FIG. 5 is a top view of the tape measure thereof.

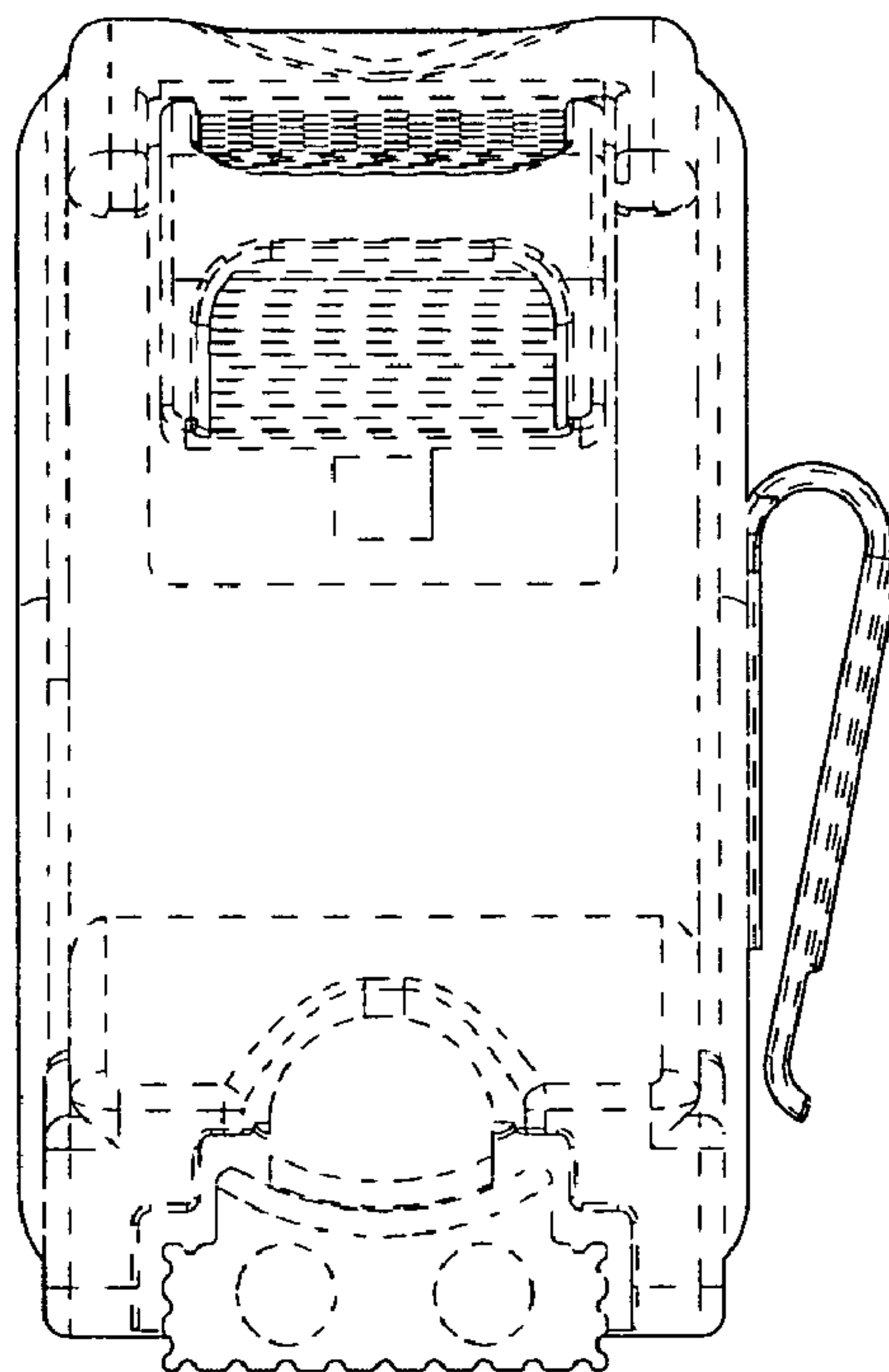
FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the tape measure thereof.

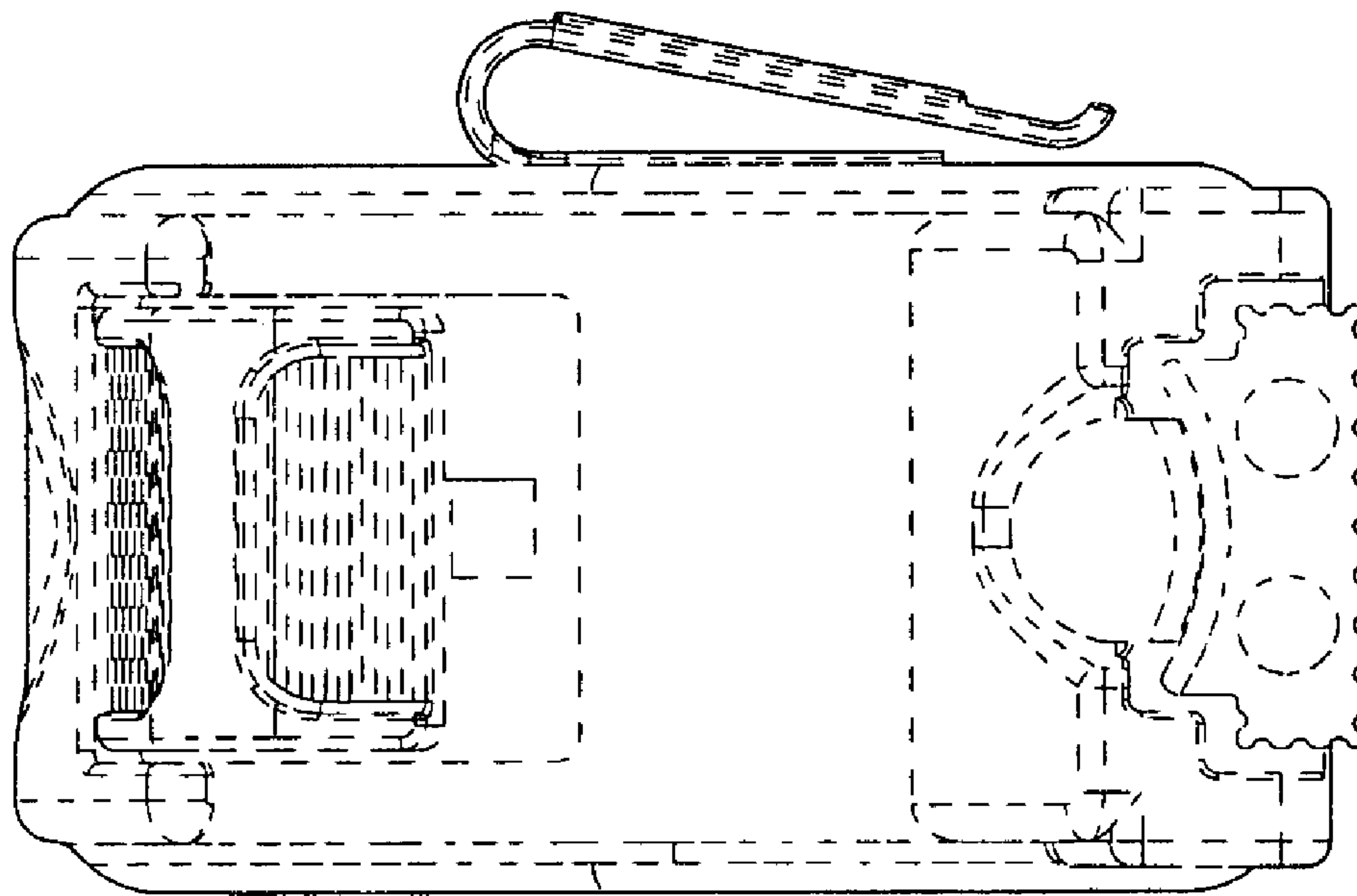

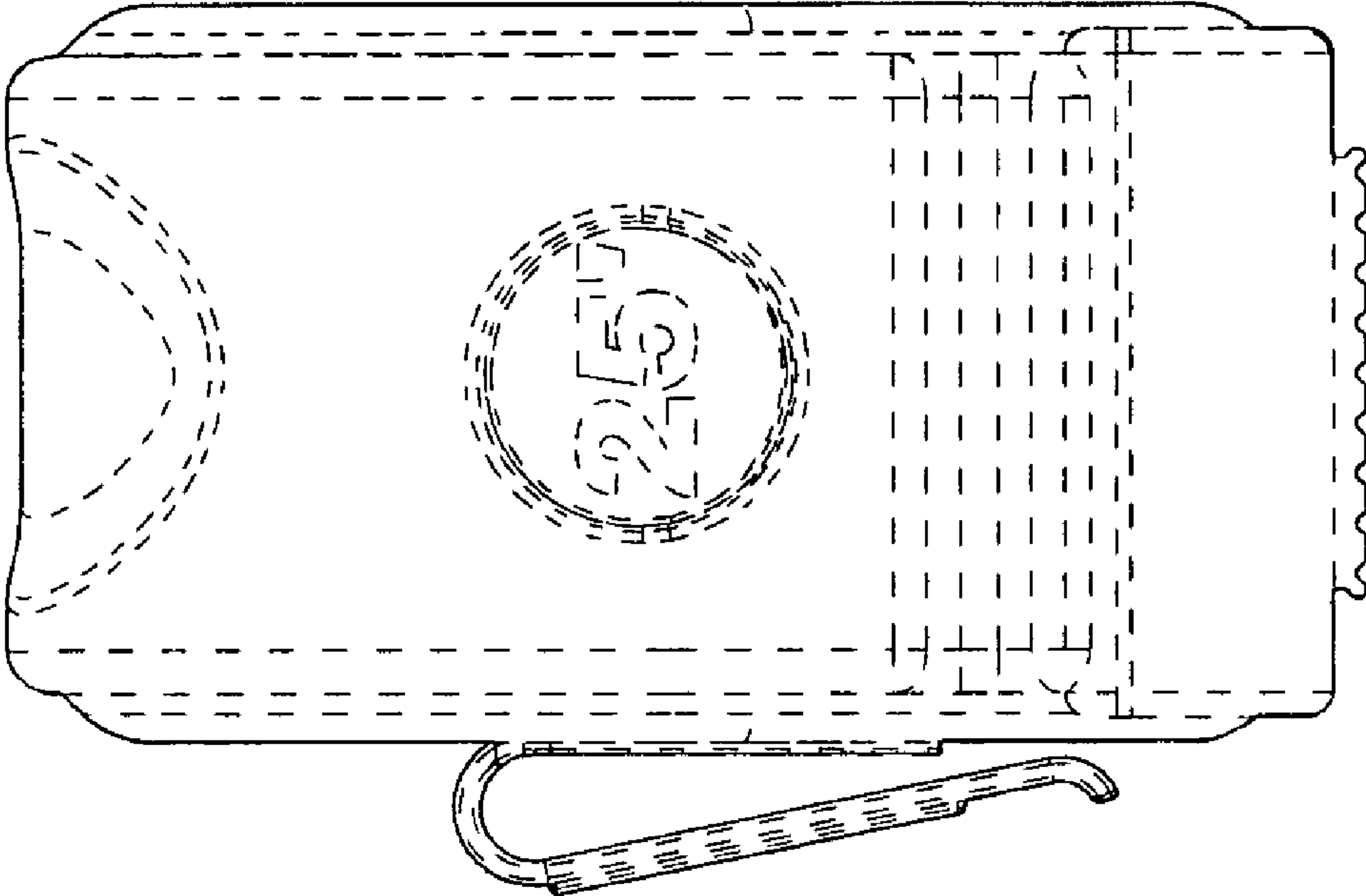

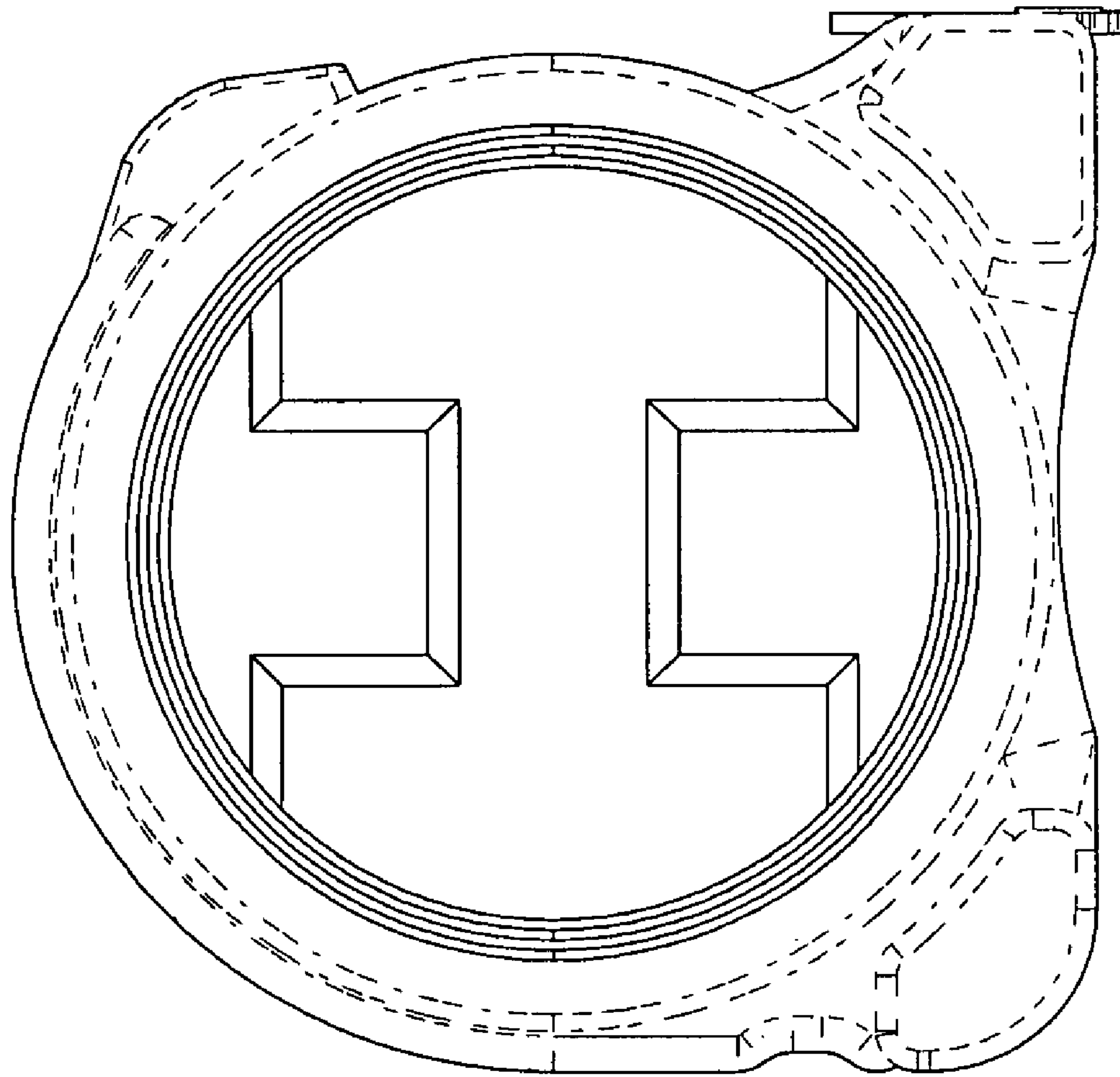

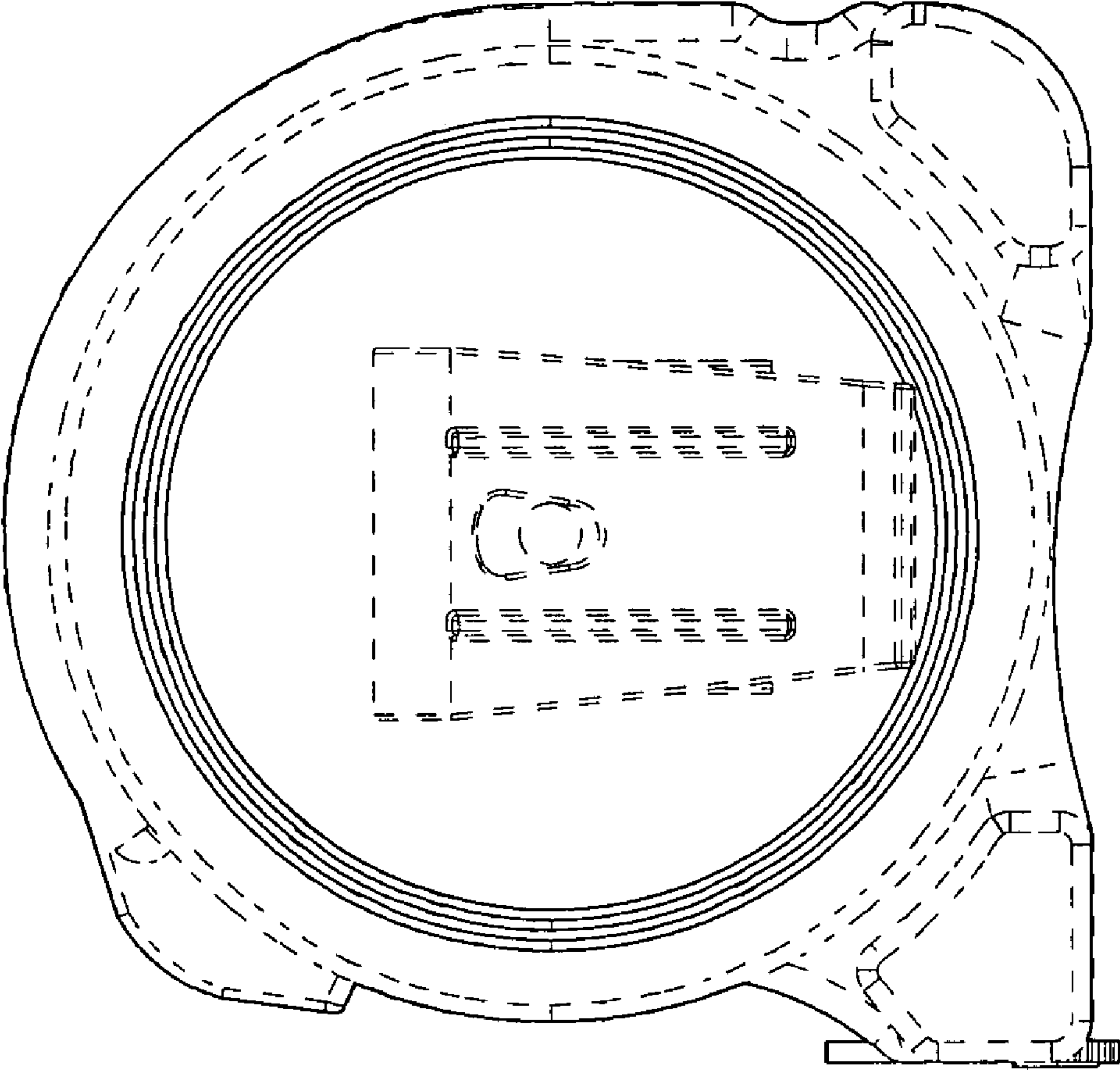

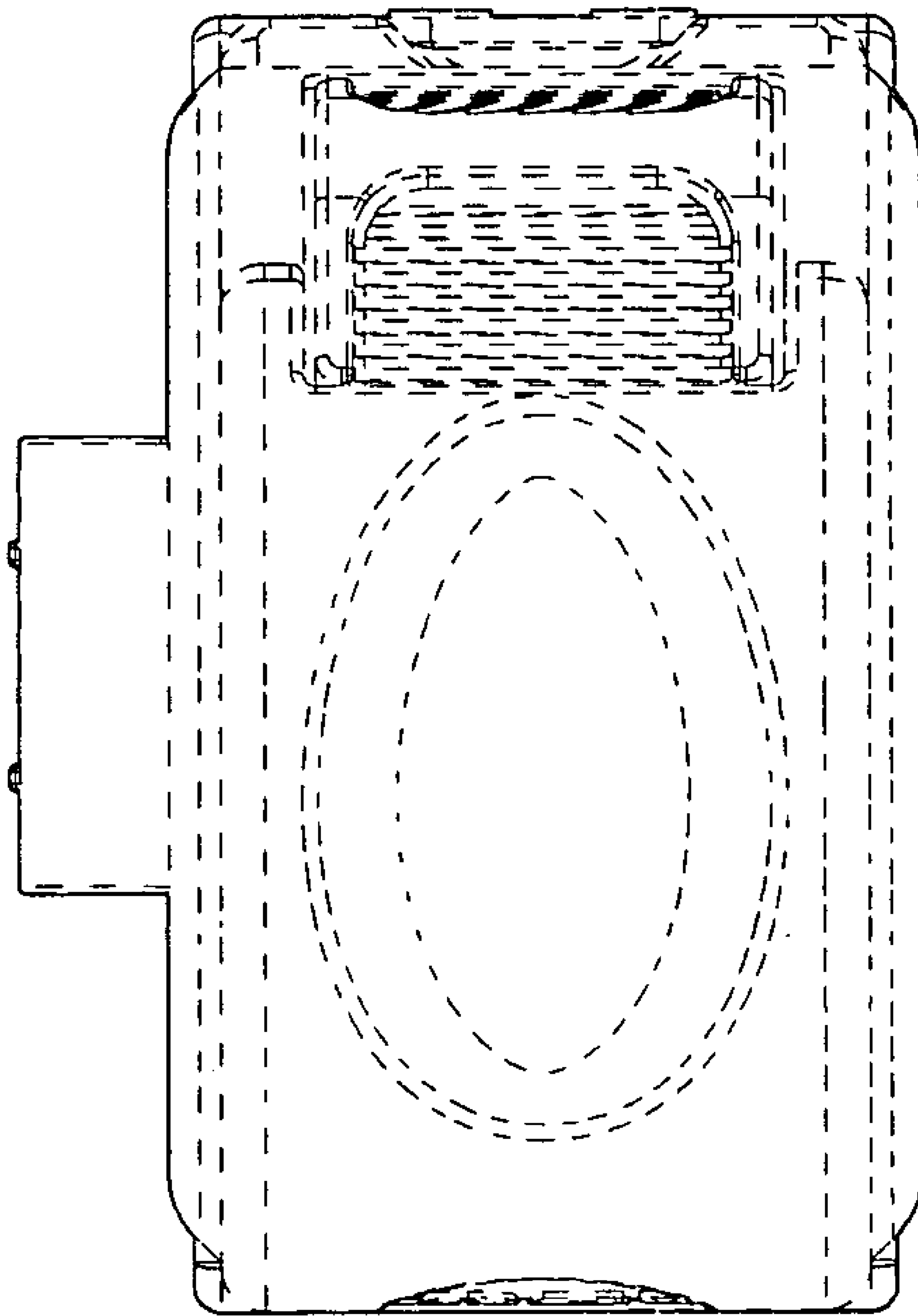

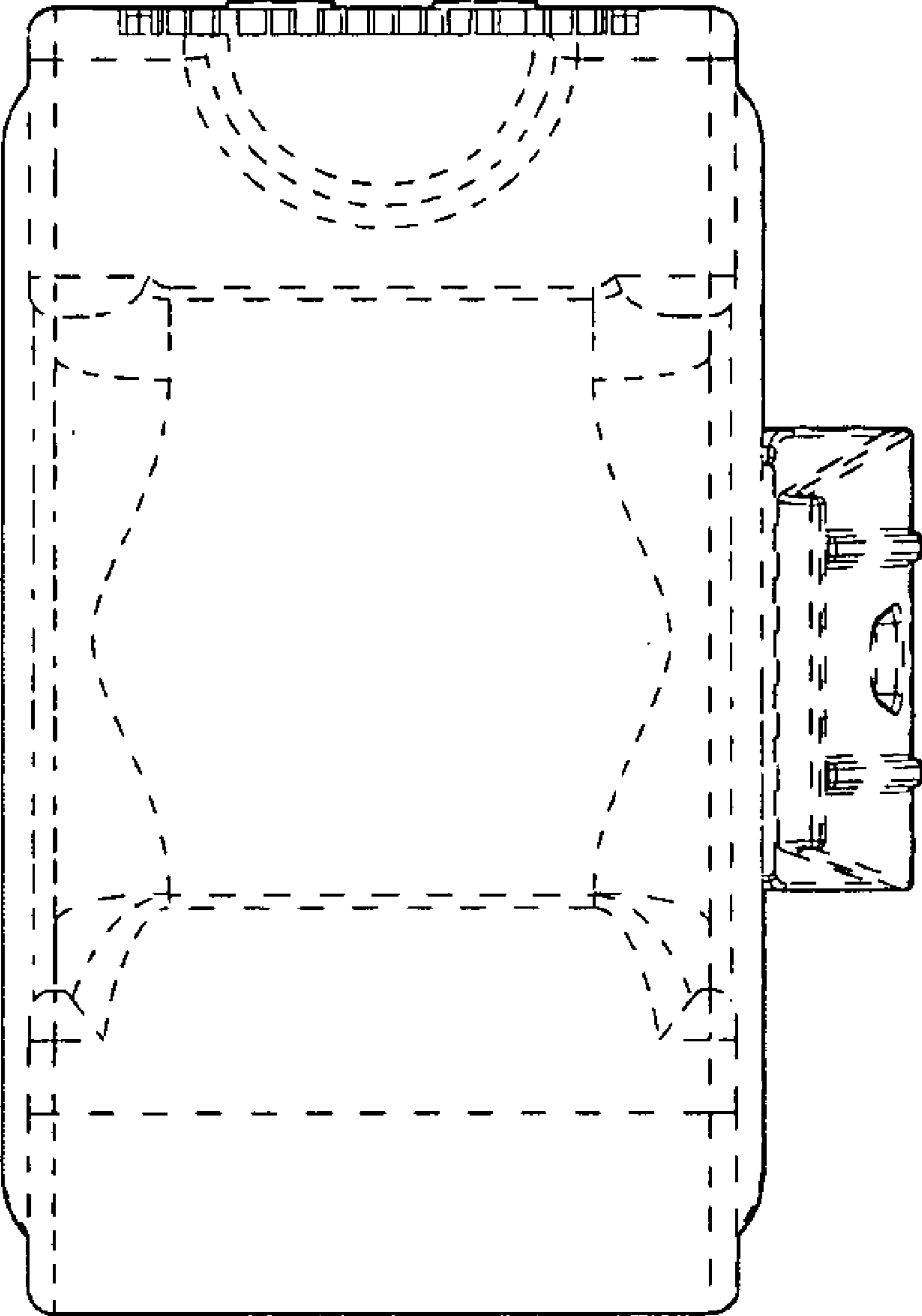

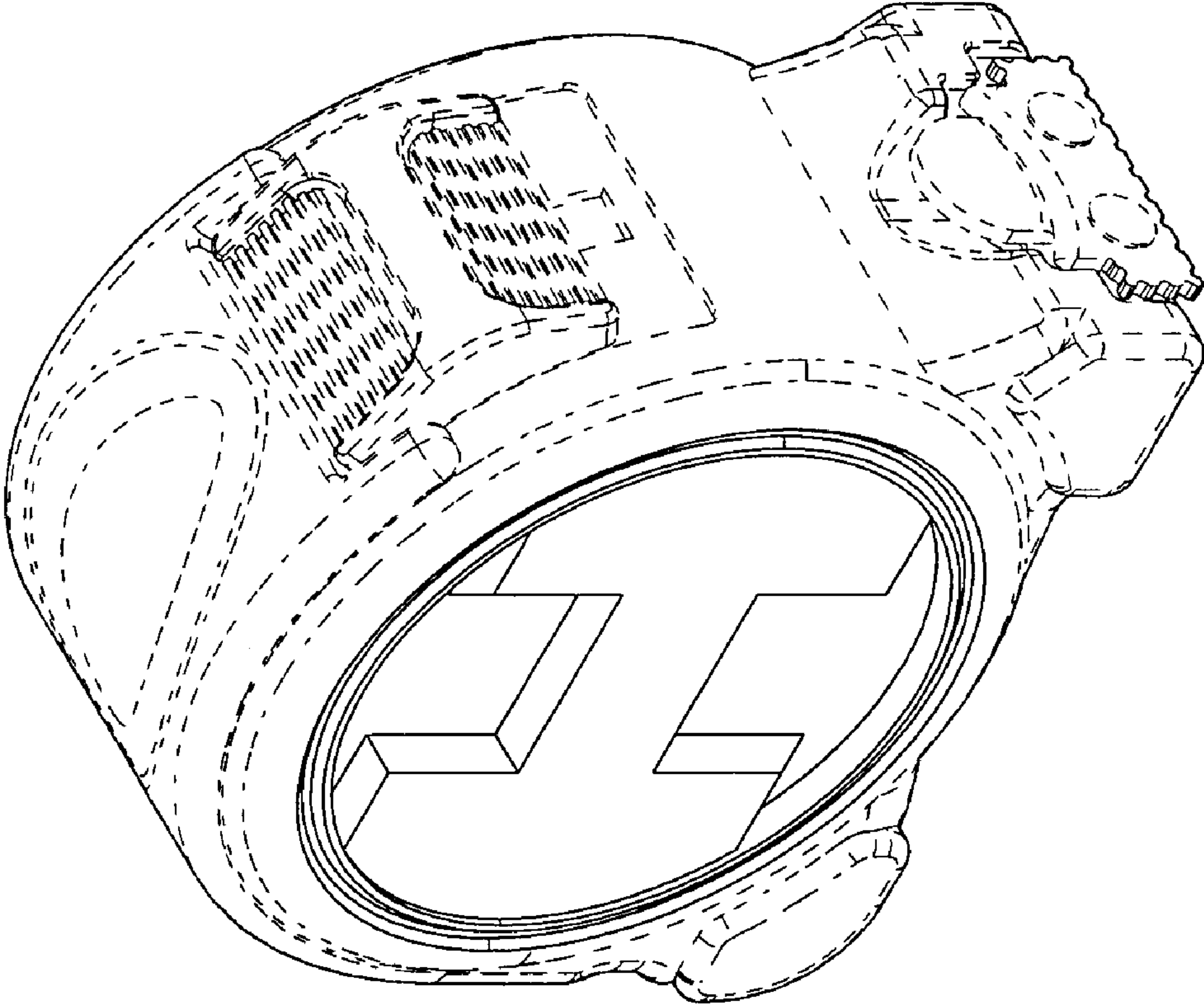

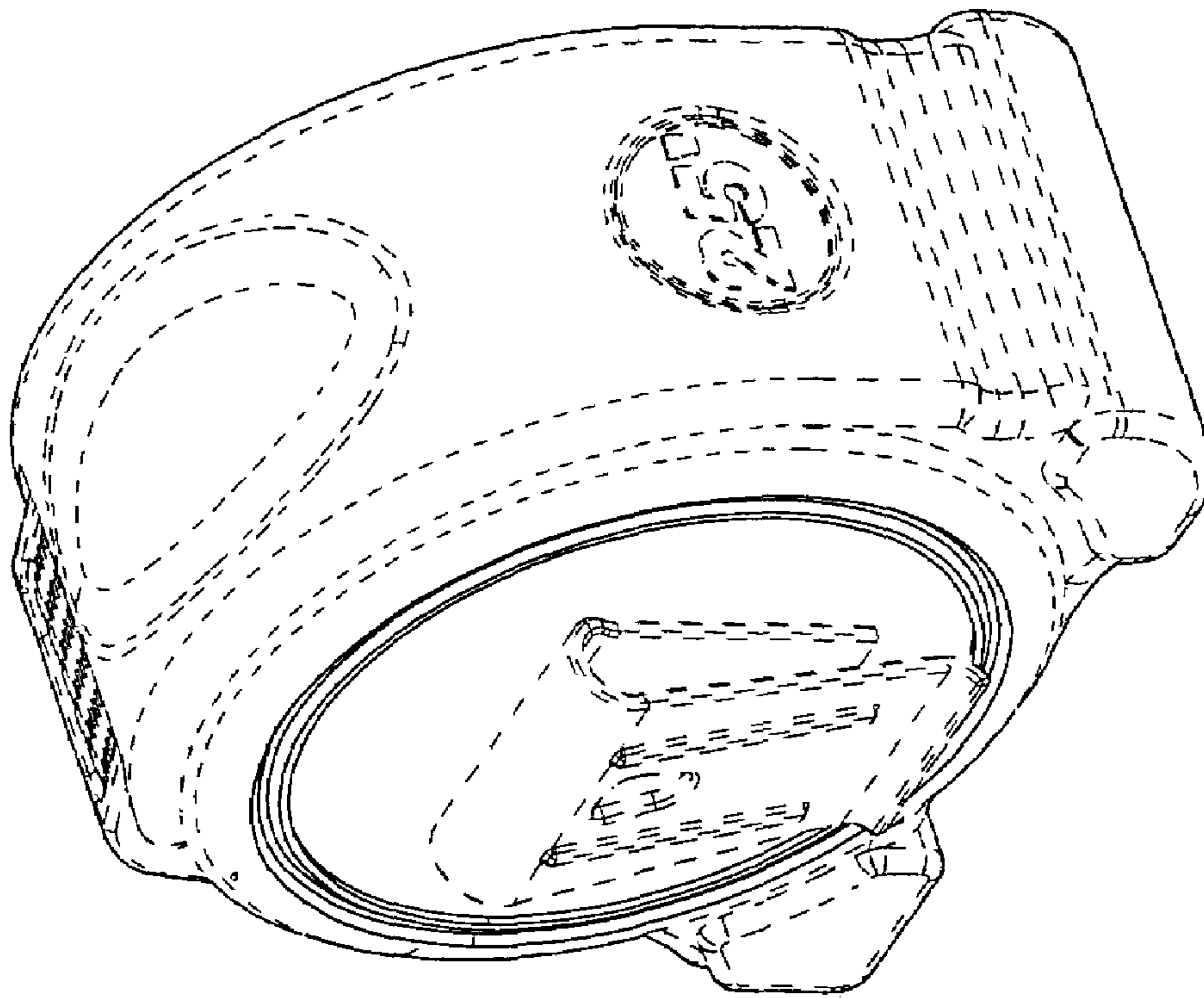
