FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof;

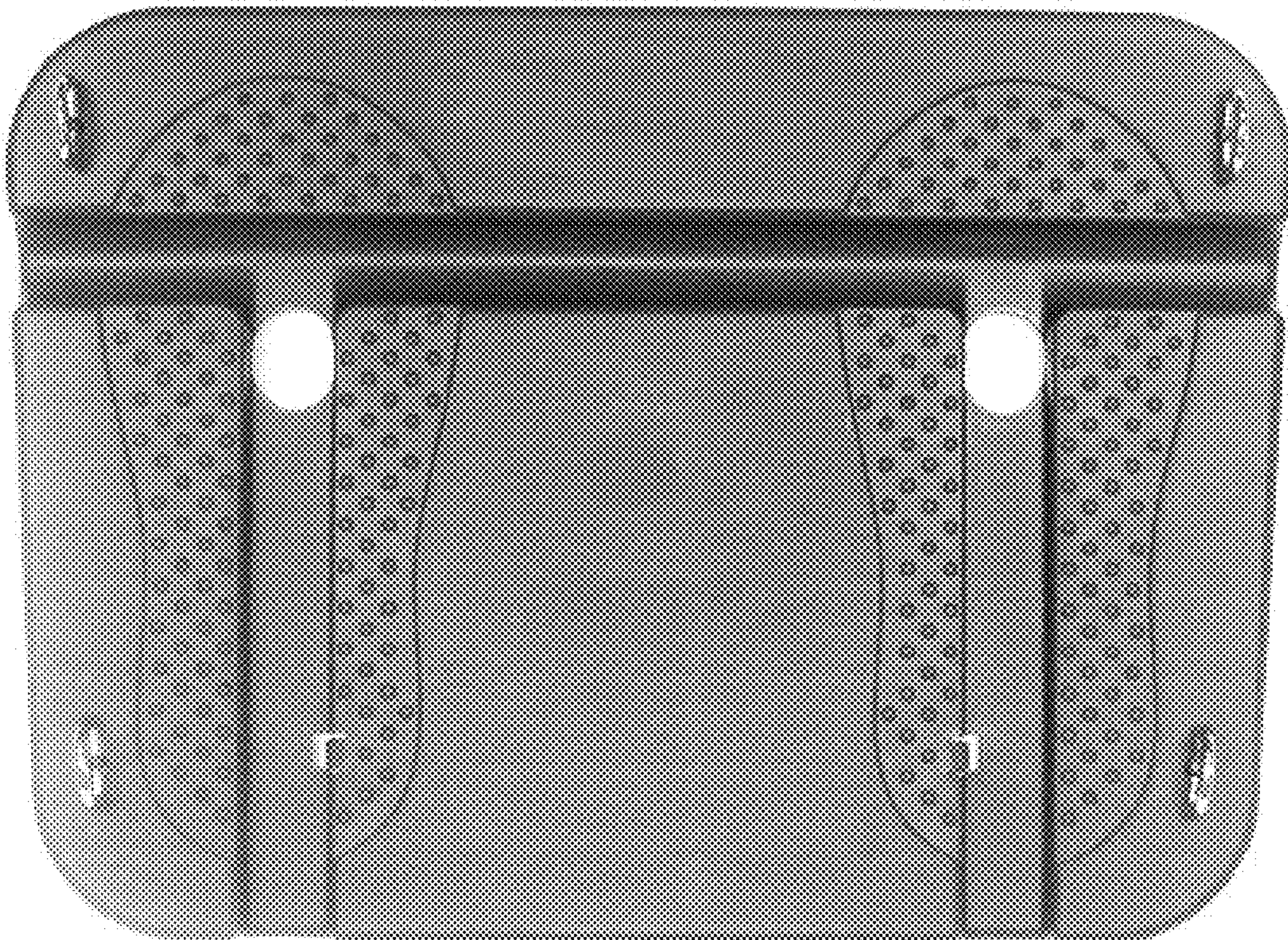
FIG. 3 is a right perspective view thereof, the left perspective view being an identical mirror image of FIG. 3;

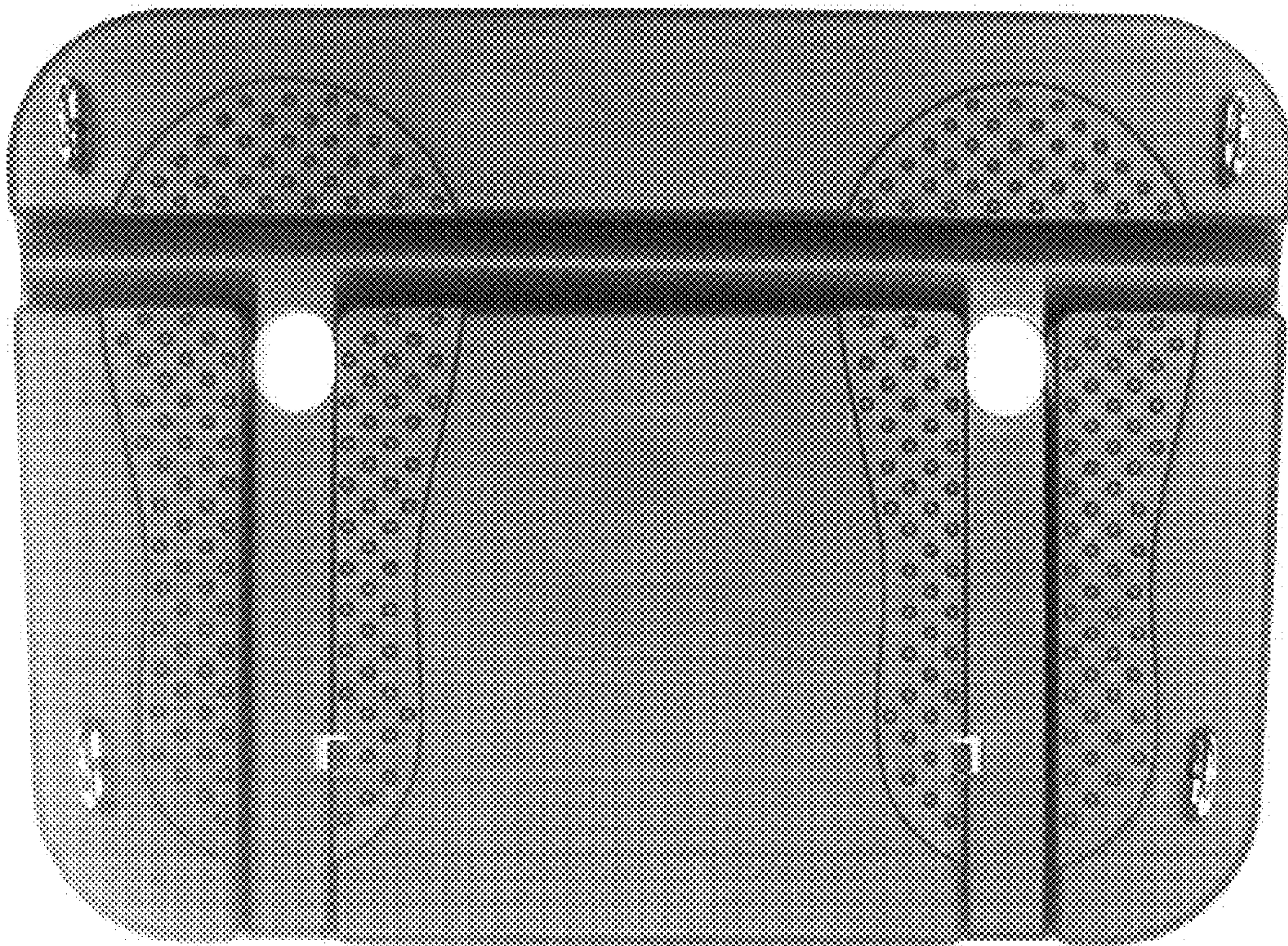

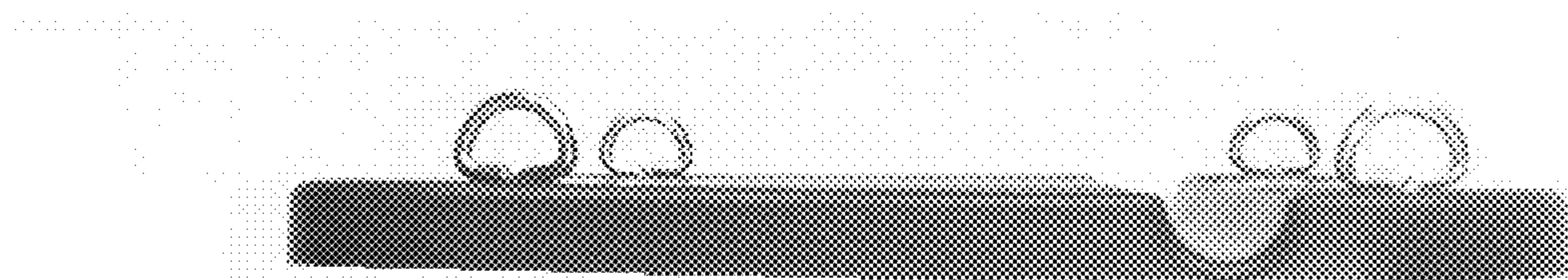

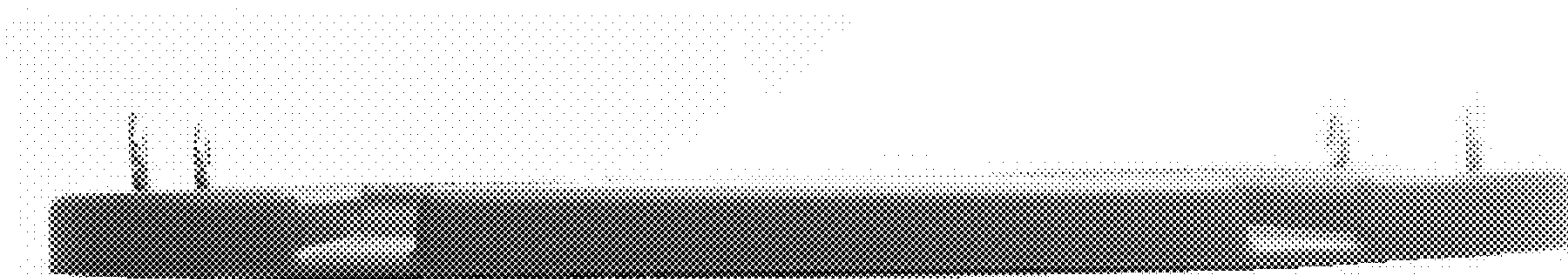

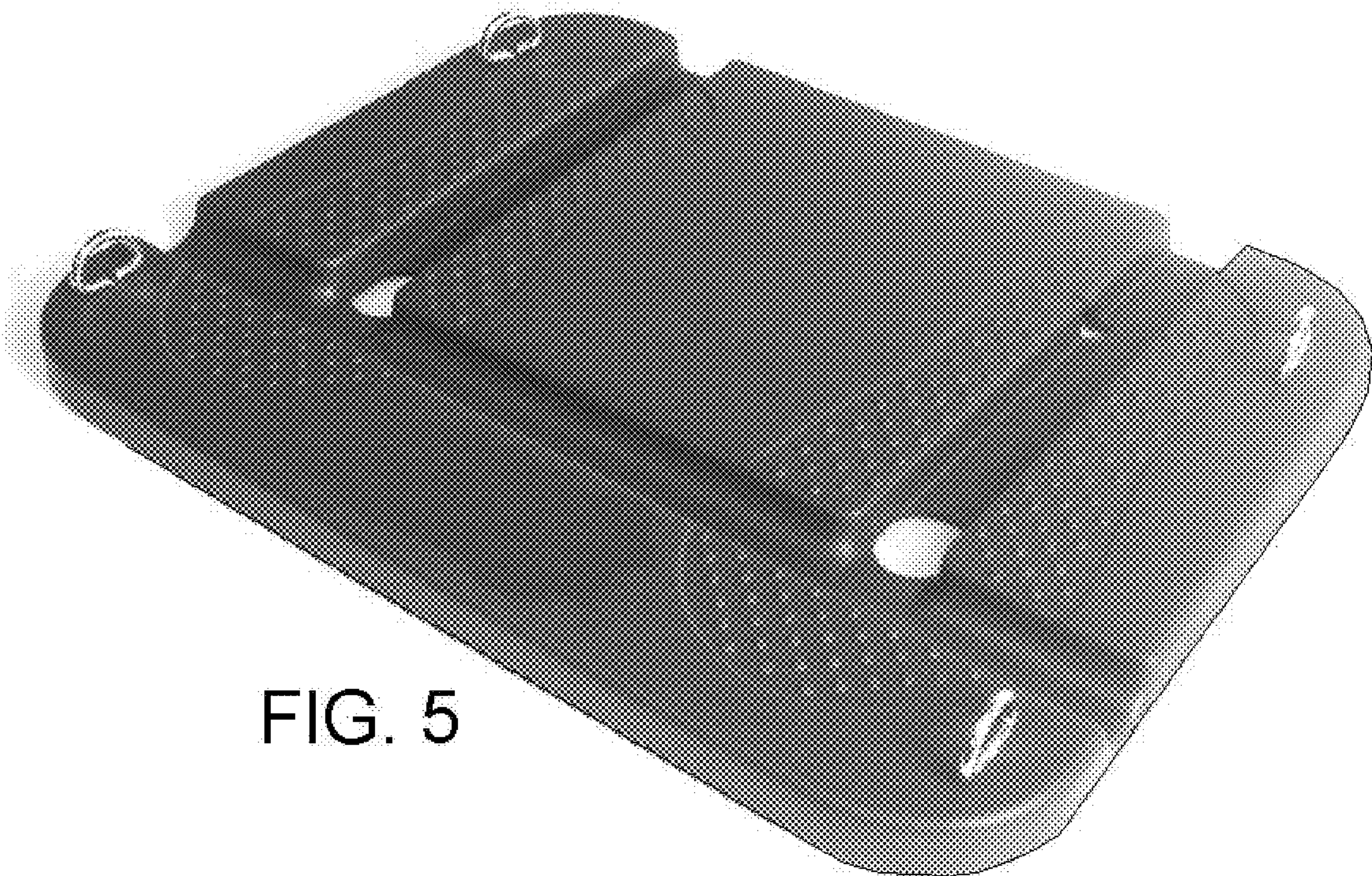
