FIG. 3 is a front view of the bed covering seen in FIG. 1.

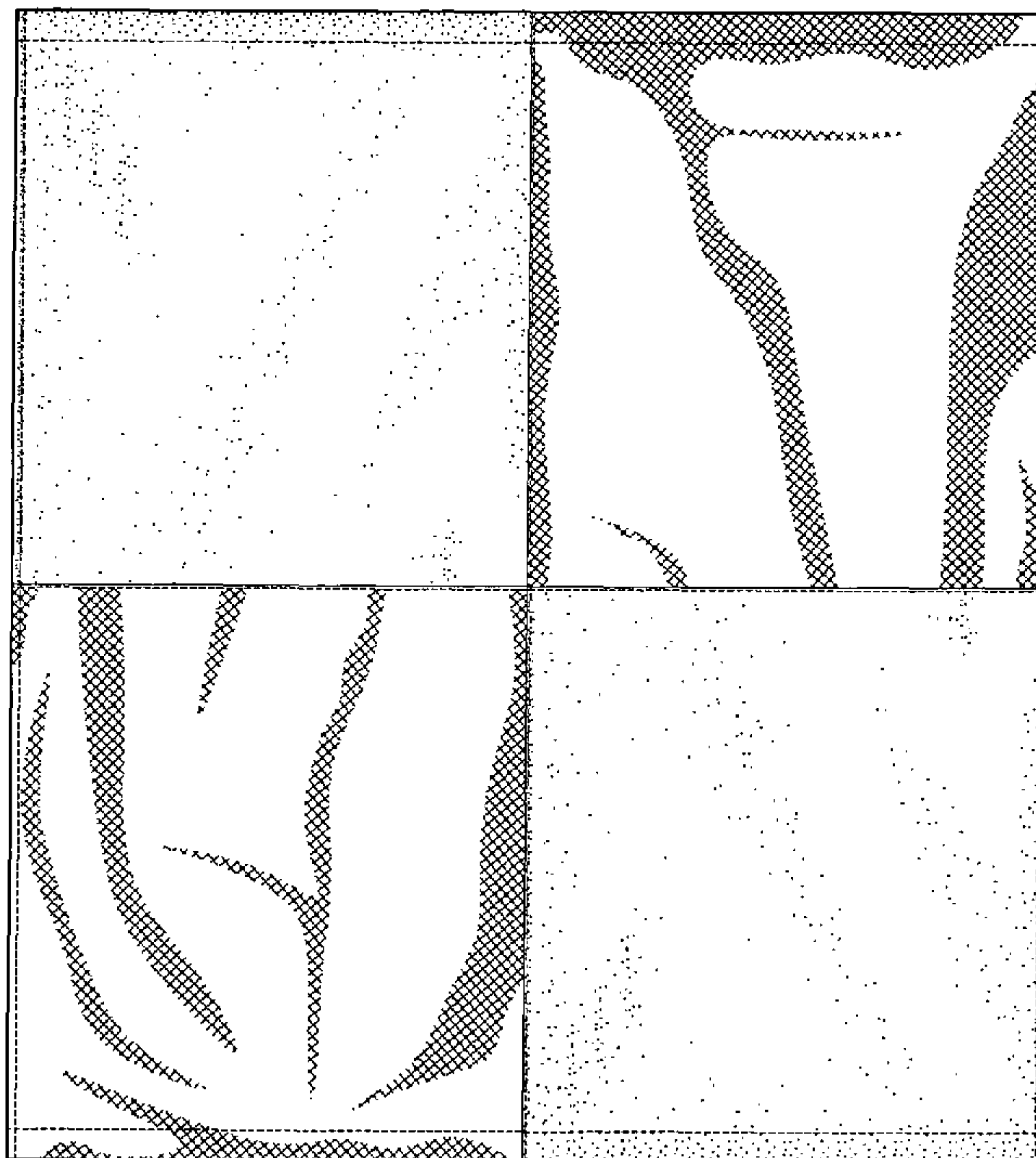
FIG. 4 is a rear view of the bed covering seen in FIG. 1.

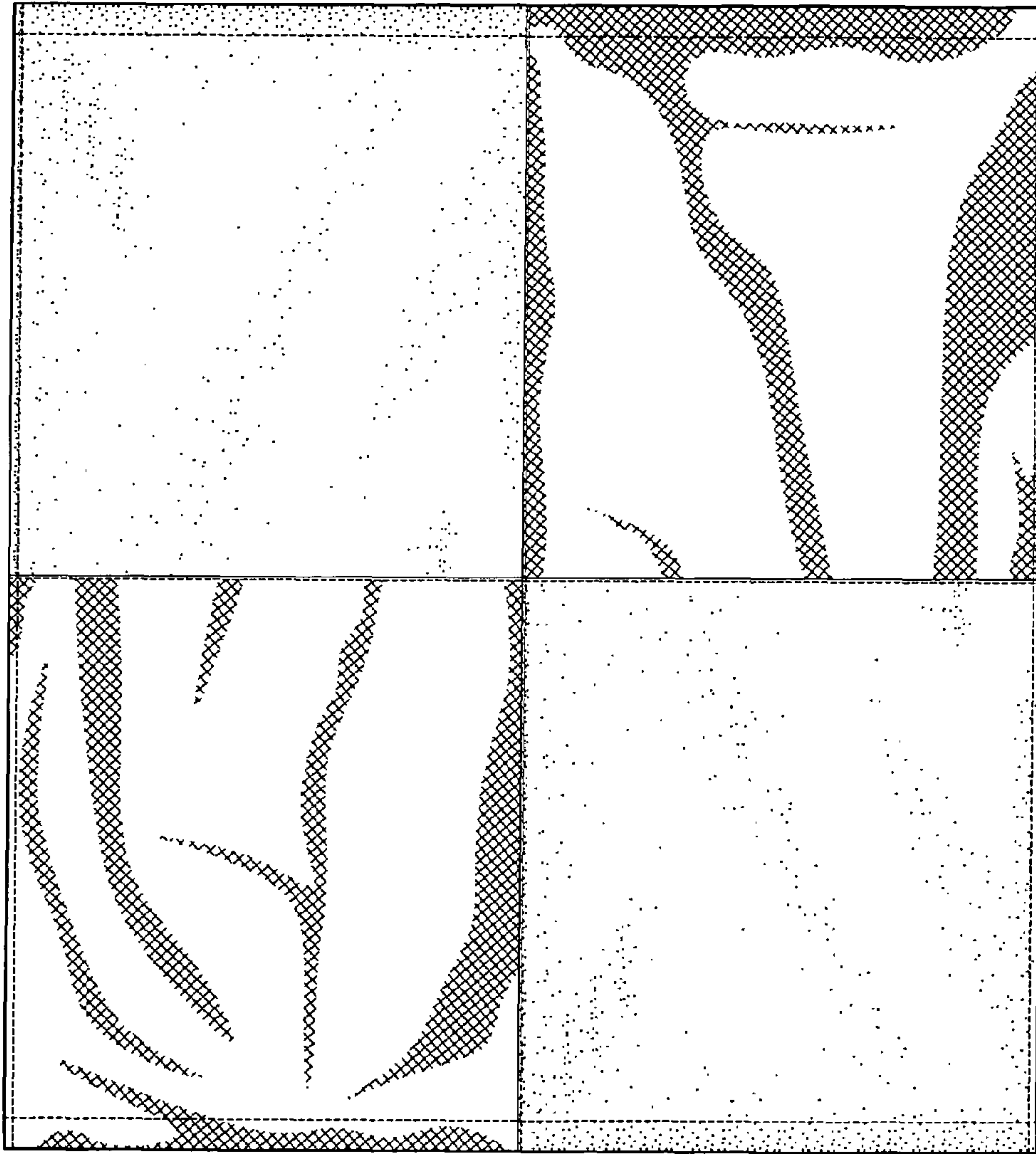

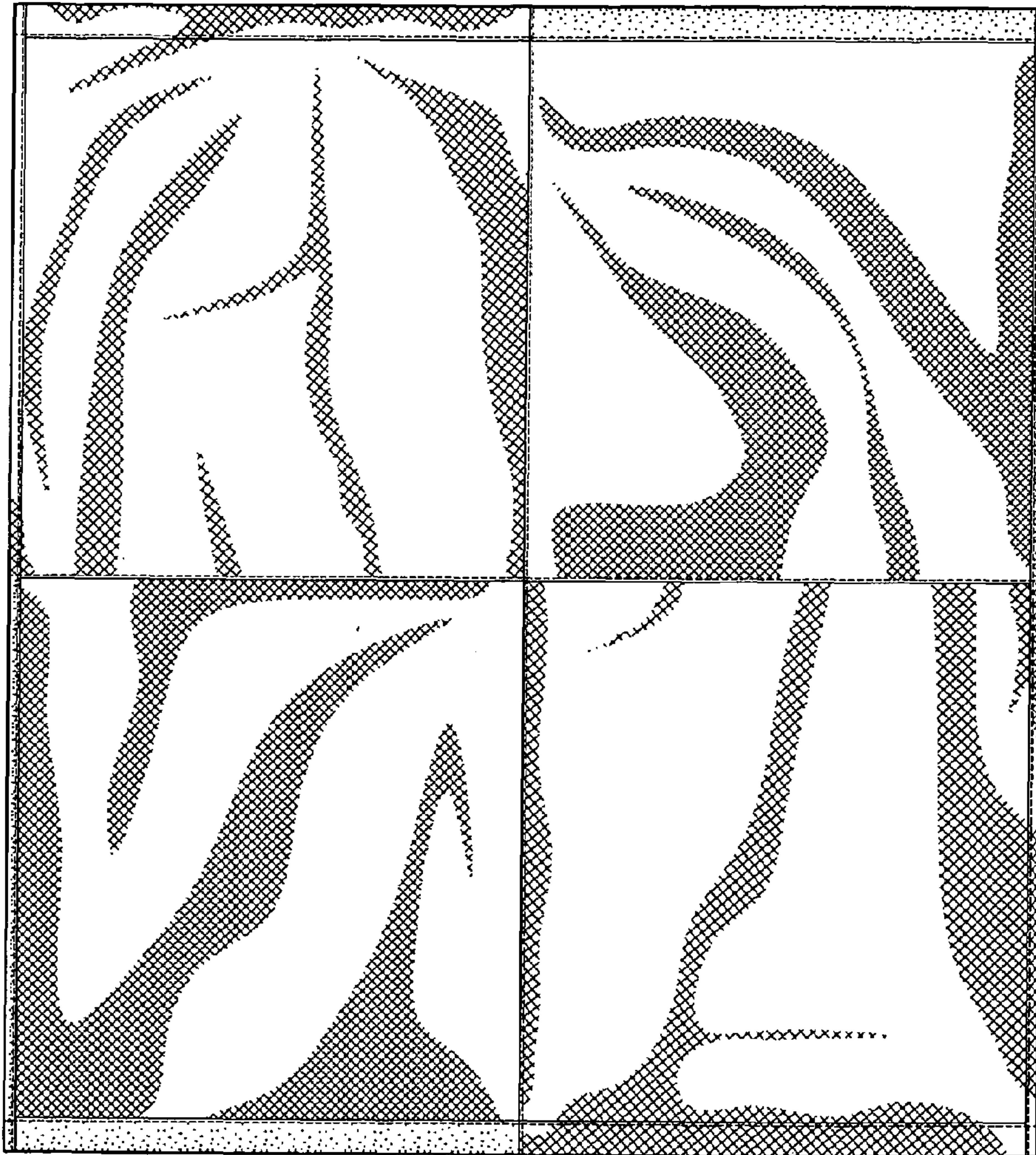
