We claim the ornamental design for a seating unit, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 21 is a left side view thereof, the right side being a mirror image thereof;

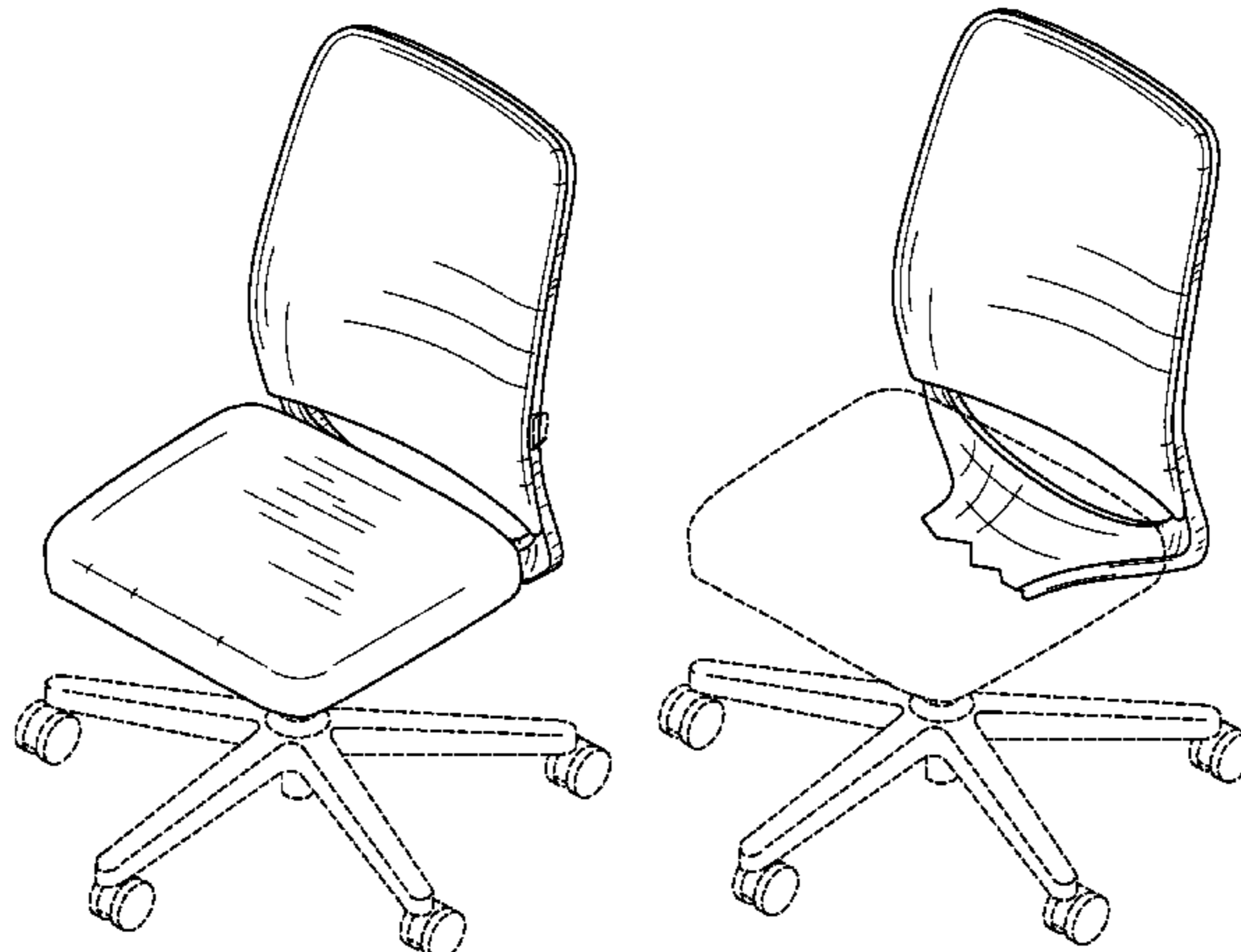
FIG. 22 is a rear view thereof;

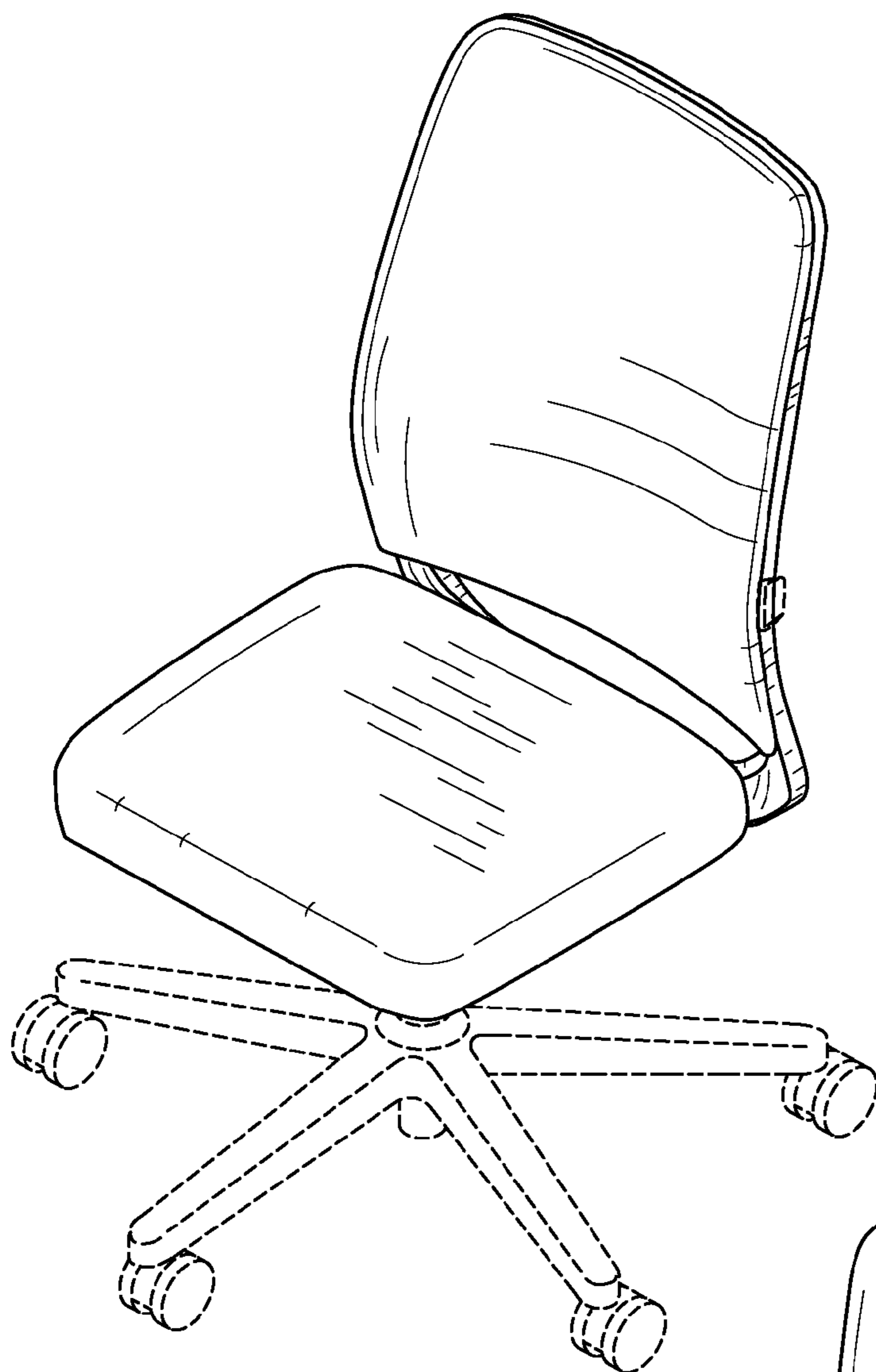

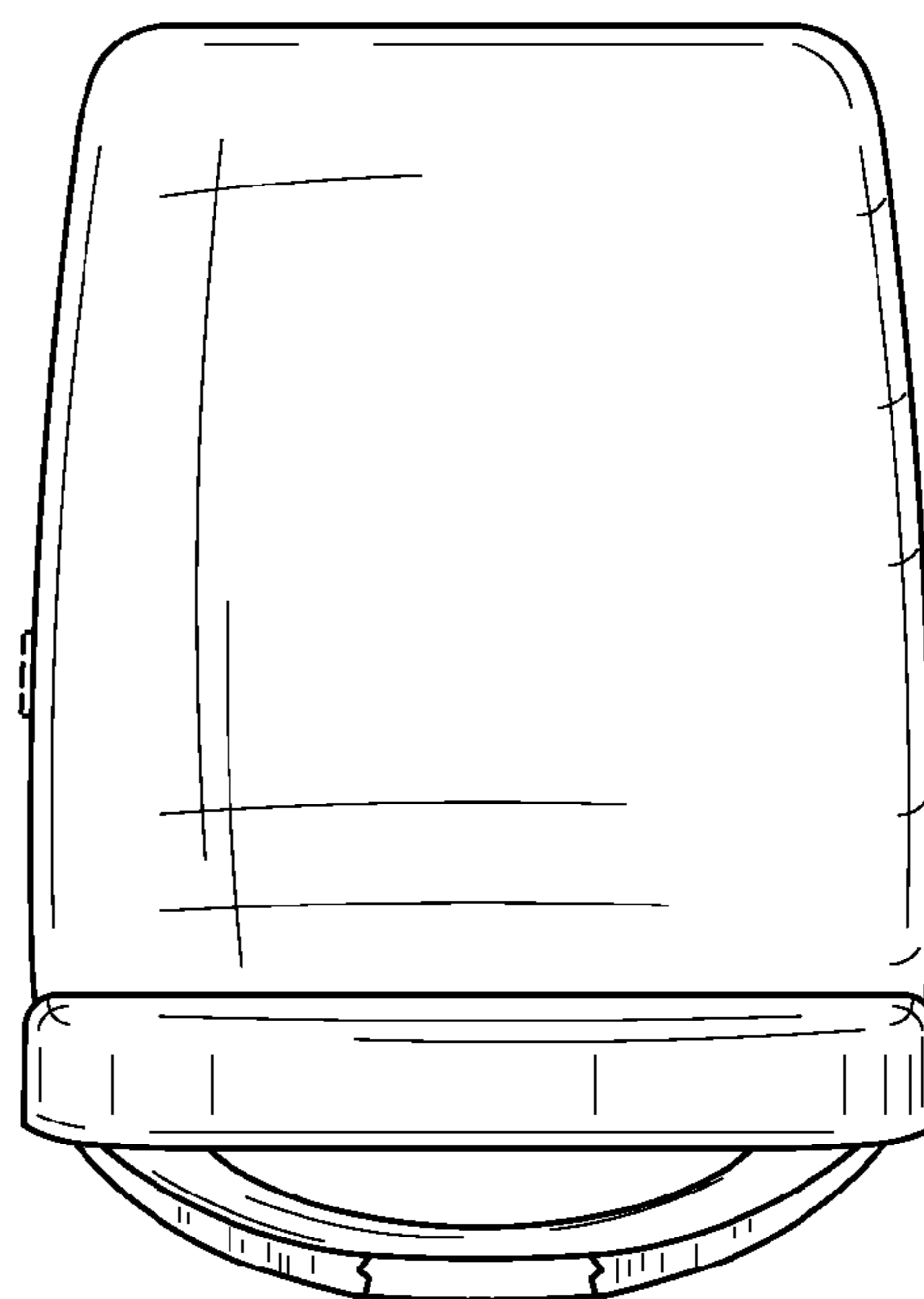

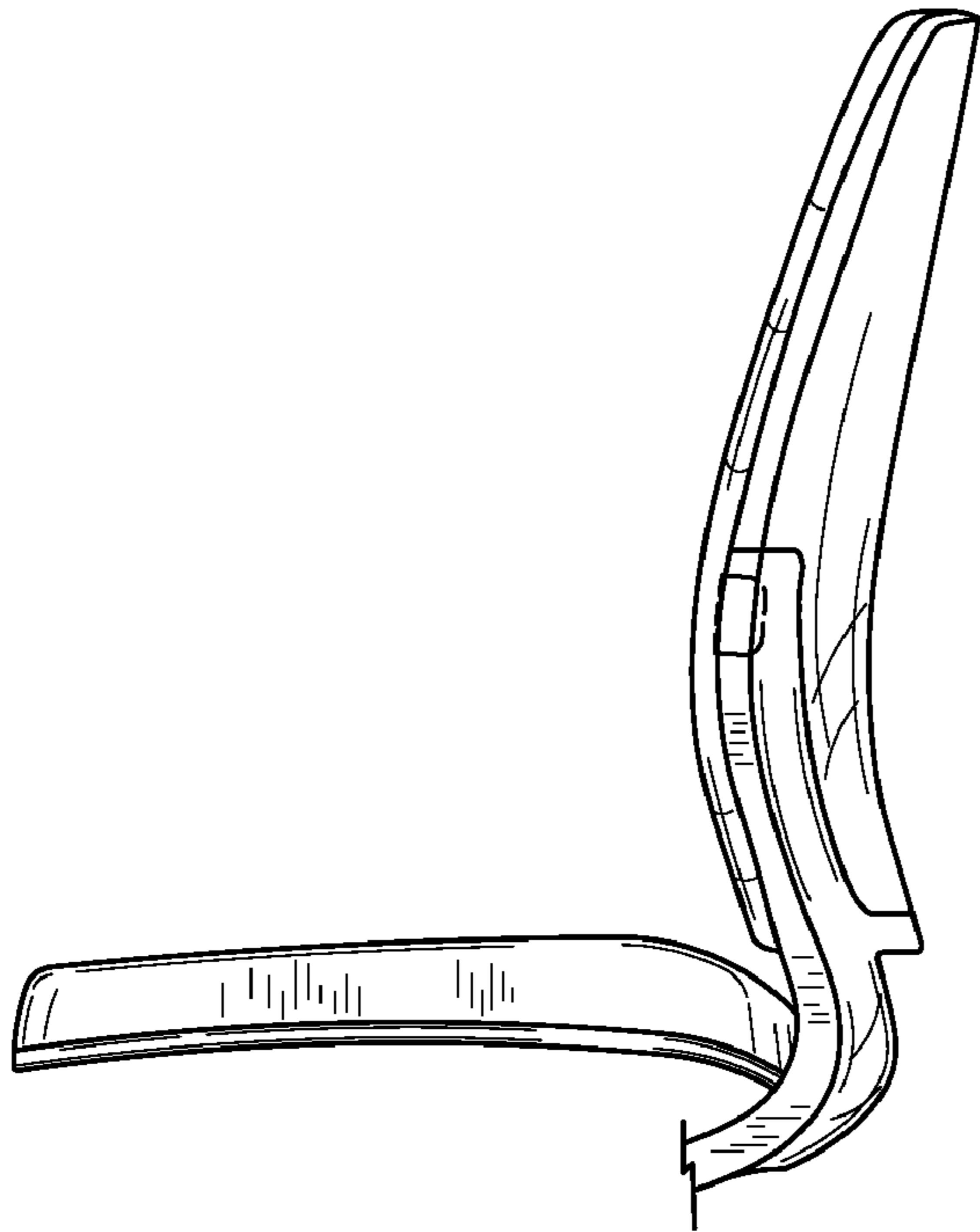

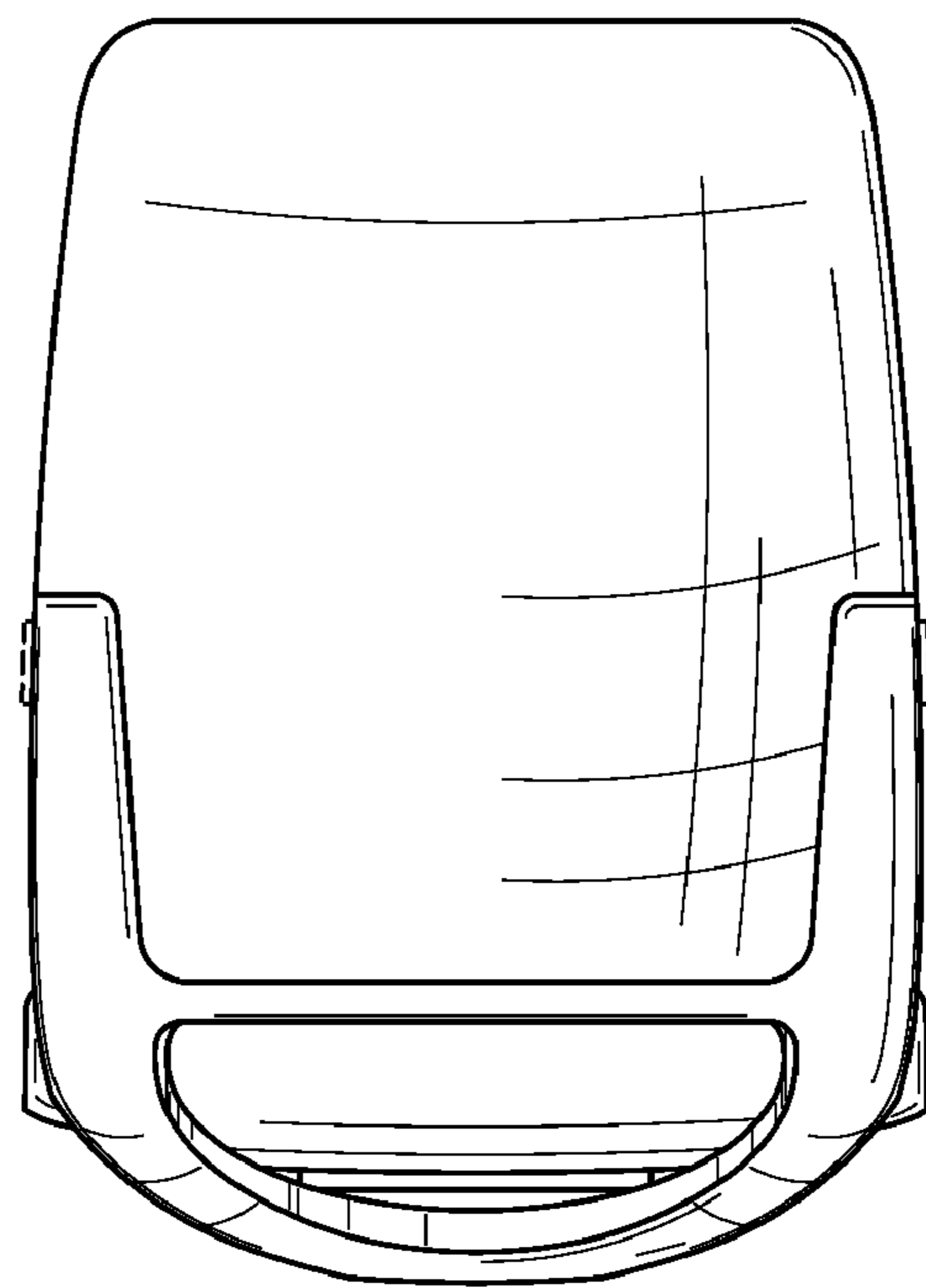

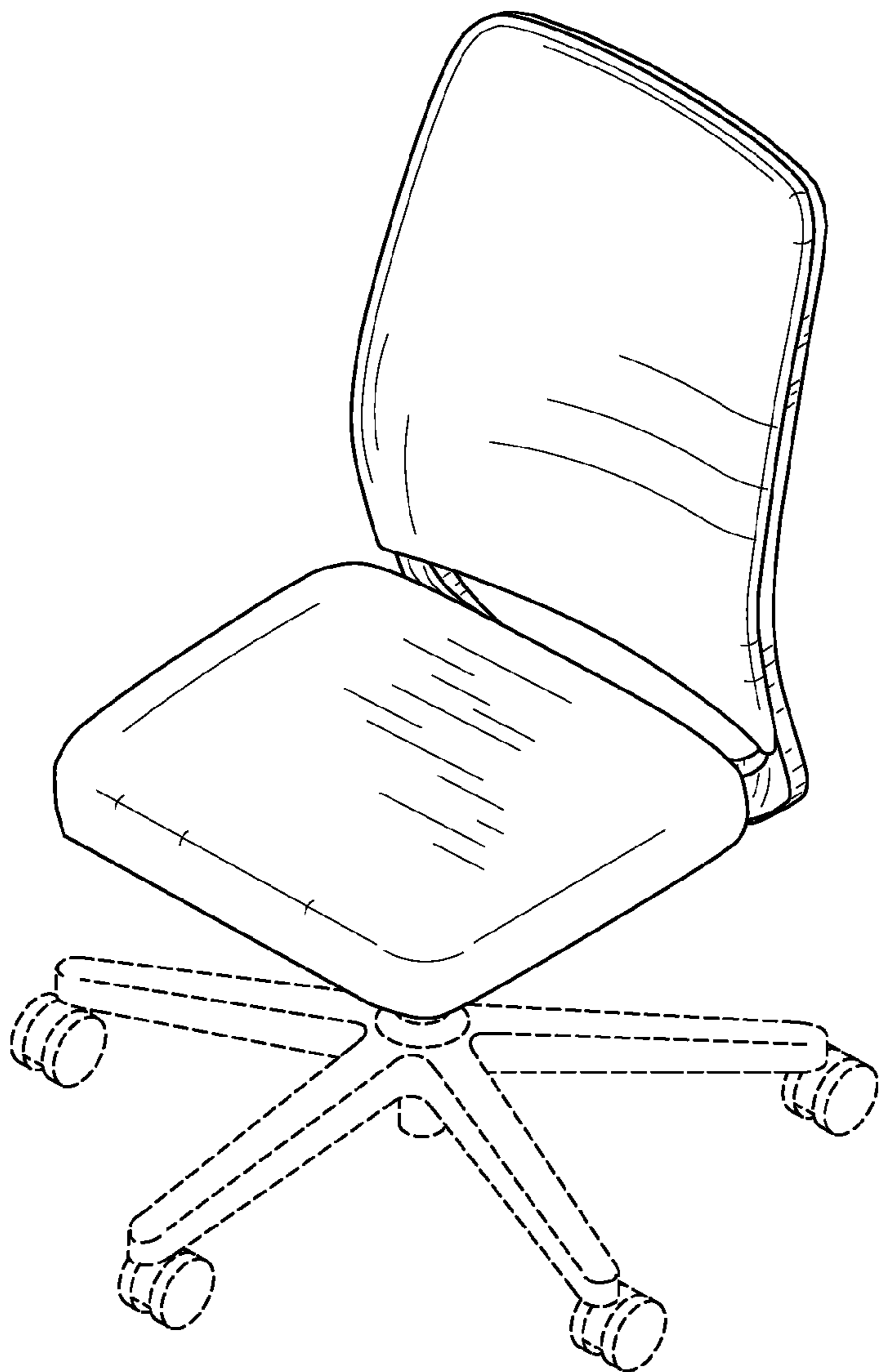

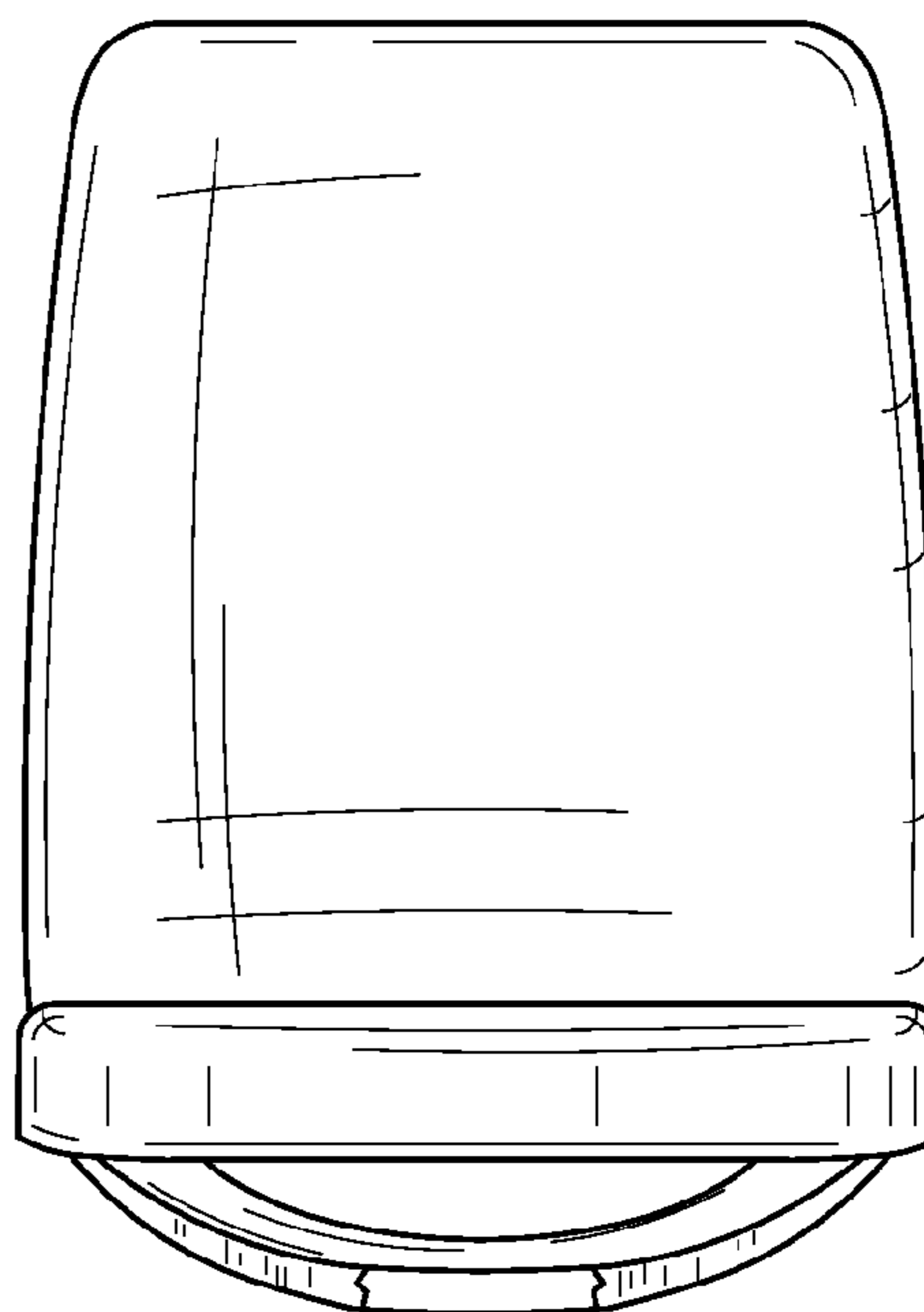

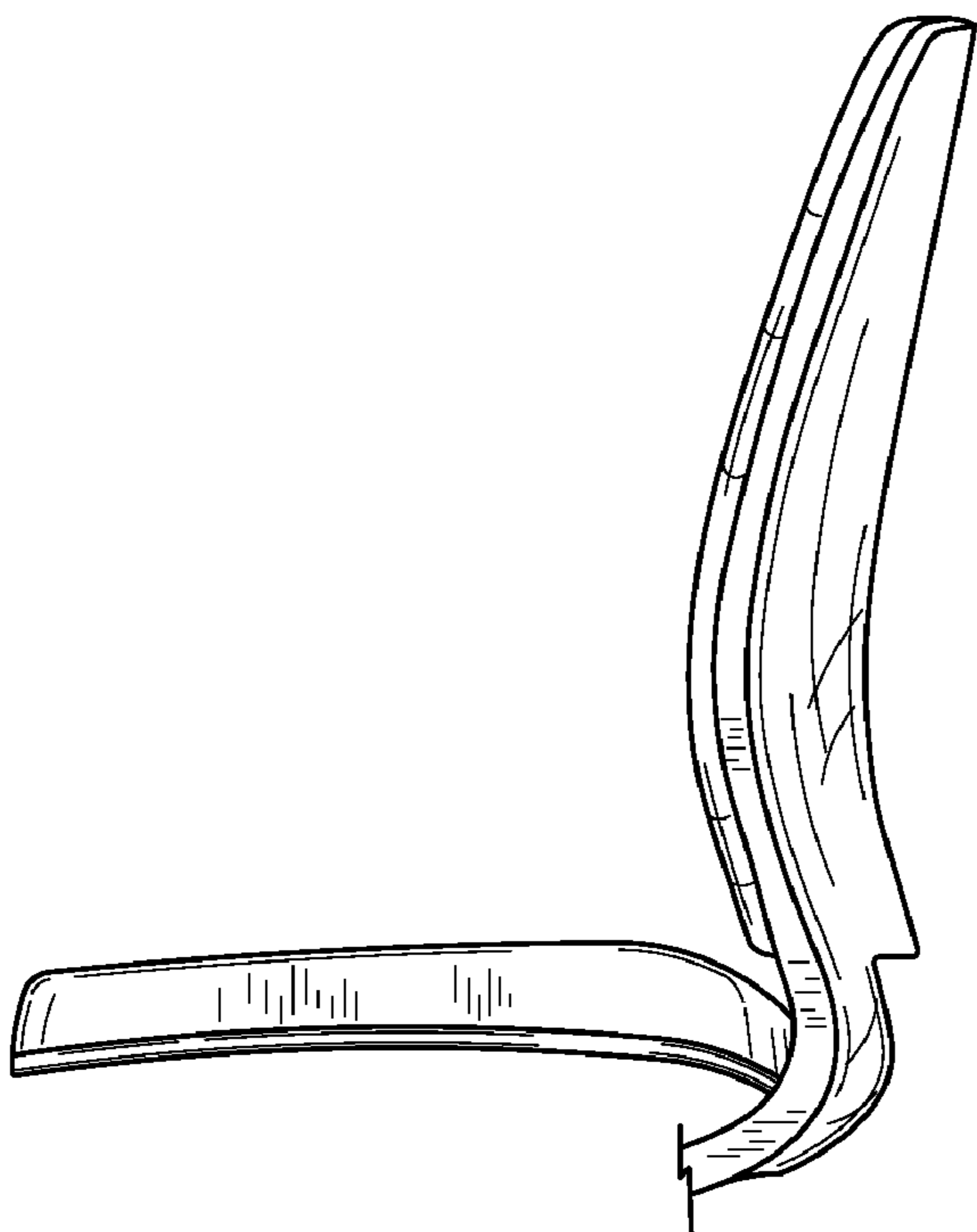

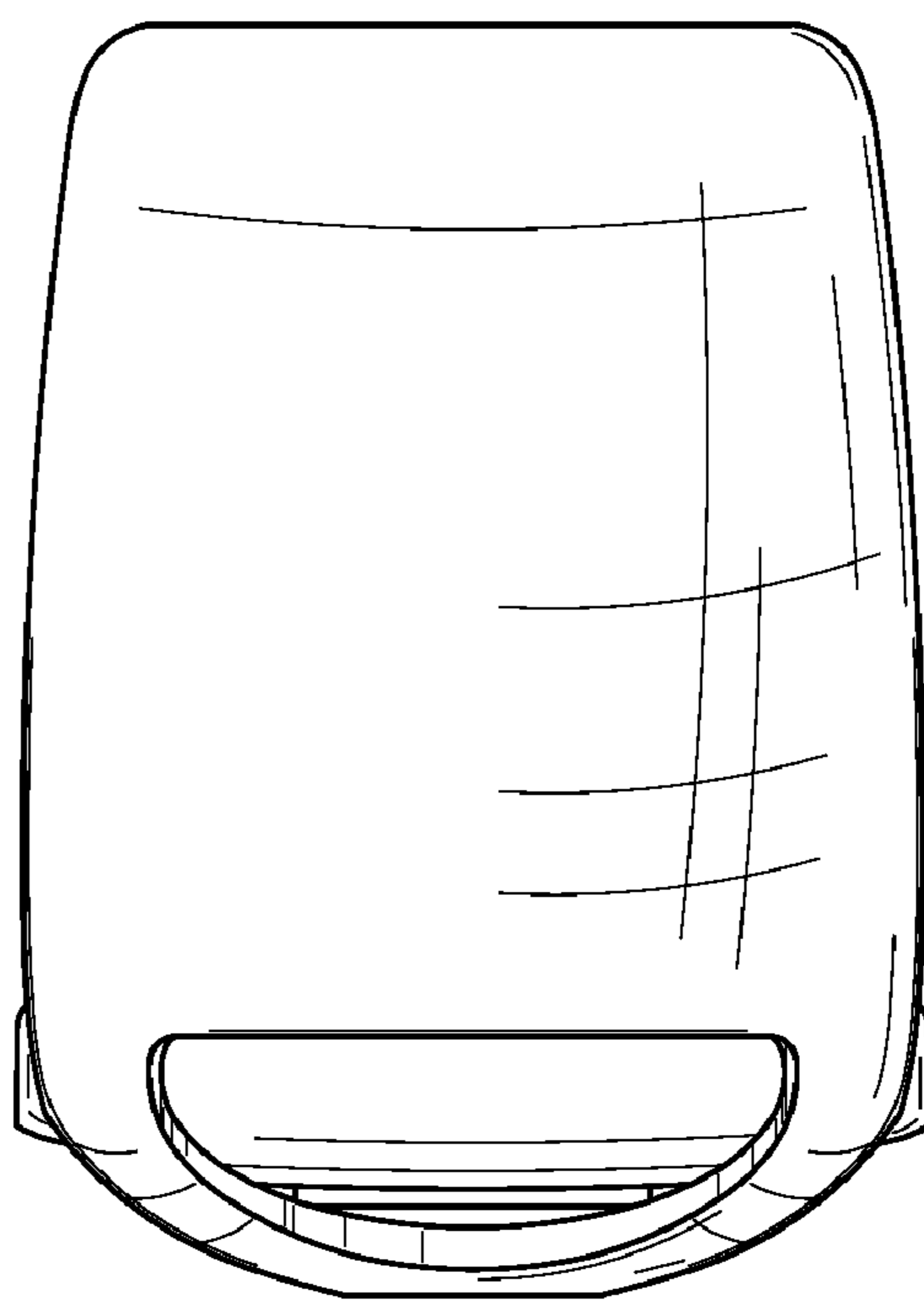

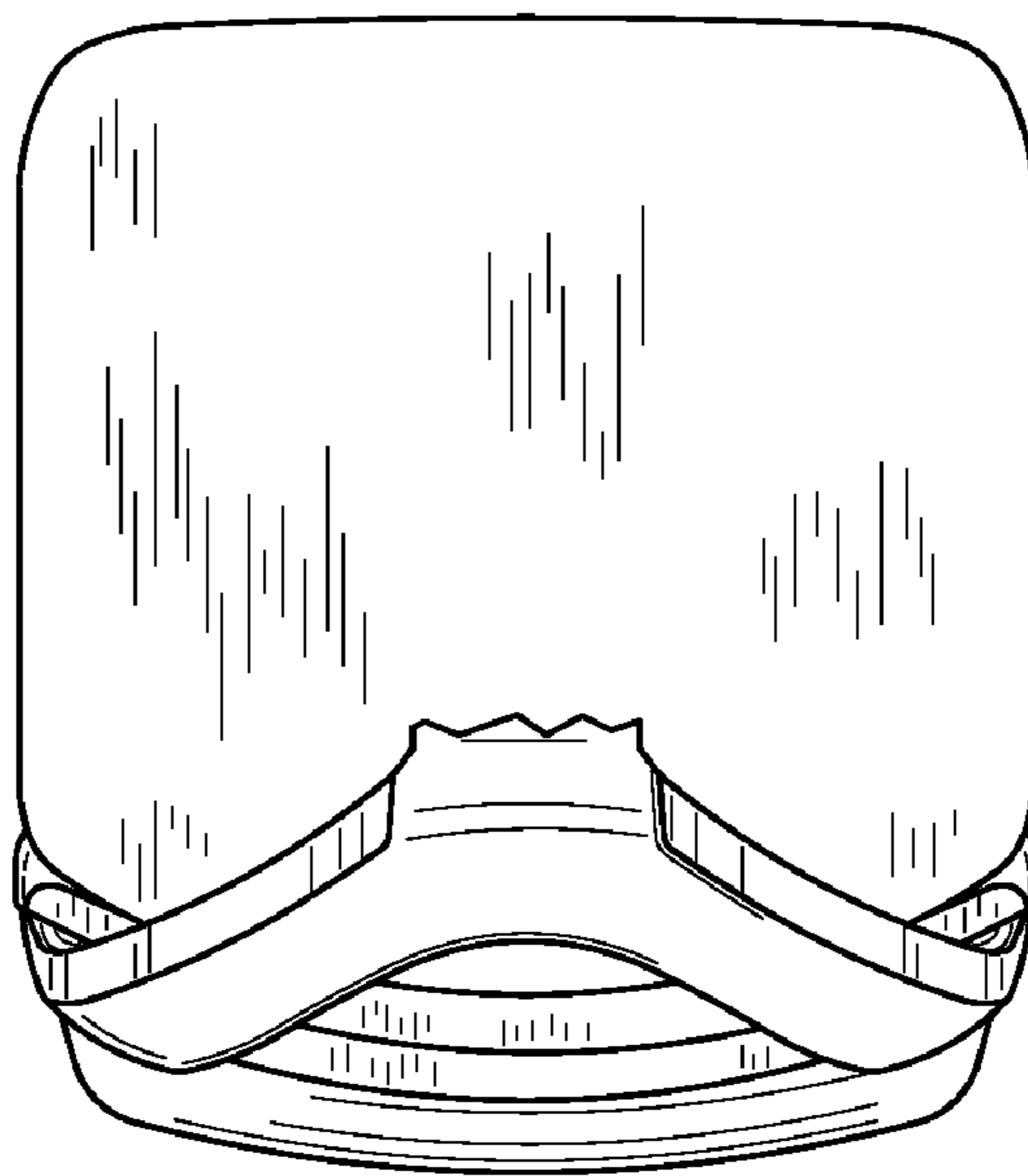

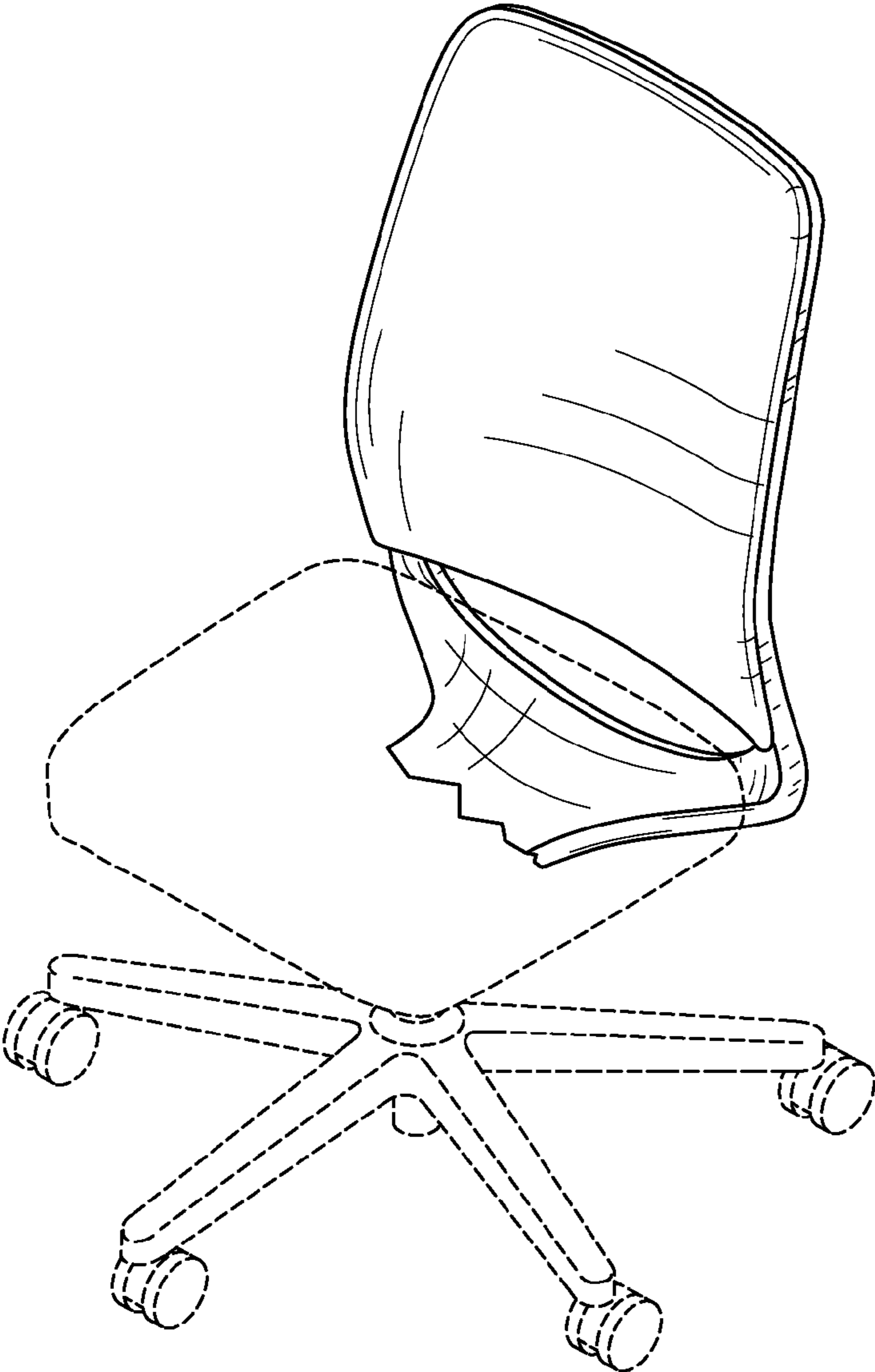

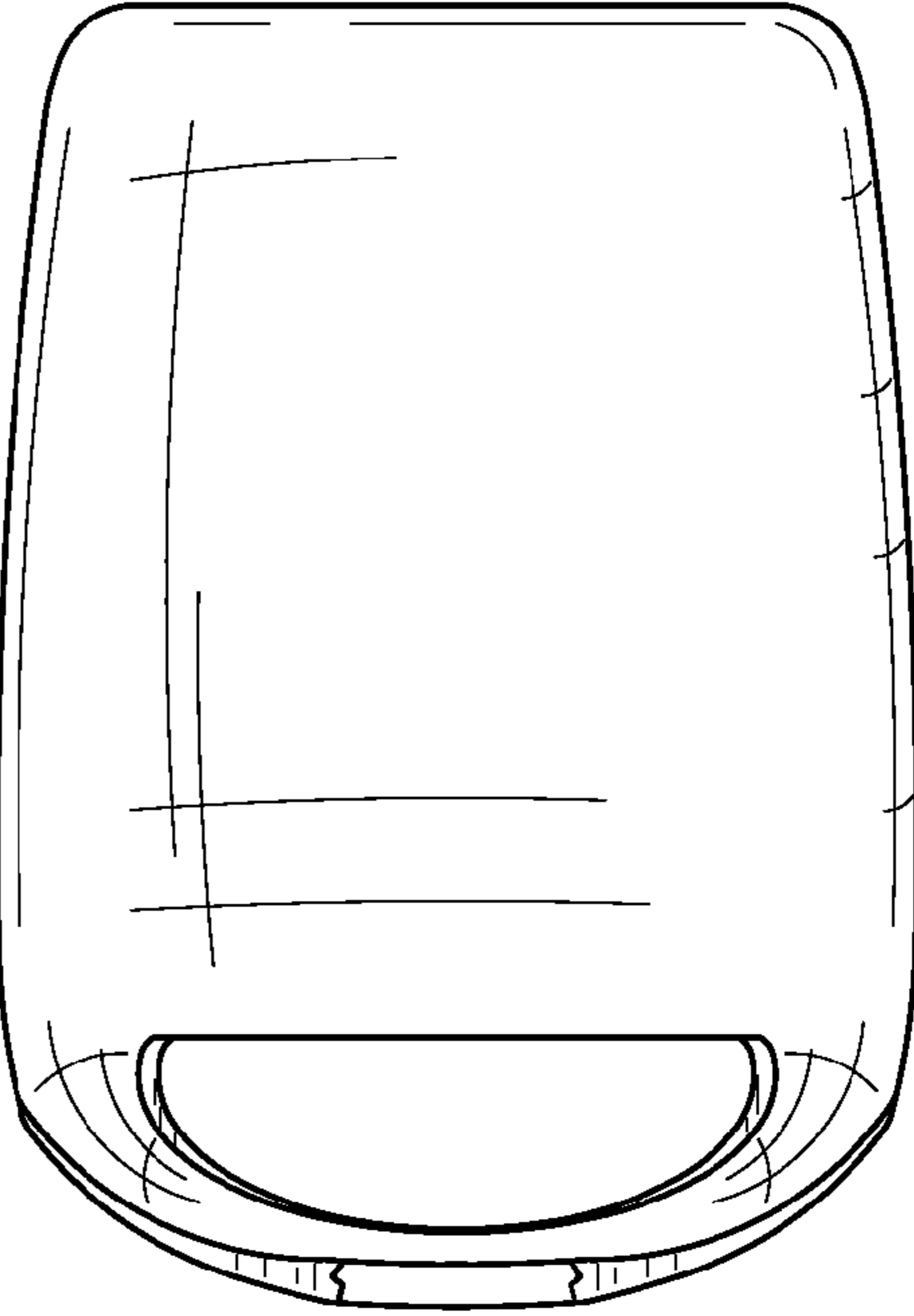

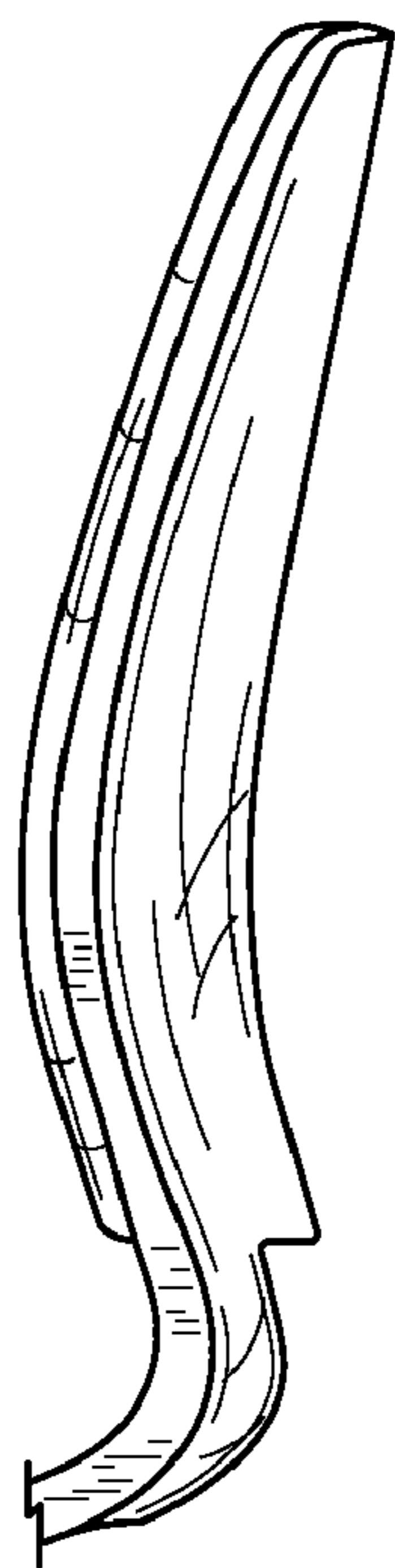

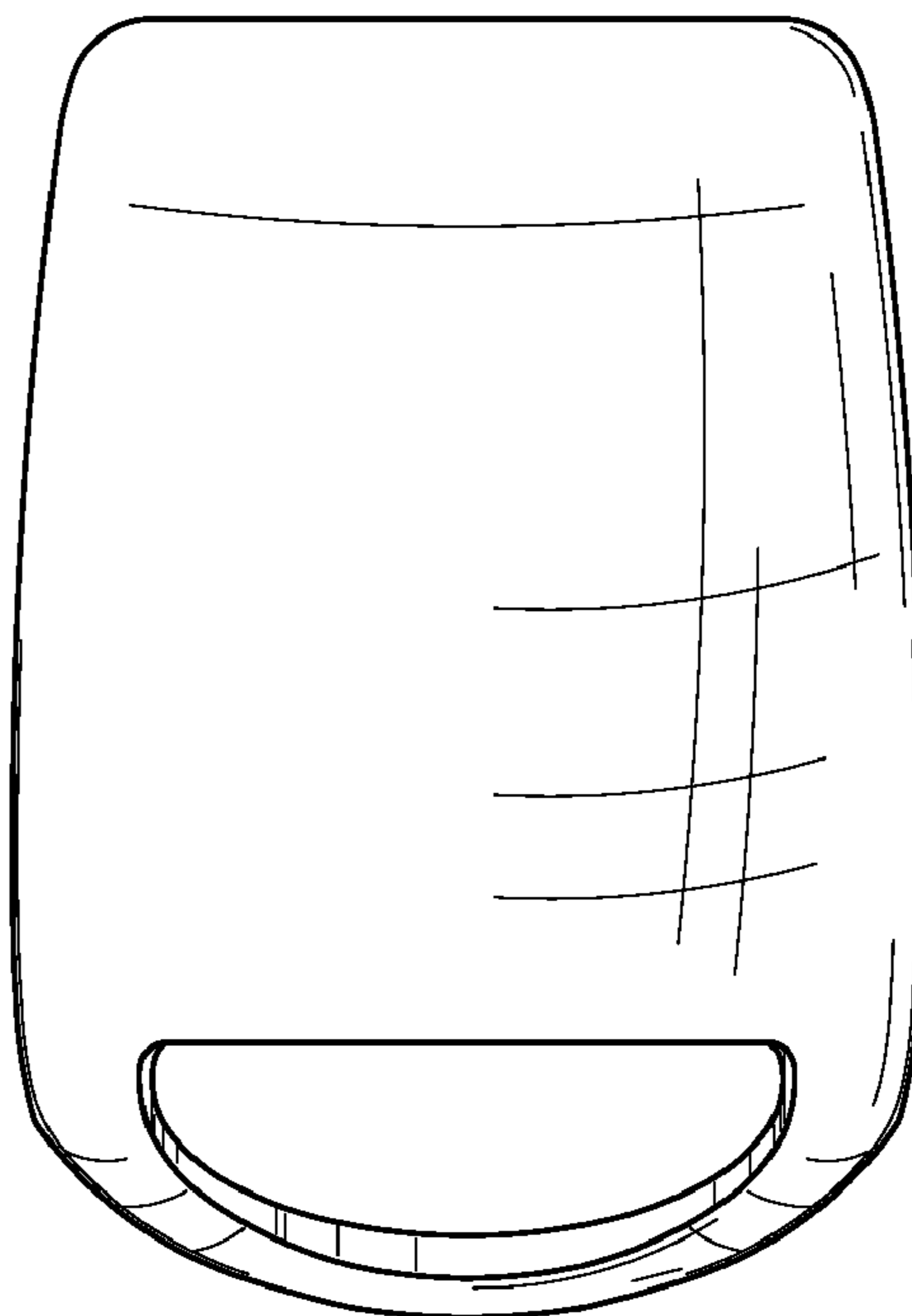

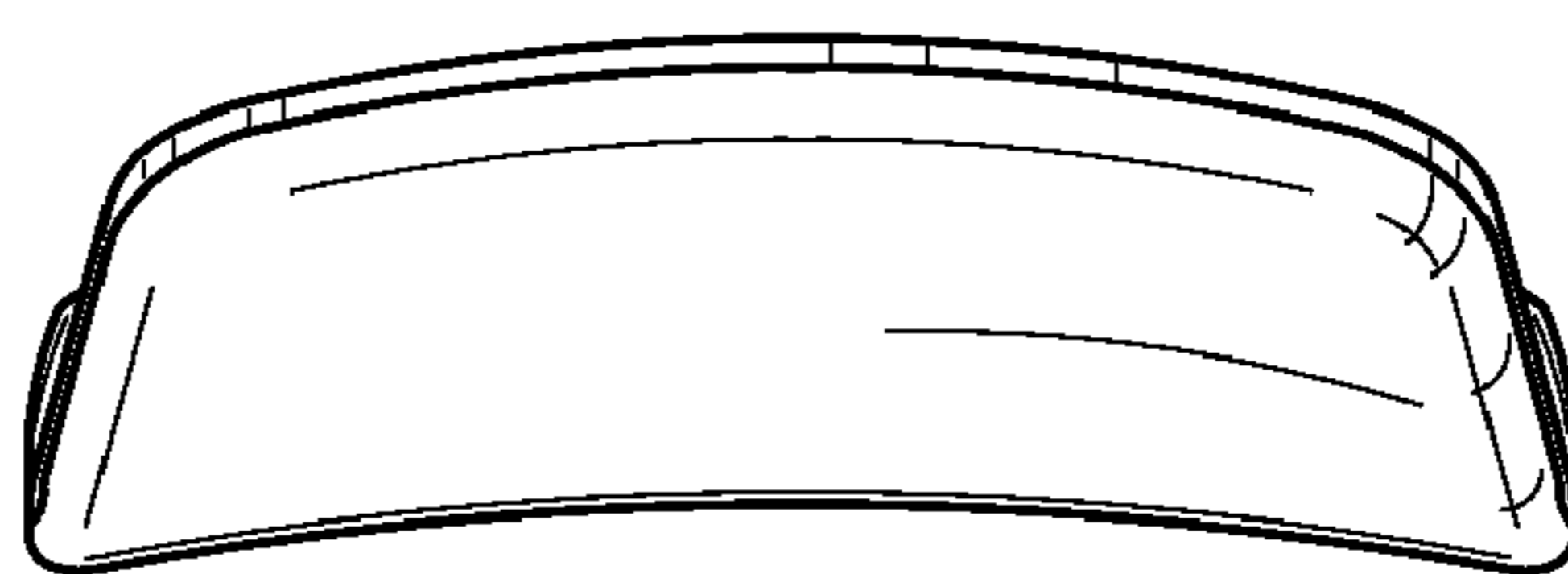

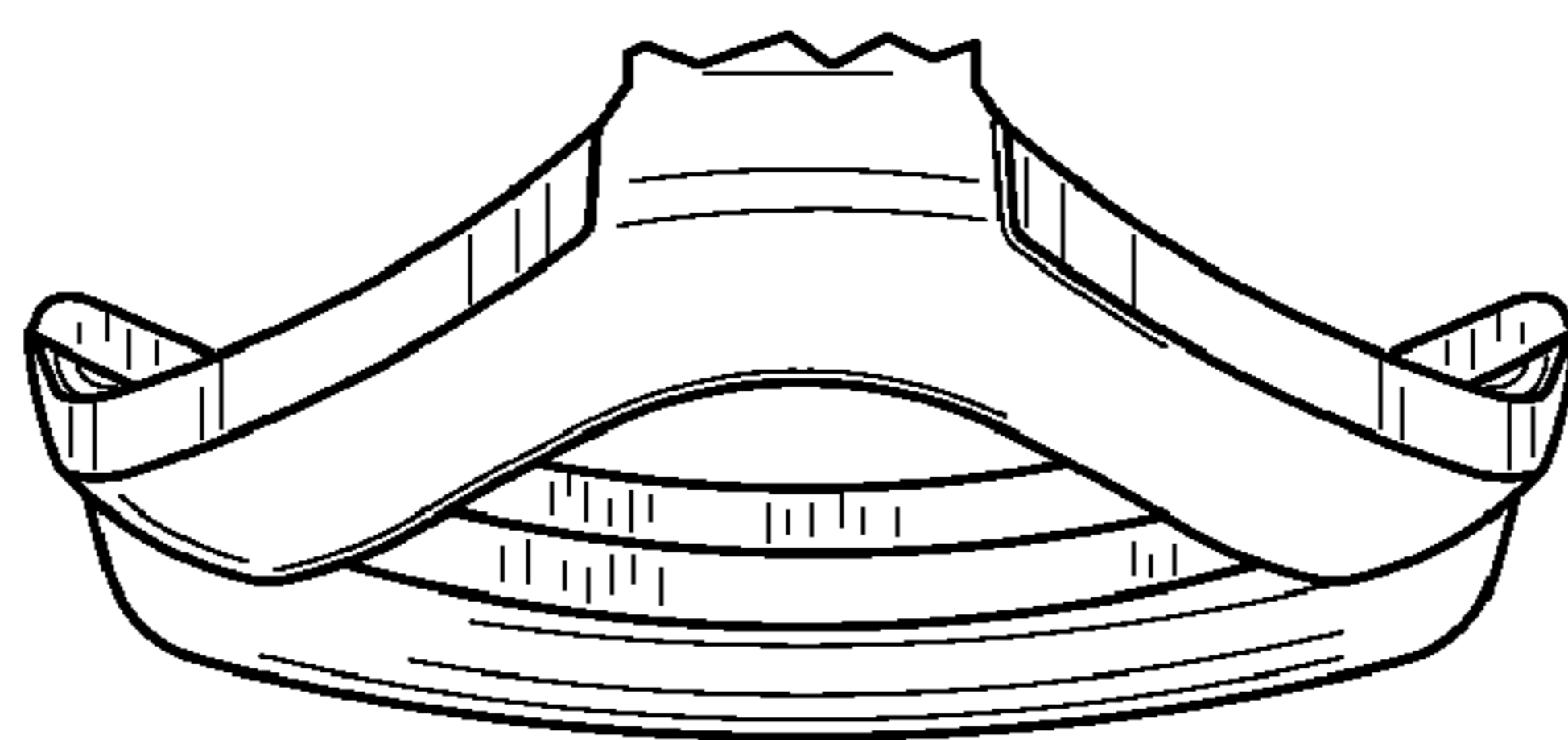

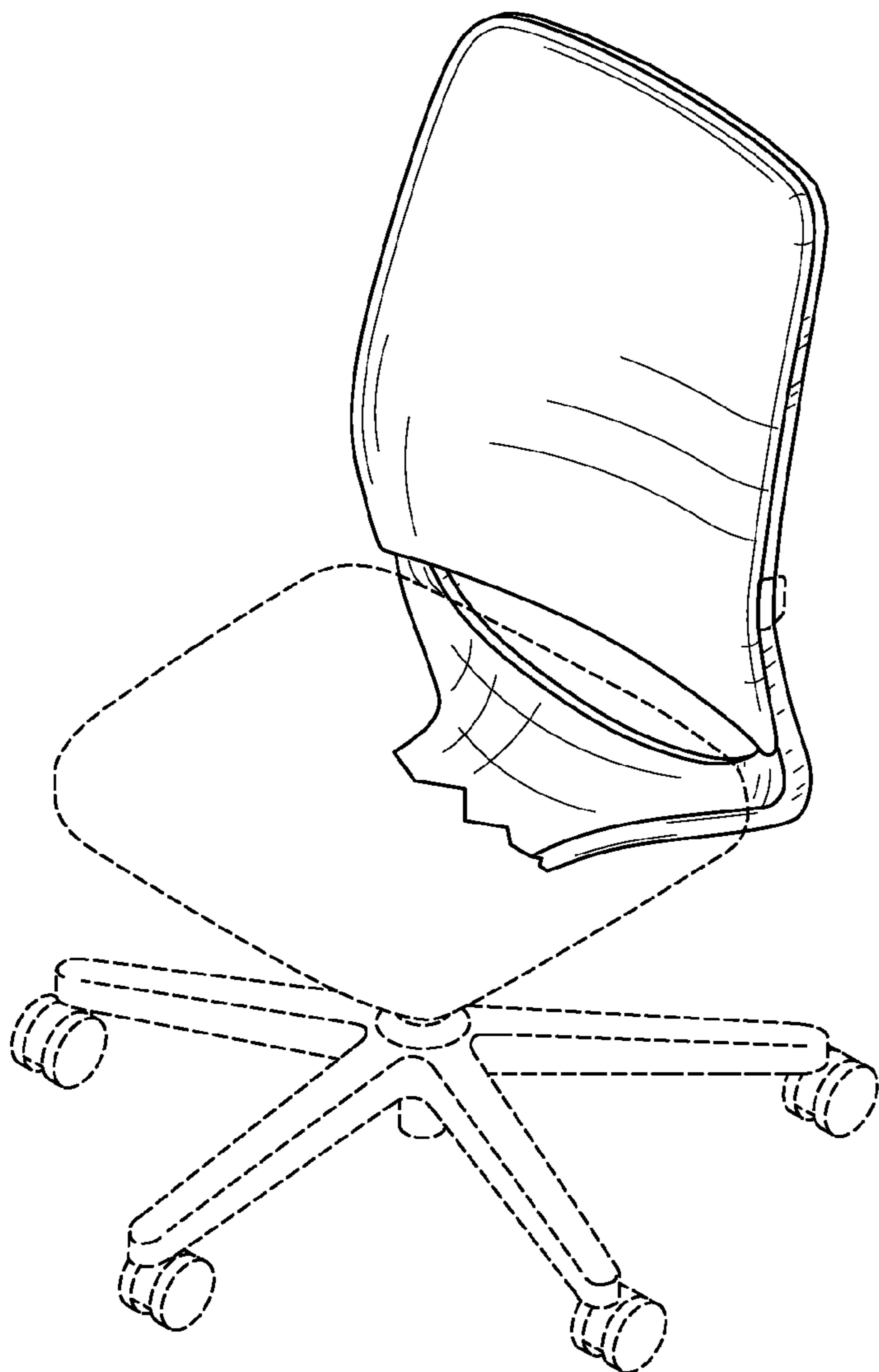

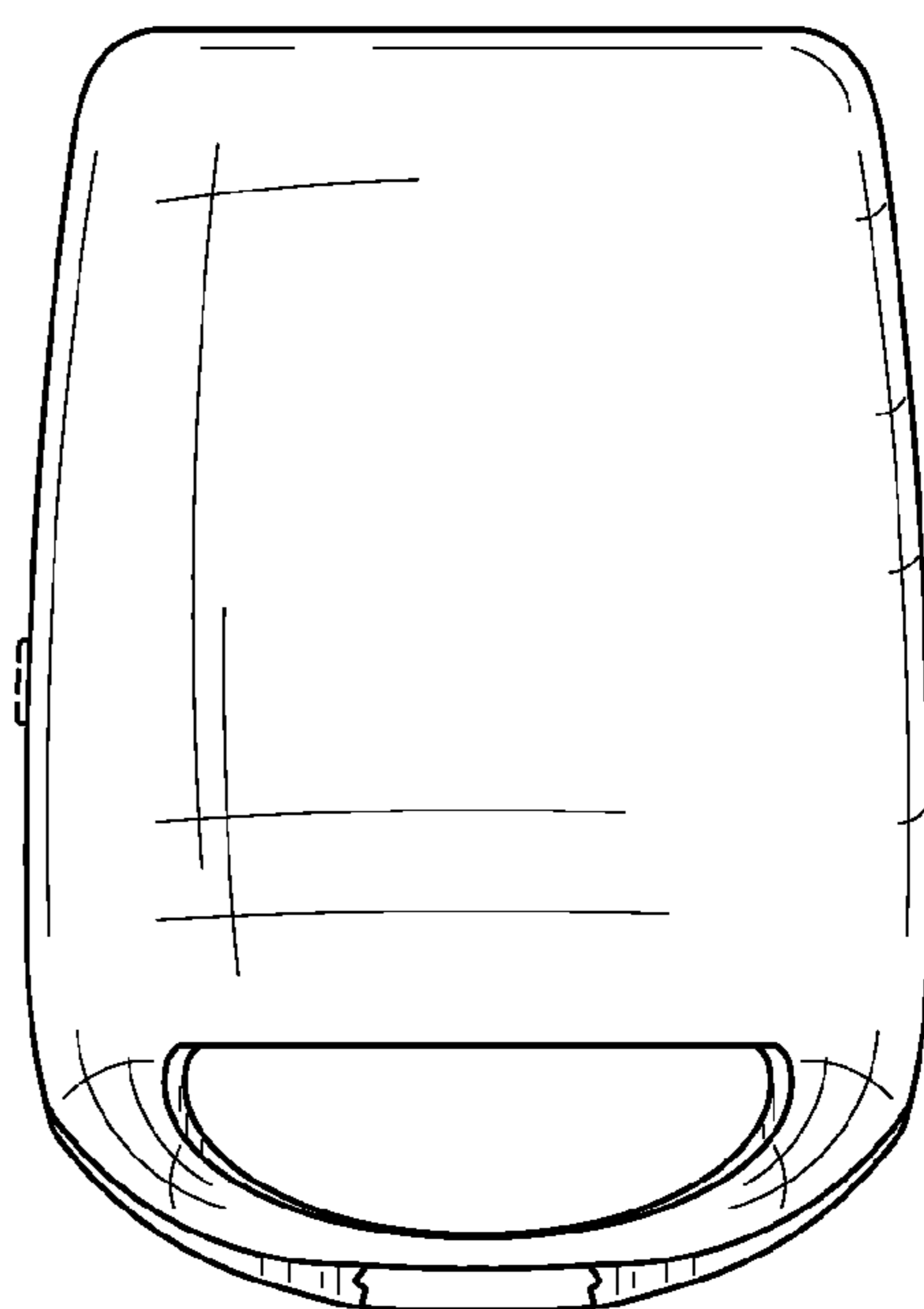

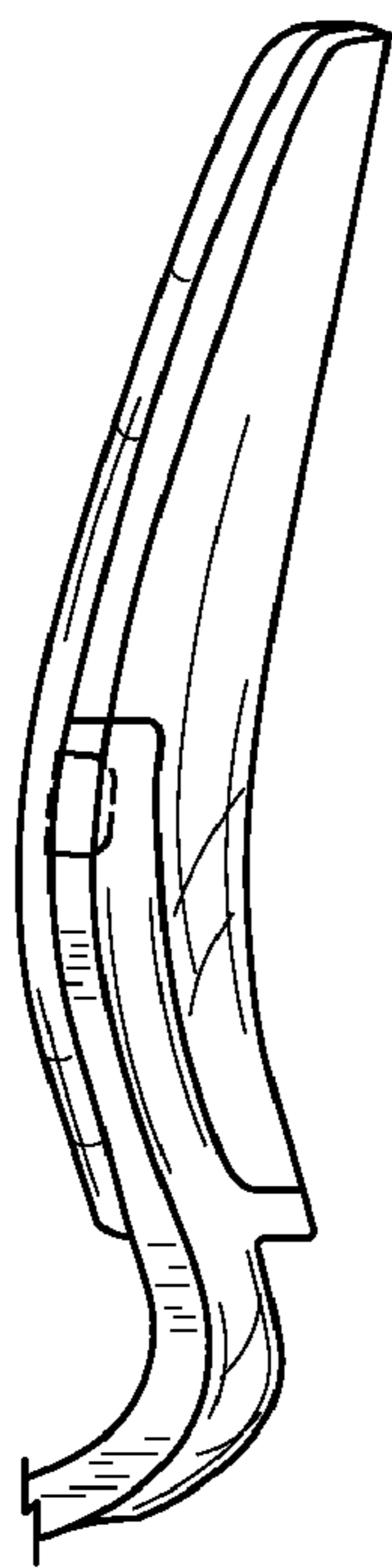

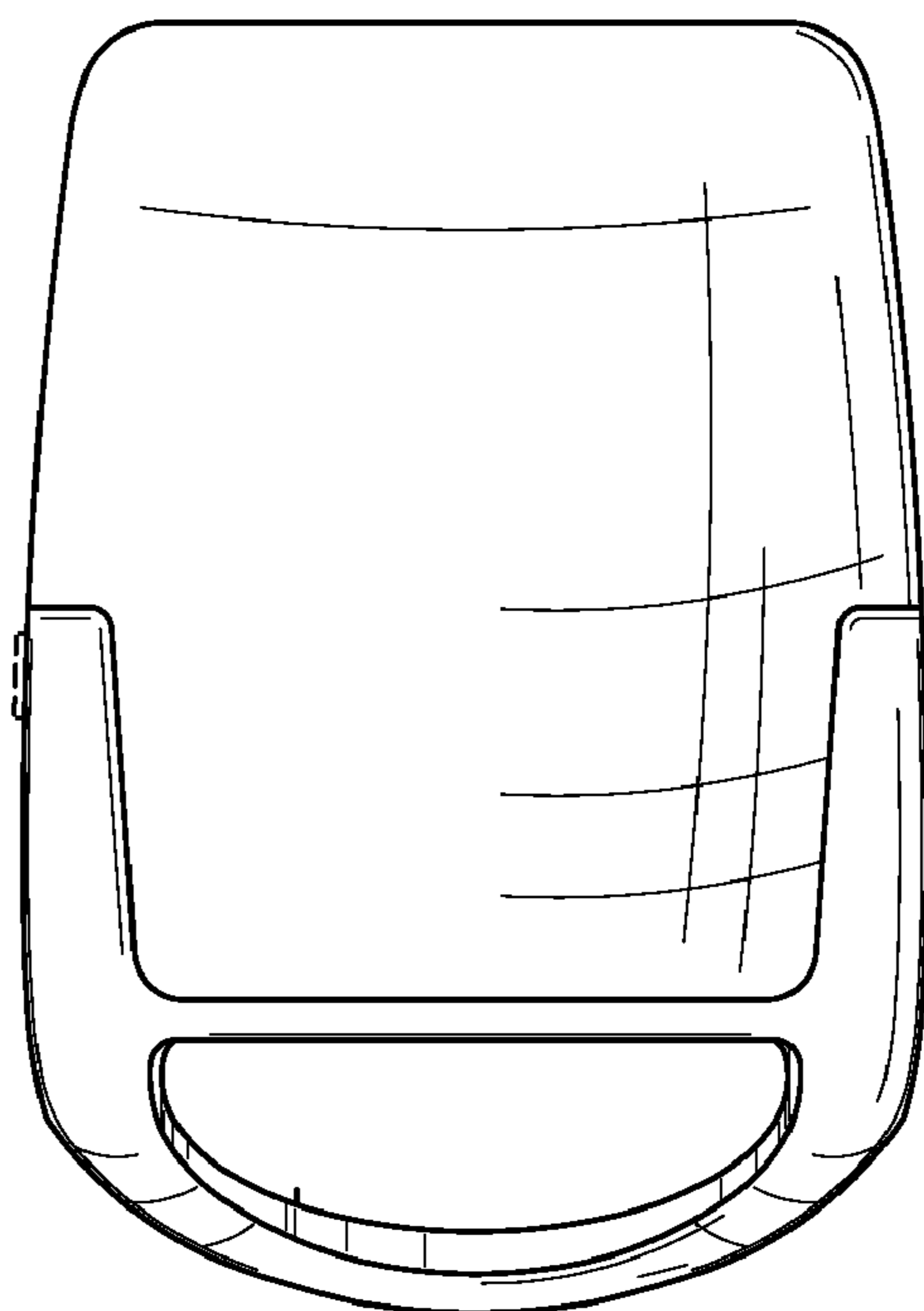

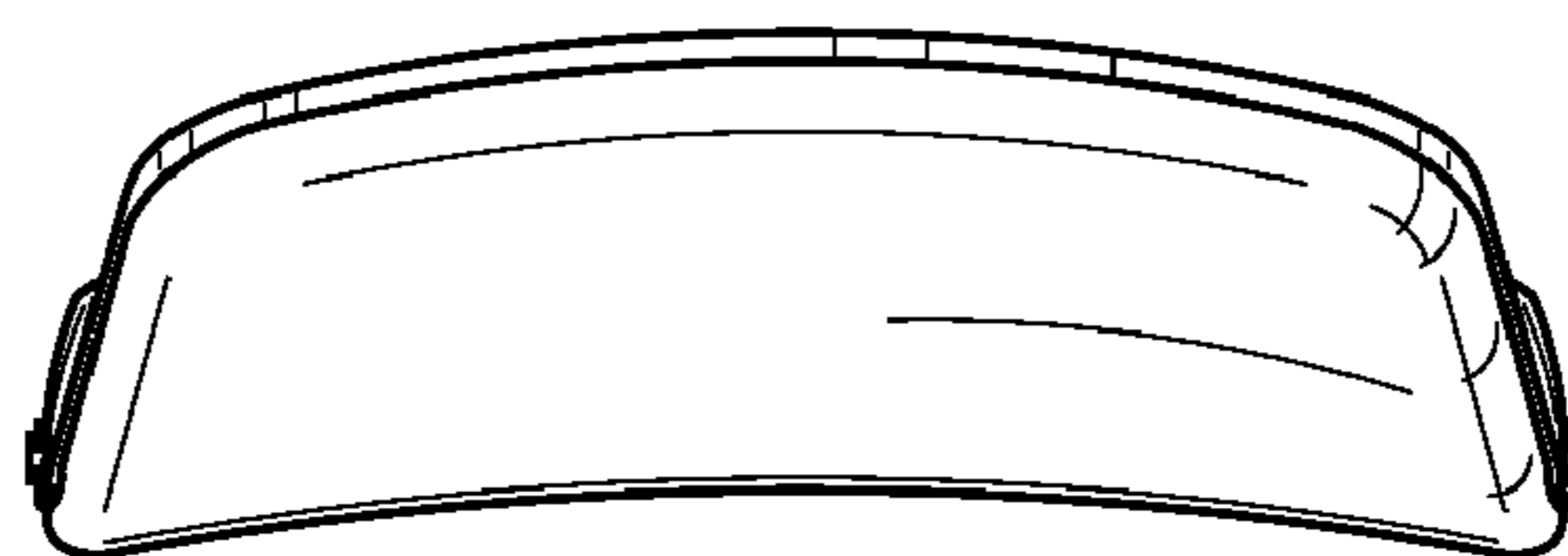

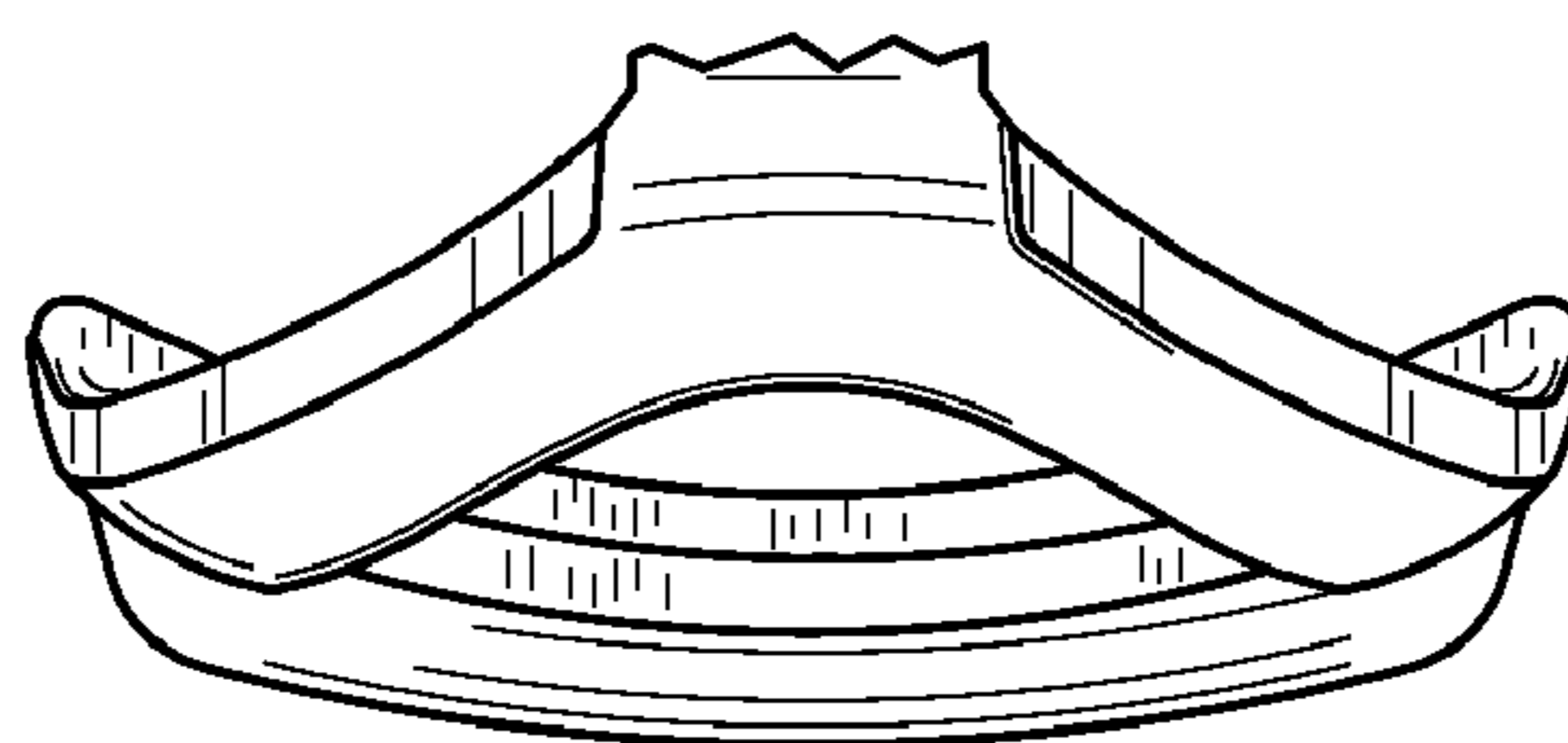
