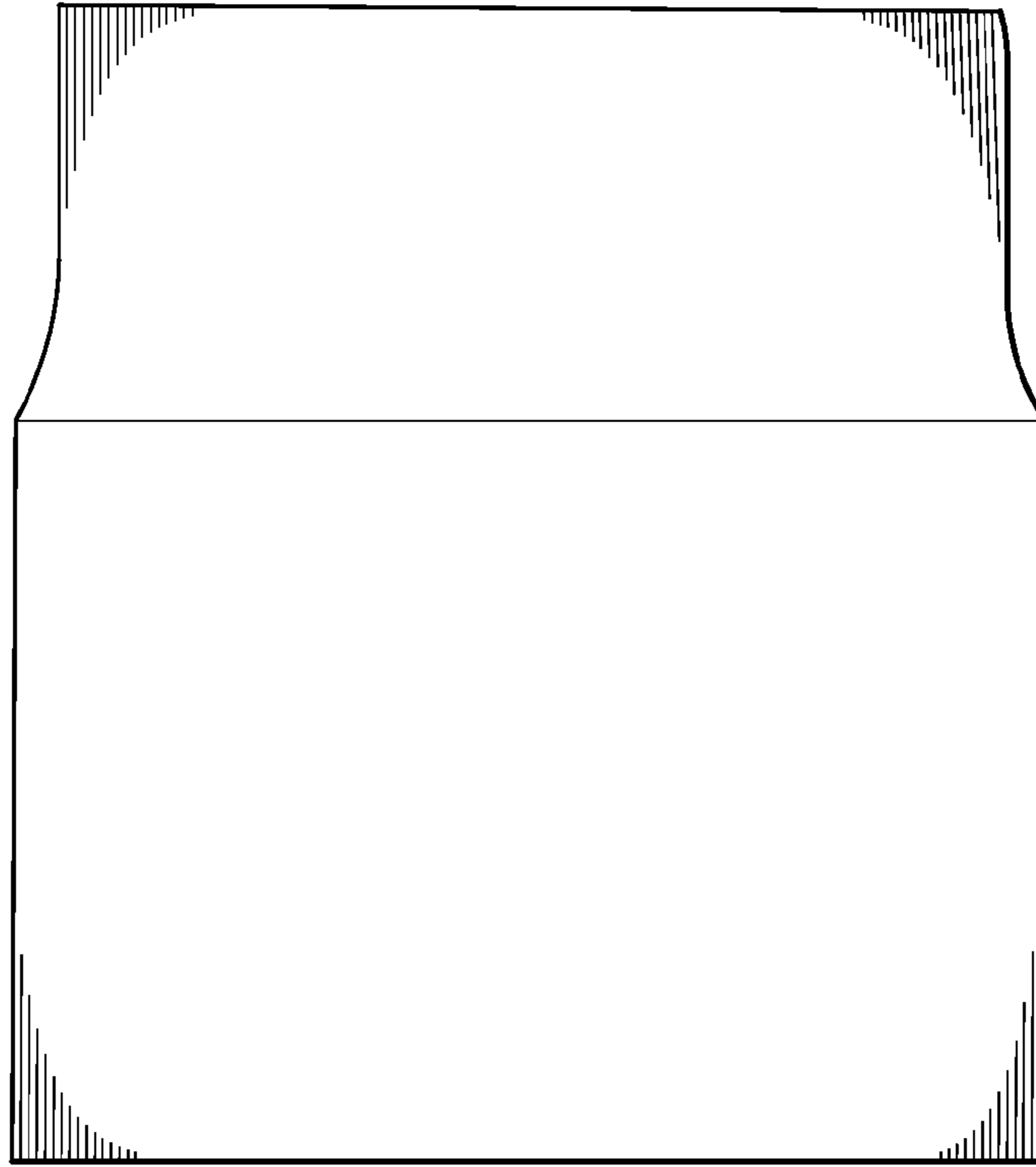

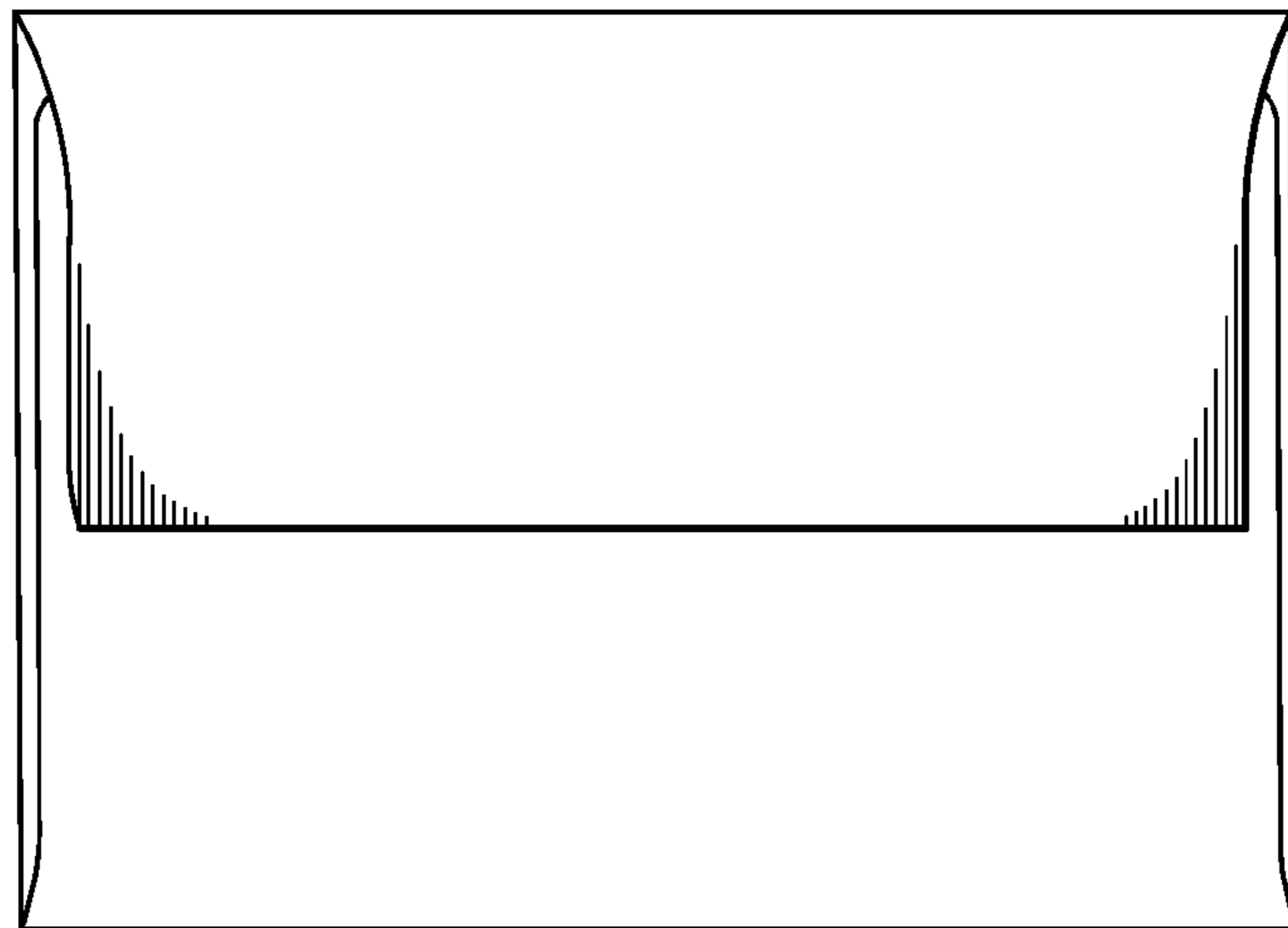

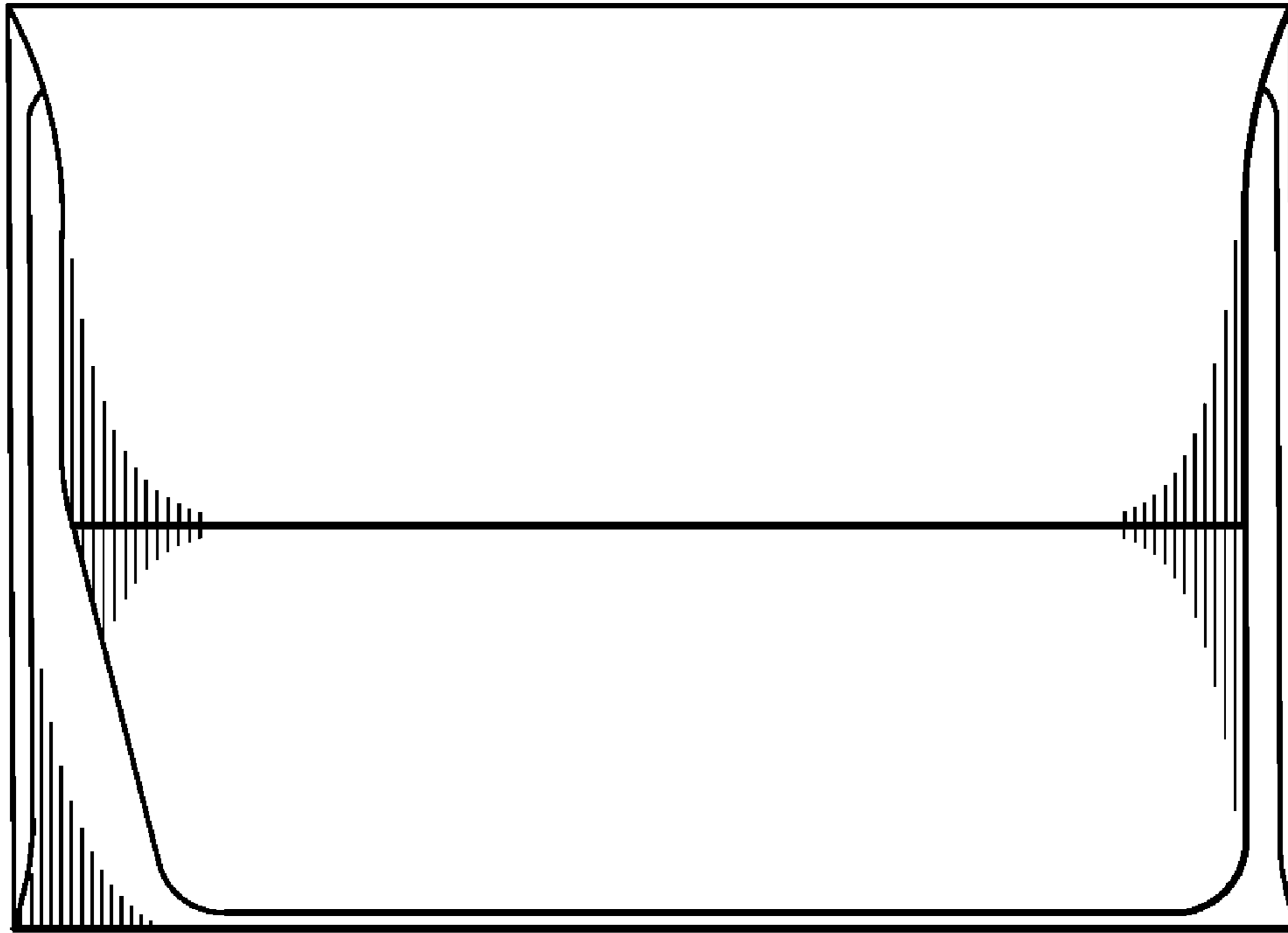
