FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;

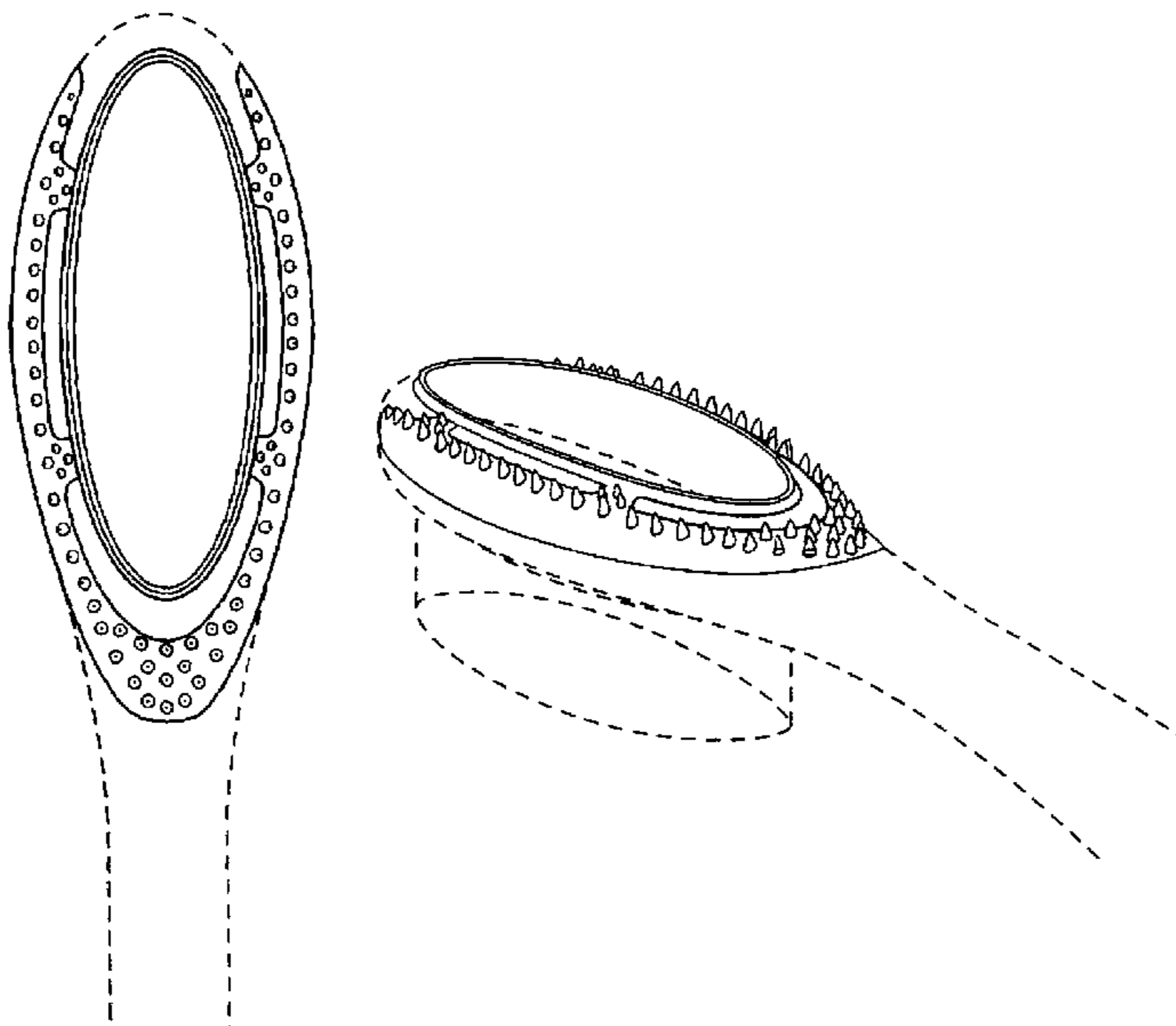
FIG. 6 is a right, frontal perspective view thereof; and,

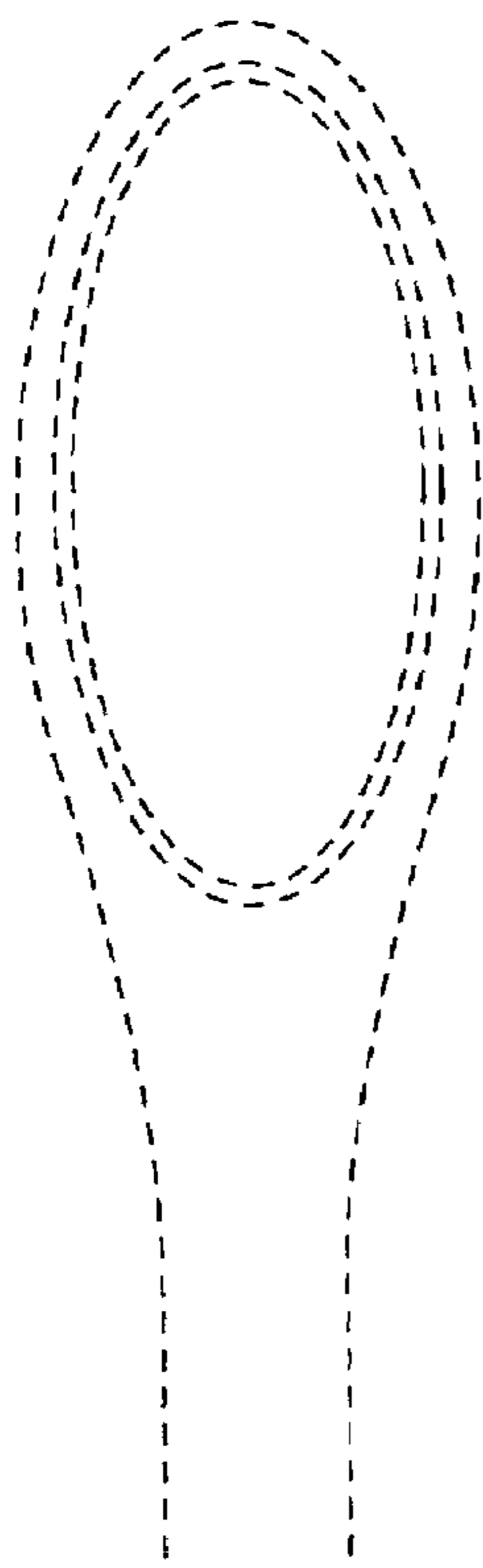

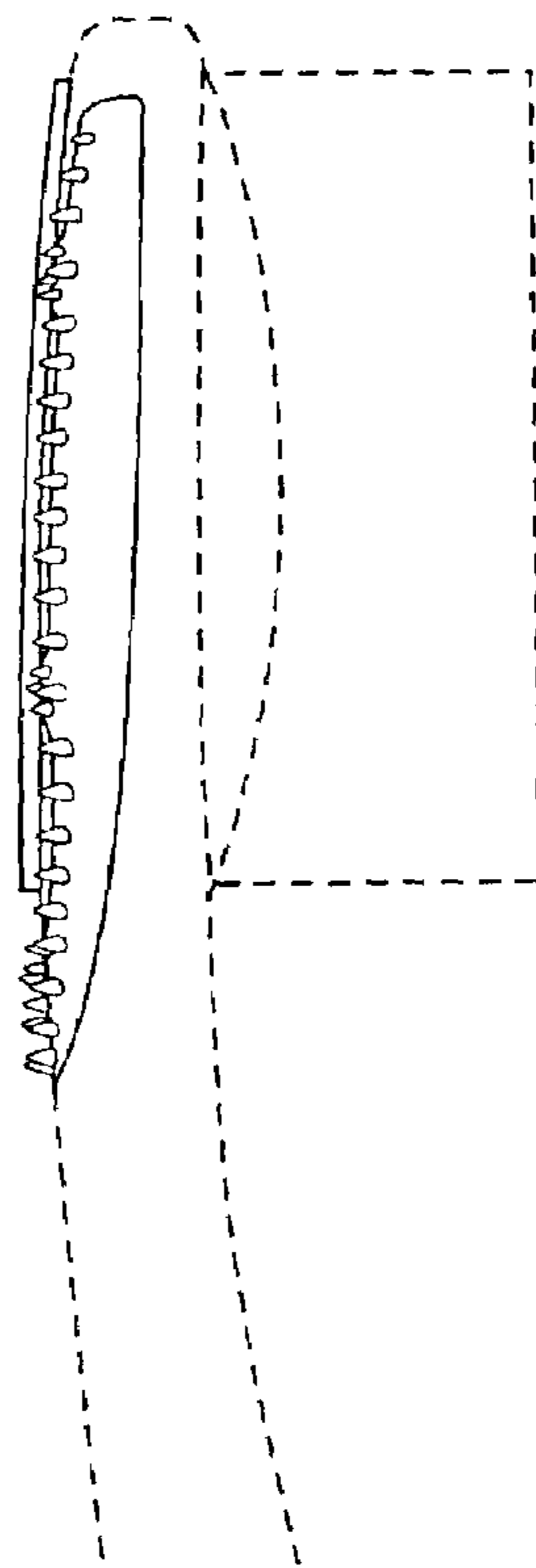

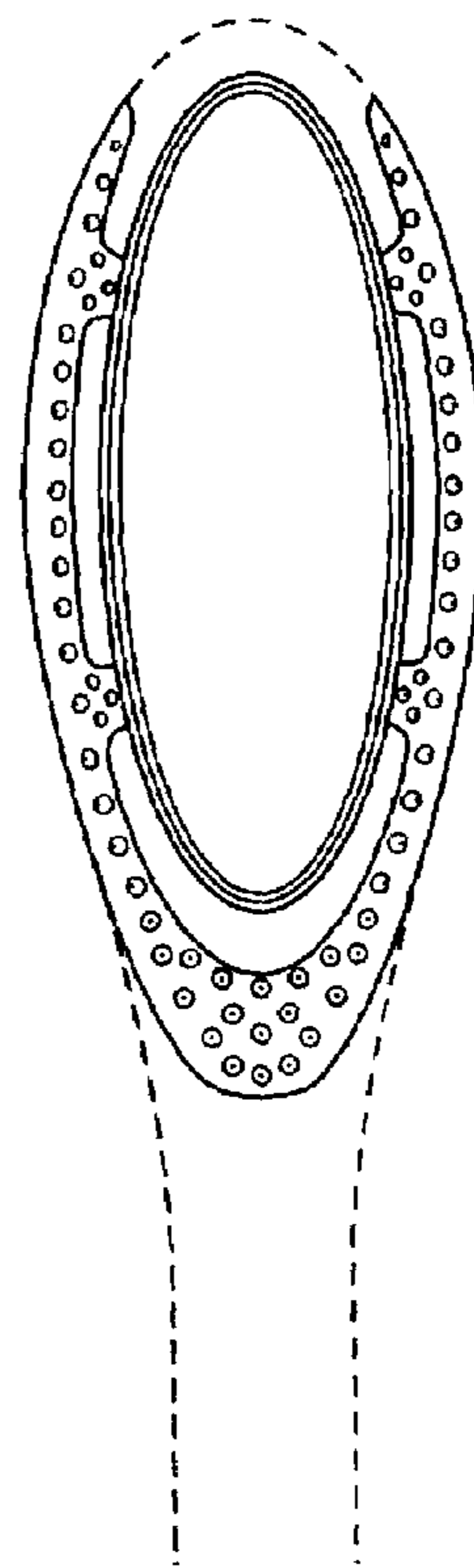

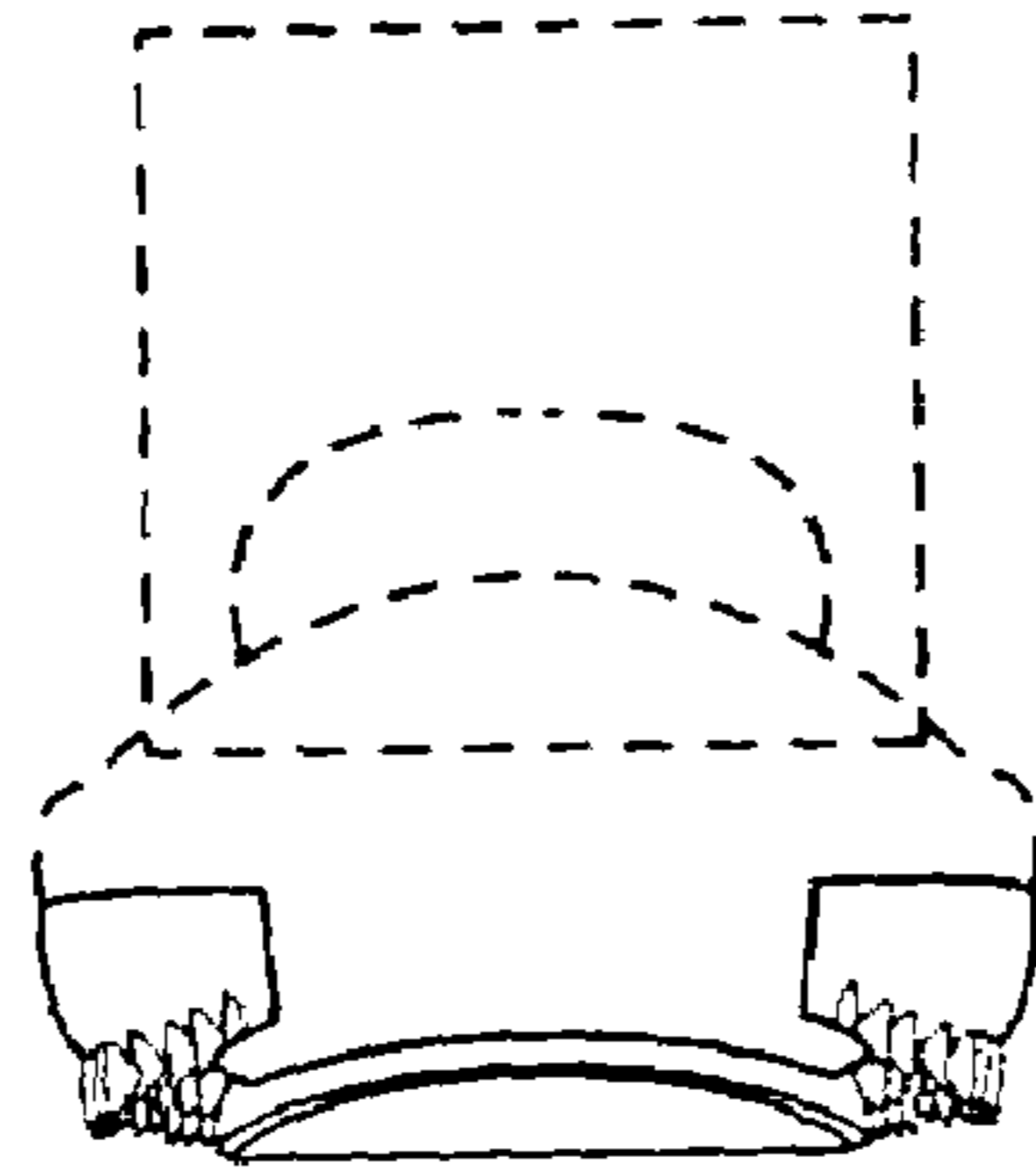

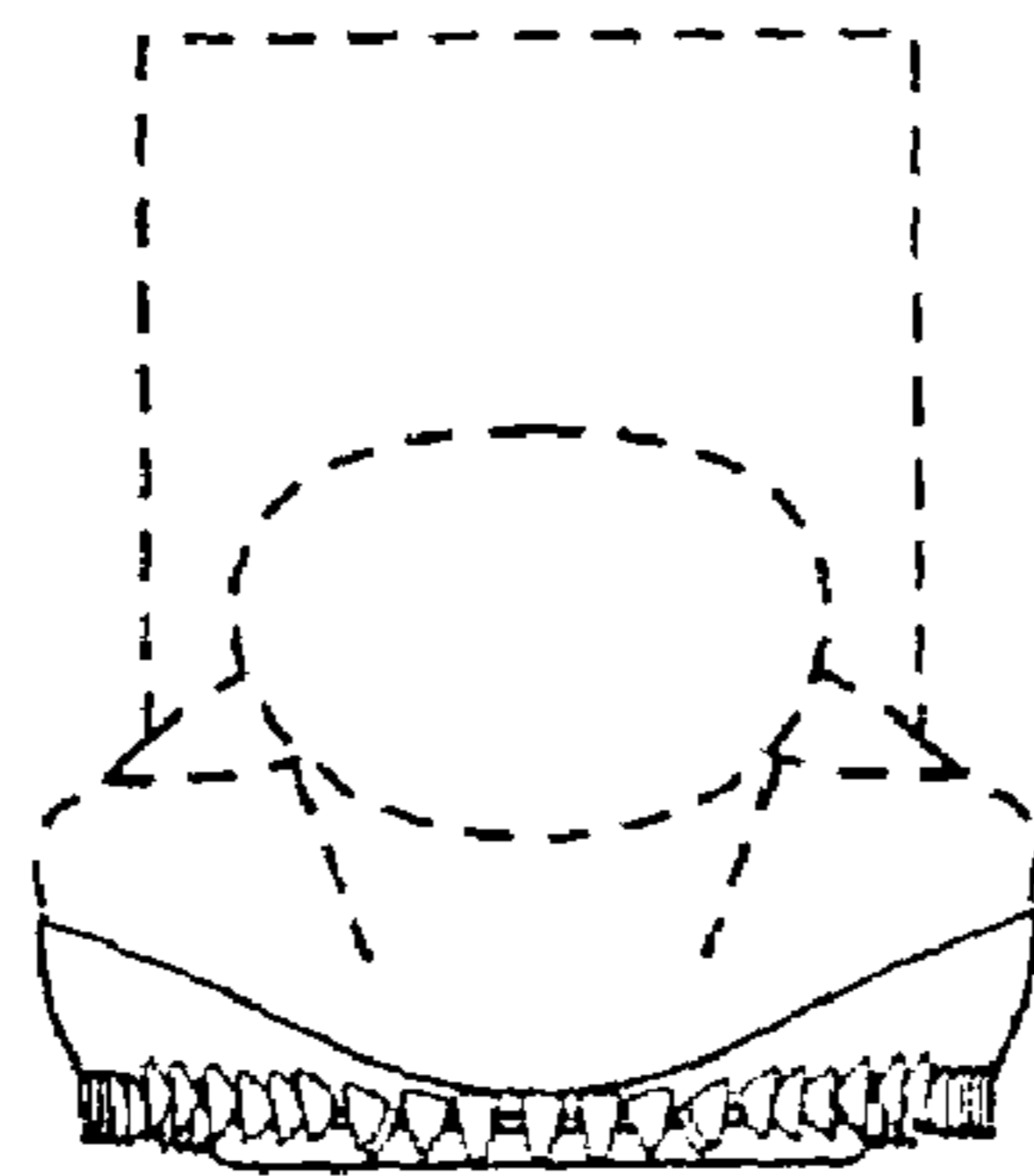

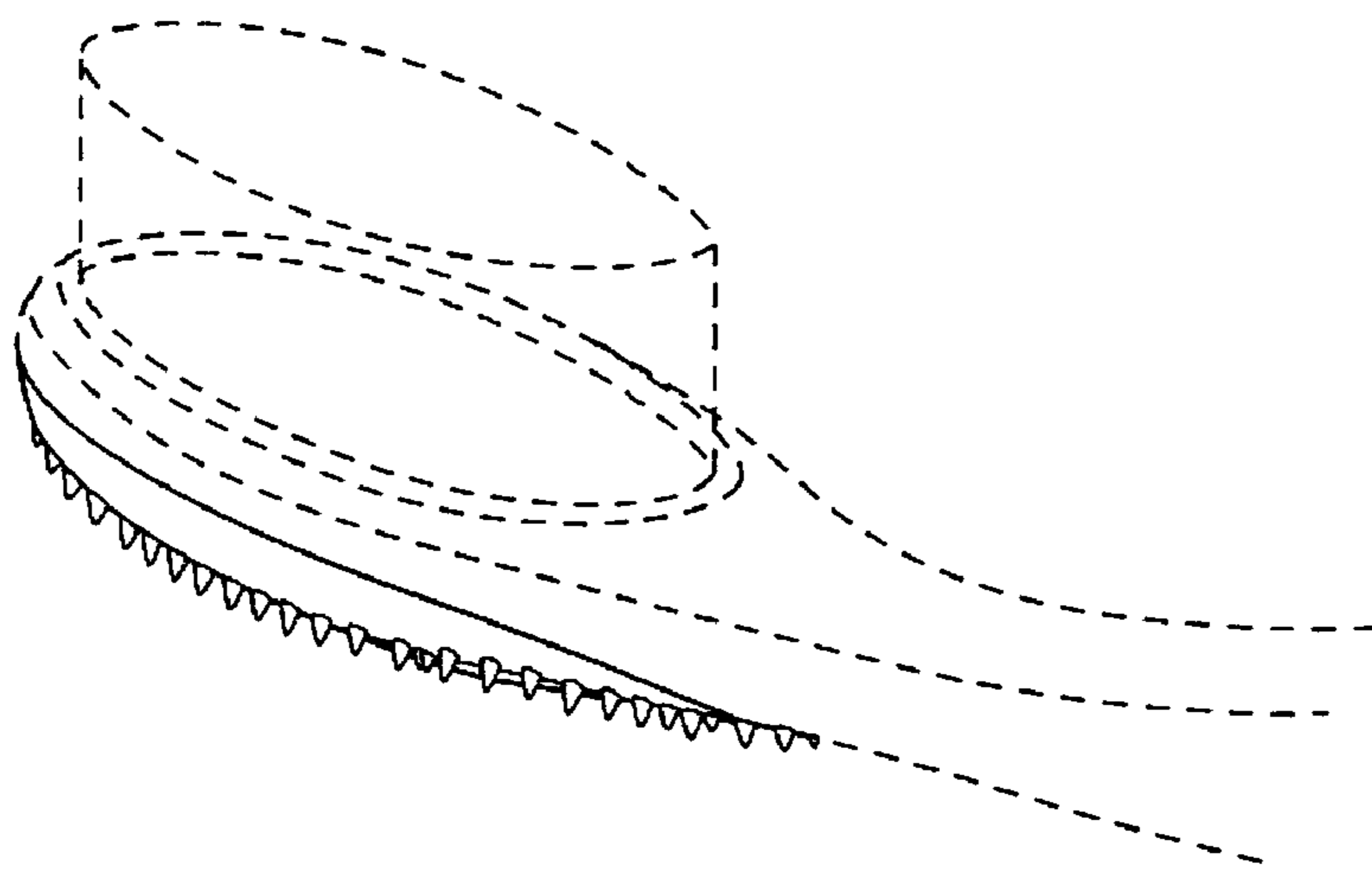

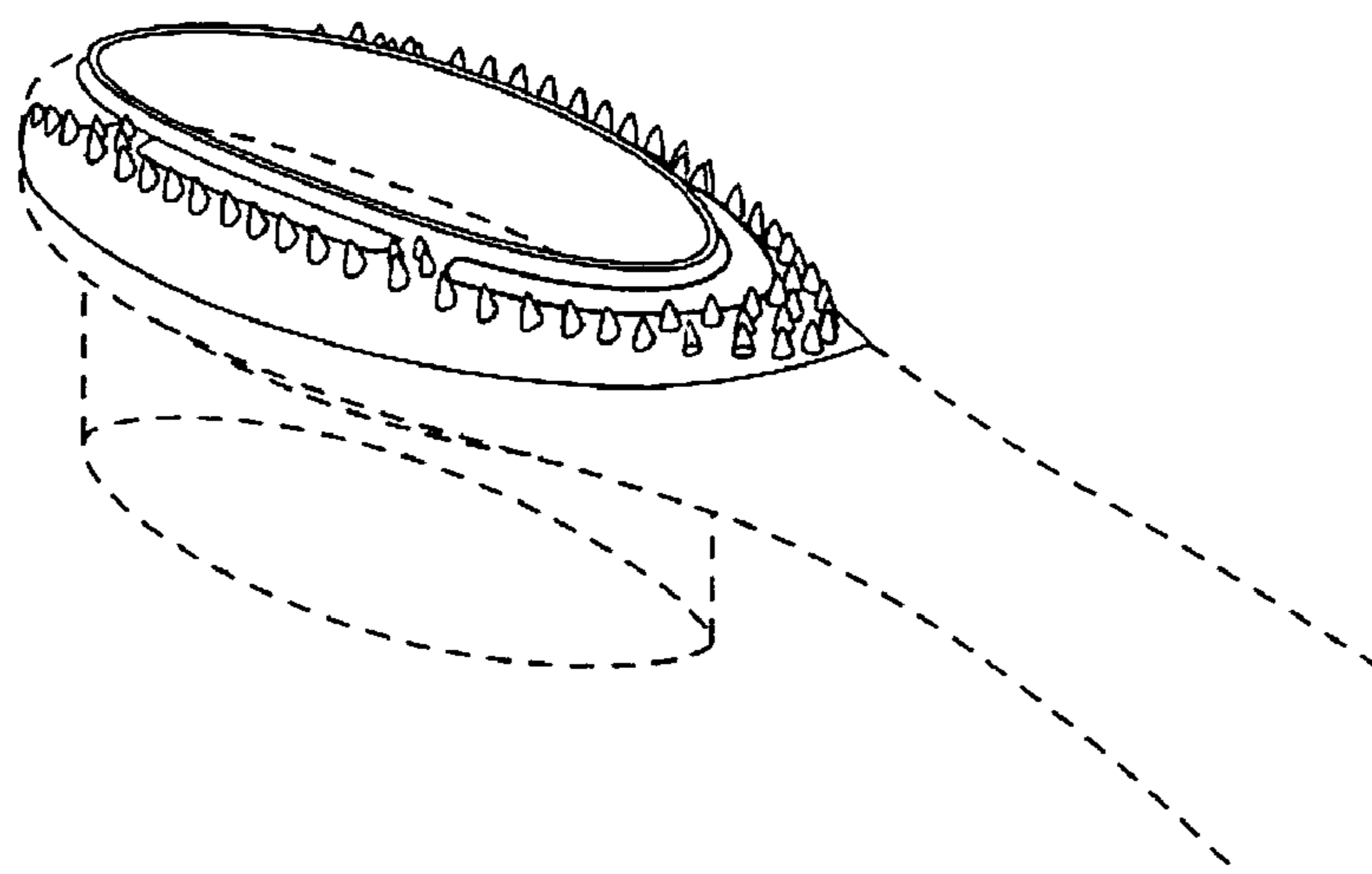
