**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 11 is a front view of the inventive night shade shown in FIG. 8;

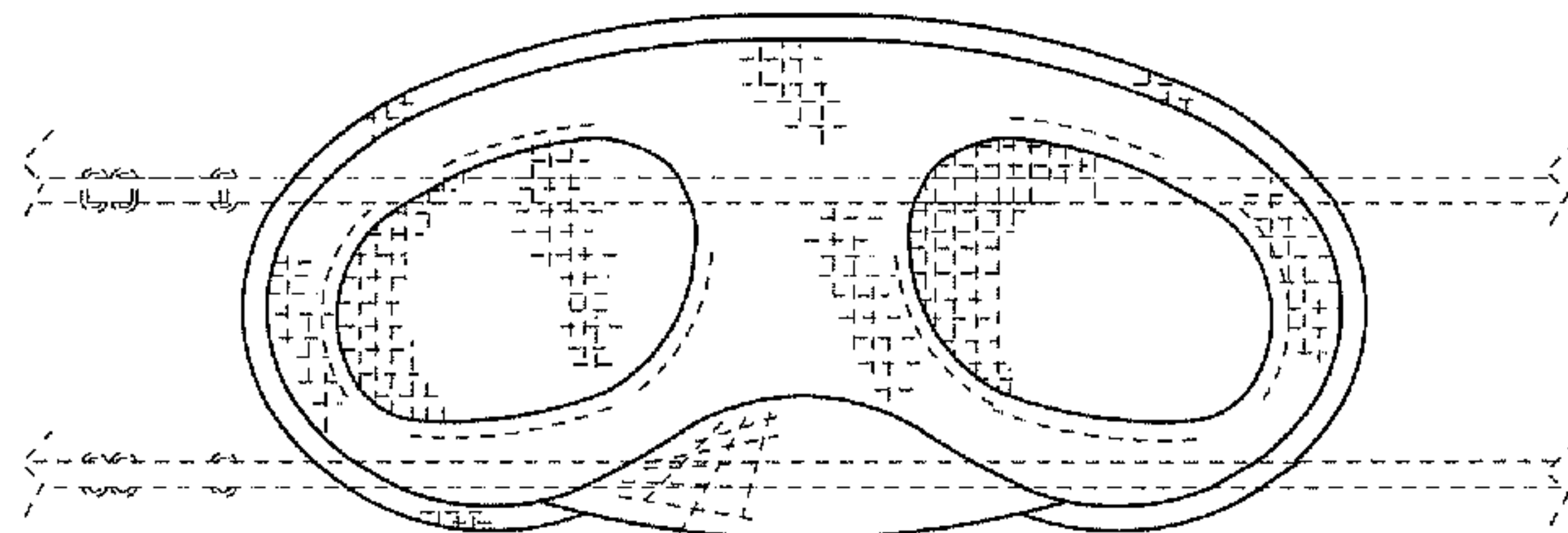
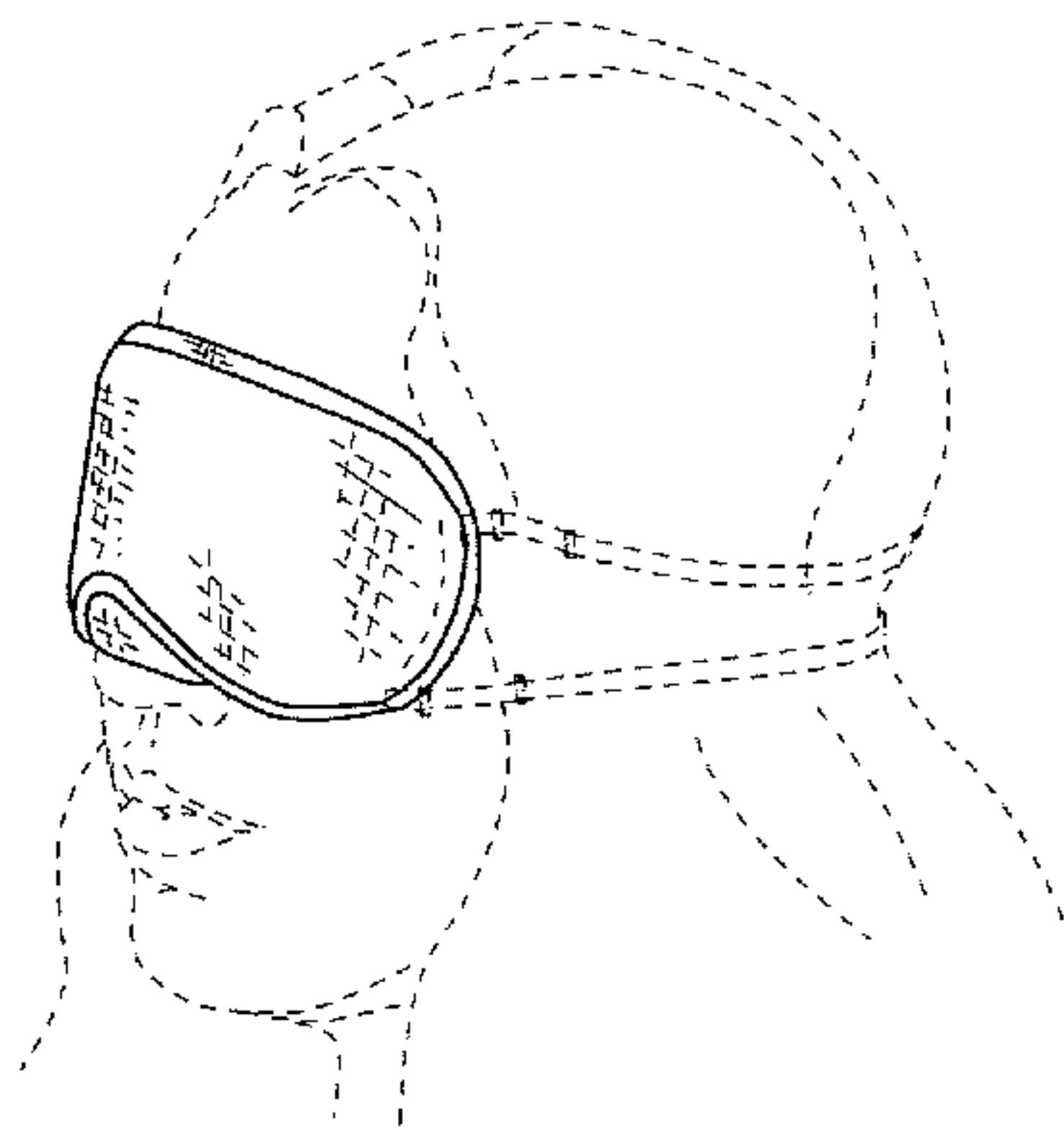
FIG. 12 is a top view of the inventive night shade shown in FIG. 8;

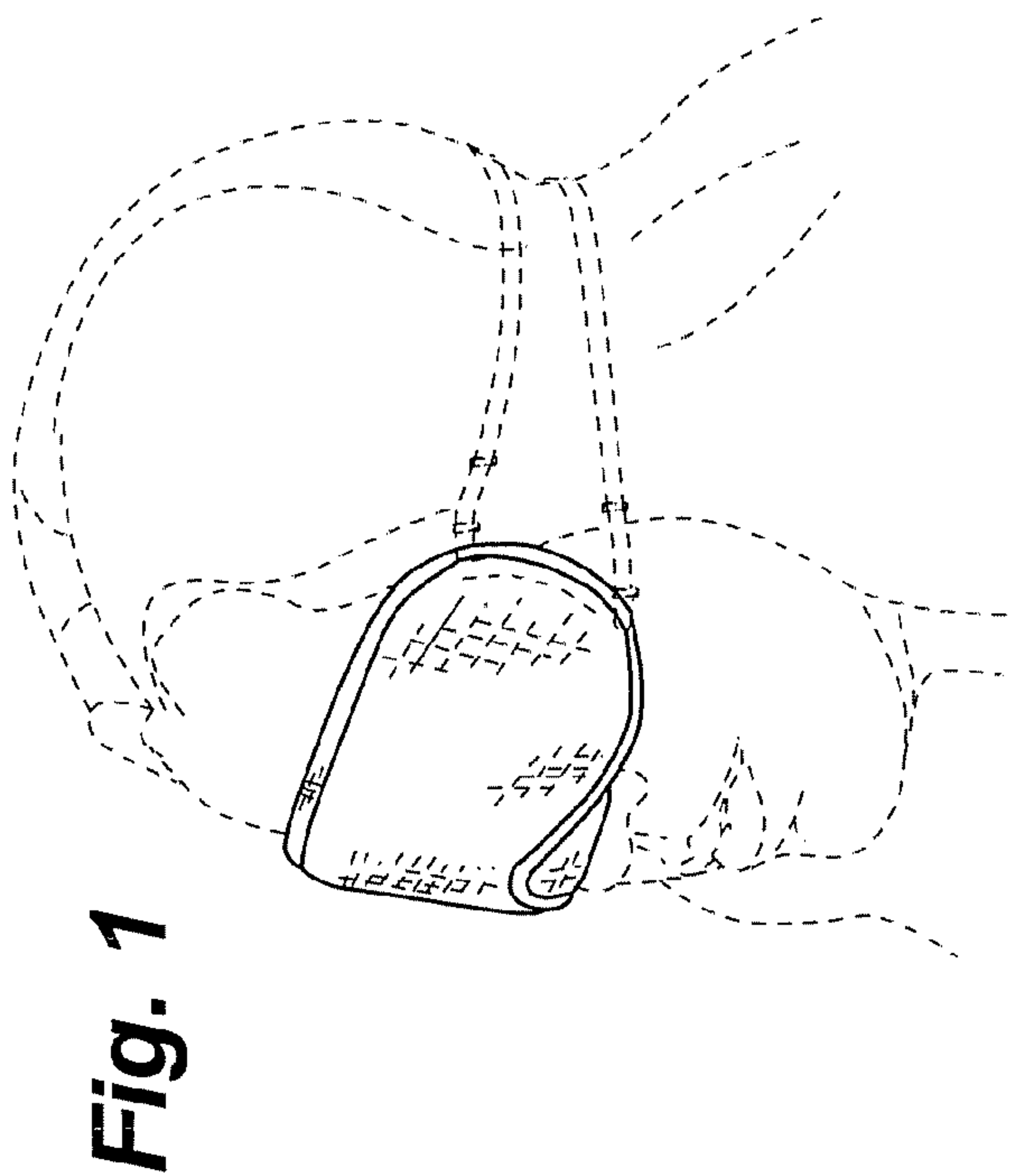
FIG. 13 is a back view of the inventive night shade shown in FIG. 8; and,

FIG. 14 is a bottom view of the inventive night shade shown in FIG. 8.

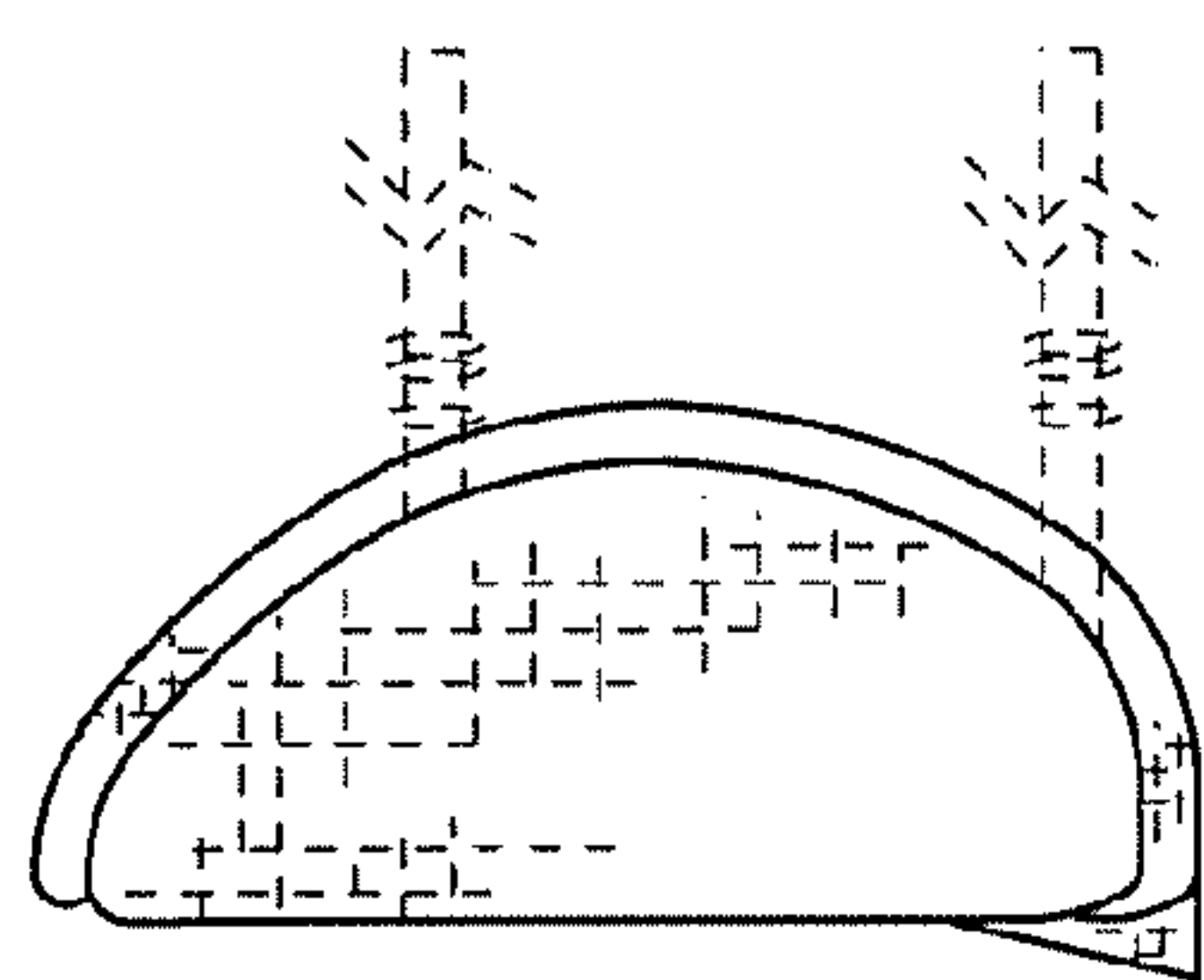
The broken lines showing the straps and human model are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

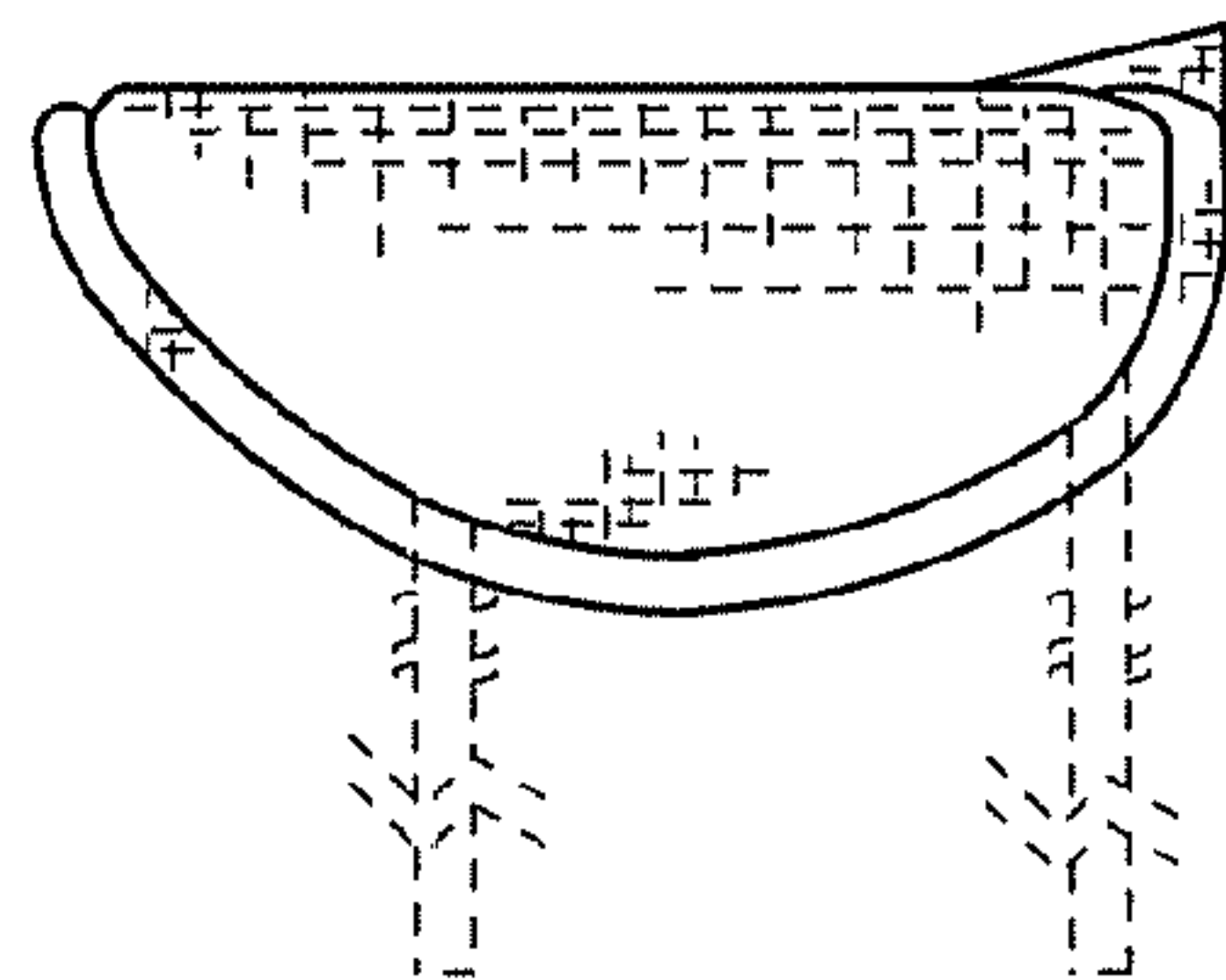




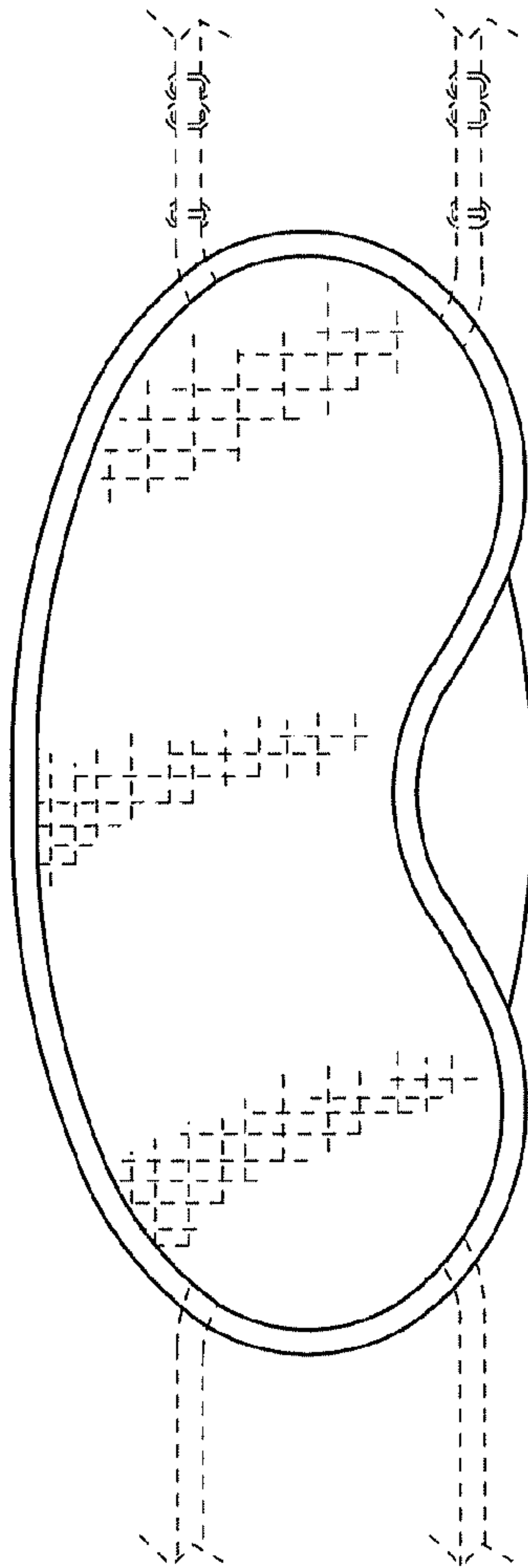

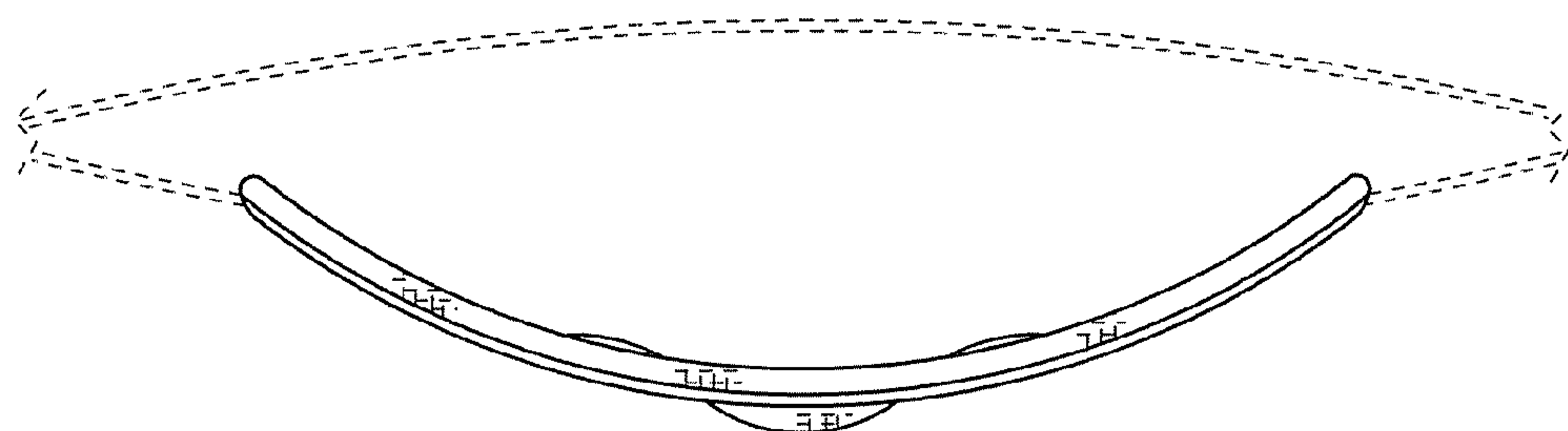

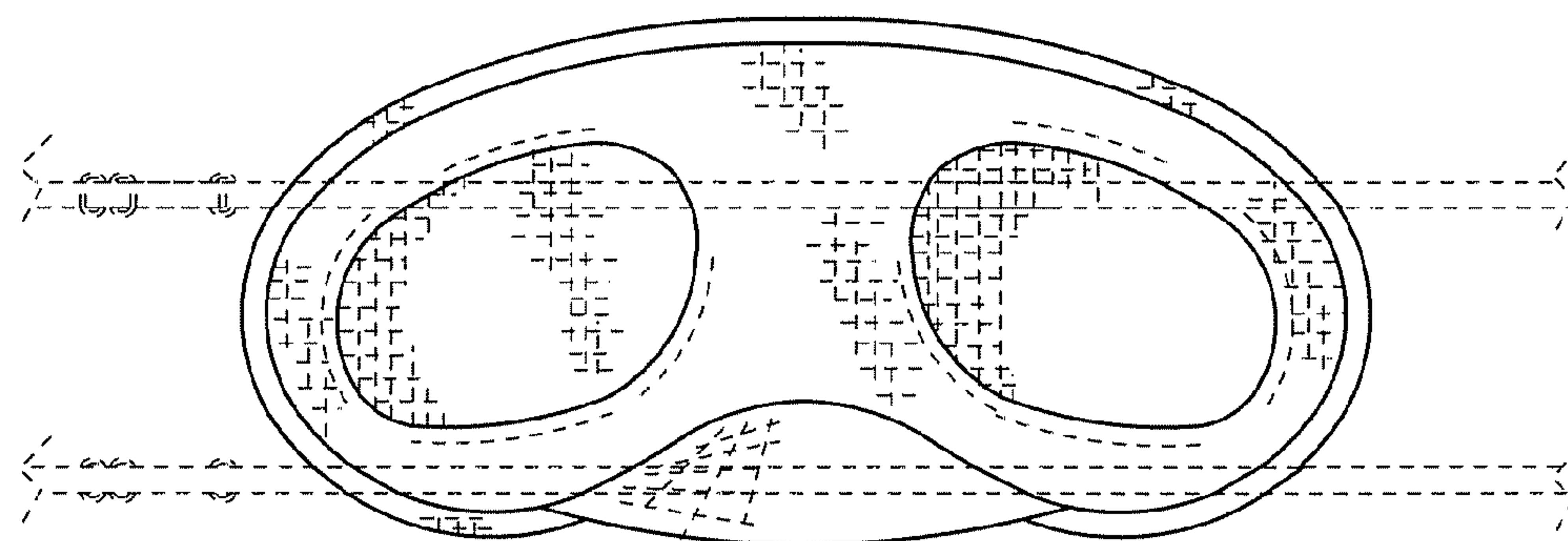

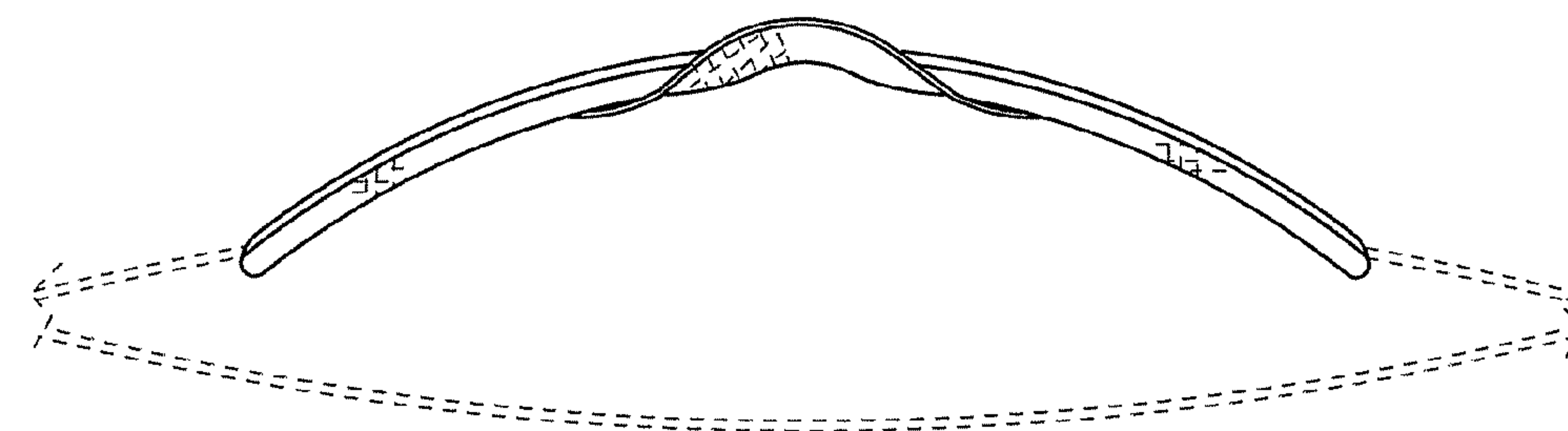

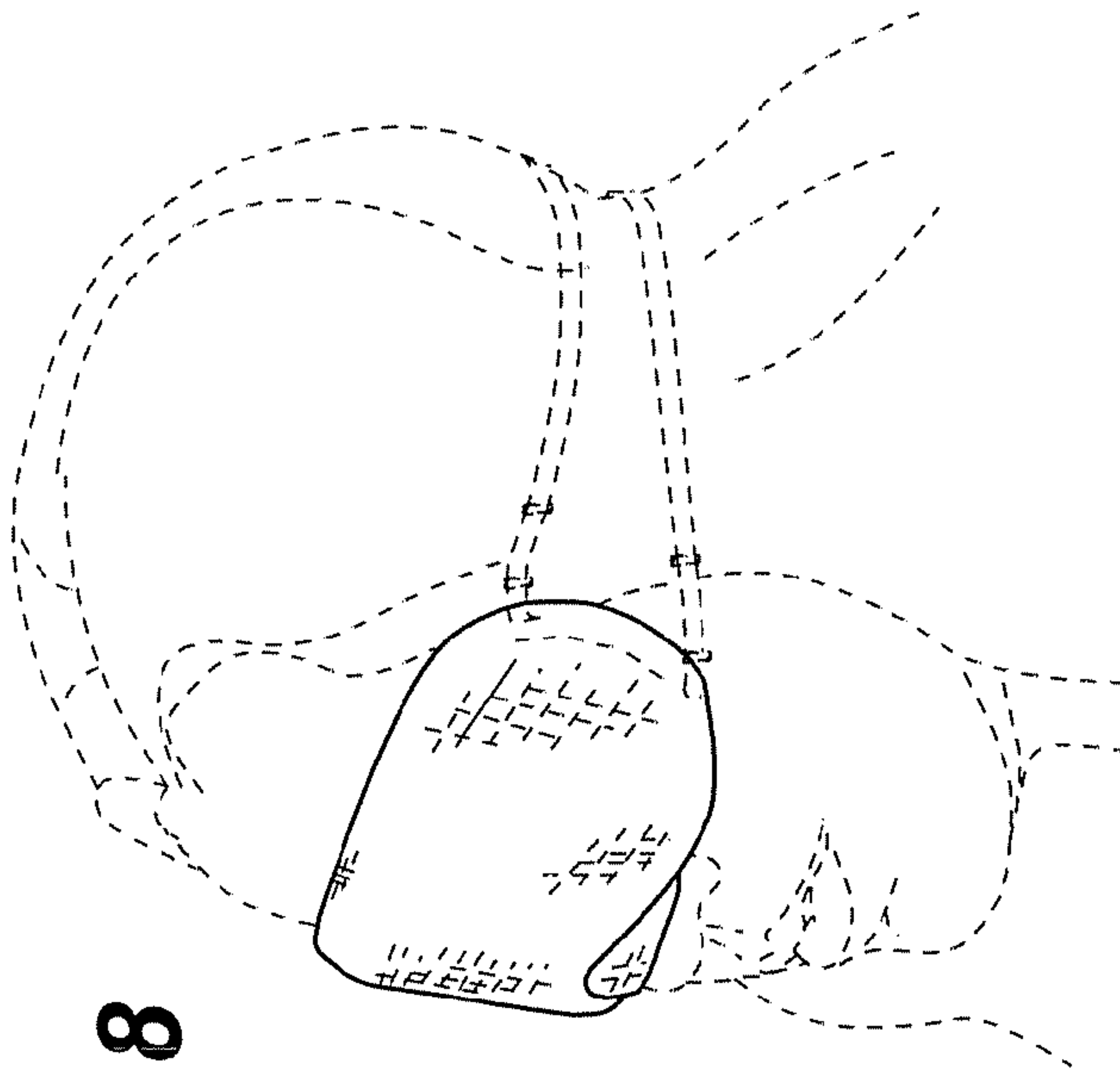

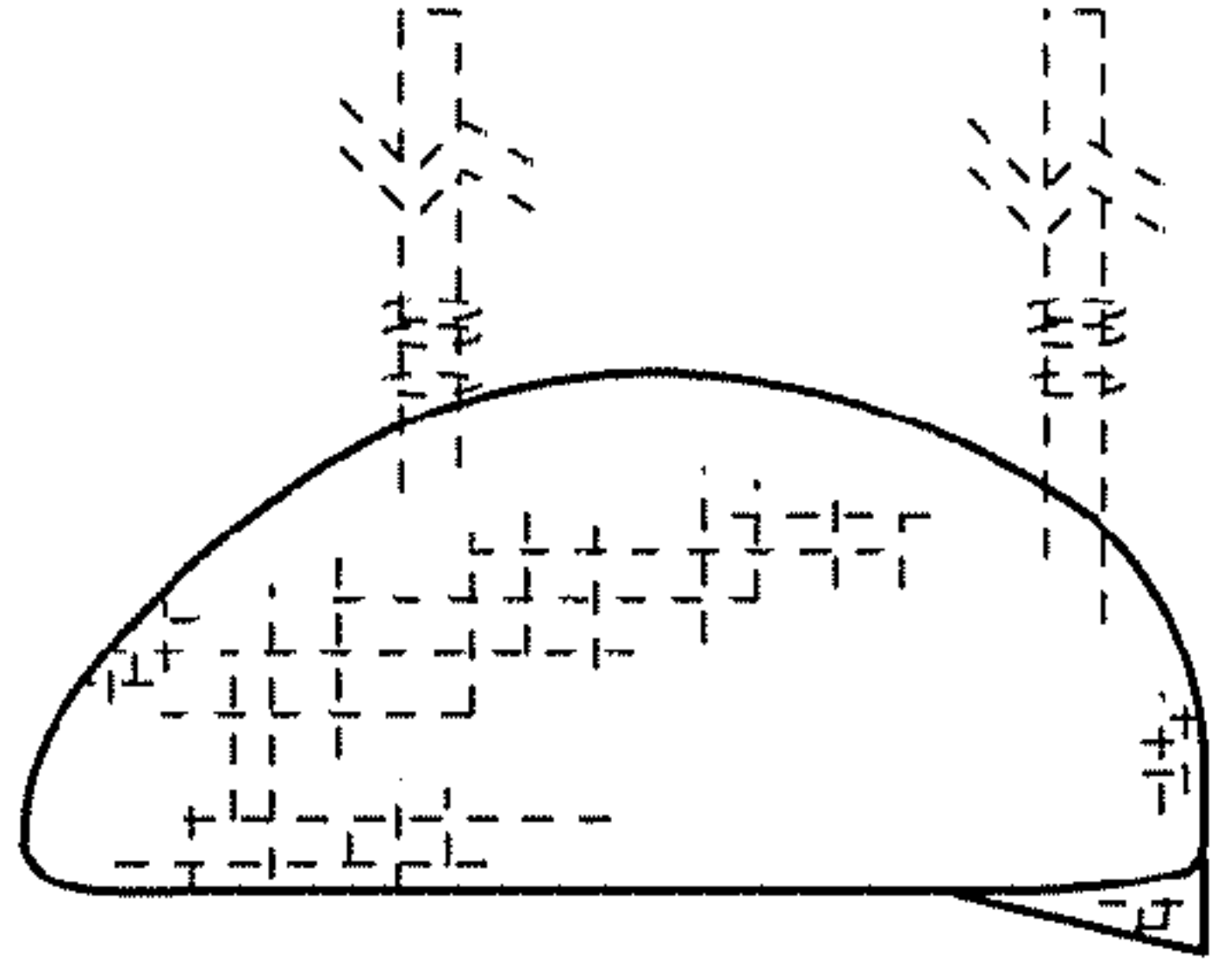

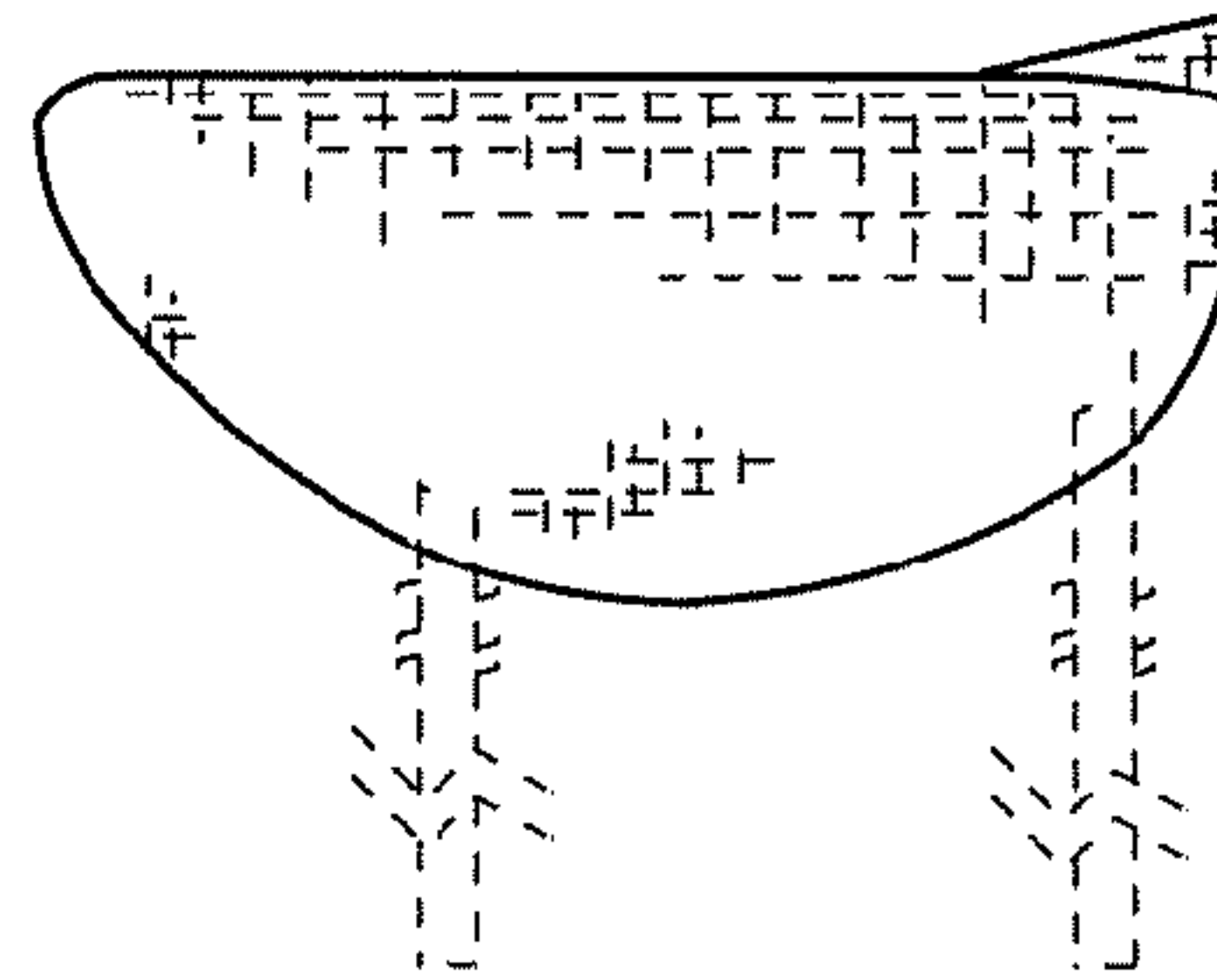

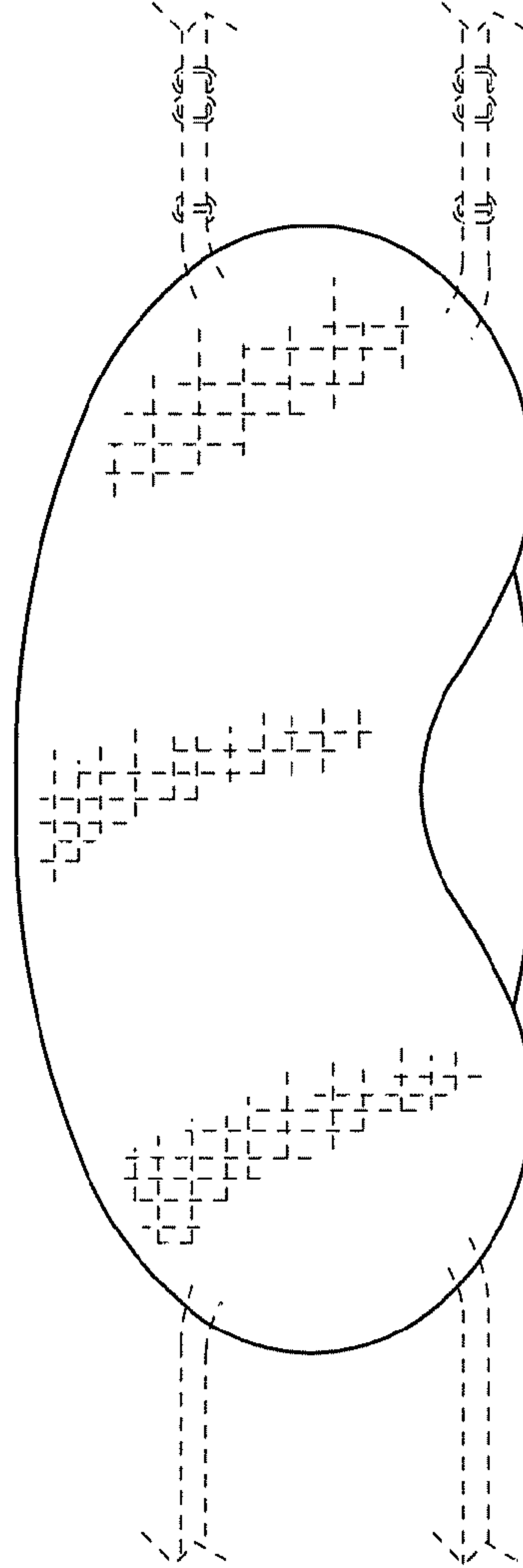

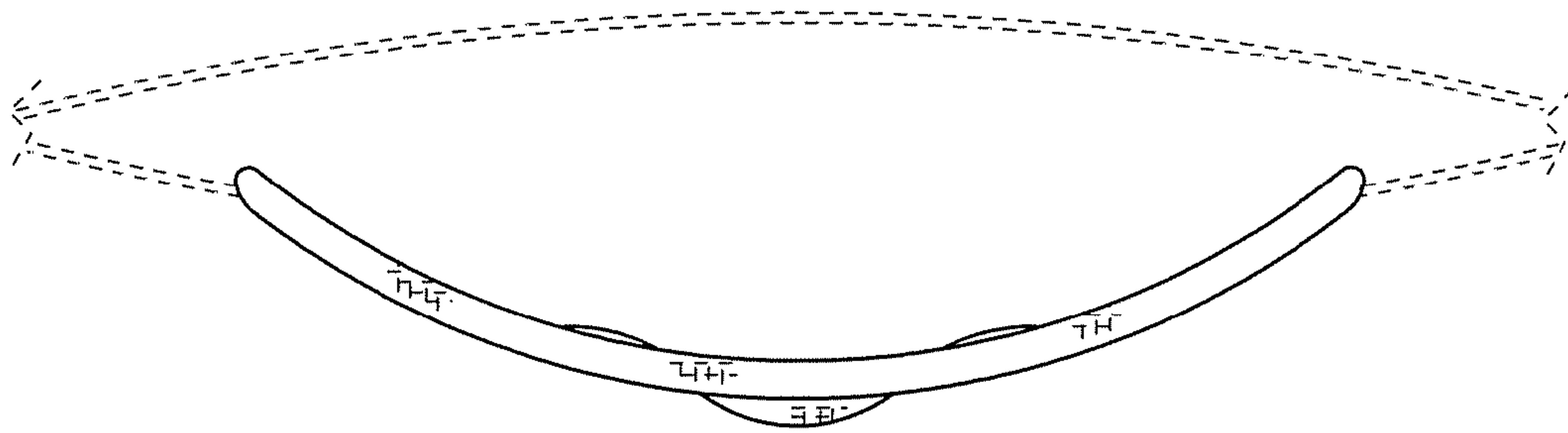

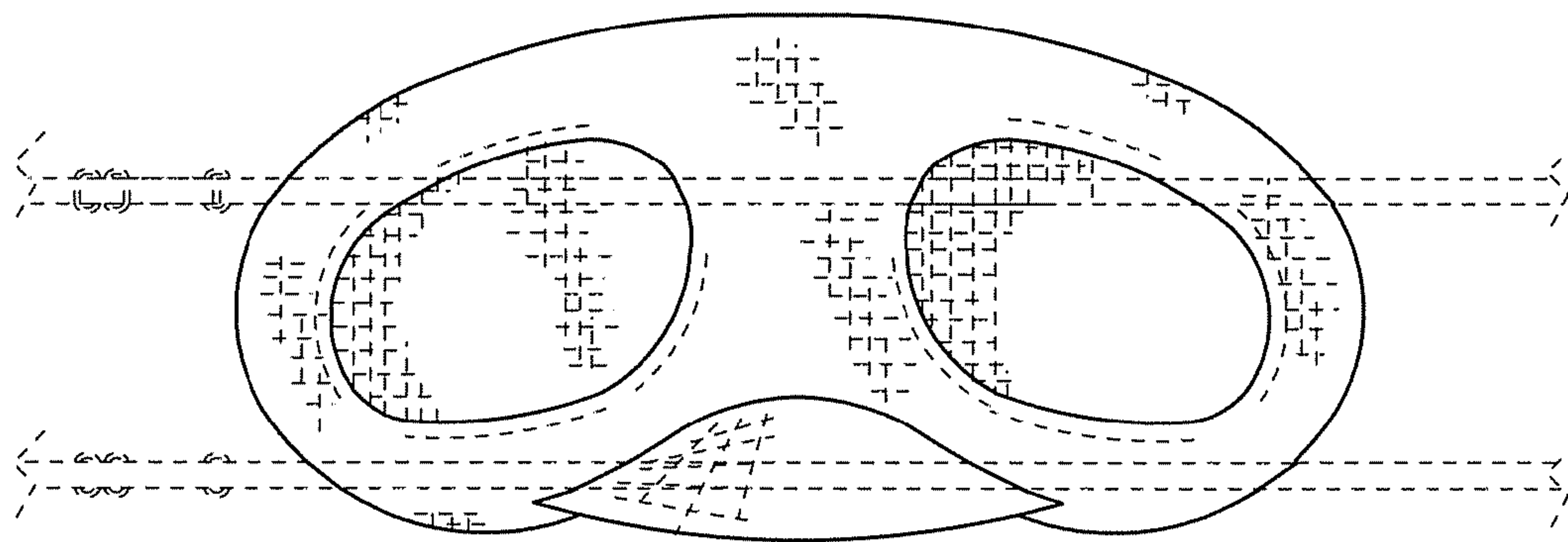

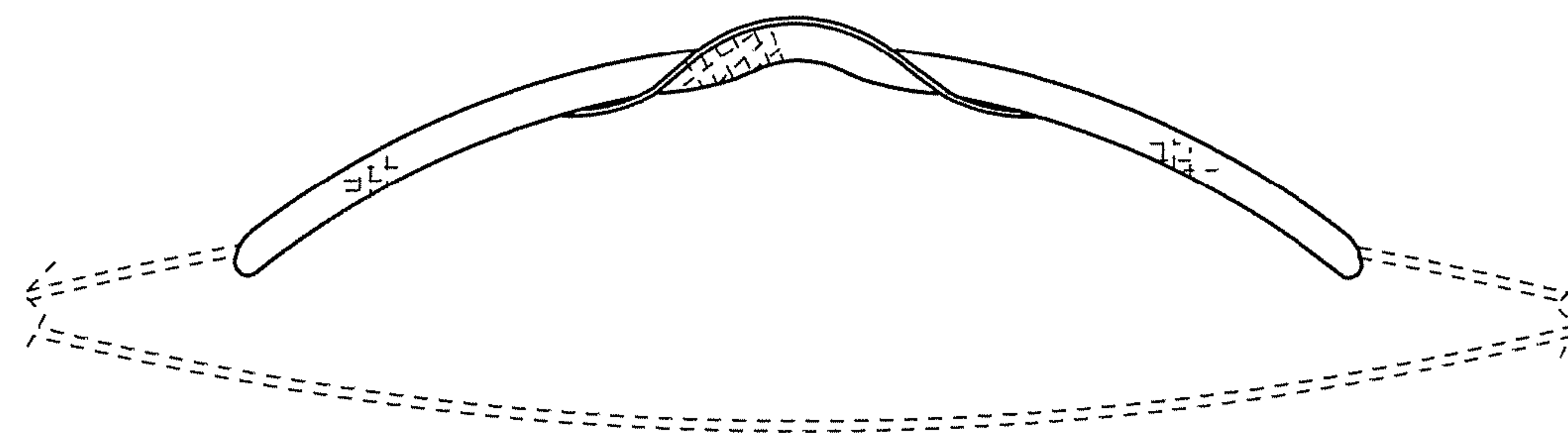
