FIG. 9 is a front view thereof;

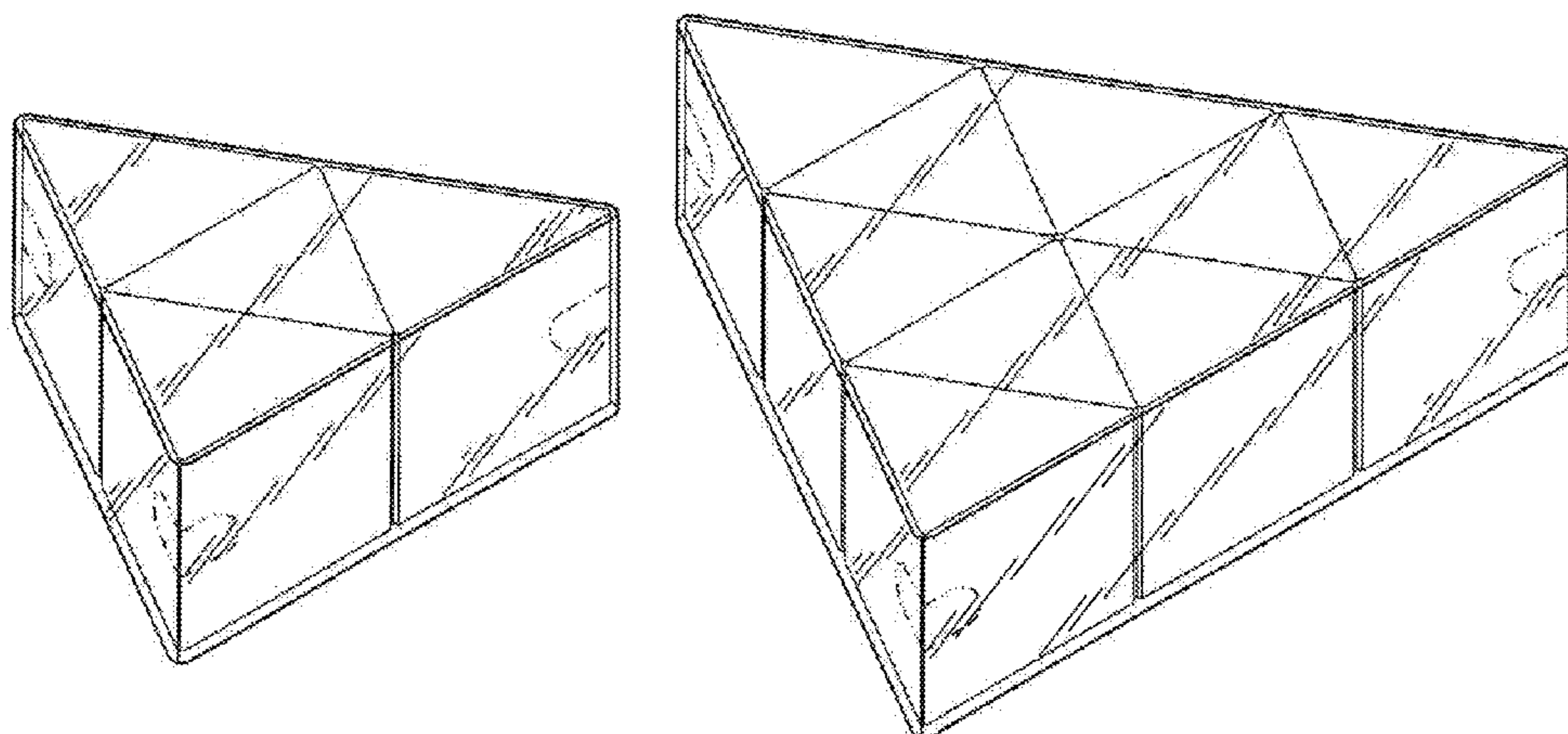
FIG. 10 is a right side view thereof with the left side view being identical;

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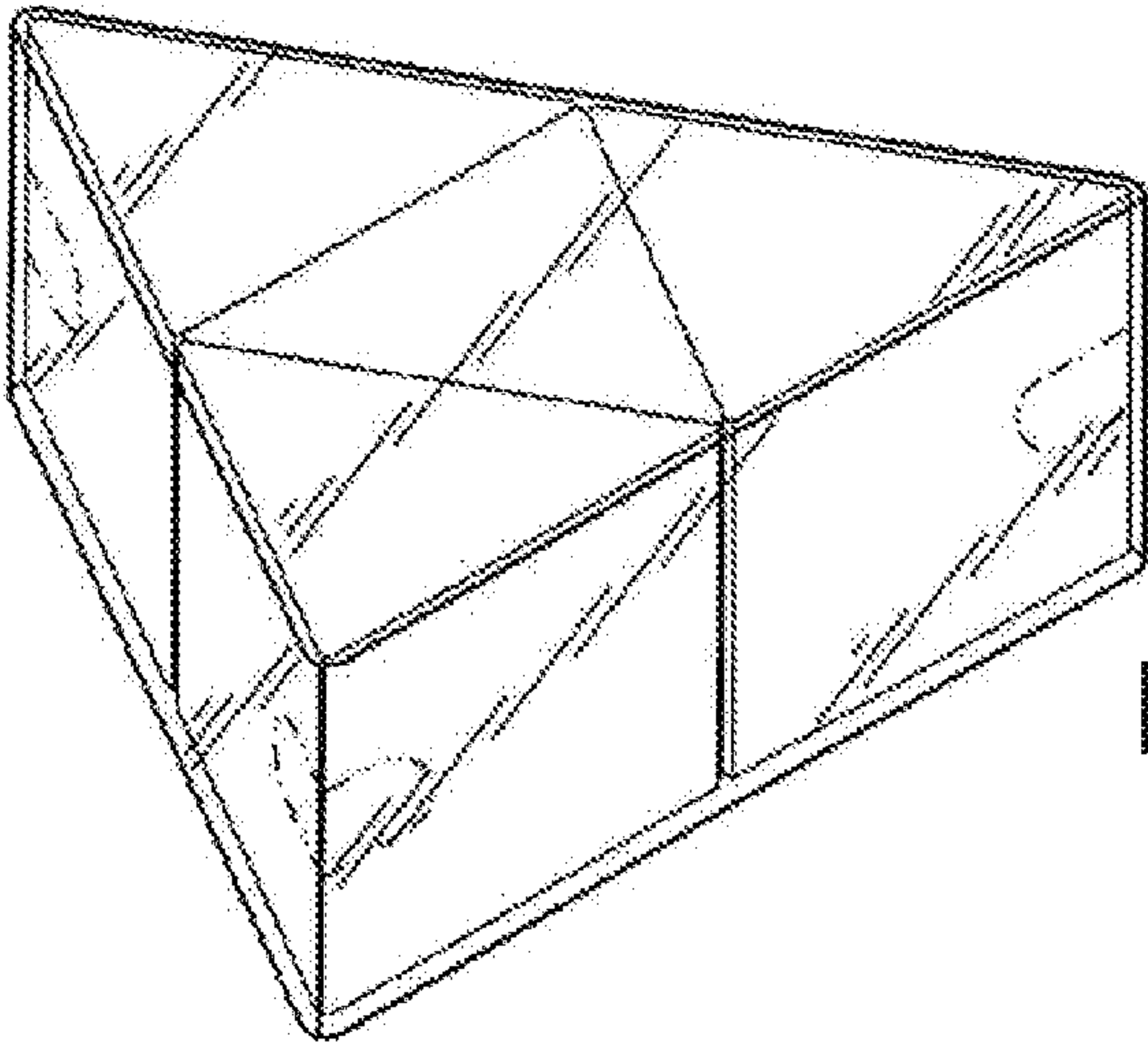

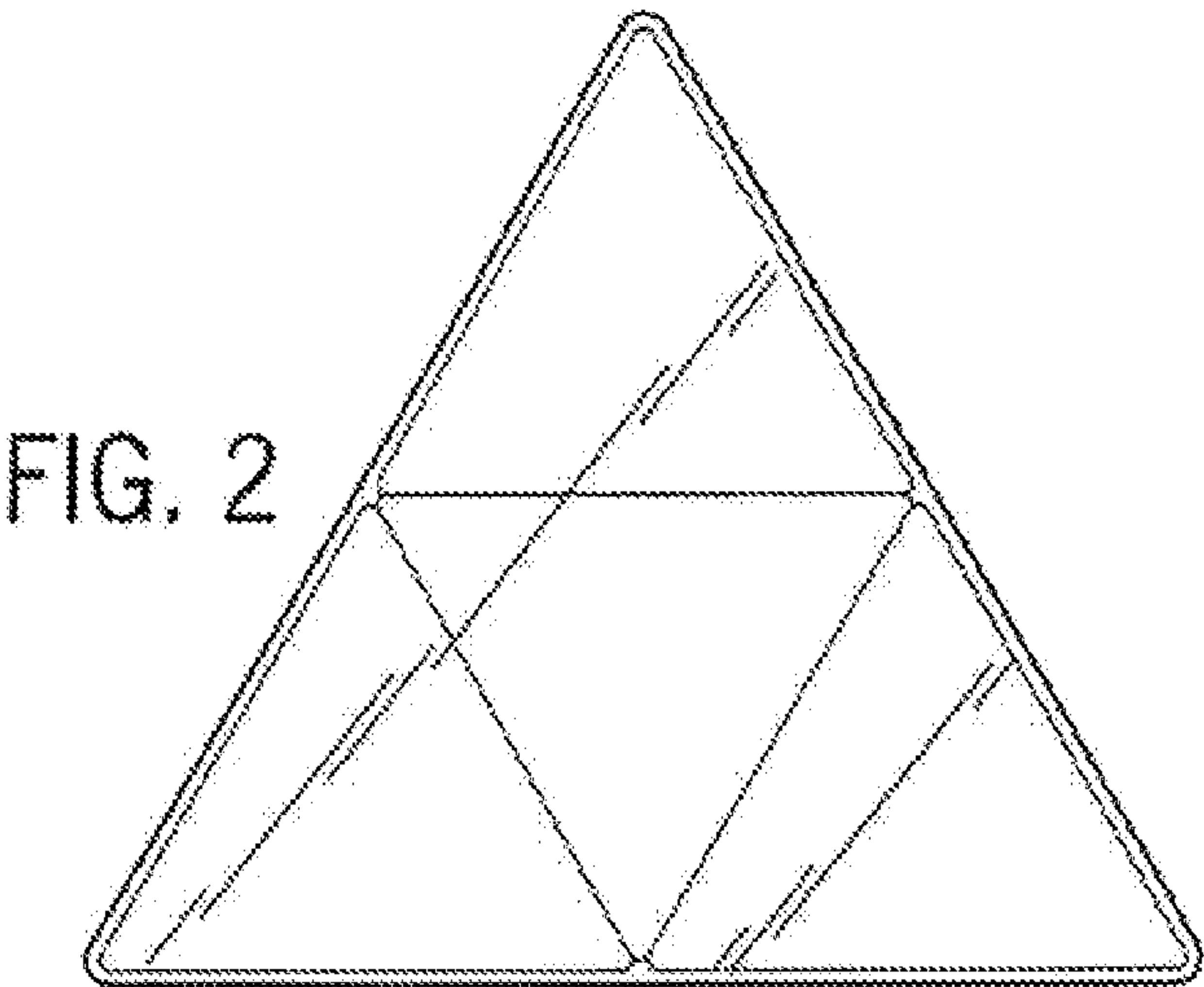

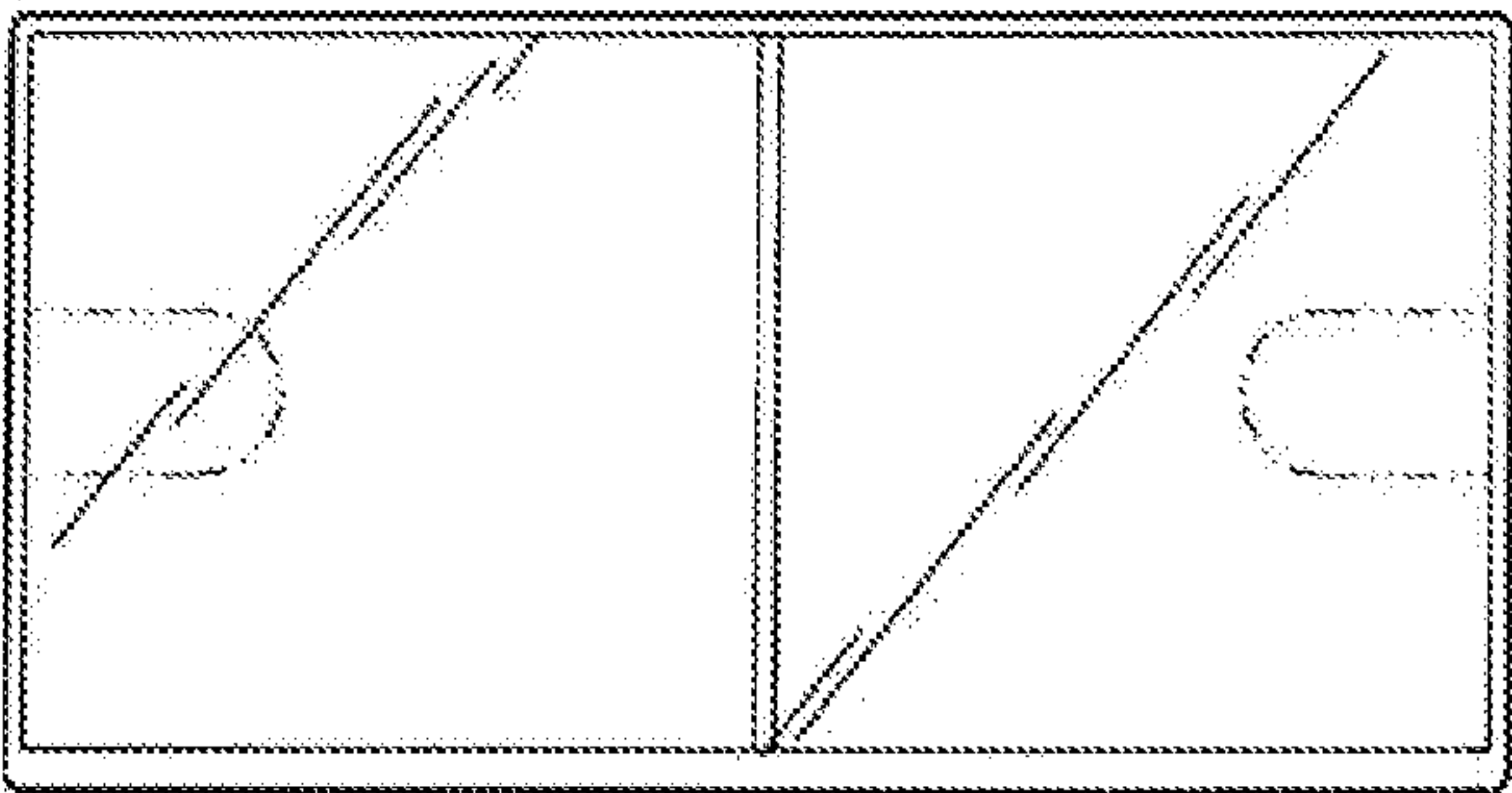

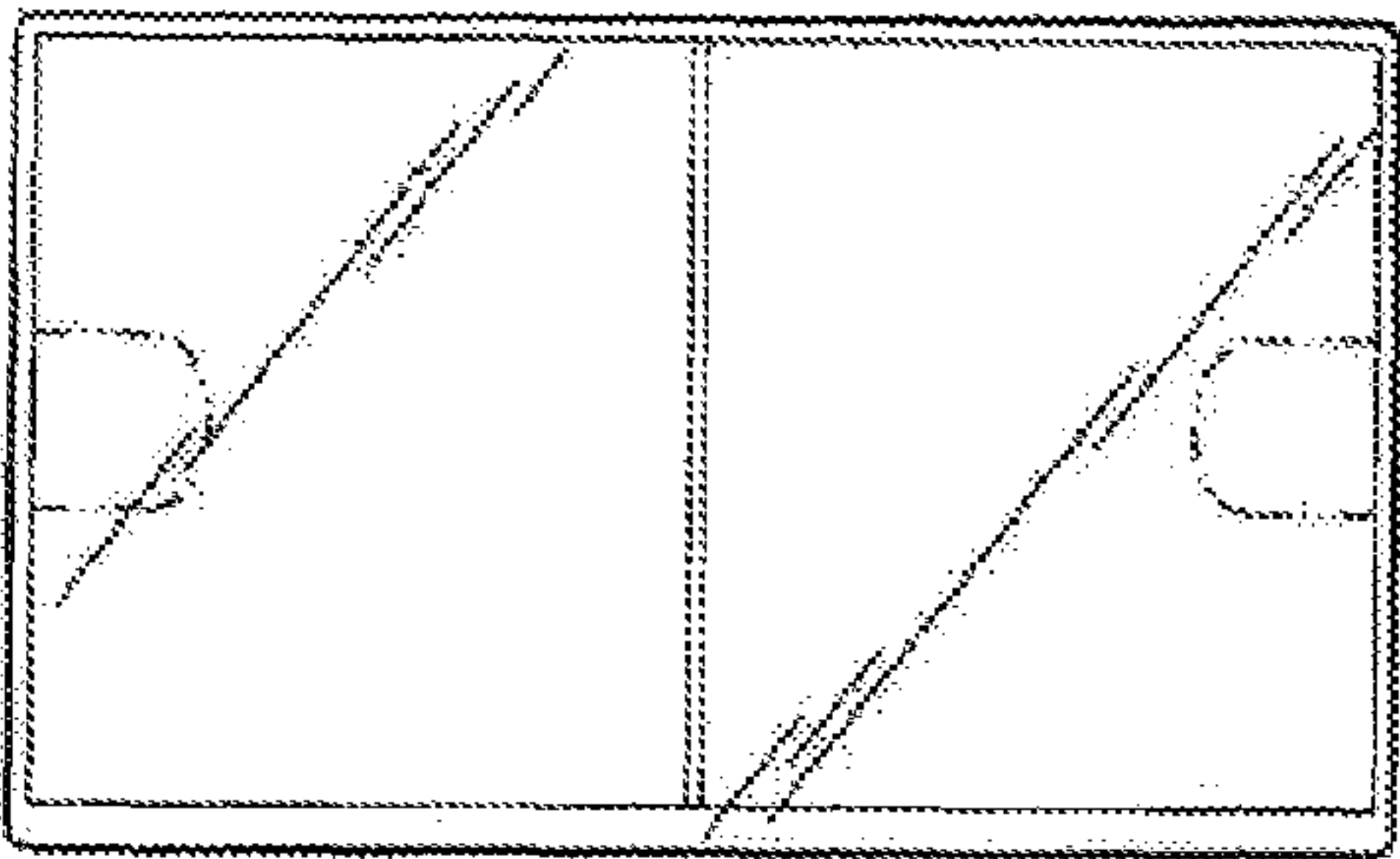

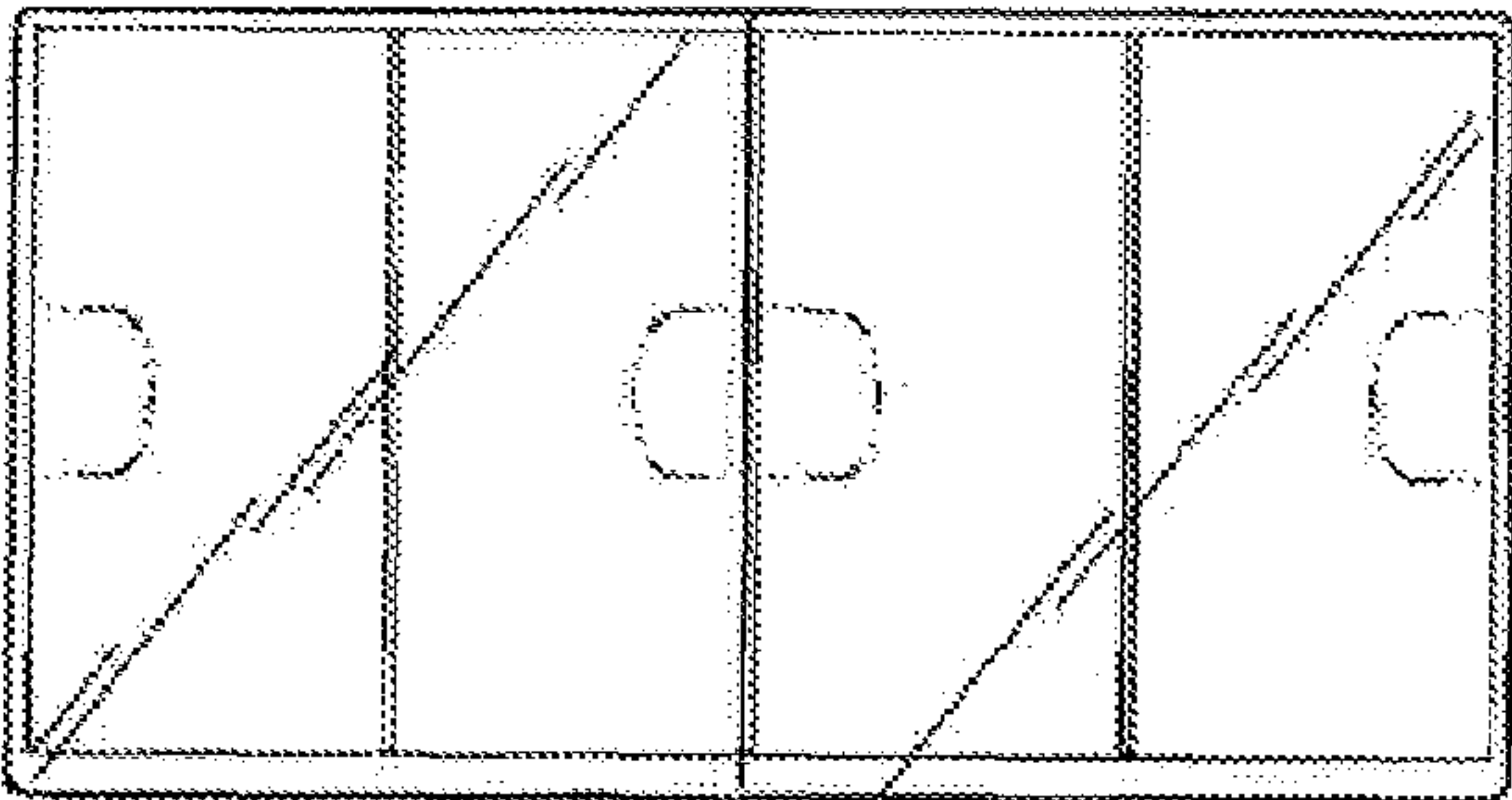
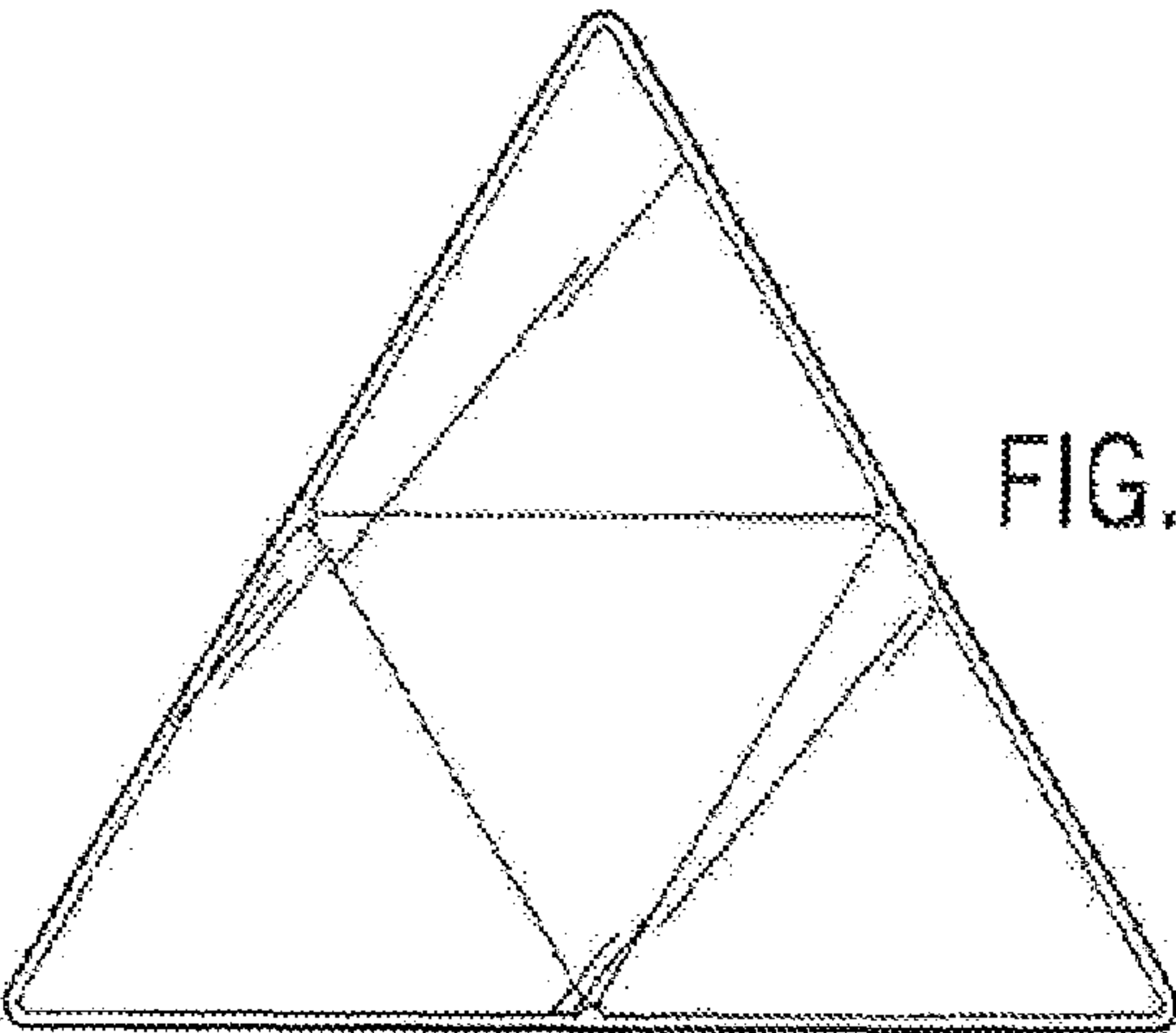

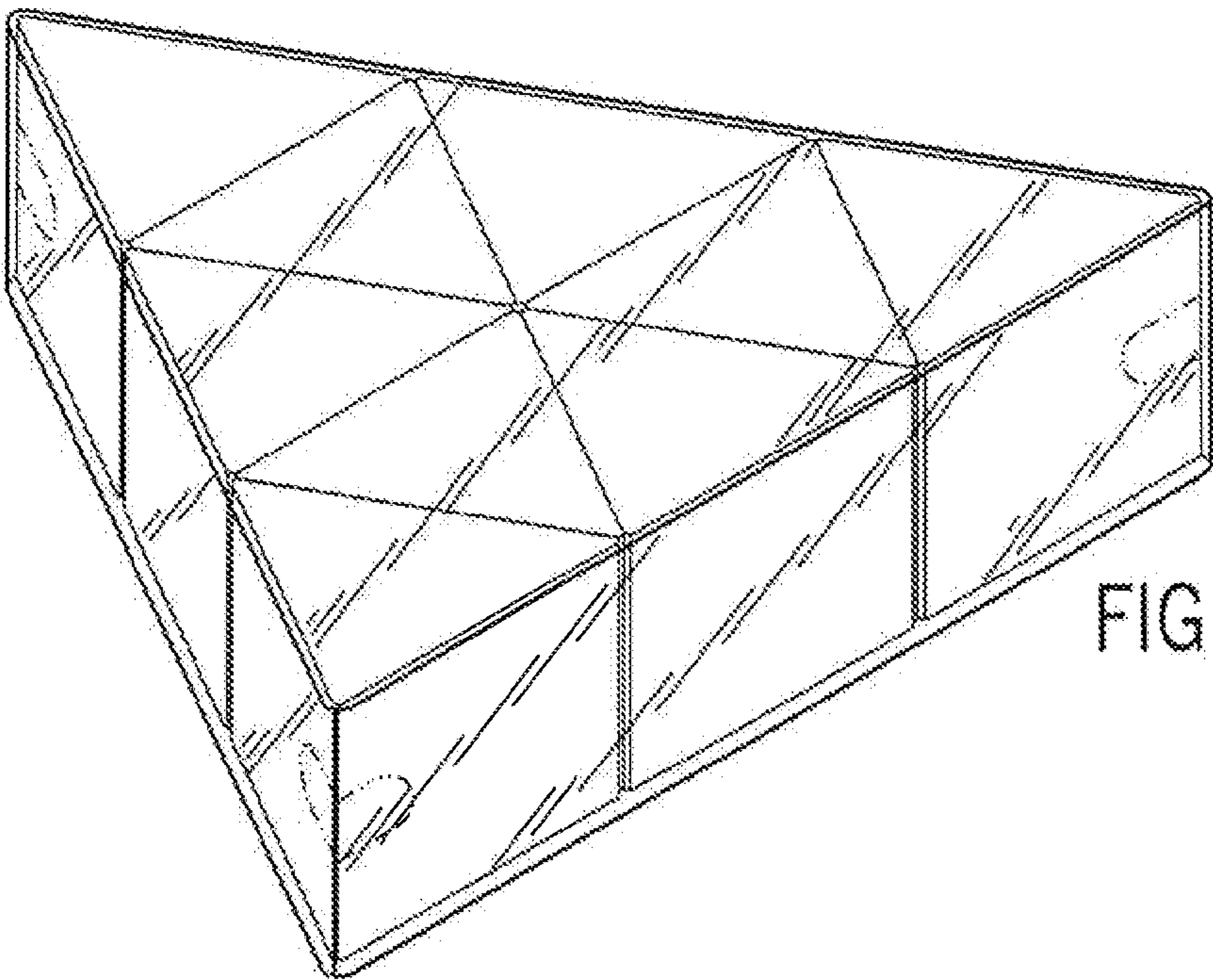

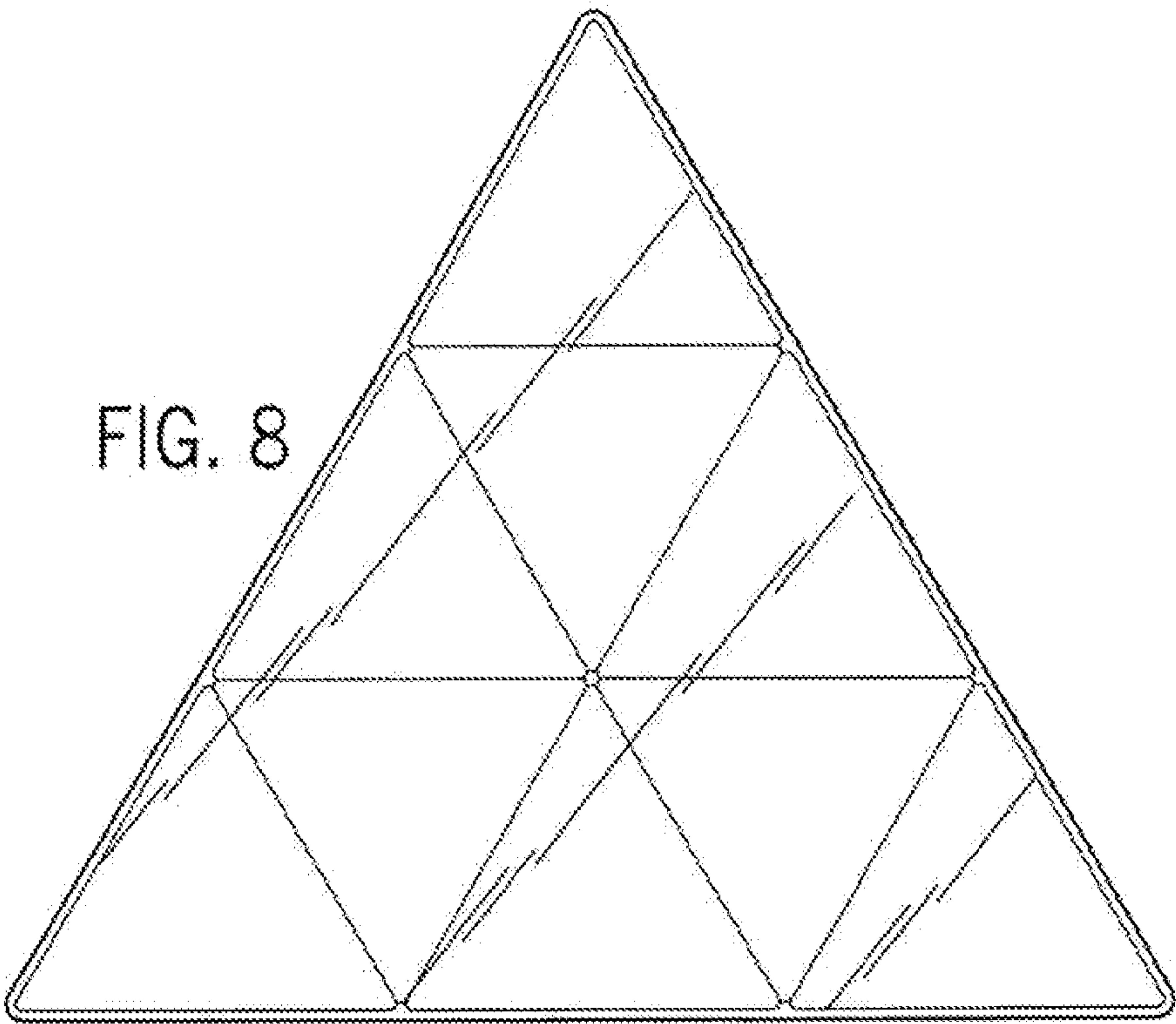

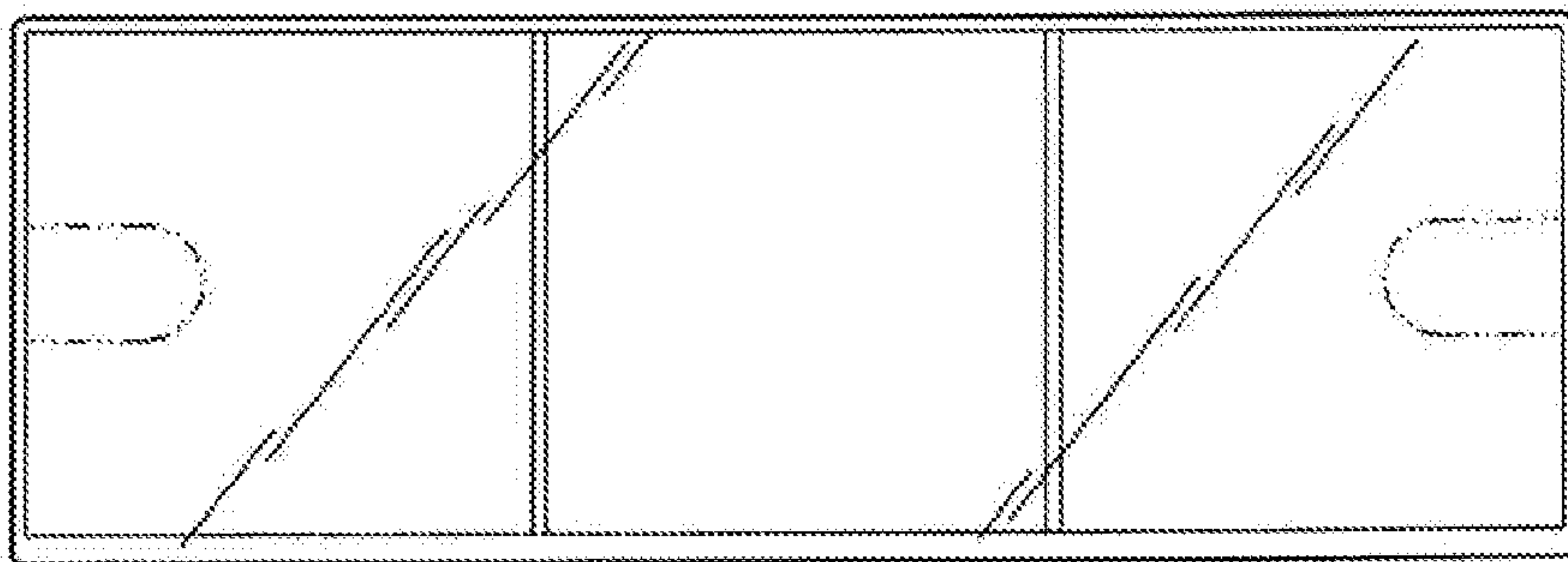

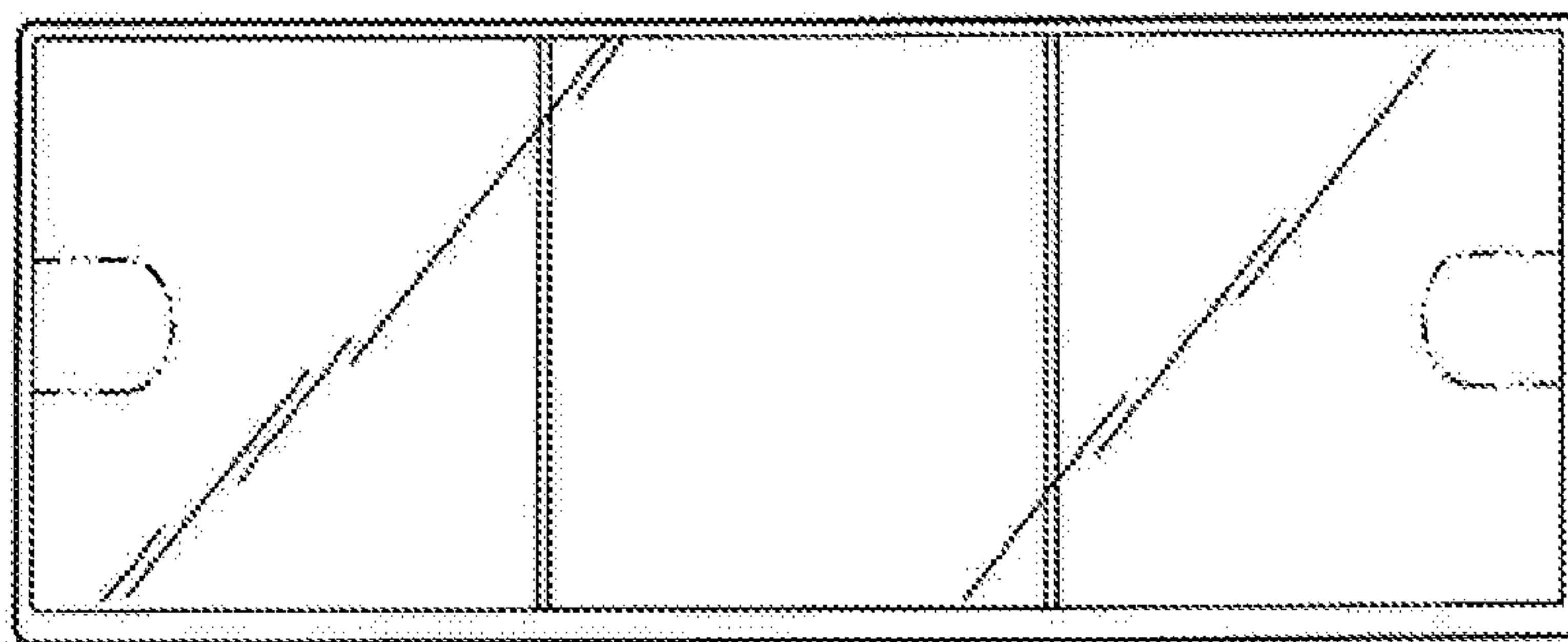

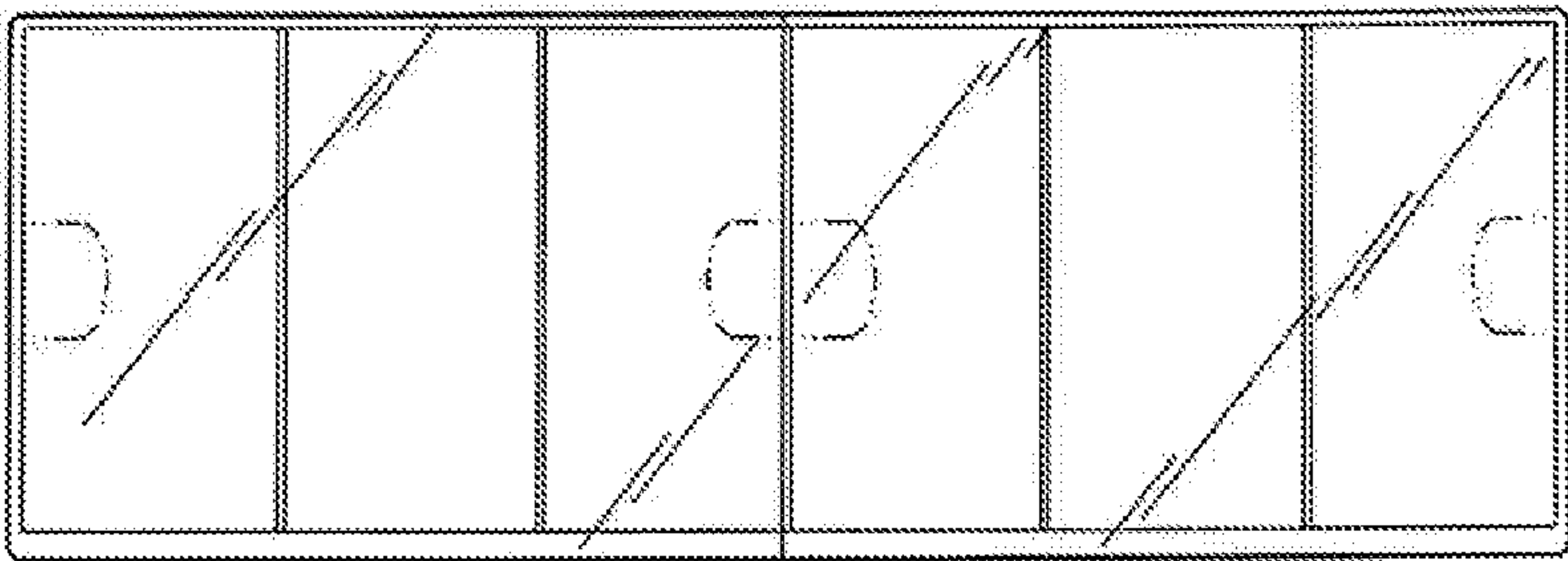
