FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the moldable fabric kayak ornamental design; and,

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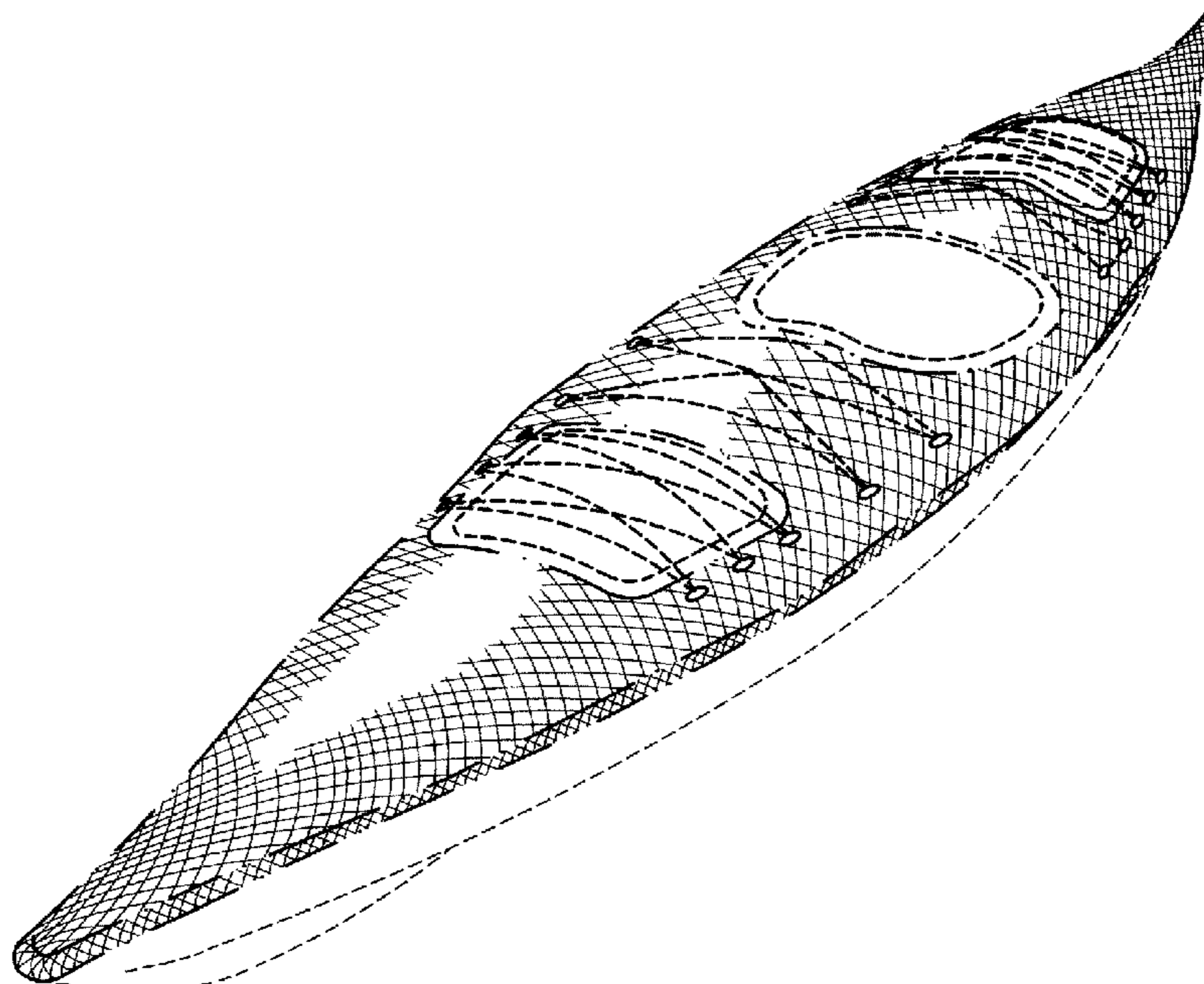
FIG. 7 is a greatly enlarged partial view showing the configuration of the surface of the moldable fabric kayak.

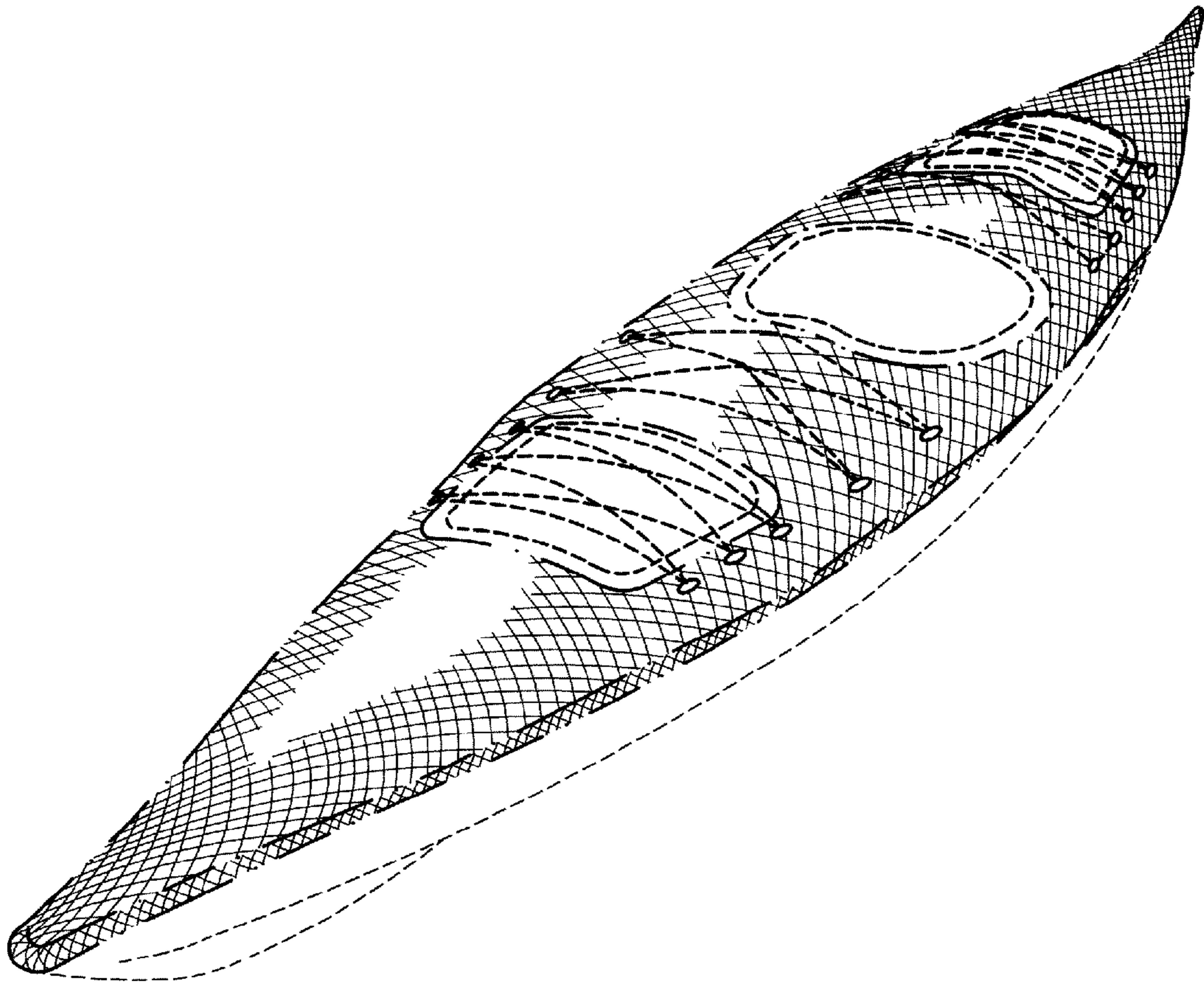

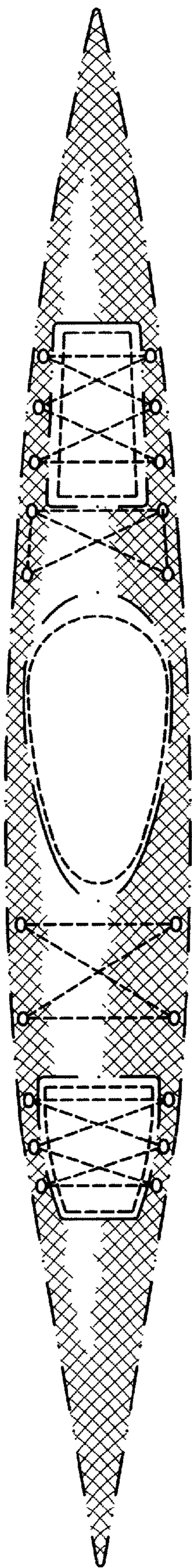

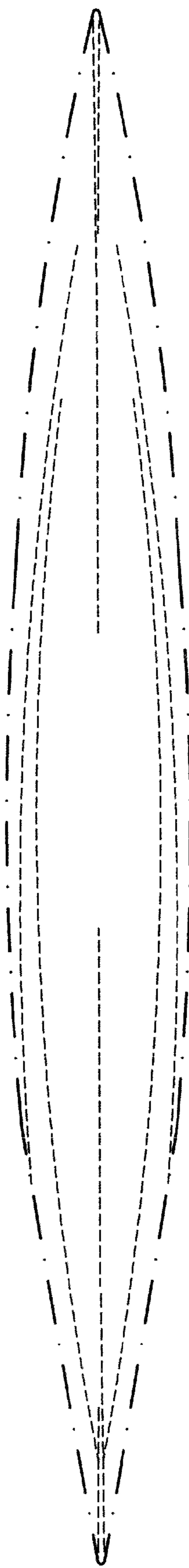

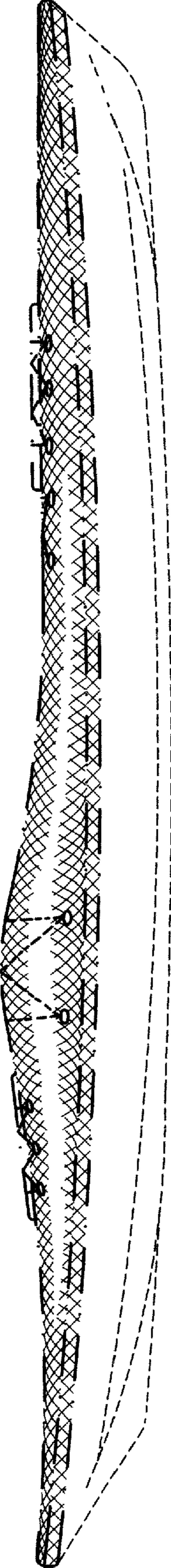

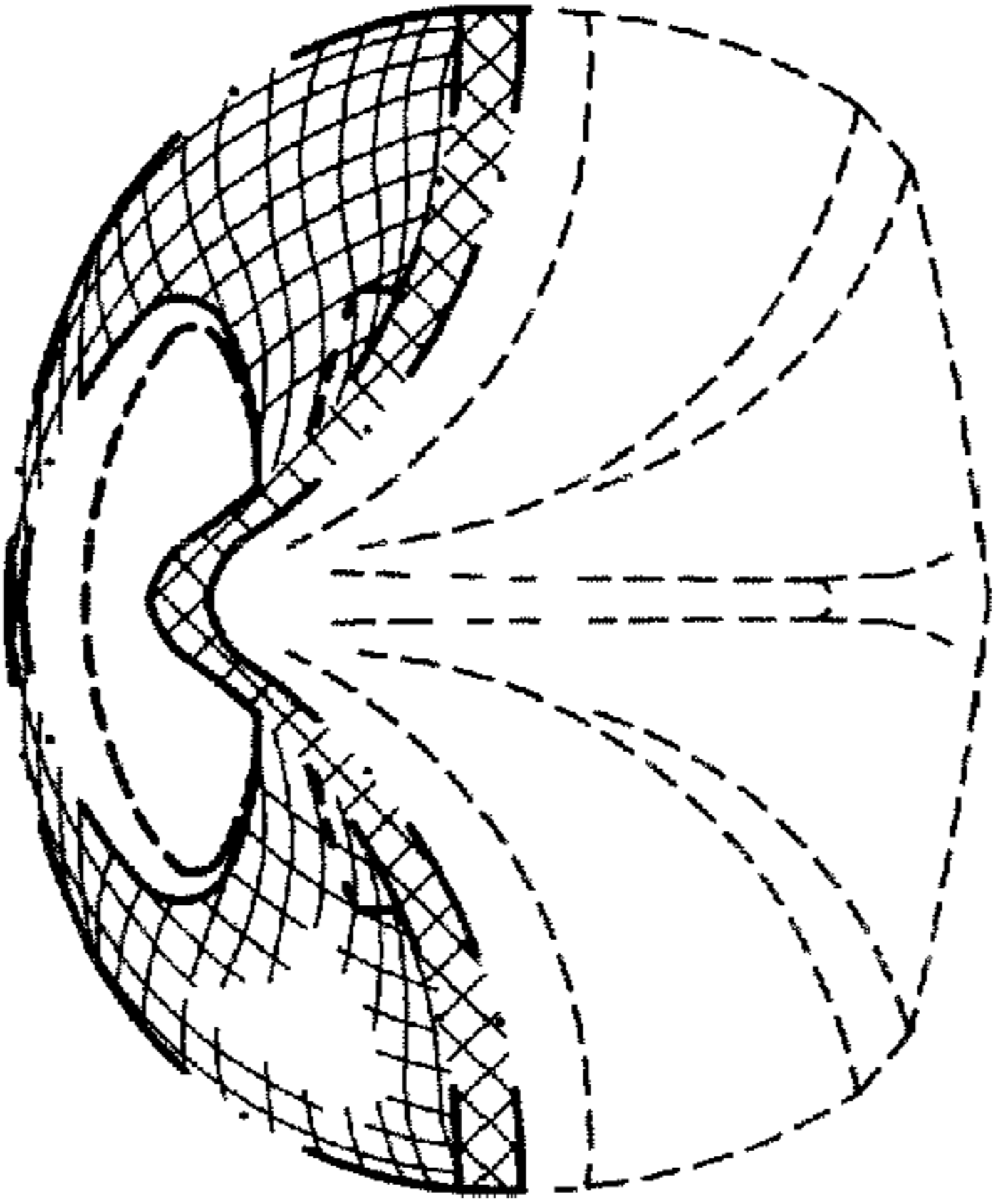

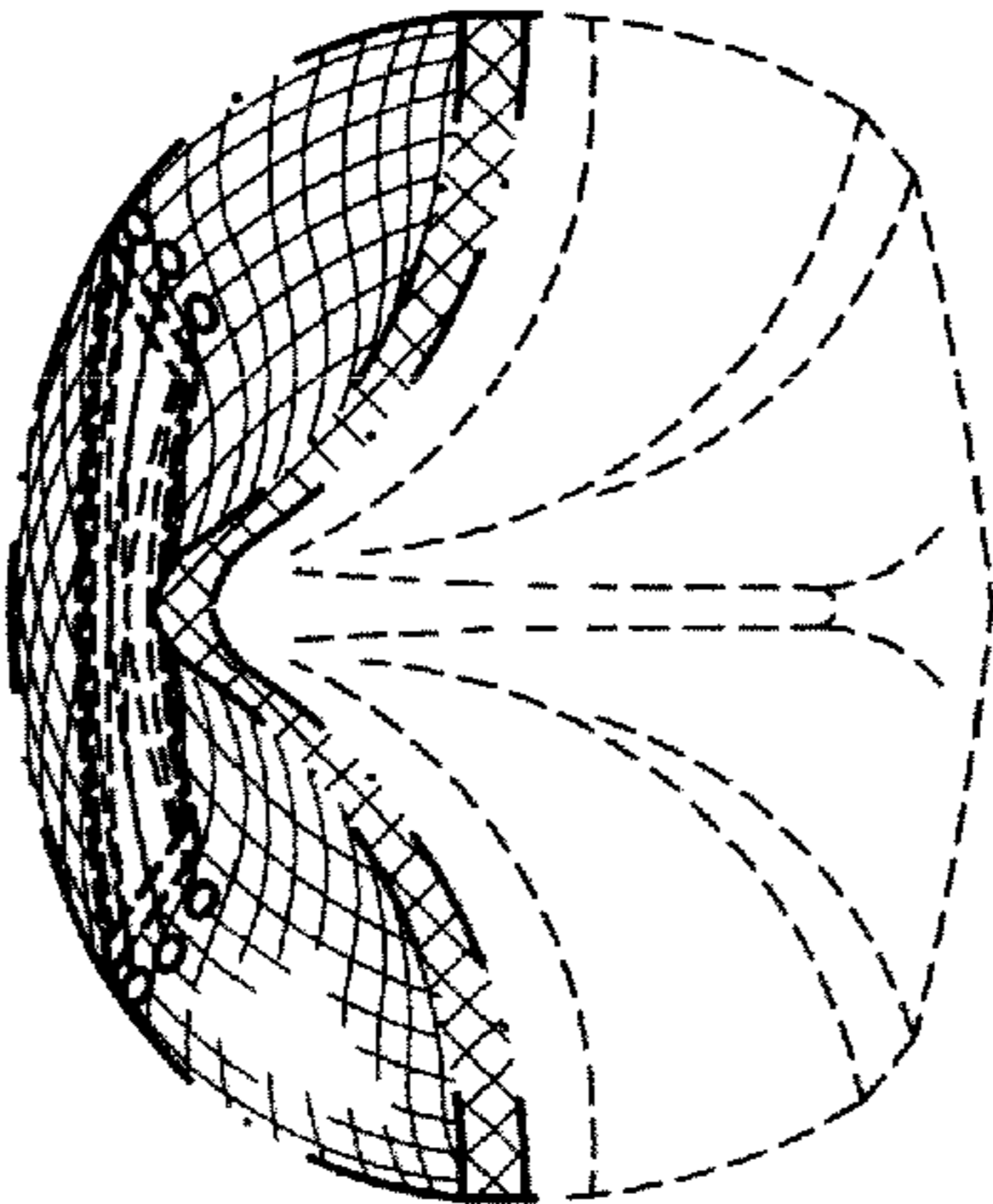

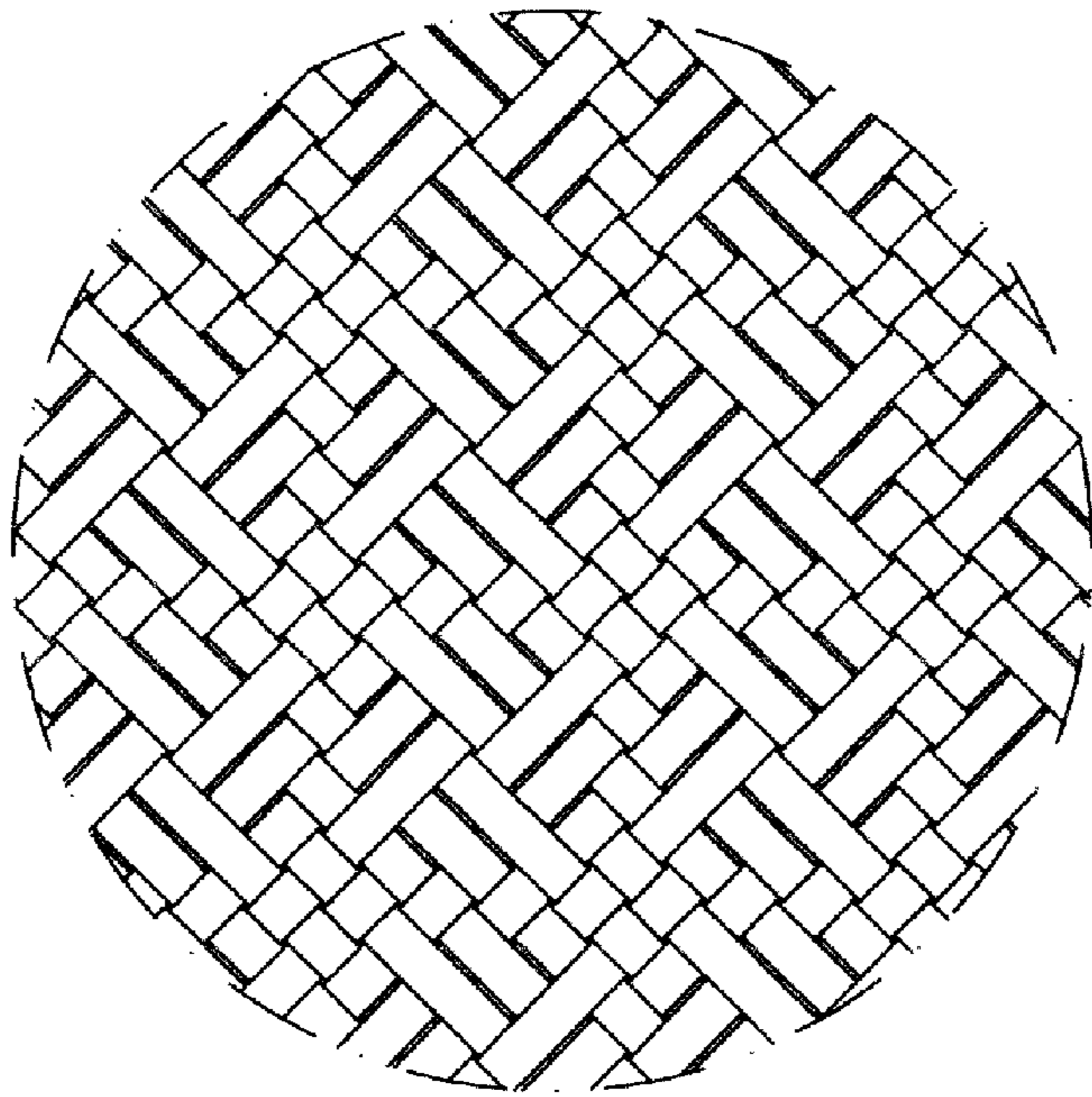
