DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from above of a portion of toilet showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;

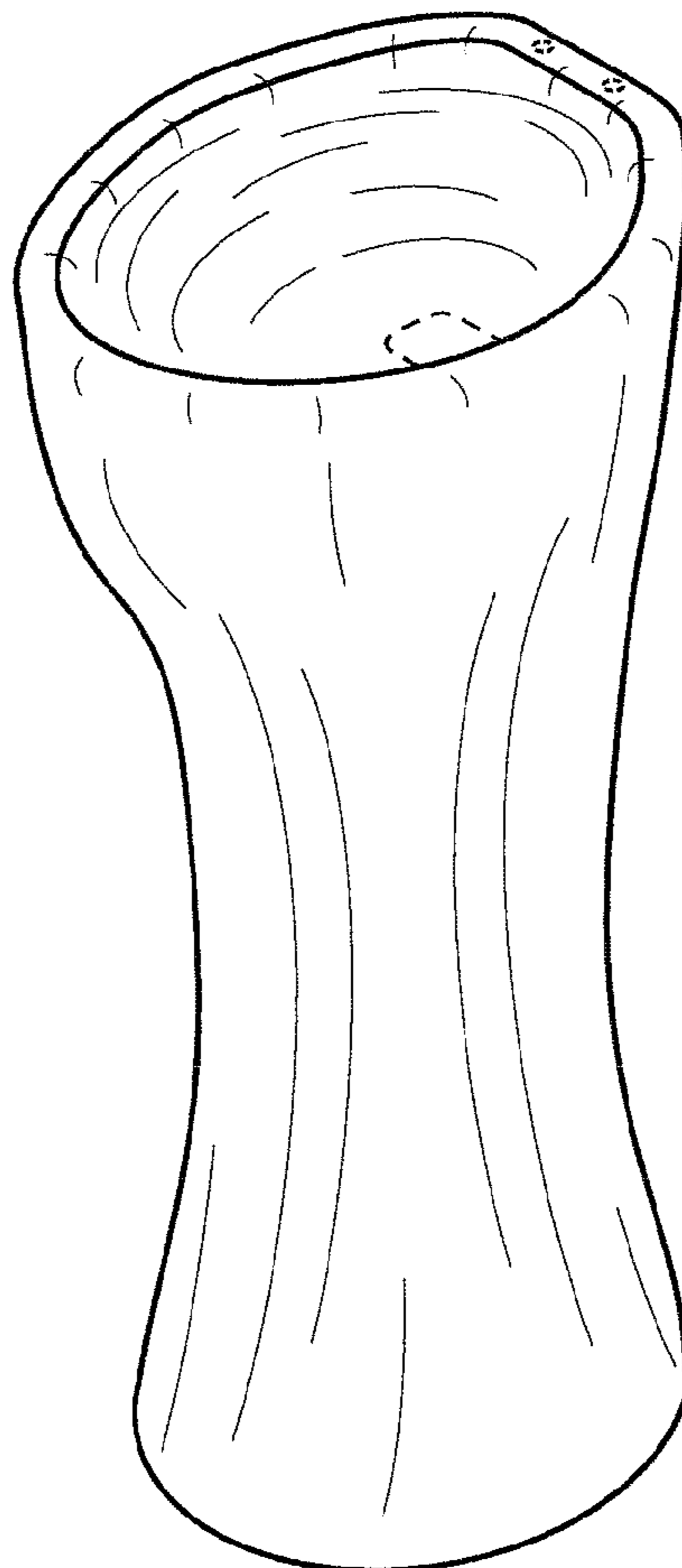
FIG. 3 is a back elevational view;

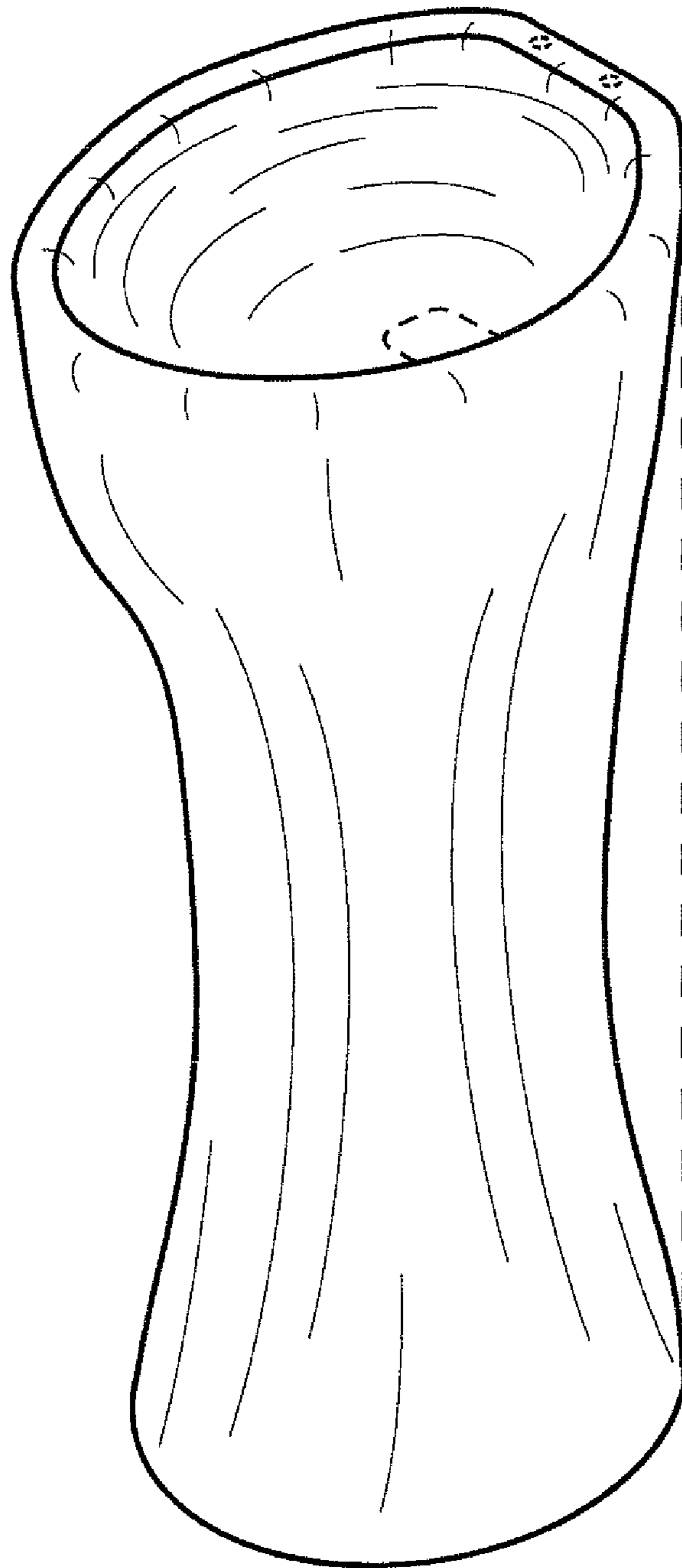

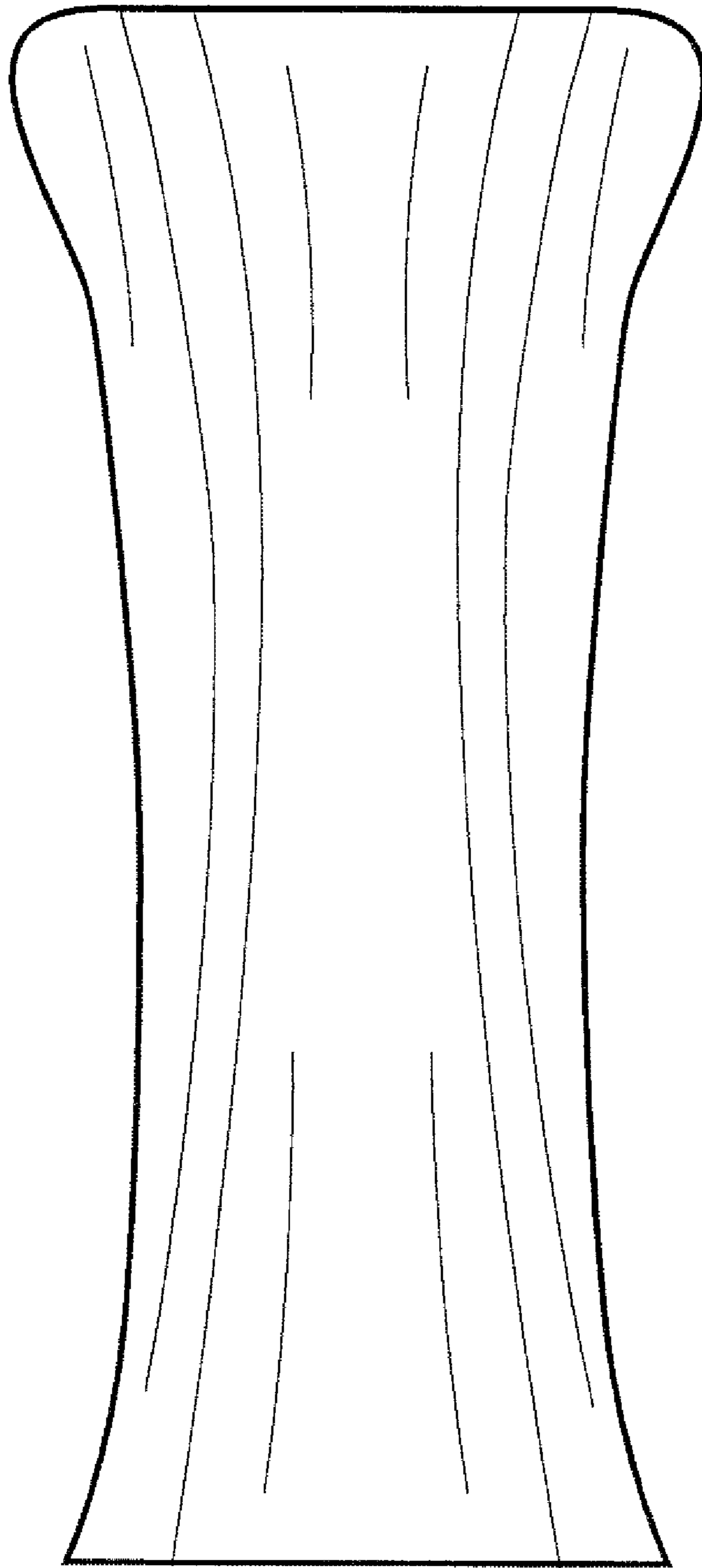

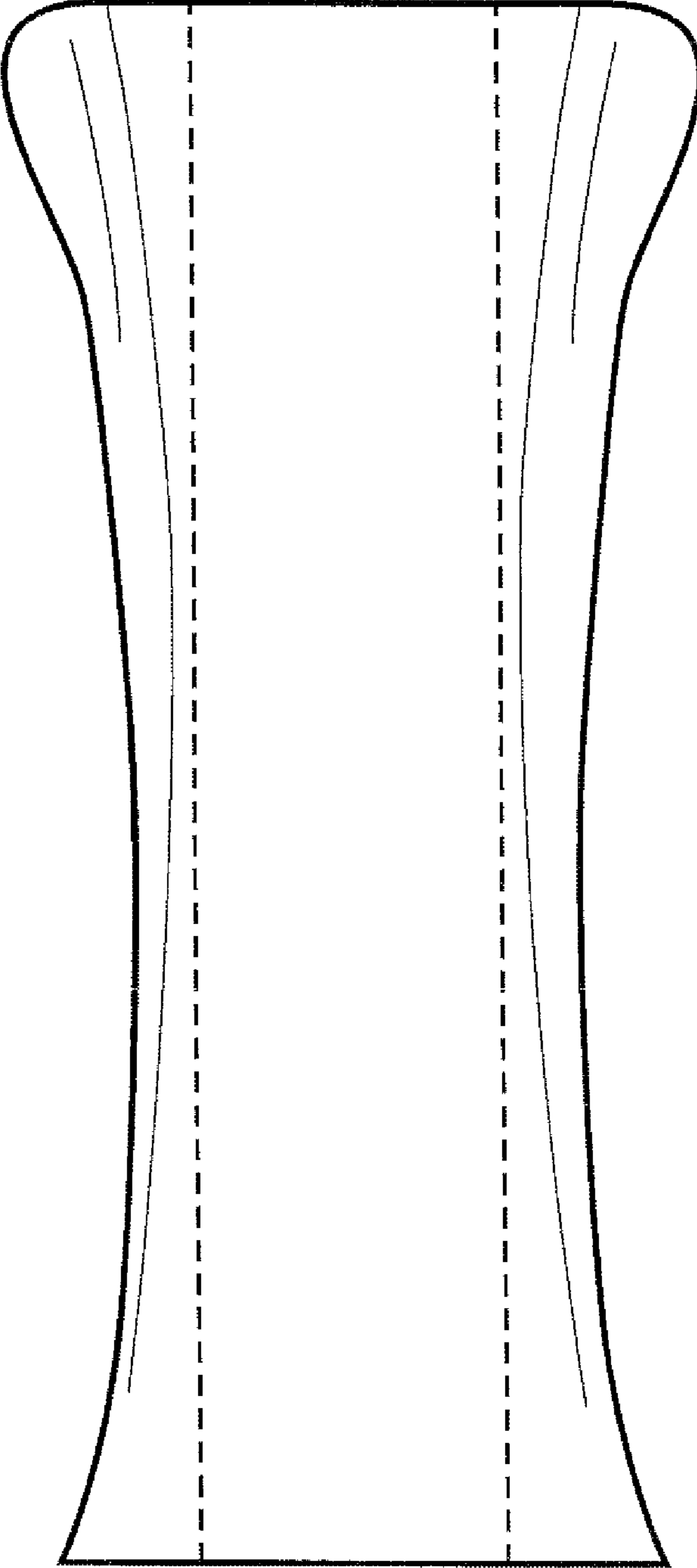

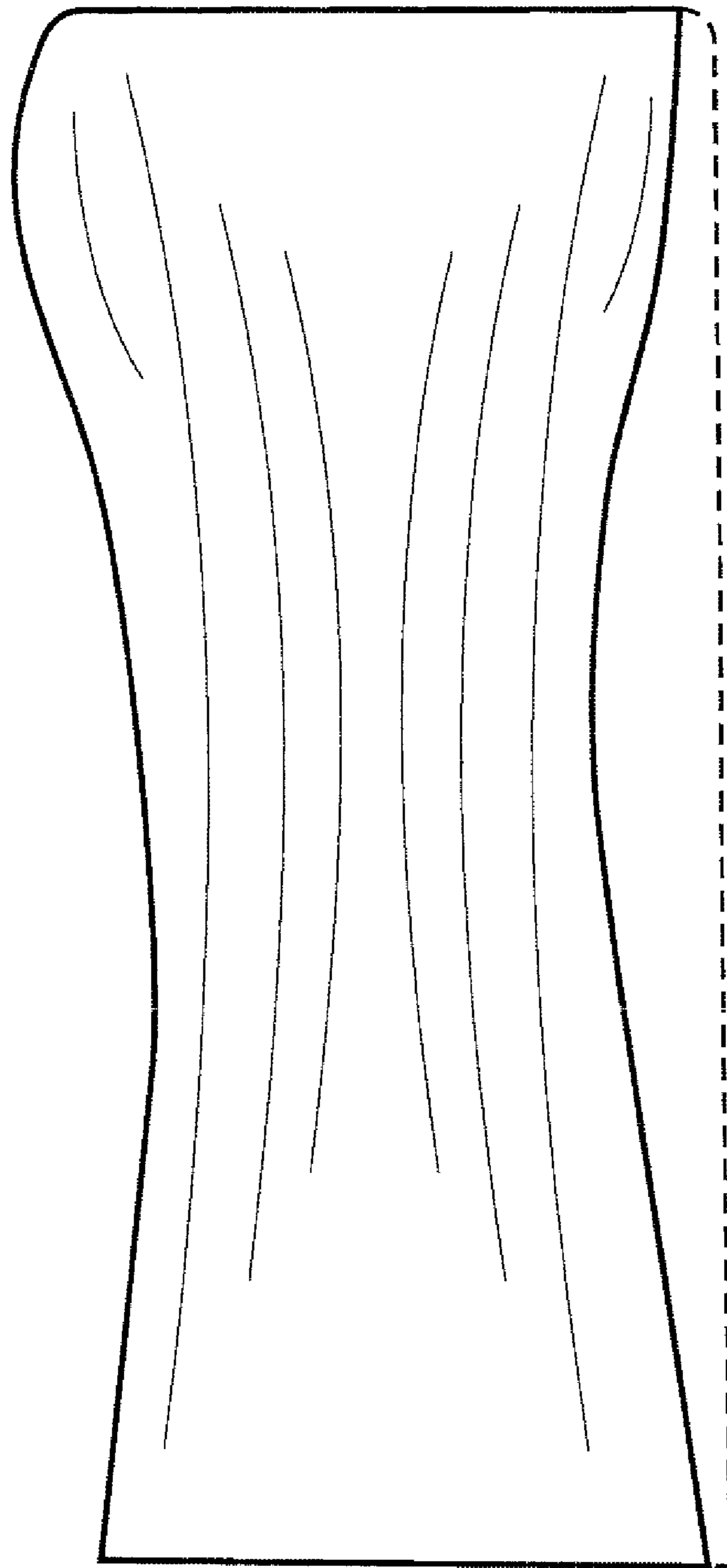

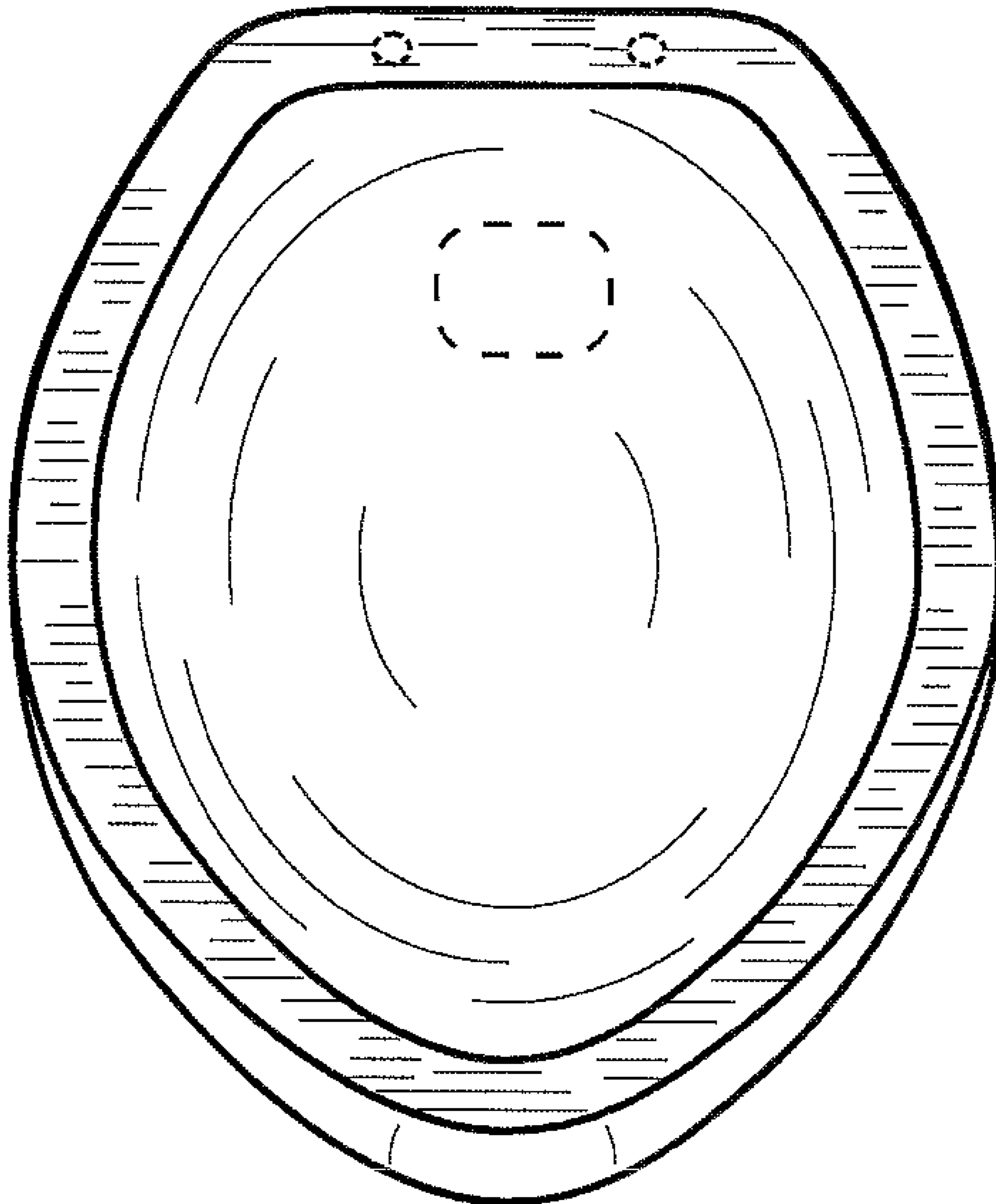
