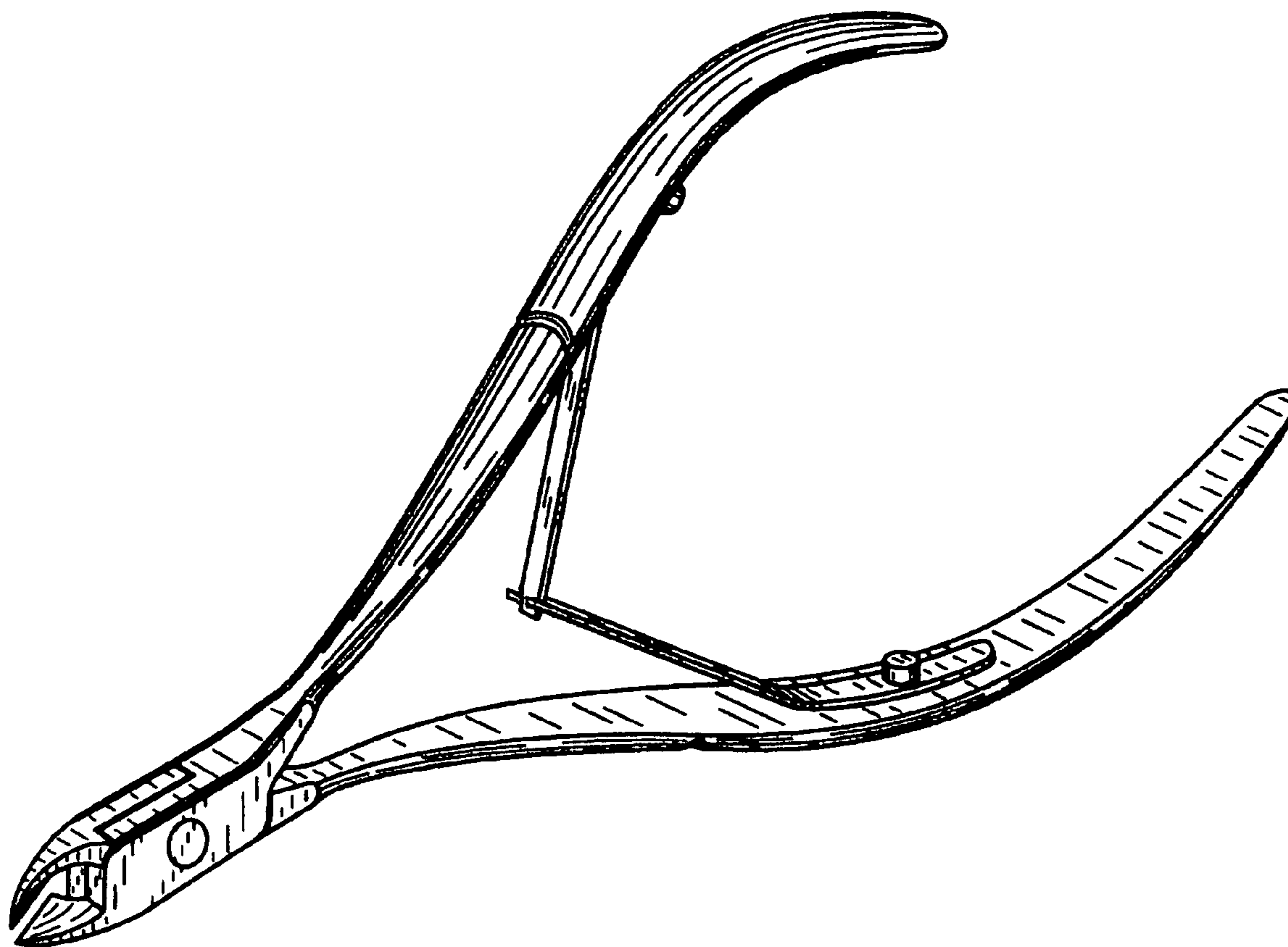
FIG. 1 is a front, side perspective view of my new design;

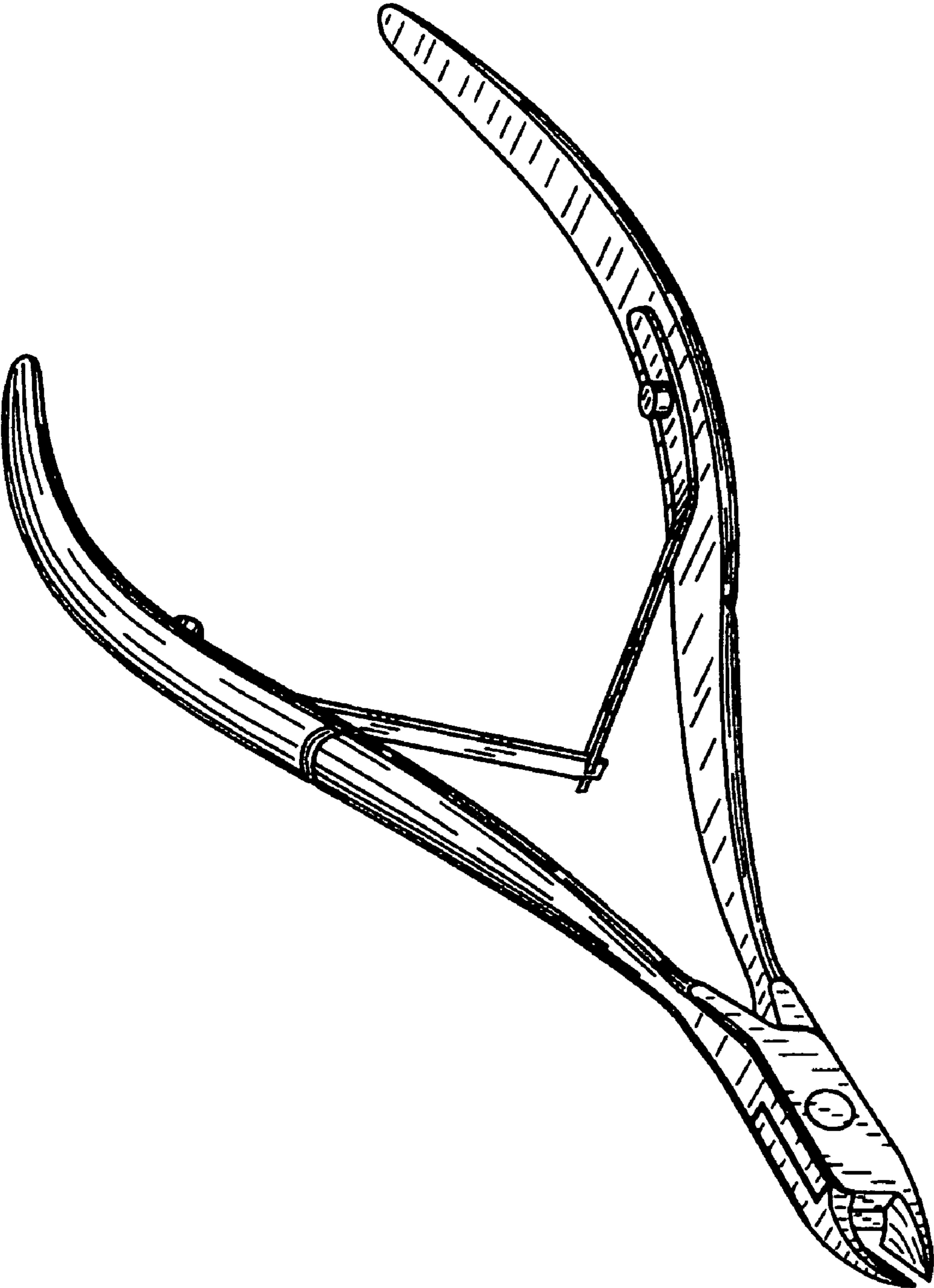

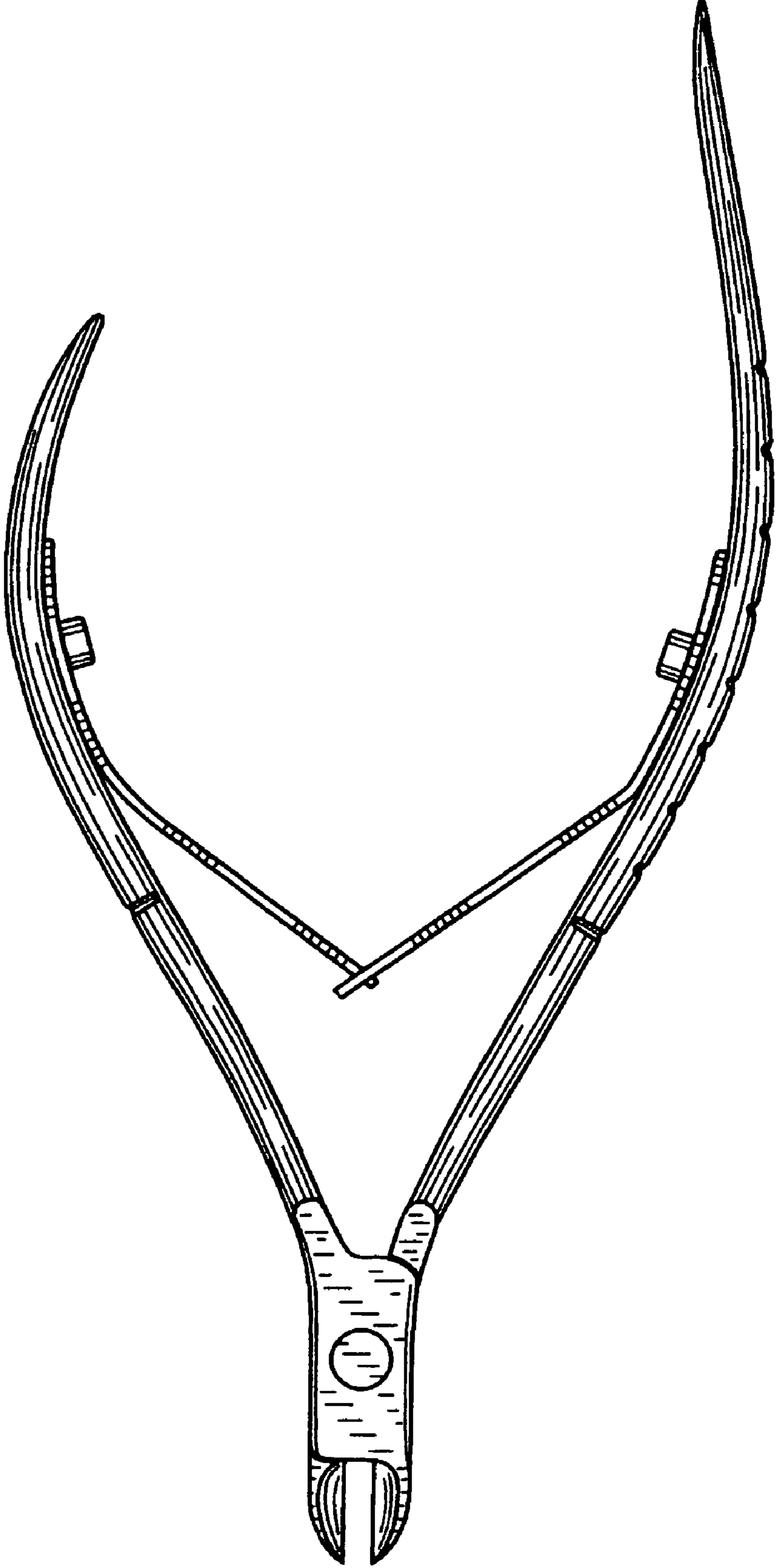

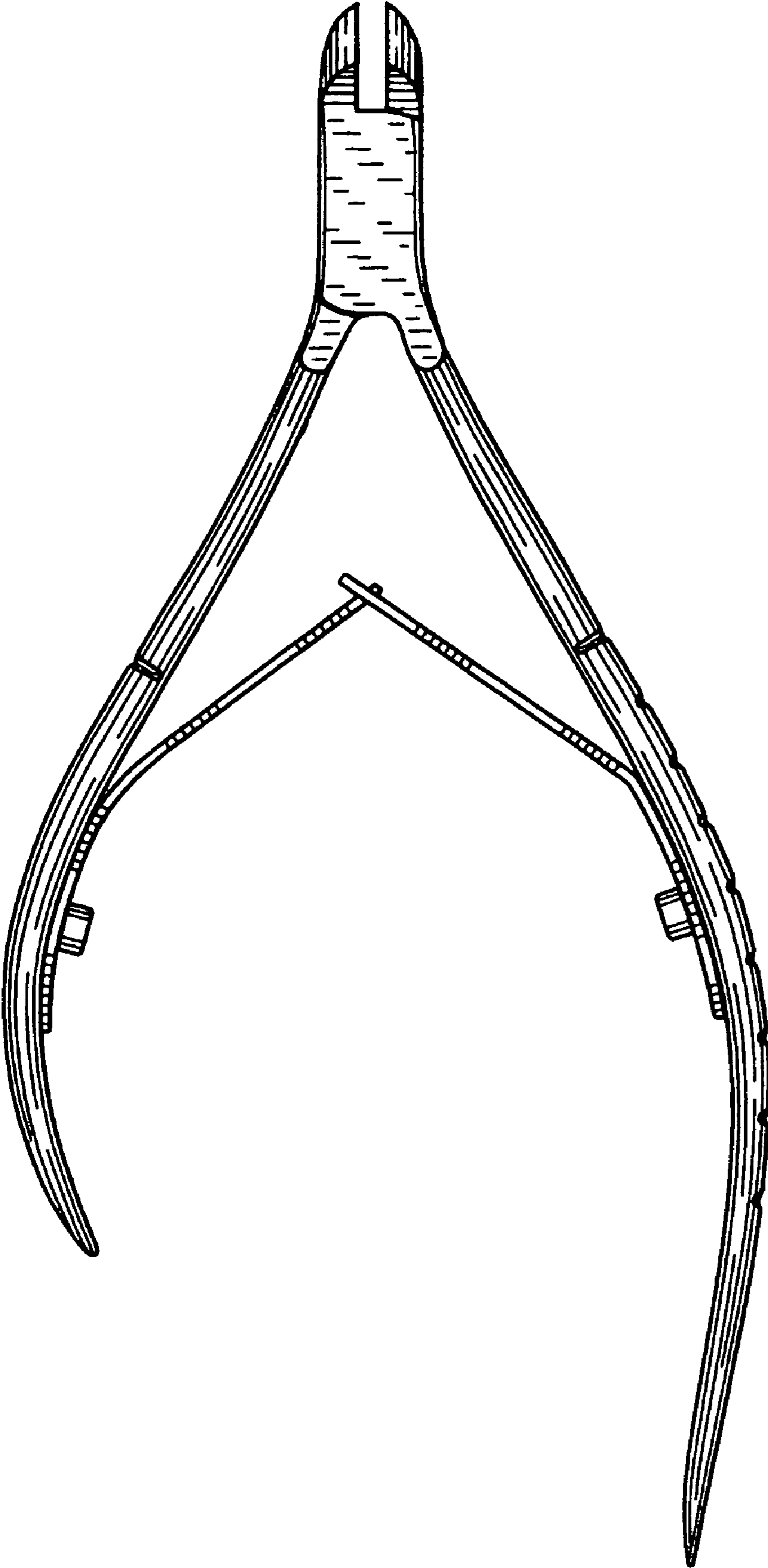

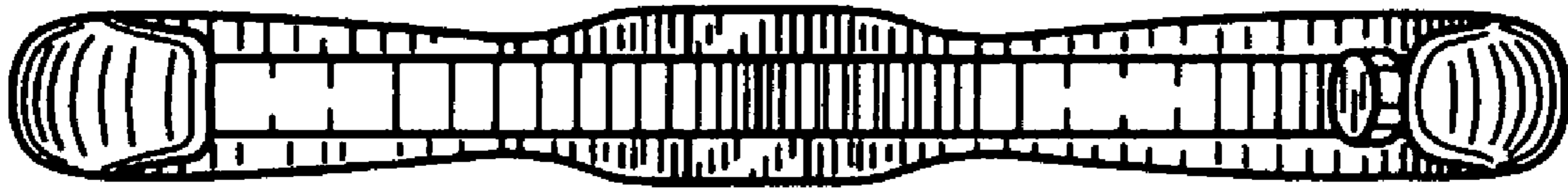
